FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chair (tete-a-tete) according to my design;

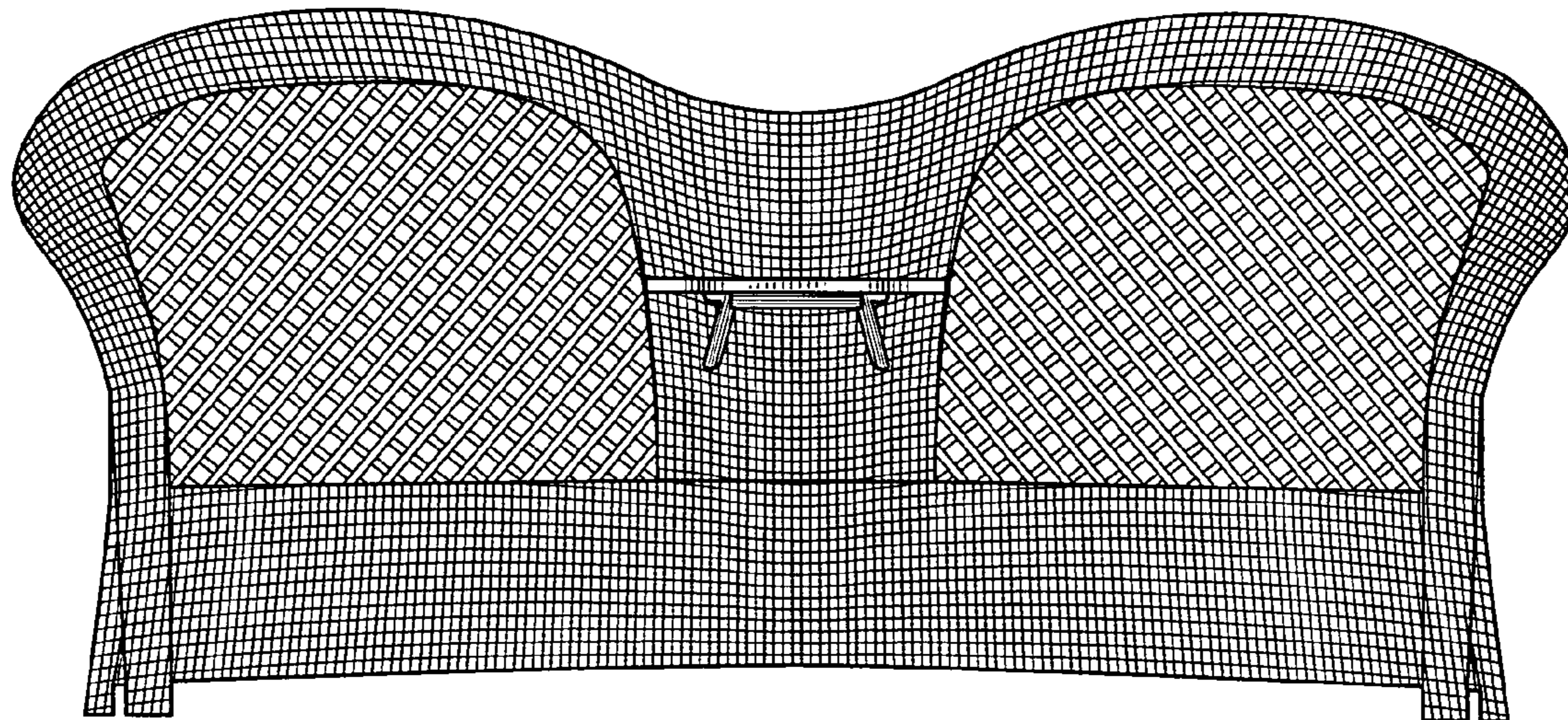
FIG. 2 is a left elevational view thereof, the right elevational view thereof being a mirror image of FIG. 2;

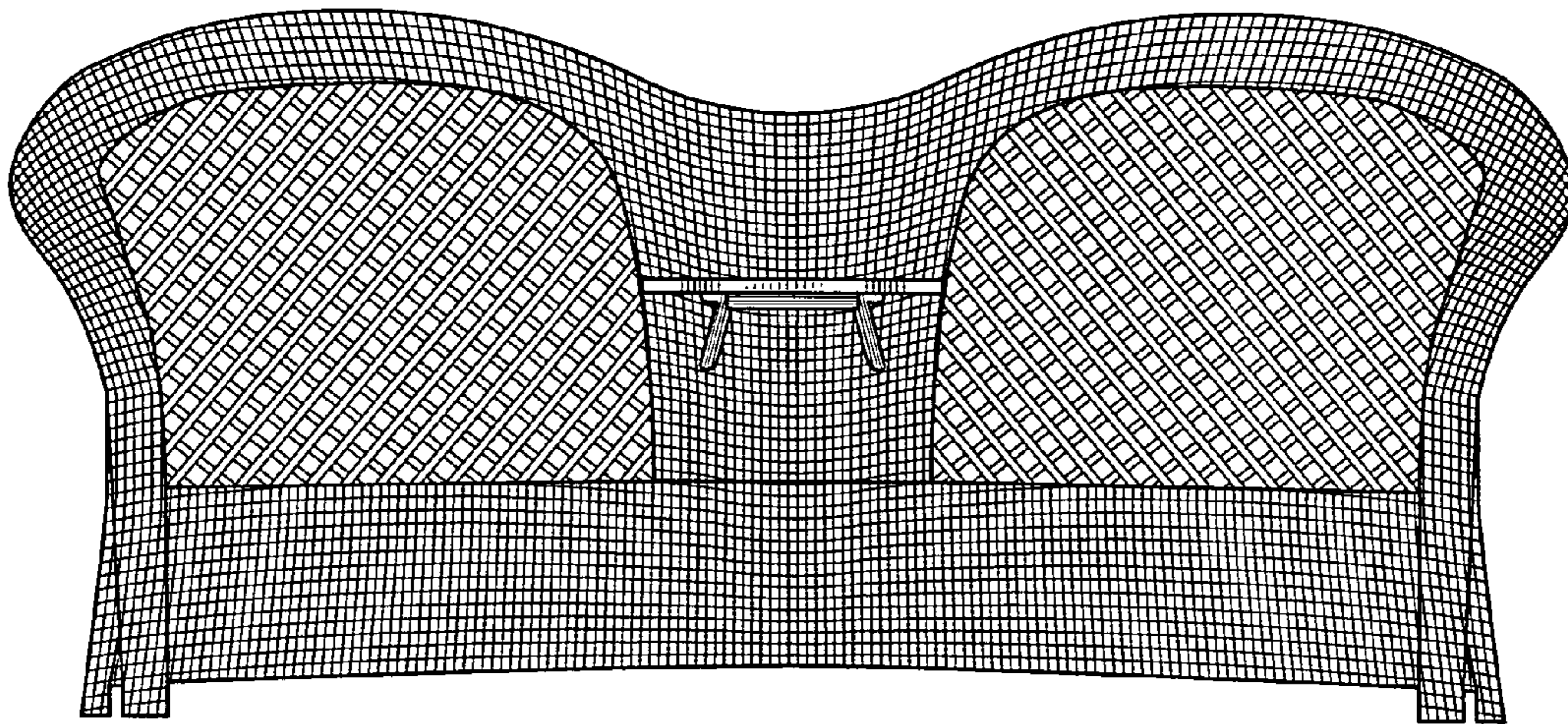

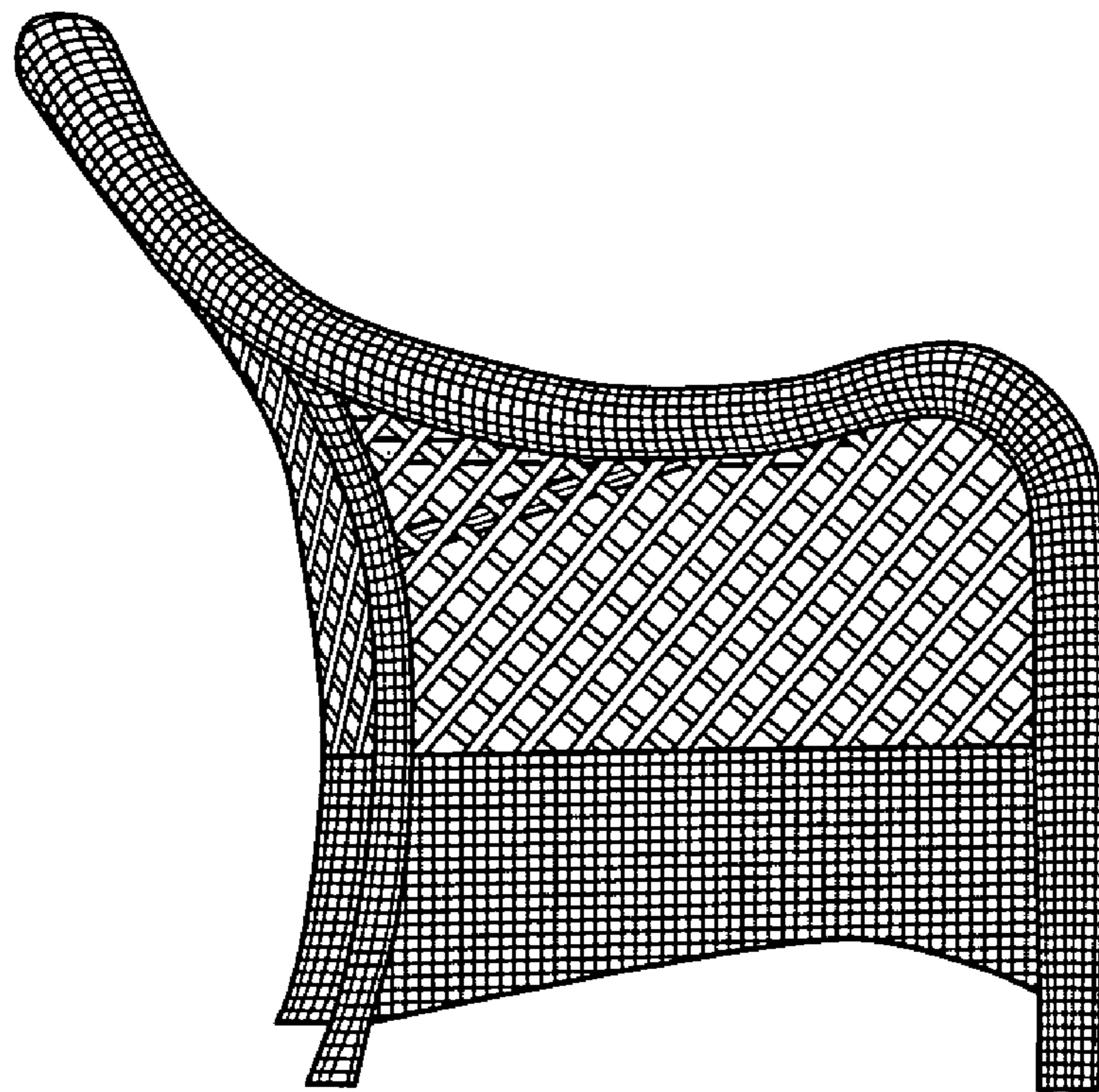

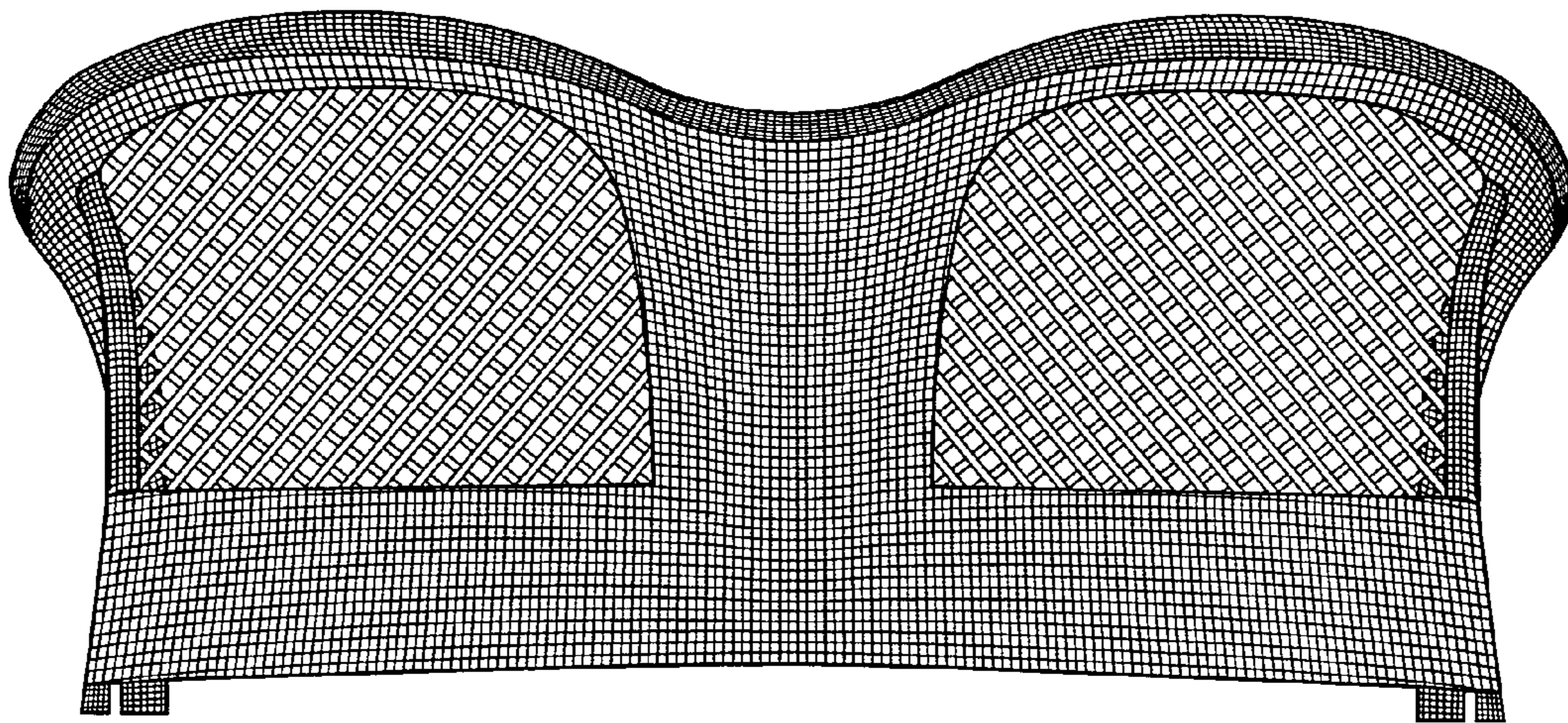

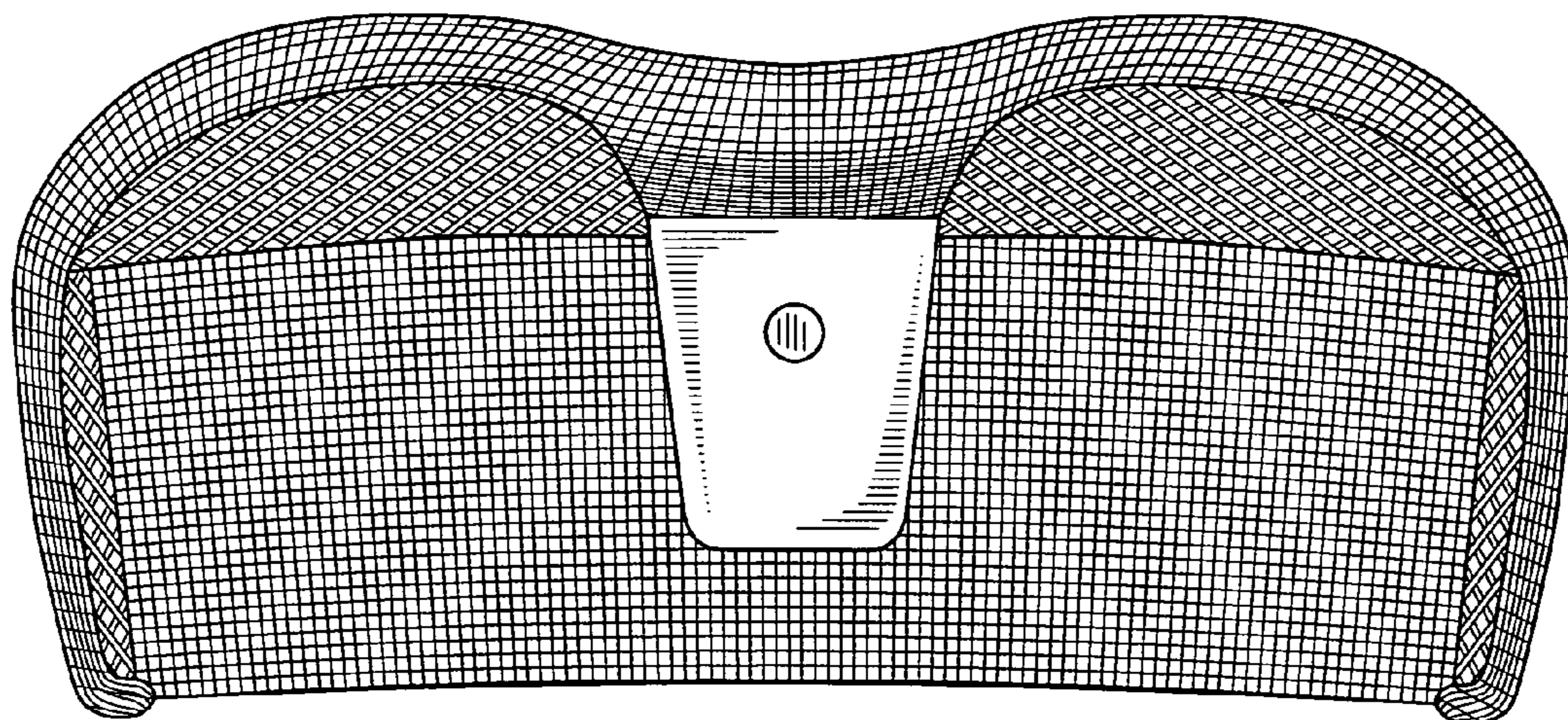

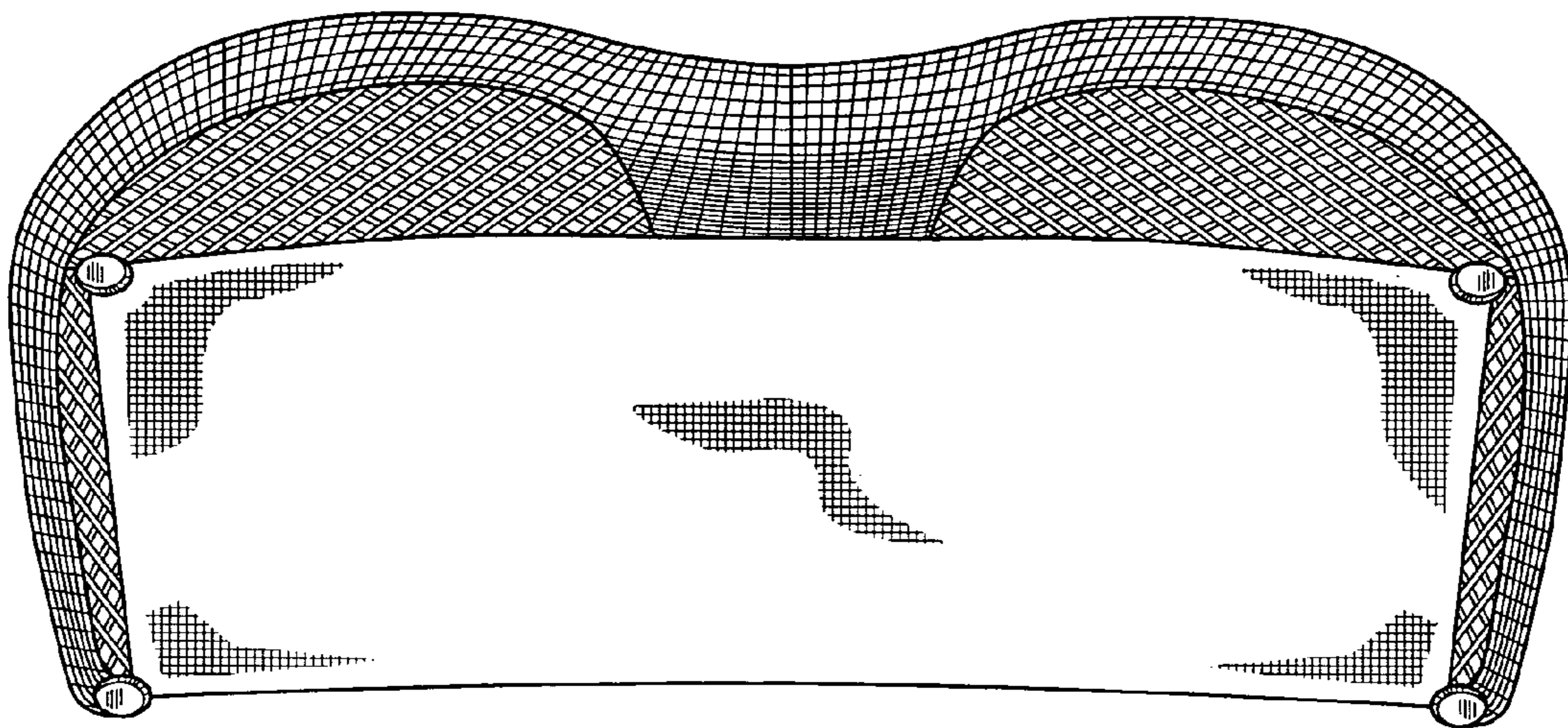
