(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a baseball arm band, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a first embodiment of a baseball arm band with attachment devices shown in dashed lines;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the band;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the band;

FIG. 4 is a side view of the band with the opposite side being a mirror image; and

FIG. 5 is an end view of the band with the opposite end being a mirror image.

FIG. 6 is a top perspective view of a Second embodiment of a baseball arm band with attachment devices shown in dashed lines;

FIG. 7 is a top view of the band;

FIG. 8 is a bottom view of the band;

FIG. 9 is a side view of the band with the opposite side being a mirror image; and

FIG. 10 is an end view of the band with the opposite end being a mirror image.

FIG. 11 is a top perspective view of a Third embodiment of a baseball arm band with attachment devices shown in dashed lines;

FIG. 12 is a top view of the band;

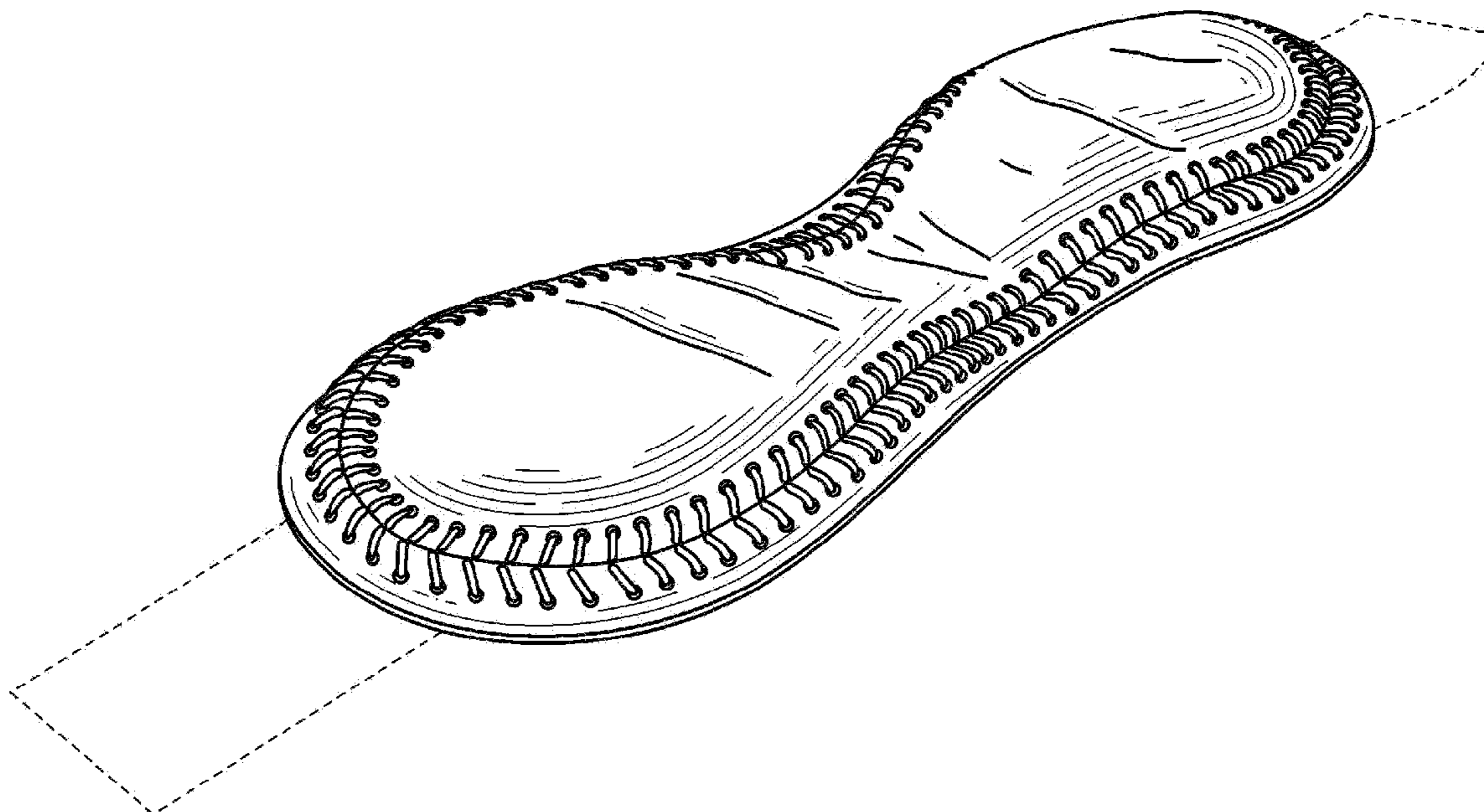
FIG. 13 is a bottom view of the band;

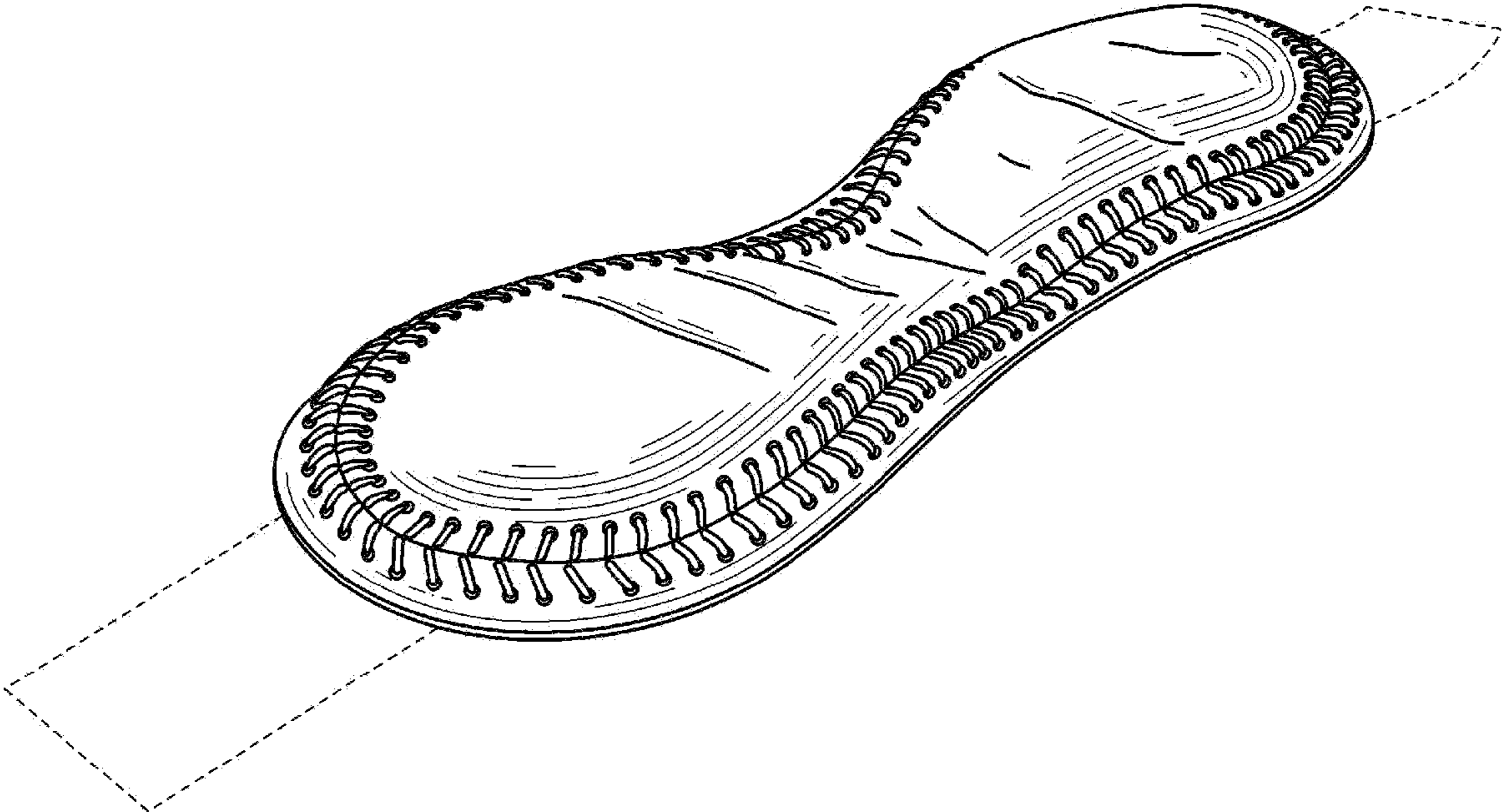

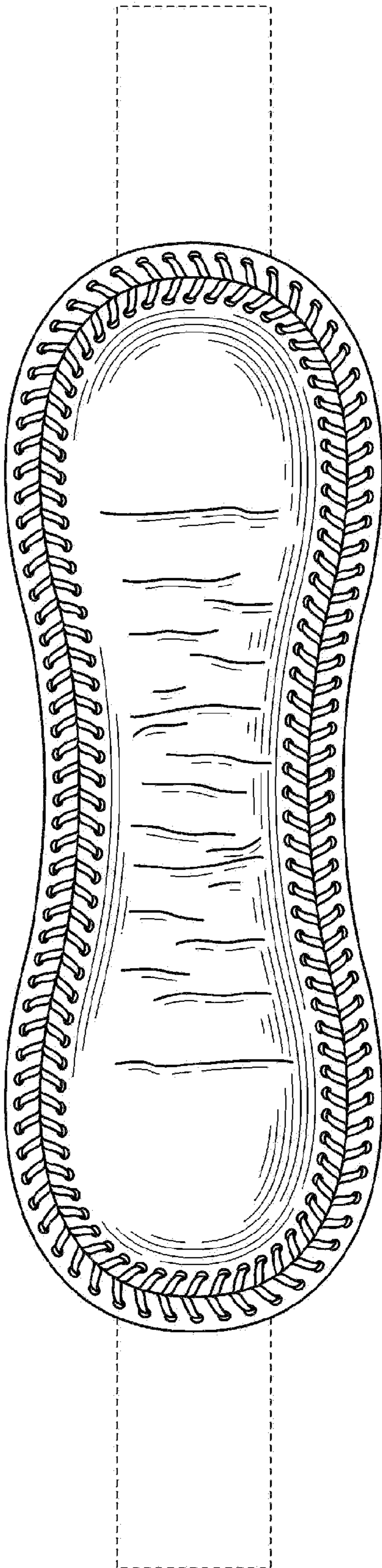

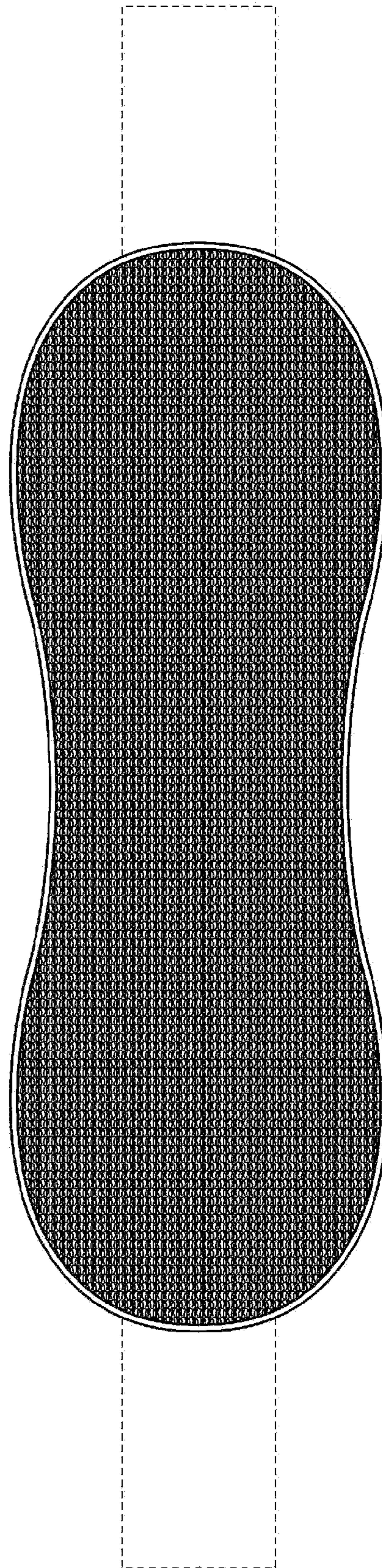

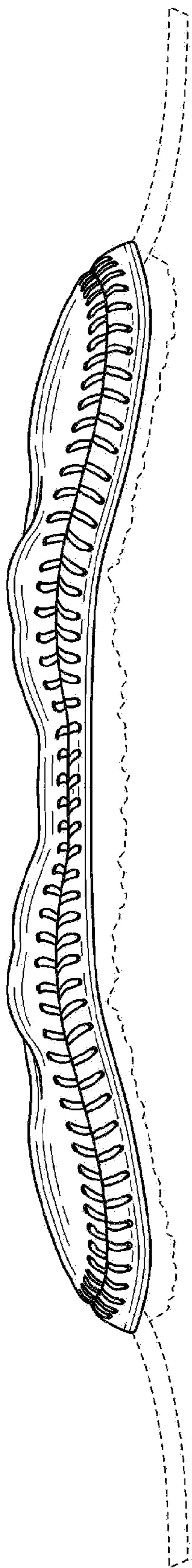

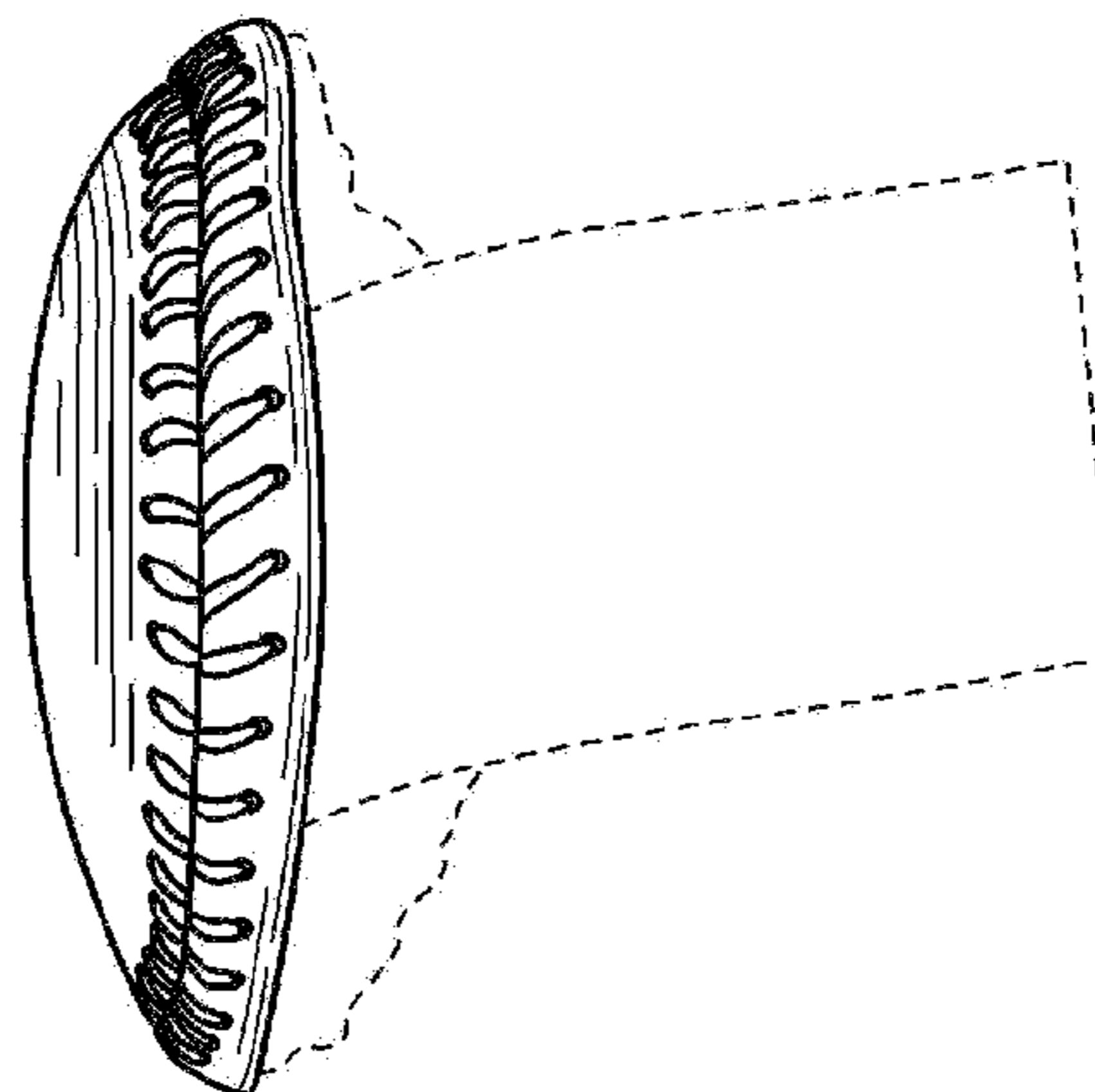

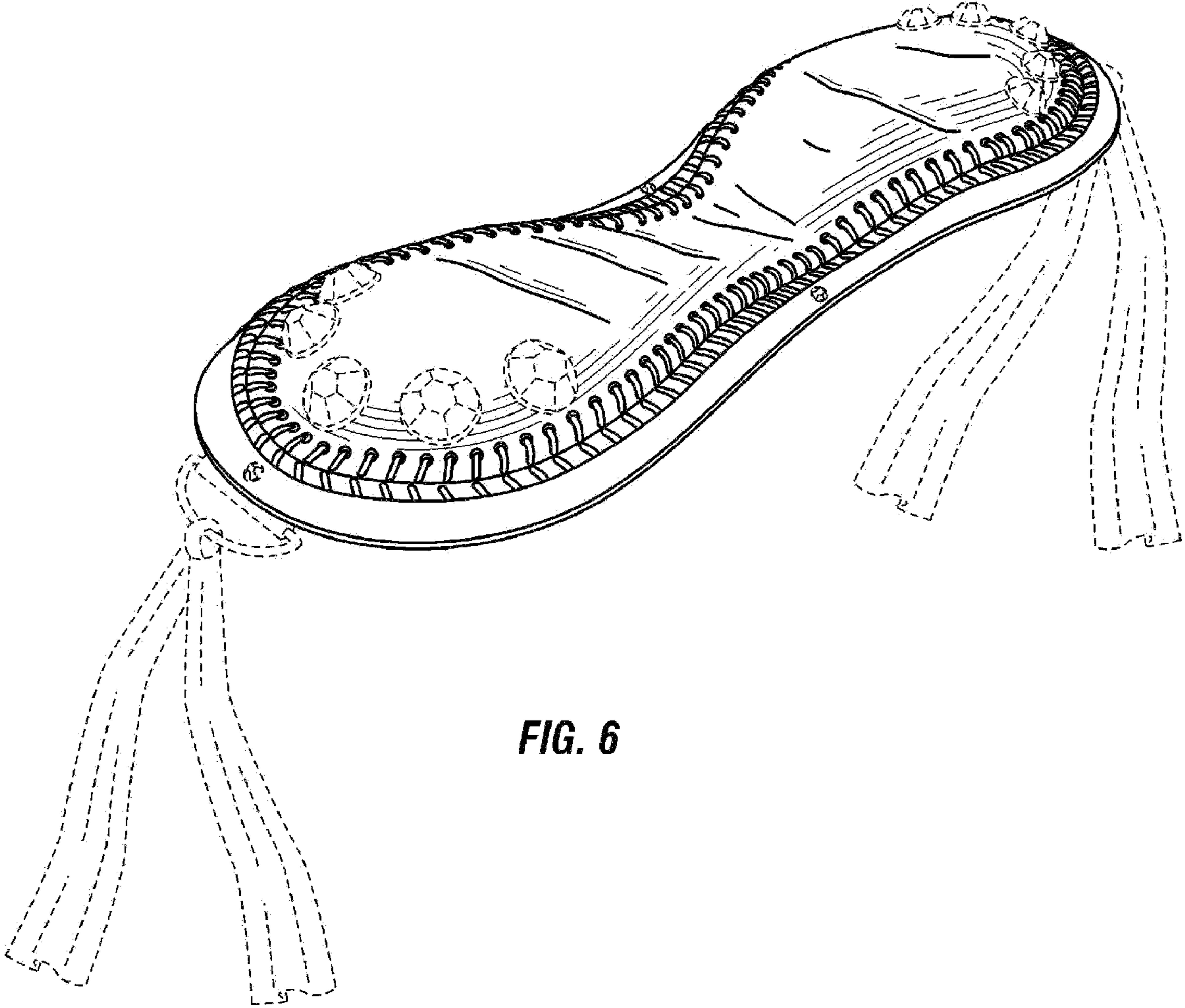

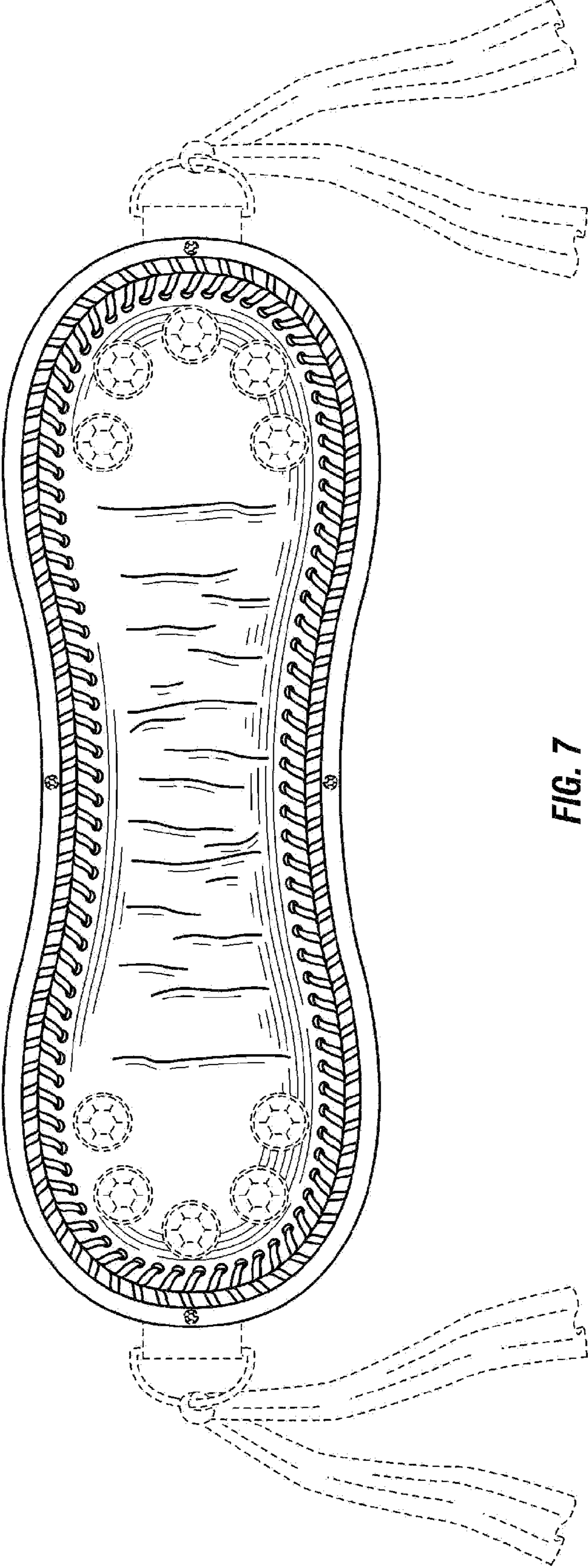

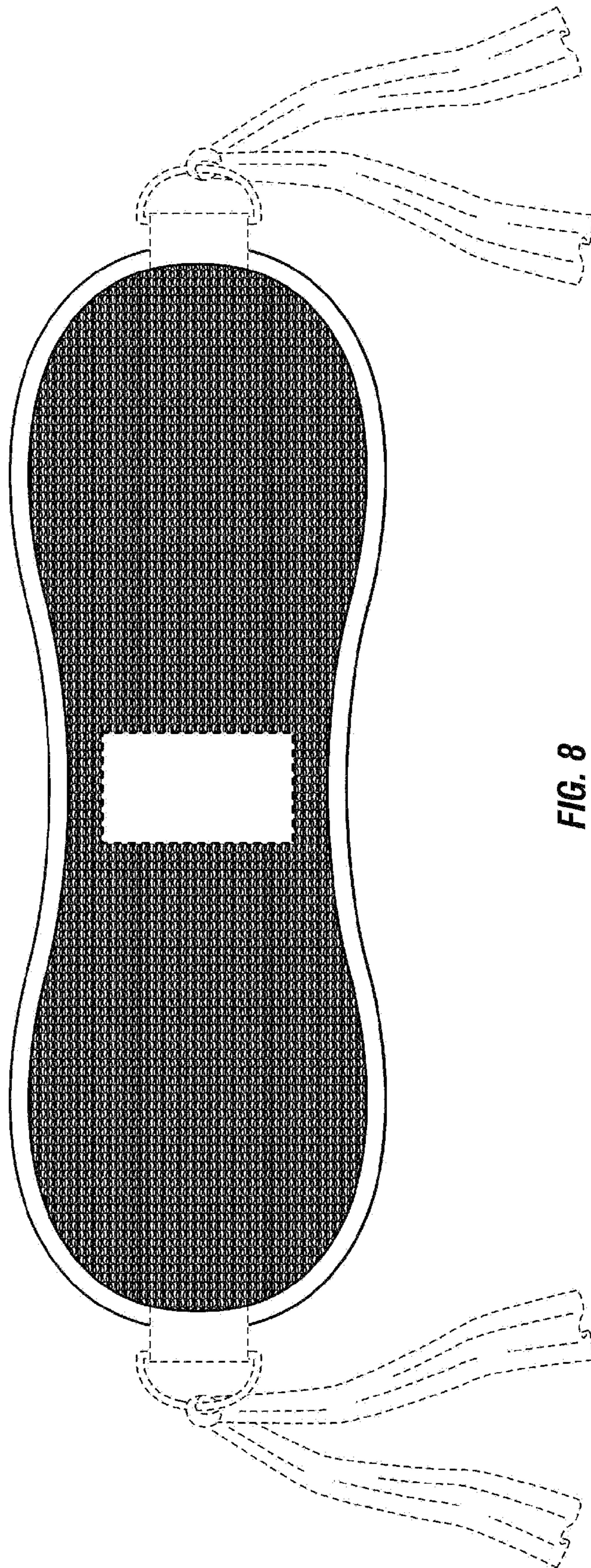

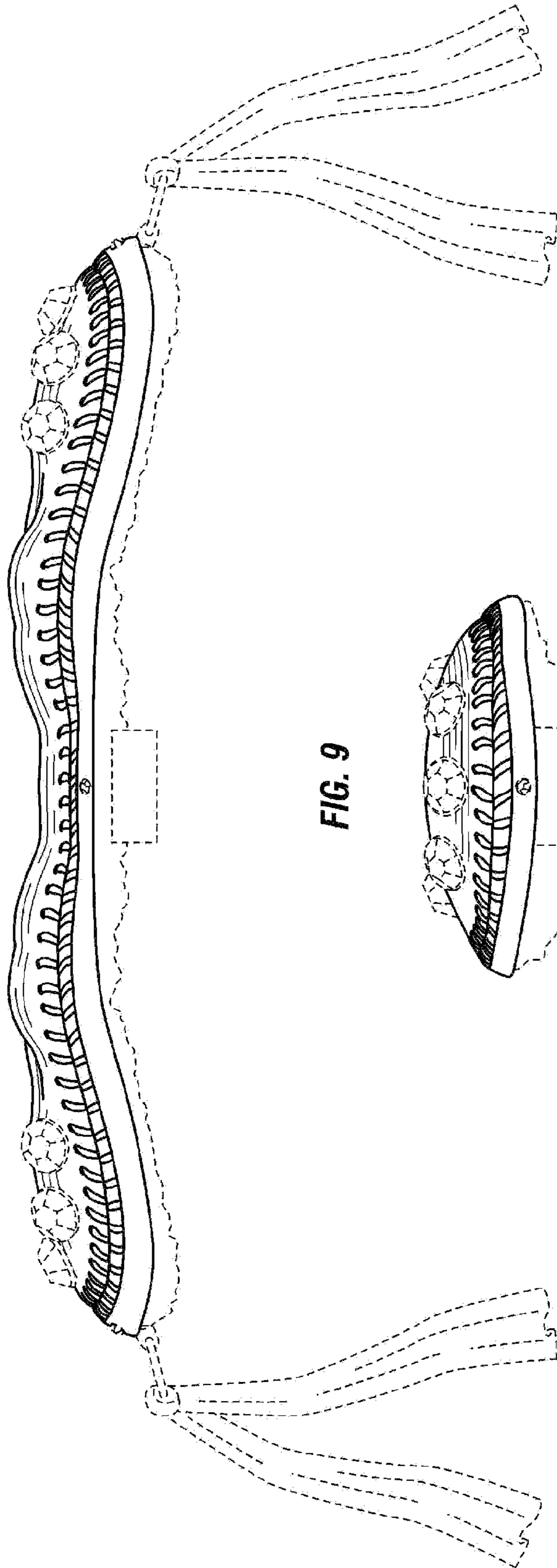

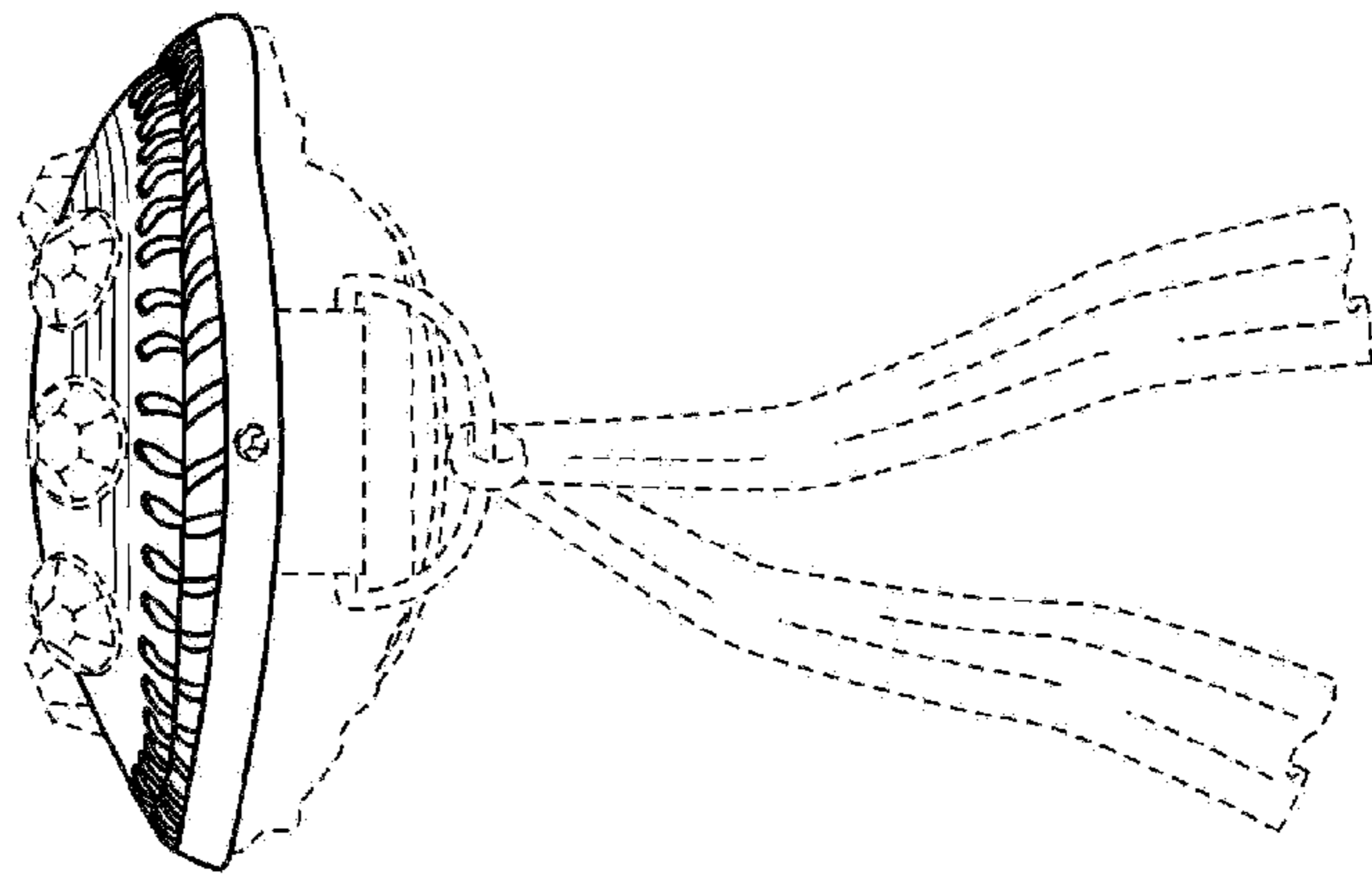

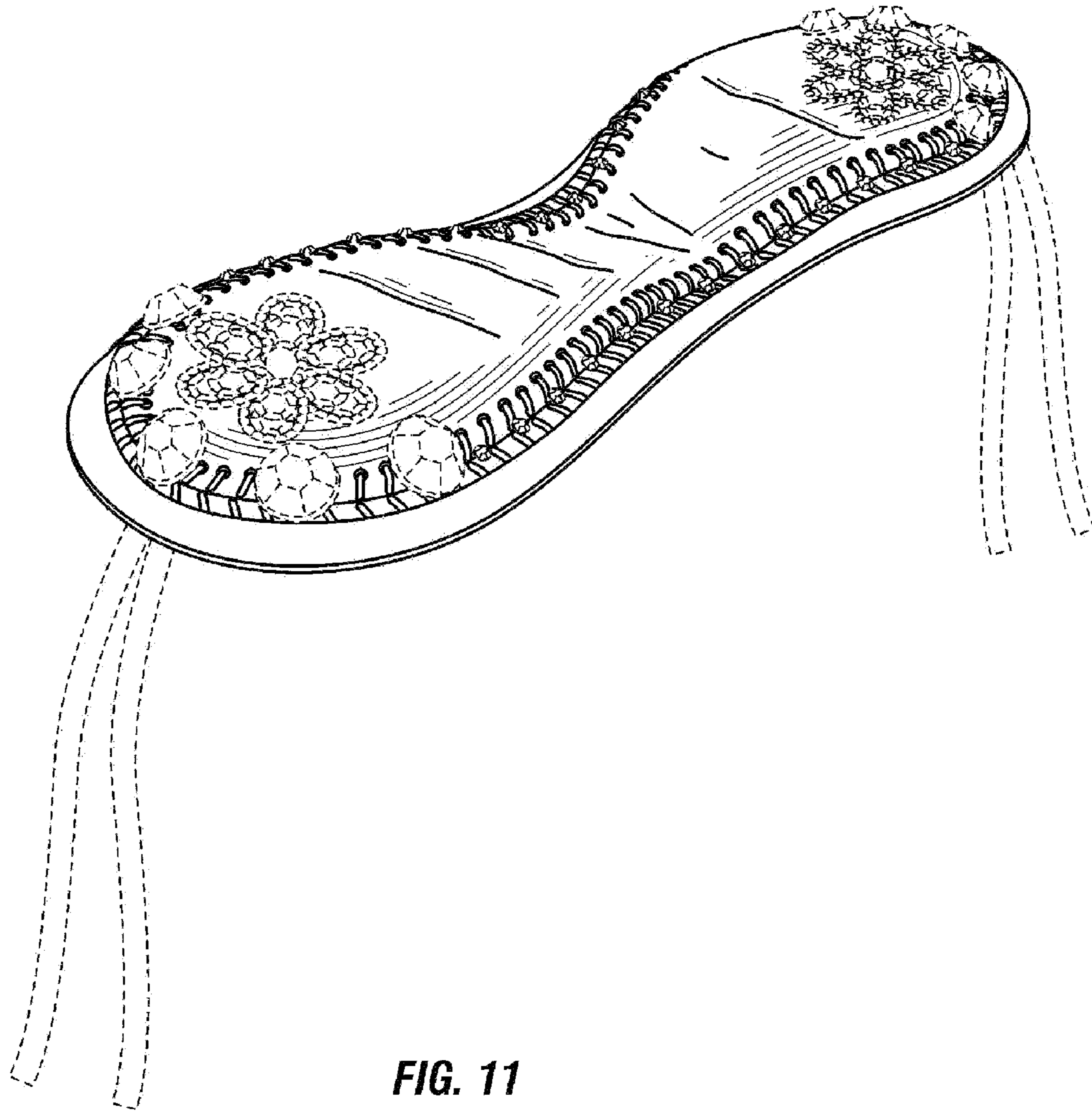

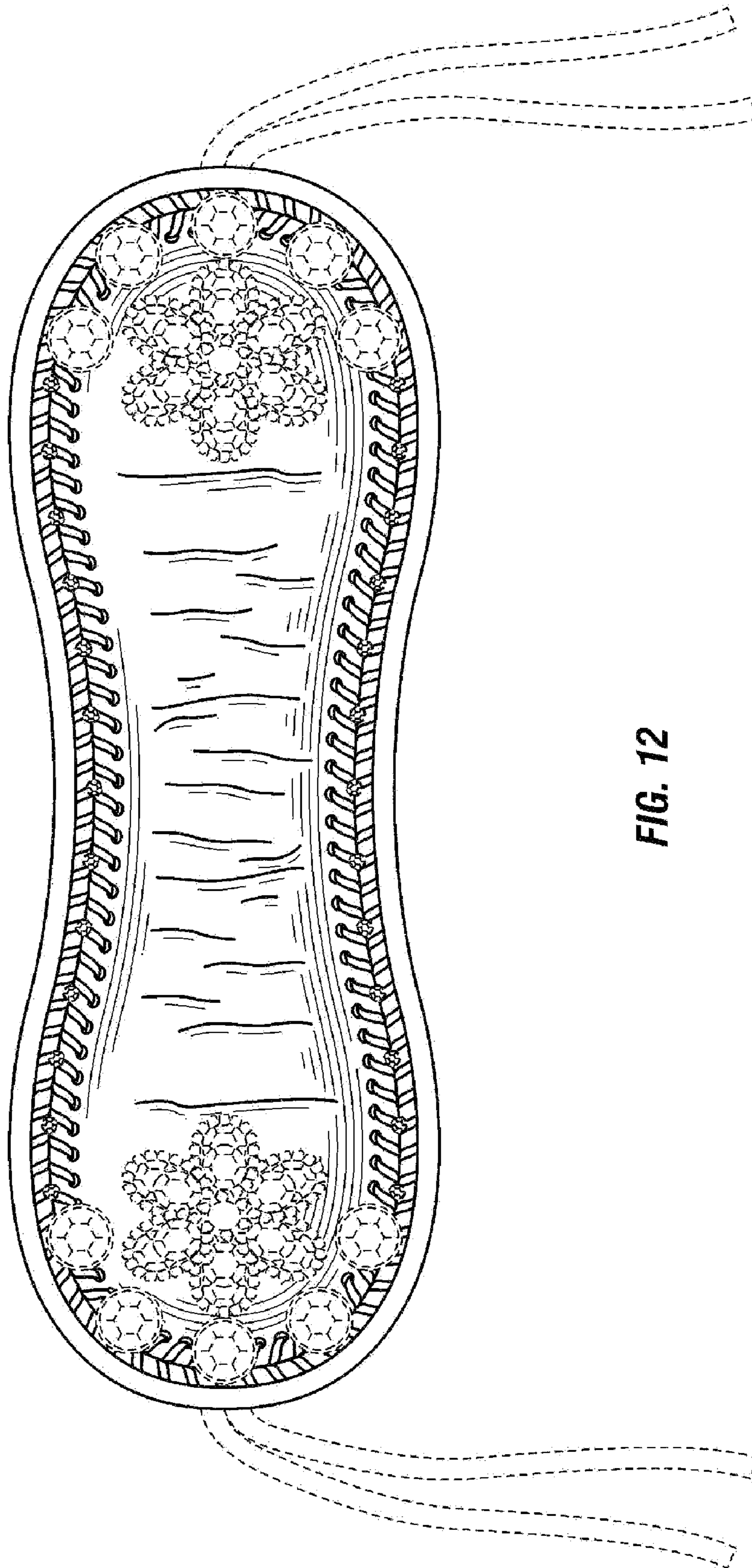

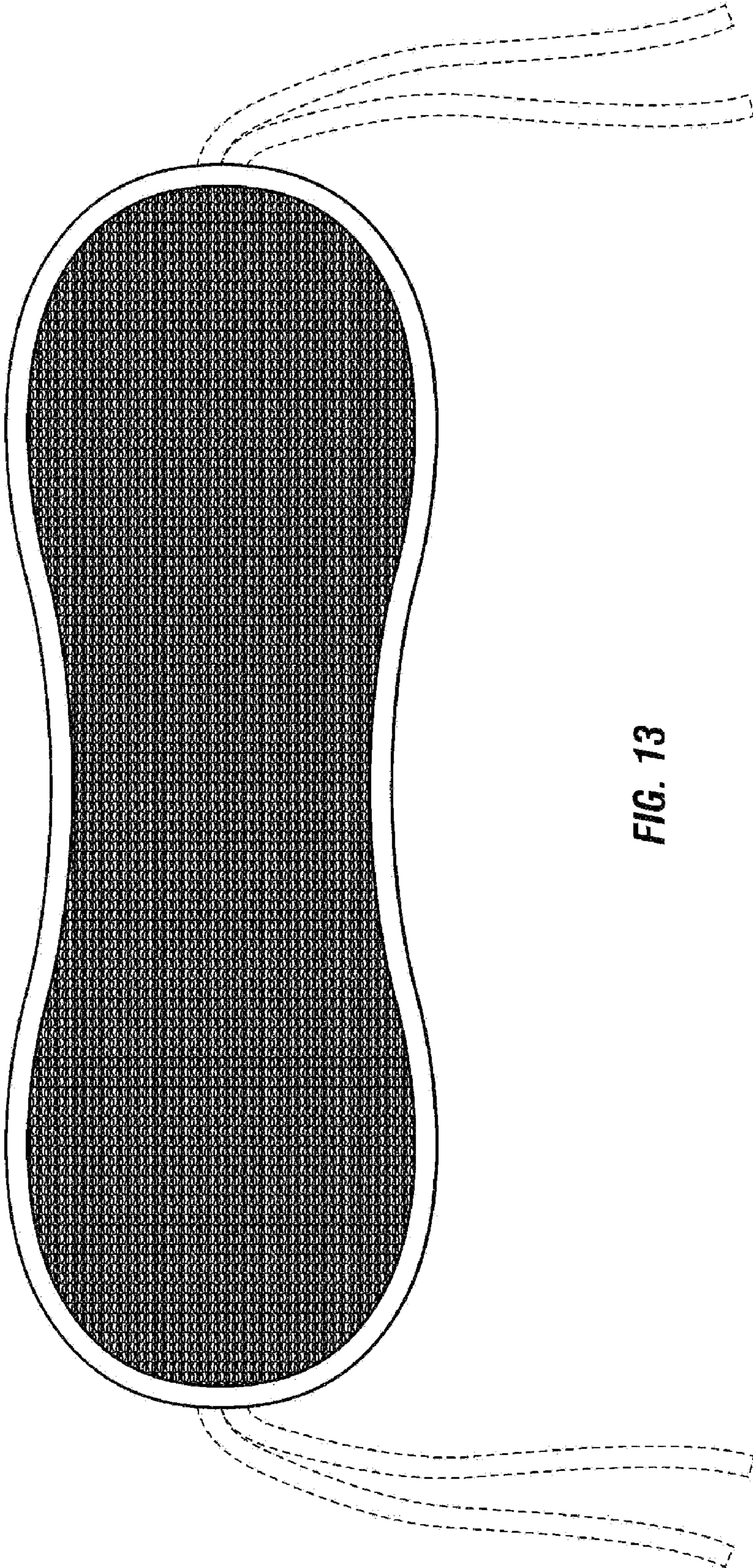

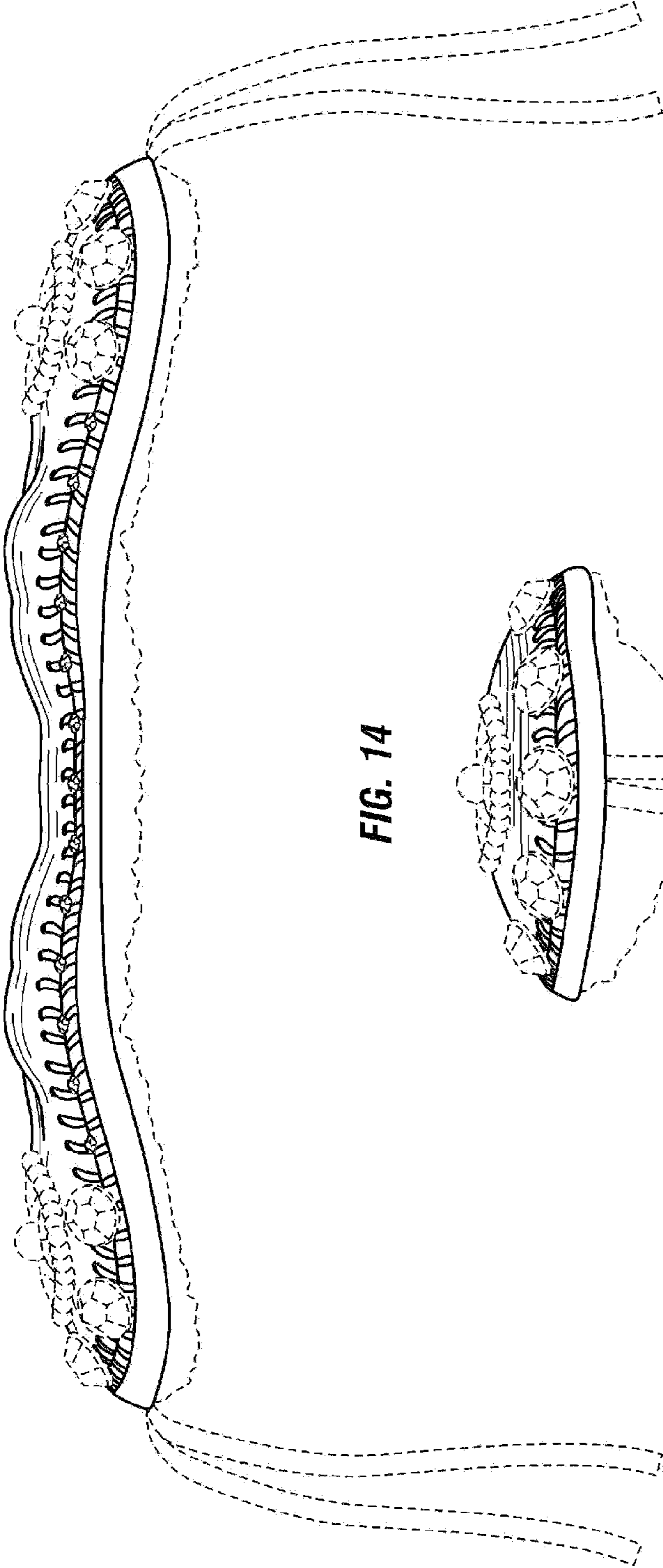

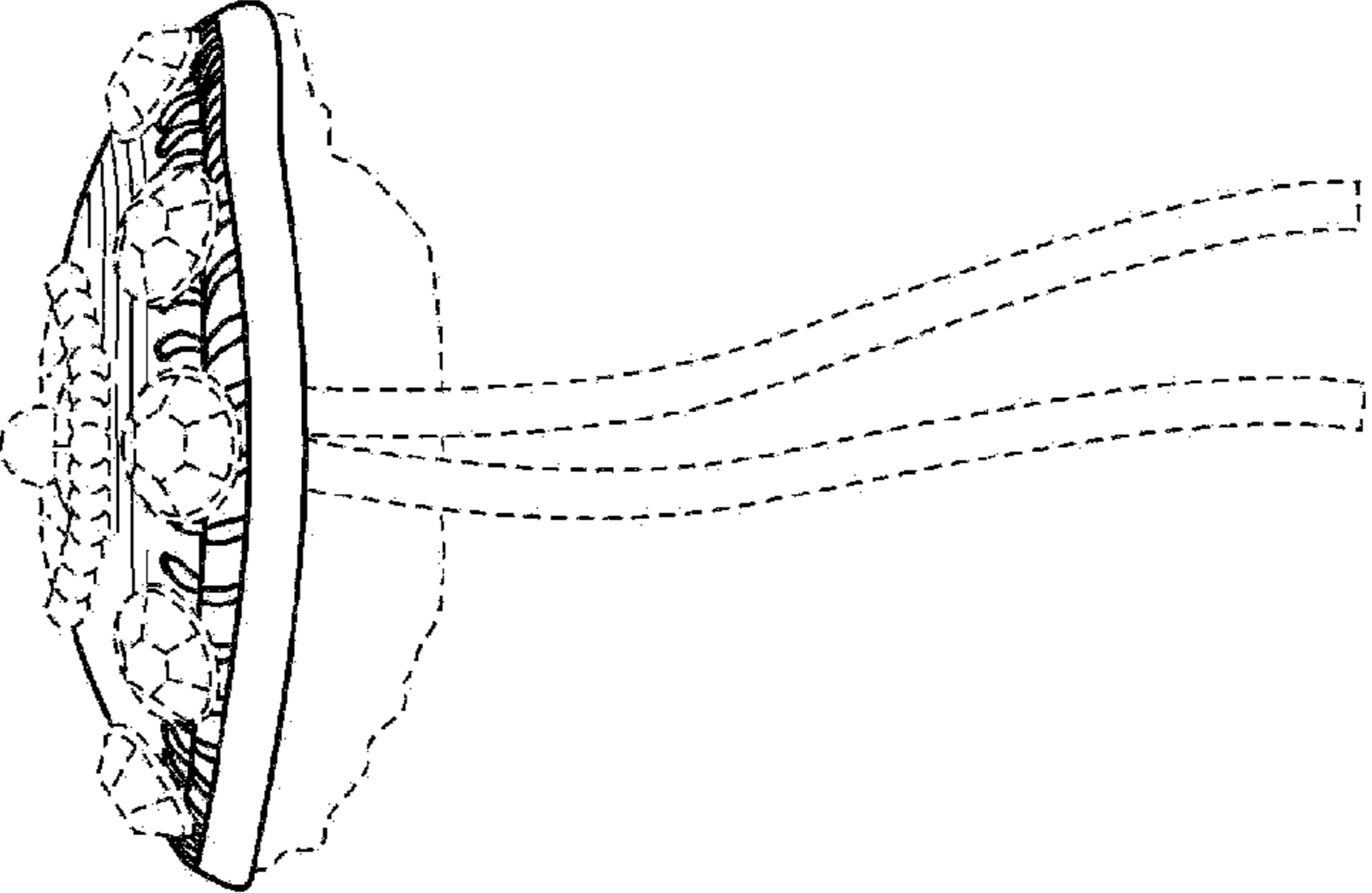
