(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a seat and back rest for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the top, left side and front of a seat and back rest for a chair which forms my new design, the broken lines showing other parts of the chair being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of my design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

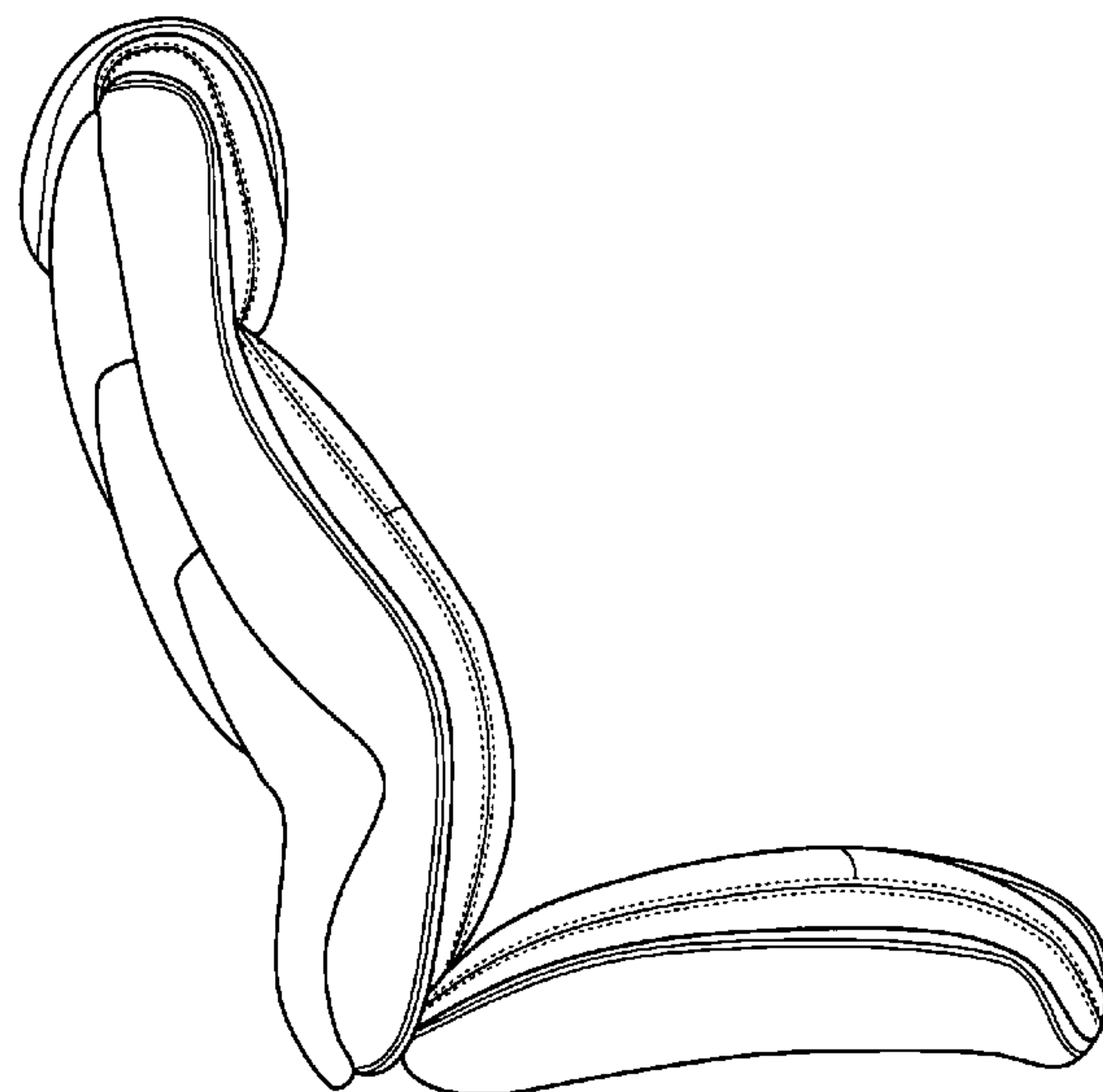
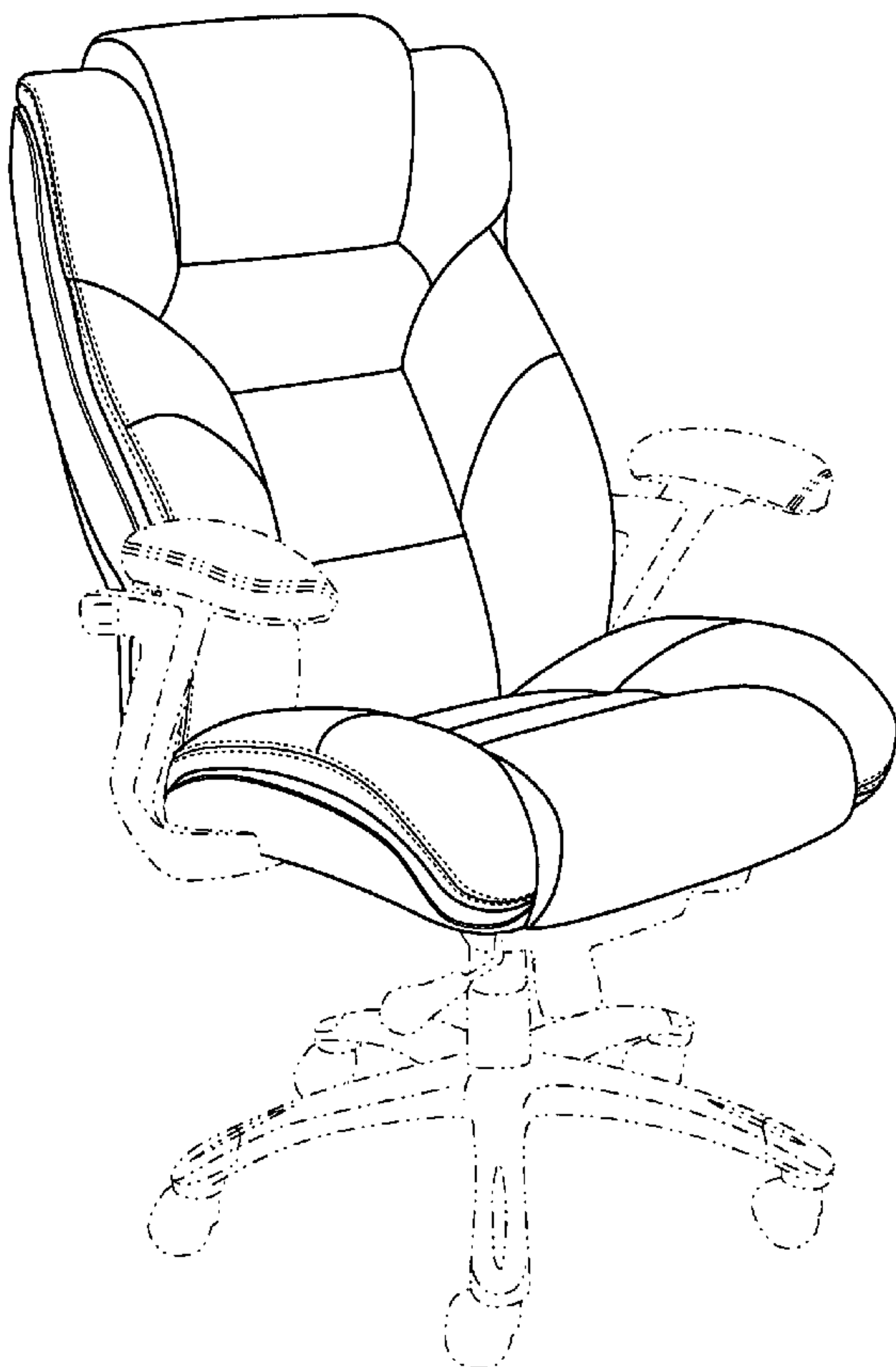
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

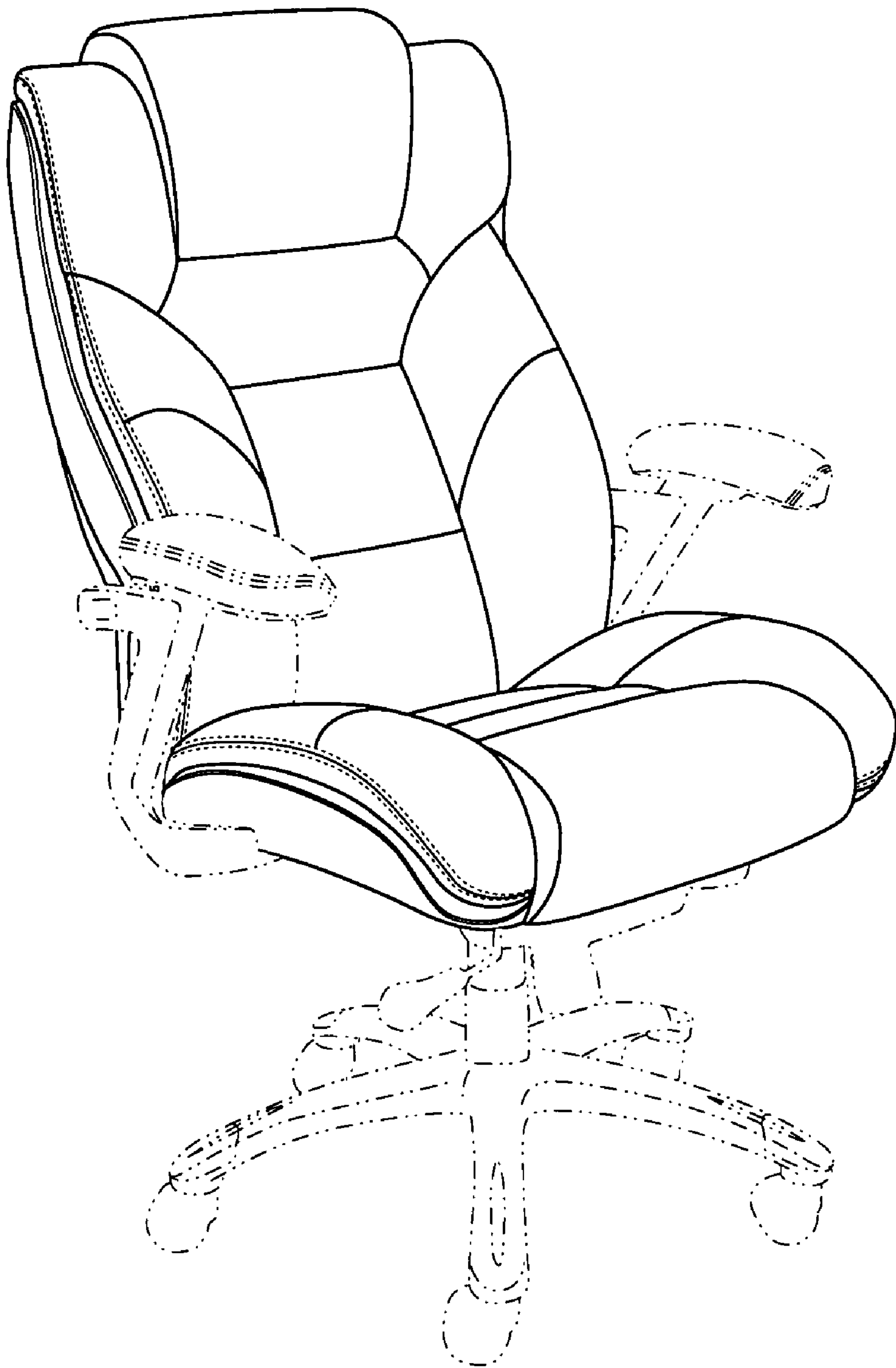

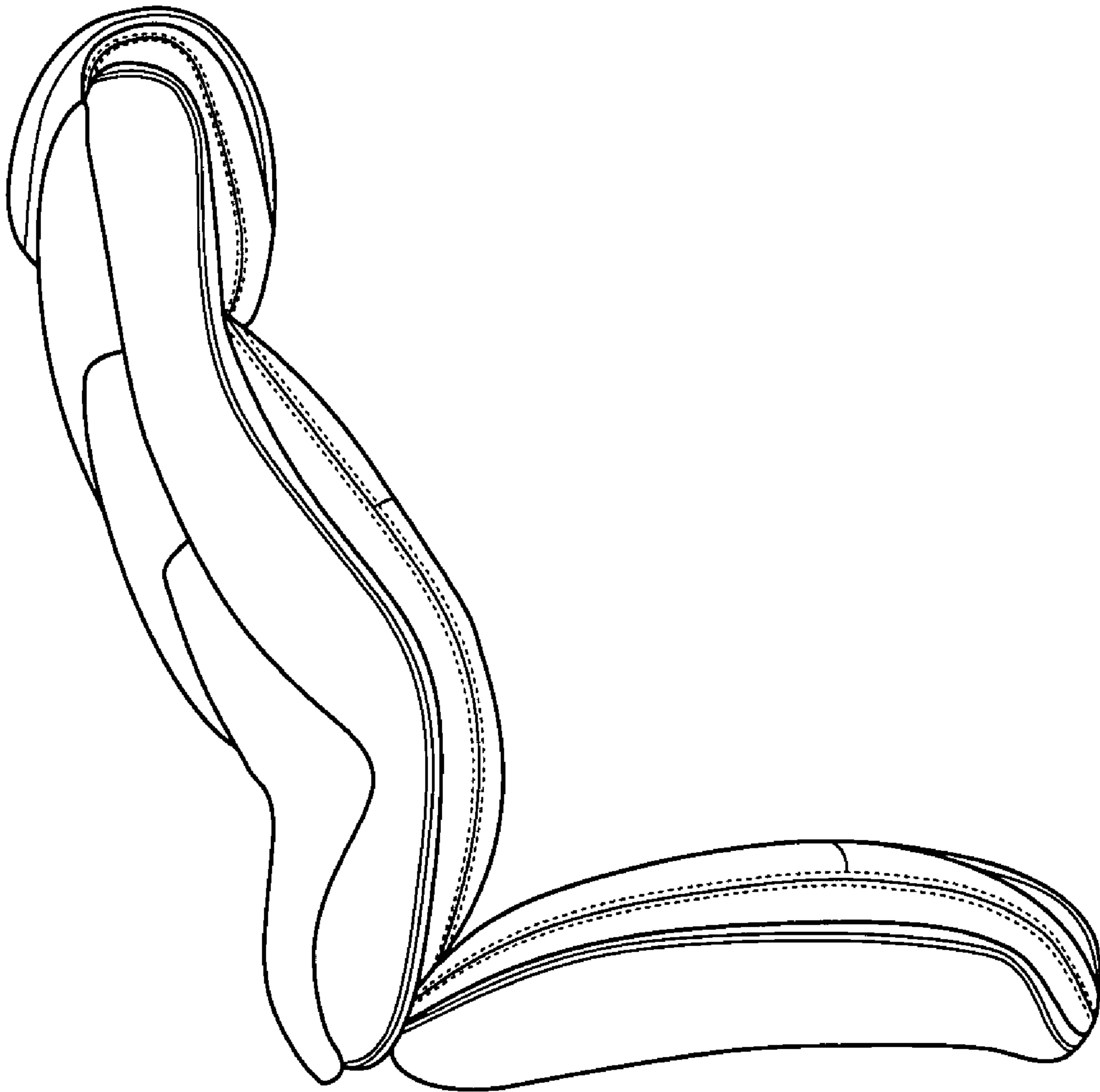

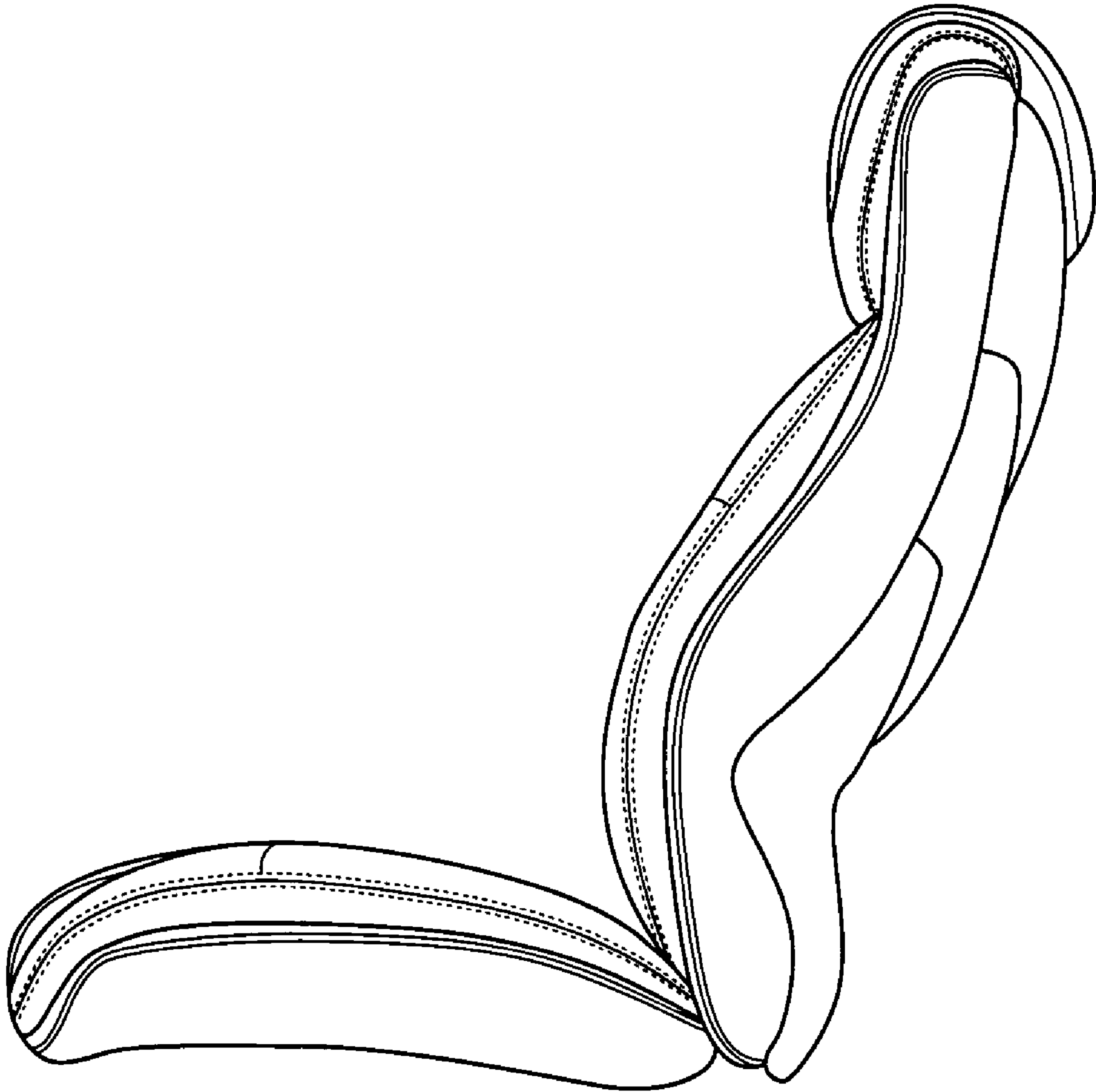

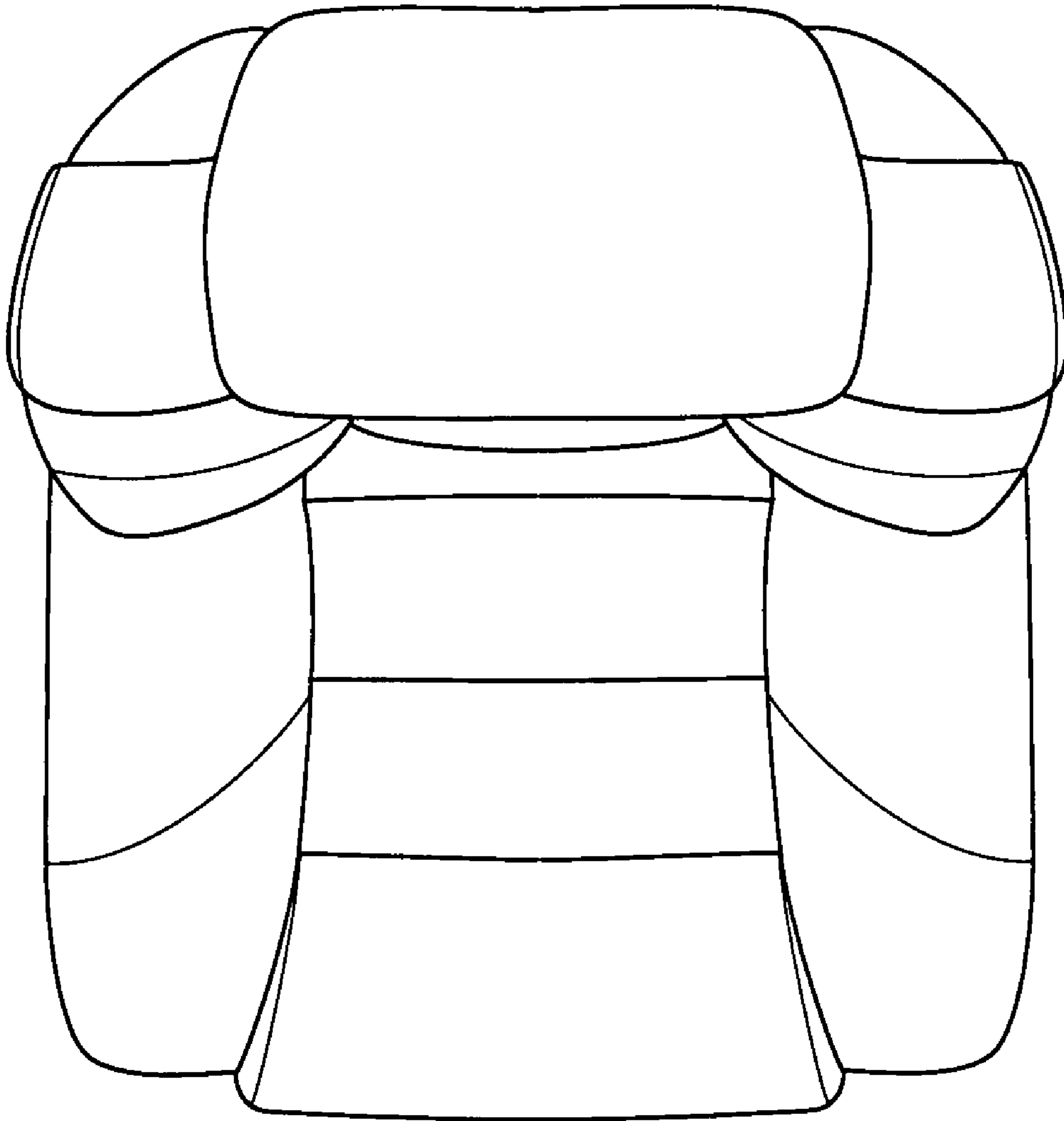

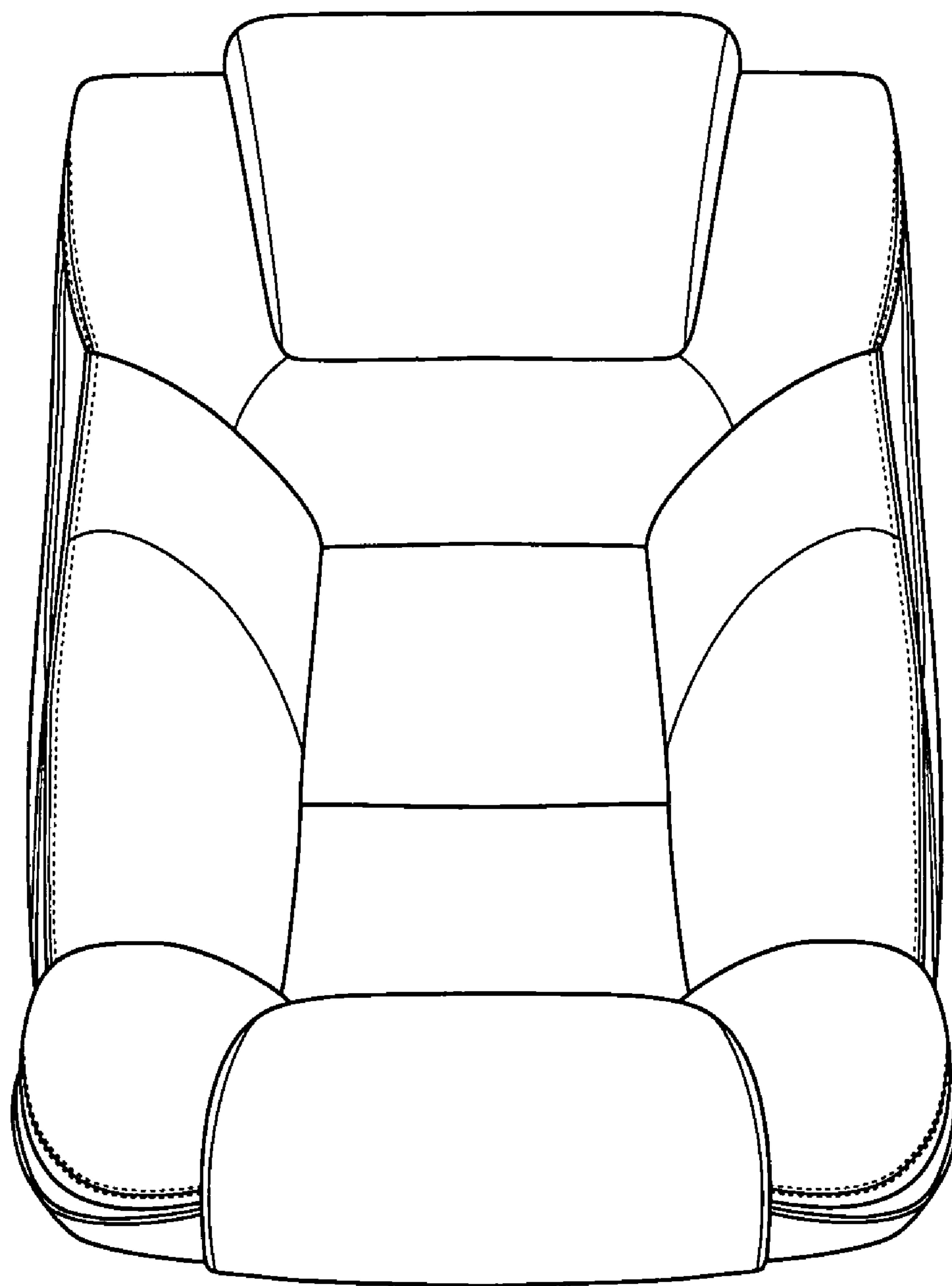
