FIG. 1 illustrates a first state of a graphical user interface embodied in a display panel according to the invention.

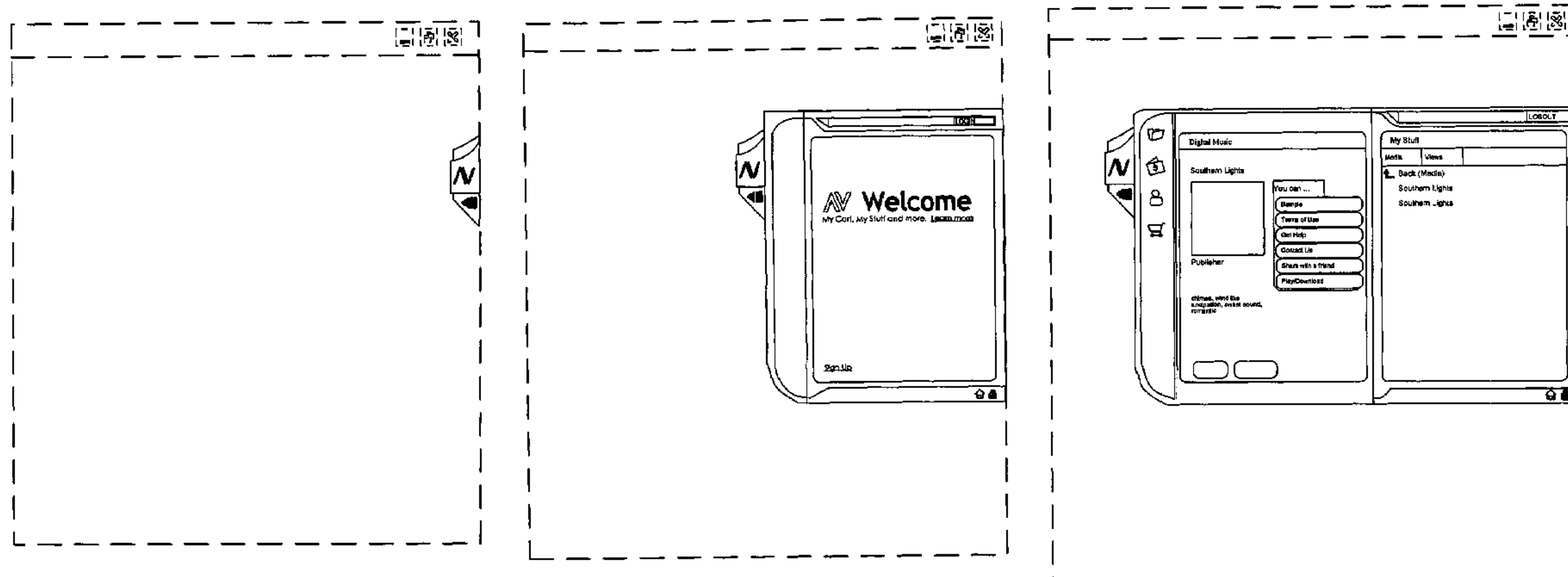
FIG. 2 illustrates a second state of the graphical user interface of FIG. 1; and,

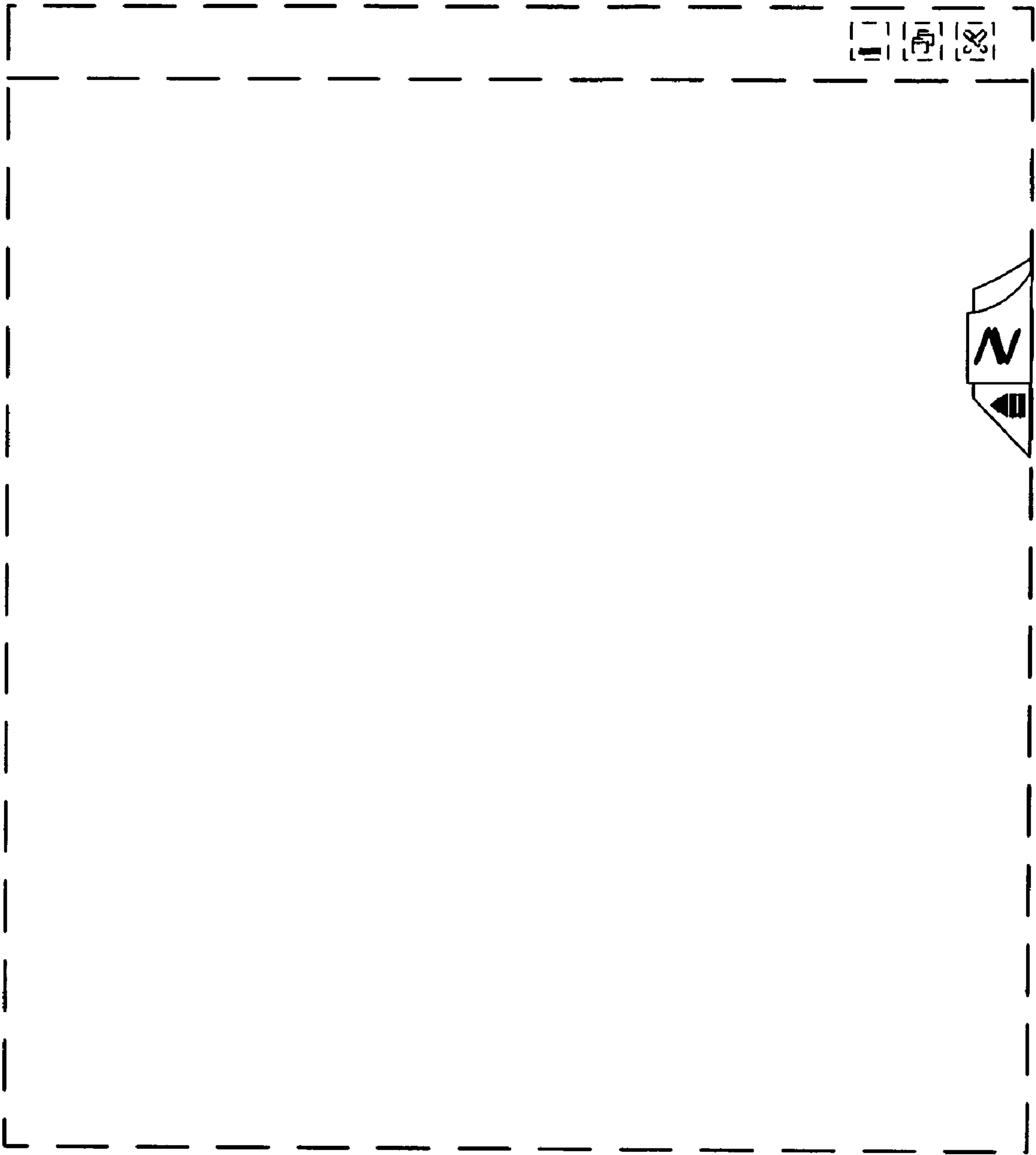

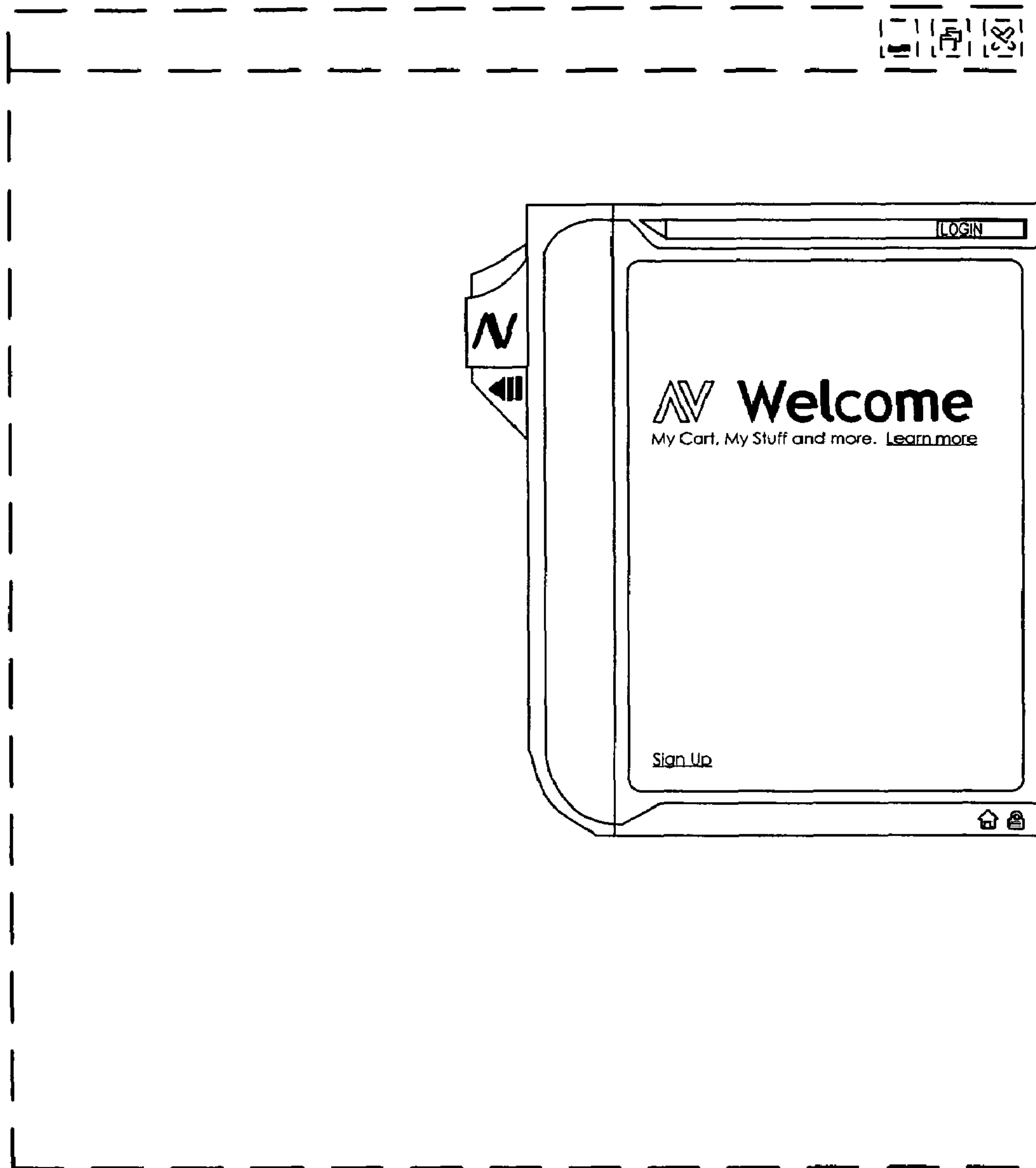
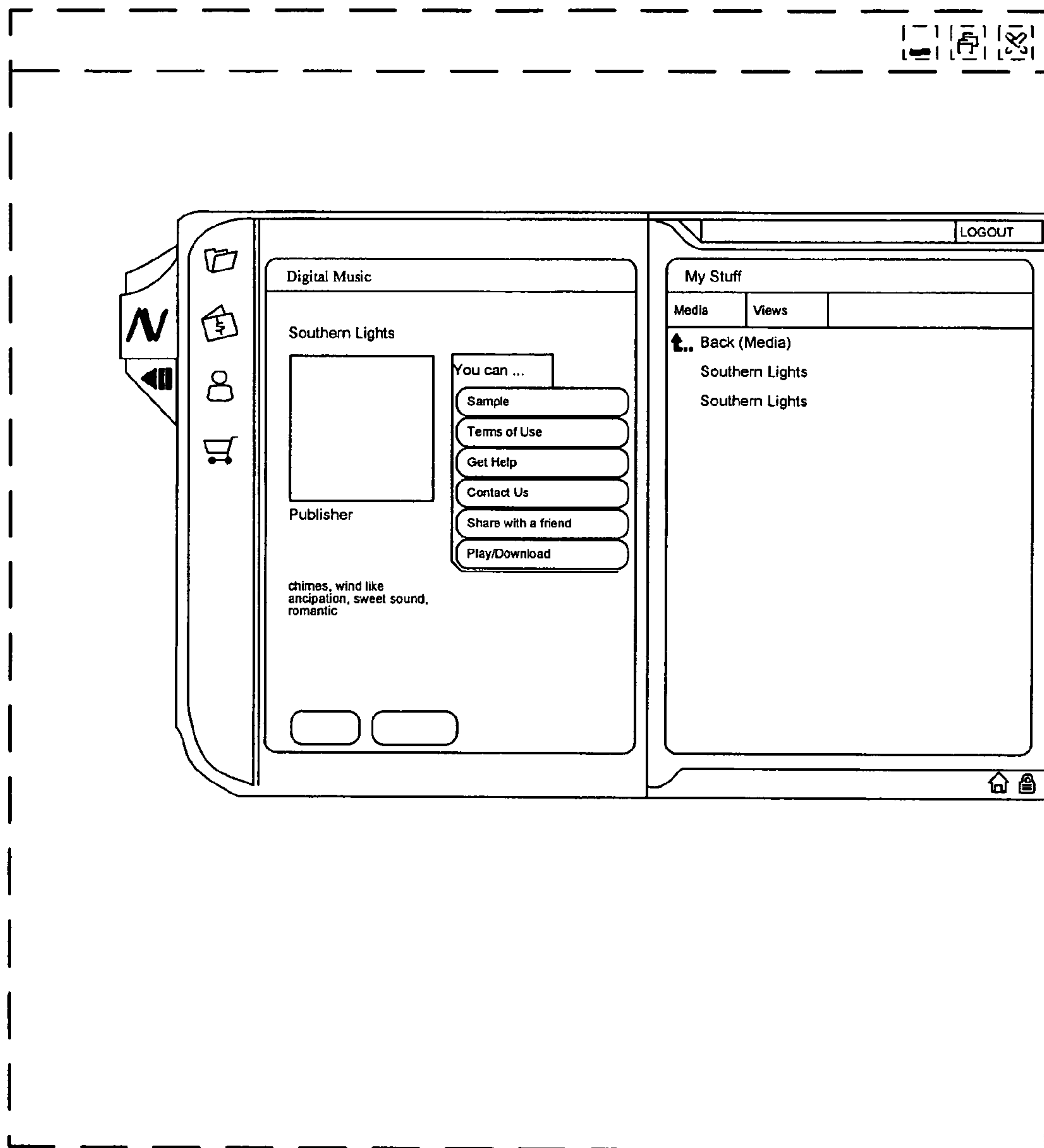
