The ornamental design for a pole mountable shower shelf with hexagonal opening and face cloth bar, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pole mountable shower shelf with hexagonal opening and face cloth bar in accordance with my design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the pole mountable shower shelf with hexagonal opening and face cloth bar of FIG. 1;

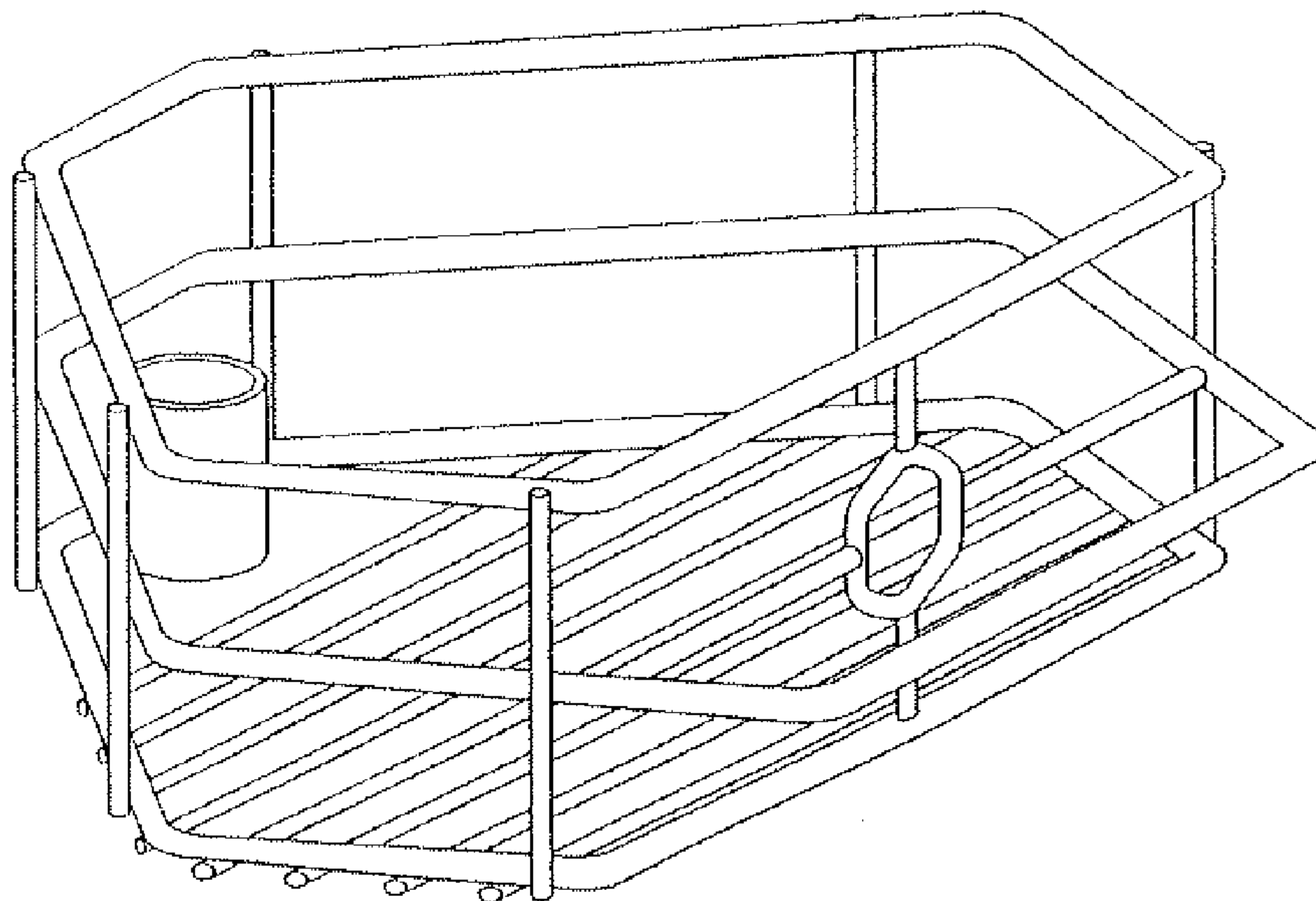
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of shelf shown in FIGS. 1 and 2;

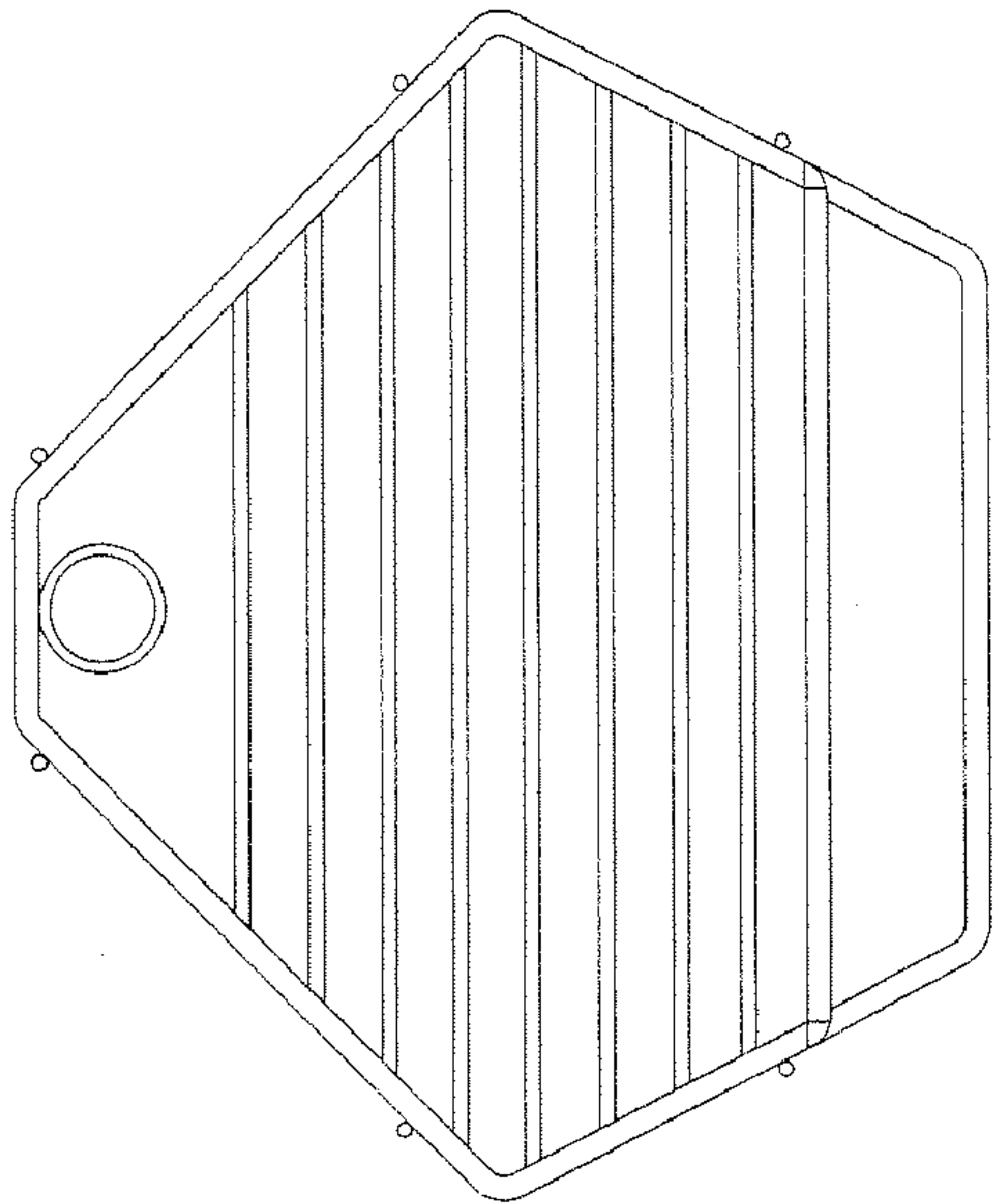

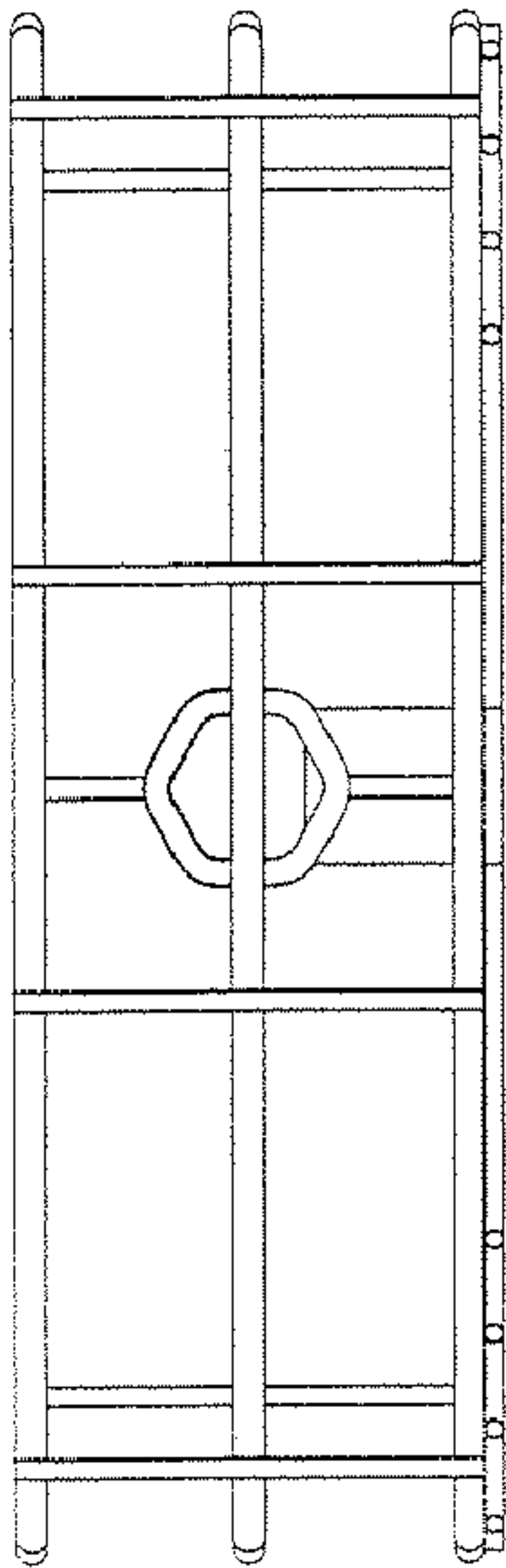

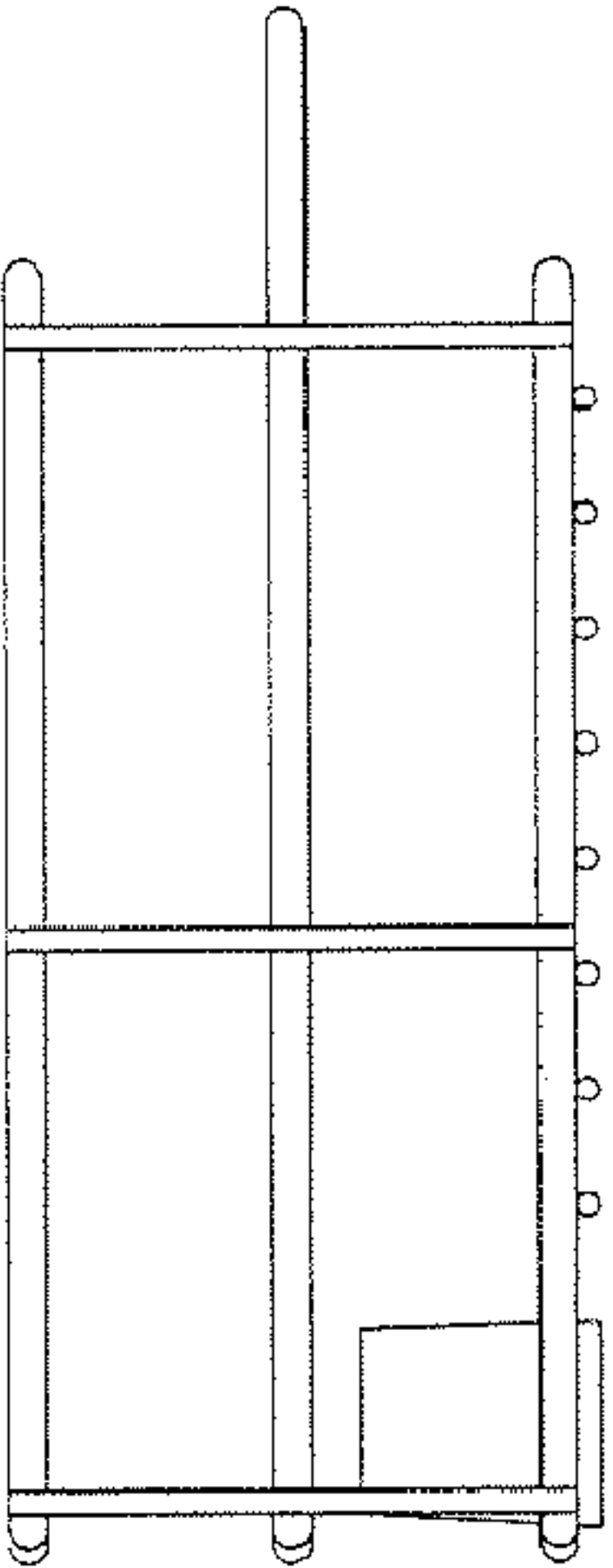

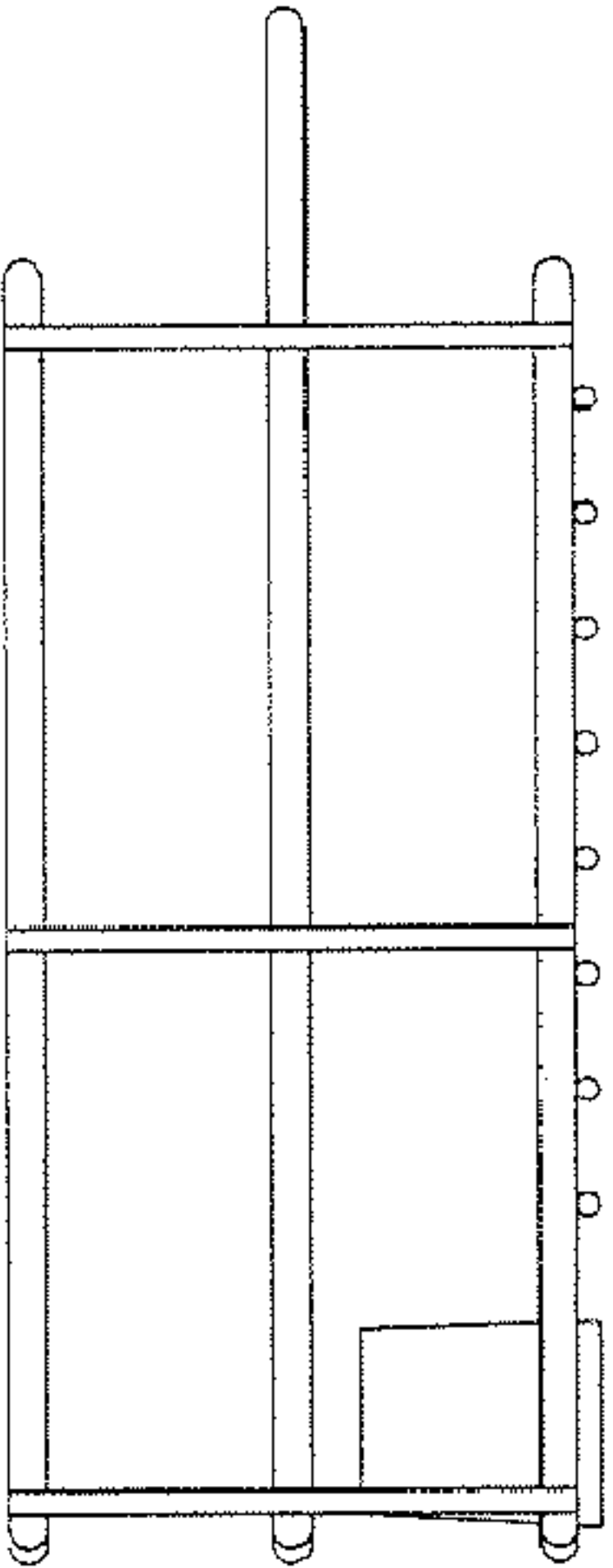

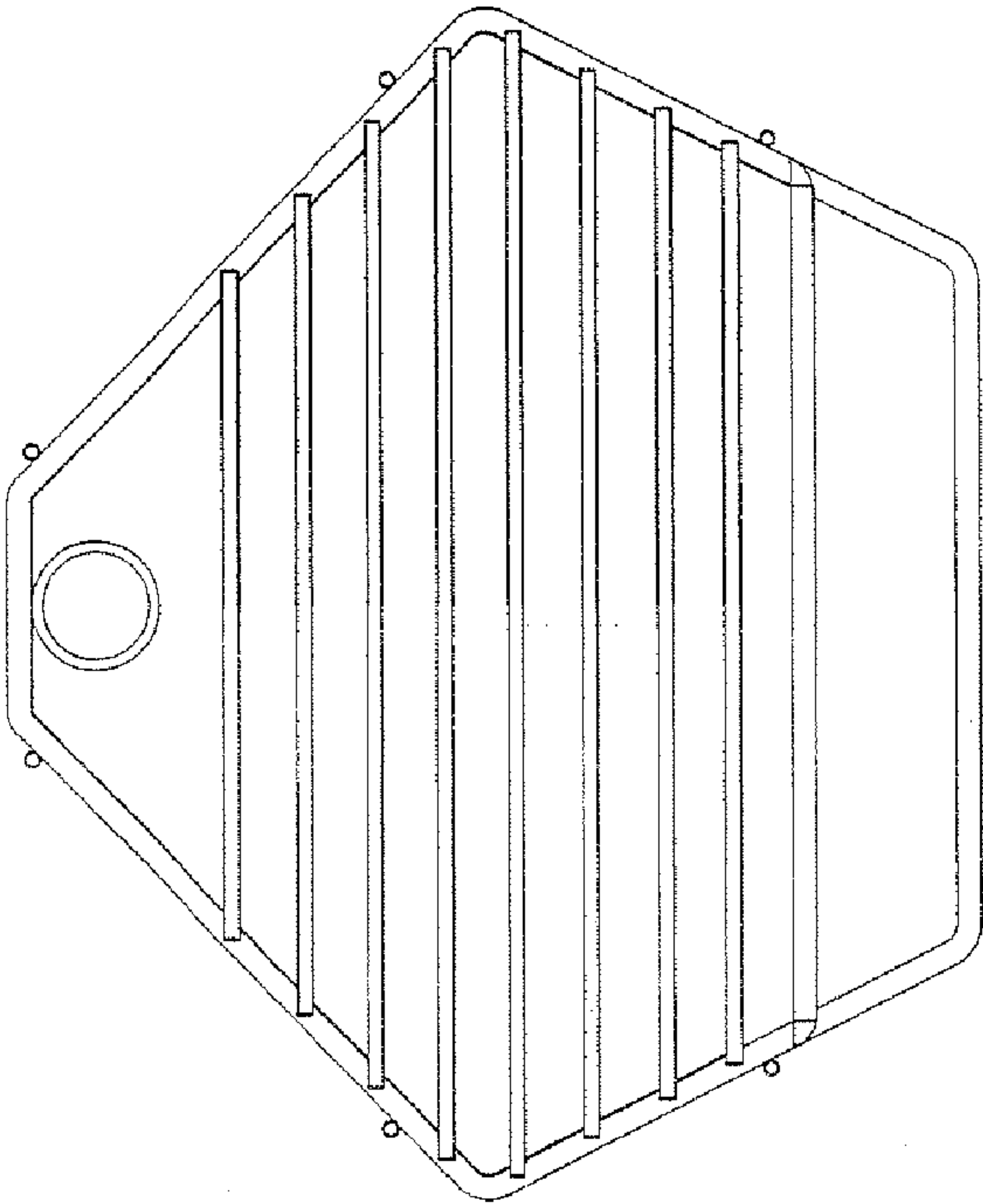

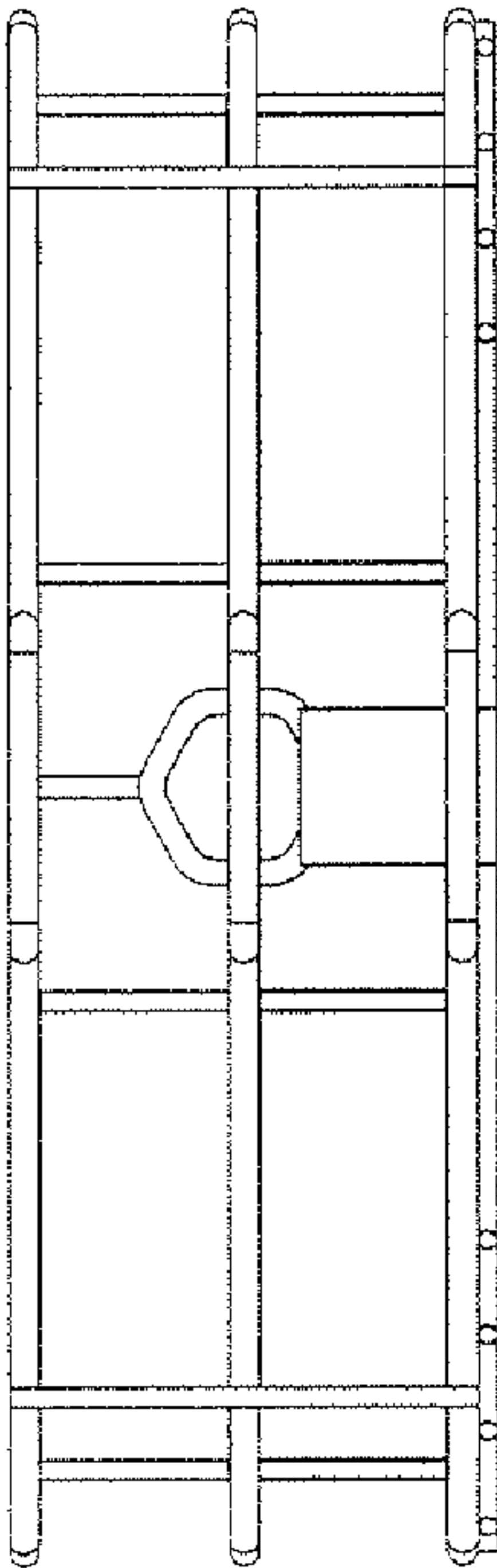
