gaming device display show in FIG. 1.

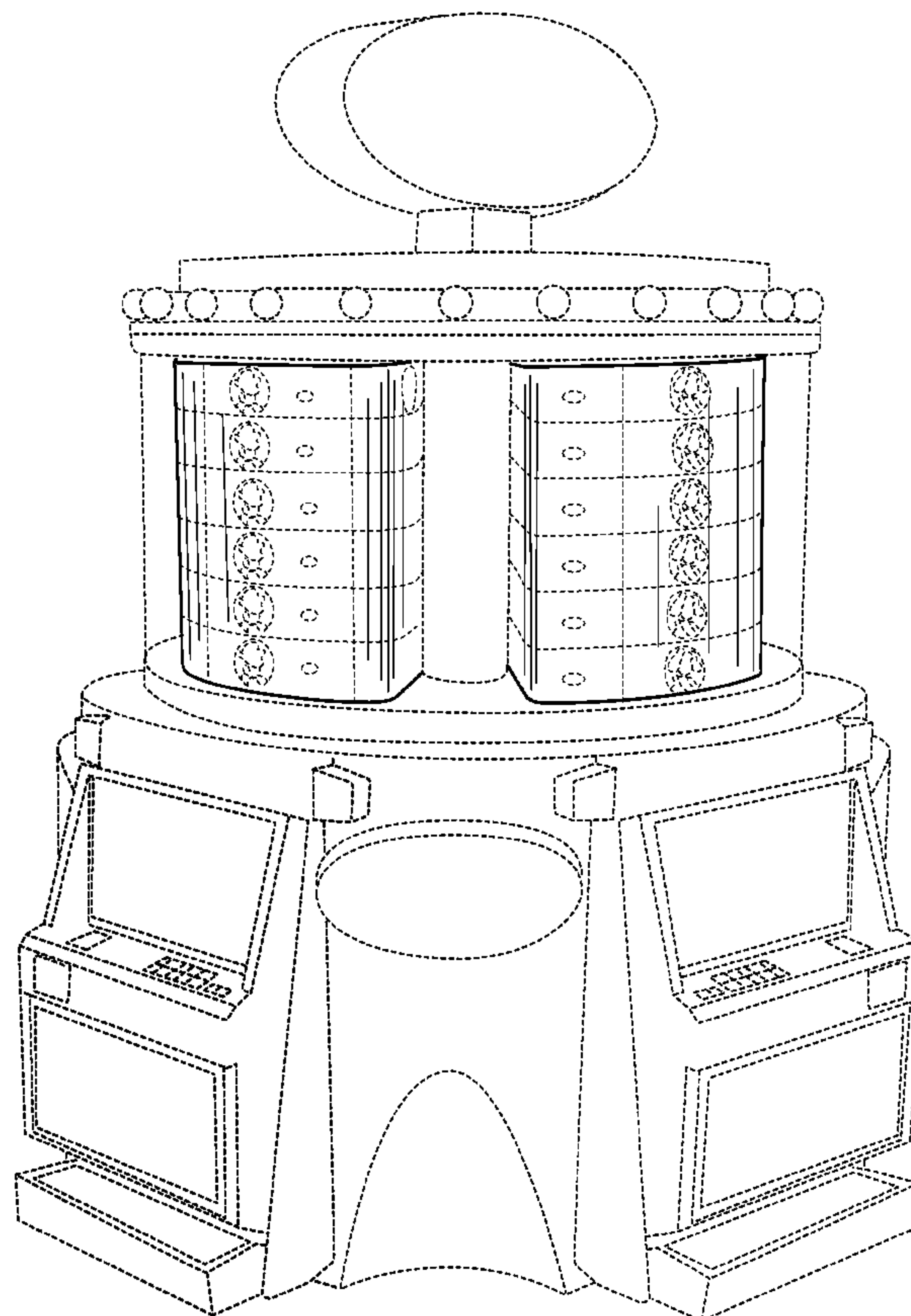

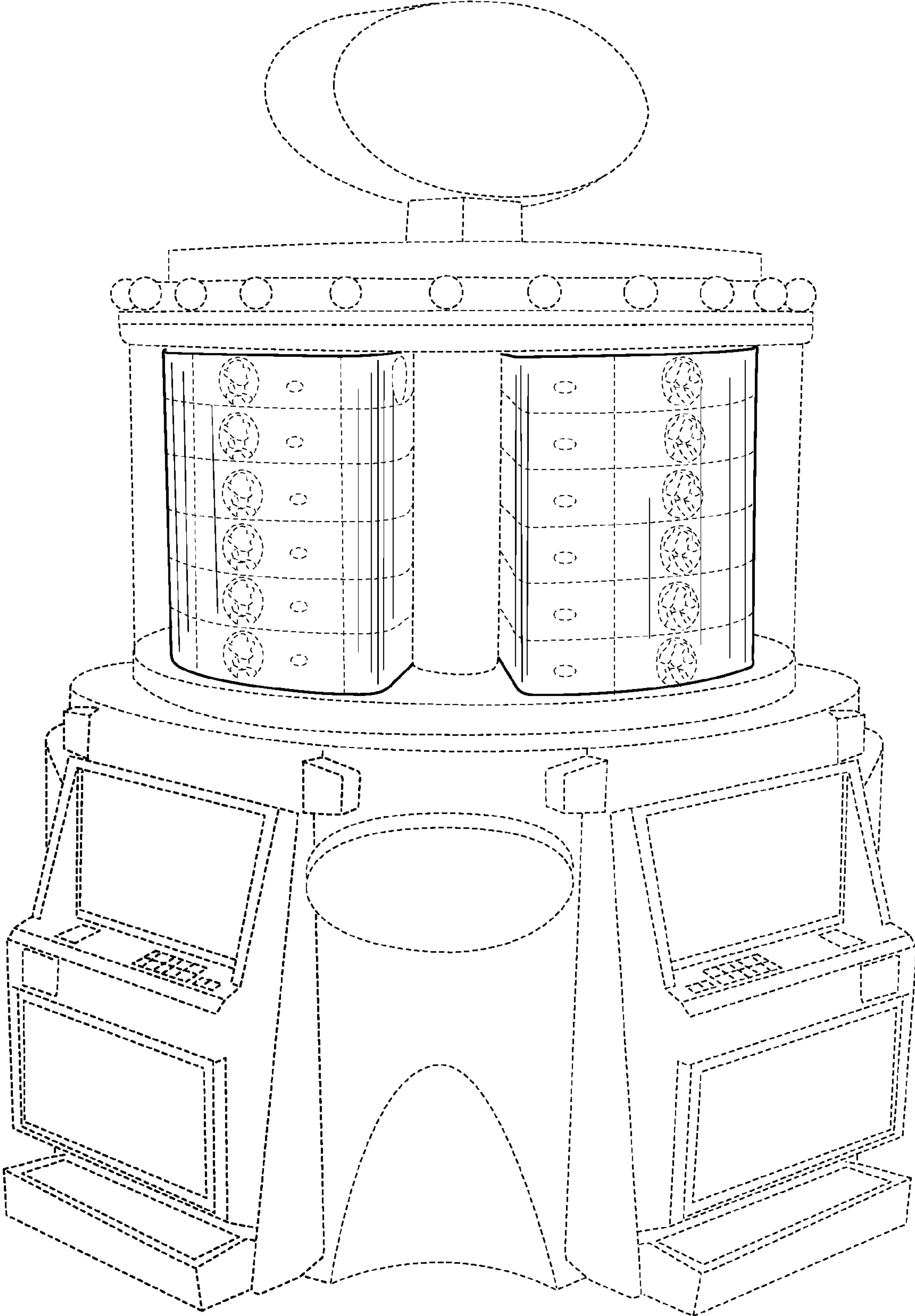

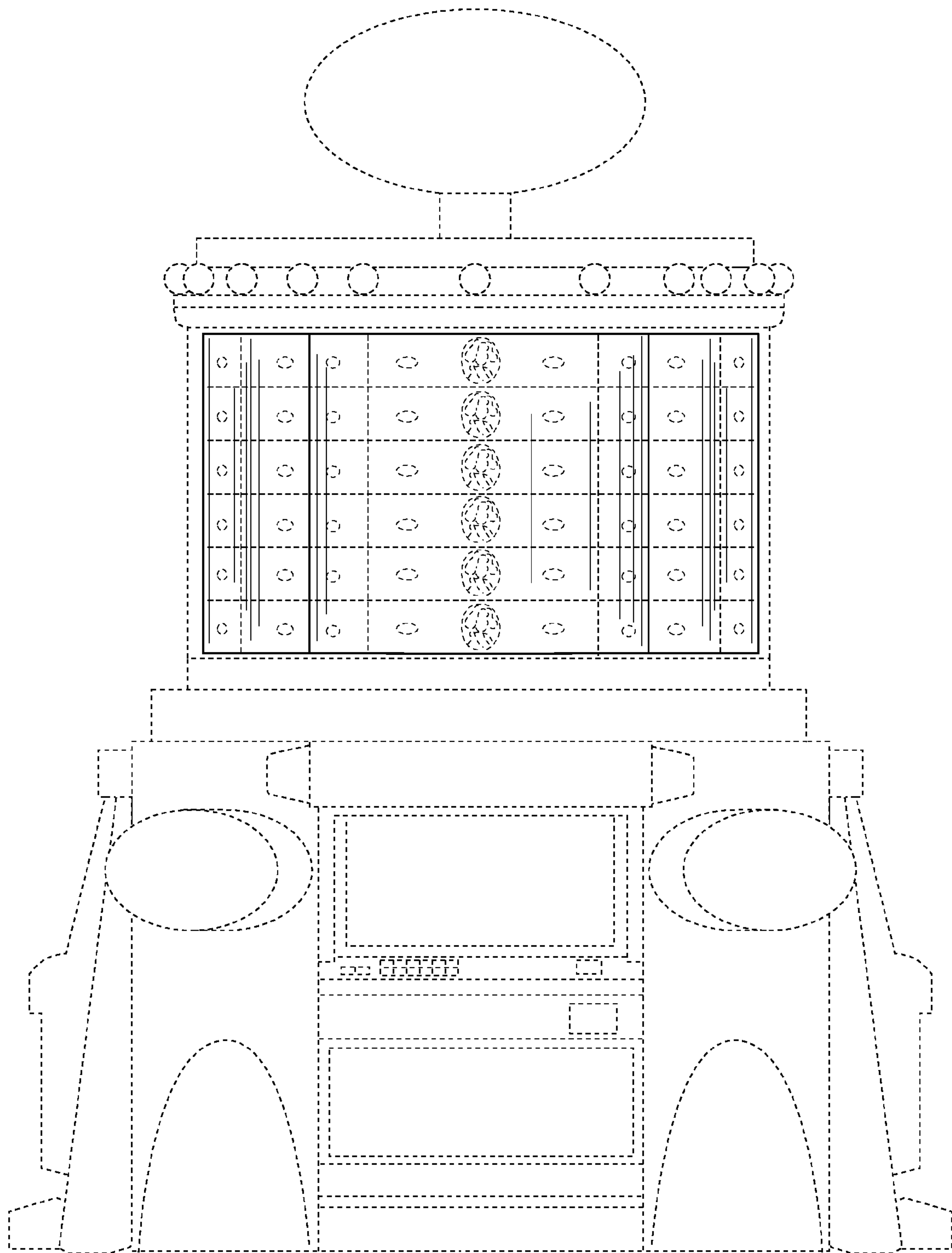

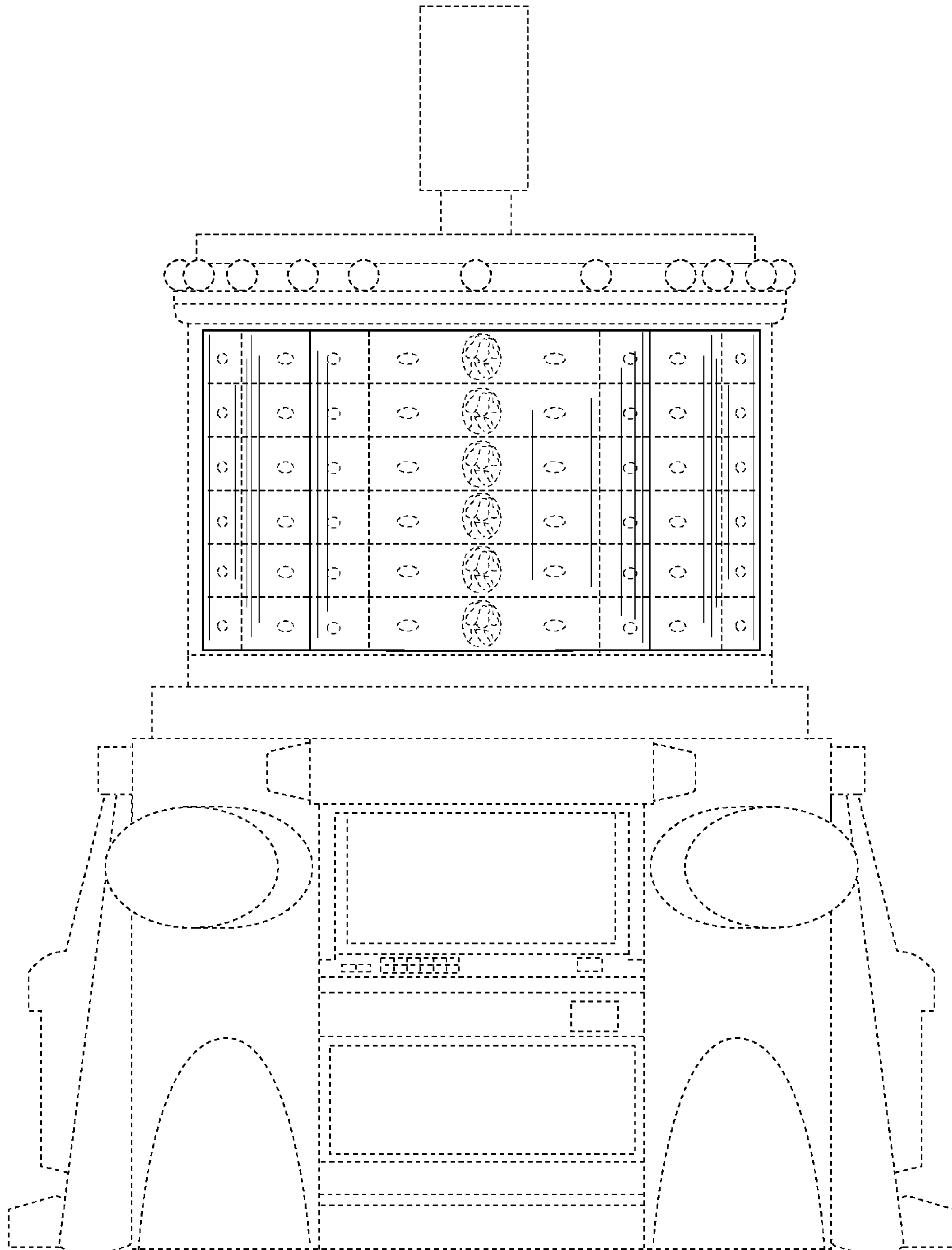

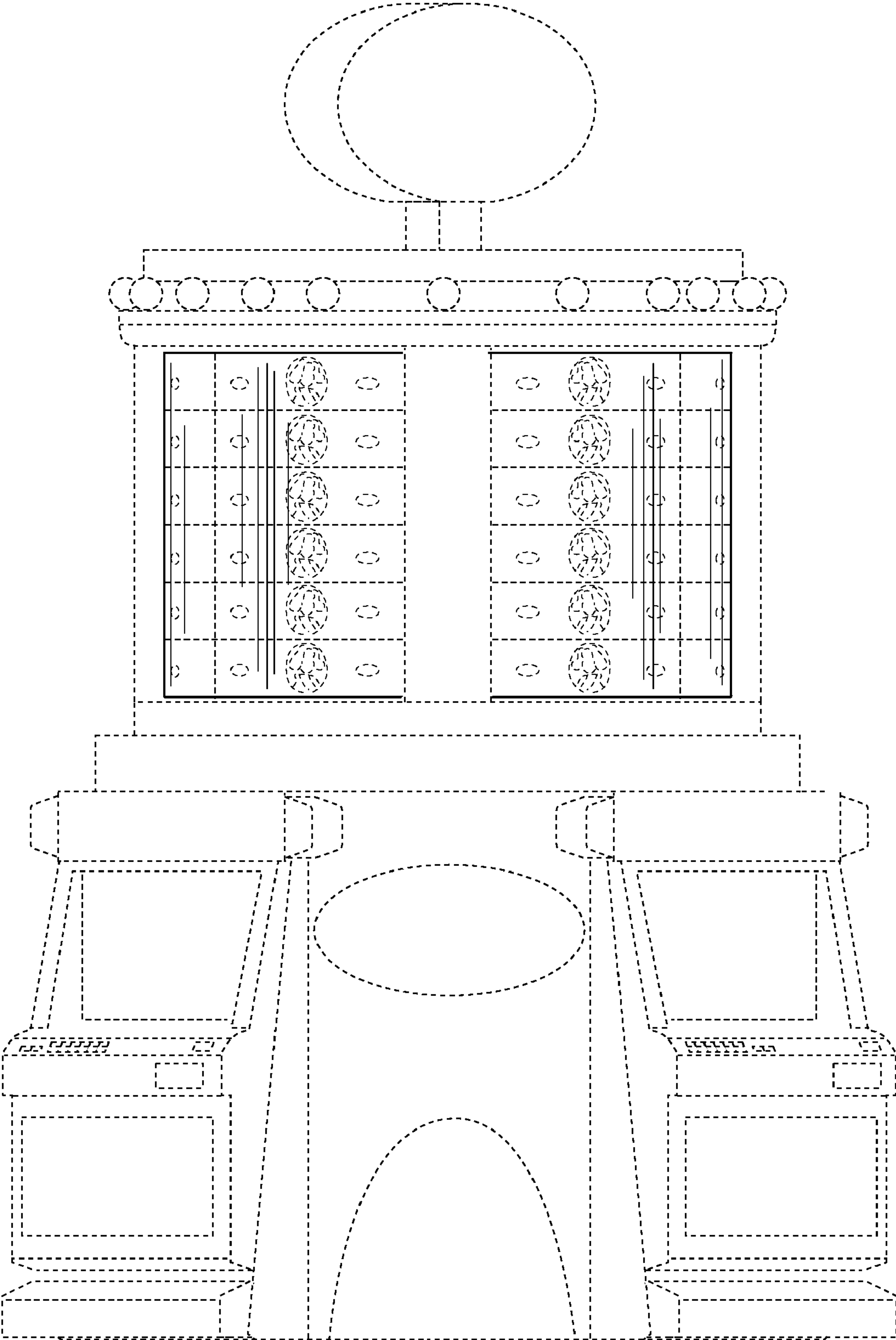
