FIG. 3 is a front view thereof, the opposite rear side being mirror image thereof;

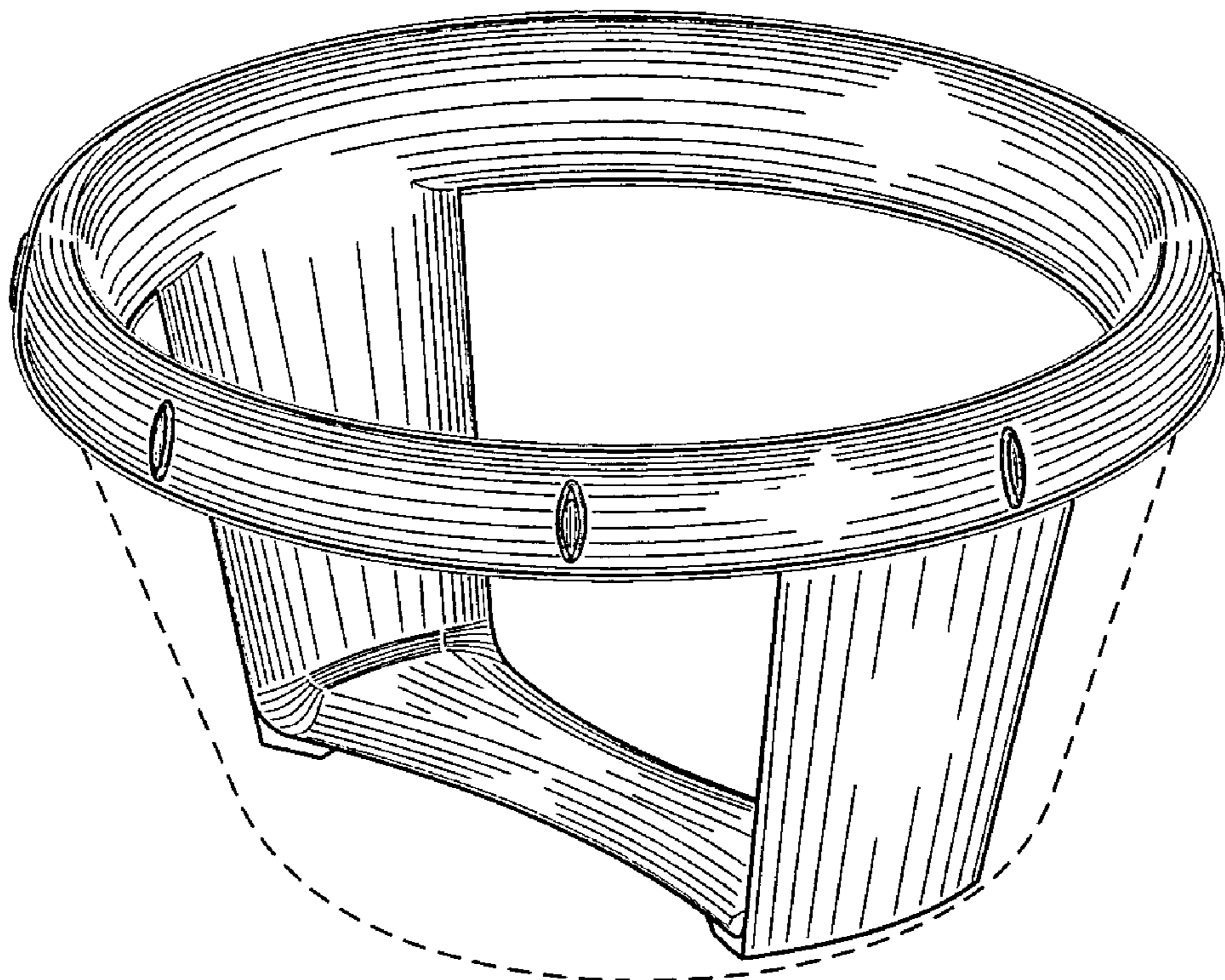
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;

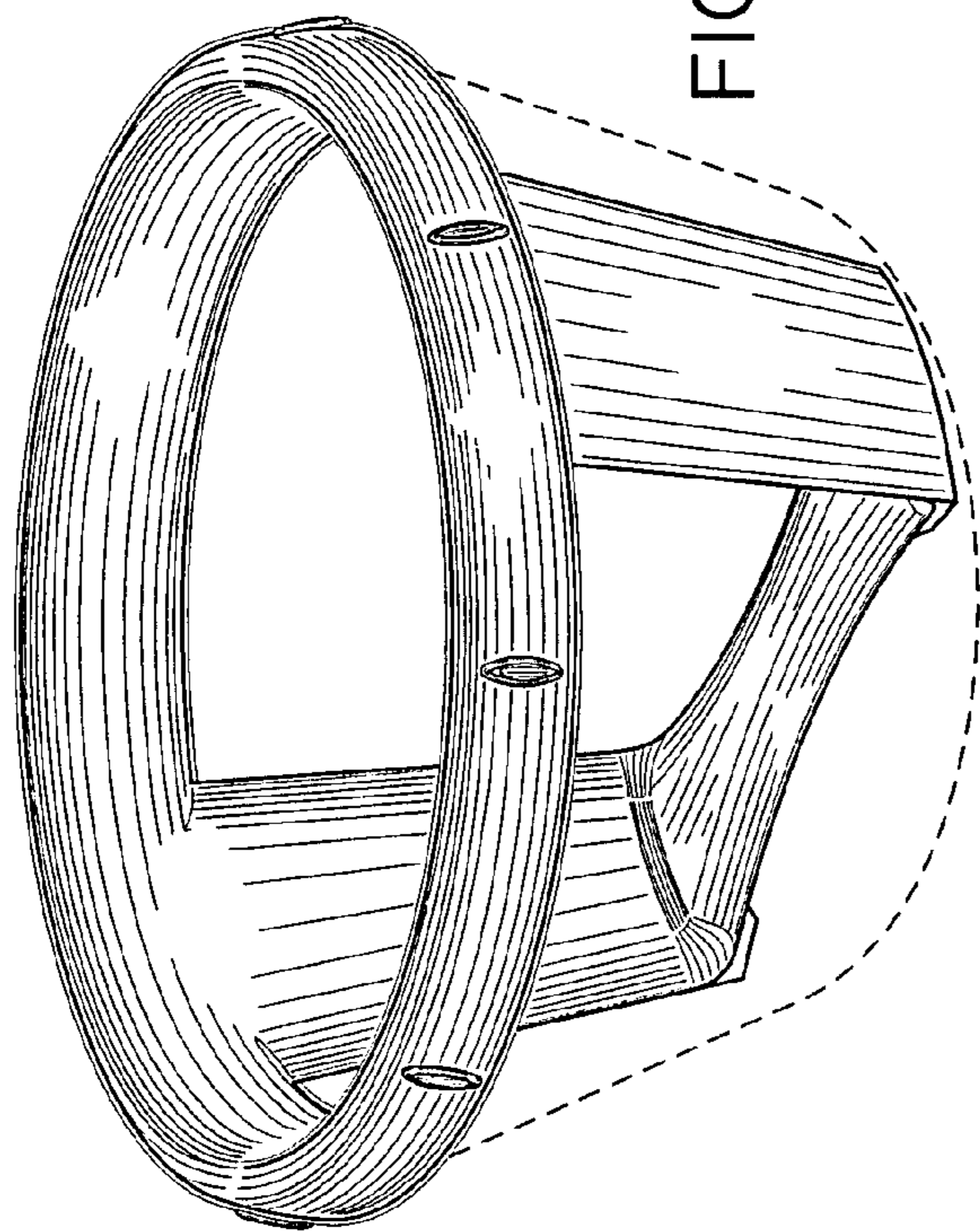

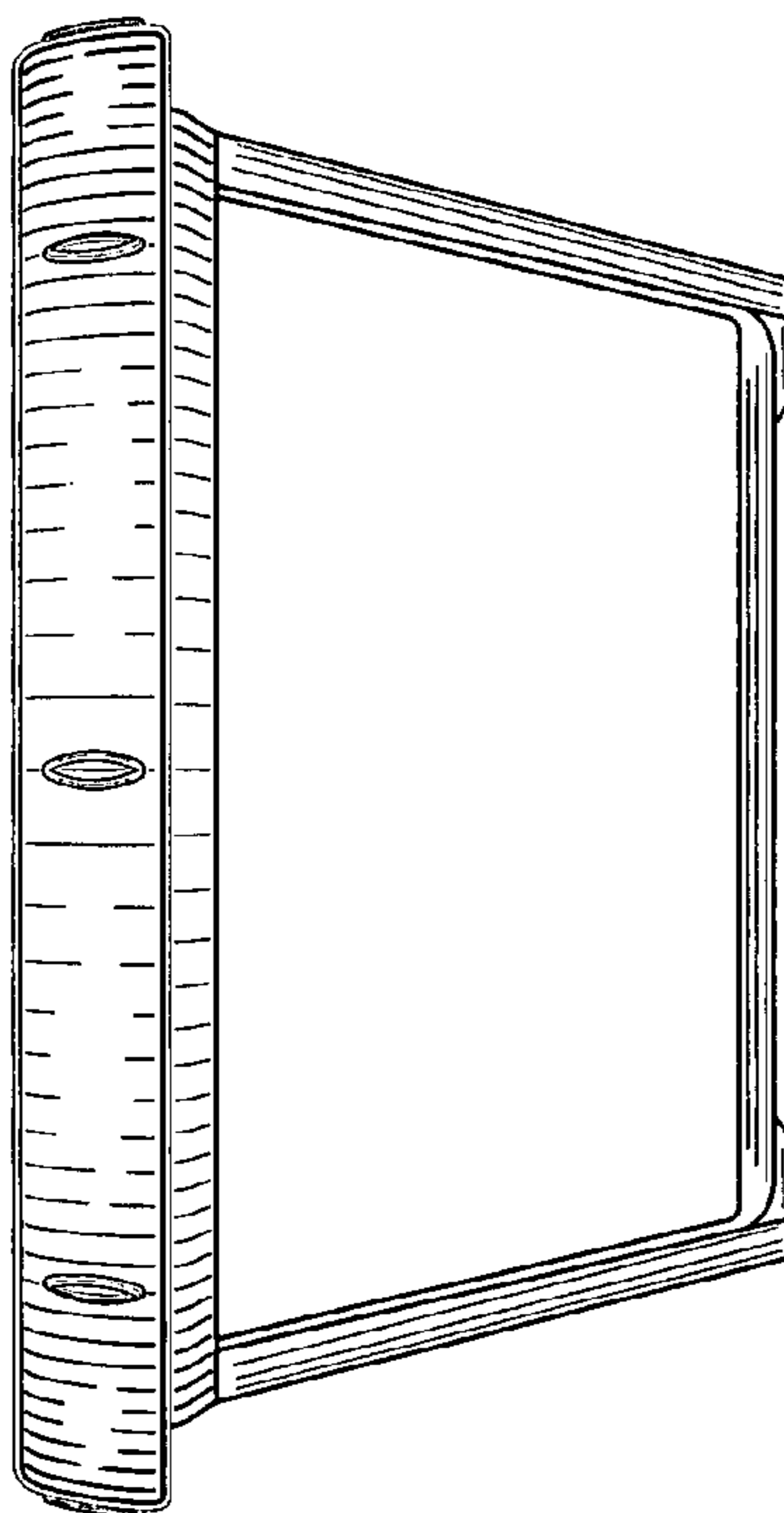

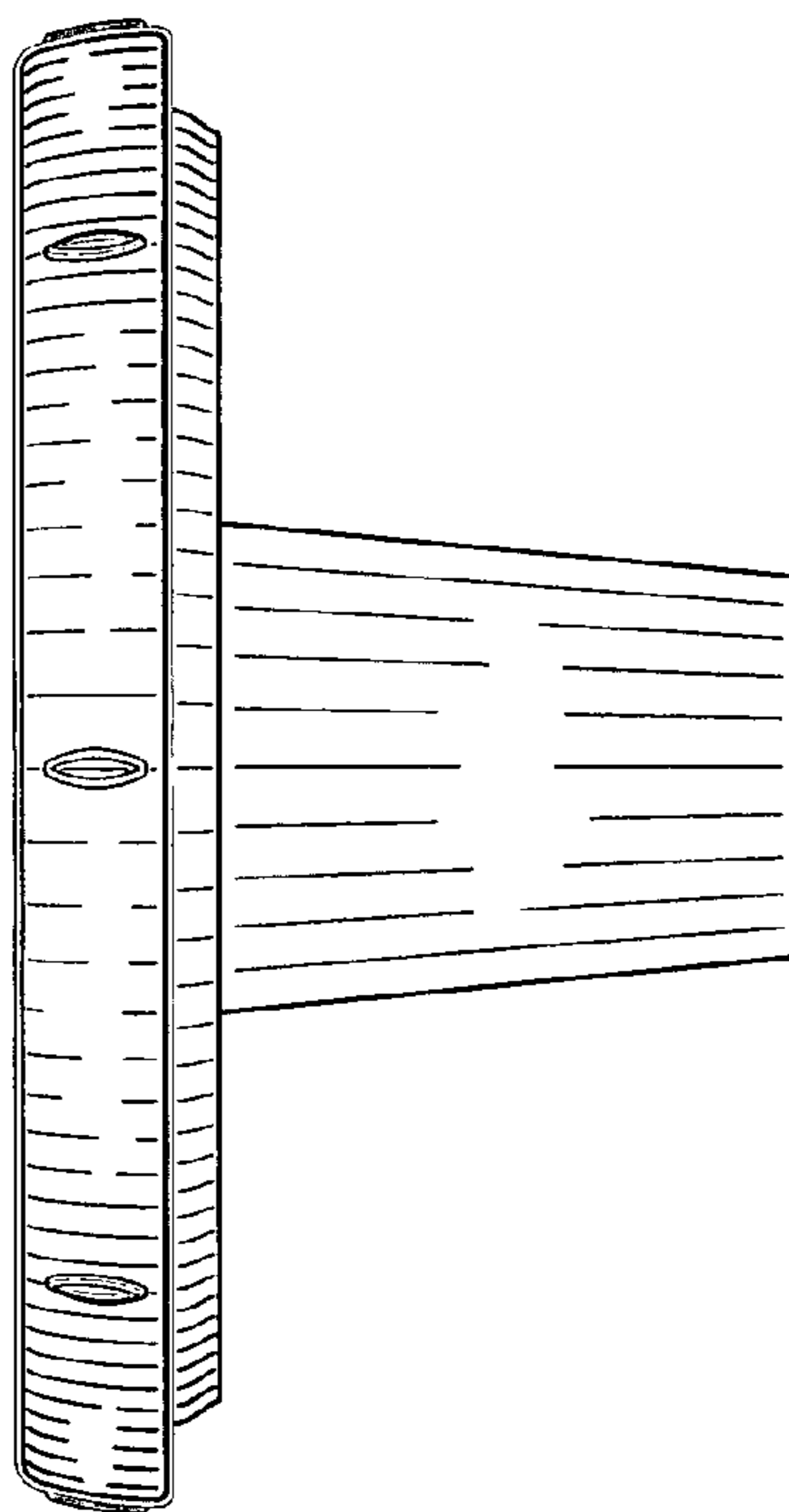

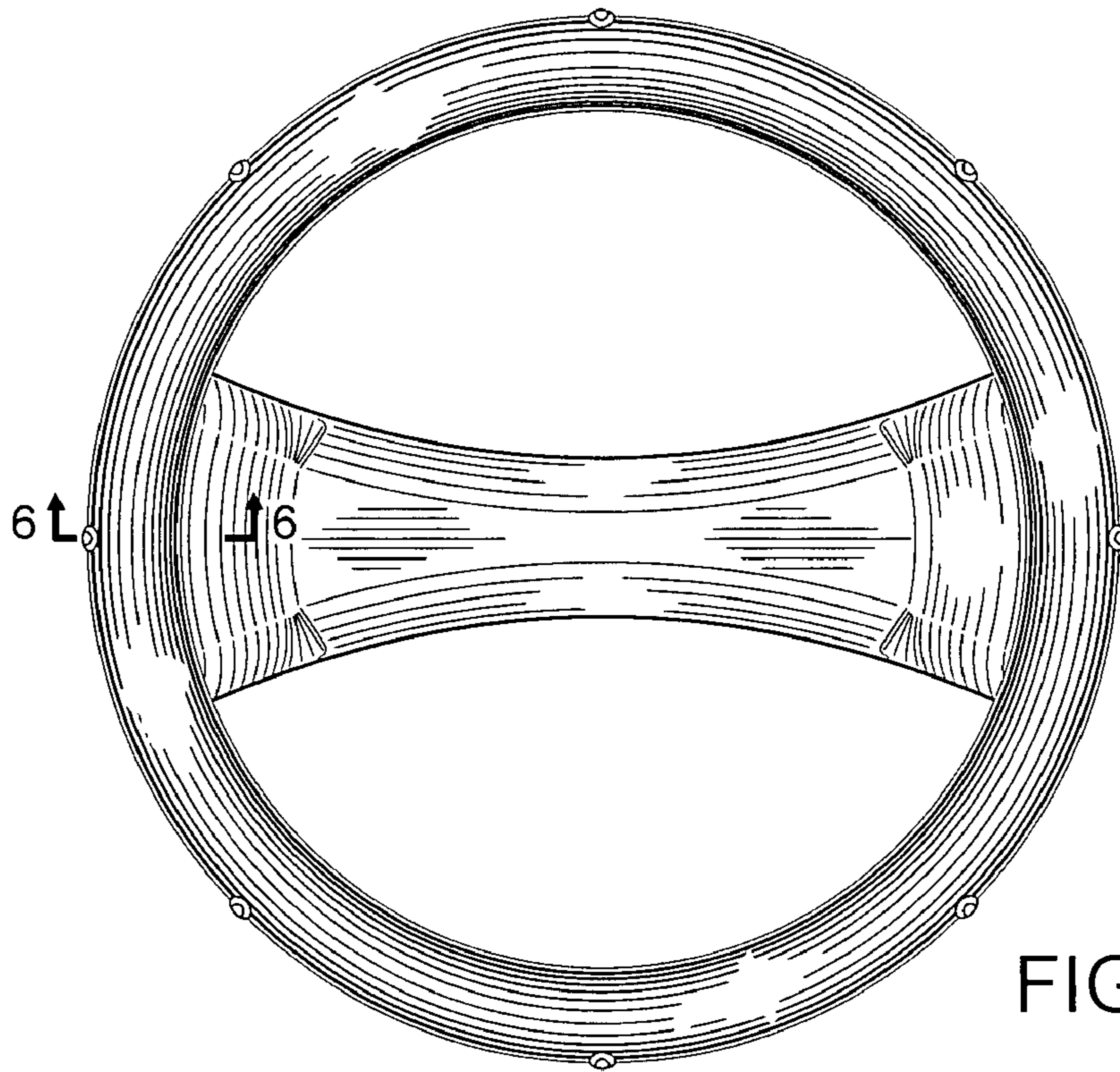

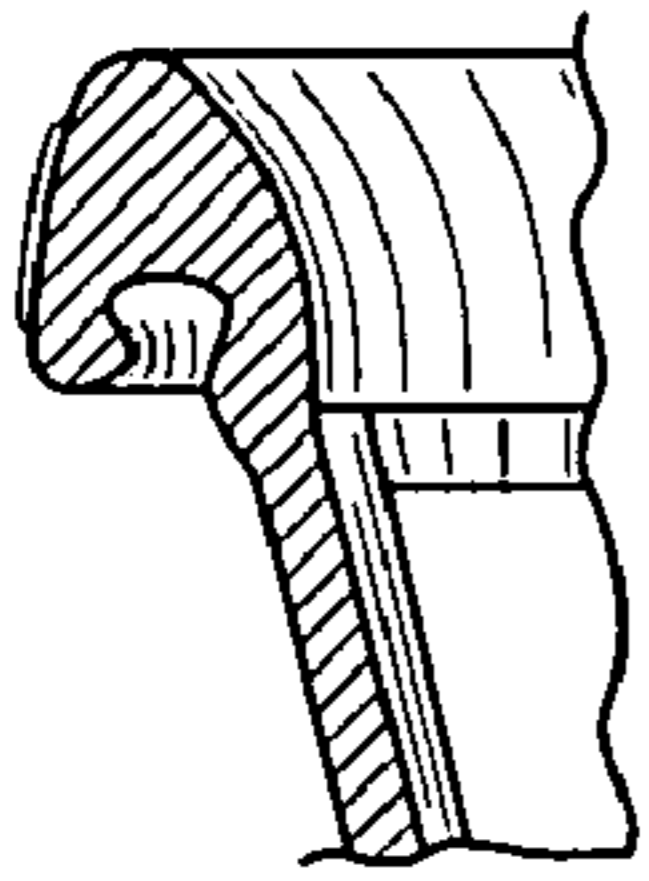

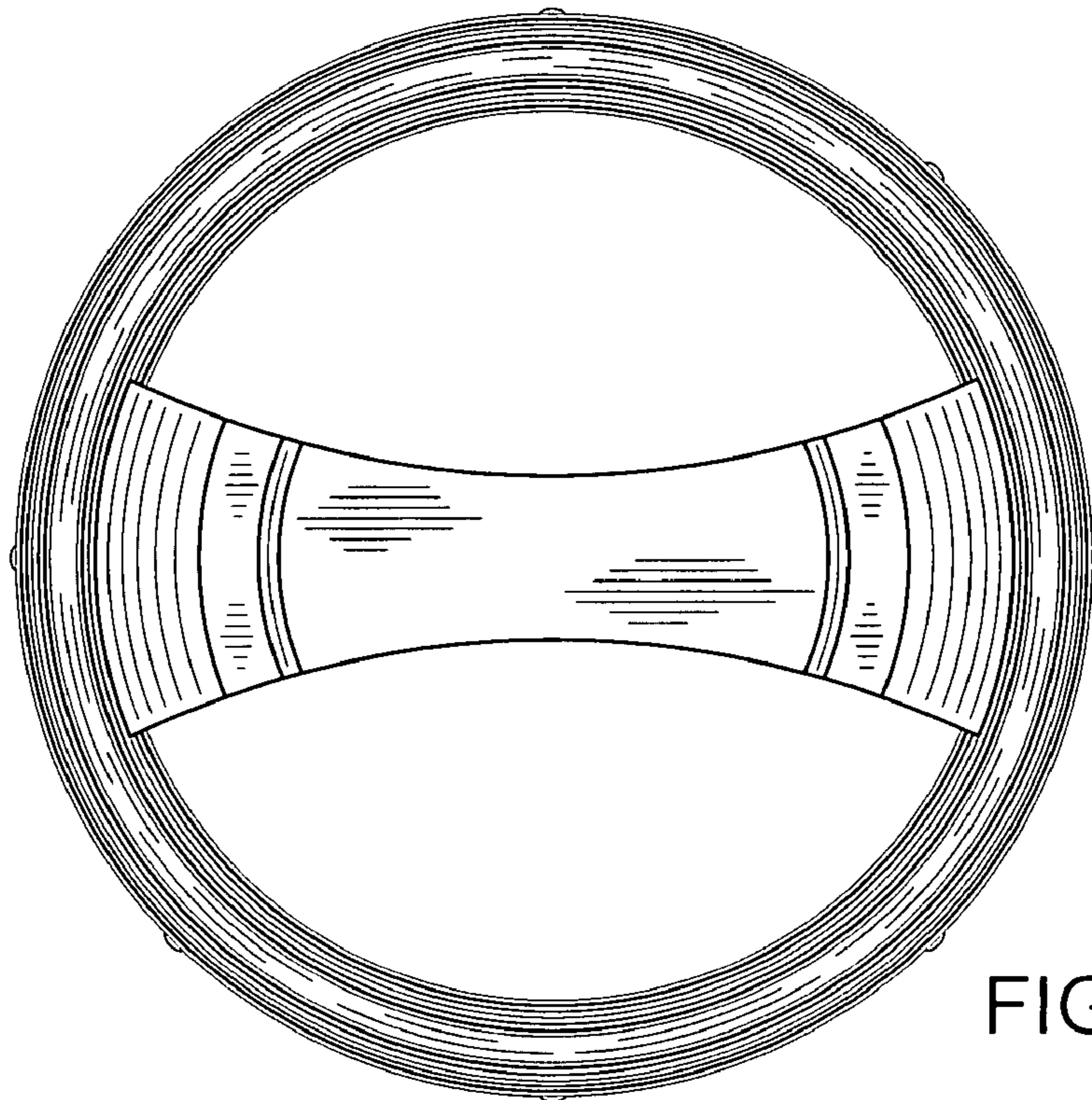
