(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a tuxedo shirt and accessories arranged in a box, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top, front, side perspective view of a tuxedo shirt and accessories arranged in a box, showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;

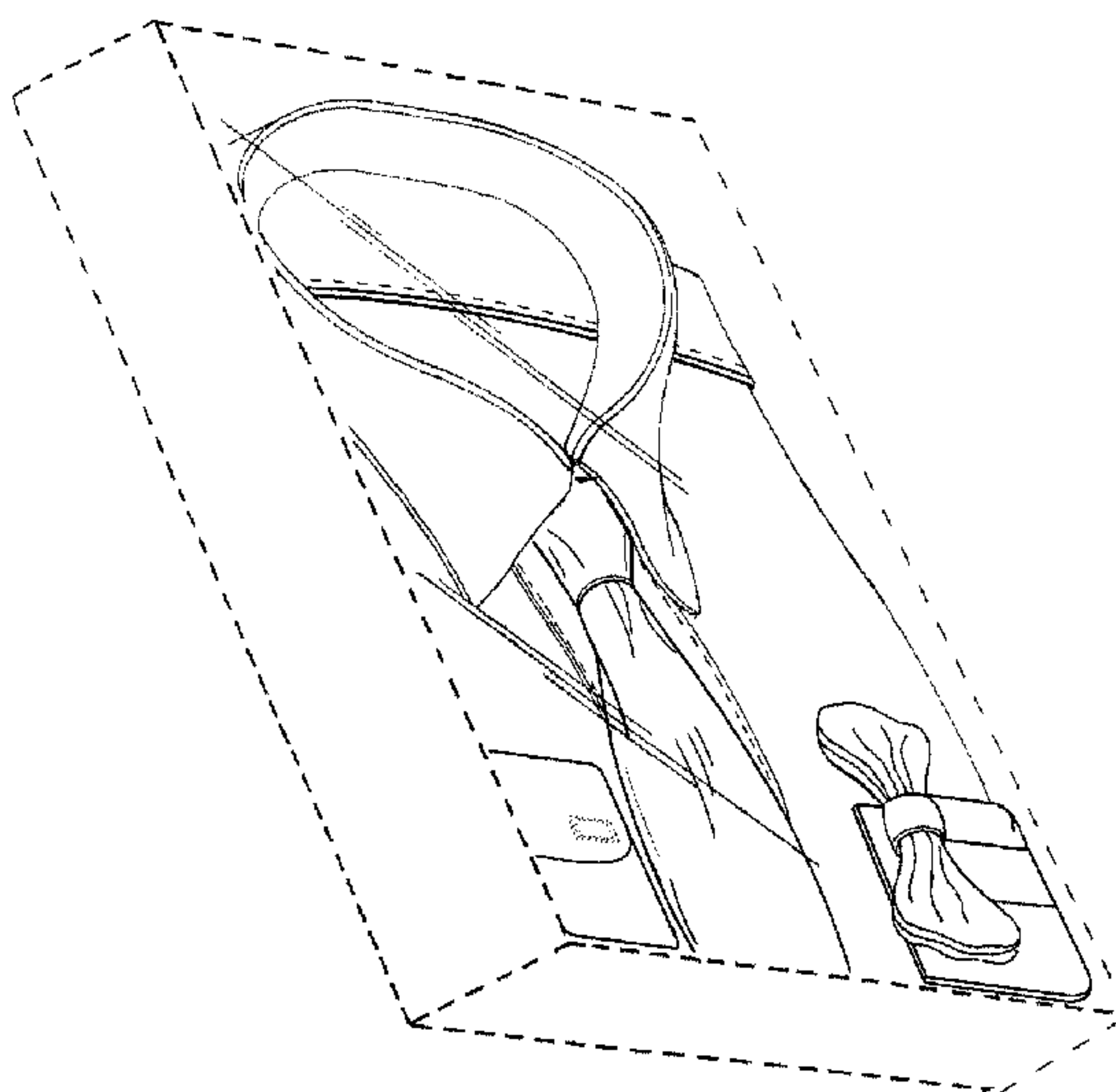
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

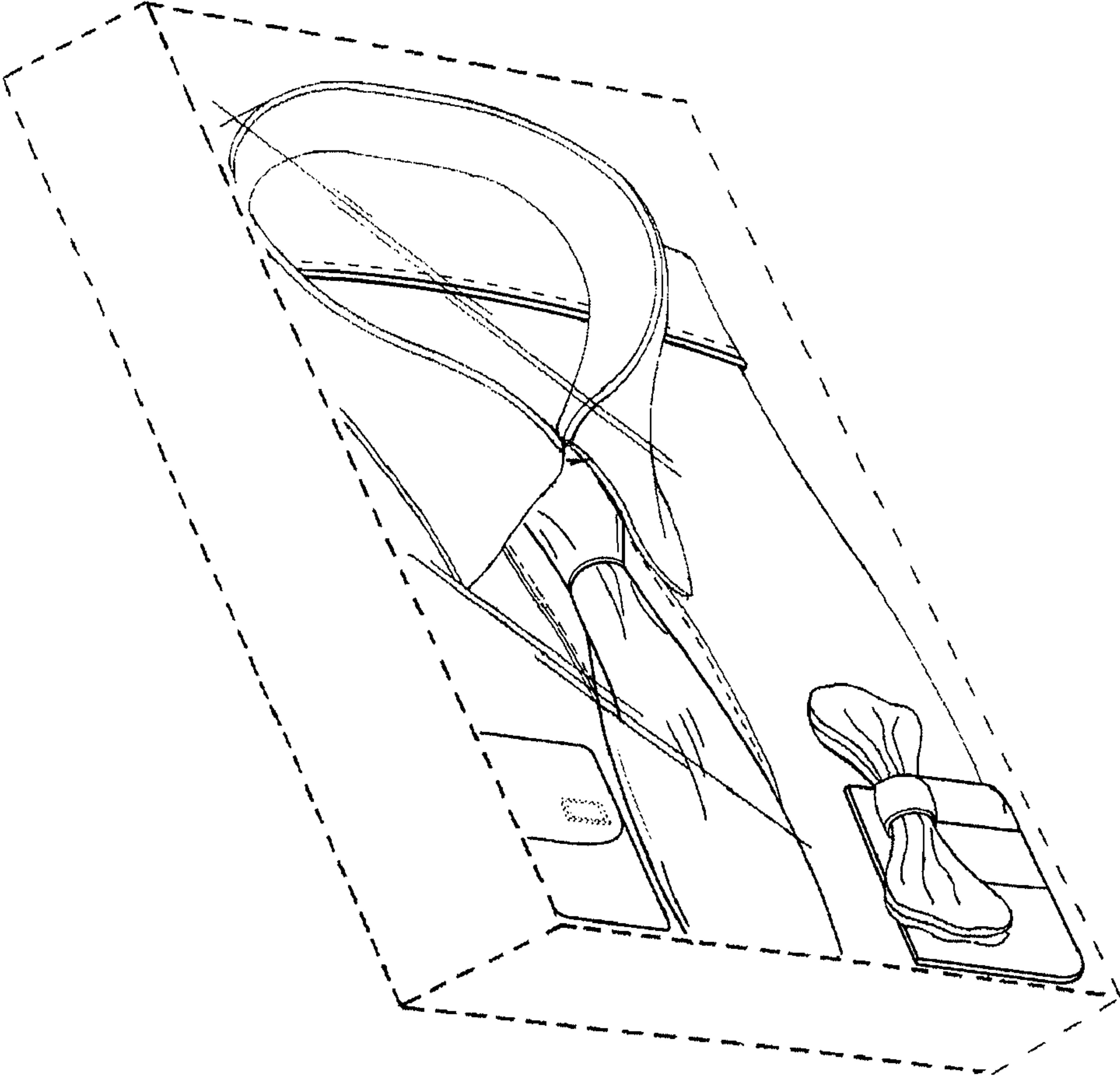
The broken lines in FIGS. 1-5 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

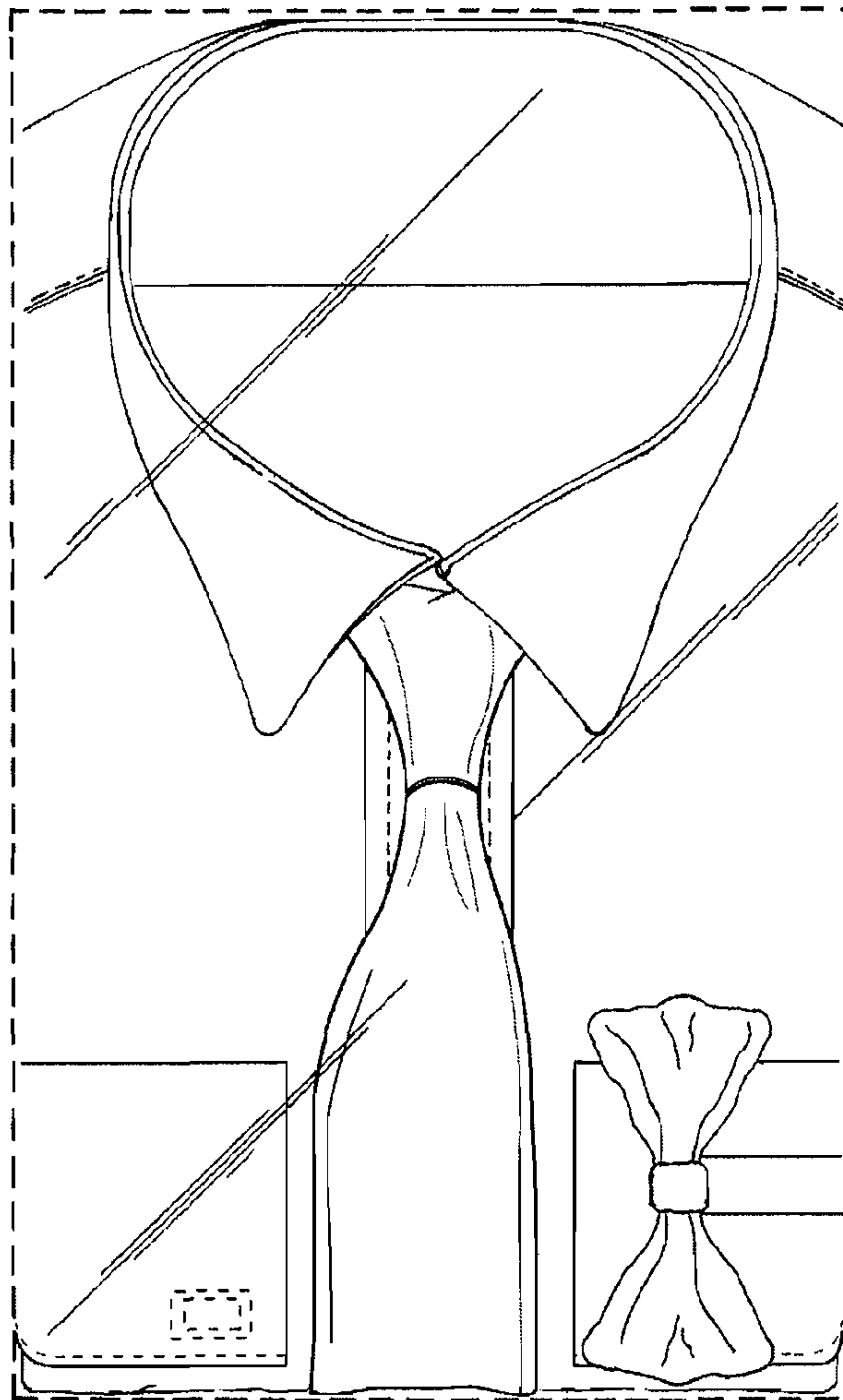
