FIG. 6 is a first perspective view of a second embodiment of the present invention from above and to the right, with bristles shown in phantom.

FIG. 7 is a second perspective view of the second embodiment of the present invention from above and to the right.

FIG. 8 is a third perspective view of the second embodiment of the present invention from below and to the right.

FIG. 9 is a fourth perspective view of the second embodiment of the present invention from below and to the right; and,

FIG. 10 is a fifth perspective view of the second embodiment of the present invention from below and to the left and showing the top.

The broken line showing of bristles is included for the purpose of illustrating environmental structure that forms no part of the claimed design.

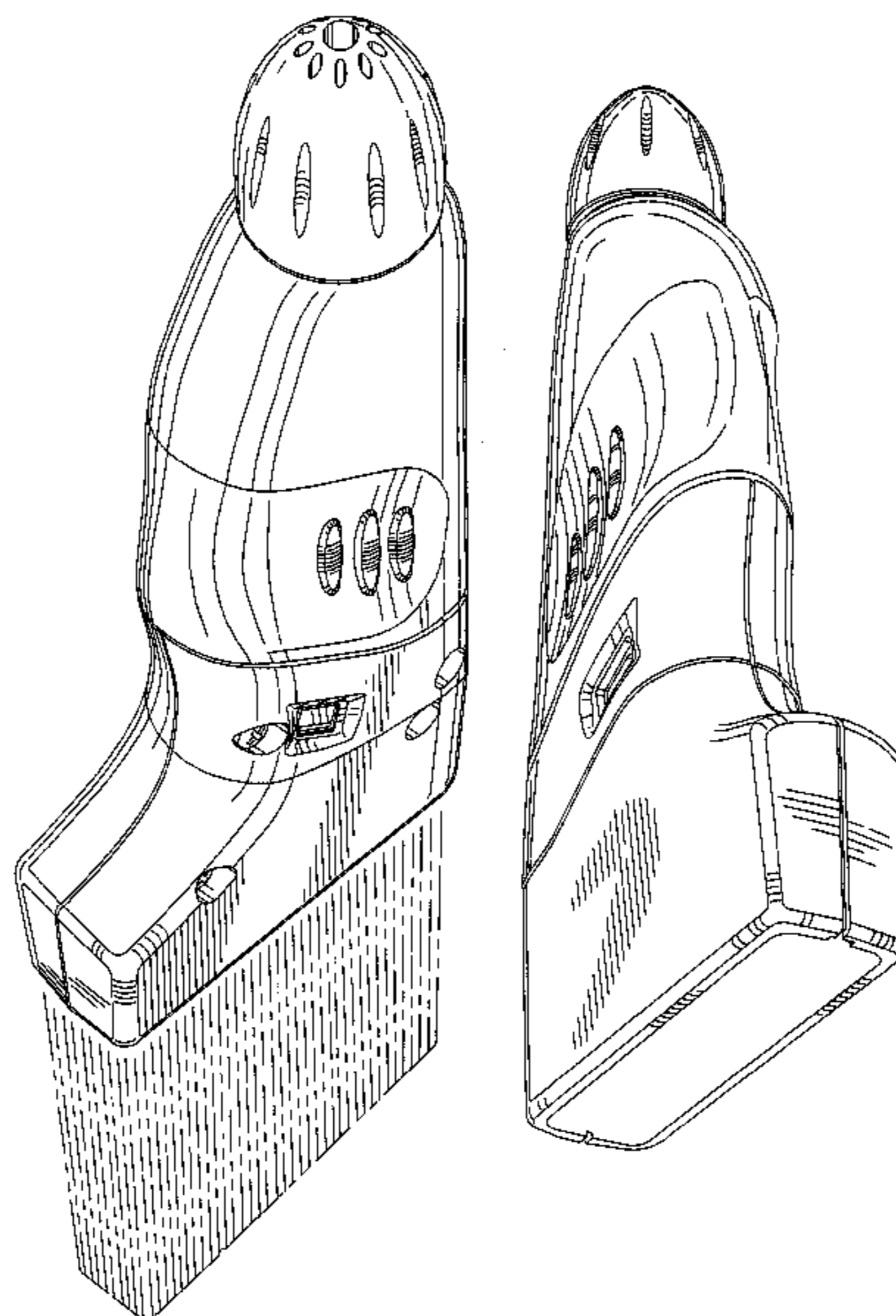

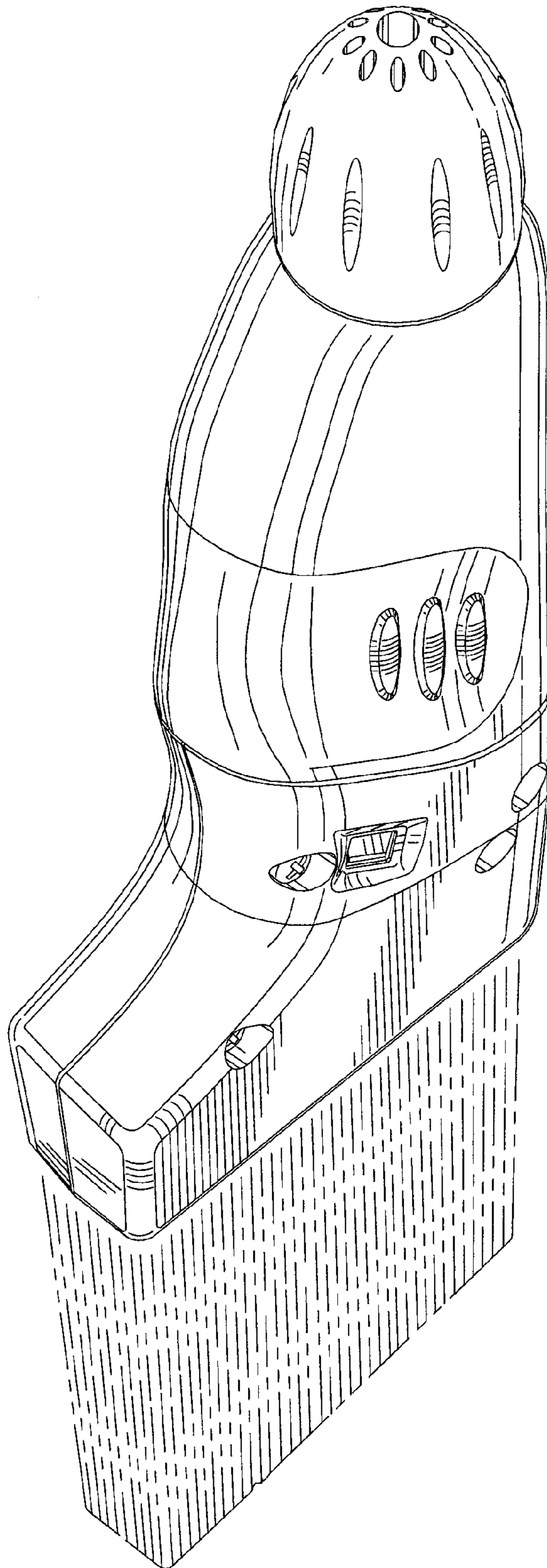

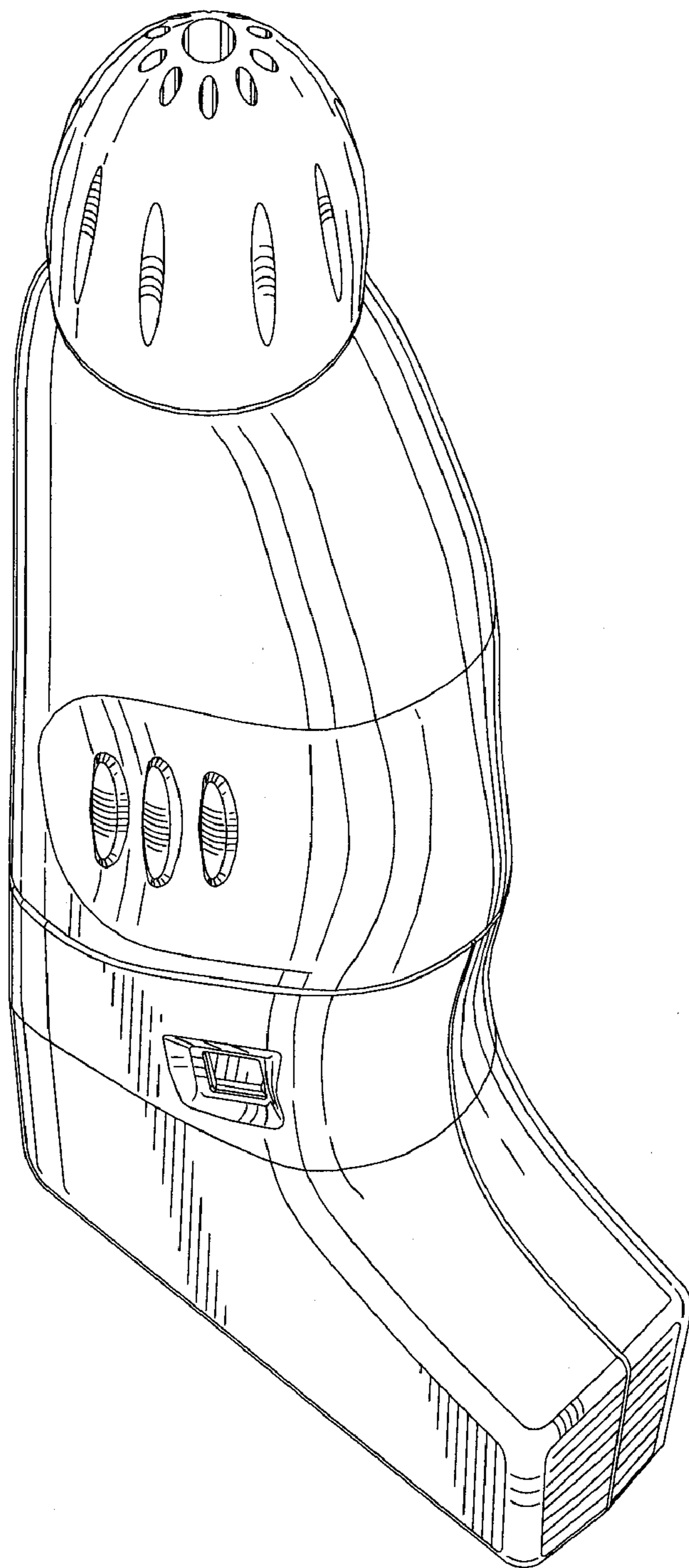

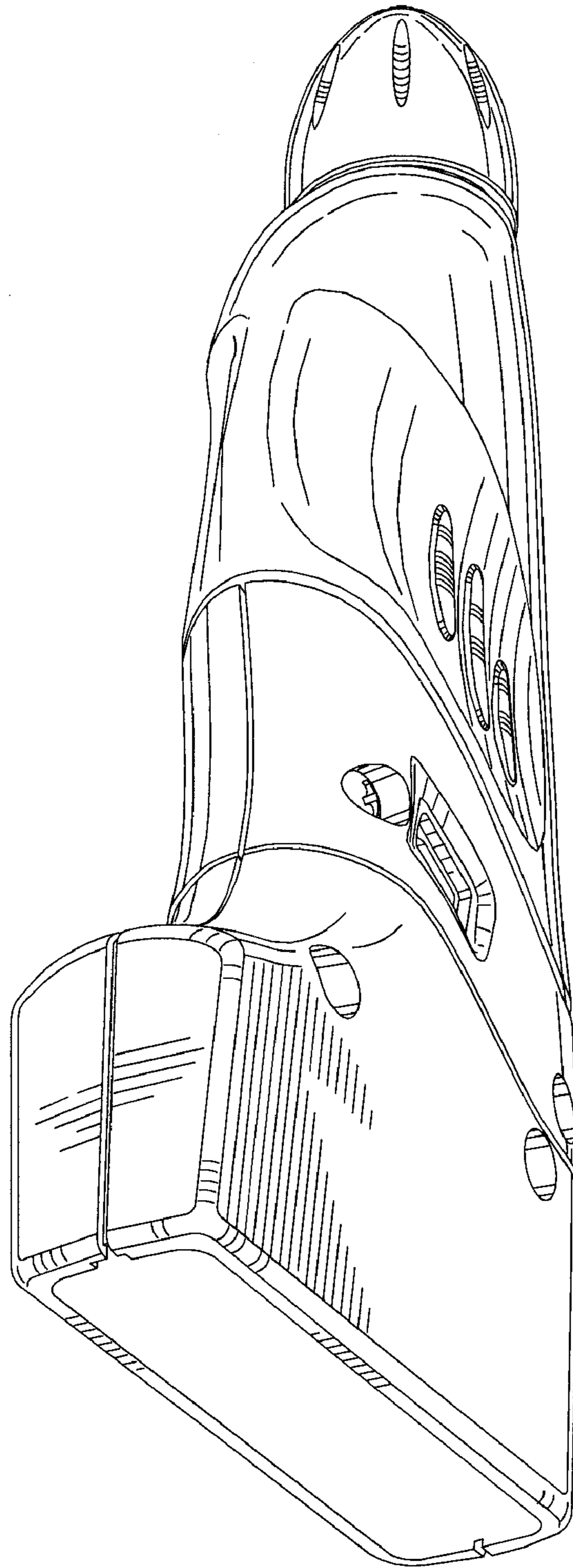

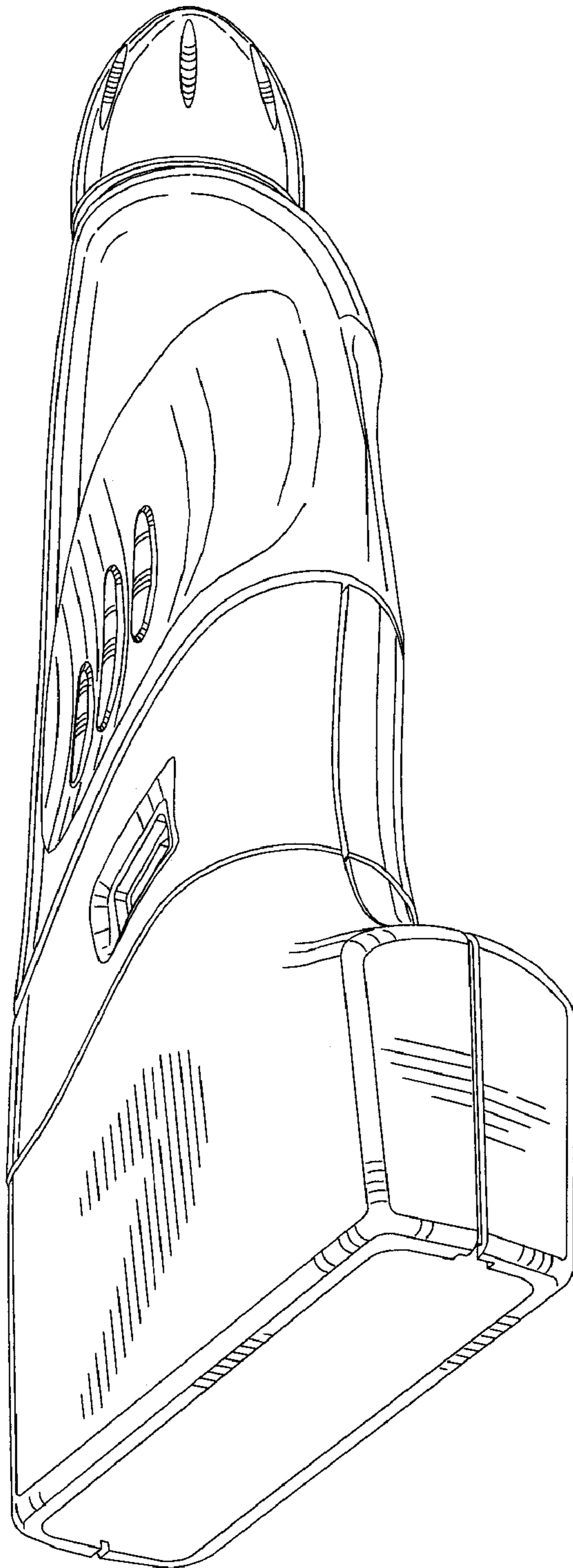

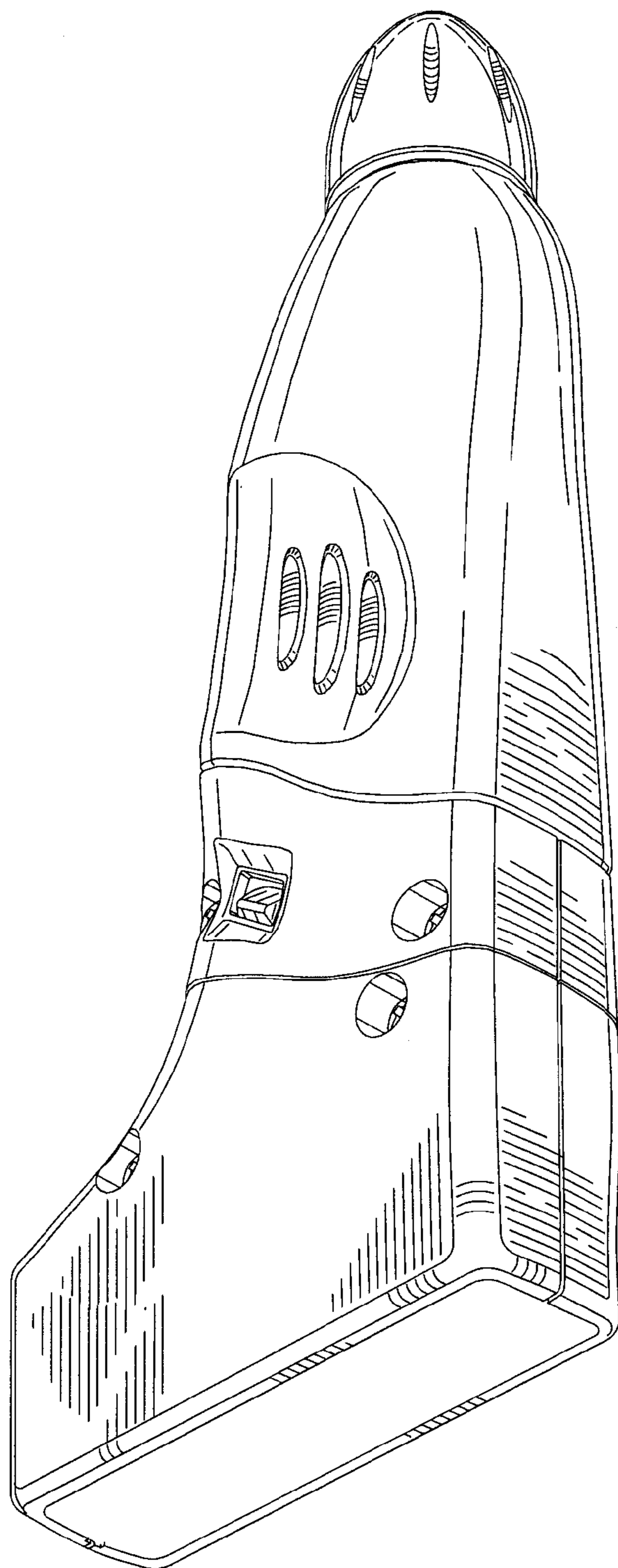

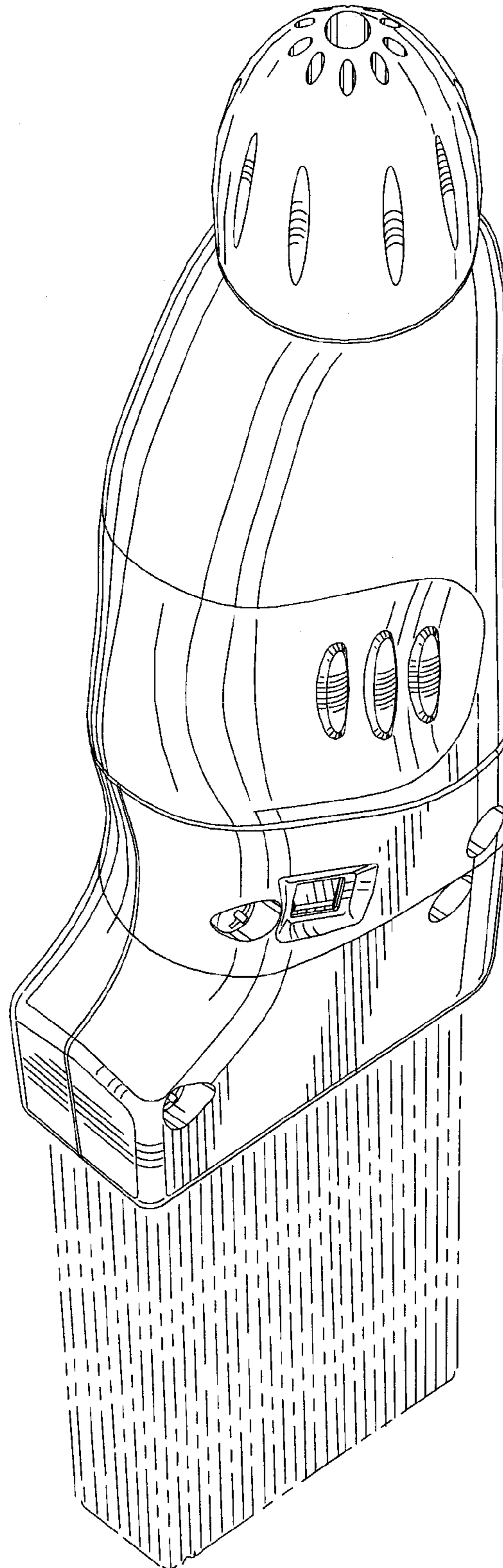

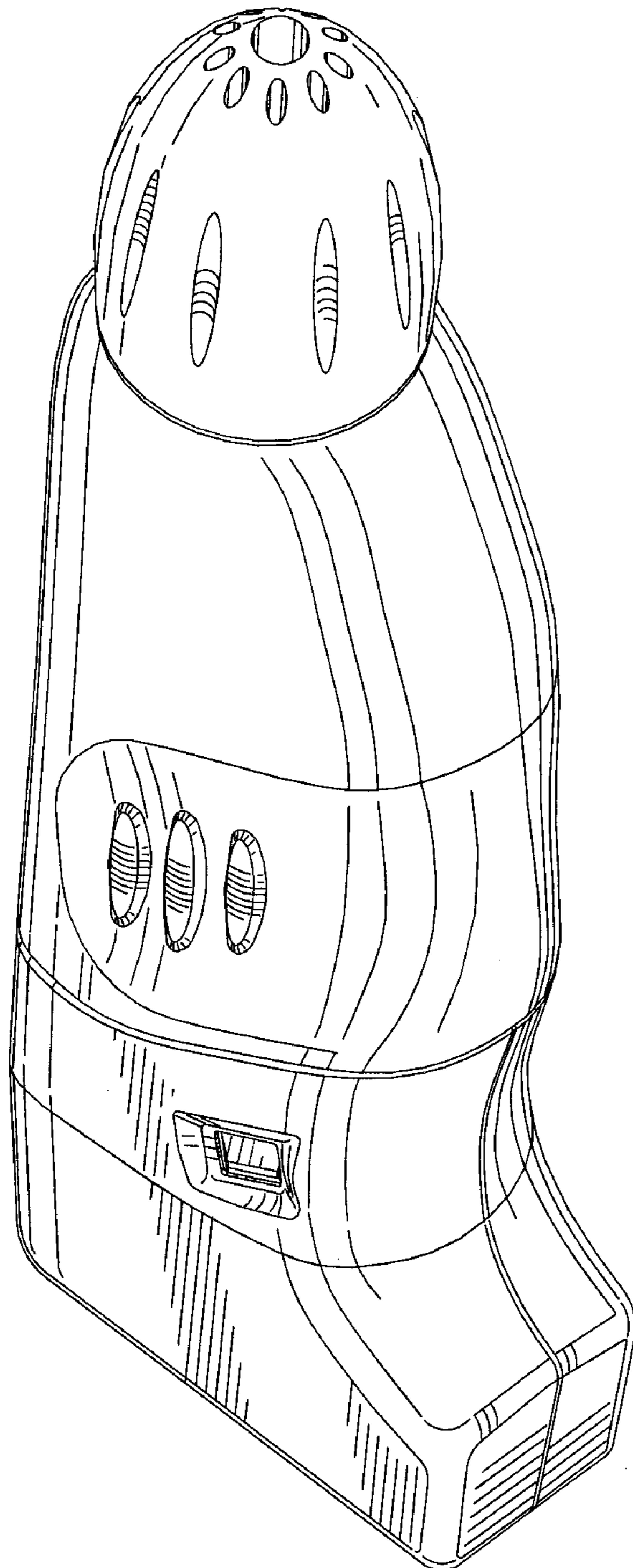

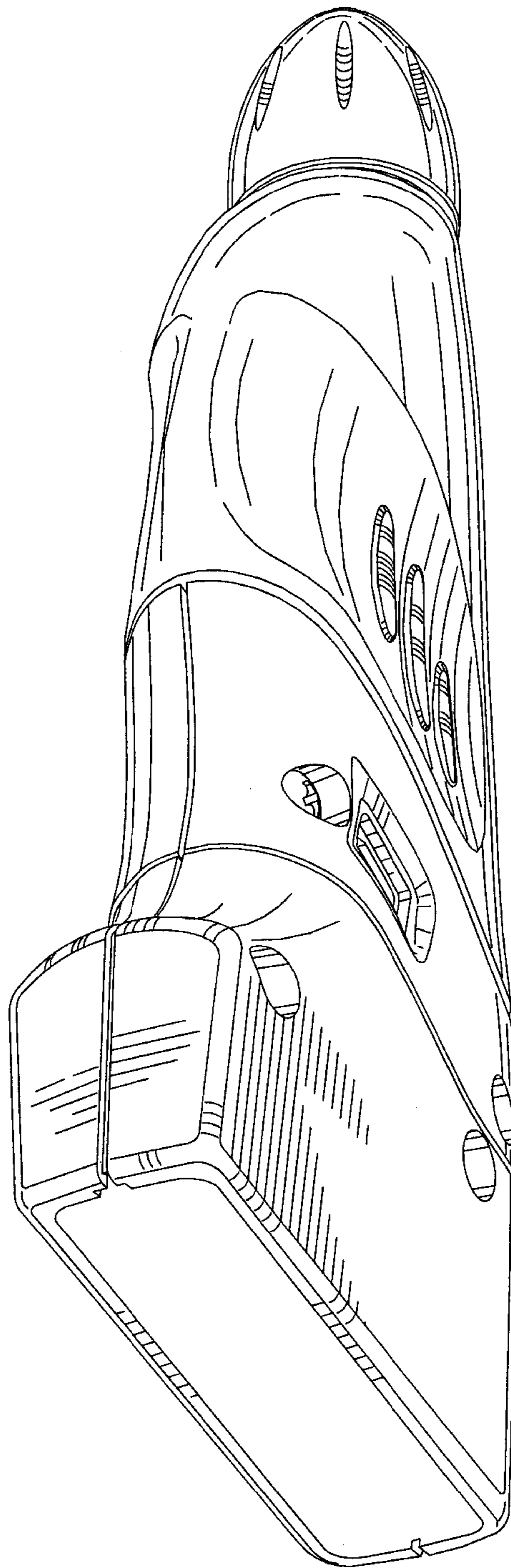

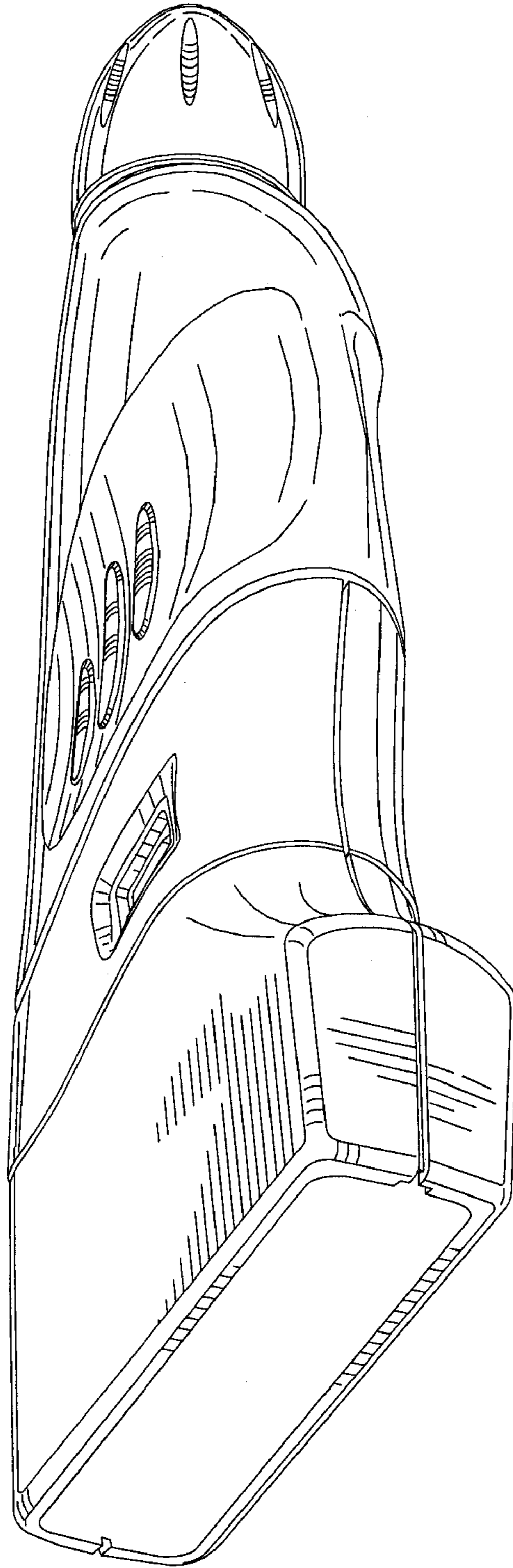
