FIG. 4 is a side elevation view thereof;

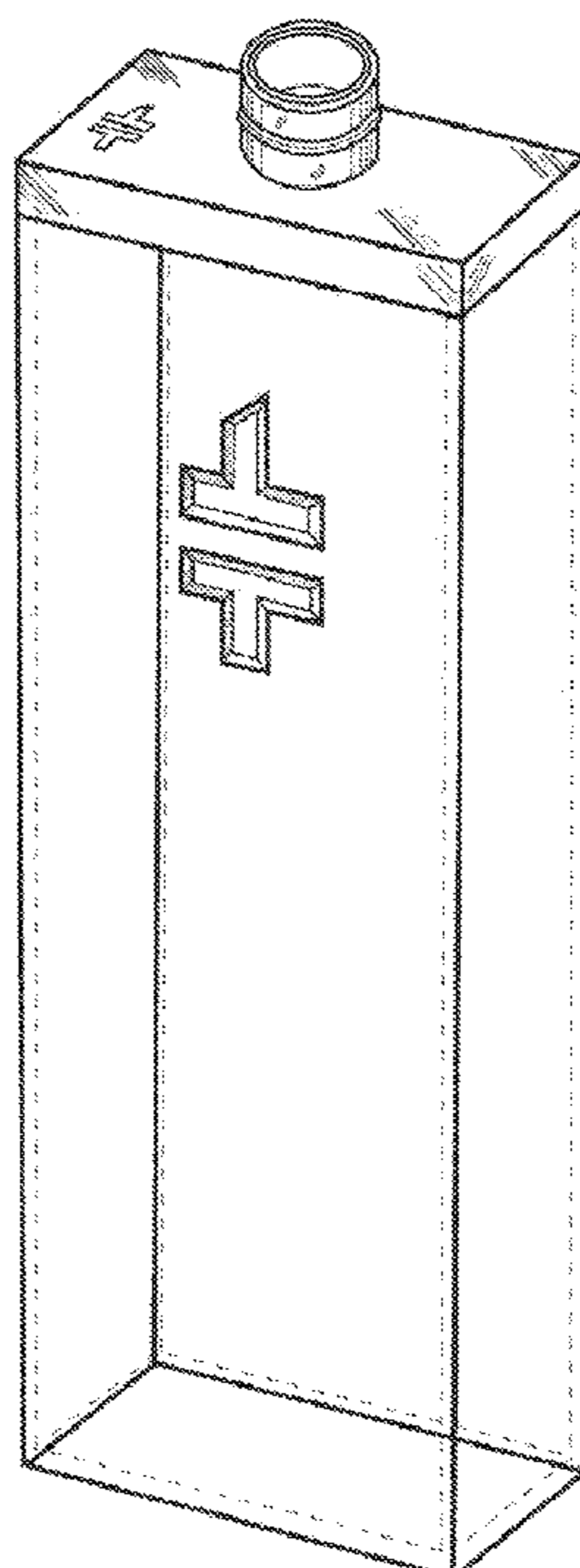
FIG. 5 is an opposite side elevation view of FIG. 4 thereof;

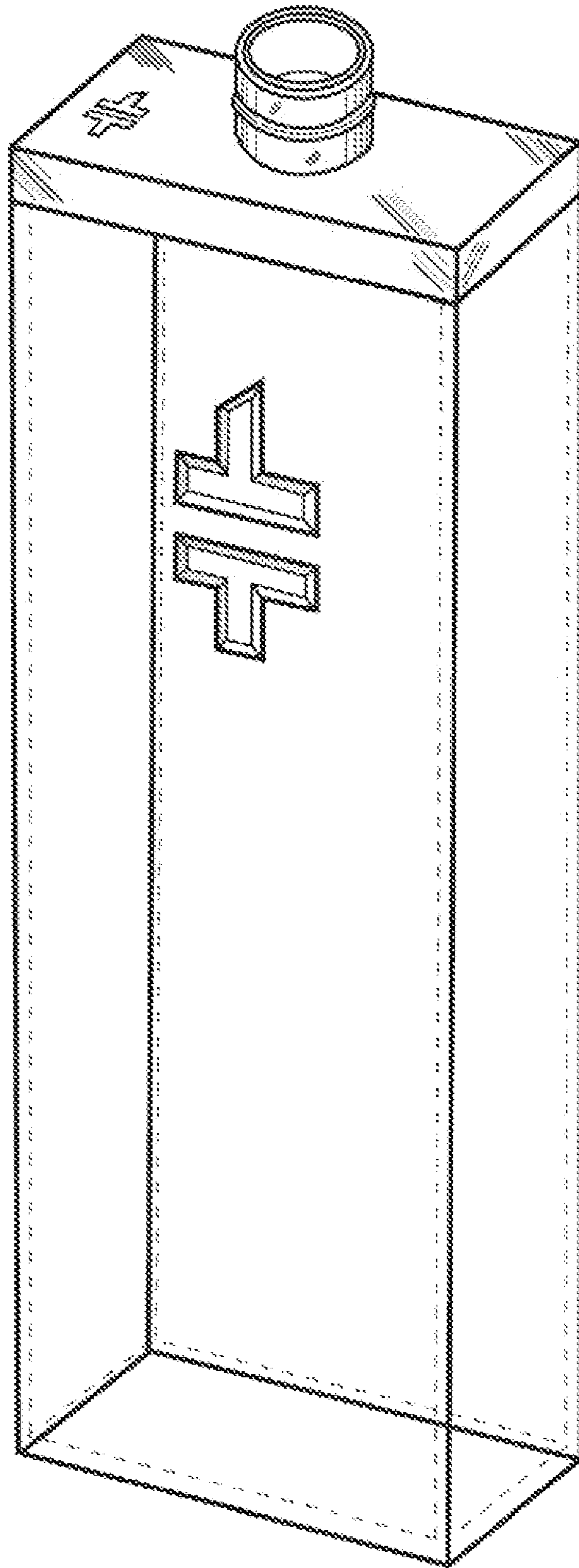

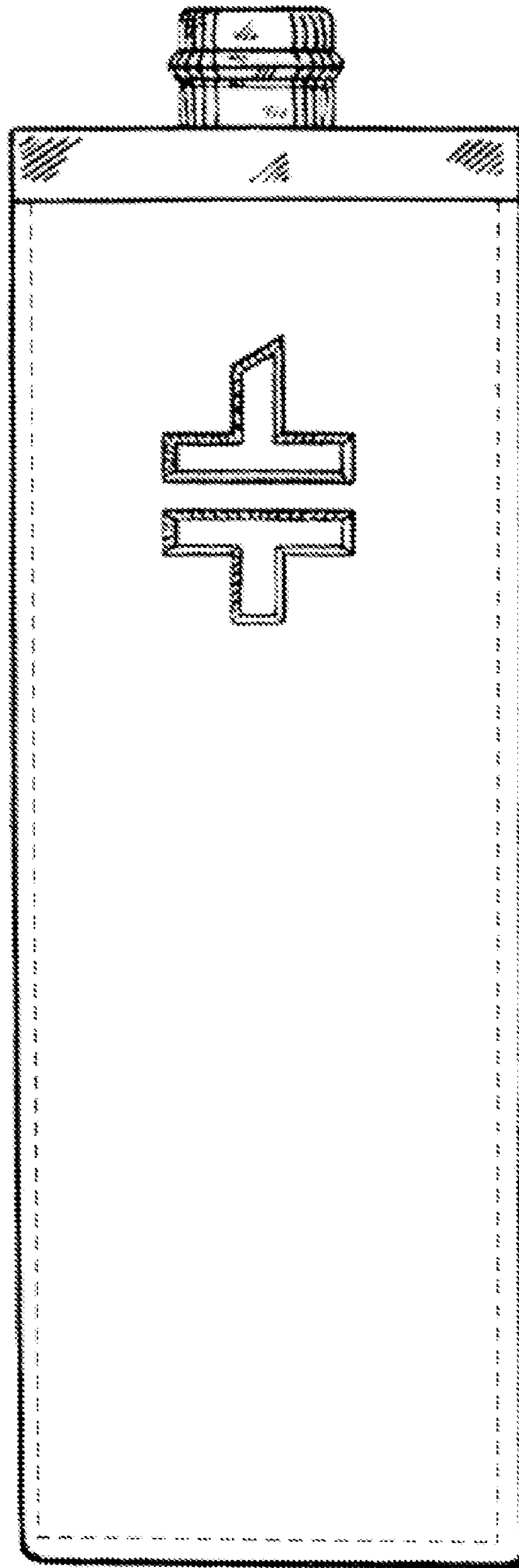

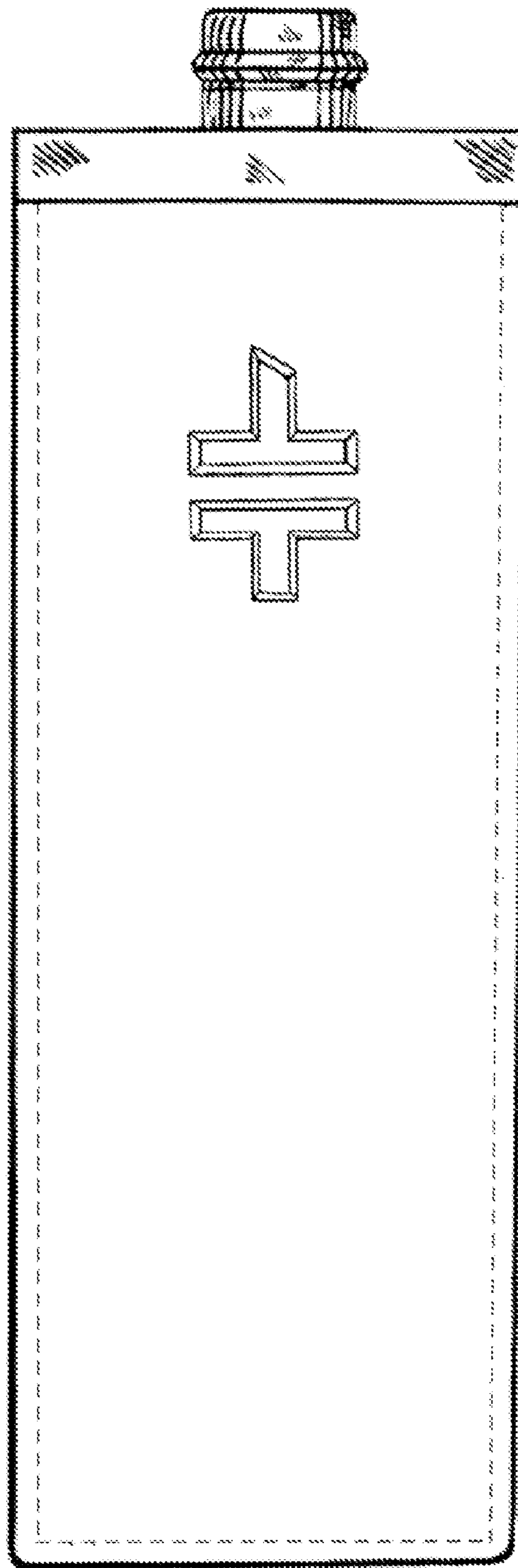

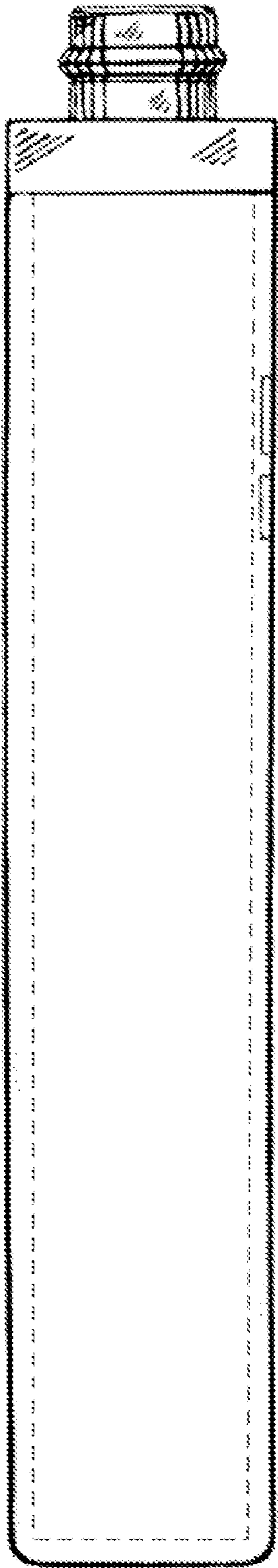

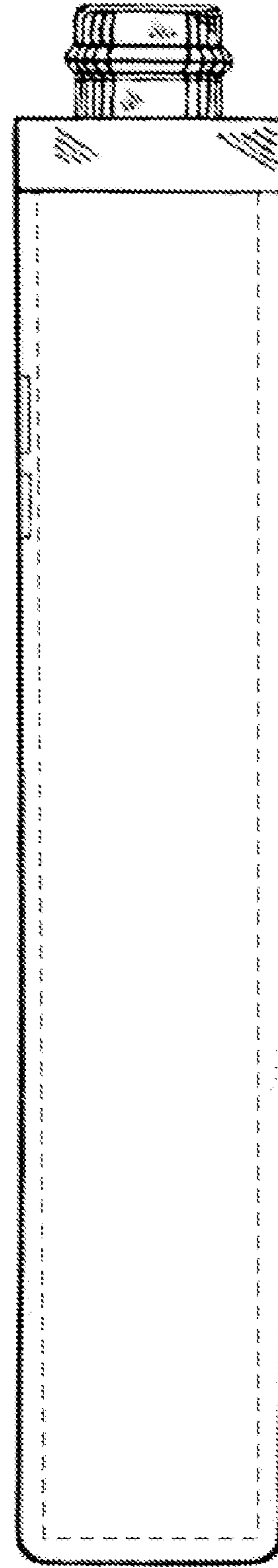

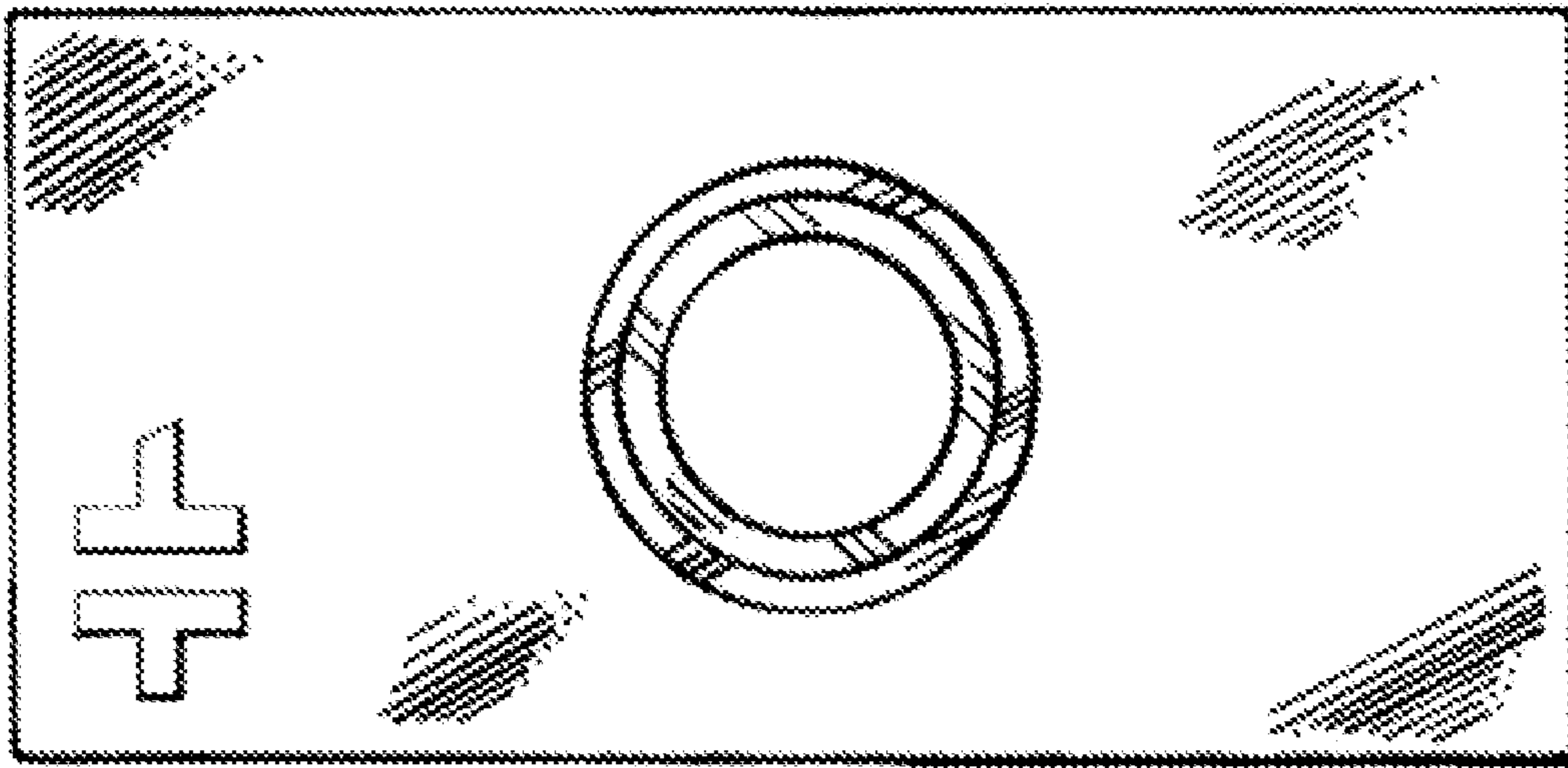

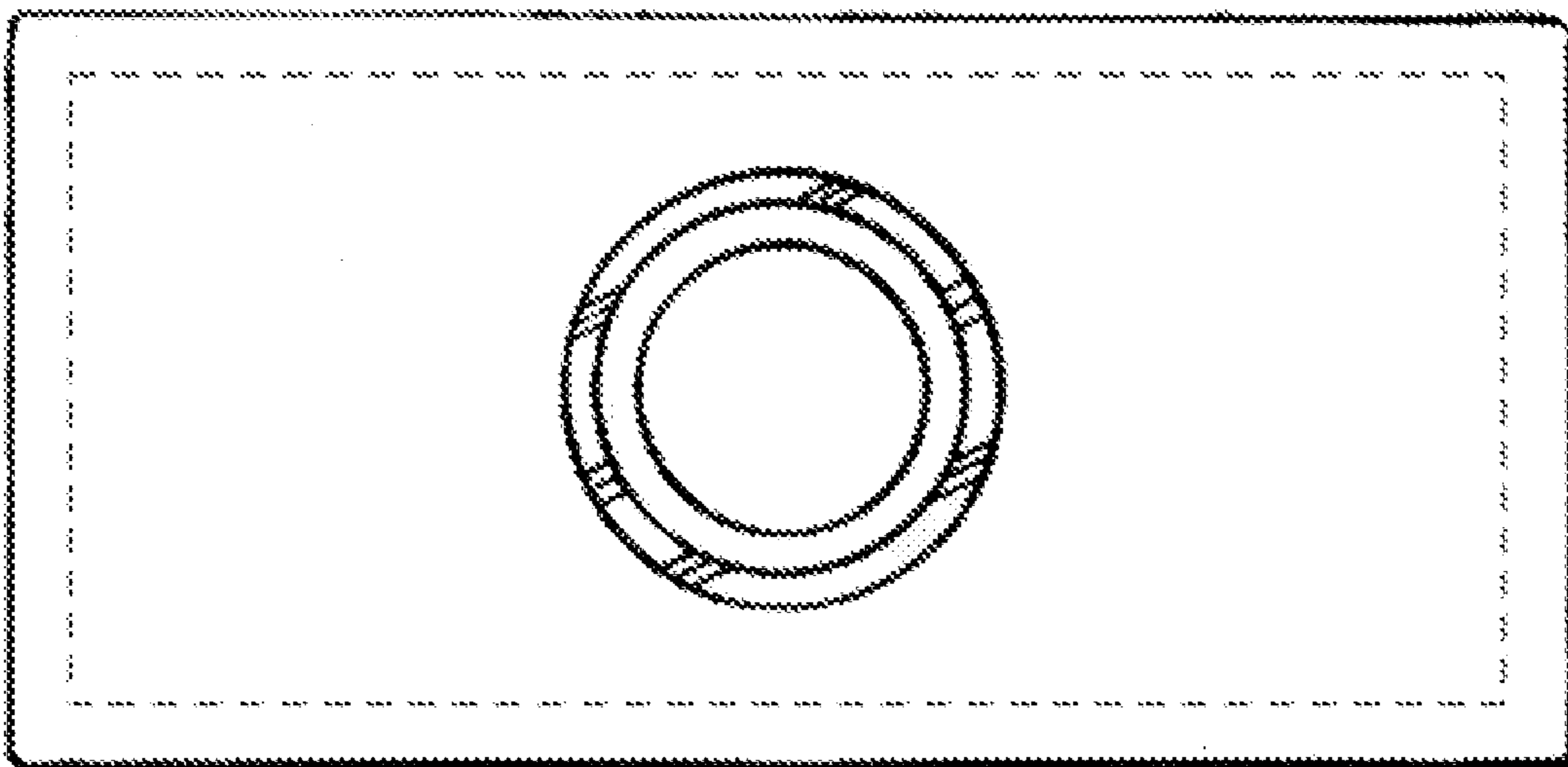
