FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an ornamental design for an evaluation tool according to the present invention; and, FIG. 2 is a plan view of FIG. 1.

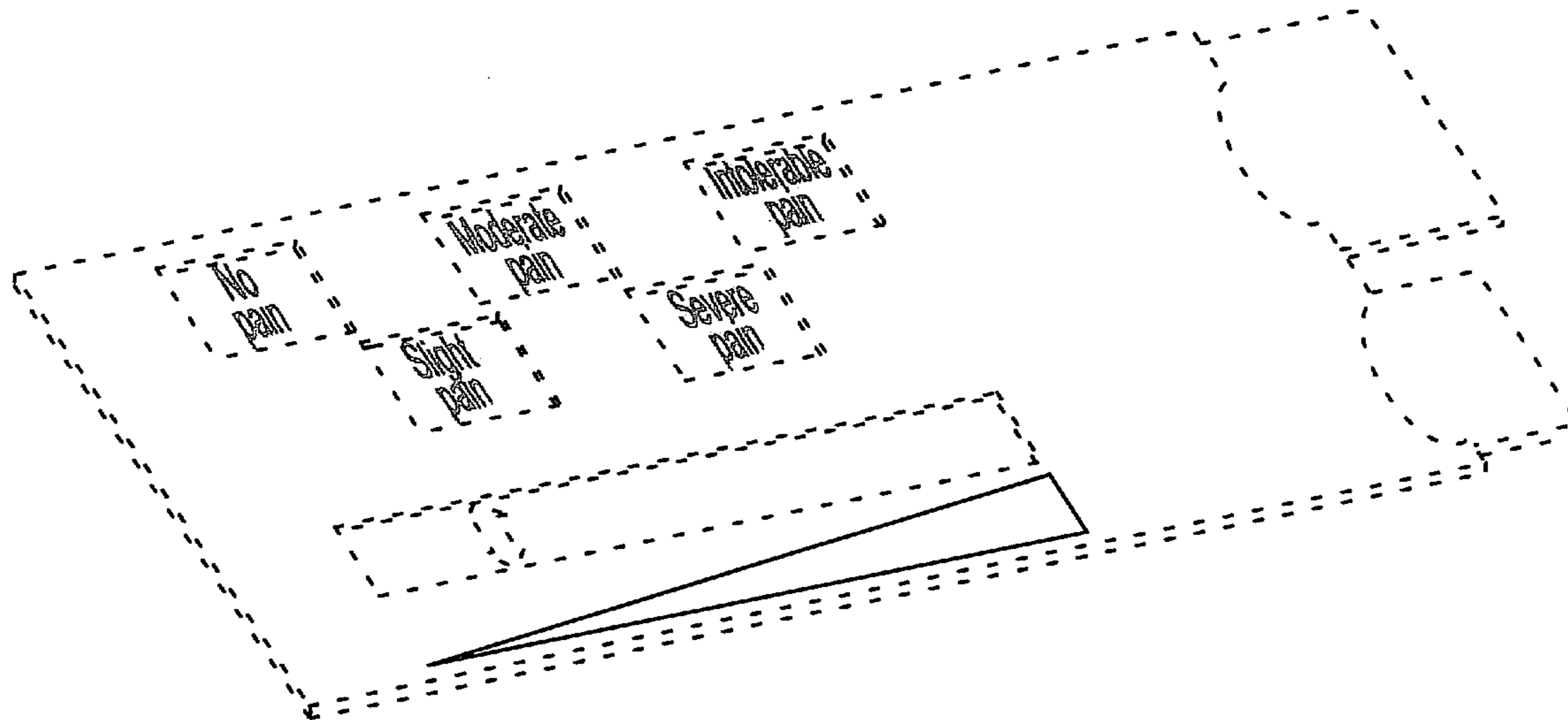

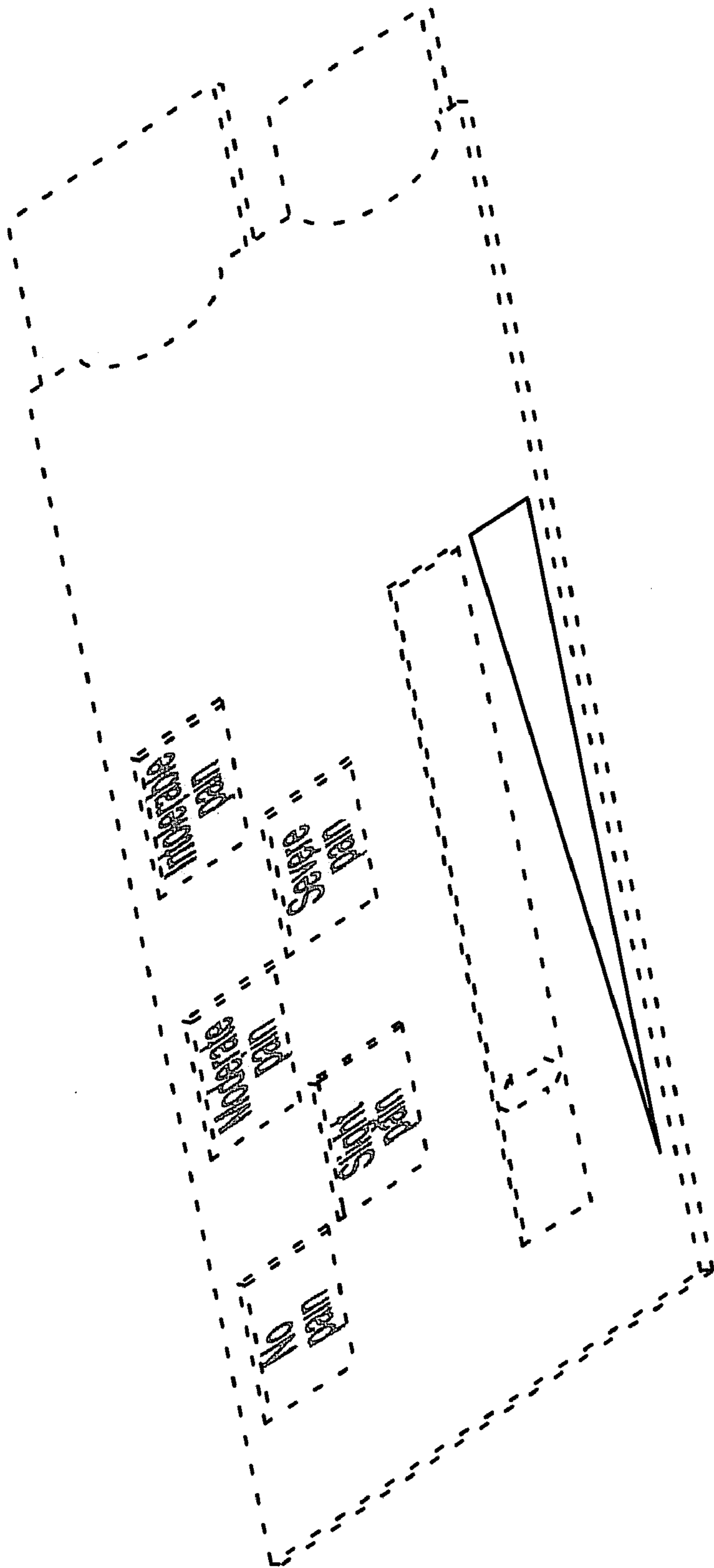

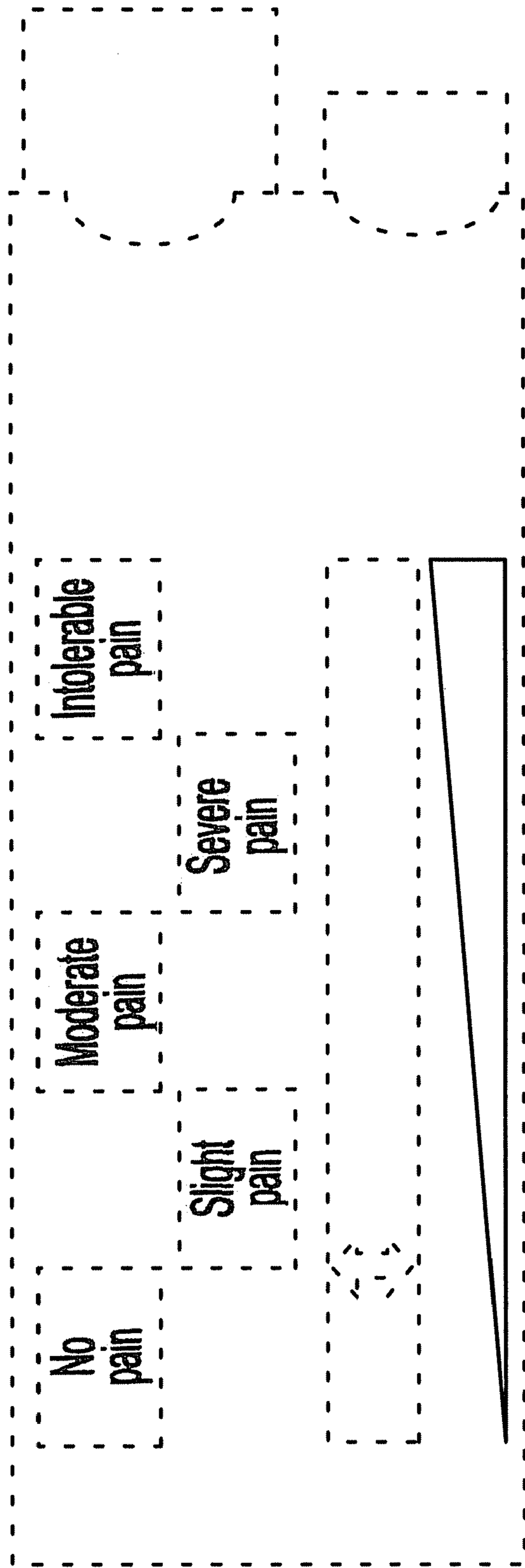
