FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view of the exterior vehicle mirror assembly design;

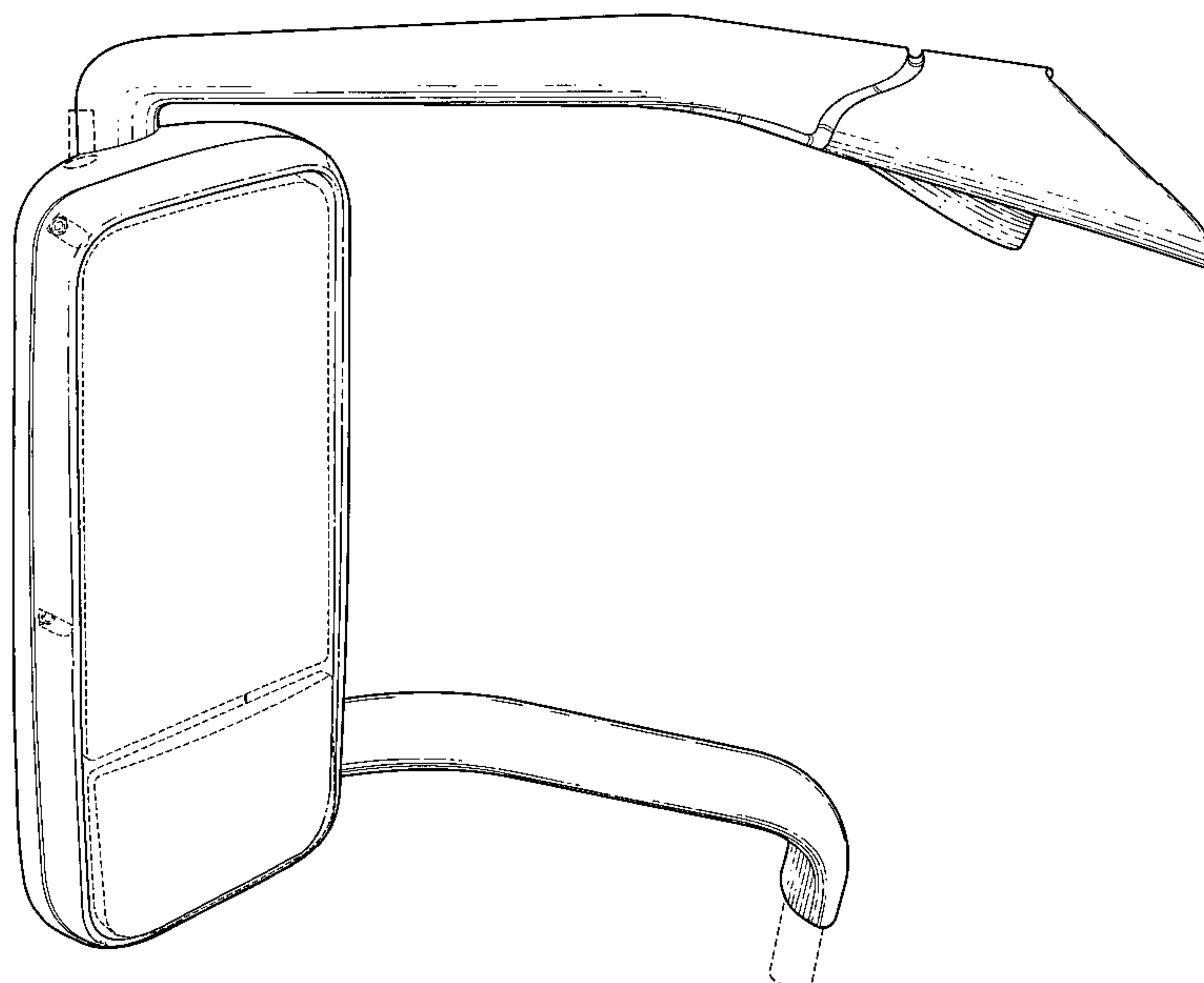
FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view of the exterior vehicle mirror assembly design;

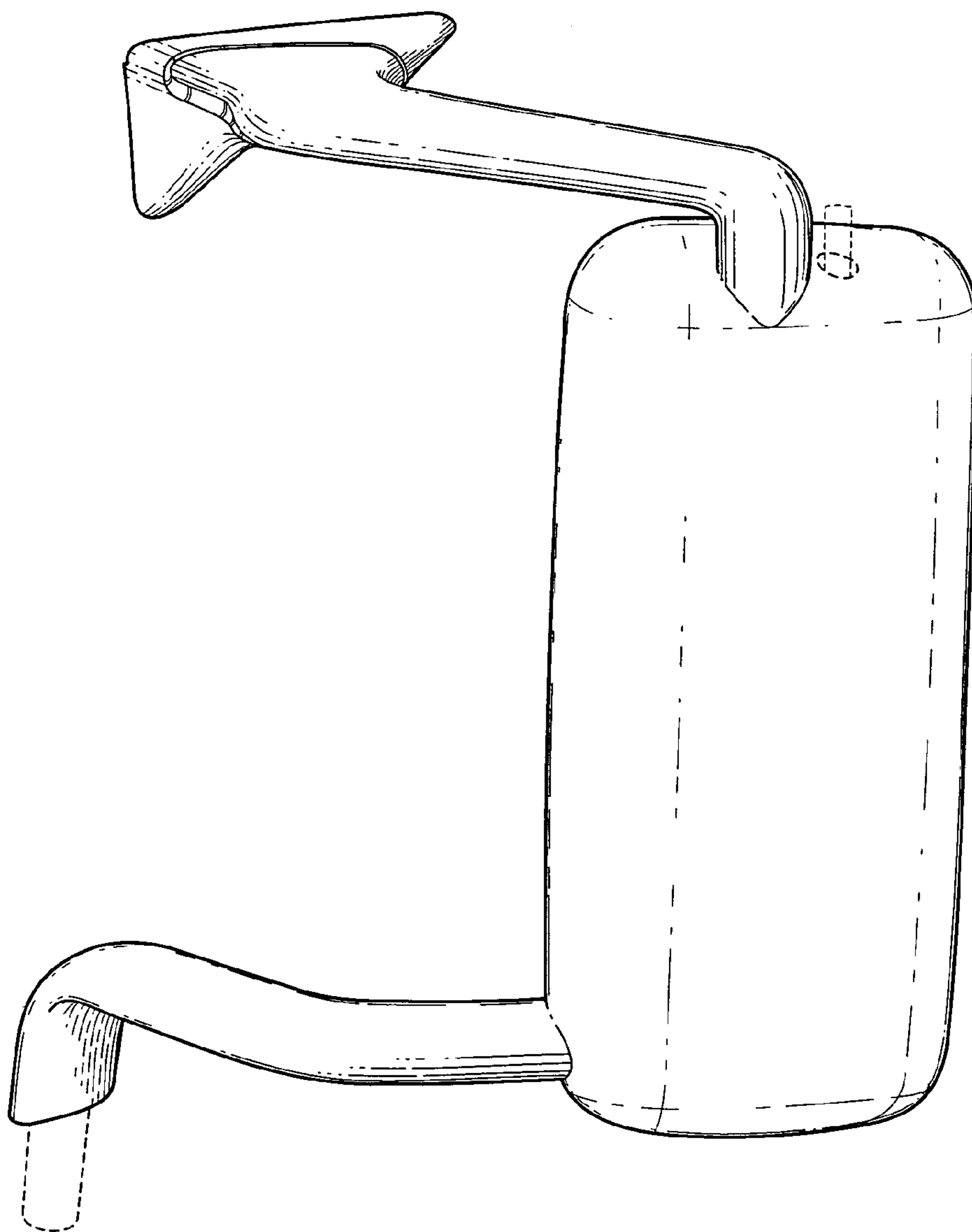

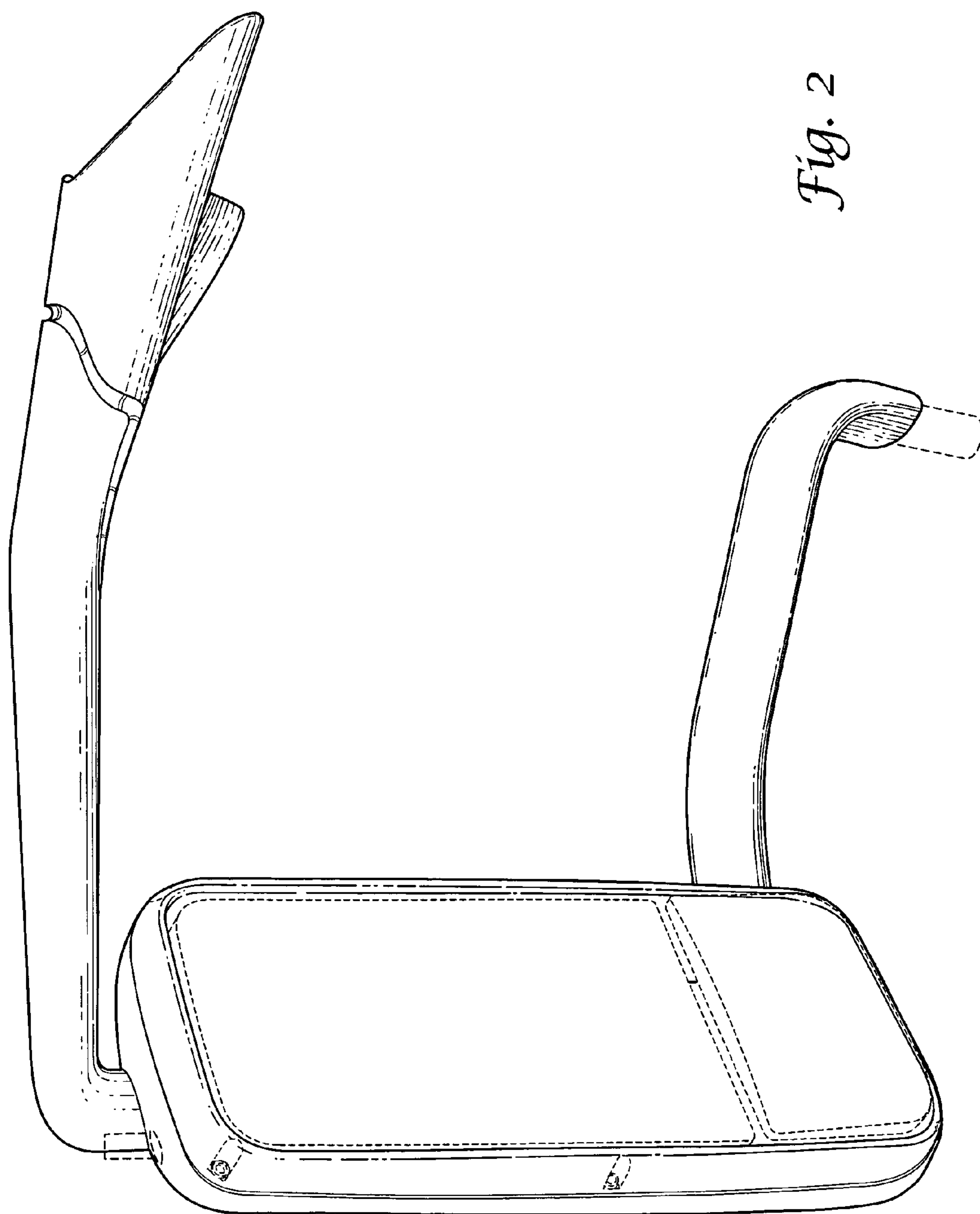

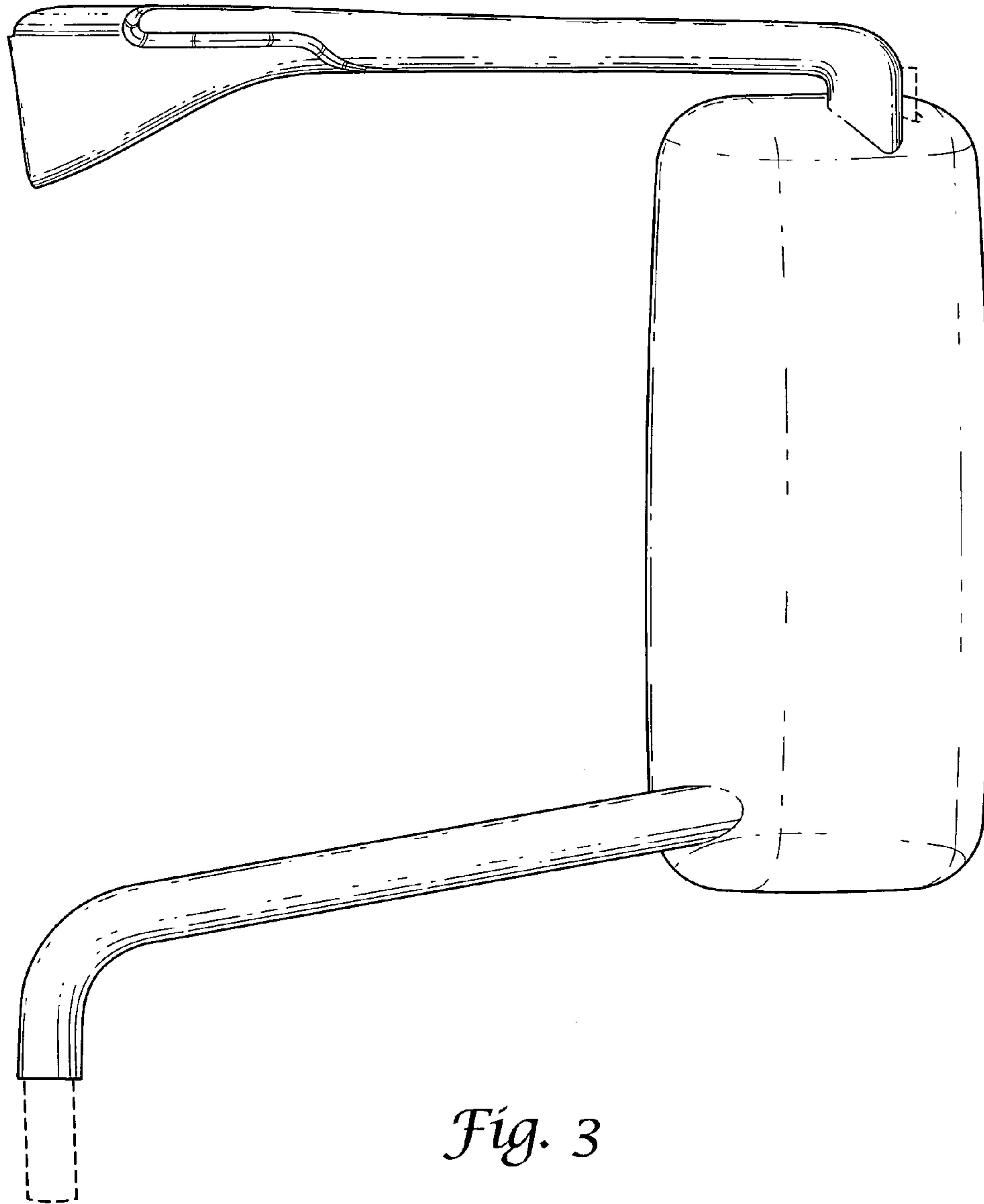

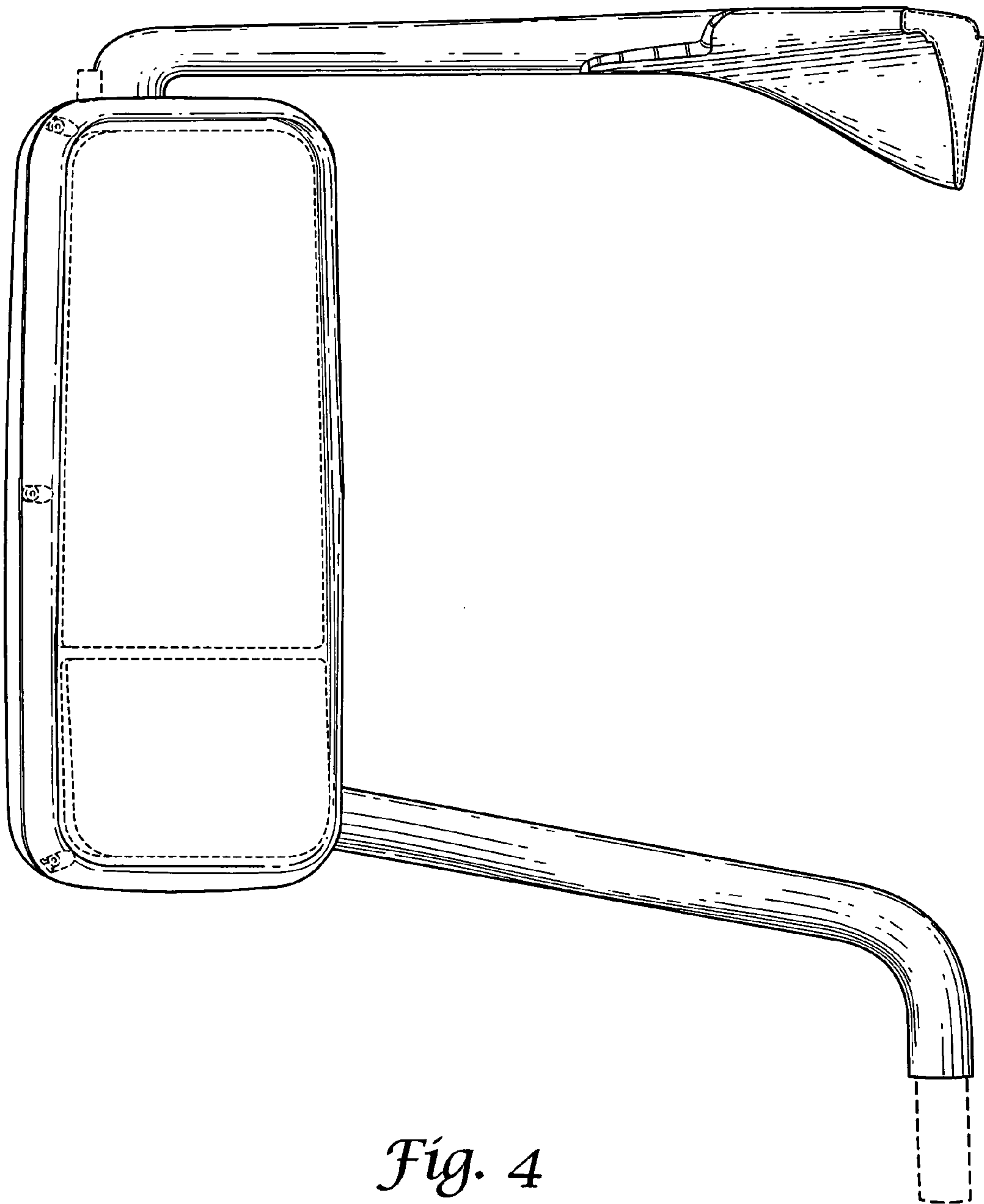

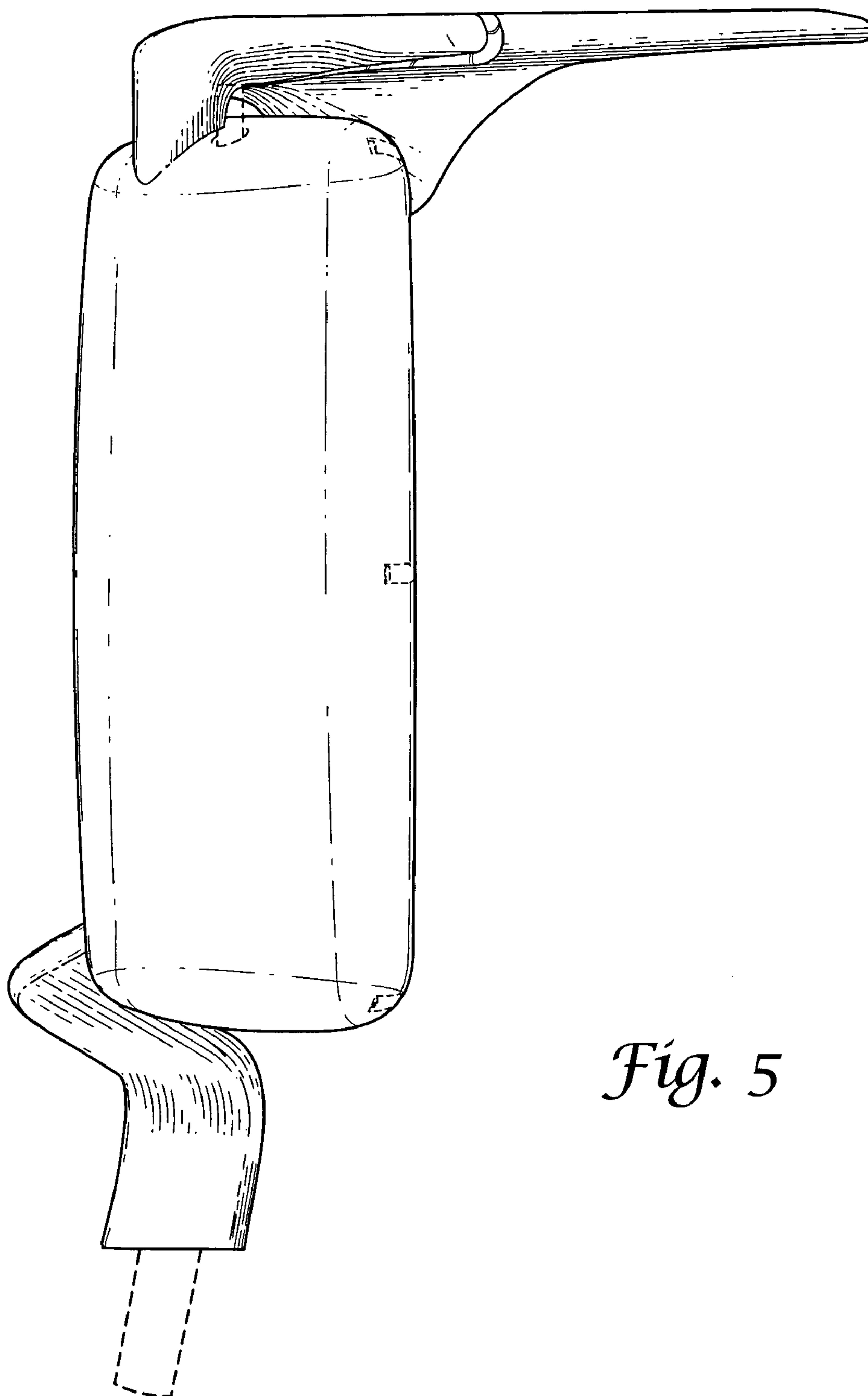

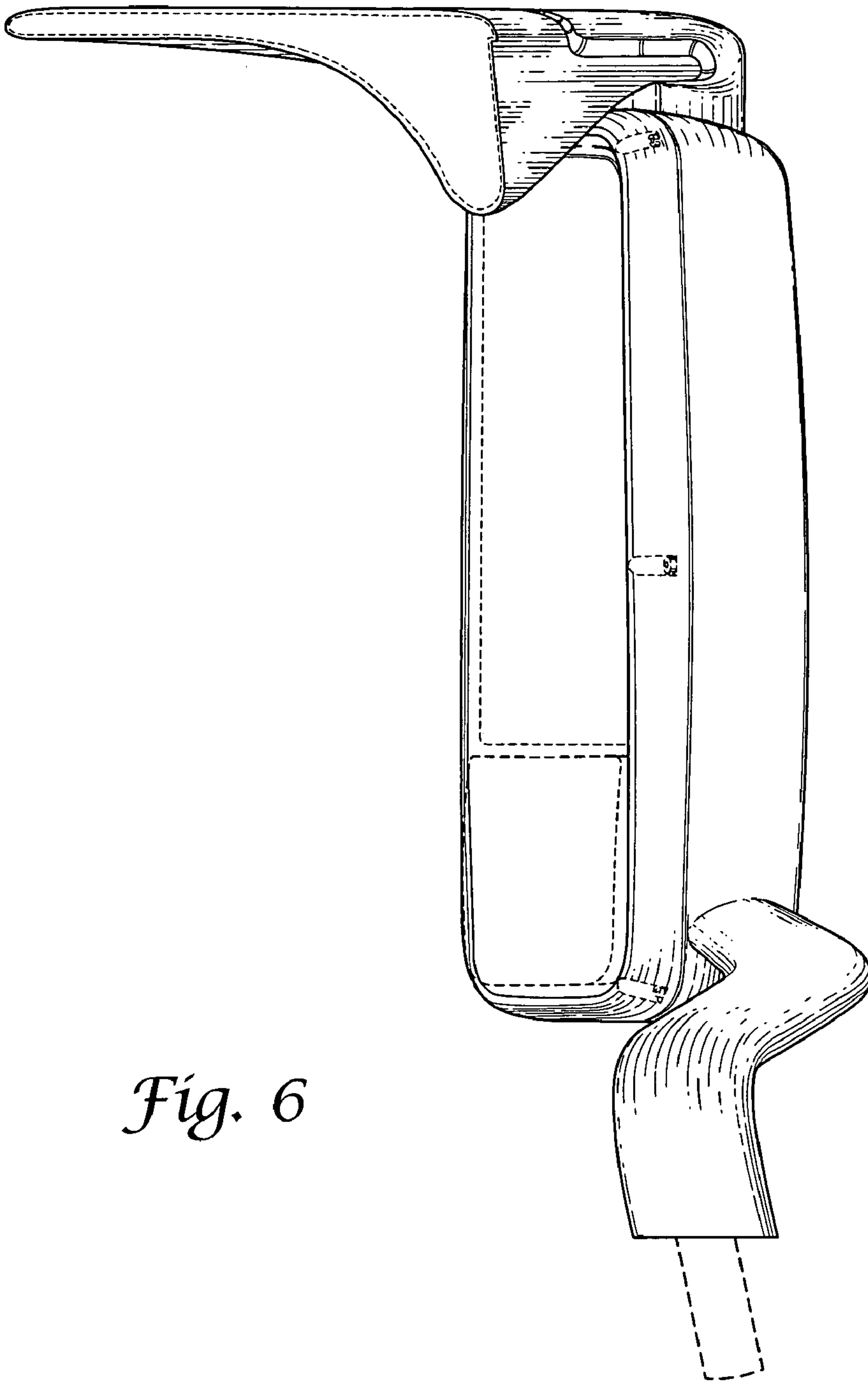
