FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a crown for a round multi-faceted gemstone showing my design; and,

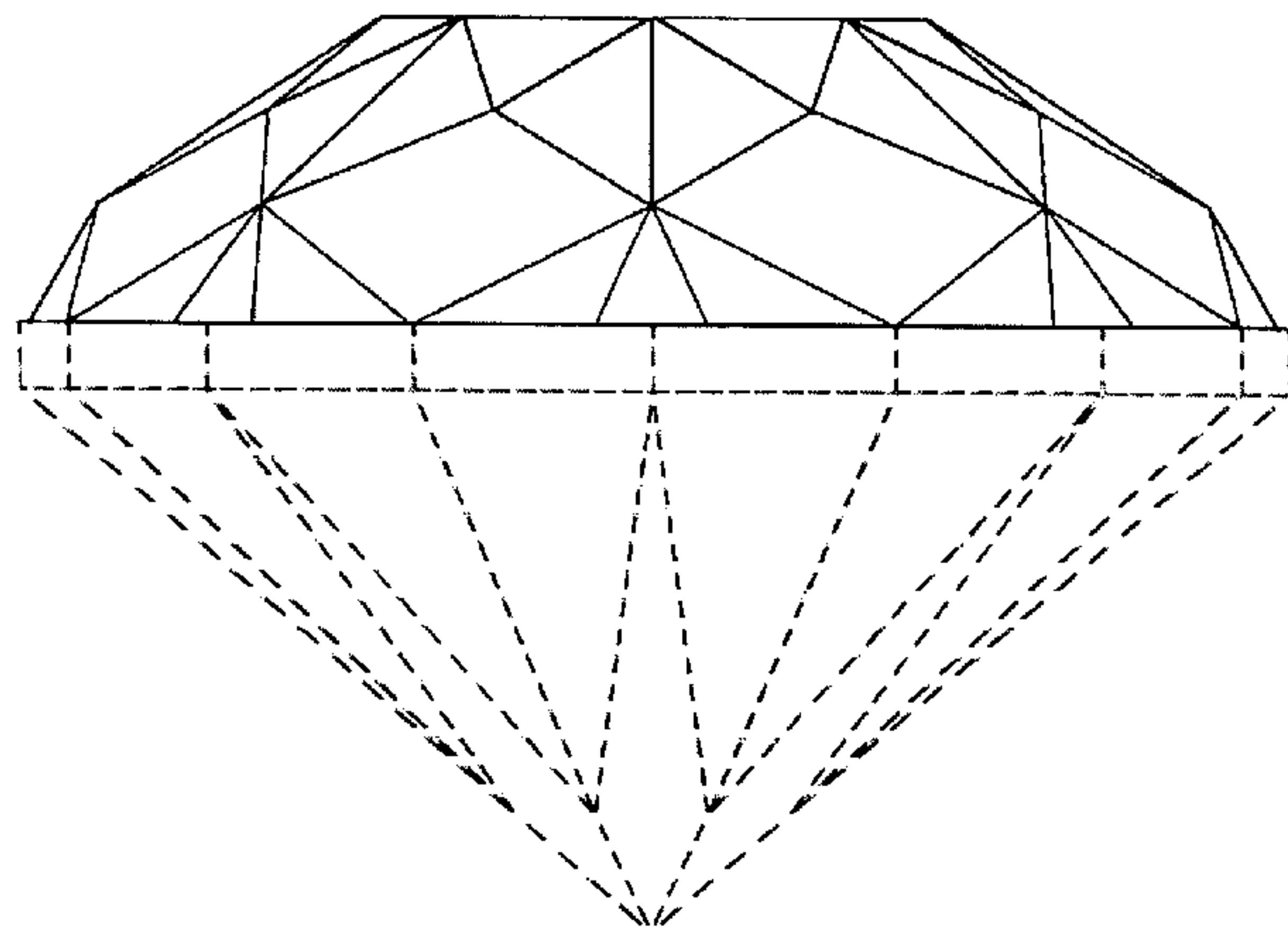
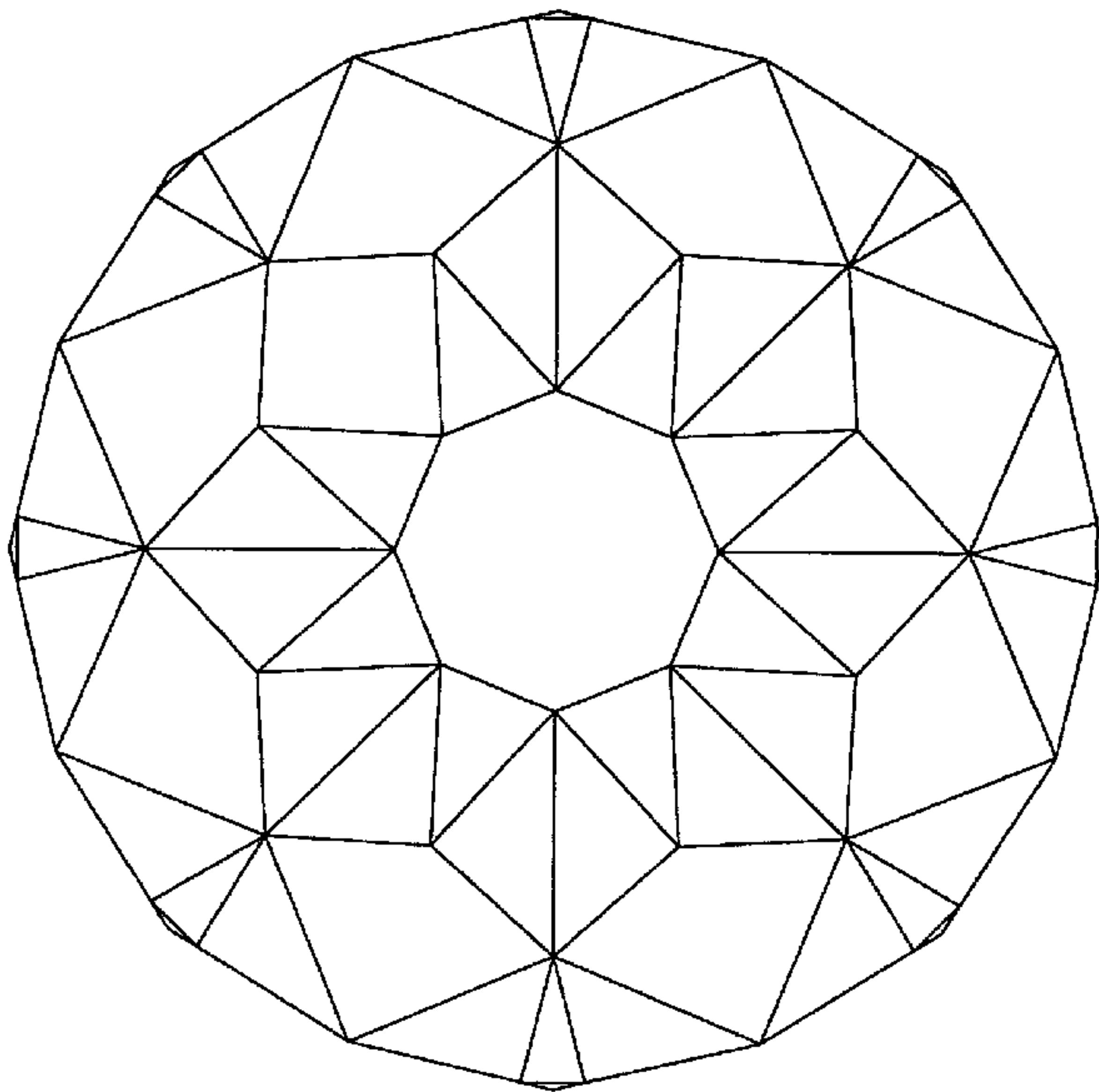
FIG. 2 is a side view of my invention, wherein all sides are identical. The pavilion is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes and forms no part of the claimed design.

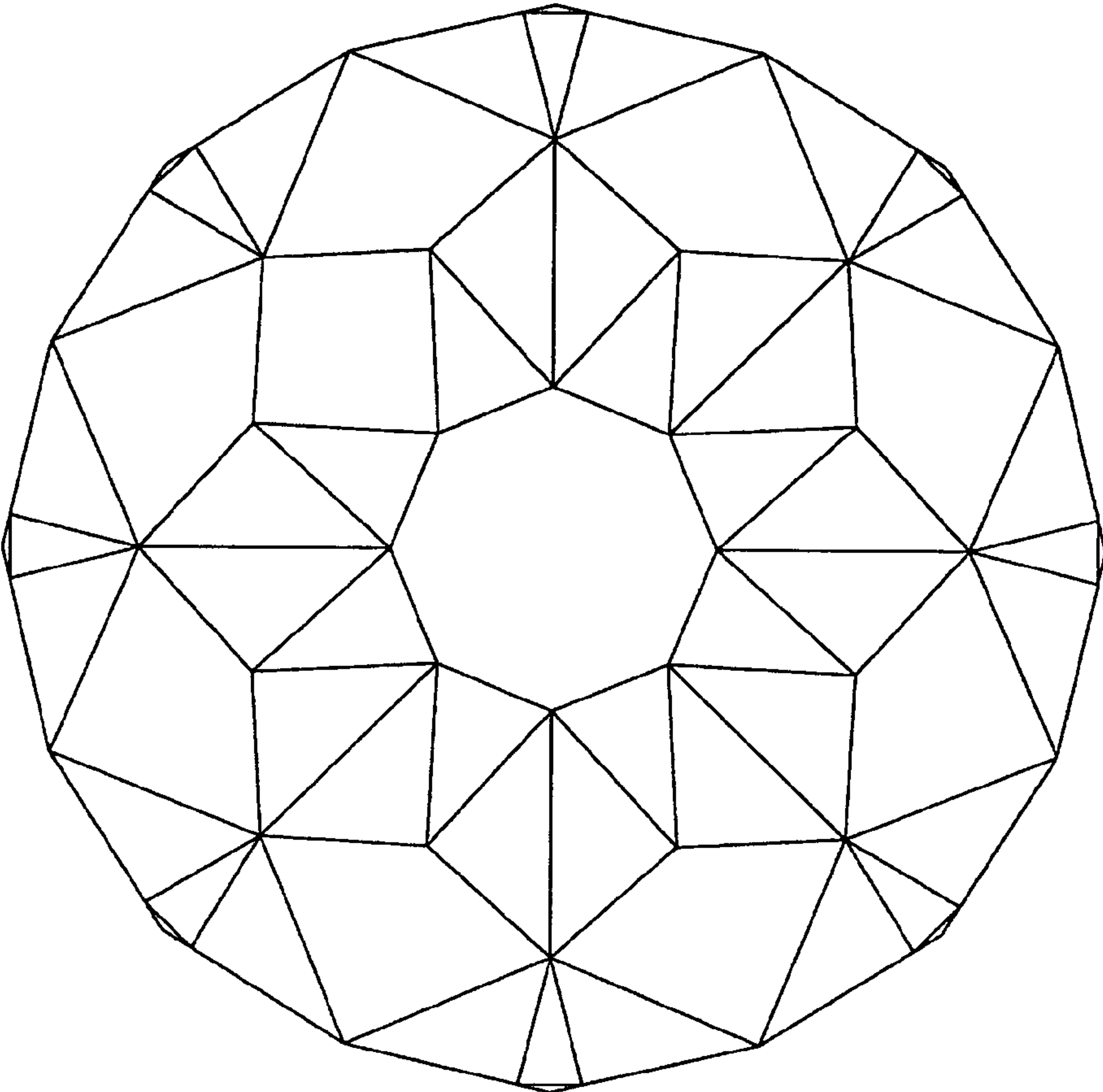

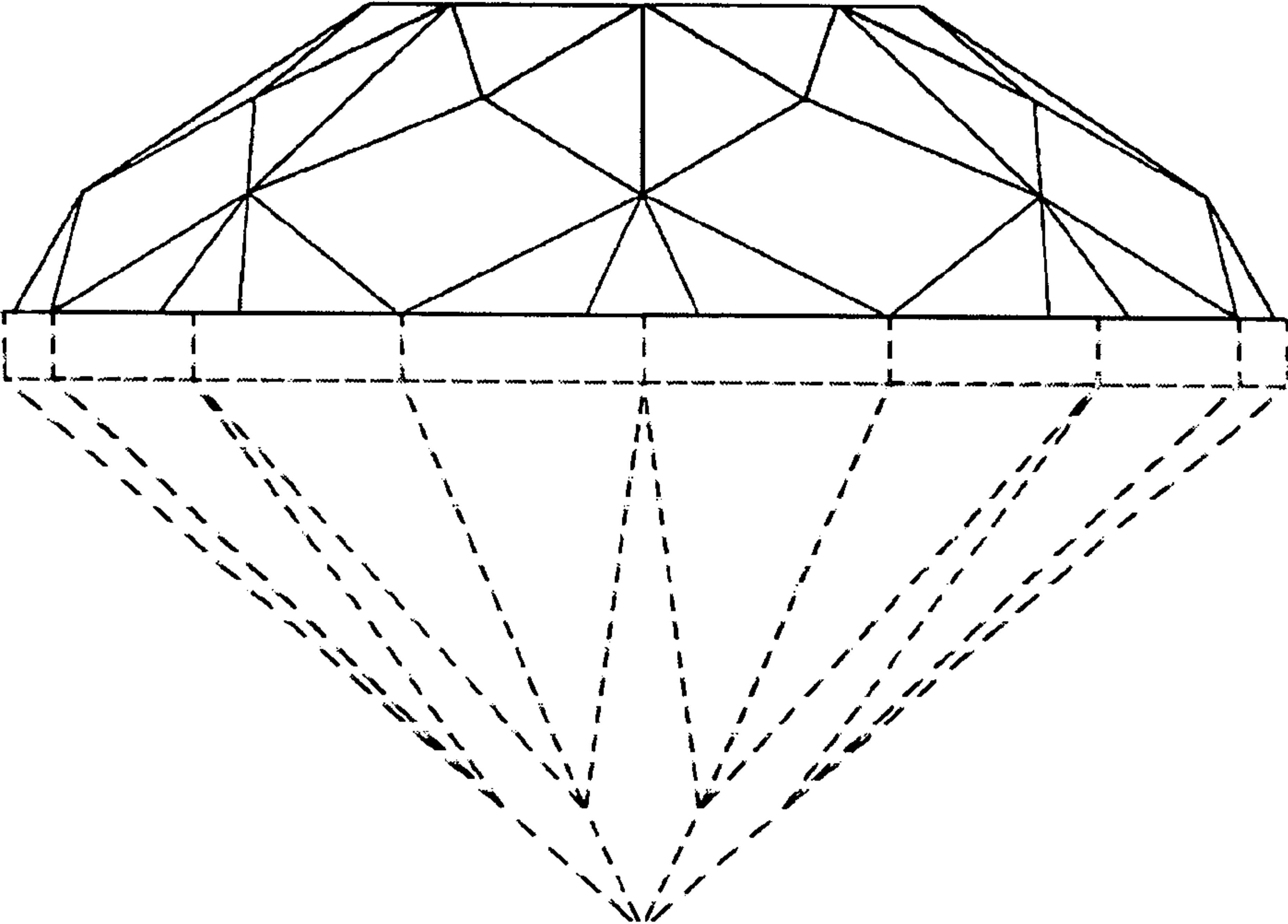
