**DESCRIPTION**

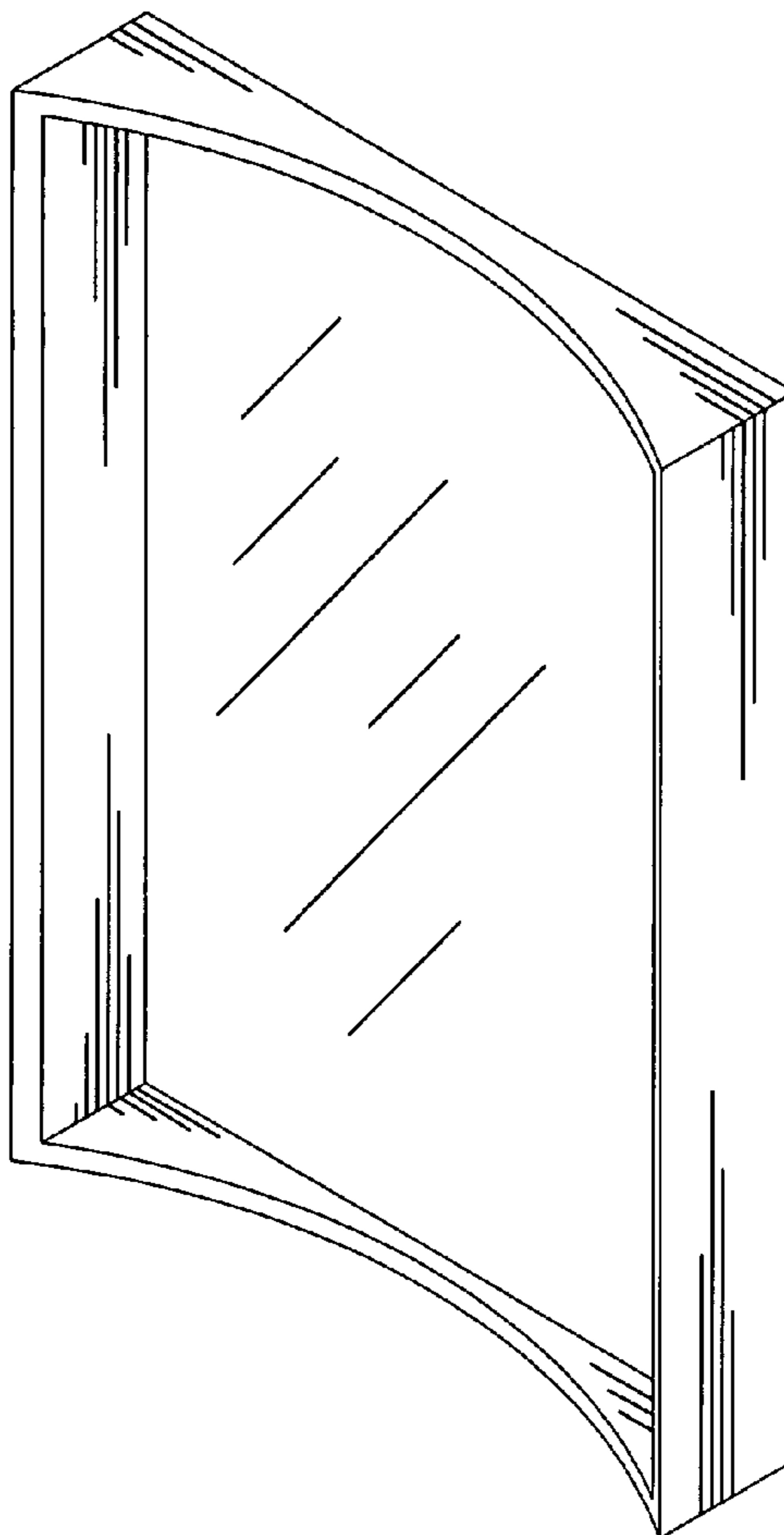
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the new design;

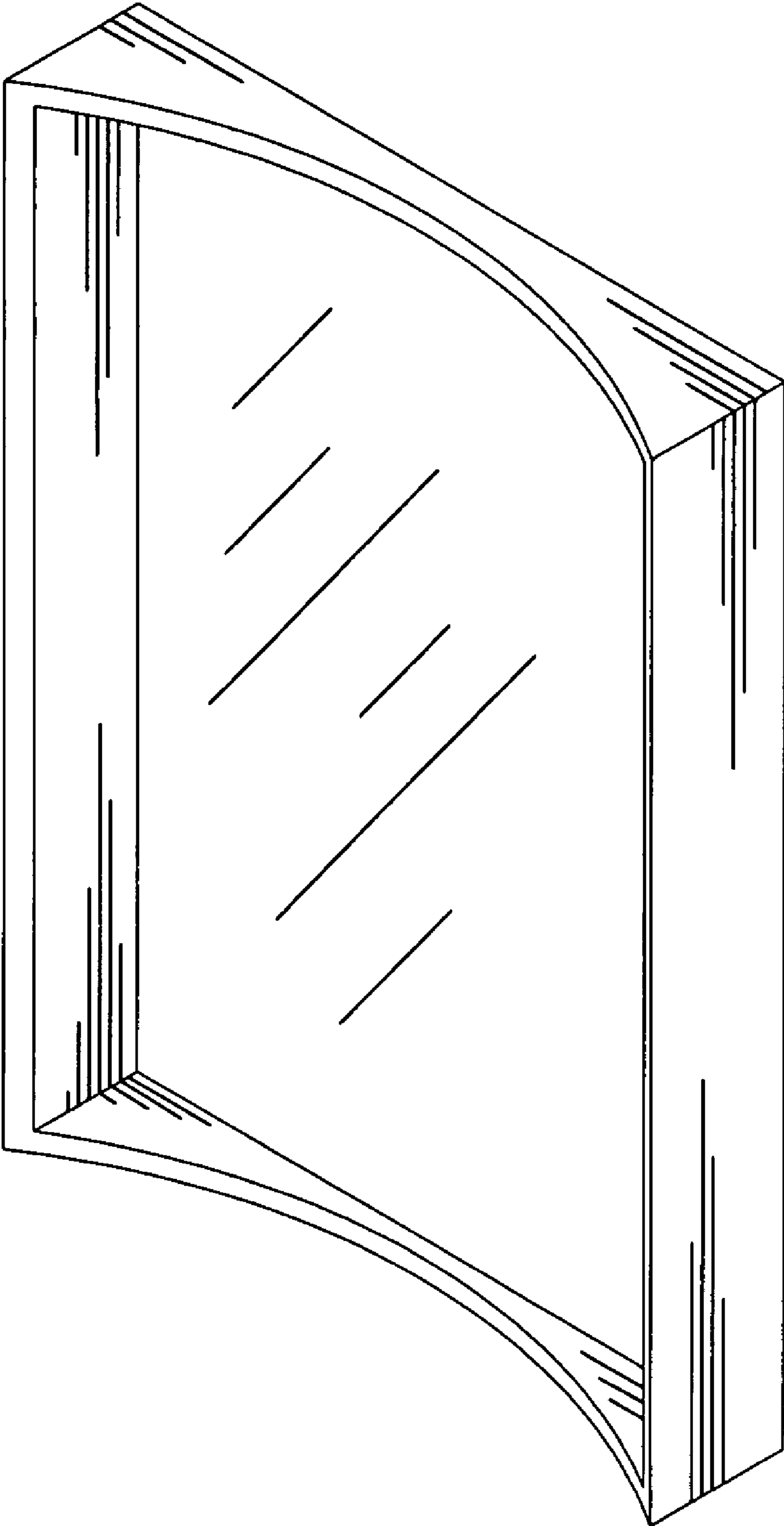

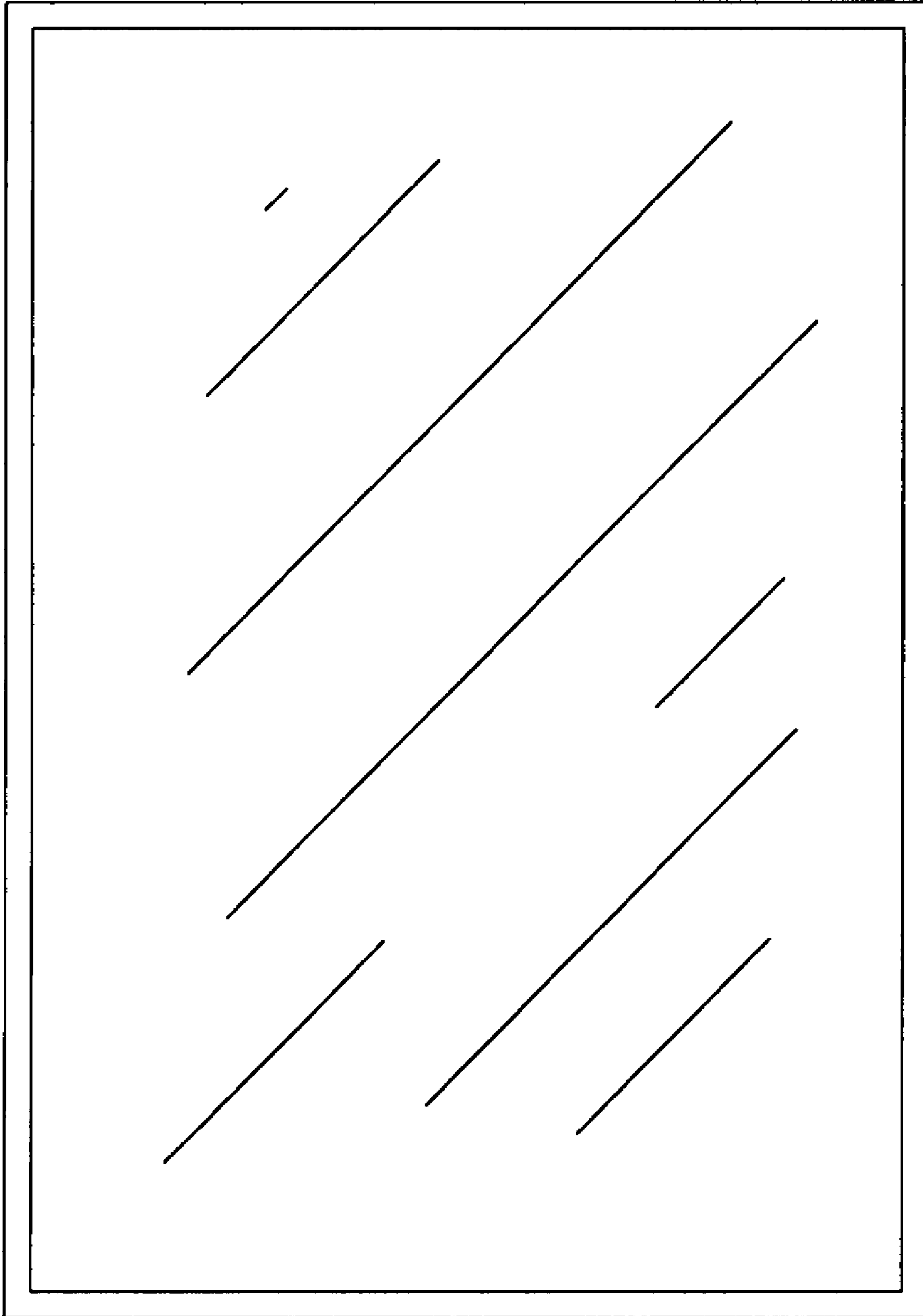

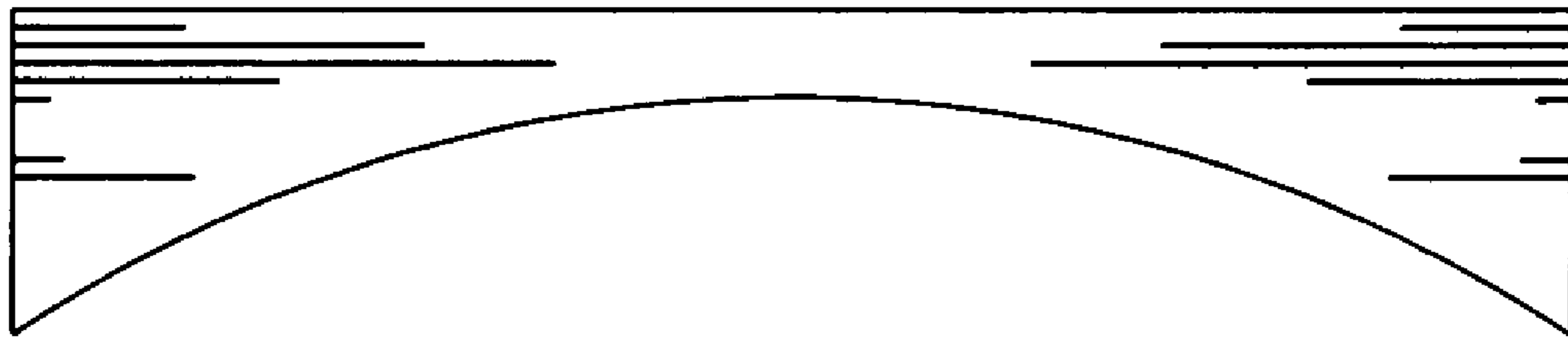
