FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

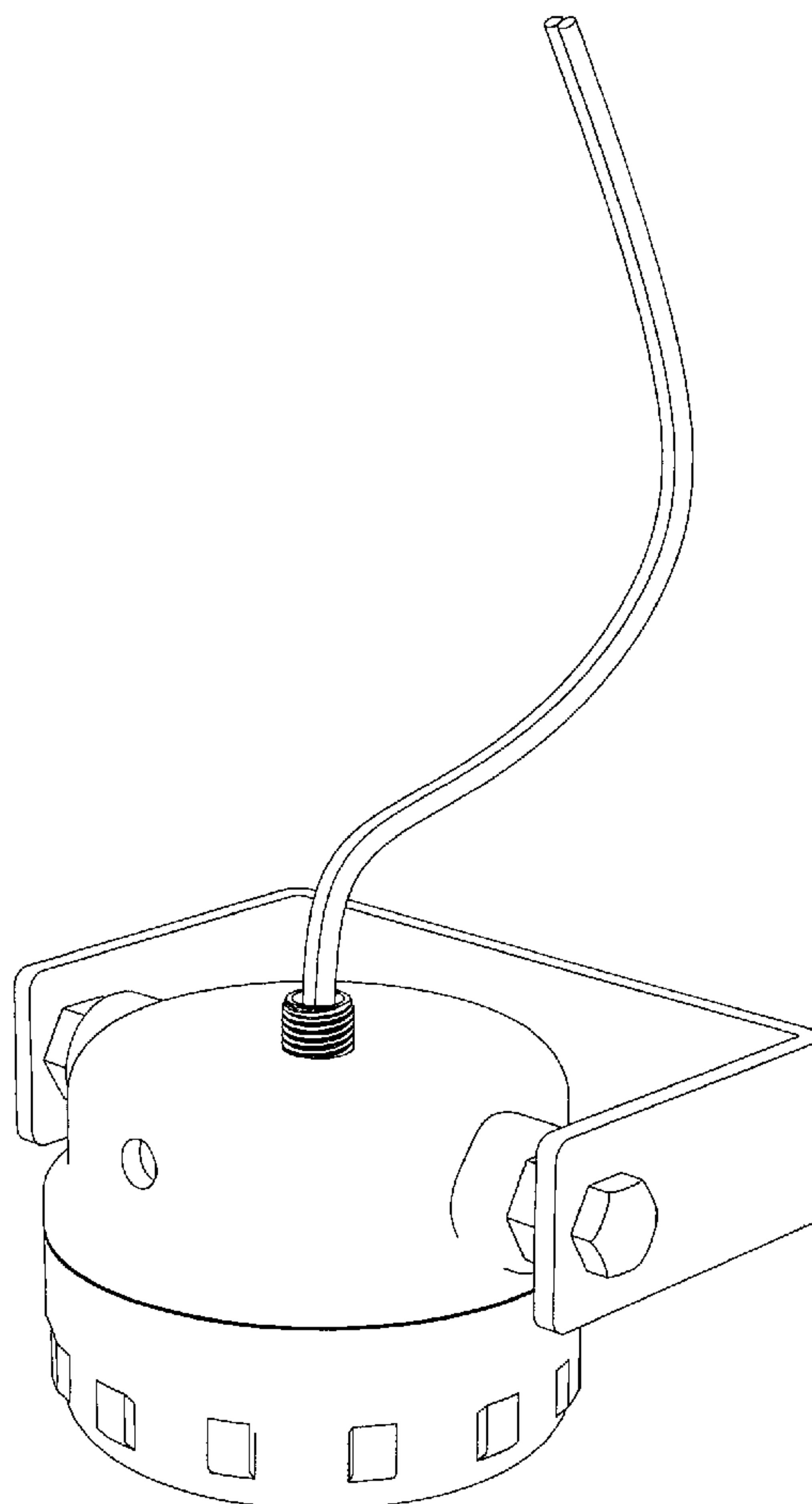
FIG. 5 is a right side plan view thereof;

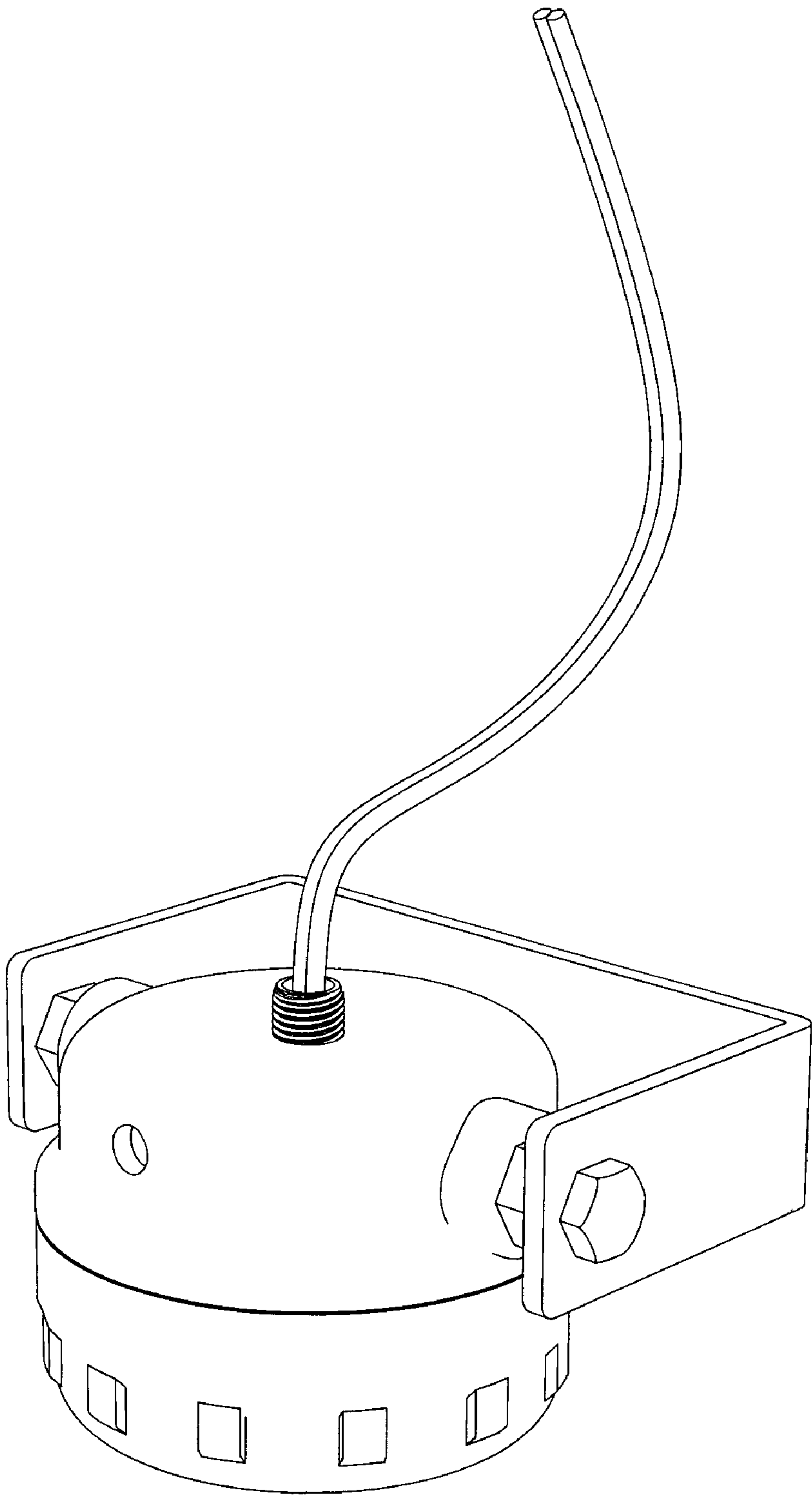

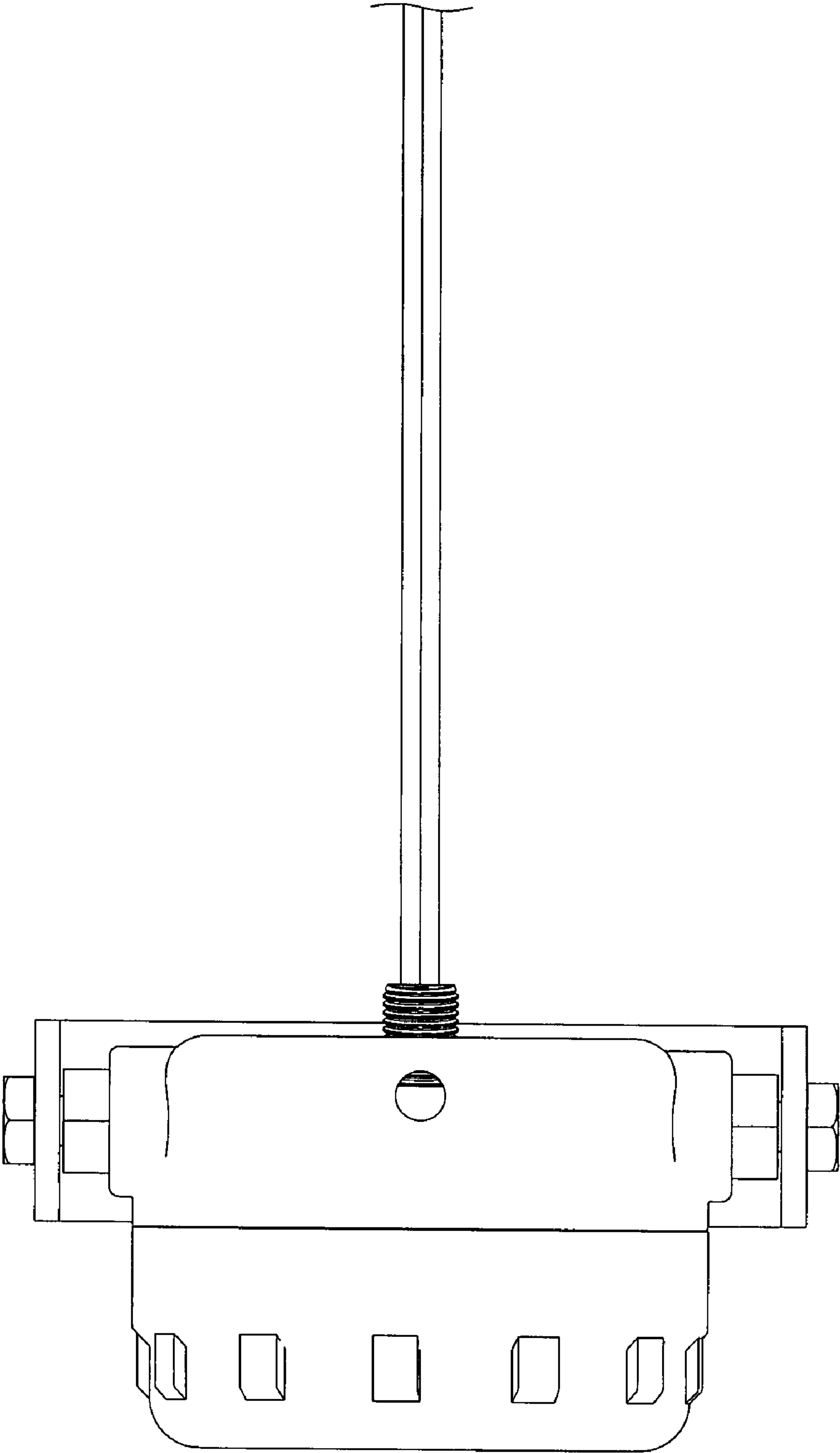

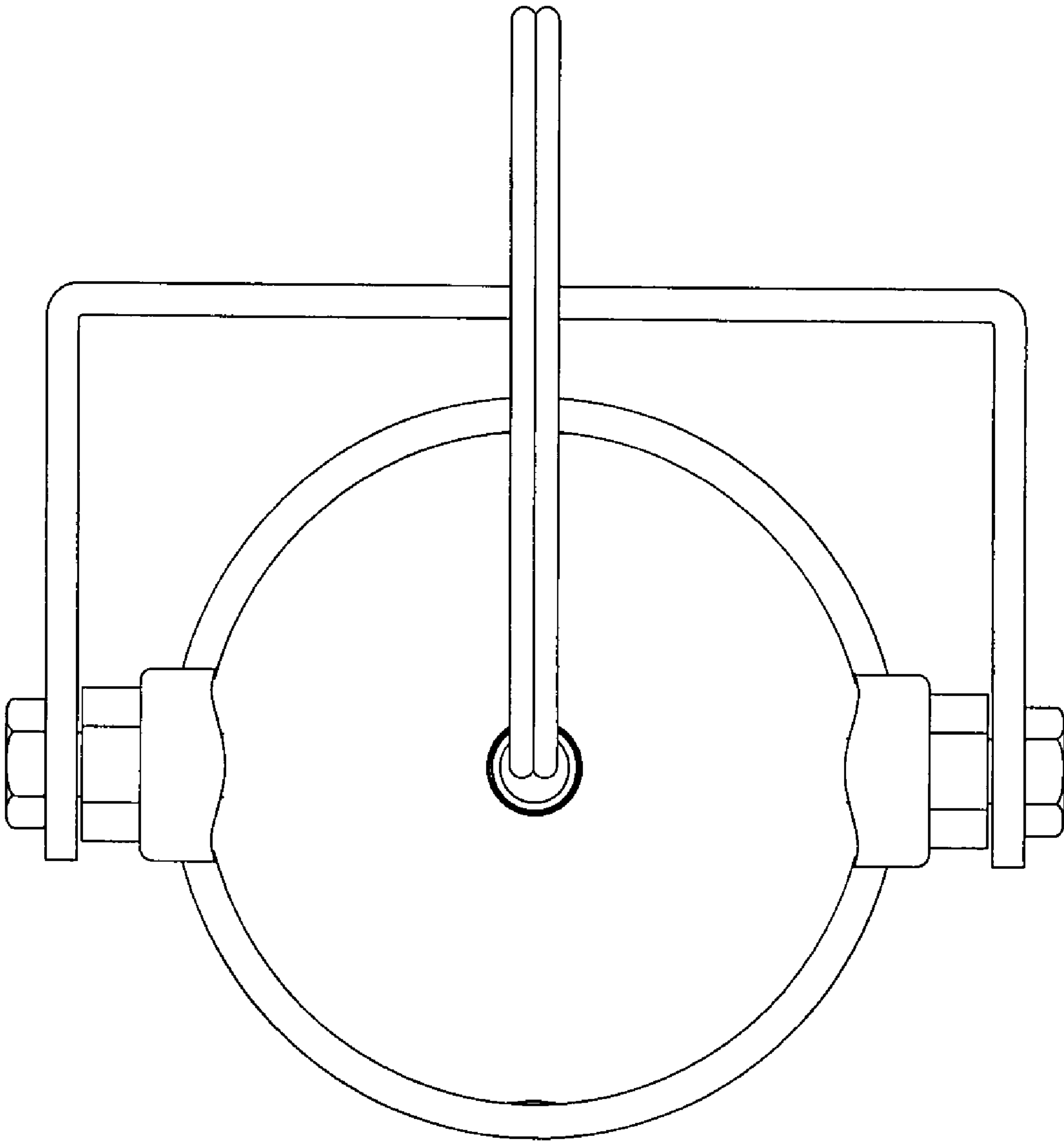

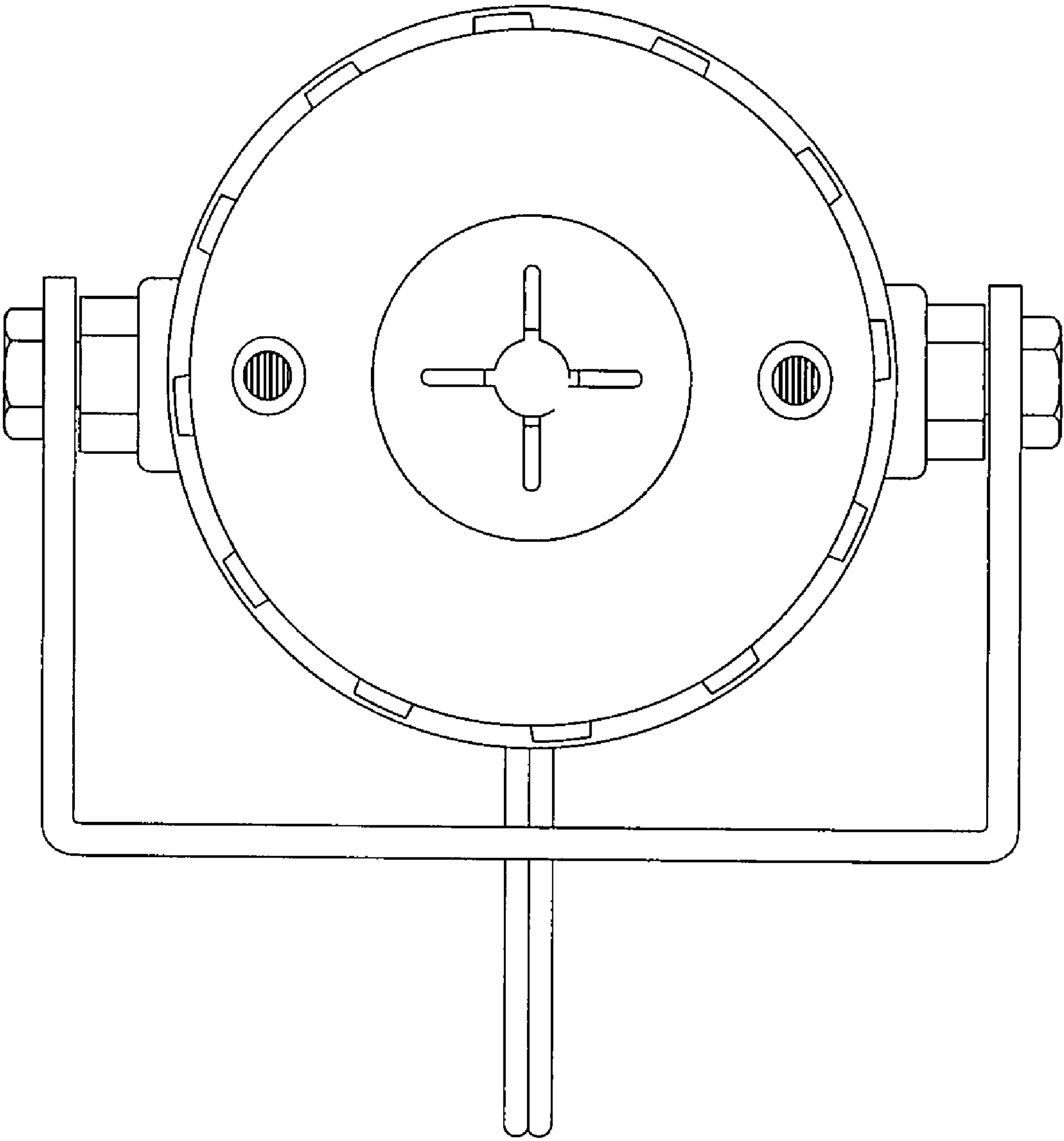

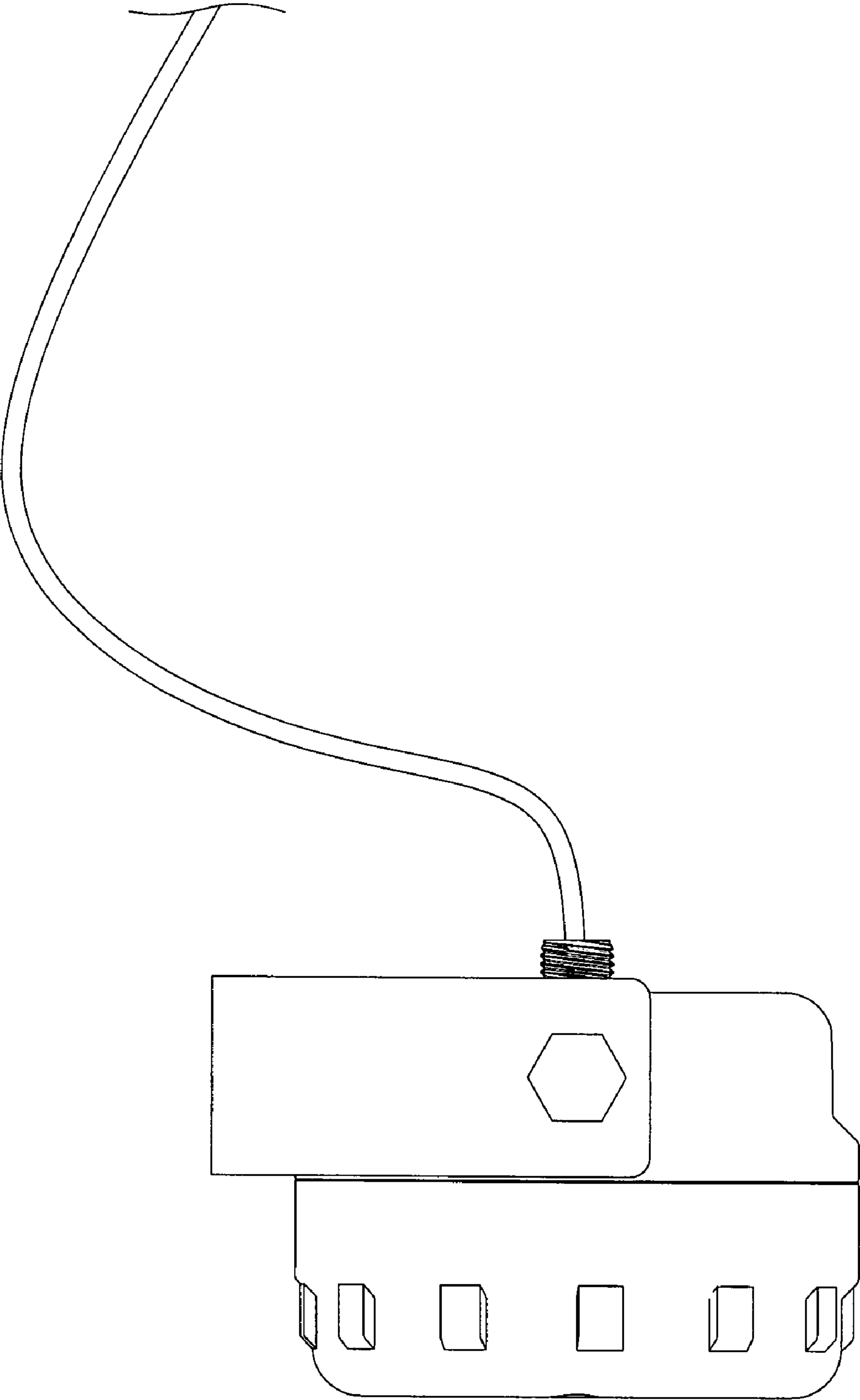

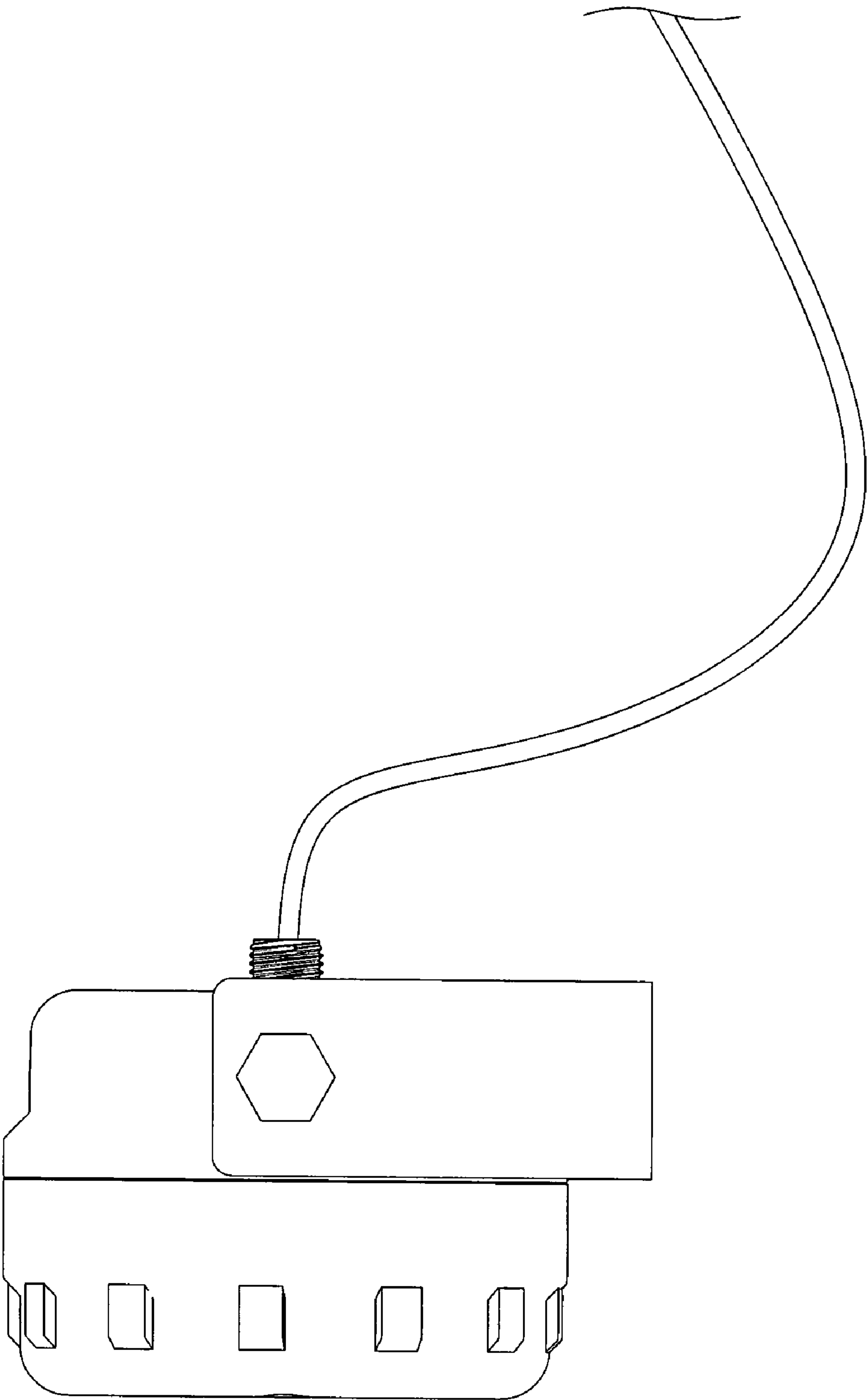

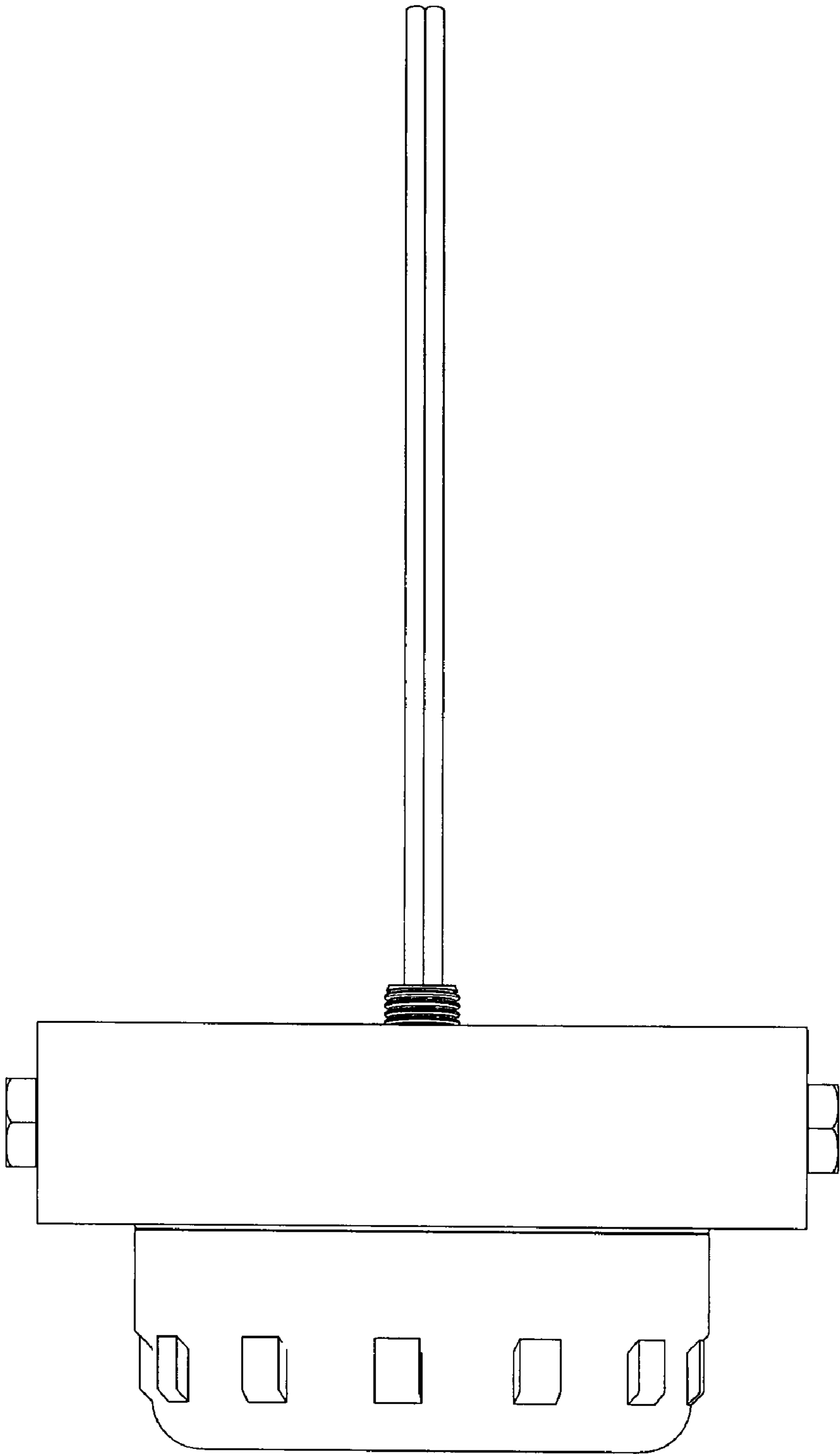
