The diagonal lines present on the edges of the portion of an embossed vertical post in shelf unit are used to represent a cut-away portion of the claimed design.

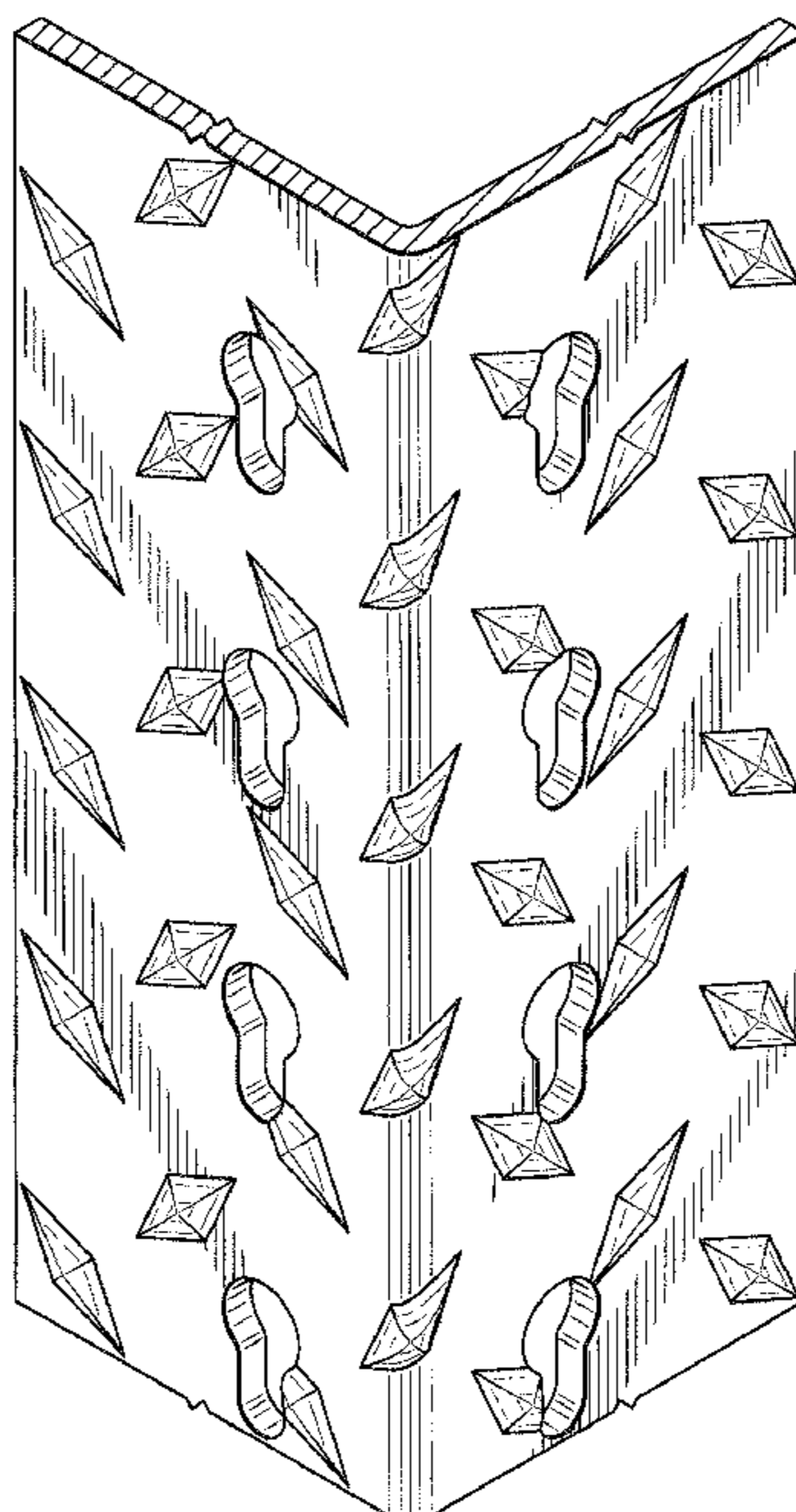
The broken lines showing in FIG. 1 are for environmental purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

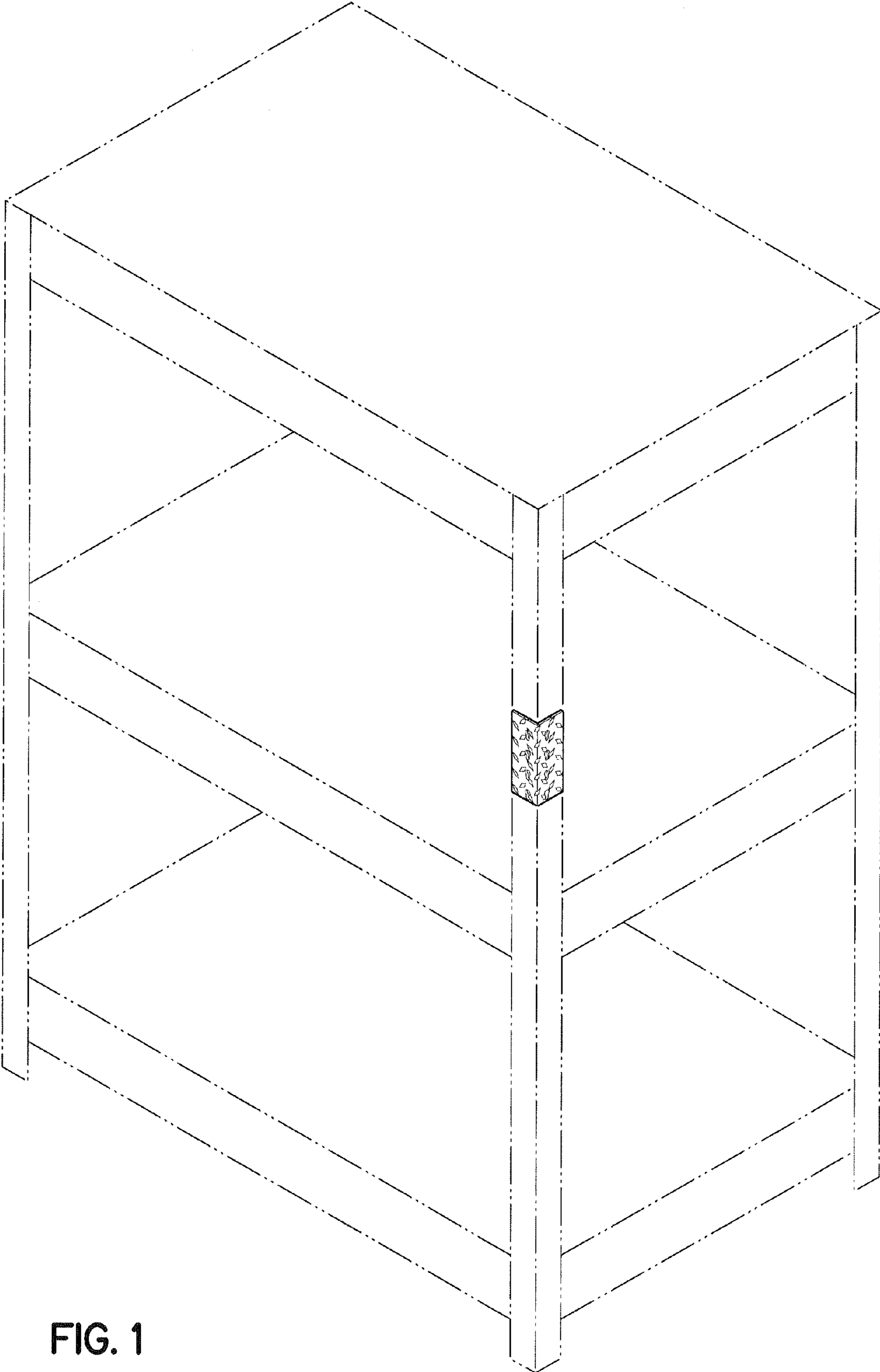

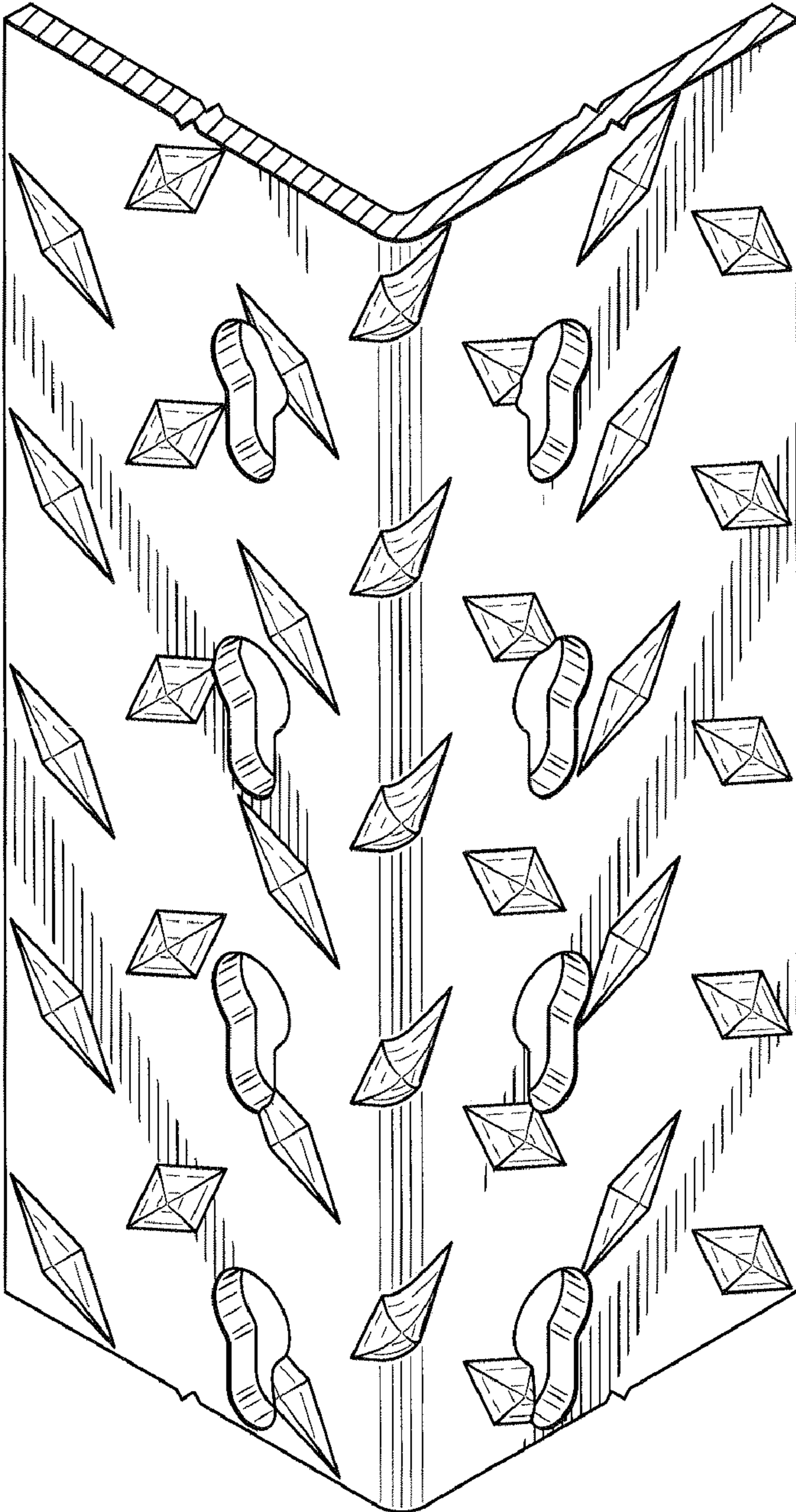

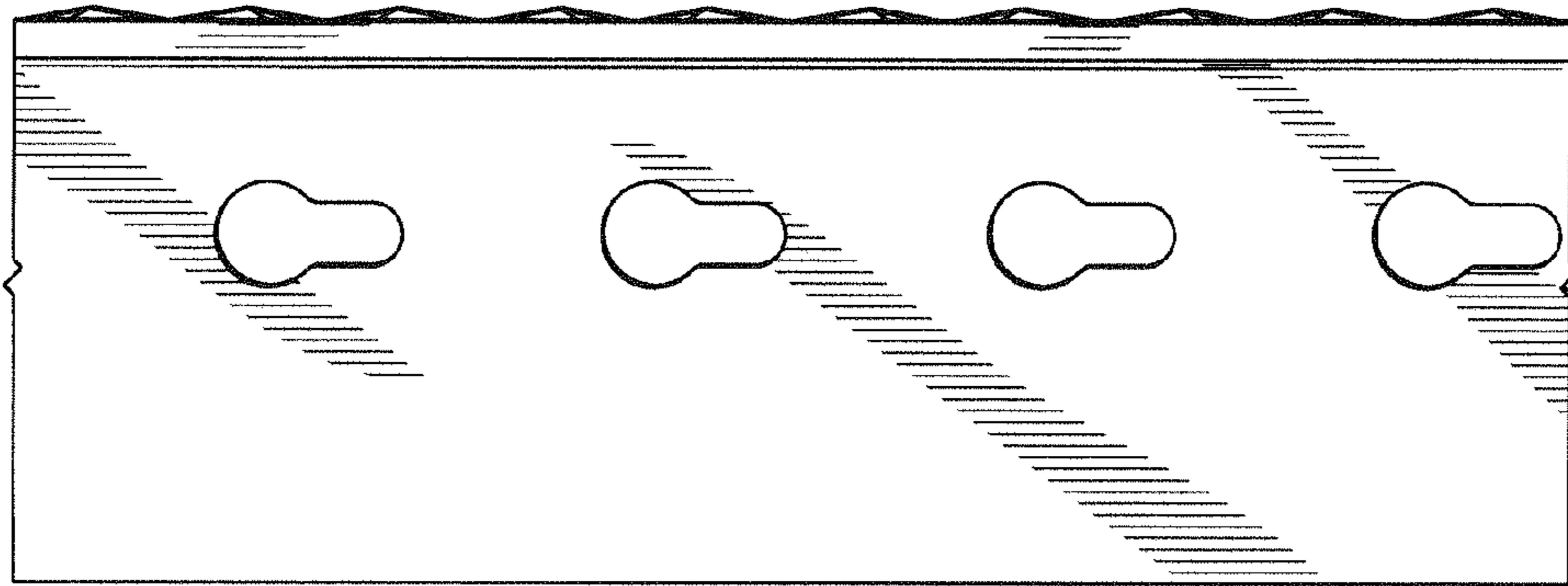

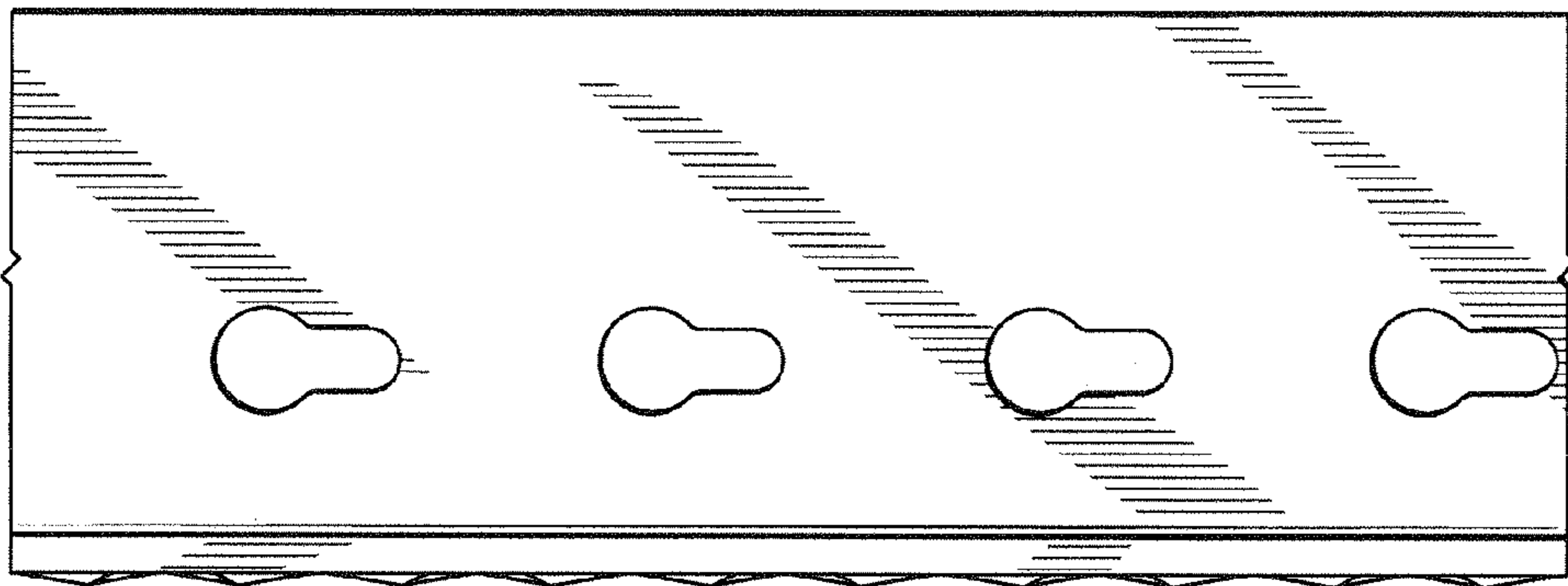

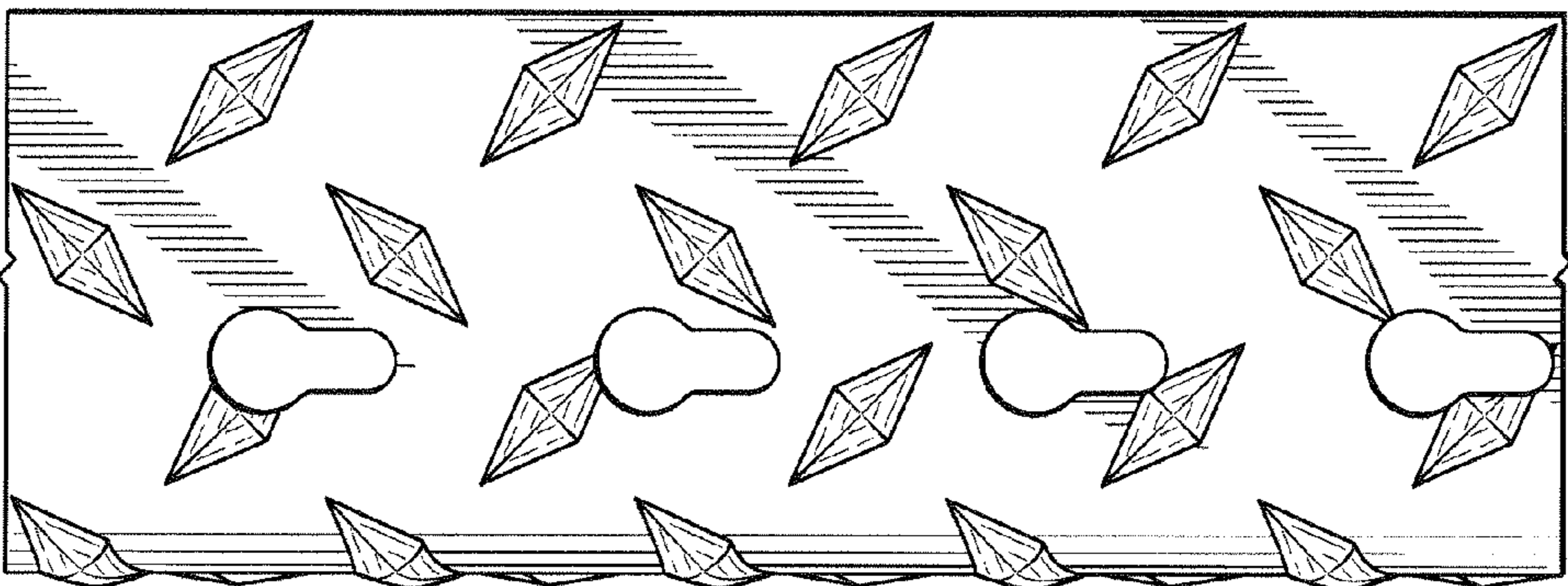

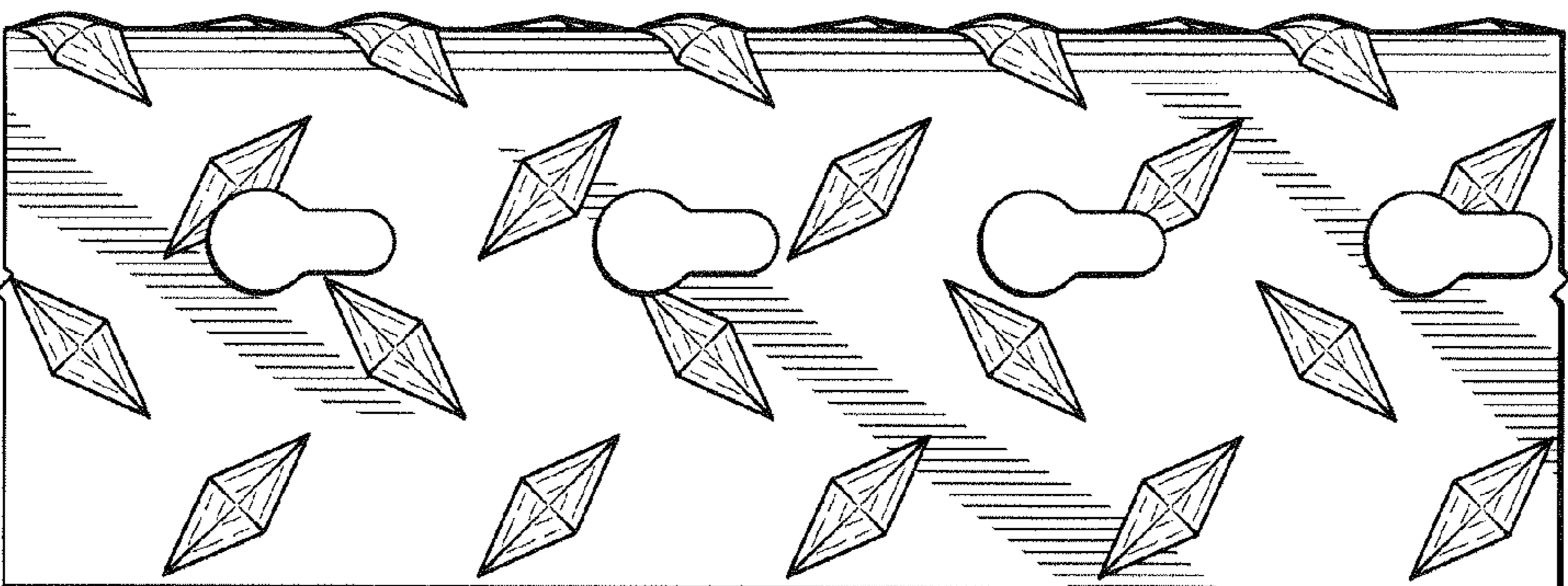

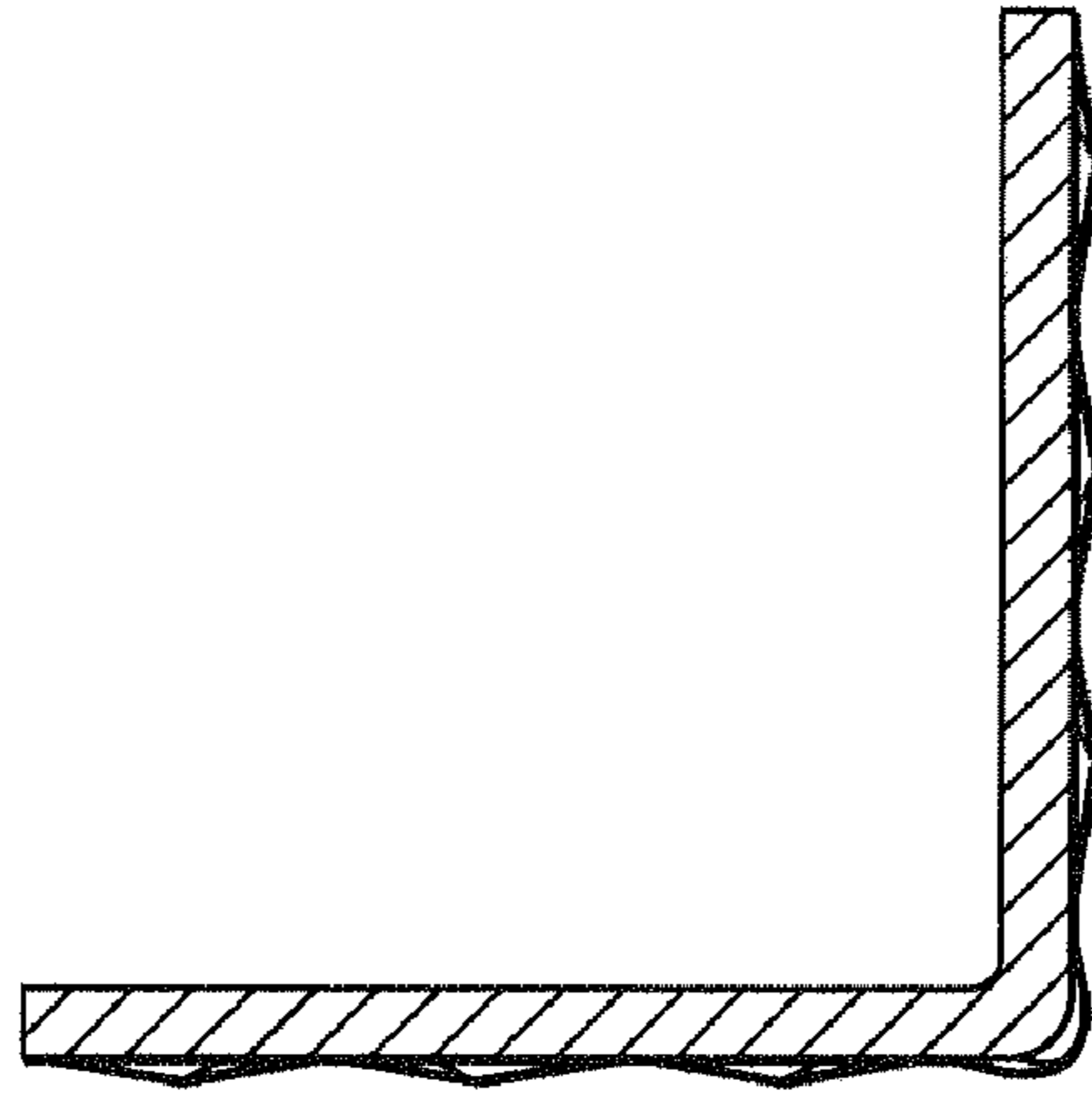

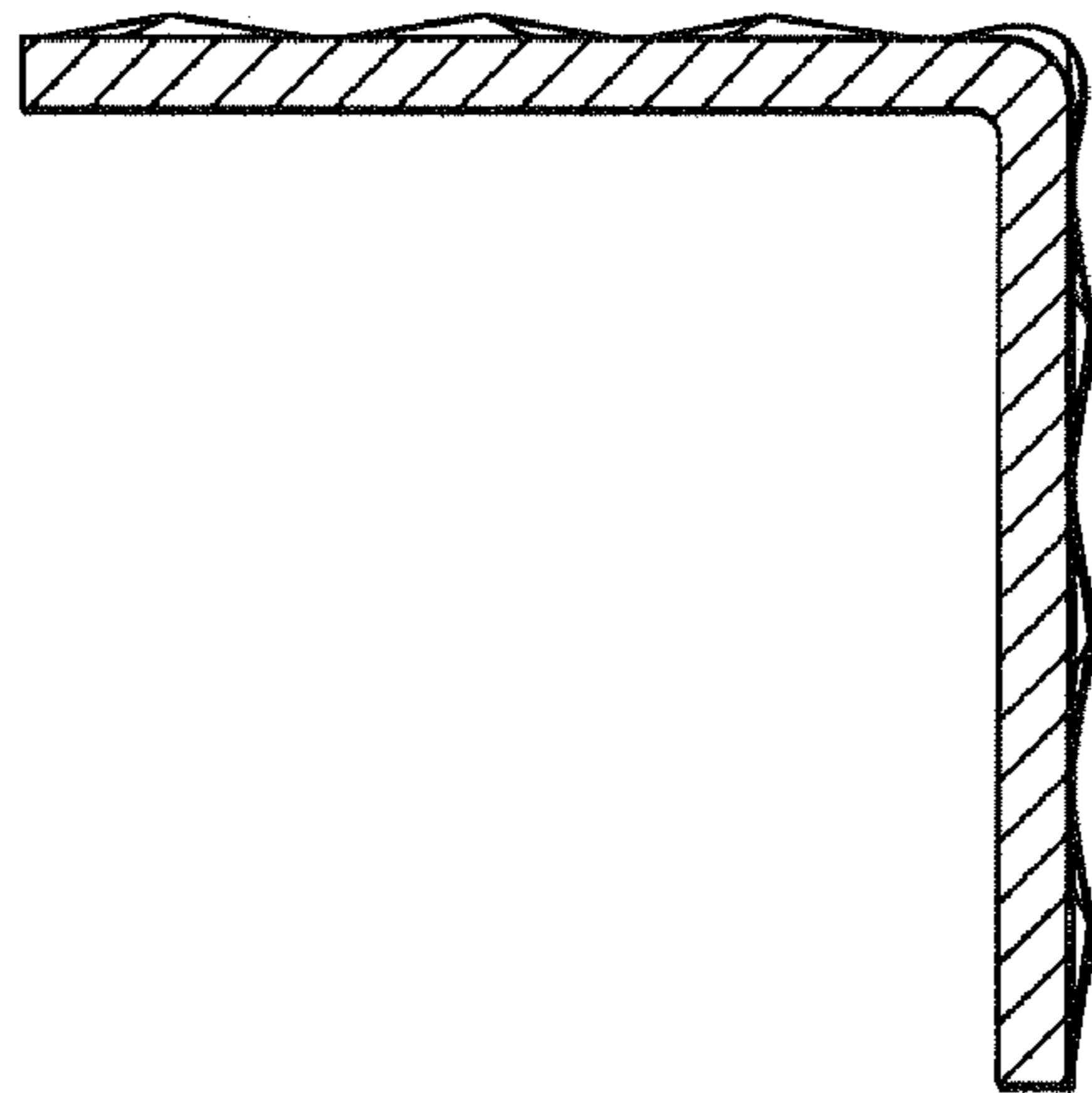
