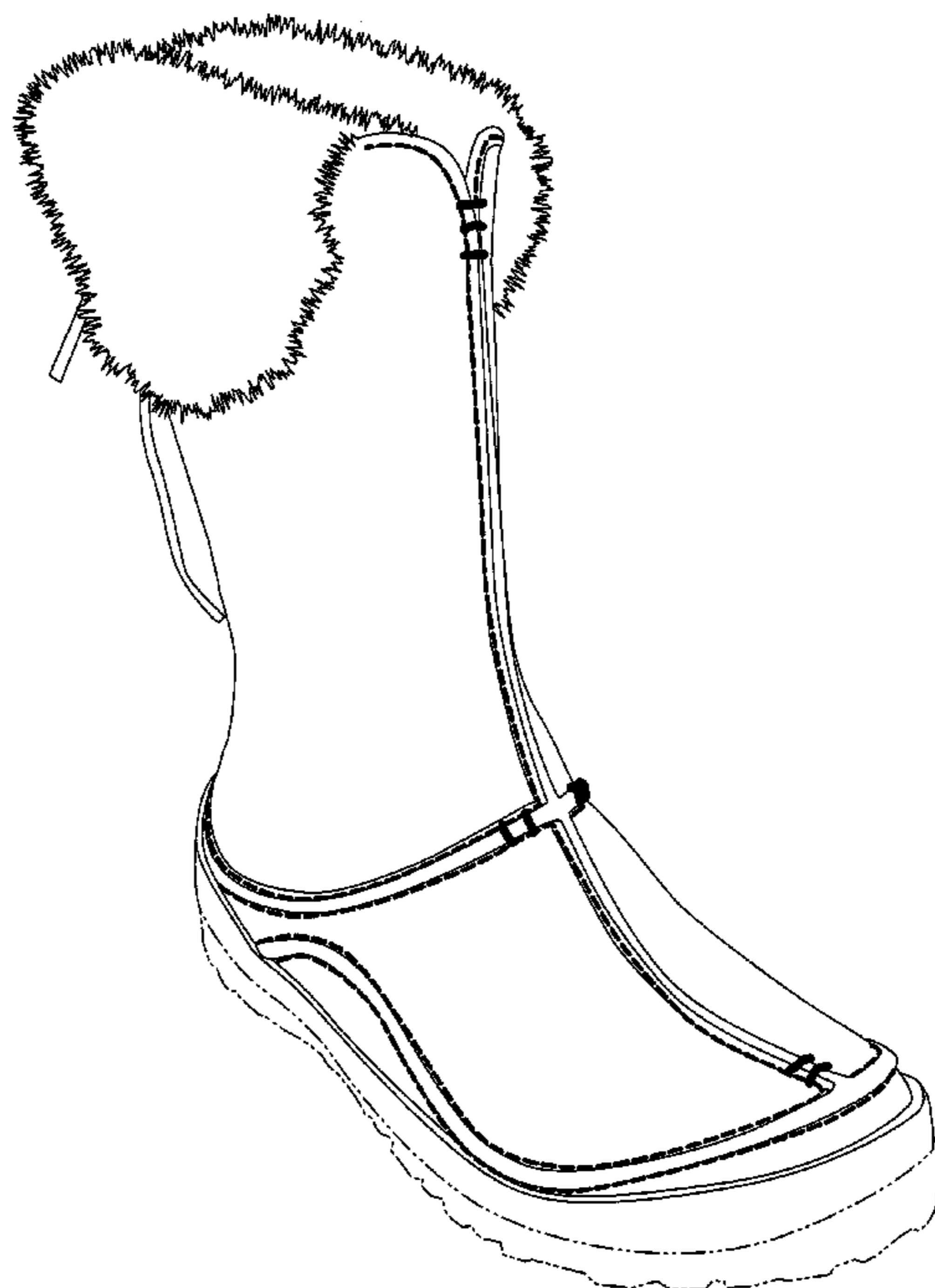
FIG. 4 is reduced left side view thereof;

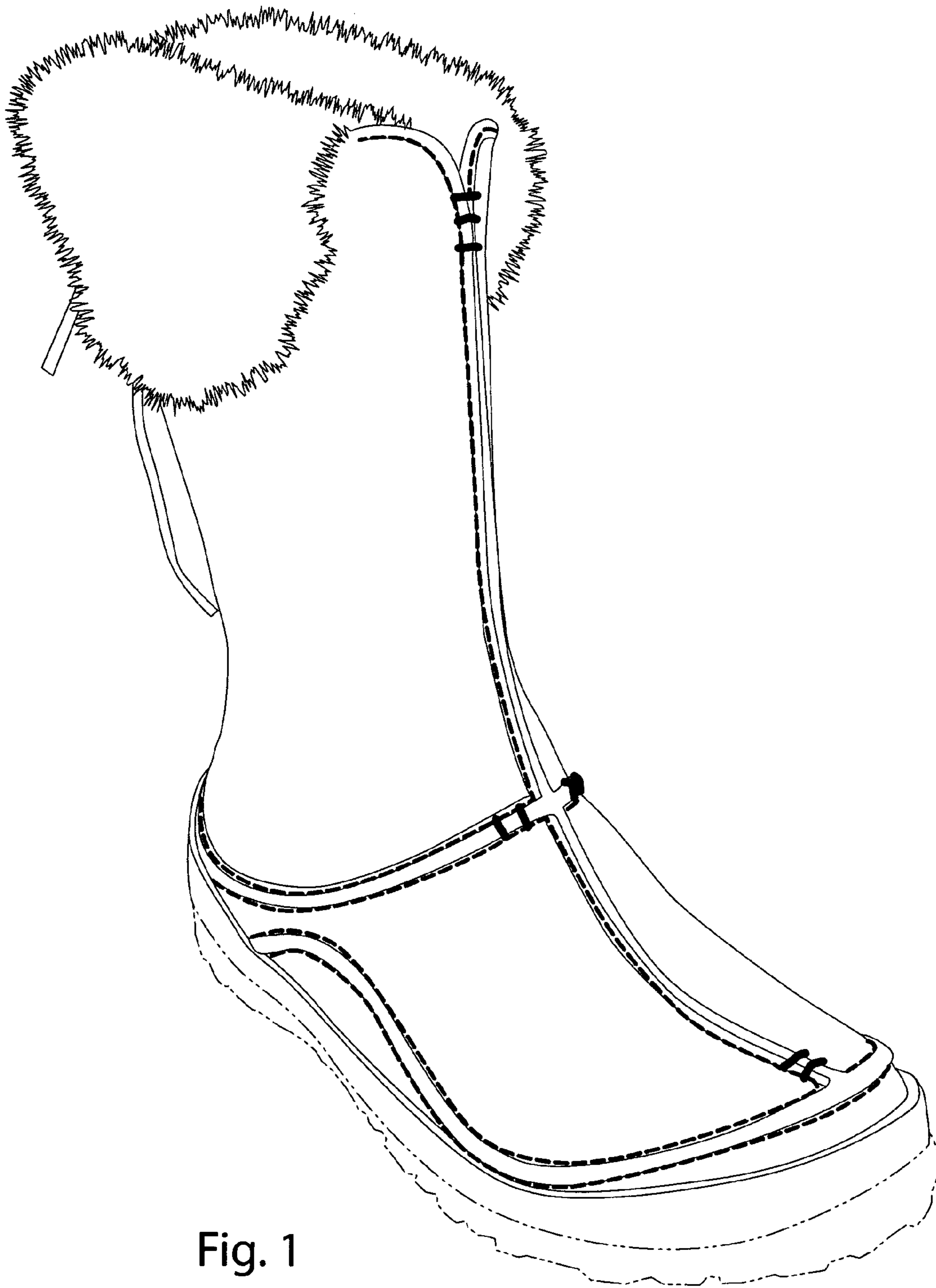

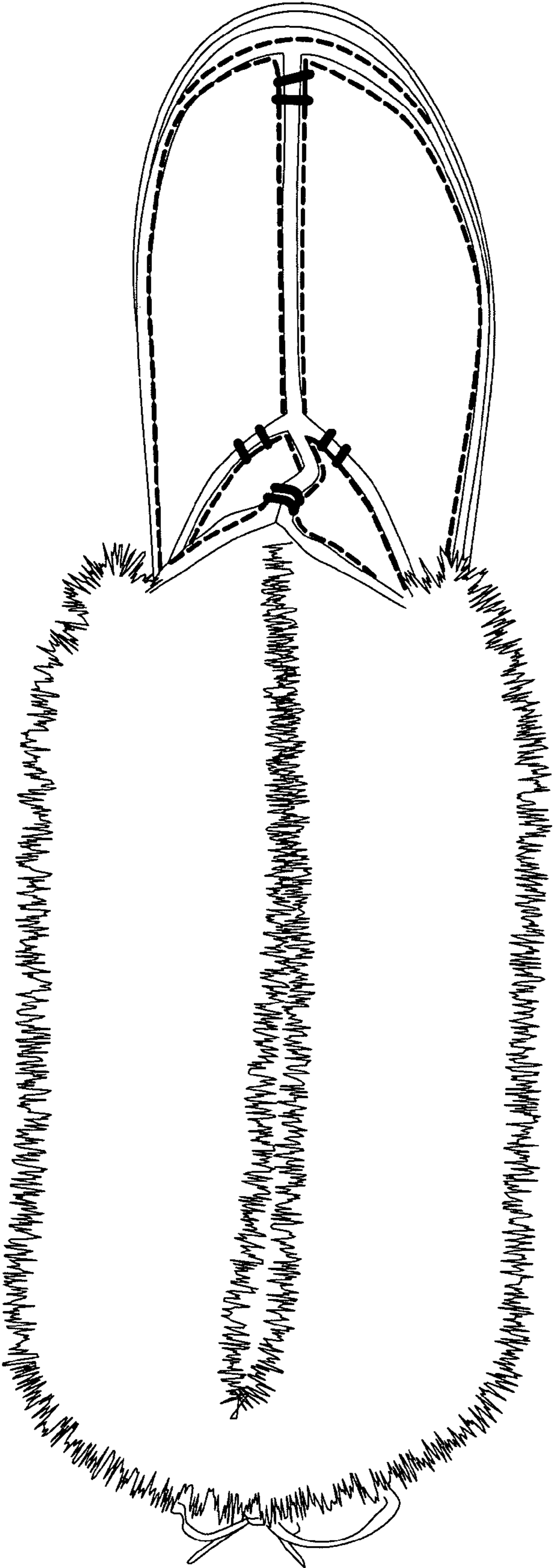

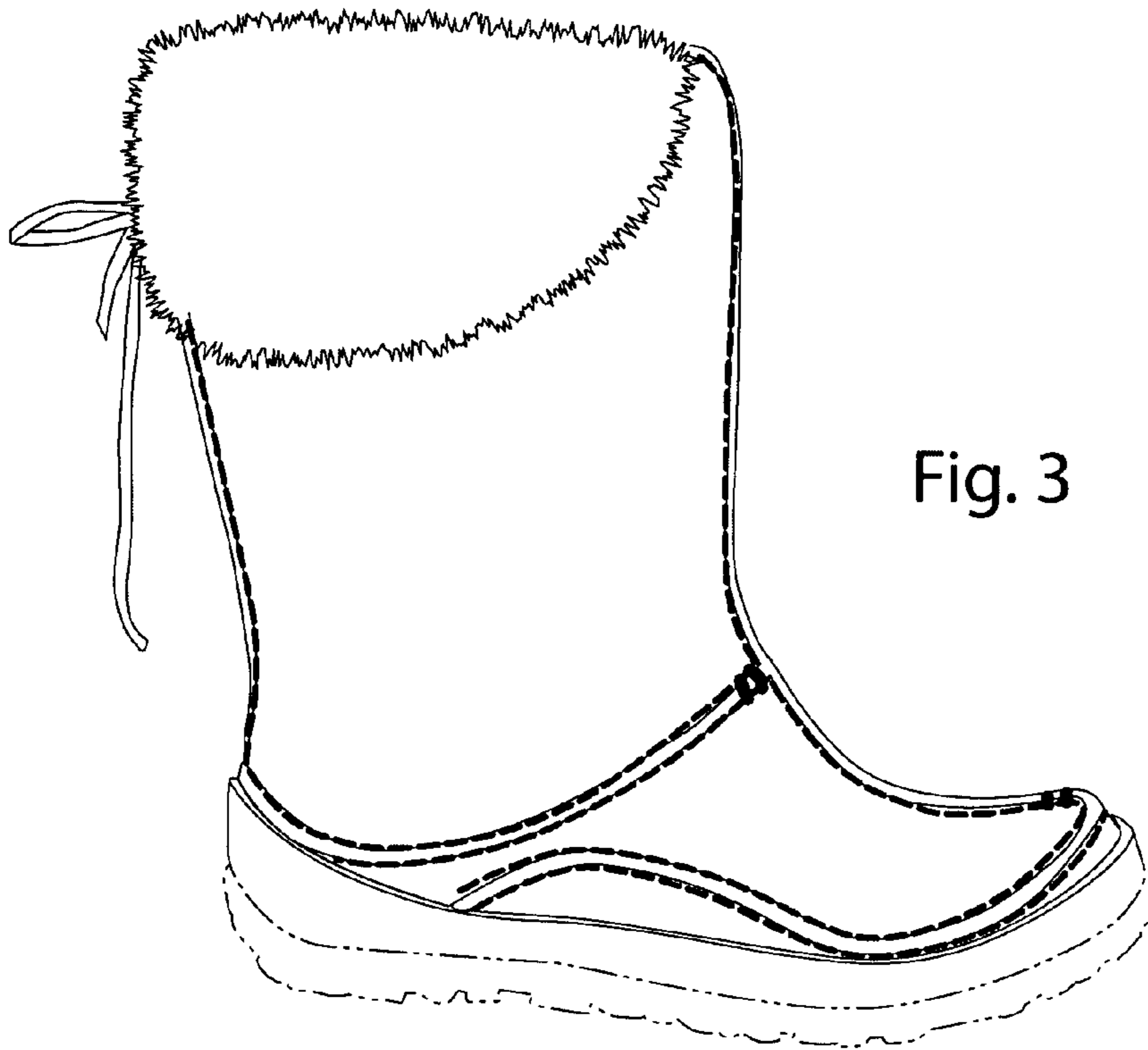

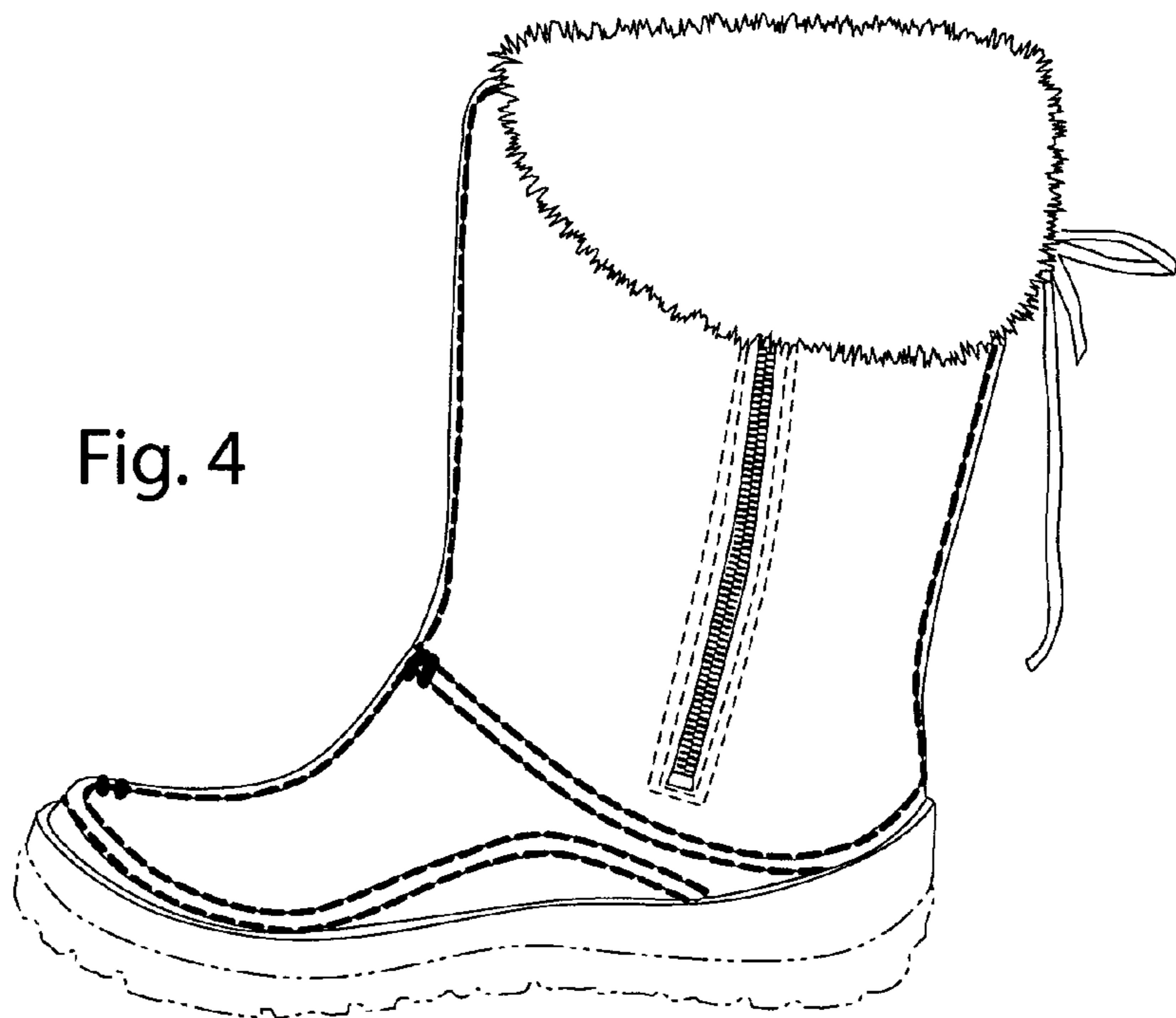

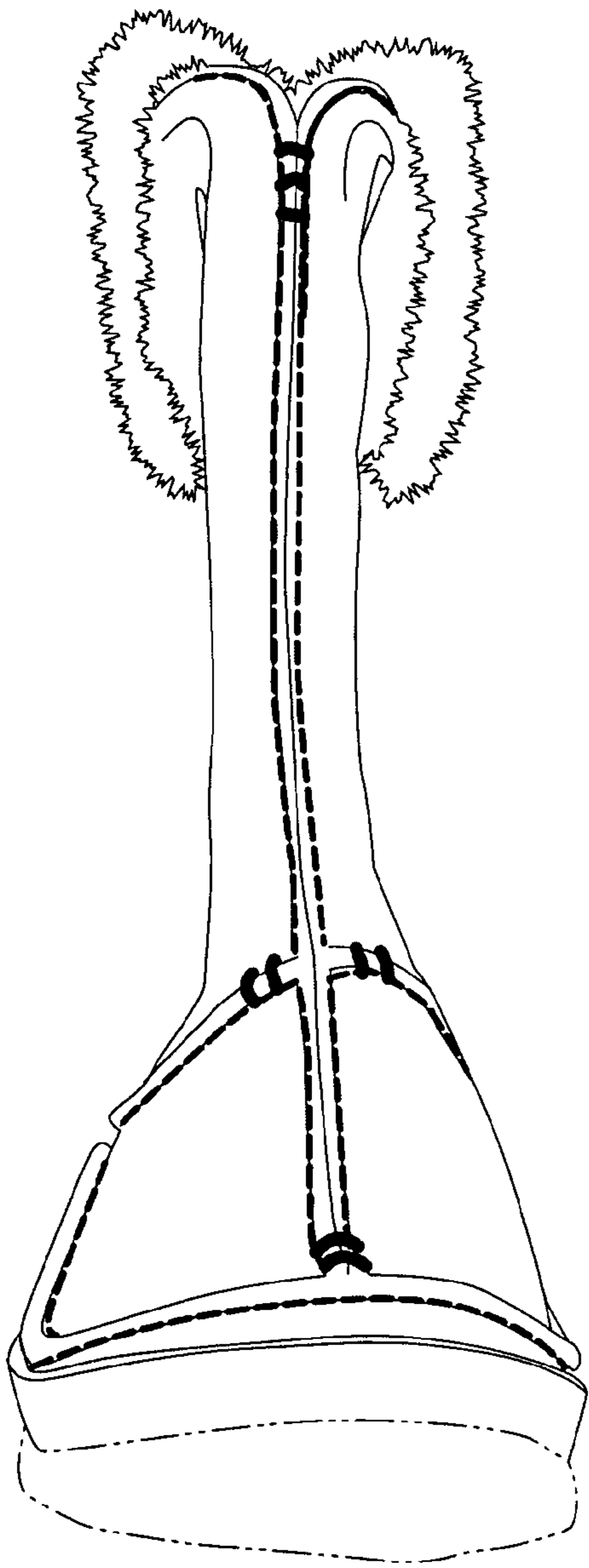

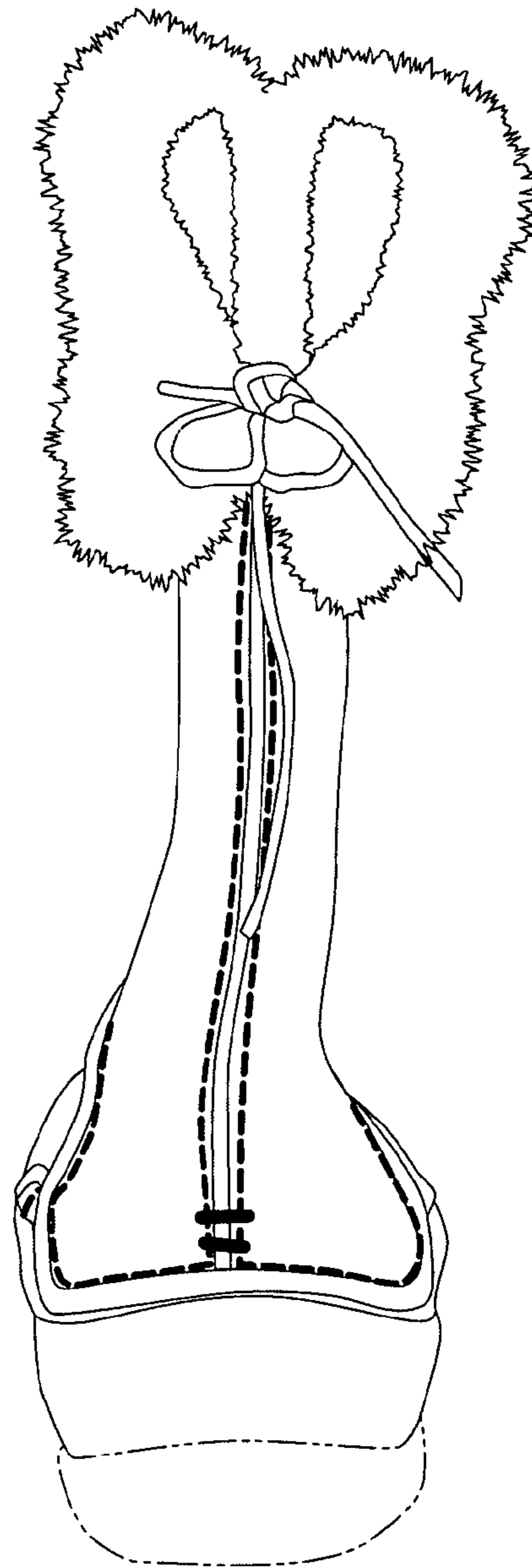
