(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an article of jewelry, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a Front elevational view of the article of jewelry showing my new design;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof; and,
