(57) **CLAIM**

I claim, the ornamental design for a mobile GPS alarm device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a mobile GPS alarm device, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view taken from the left of FIG. 1;

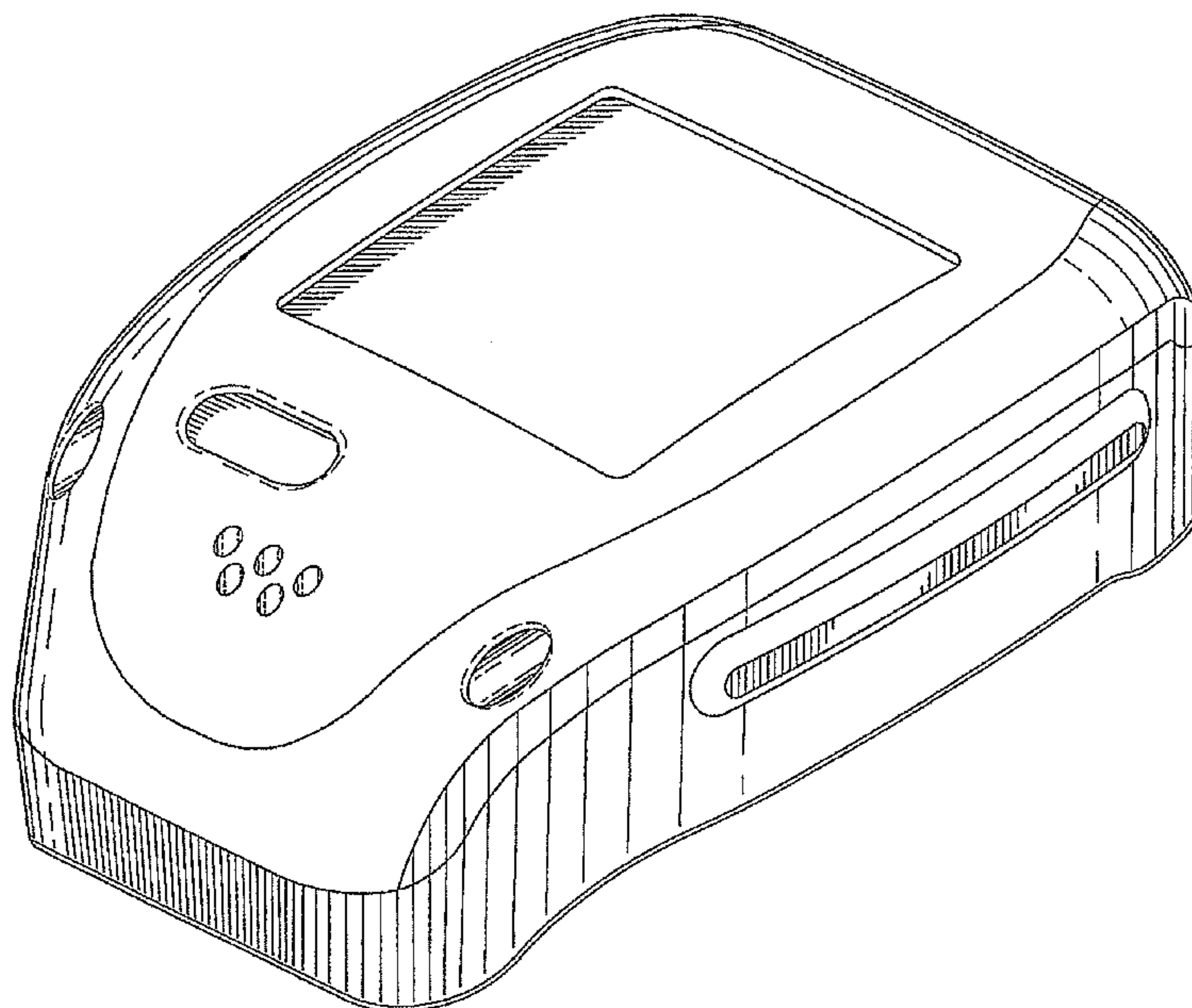
FIG. 4 is a side elevation view taken from the right of FIG. 1;

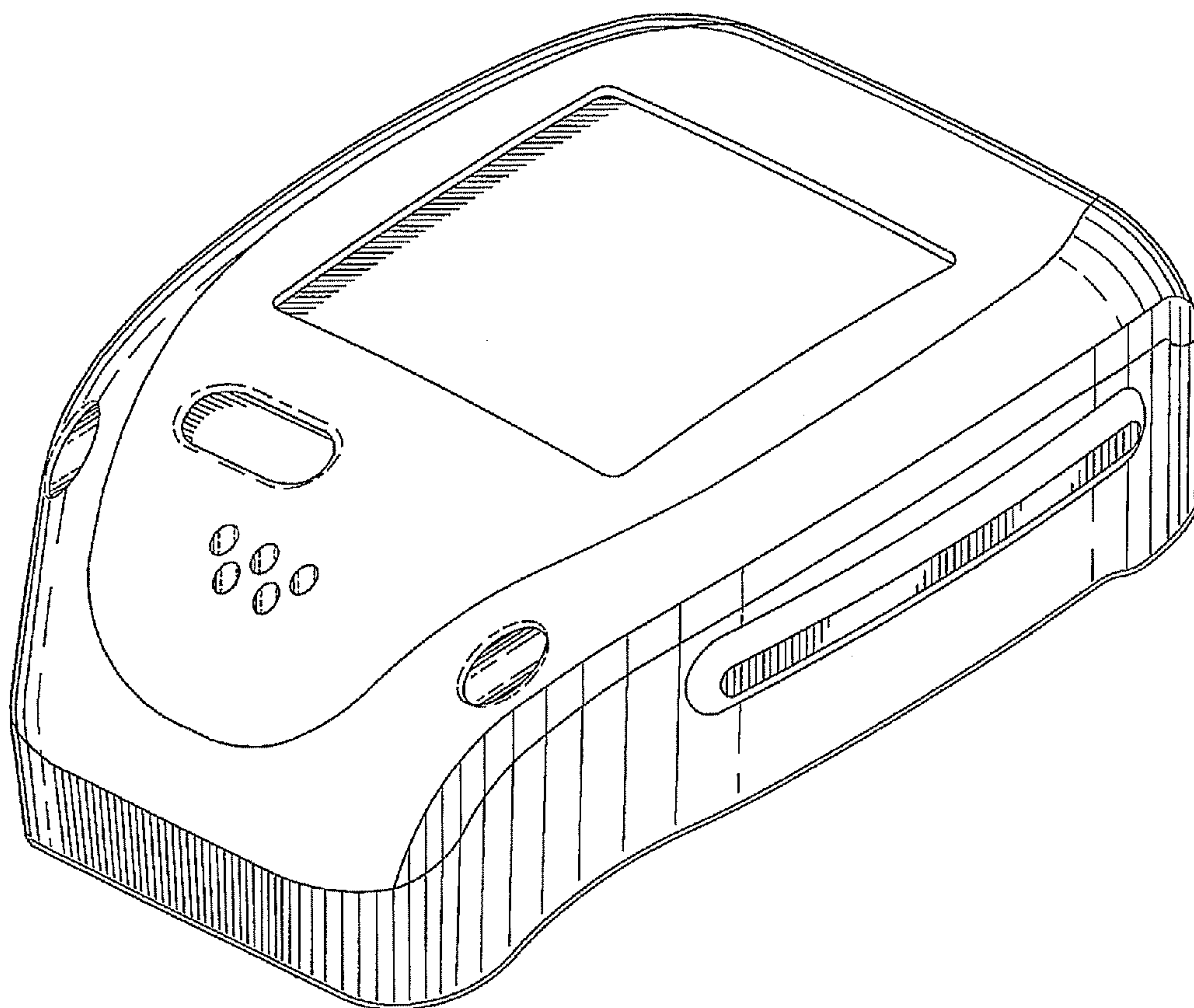

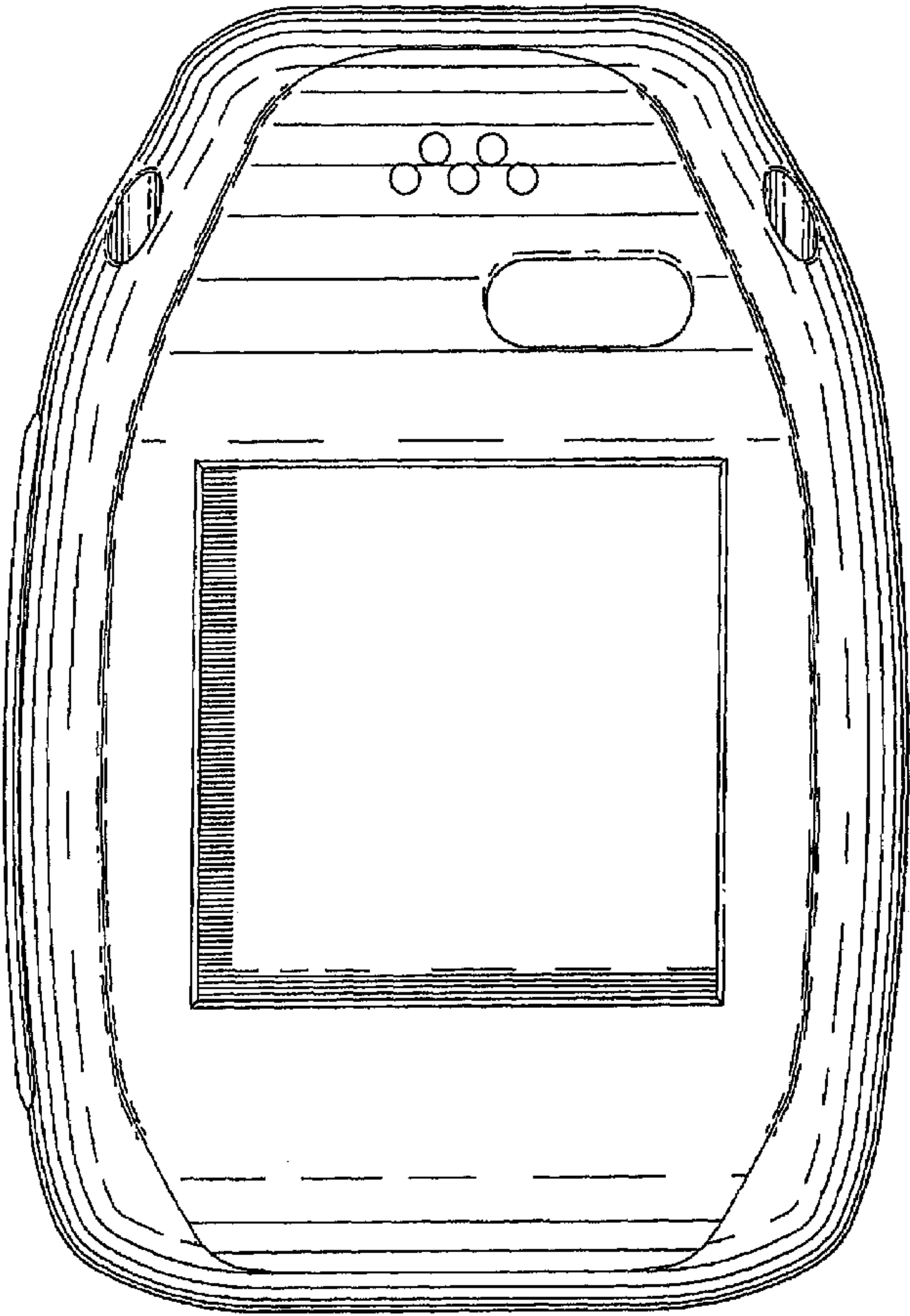

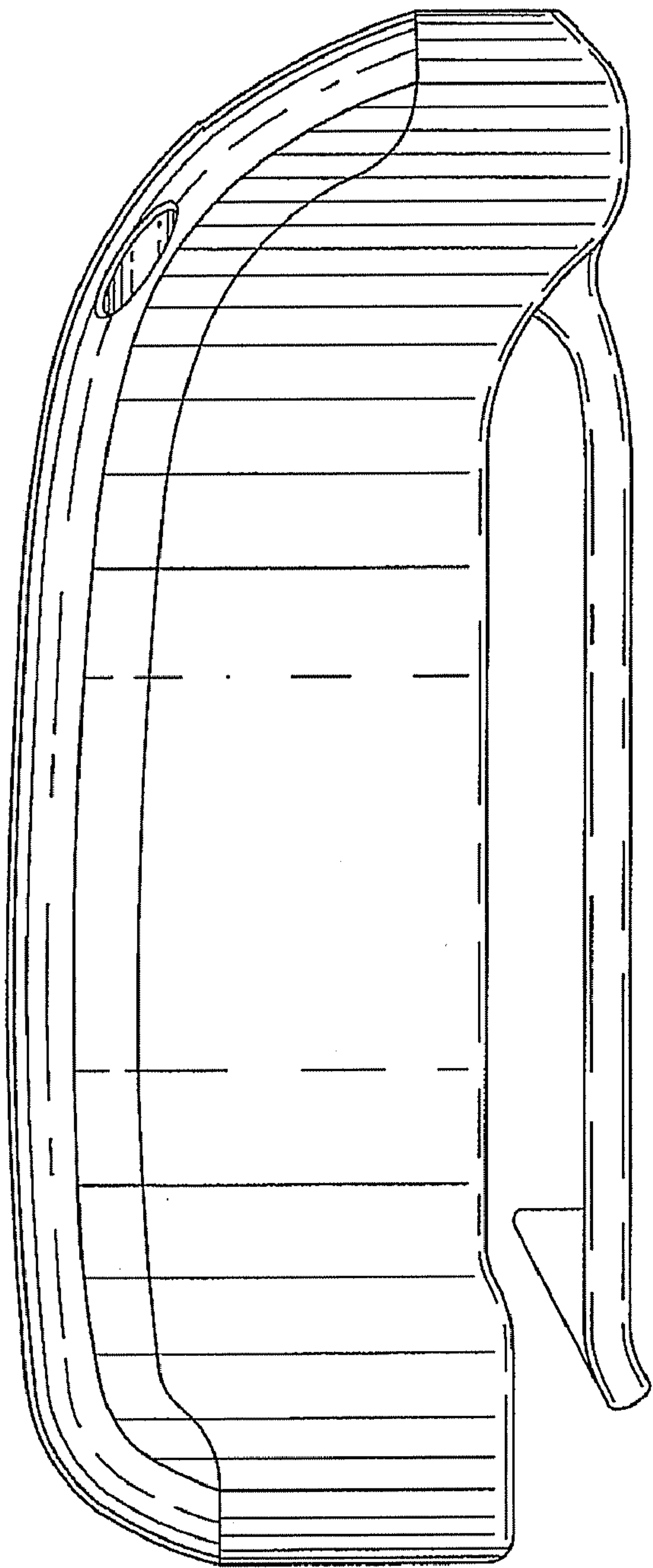

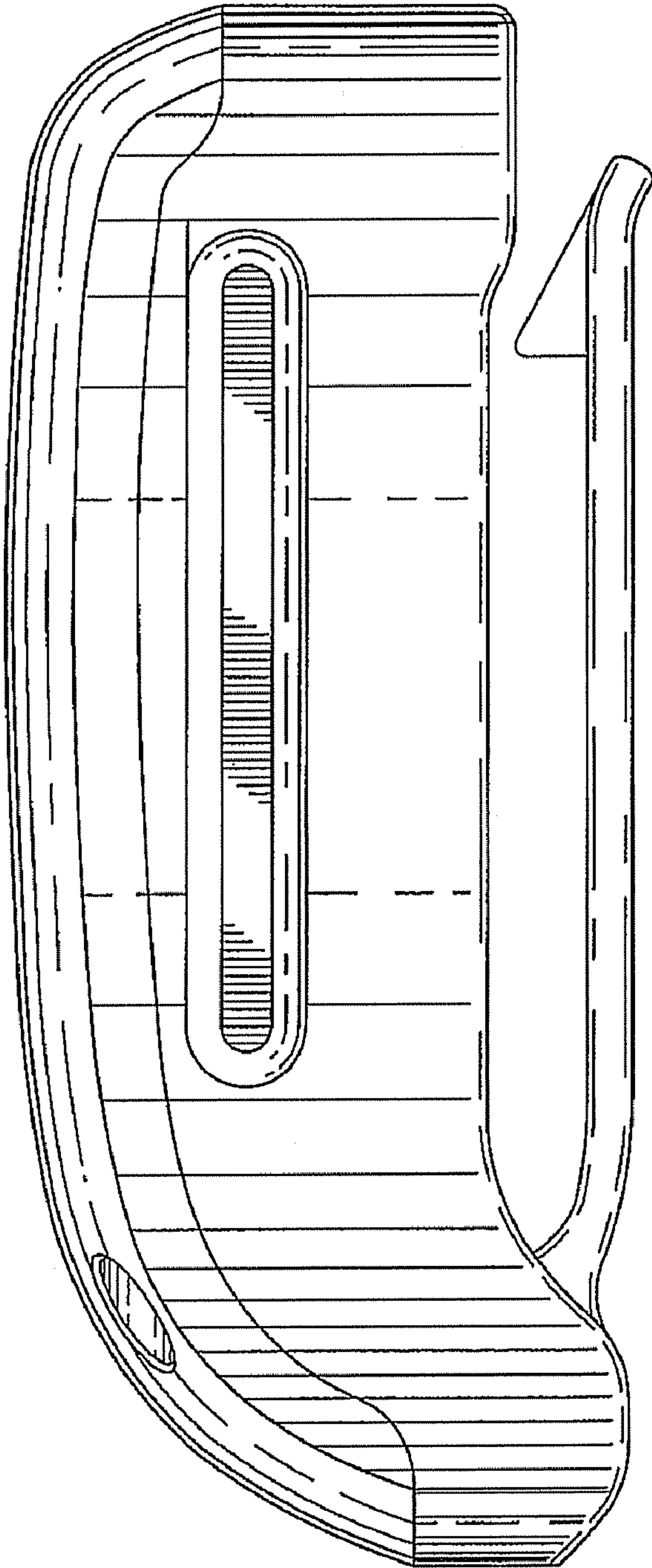

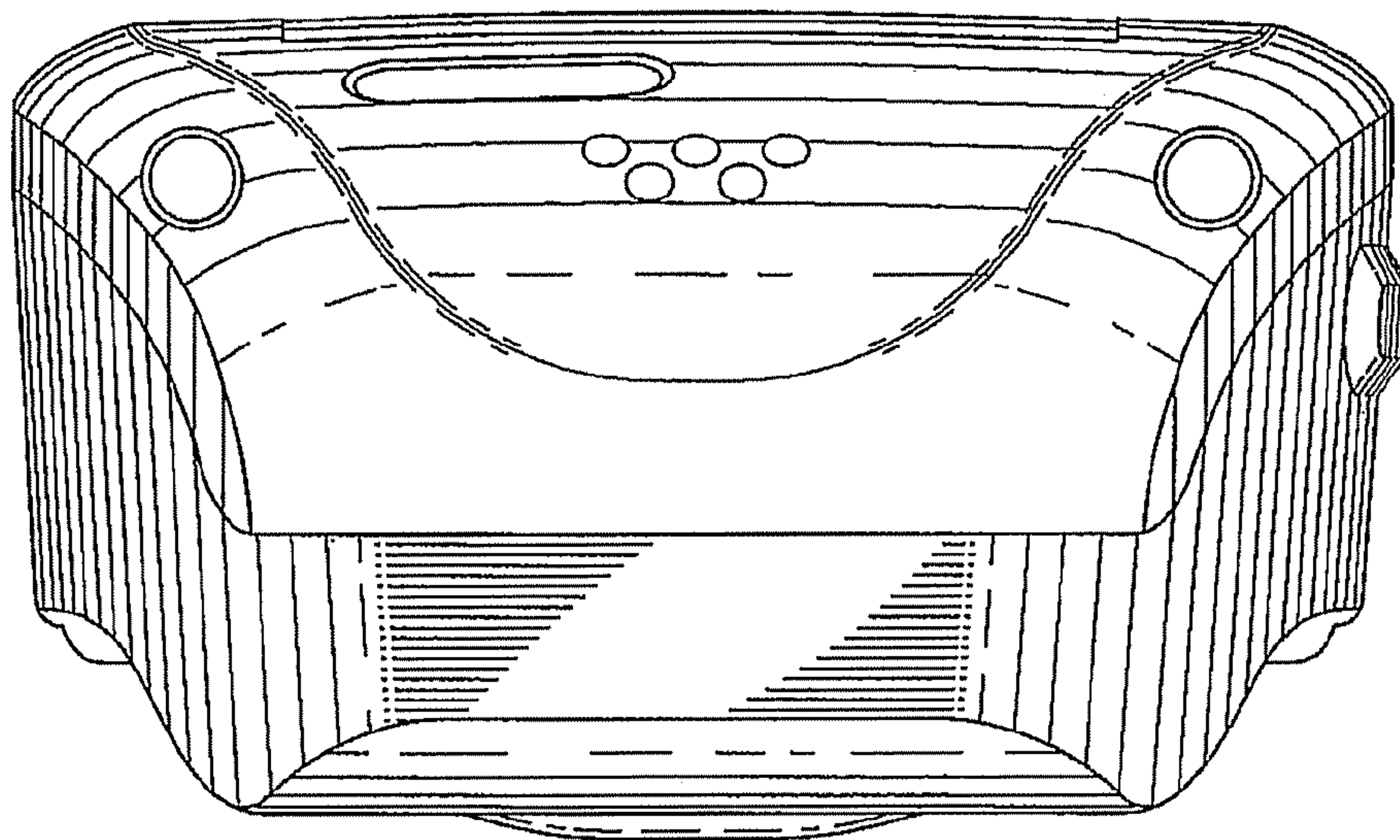

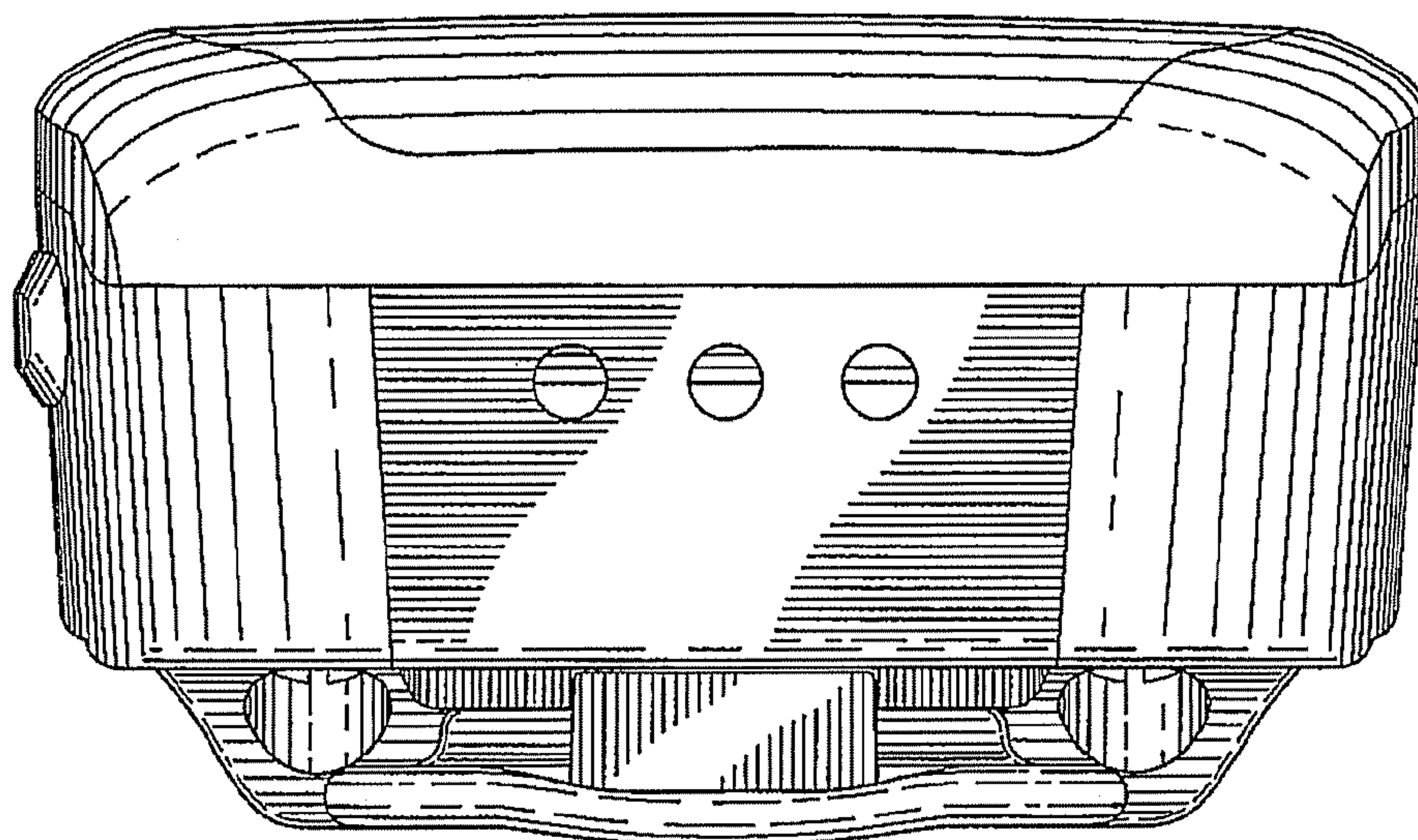

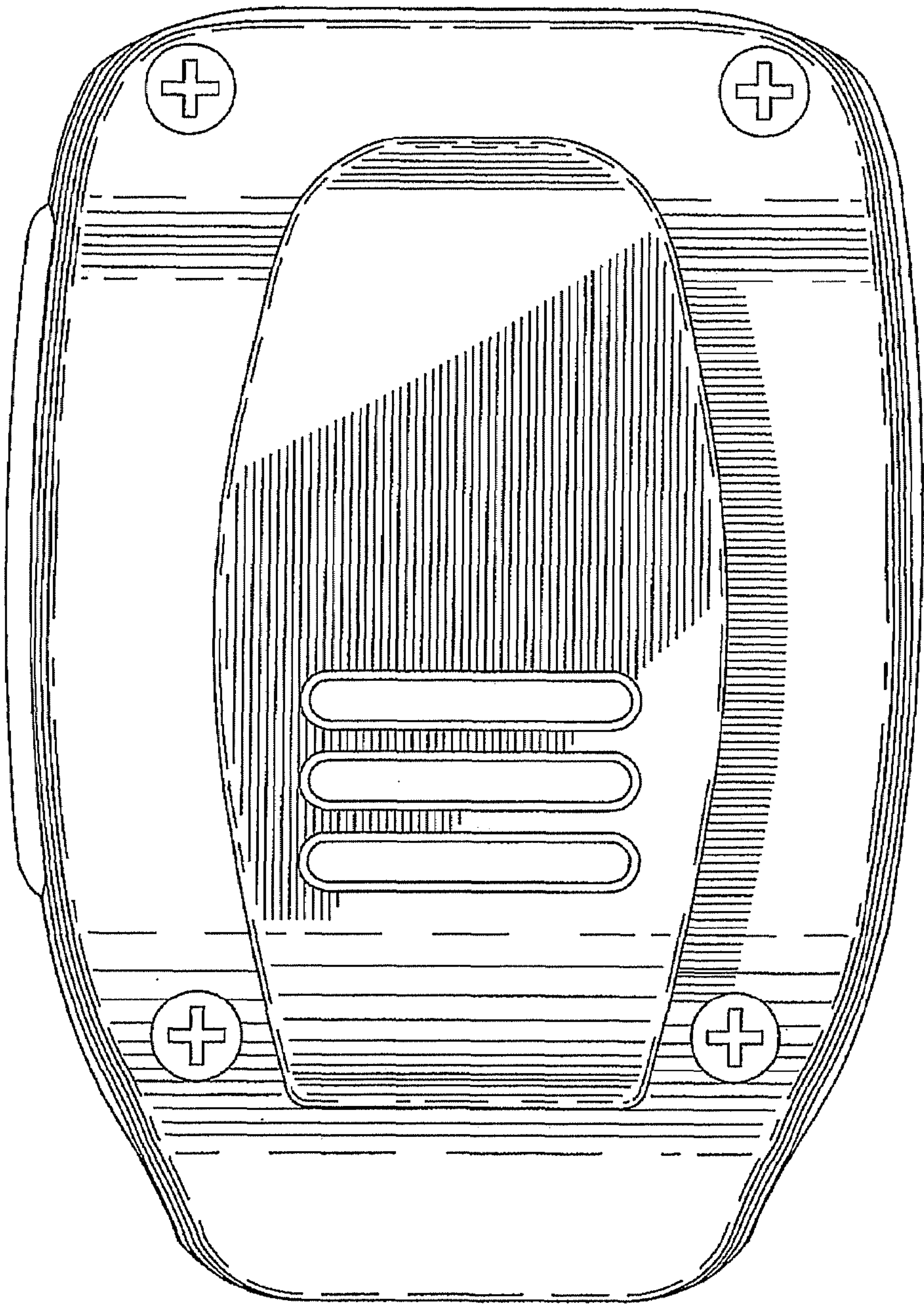
