FIG. 5 is a right elevational view of the embodiment.

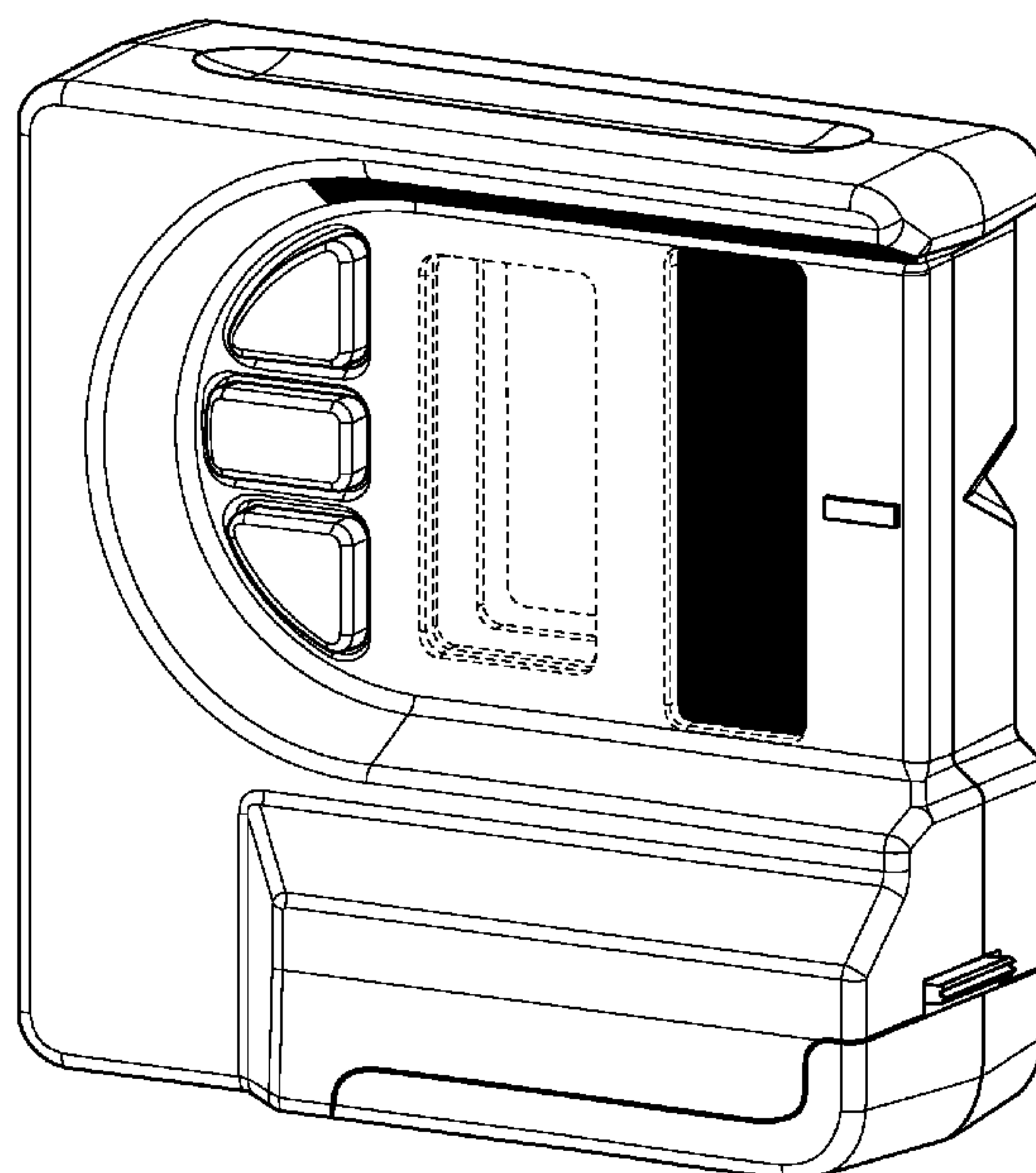
FIG. 6 is a top elevational view of the embodiment; and,

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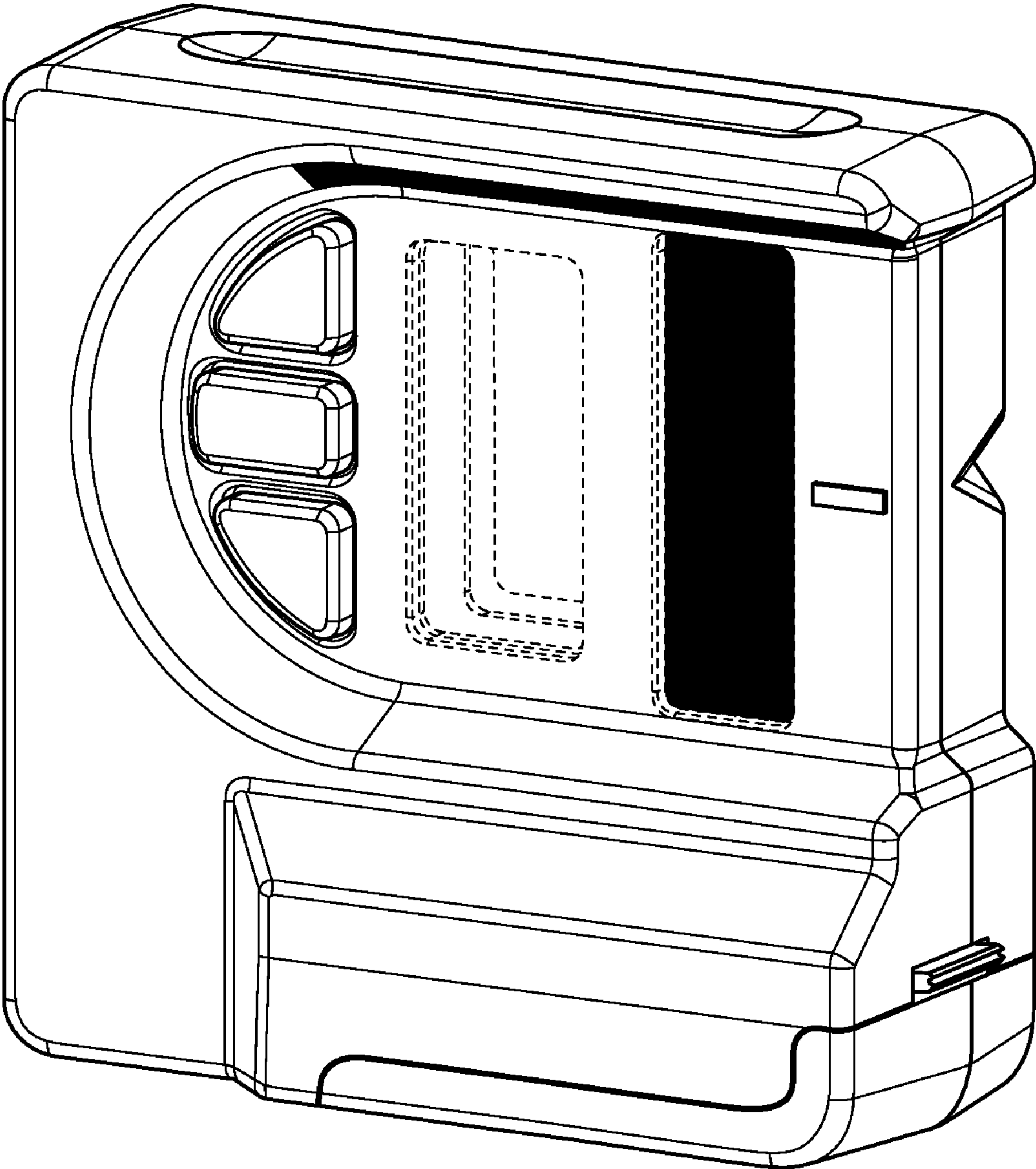

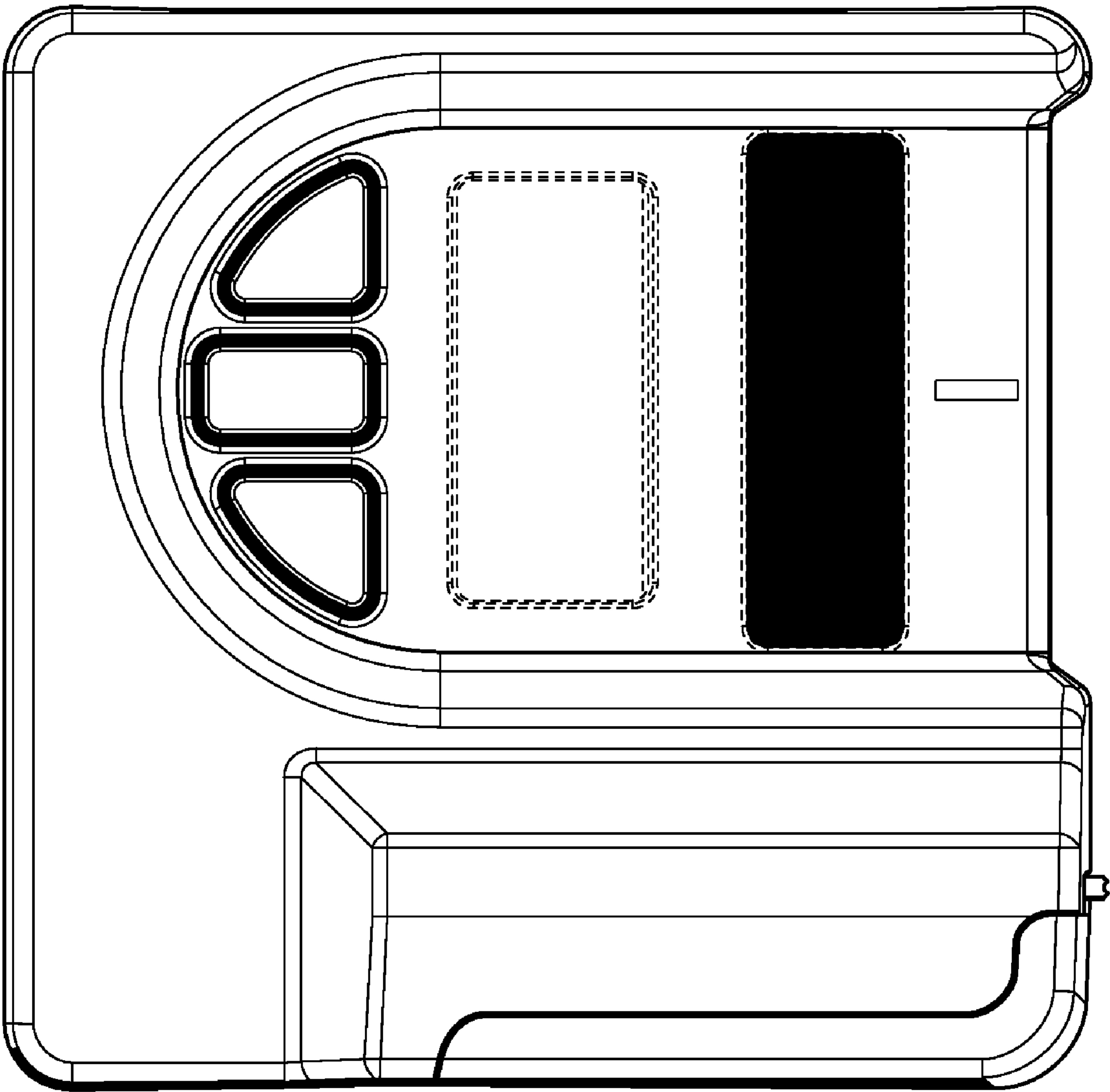

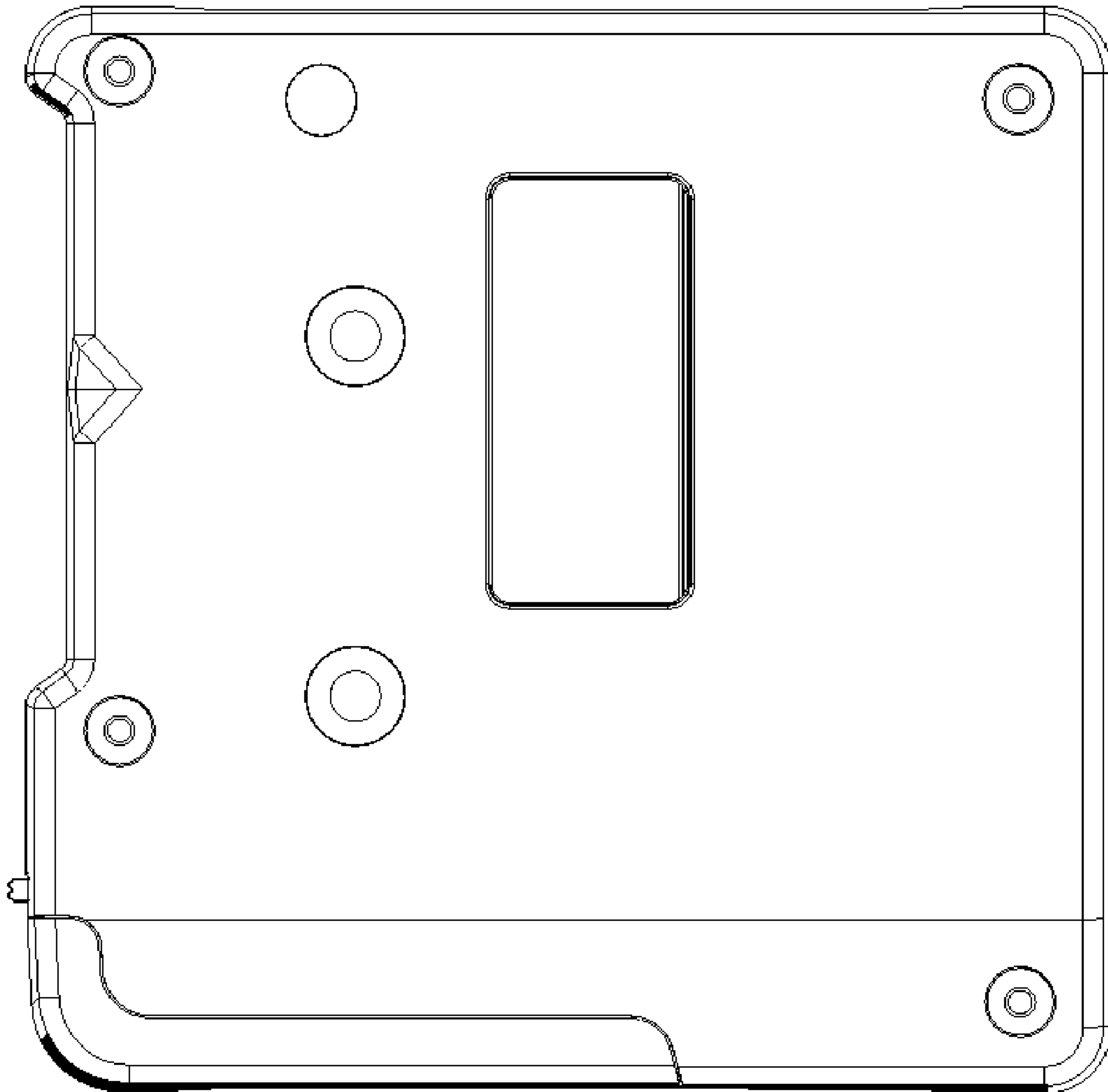

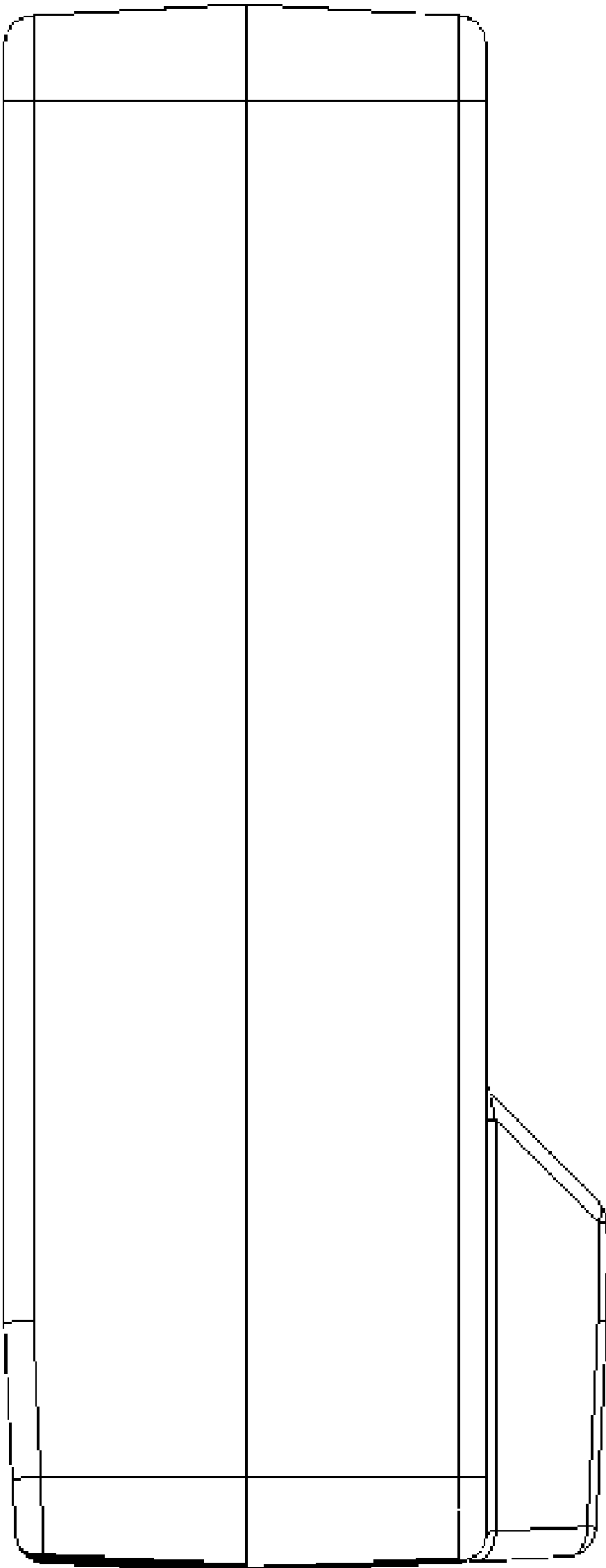

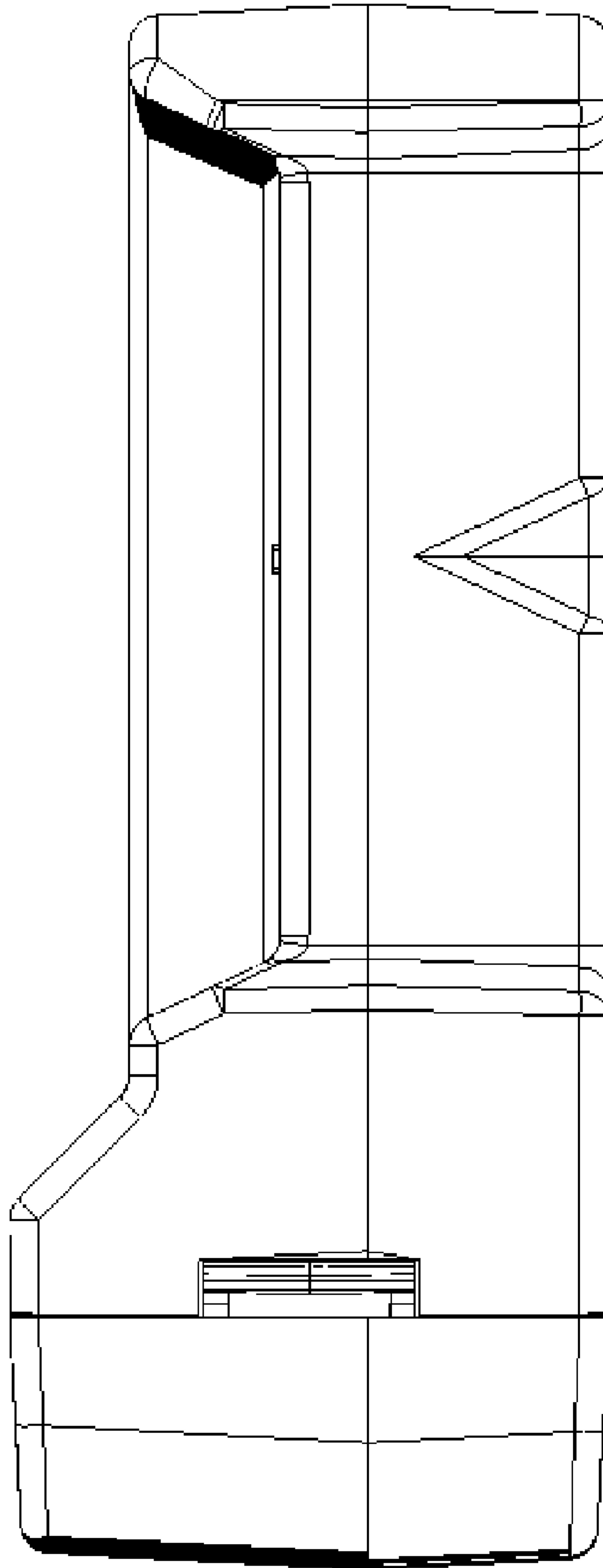

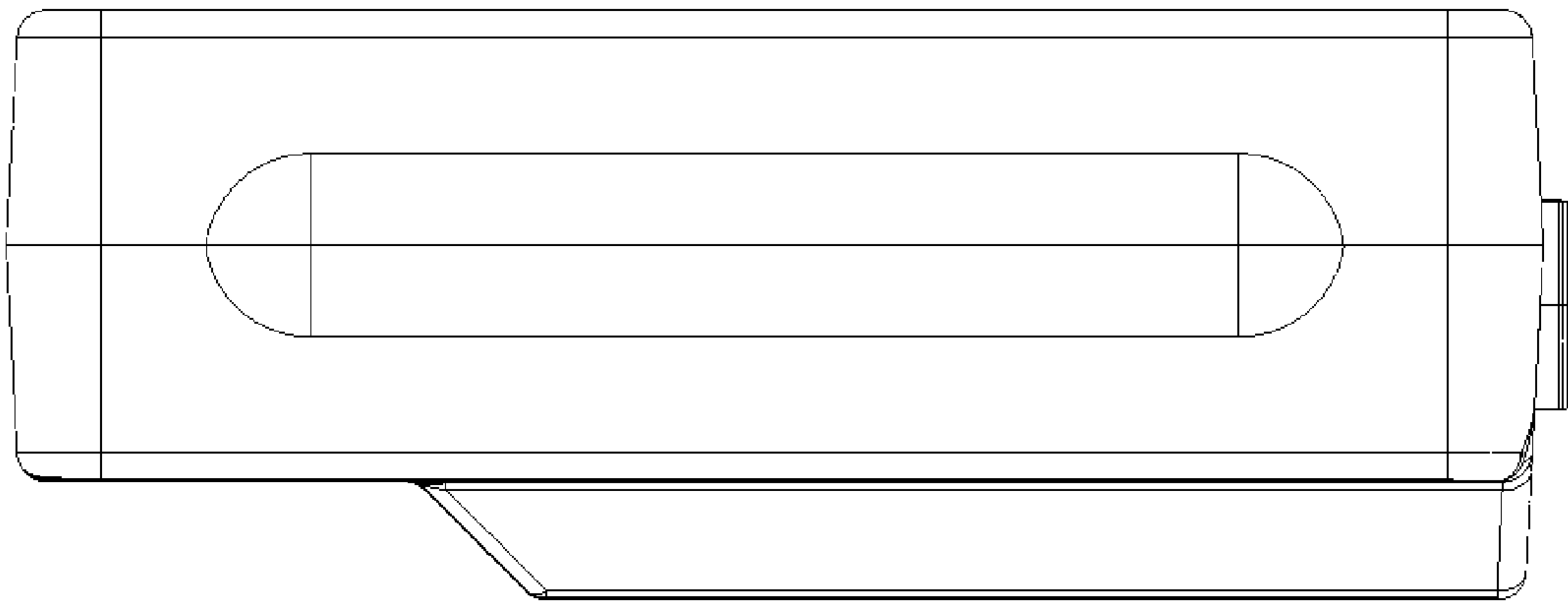

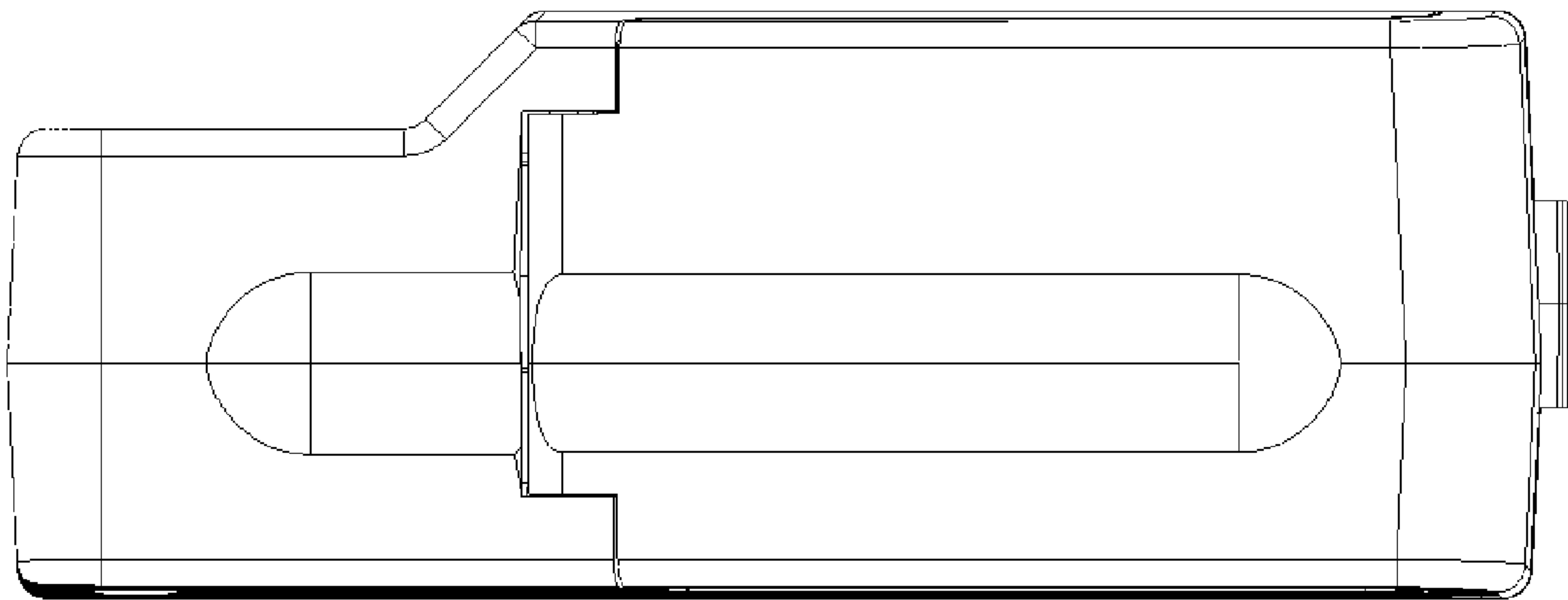
