(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a frame for television receiver, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a frame for television receiver showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof.

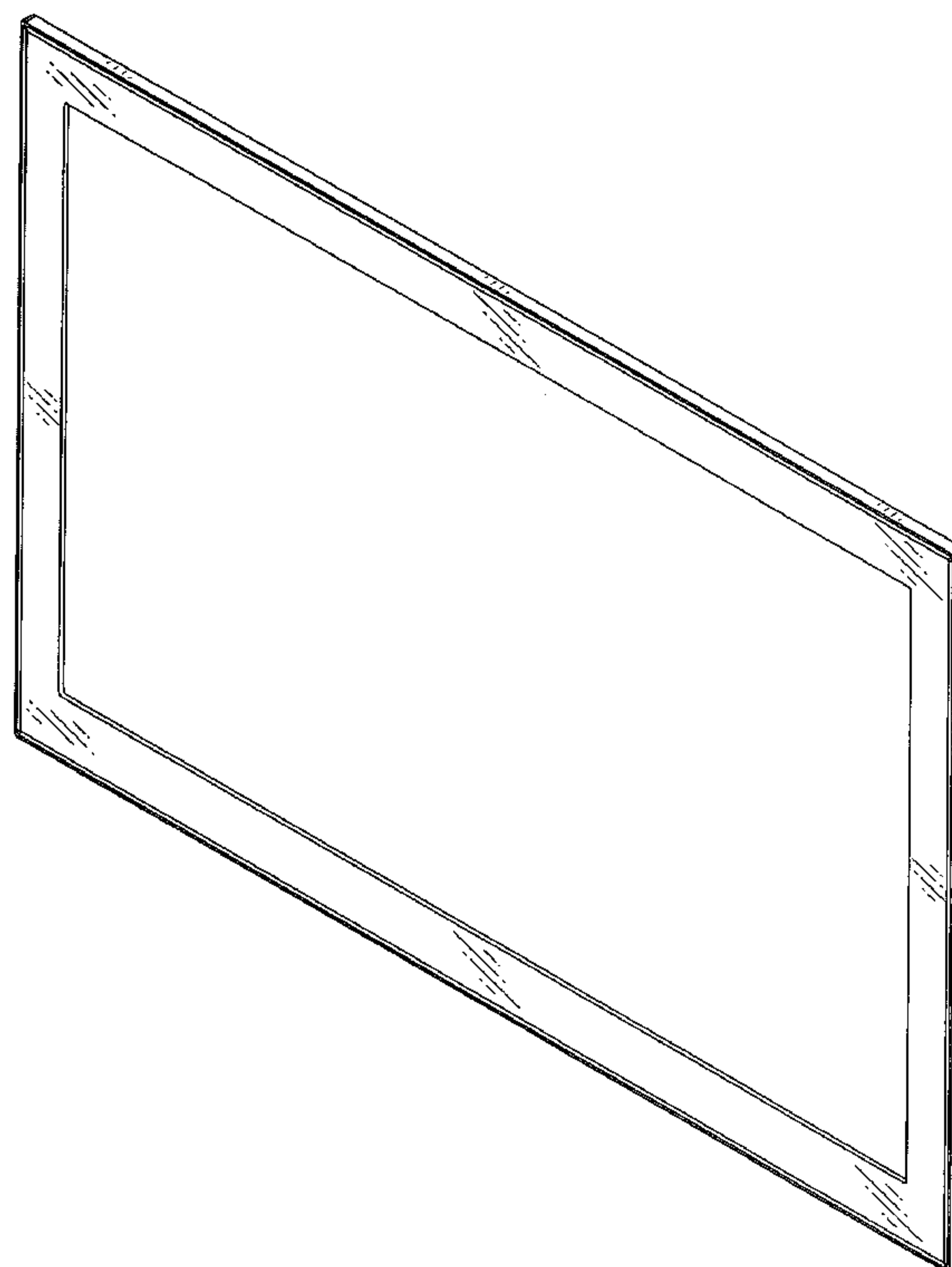

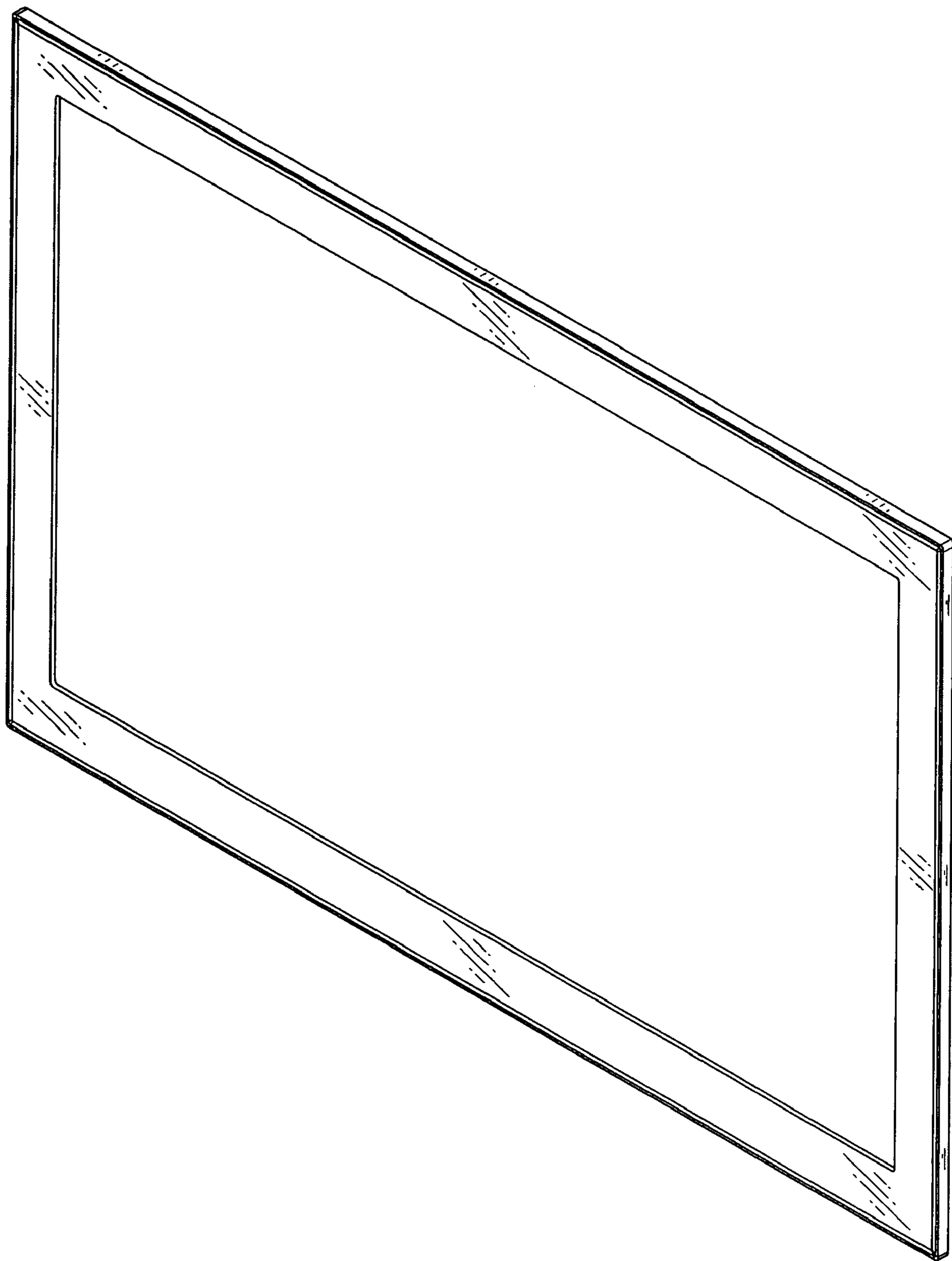

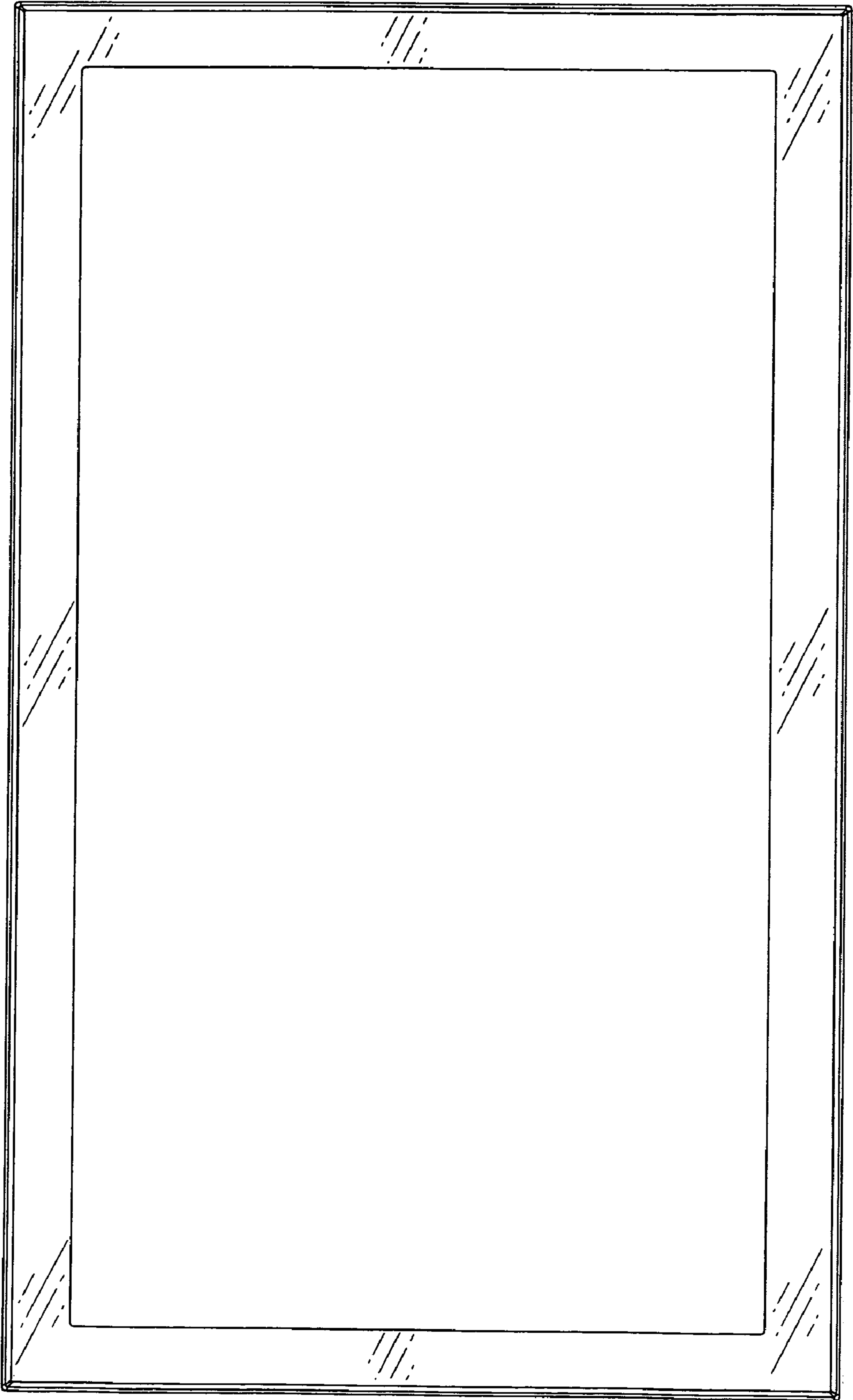

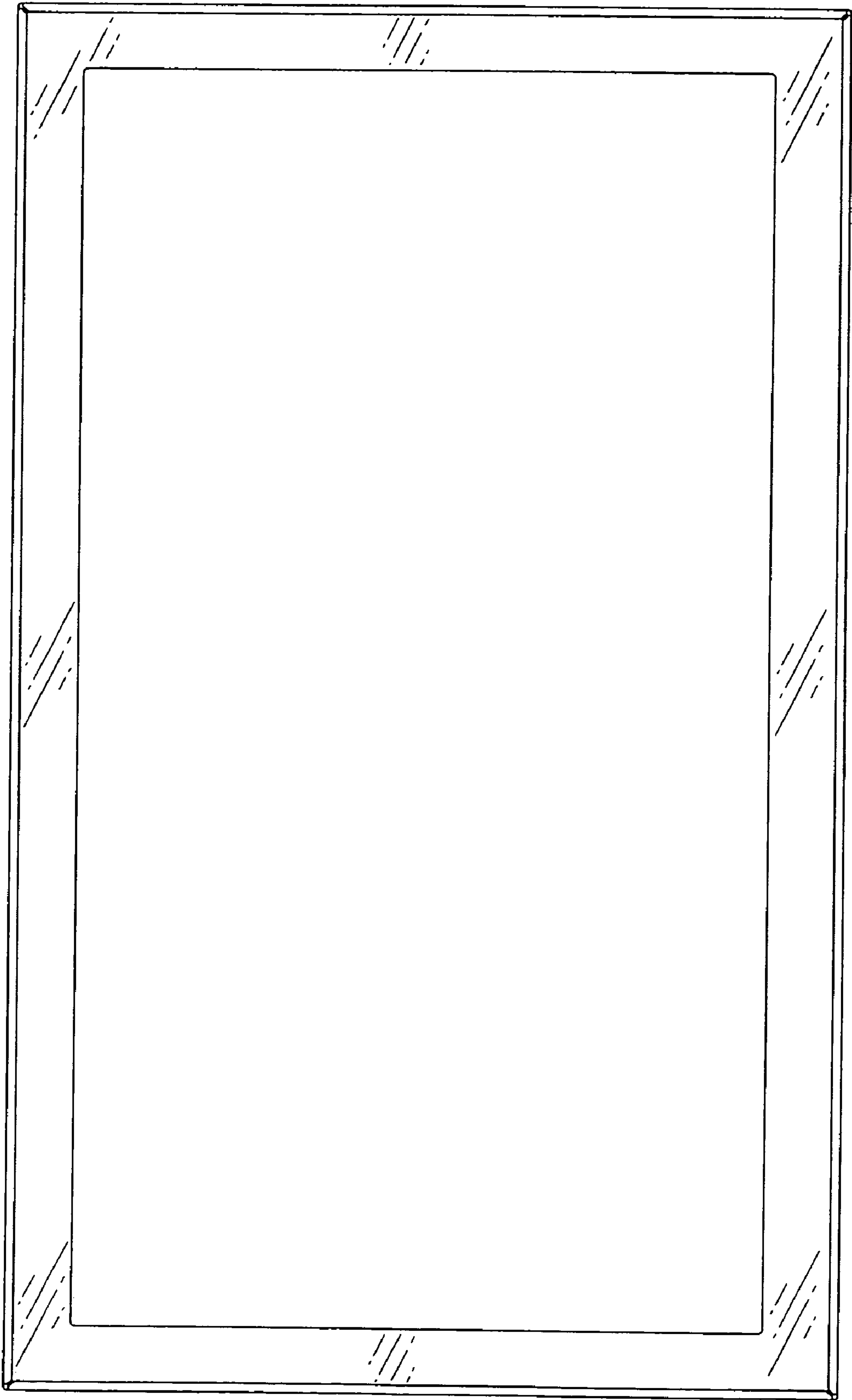
