FIG. 2 is a side elevation of FIG. 1.

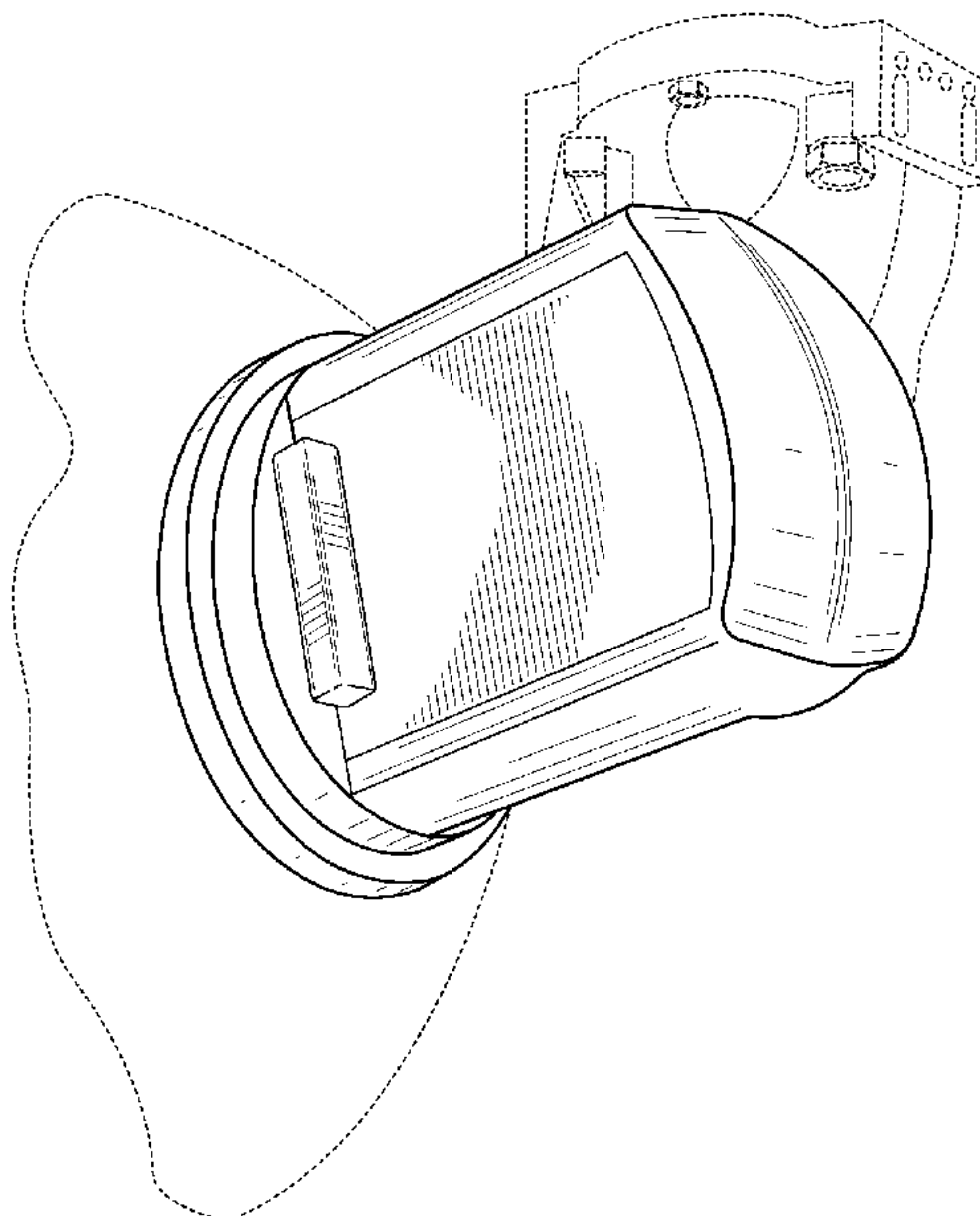
FIG. 3 is a top view of FIG. 1.

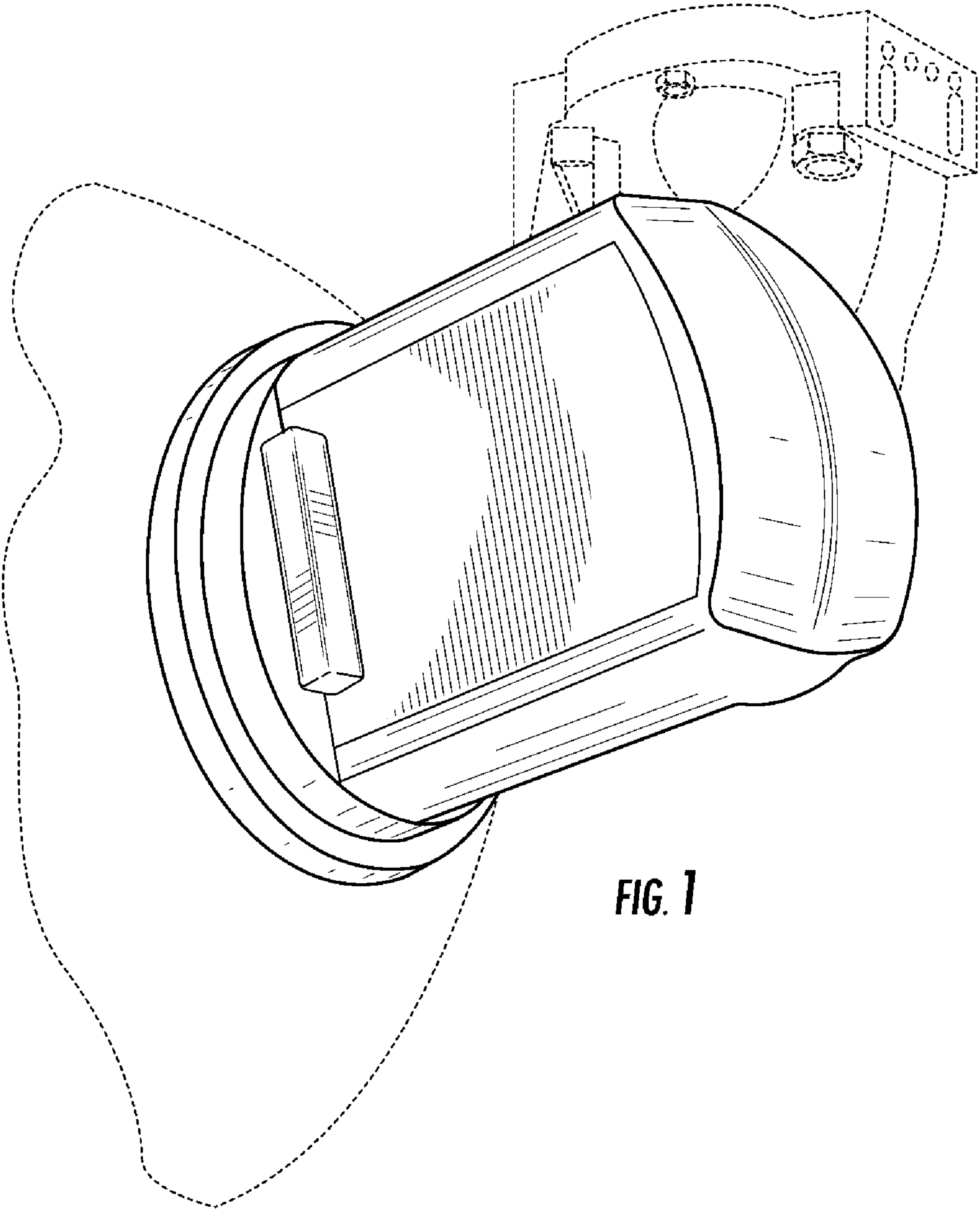
FIG. 4 is a plan view of the opposite side from that of FIG. 2; and,

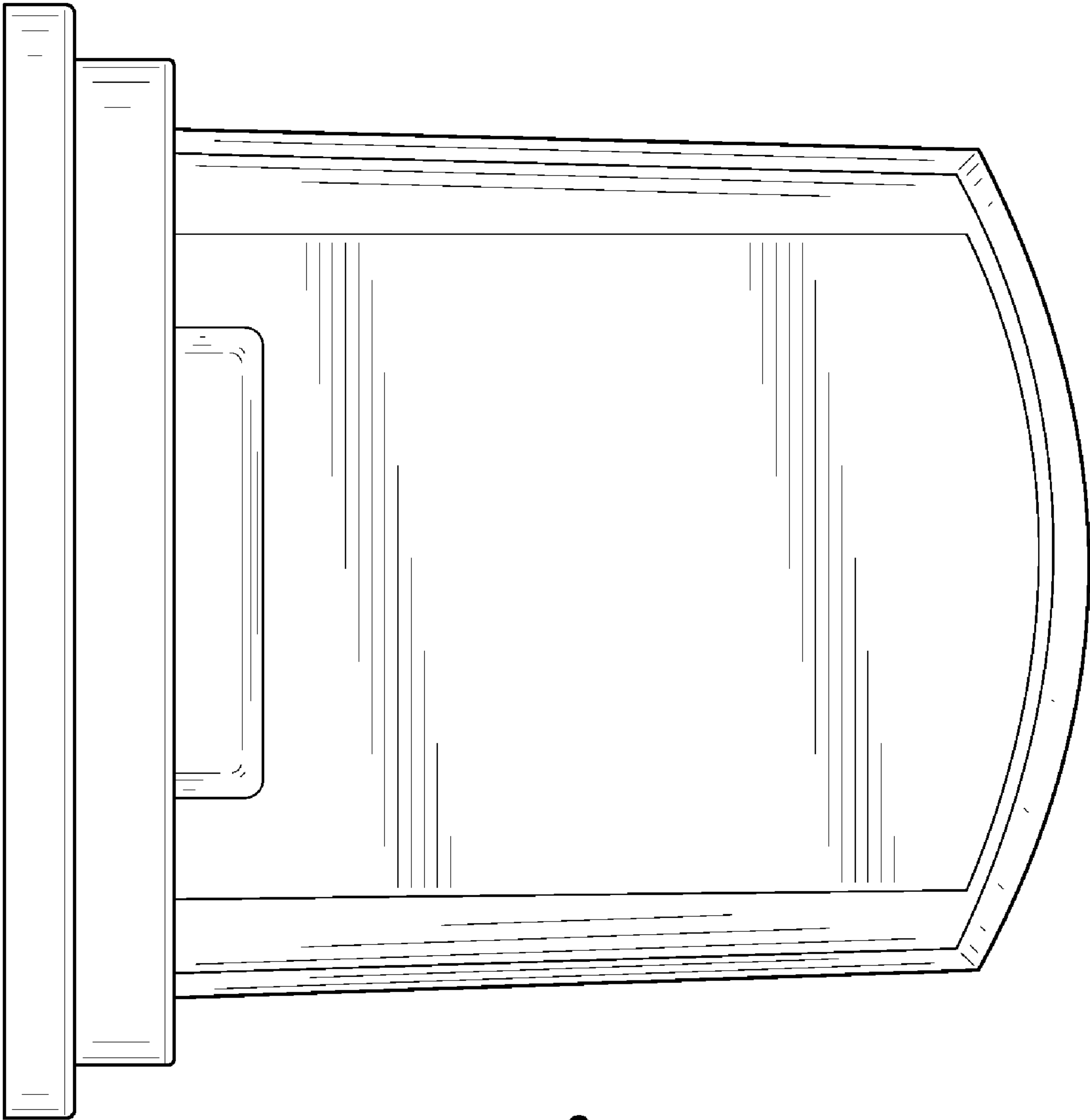

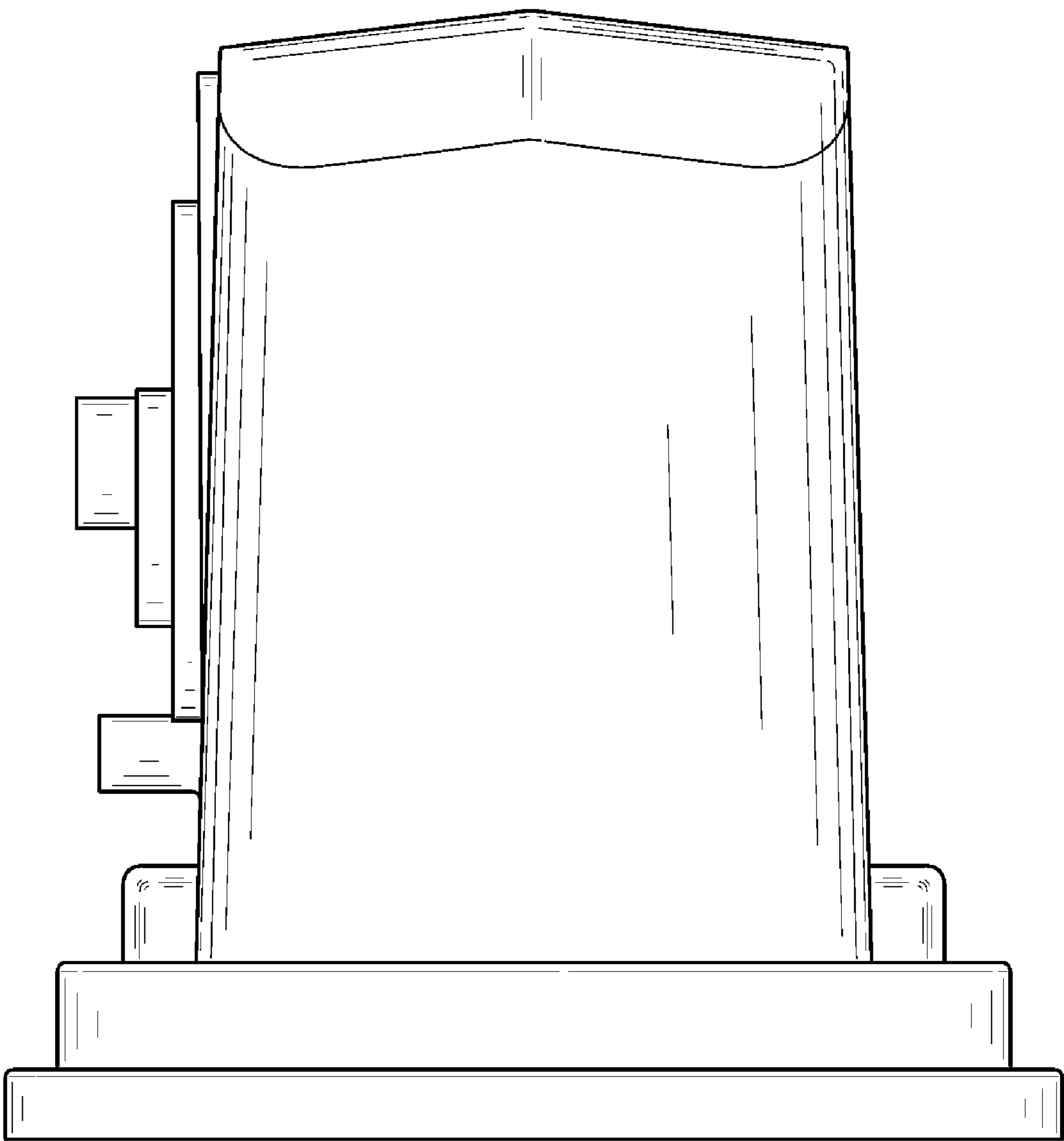

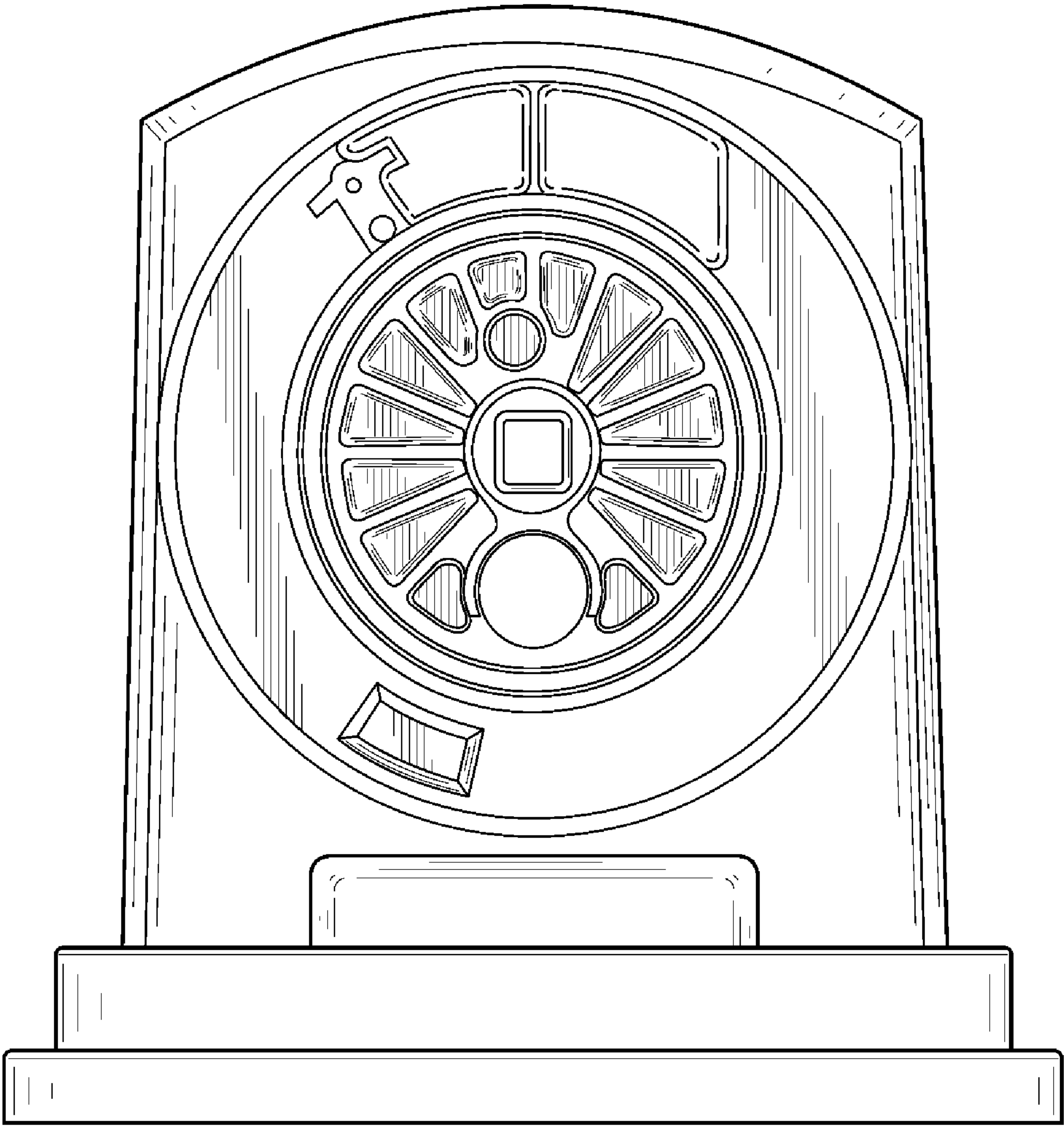

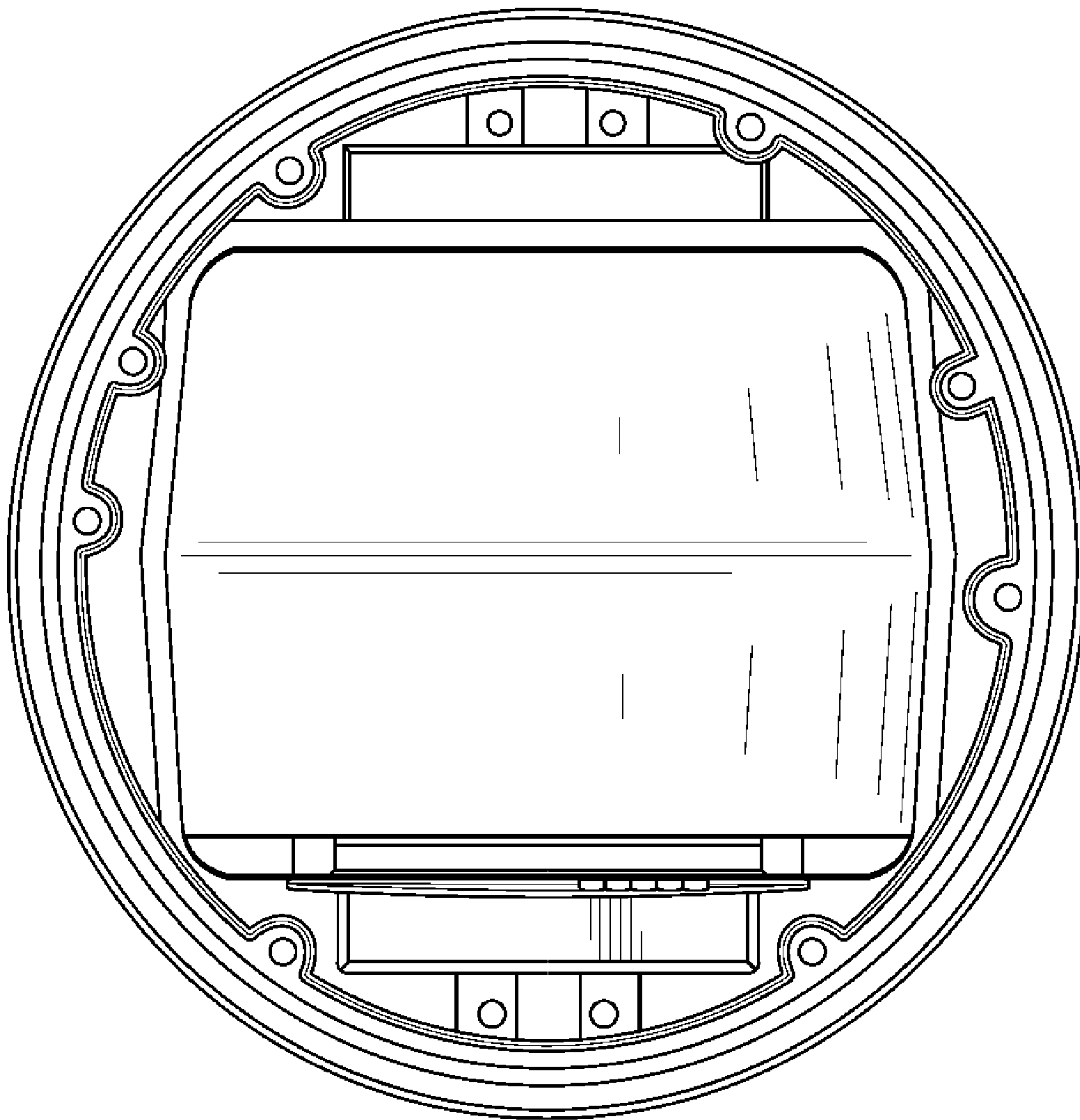
