The fragmented depiction of a weave pattern is understood to repeat uniformly throughout the circumscribed areas.

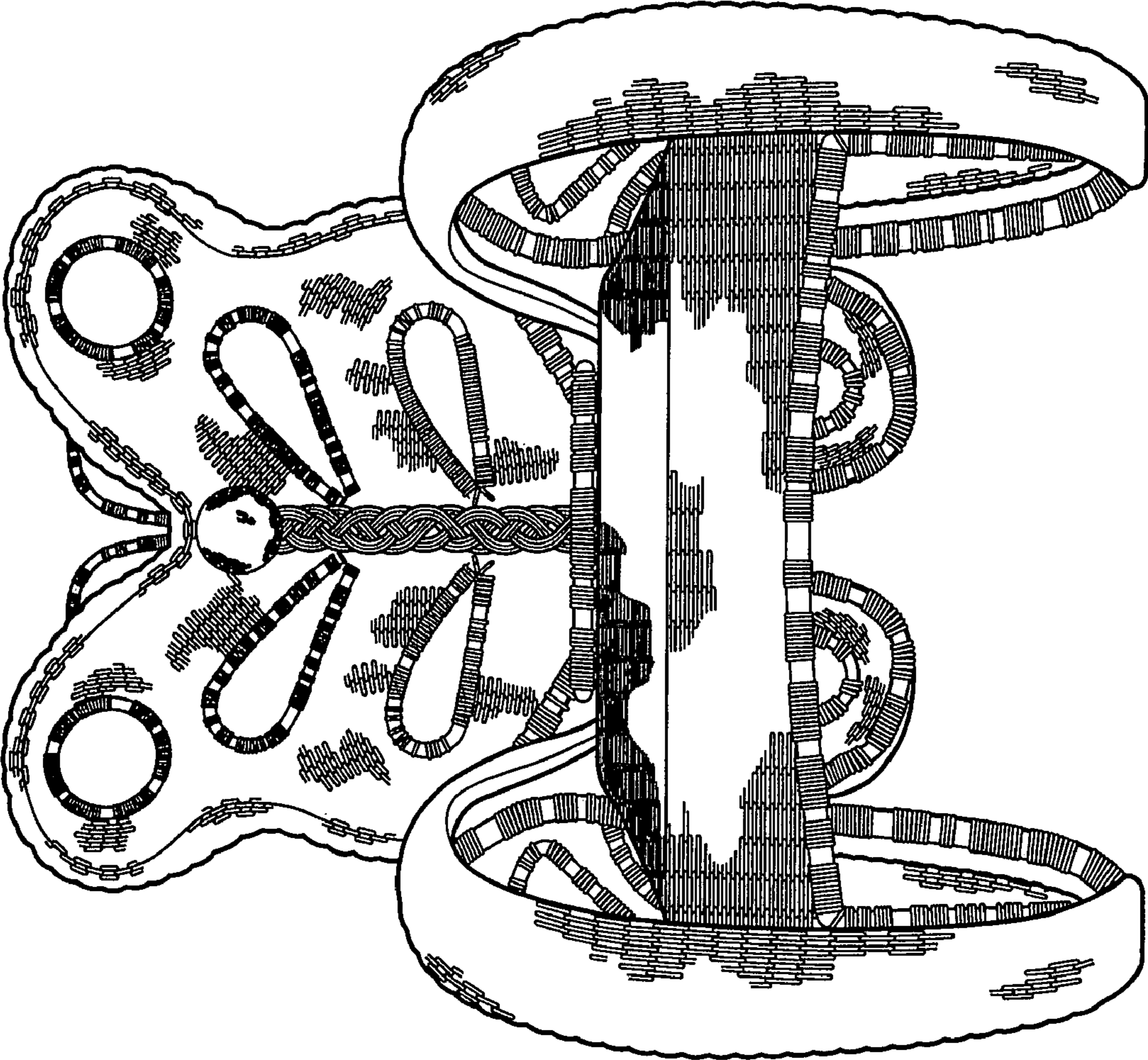

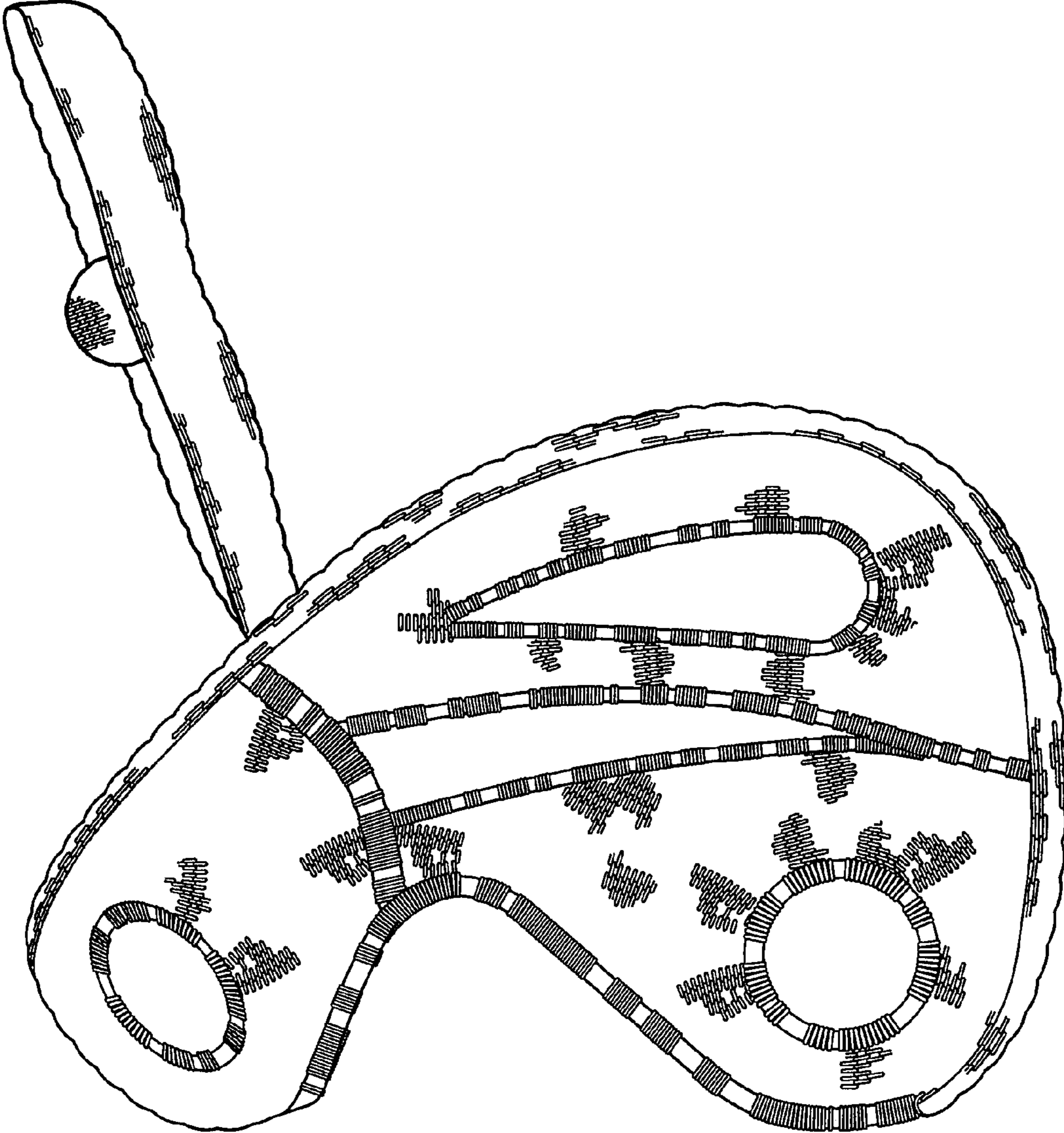

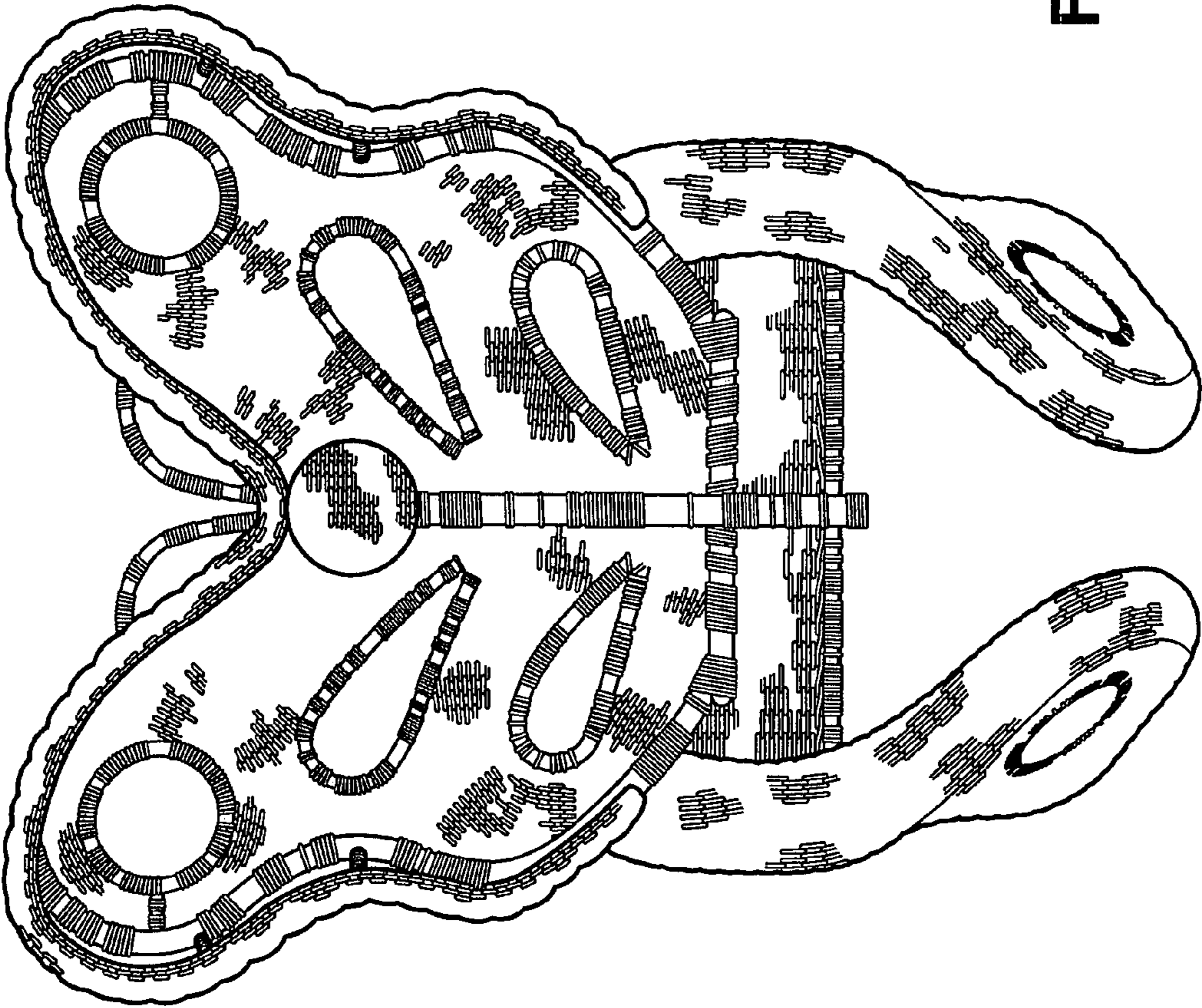

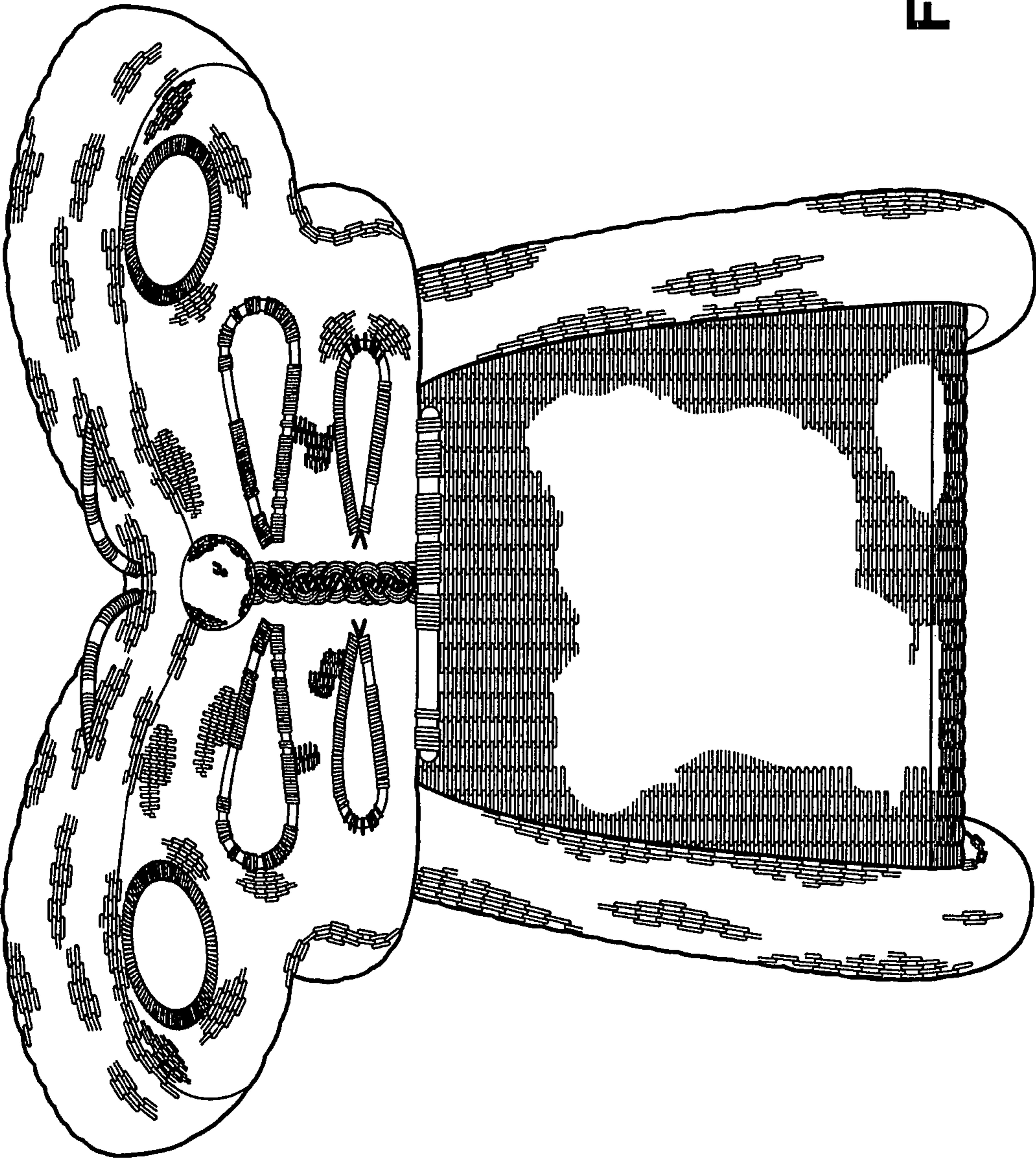
