(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a hitch cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a hitch cover showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view with the left side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.

The broken line showing of the human face in FIGS. 1, 2, and 4–6 represent environmental structure and forms no part of the claimed design. The broken line showing of the hair in FIGS. 4 and 6 represents environmental structure and forms no part of the claimed design. The break lines in FIGS. 1 and 4–6 indicate indeterminate length.






