image thereof;

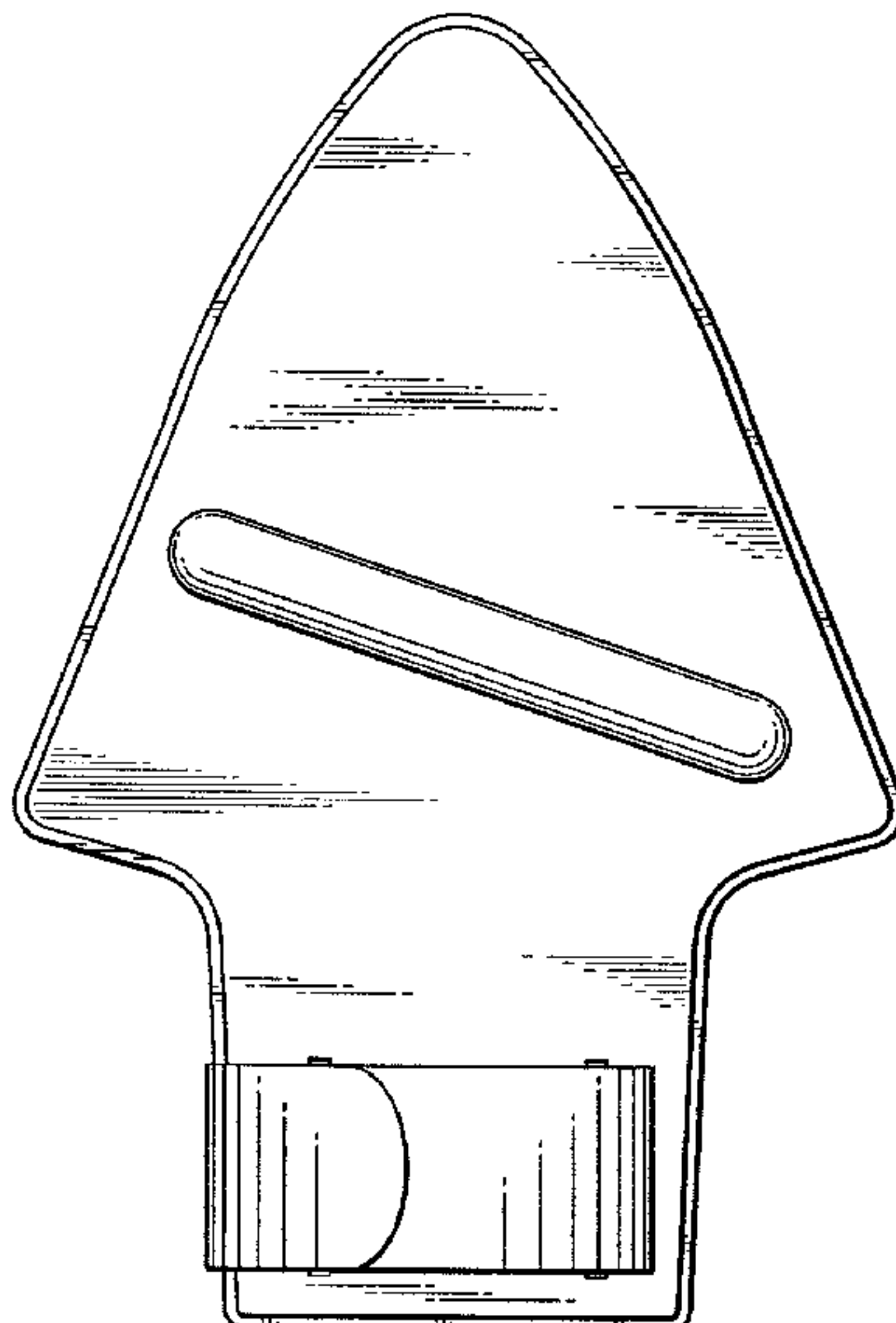
FIG. 4 is a front side view thereof;

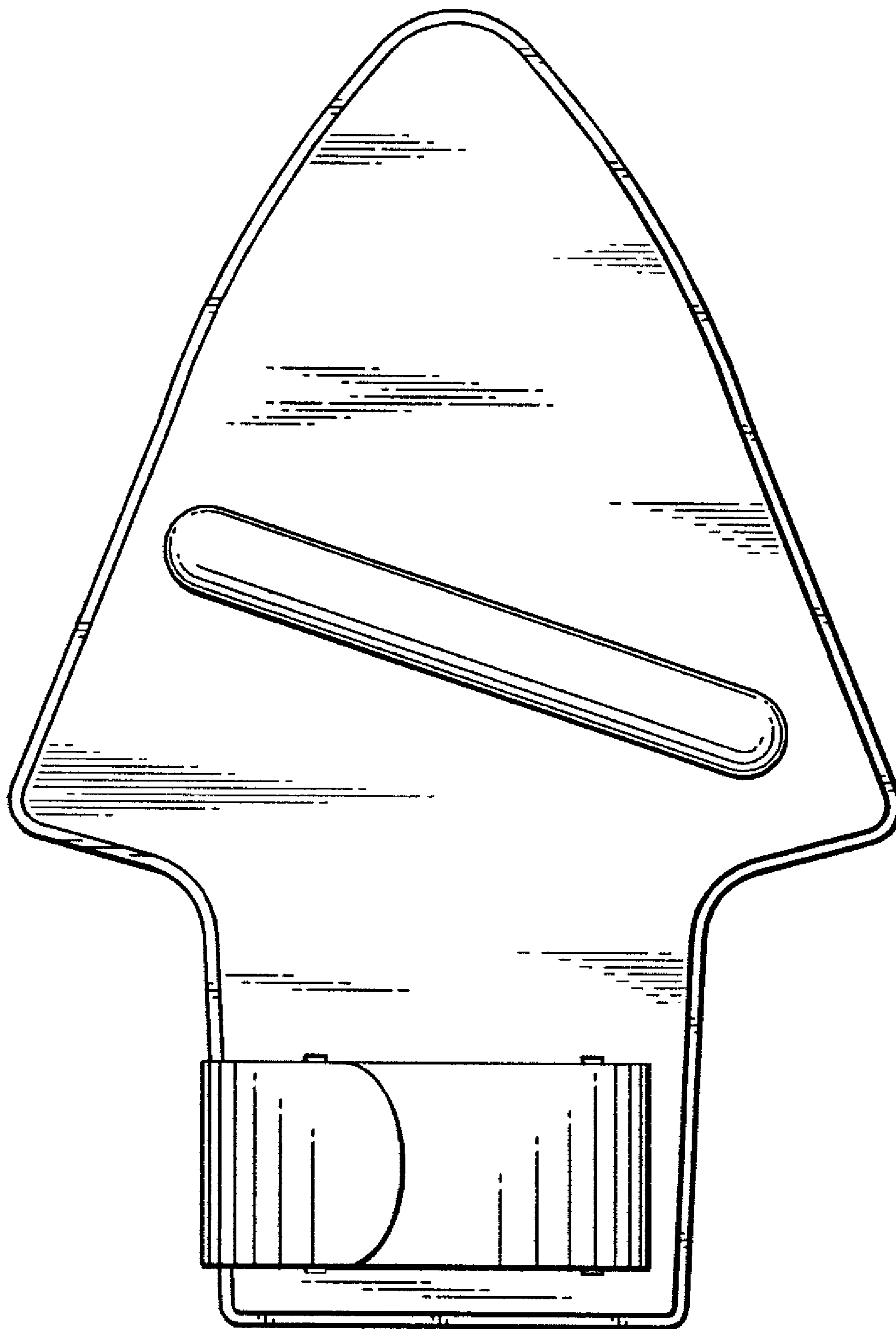

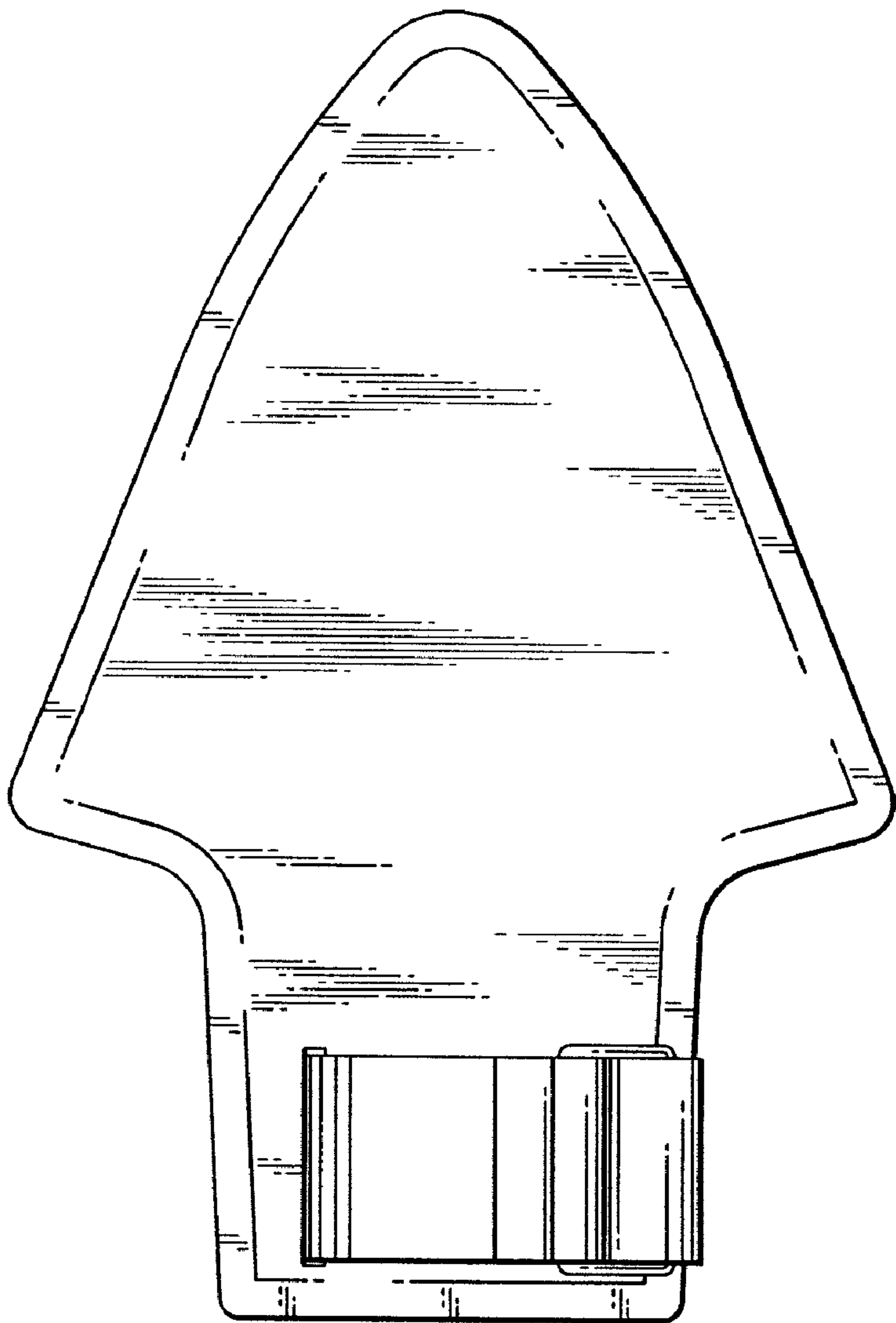

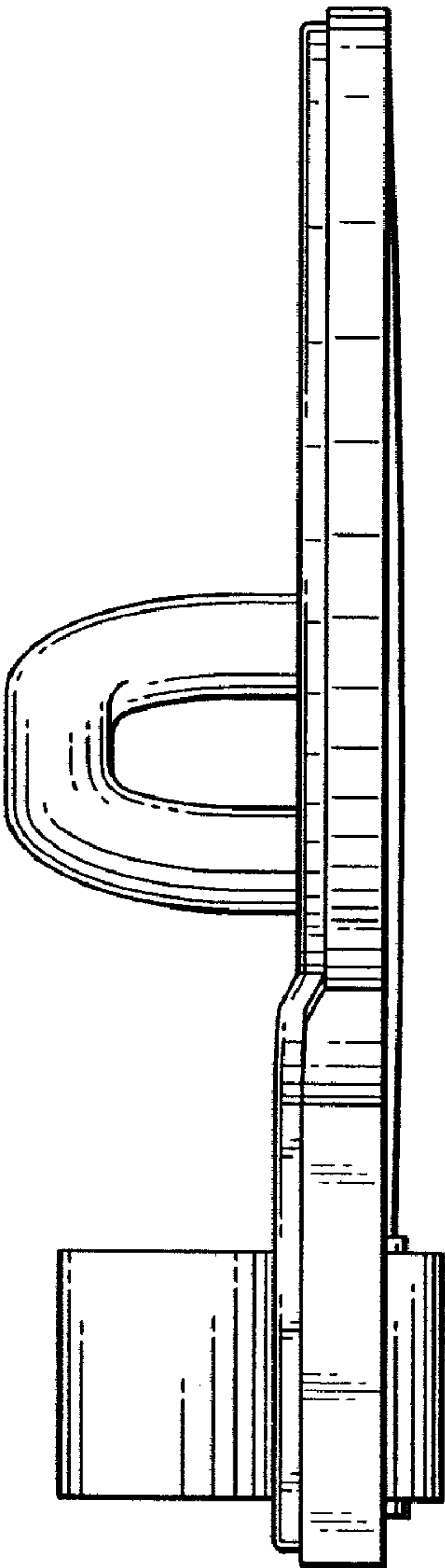

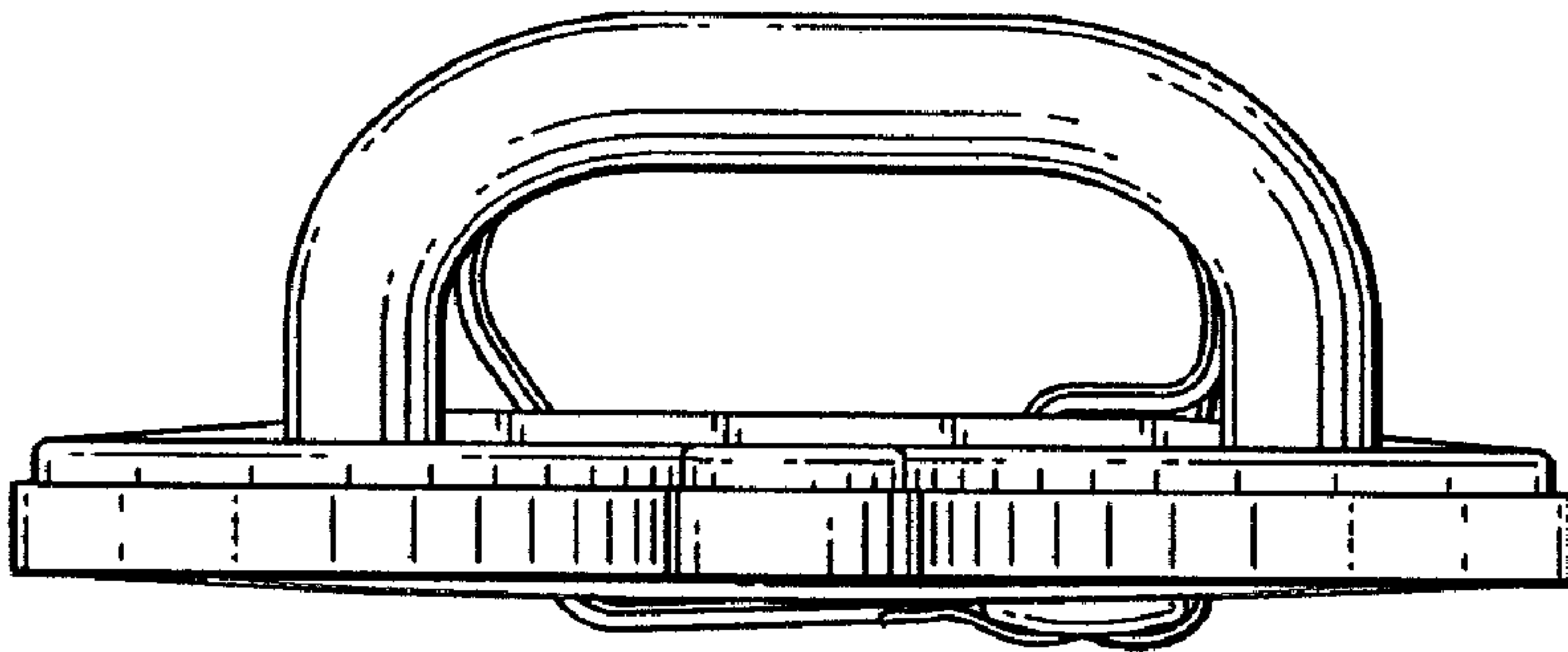

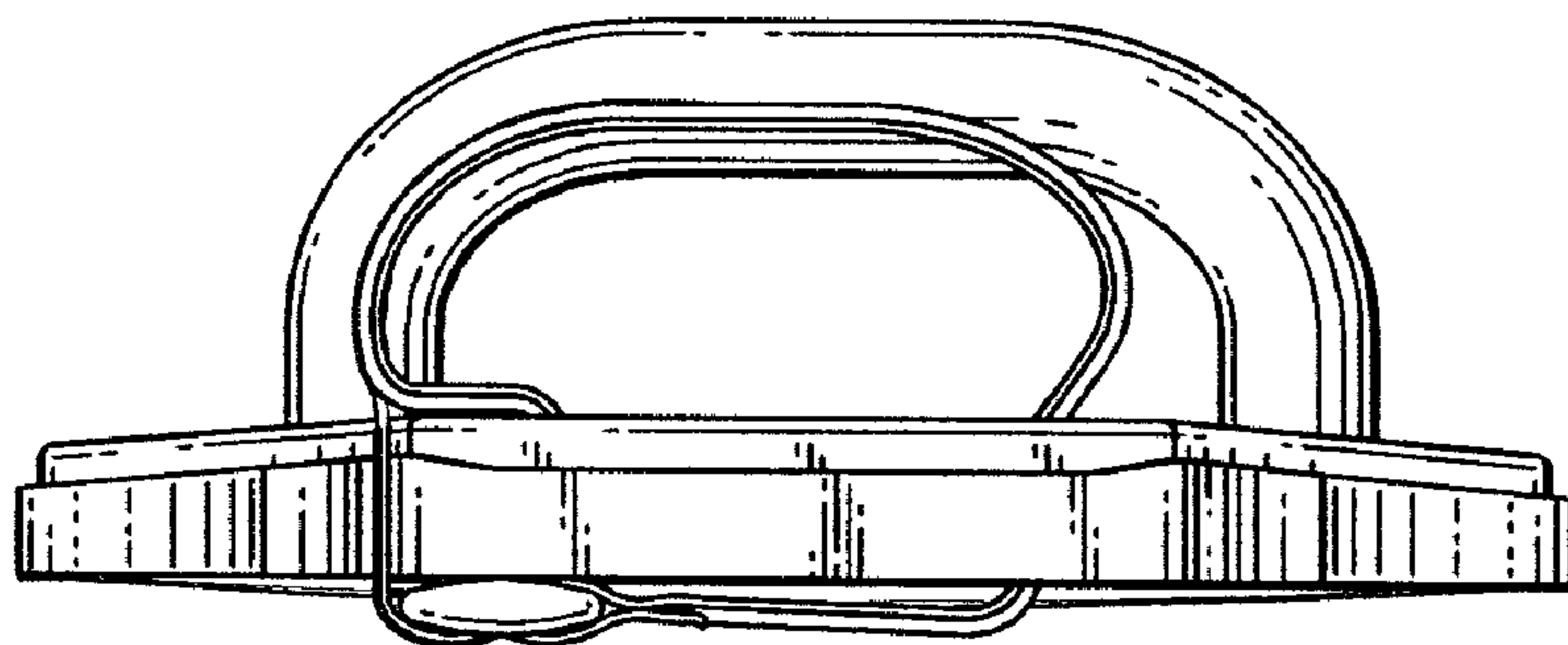

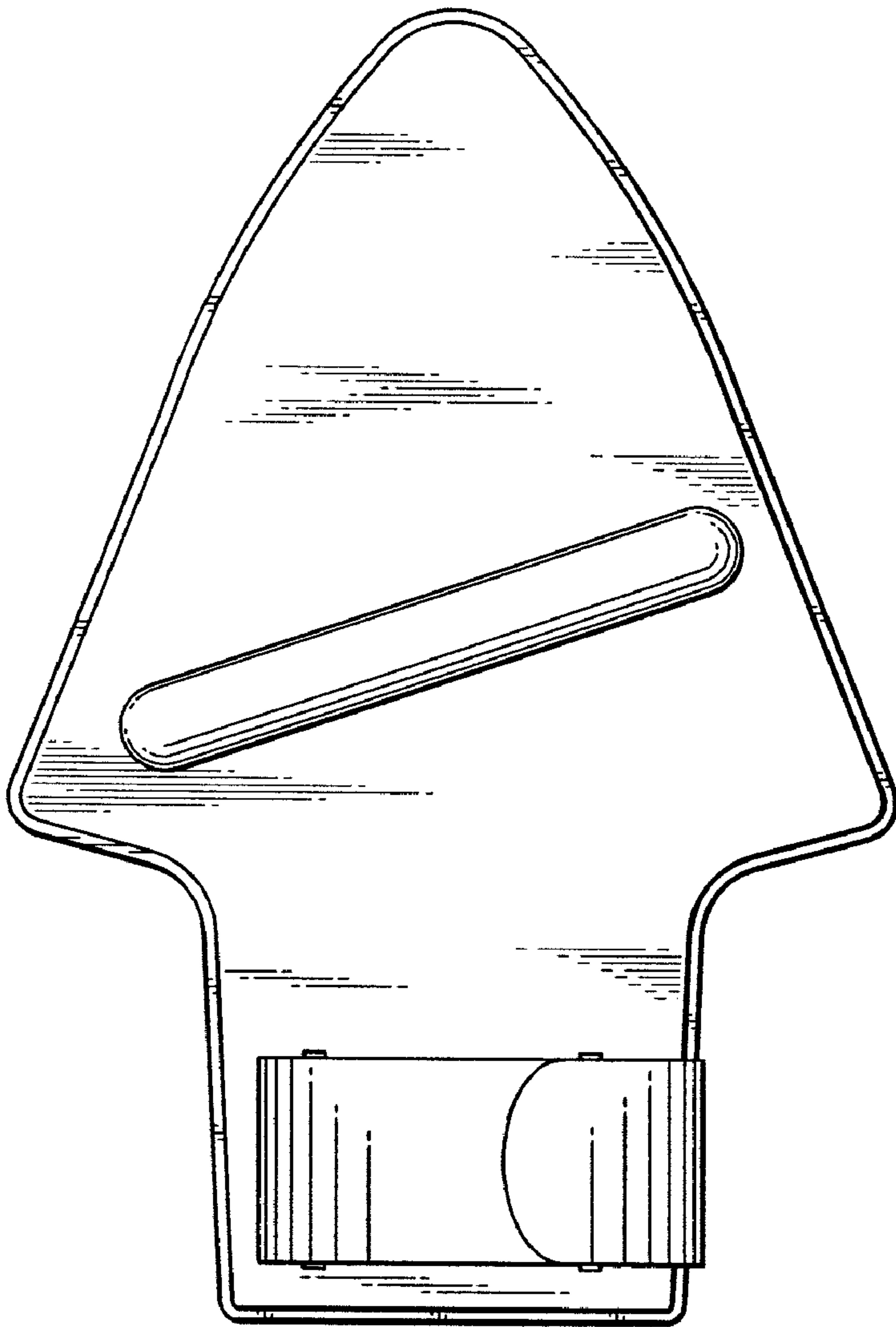

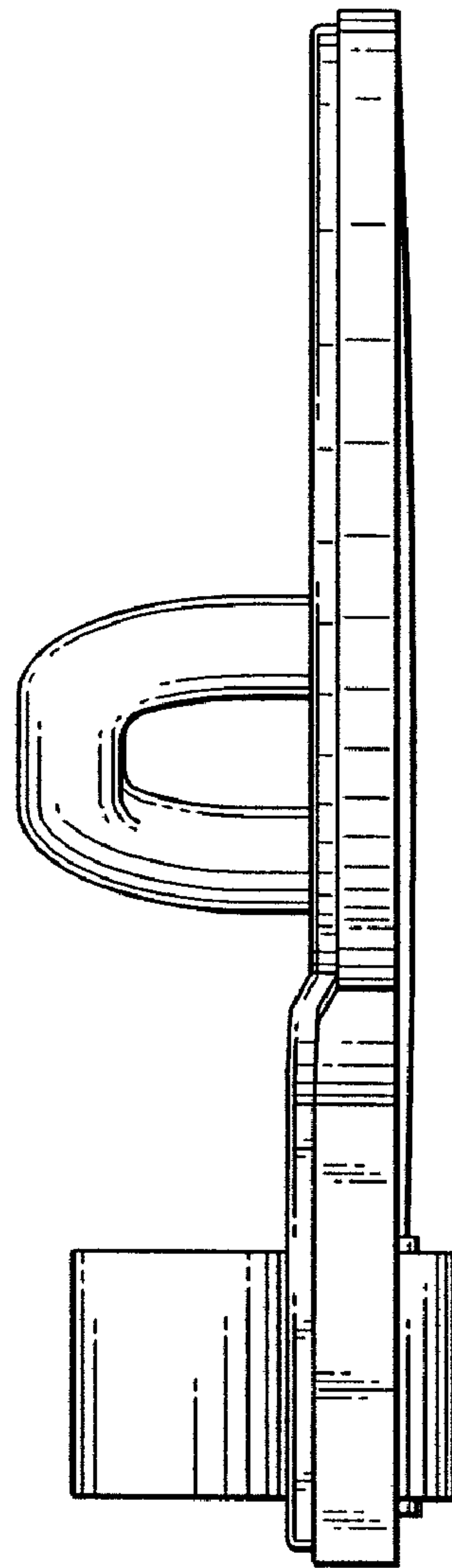
