(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a piece of jewelry, as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of a plurality of pieces of jewelry having
block letters, shown in phantom, with stones, shown in phan-
tom, fixedly secured to the bottom thereof, with the pieces of
jewelry strung together with a necklace chain, shown in phan-
tom;

FIG. 2 is a front view of one embodiment of the piece of
jewelry;

FIG. 3 is a back view of the piece of jewelry shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a side view of the piece of jewelry shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a top view of the piece of jewelry shown in FIG. 2;
and,

FIG. 6 is bottom view of the piece of jewelry shown in FIG. 2.

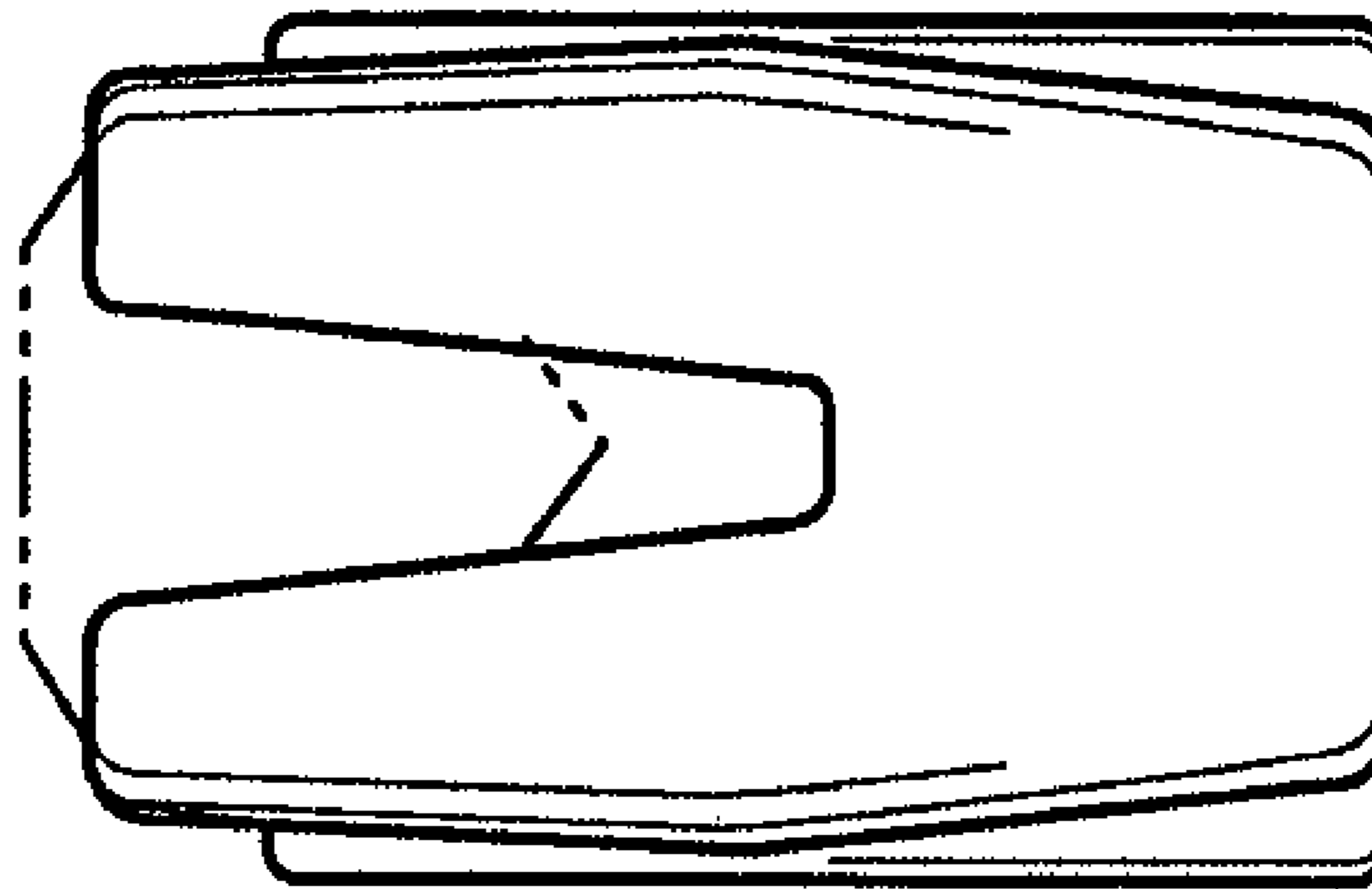

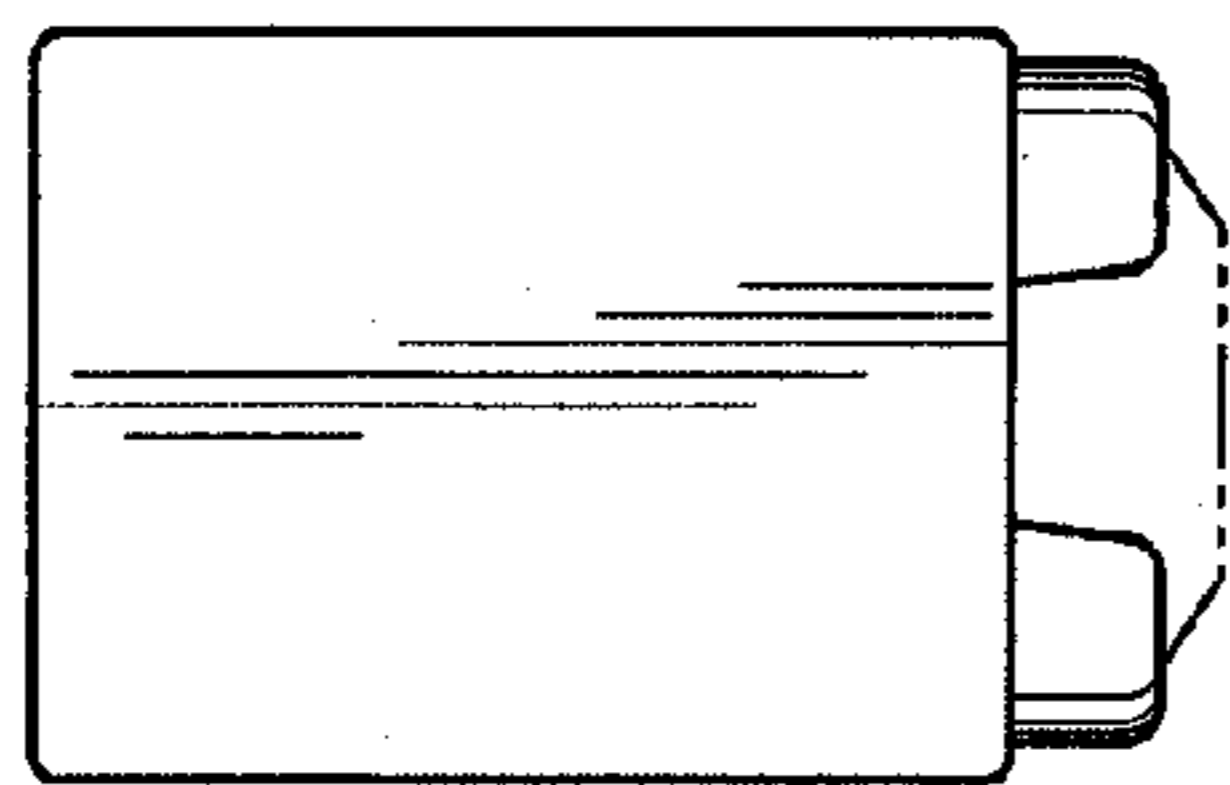
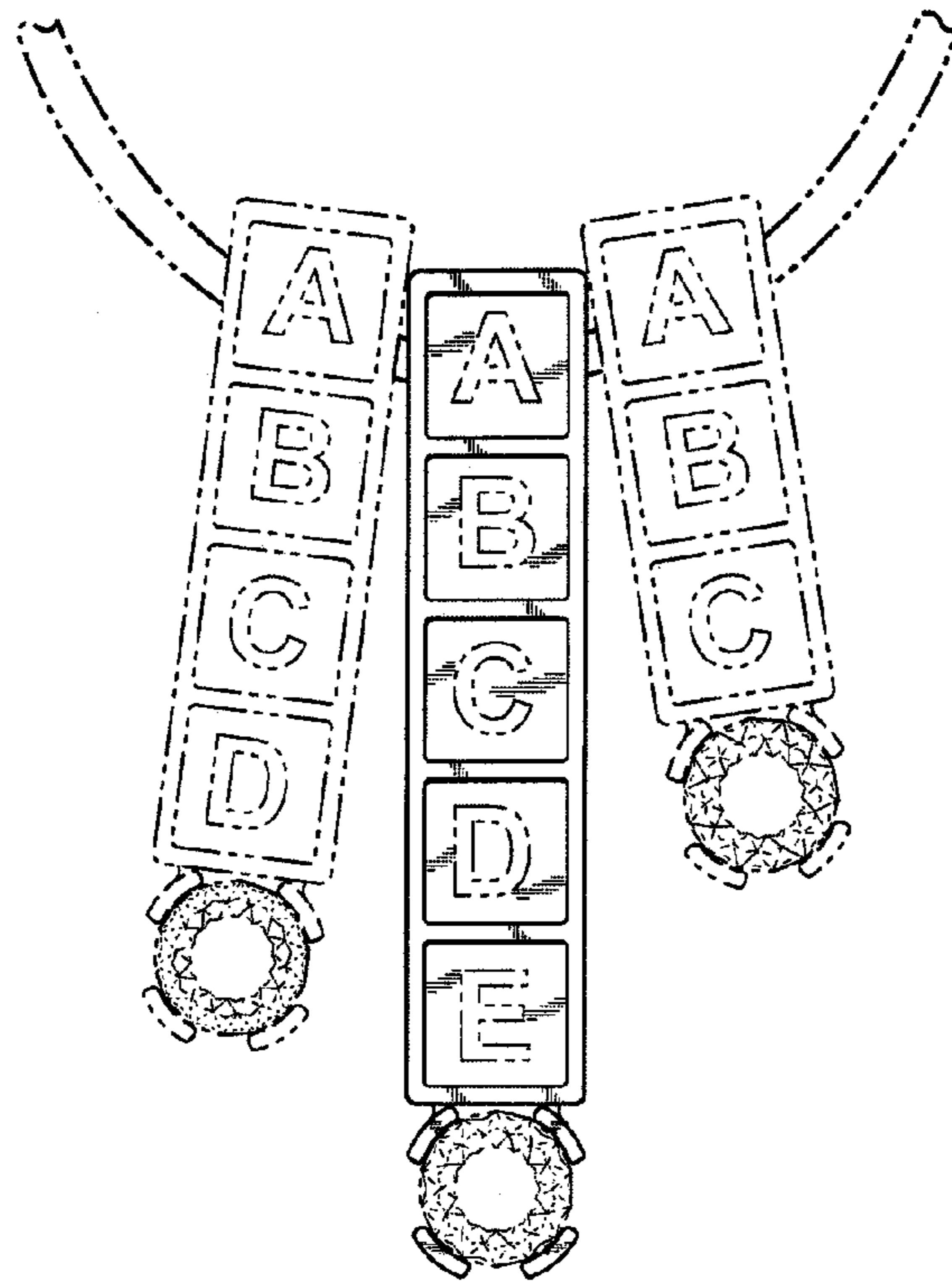

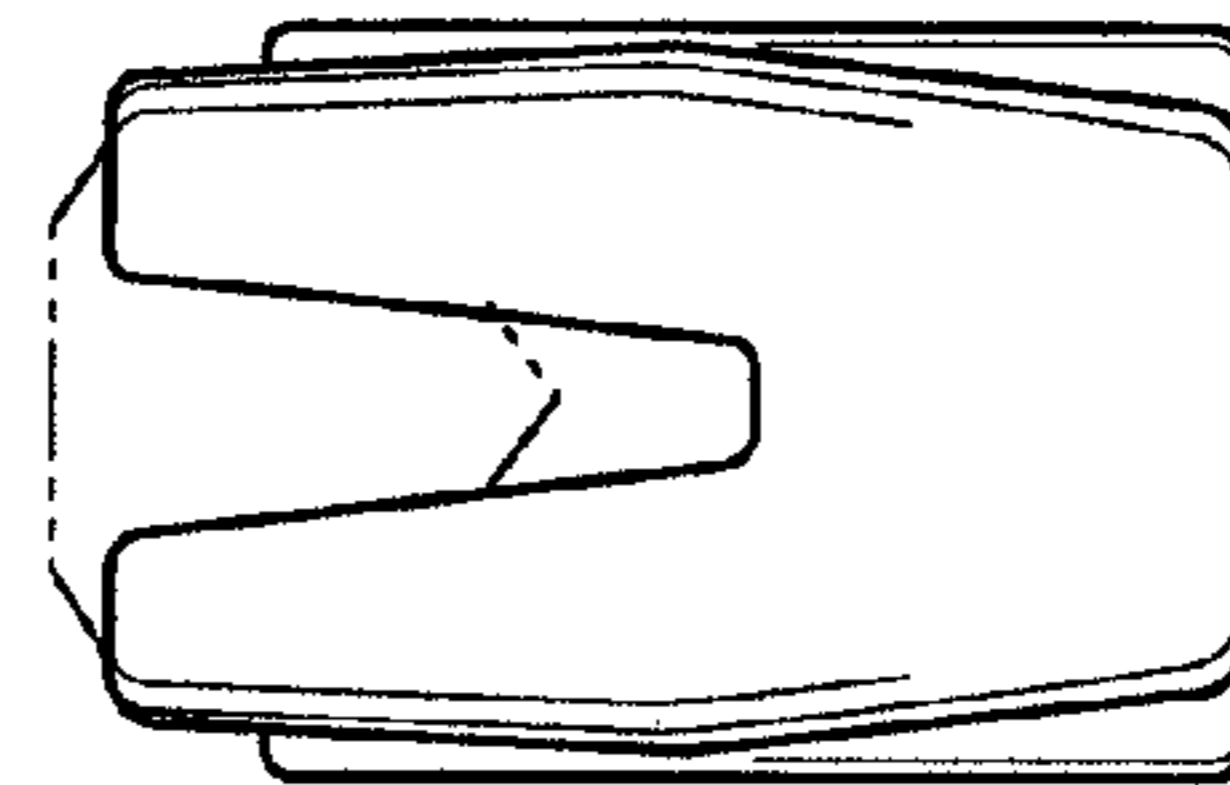

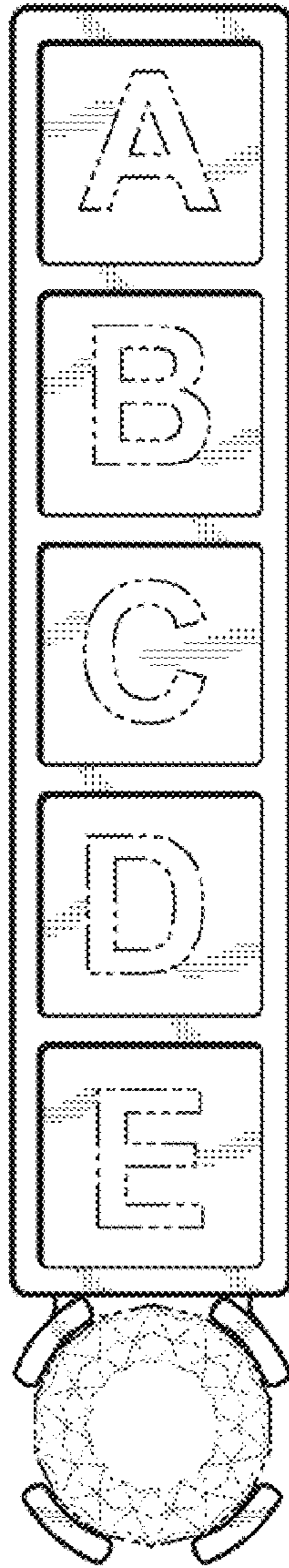

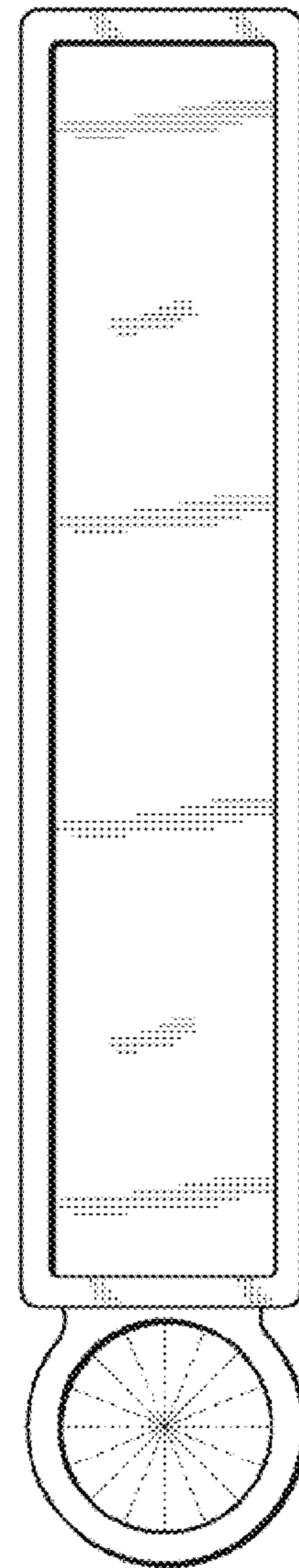

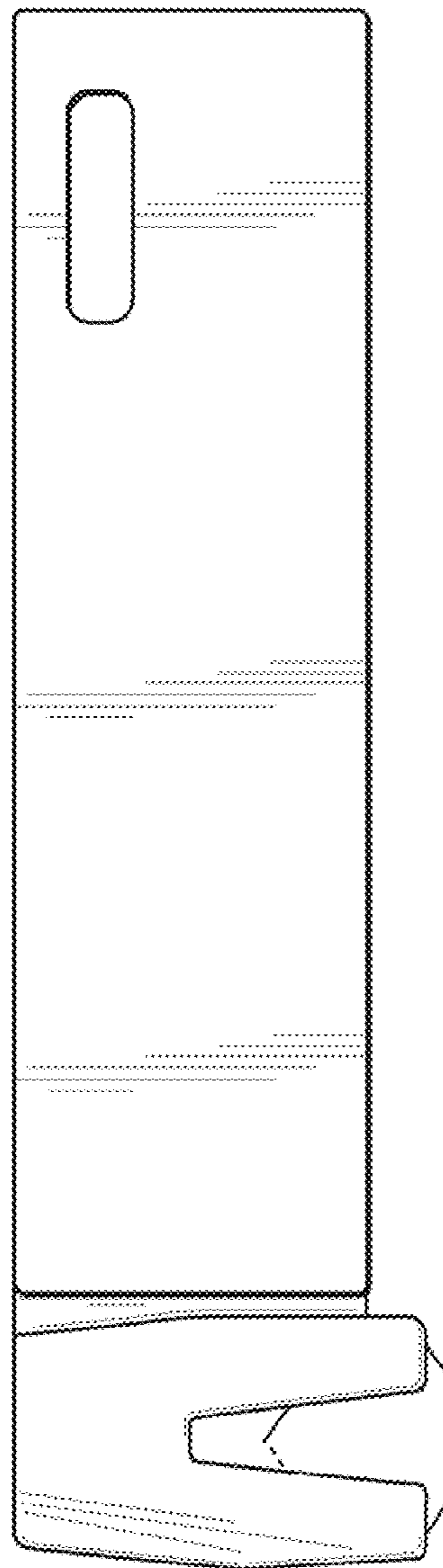
