FIG. 4 is a front view of the toy seen in FIG. 1;

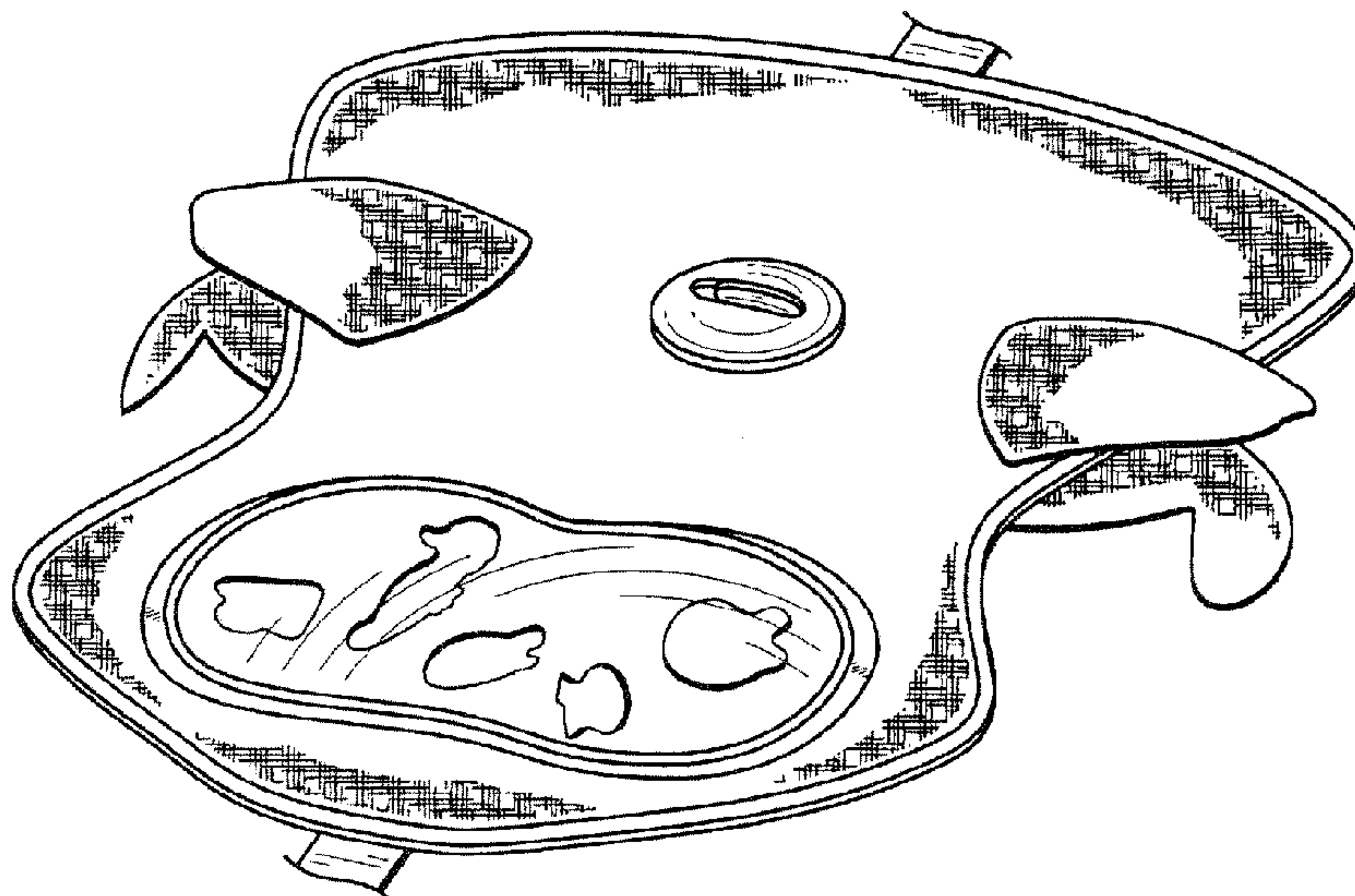
FIG. 5 is a back view of the toy seen in FIG. 1;

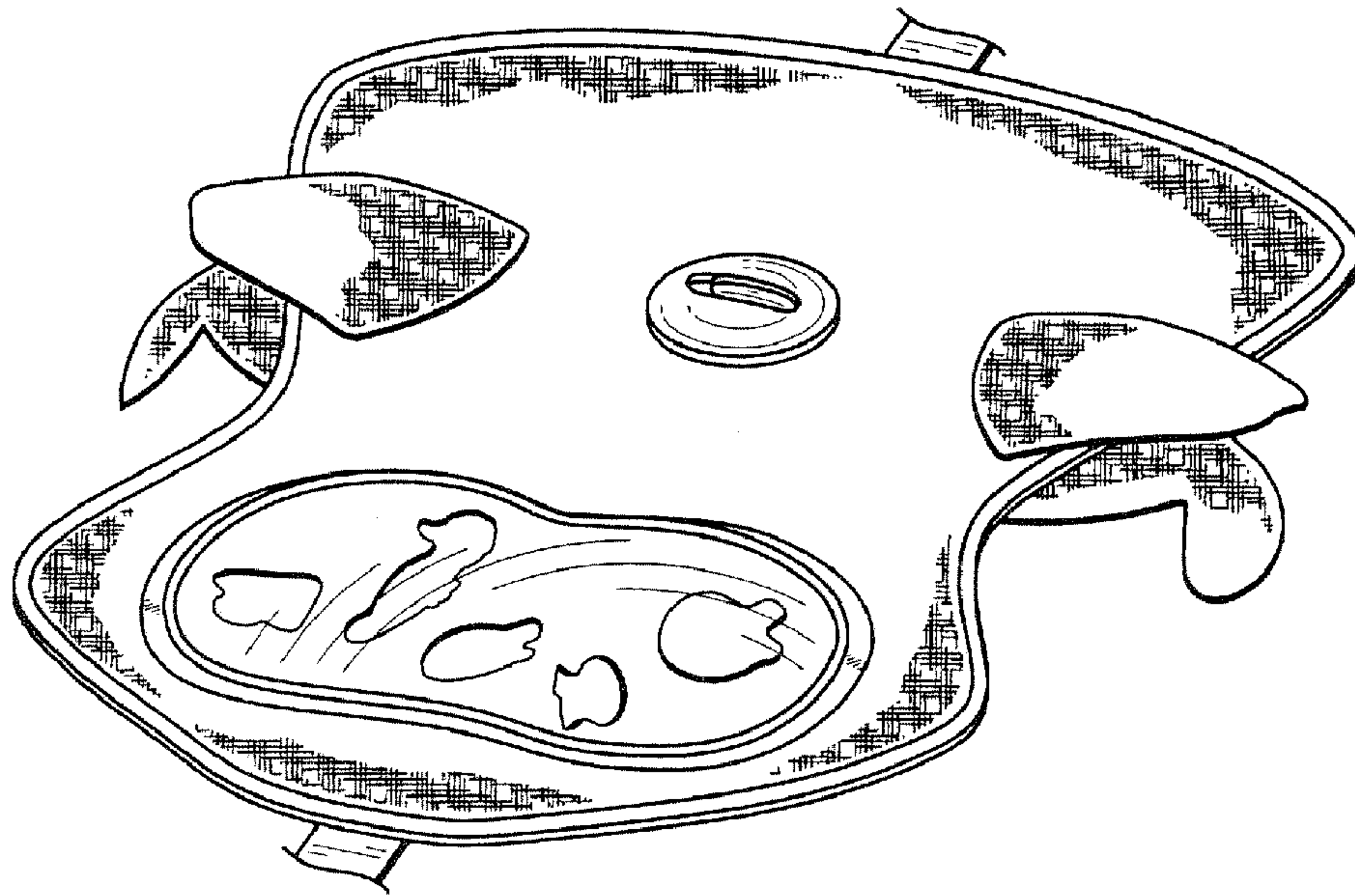

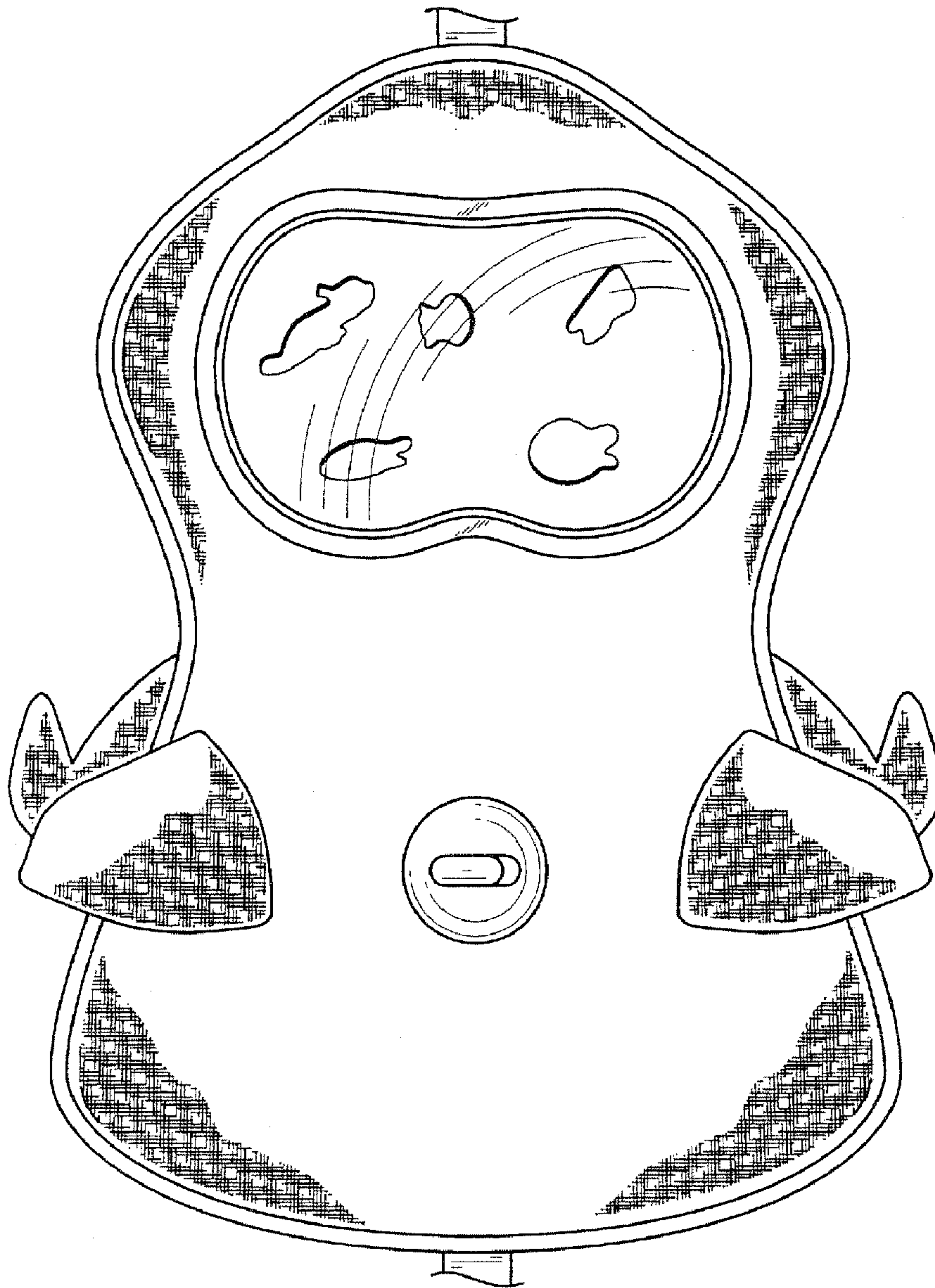

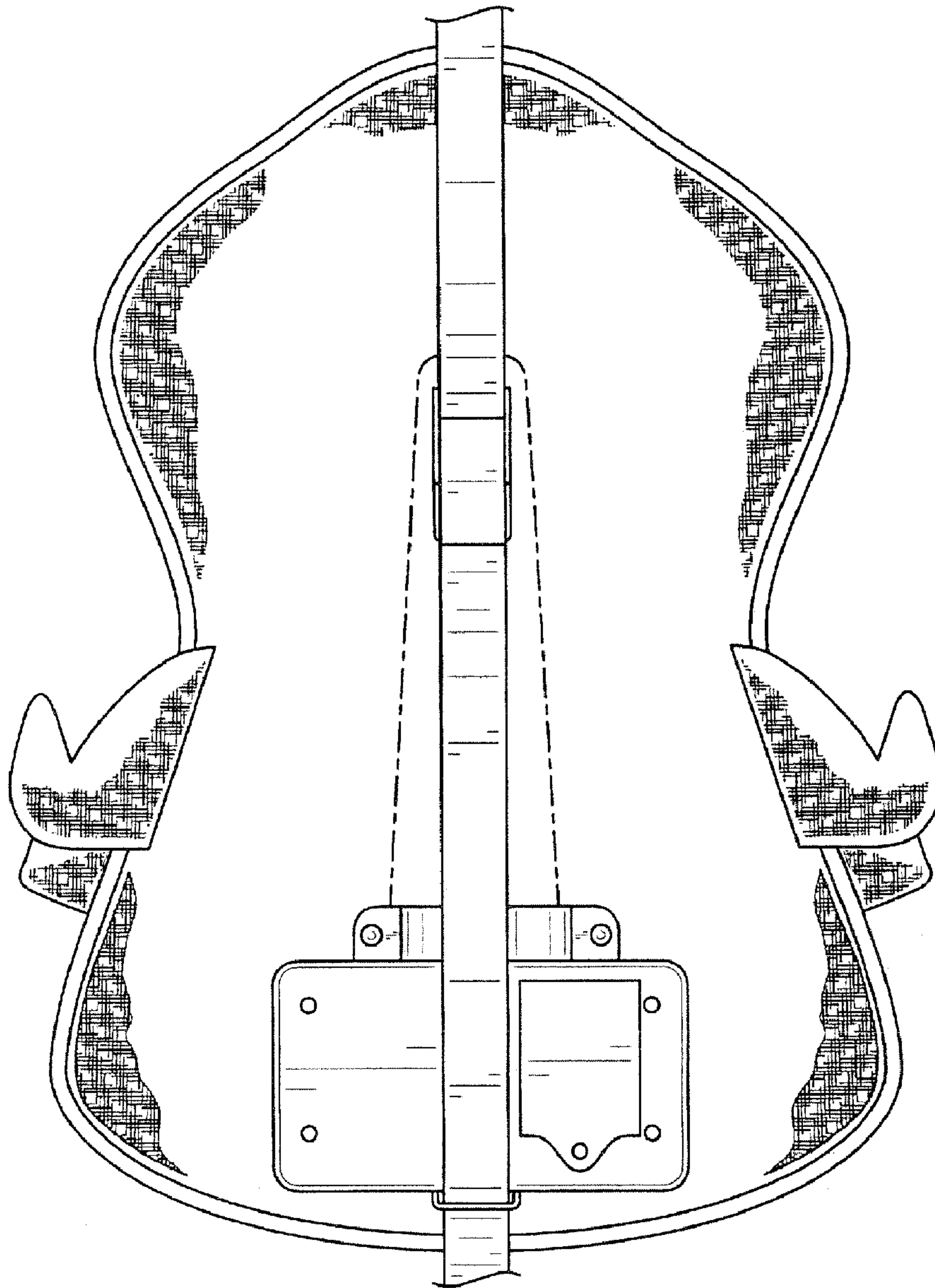

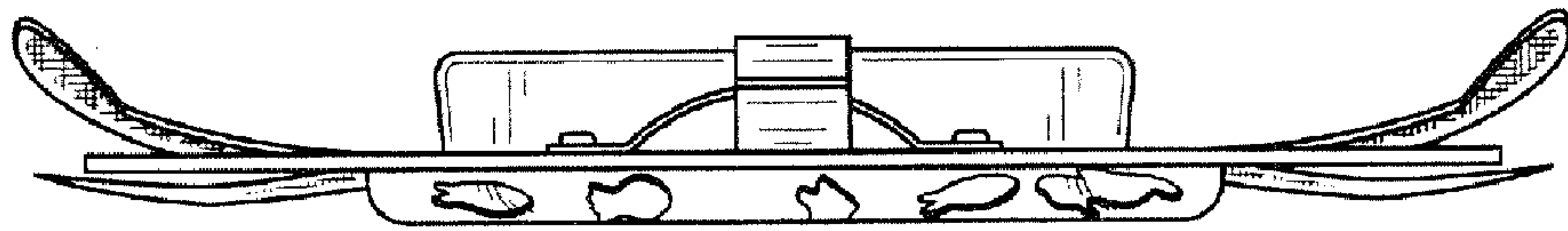

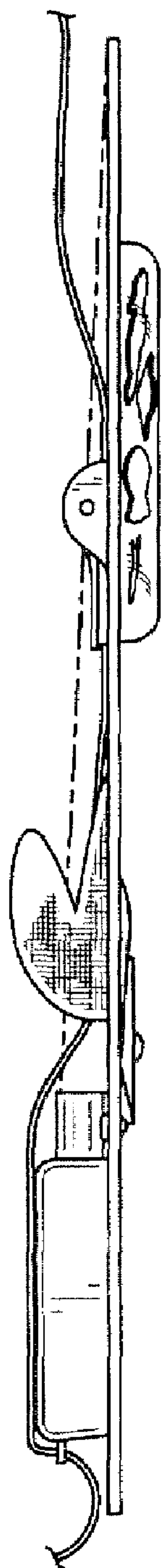
