(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a table leg, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a table leg incorporating our new design, wherein the portions in phantom indicate environment and form no part of the claimed design, and also indicate indeterminate length;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged isometric view thereof, wherein the portions in phantom again indicate environment and form no part of the claimed design, and also indicate indeterminate length;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side elevation view being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a view similar to FIG. 1 showing another embodiment of a table leg incorporating our new design, wherein the portions in phantom indicate environment and form no part of the claimed design, and also indicate indeterminate length;

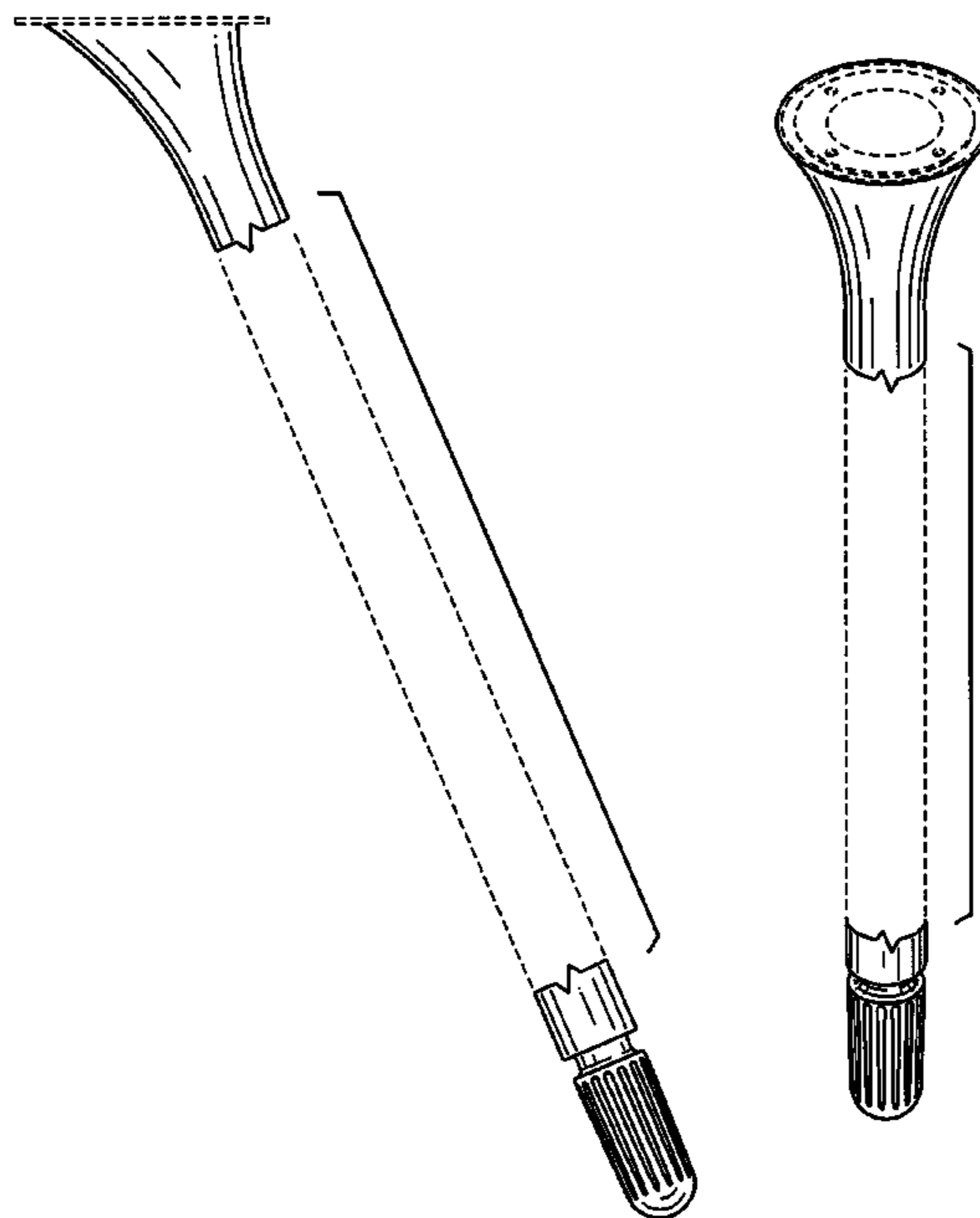
FIG. 9 is an enlarged isometric view thereof, wherein the portions in phantom again indicate environment and form no part of the claimed design, and also indicate indeterminate length;

FIG. 10 is a side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view thereof; and,

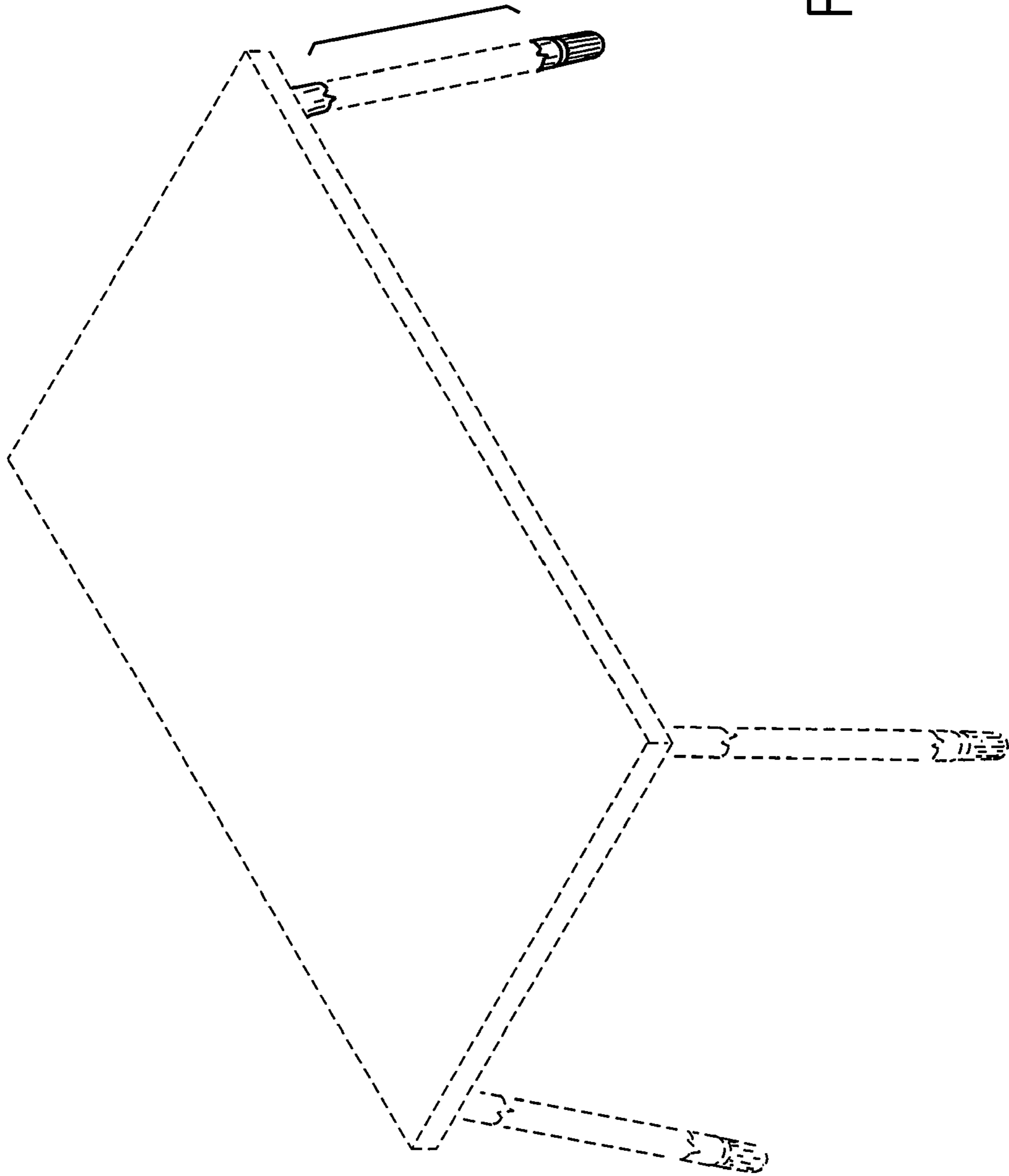
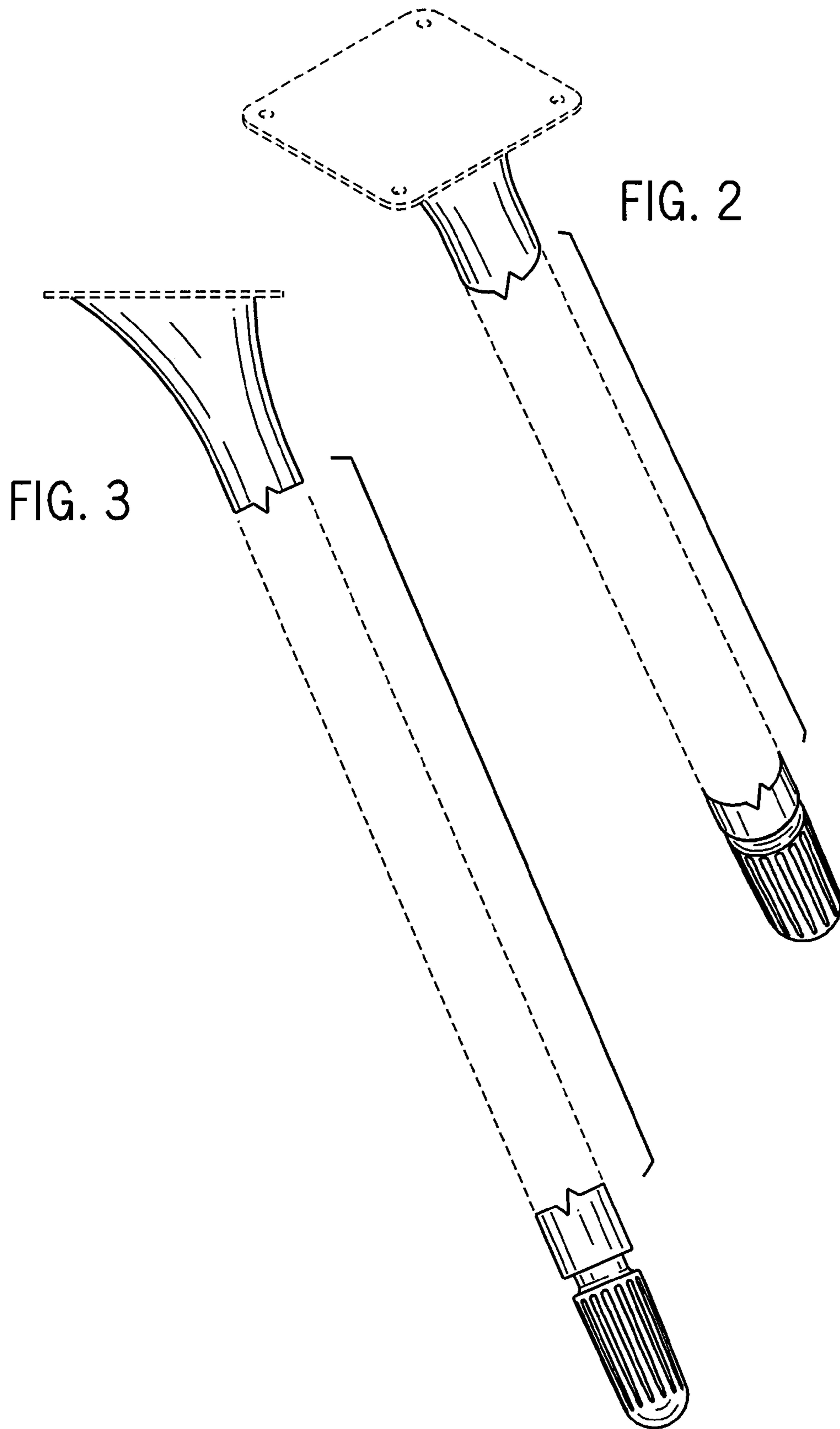

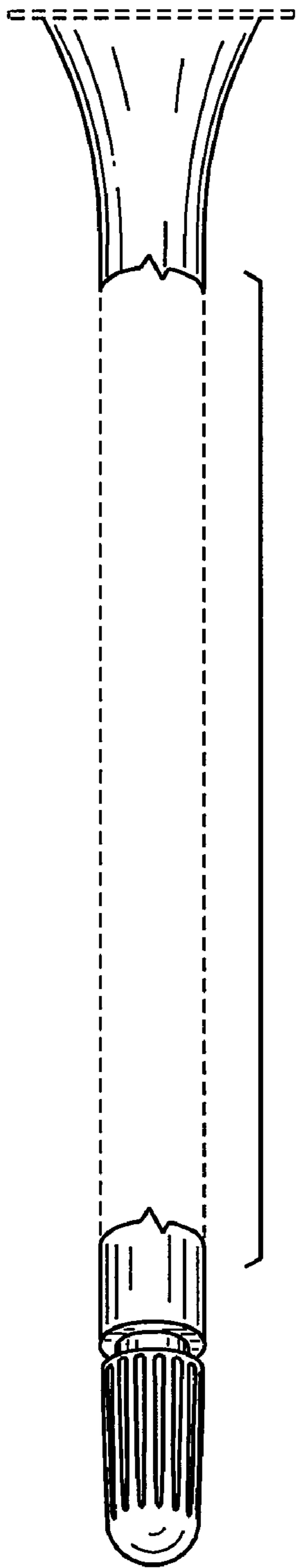

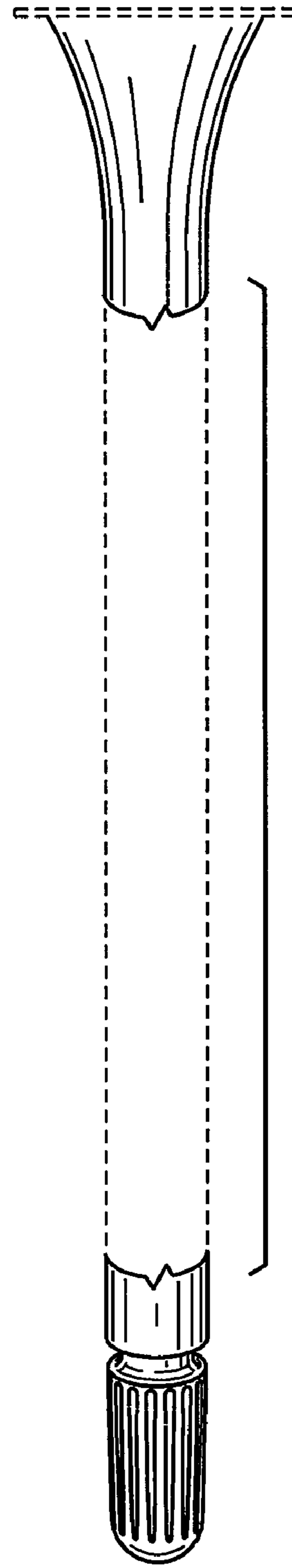

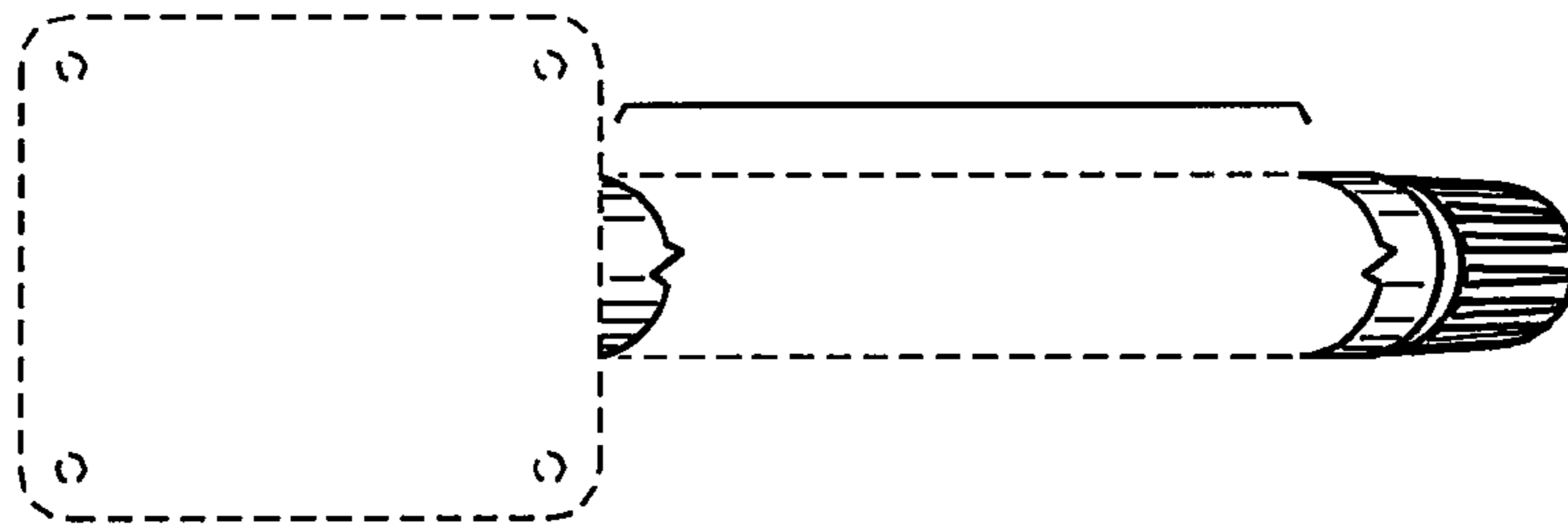

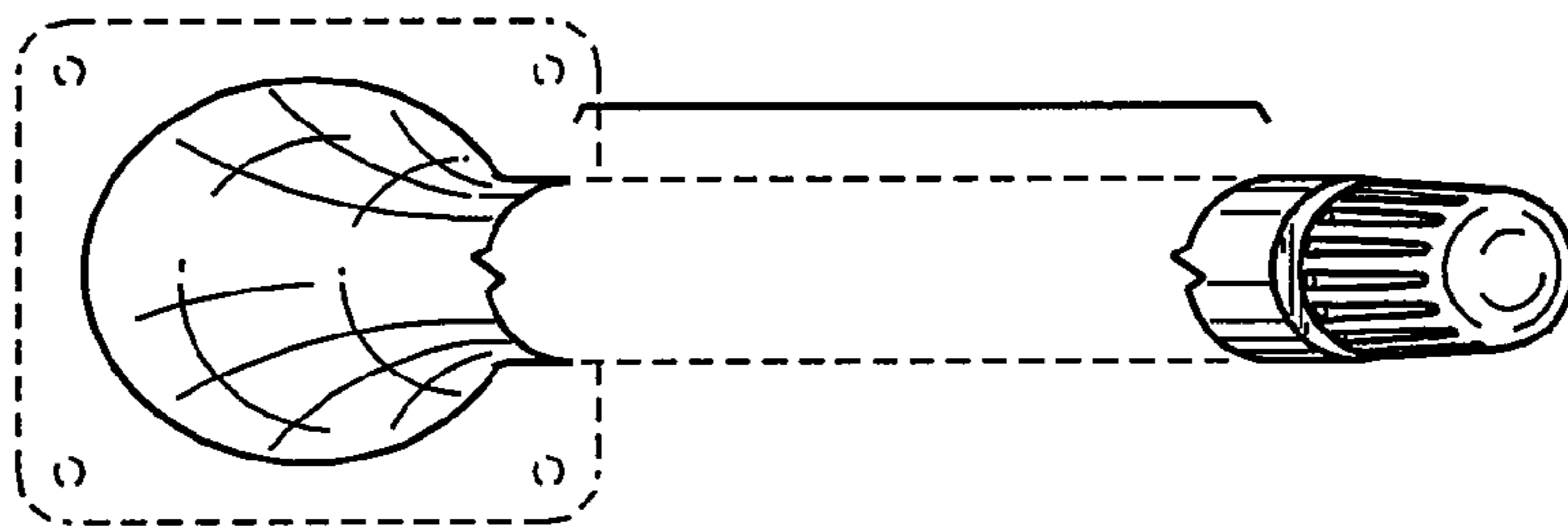

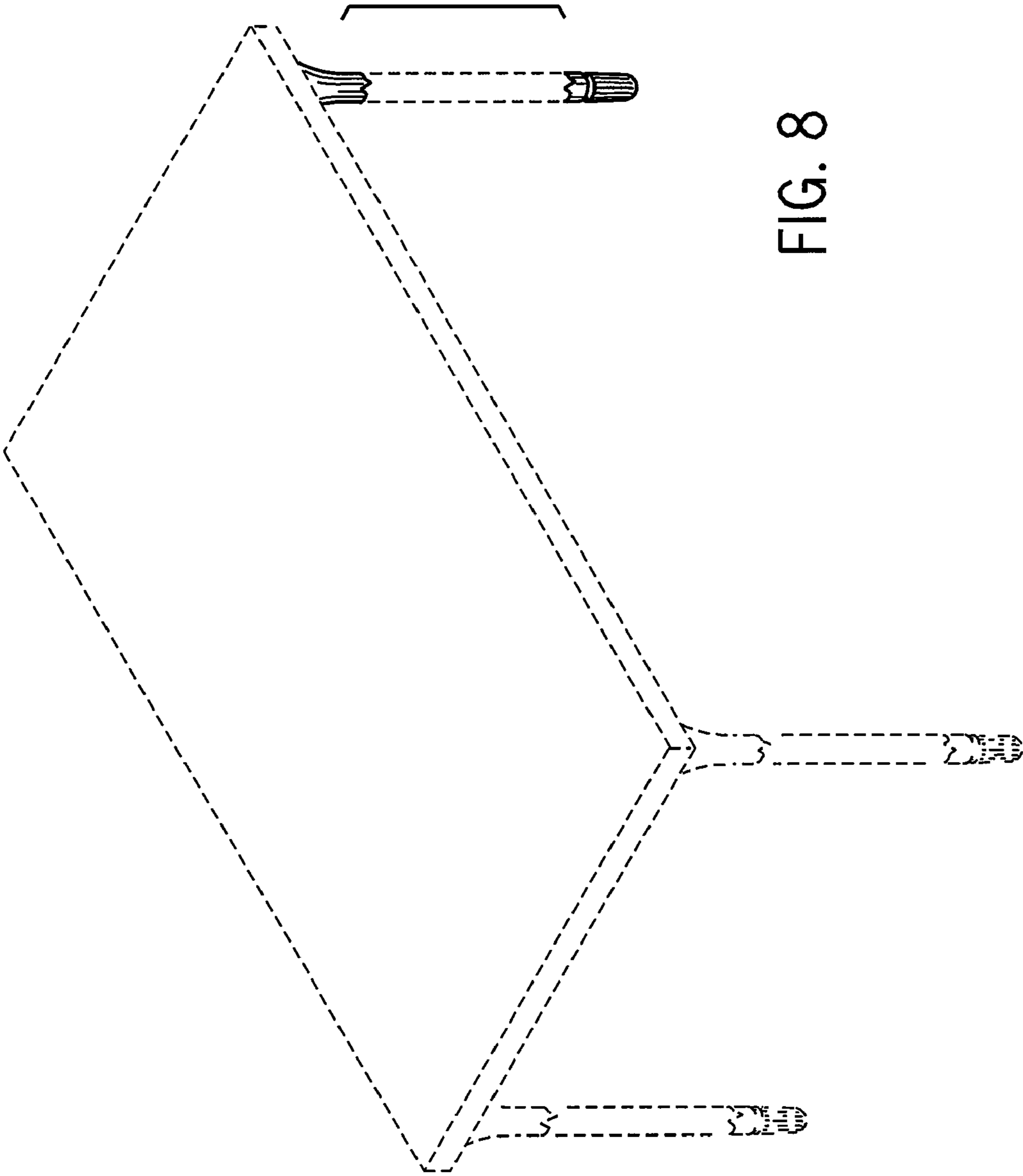

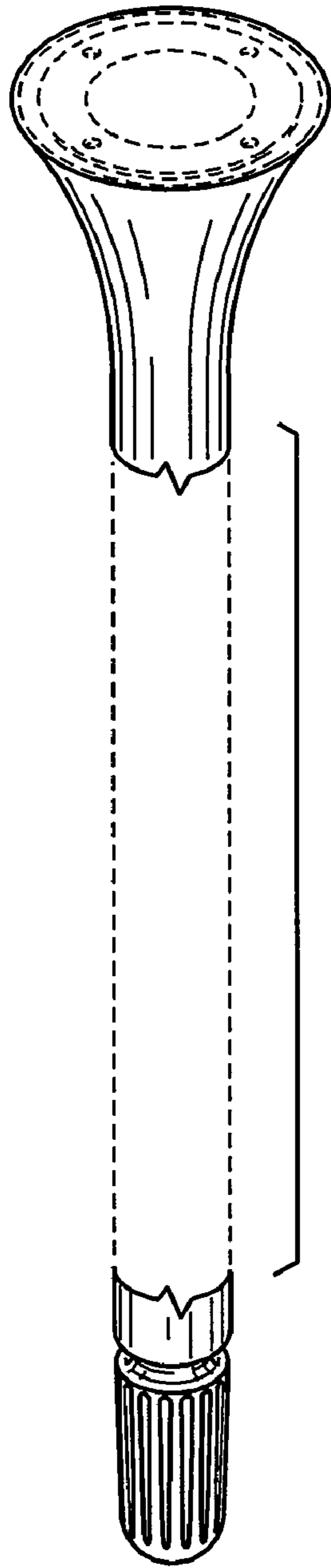

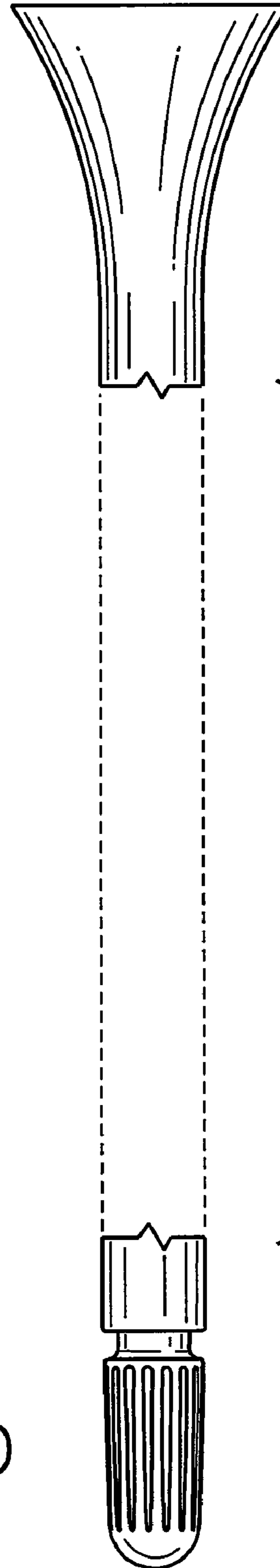

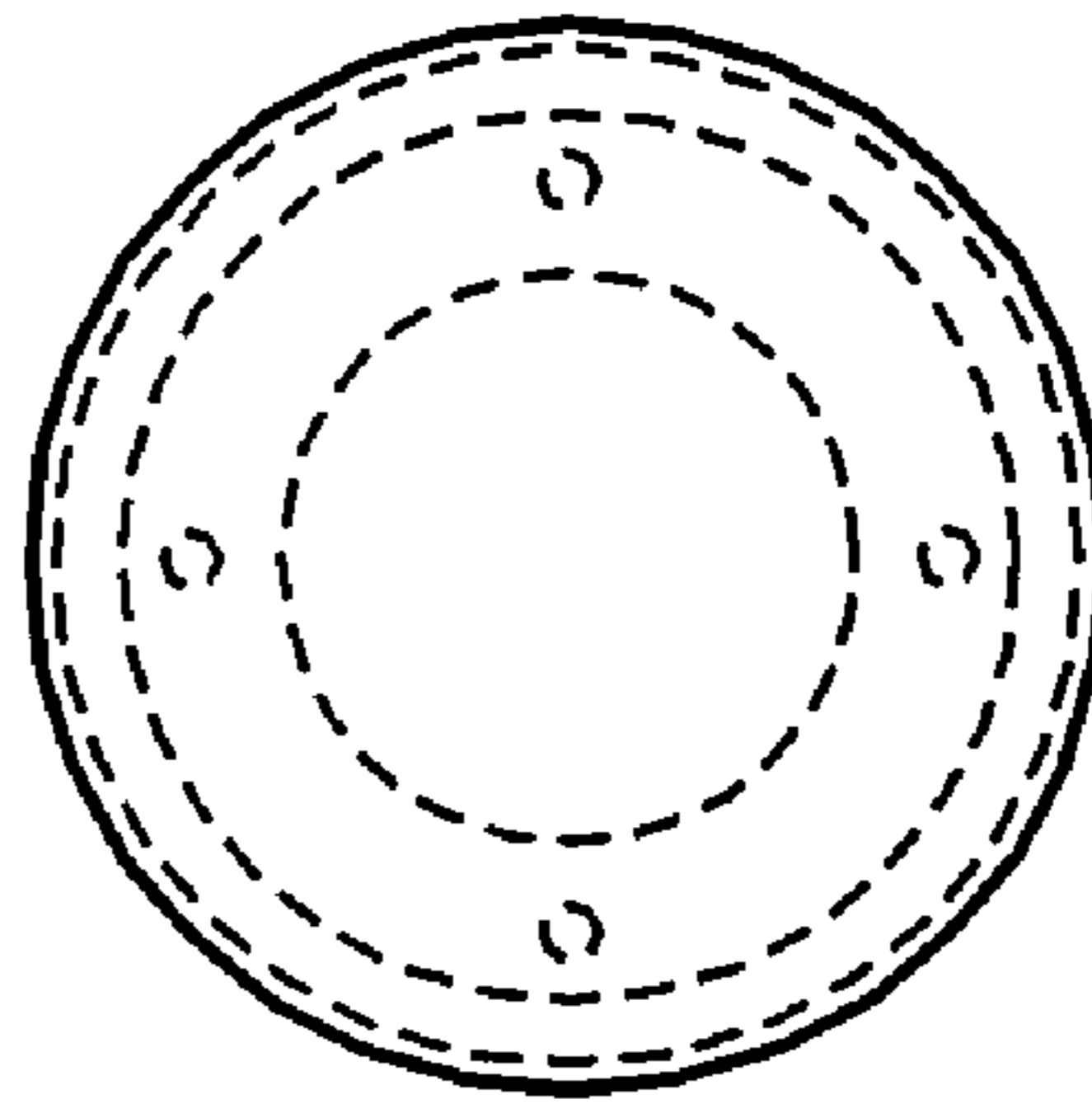
