(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an ornamental surface pattern for a five card Omaha casino table, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a first embodiment of a surface pattern for a casino table game;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged fragmentary view of the first embodiment of the surface pattern for a casino table game, as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of a surface pattern for a casino table game;

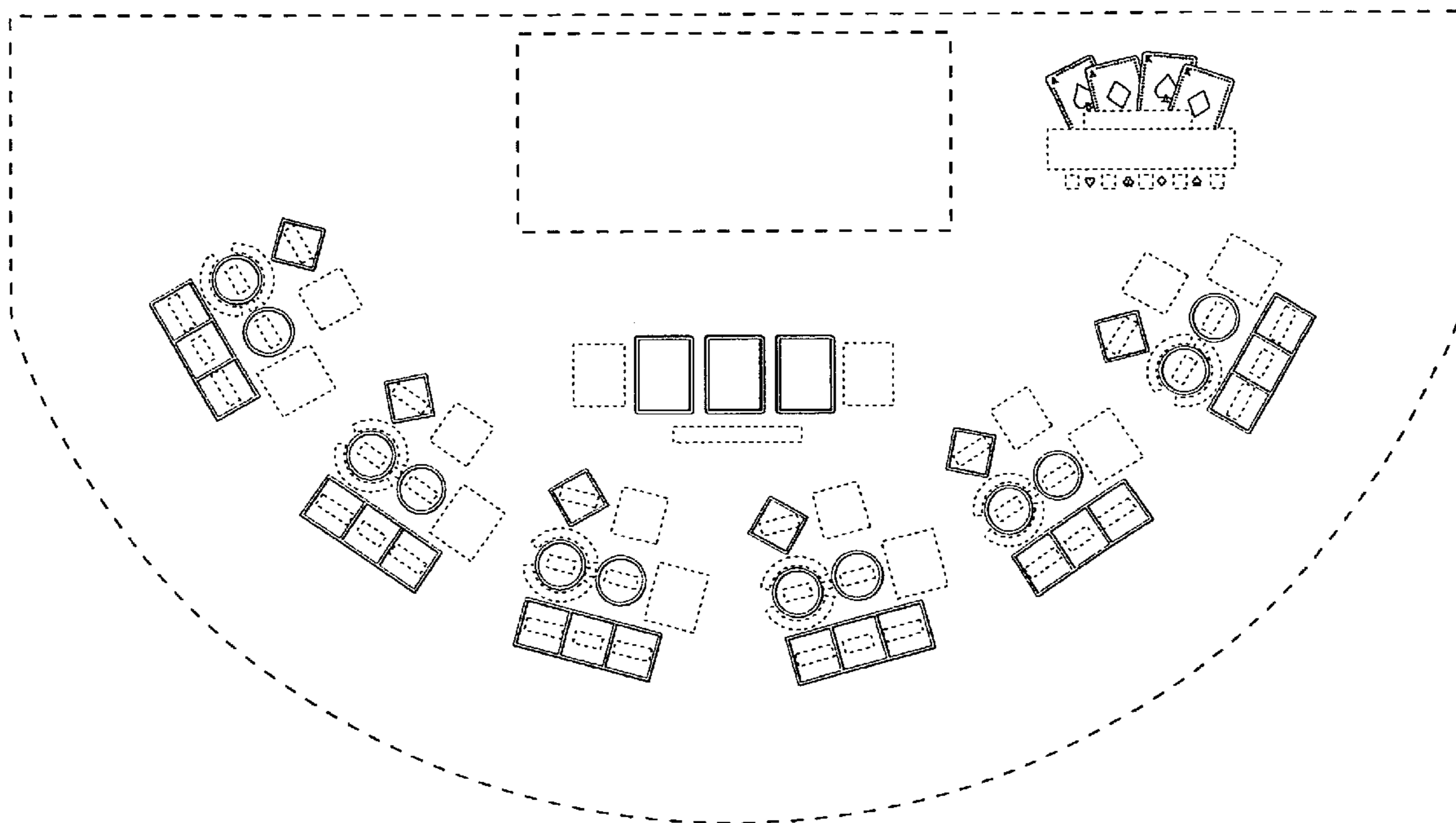
FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary view of the second embodiment of the surface pattern for a casino table game, as shown in FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary view of another ornamental portion of the surface pattern for the second embodiment of a casino table game, as shown in FIG. 3; and,

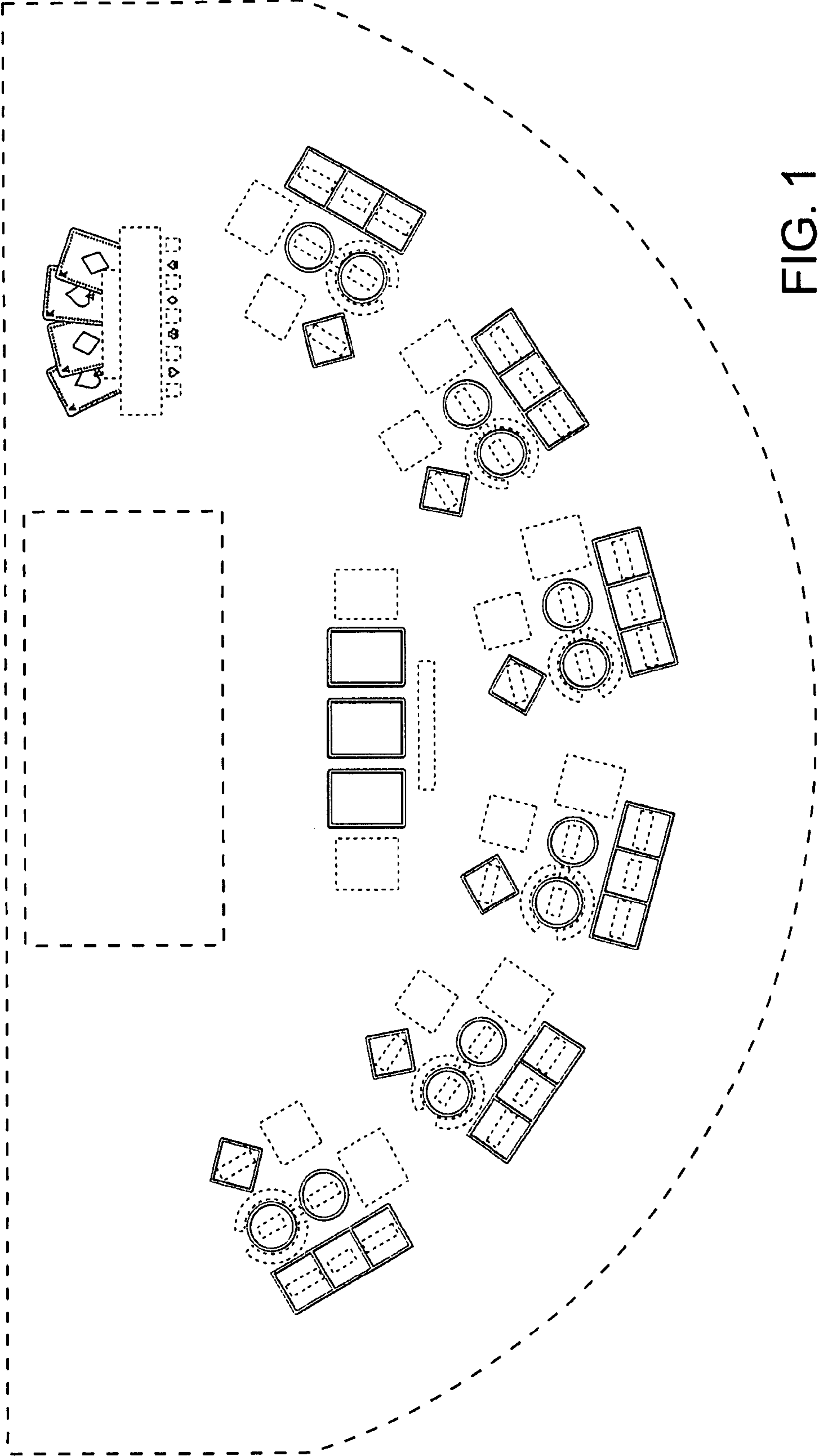

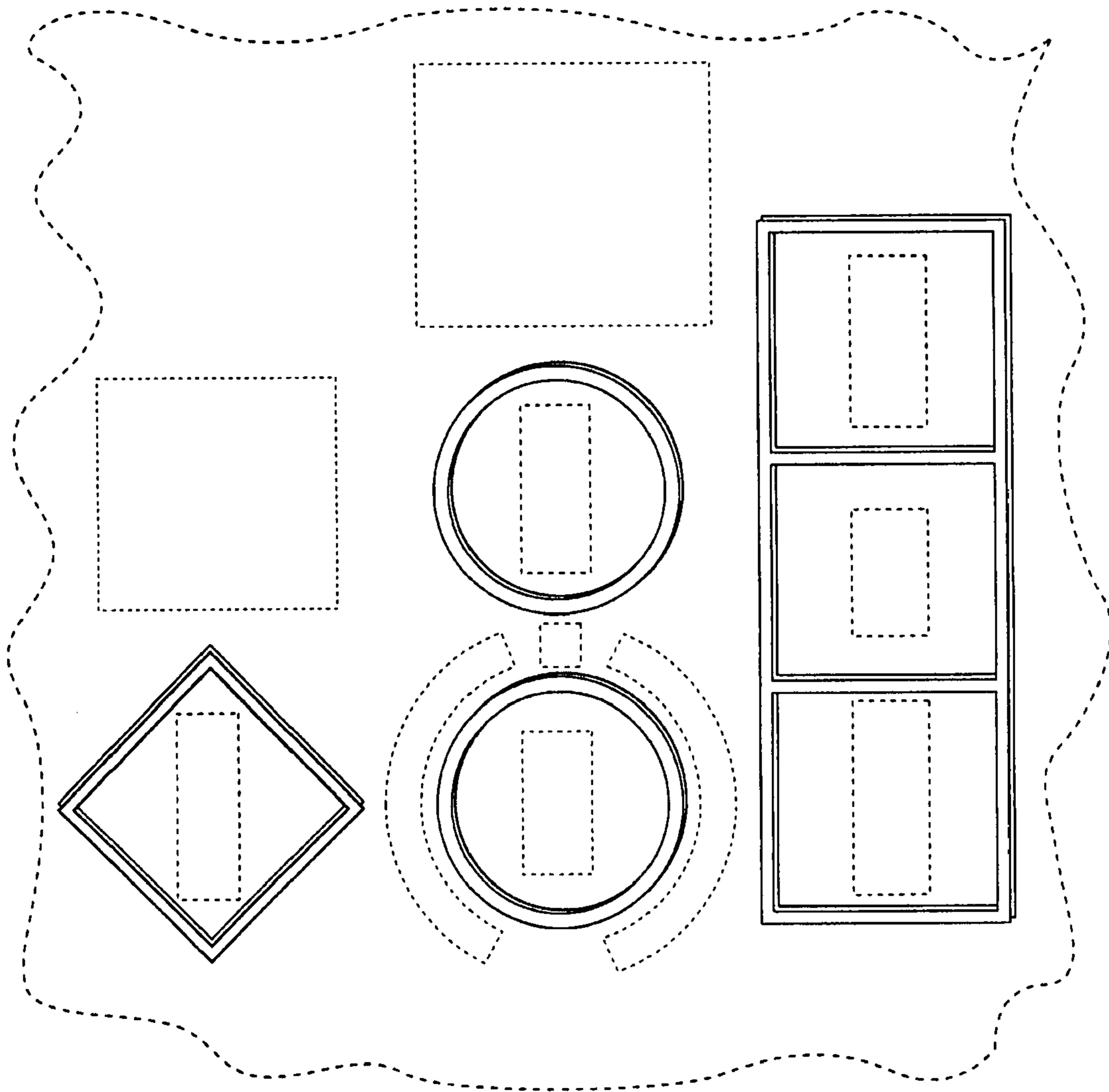
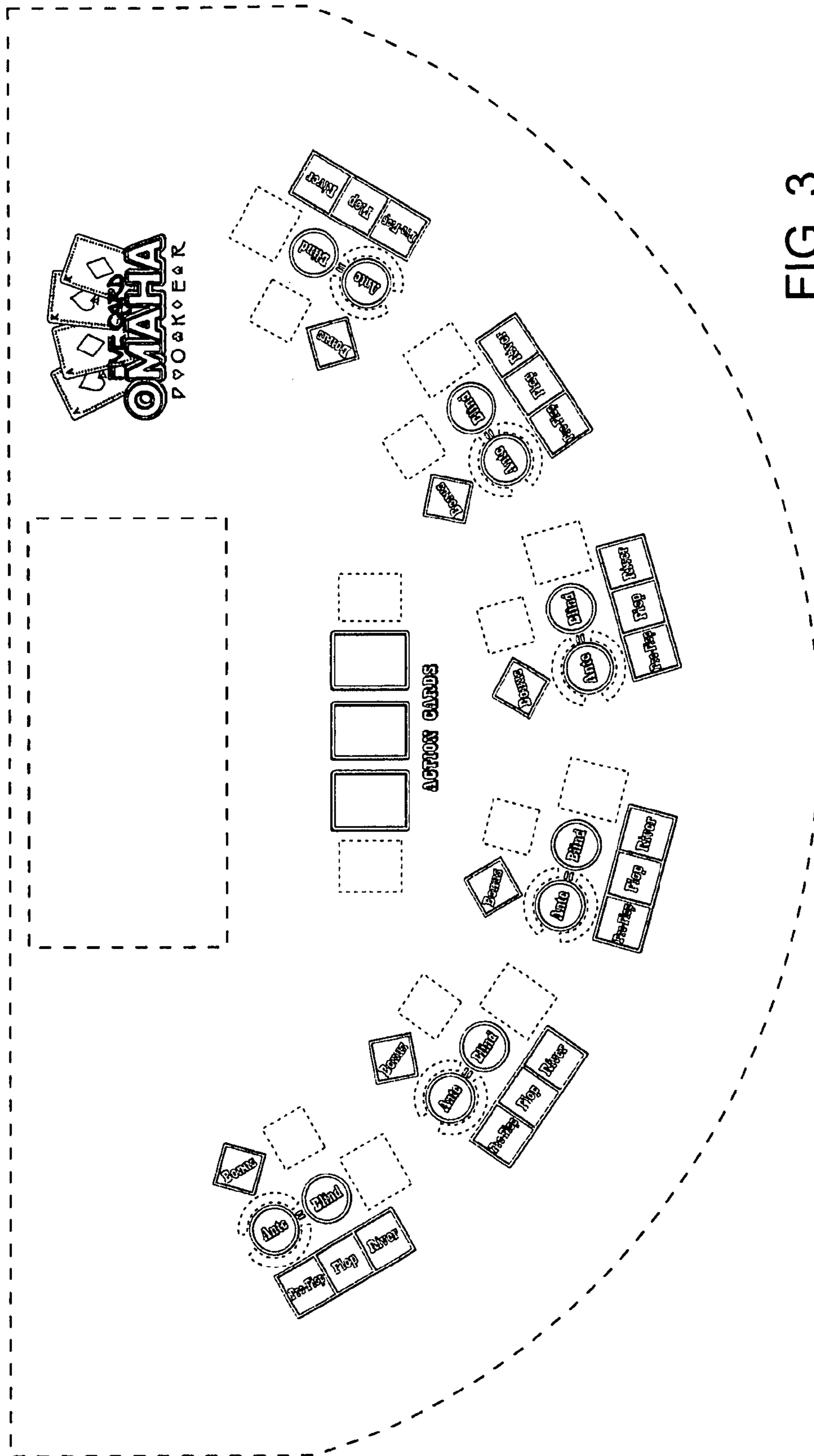

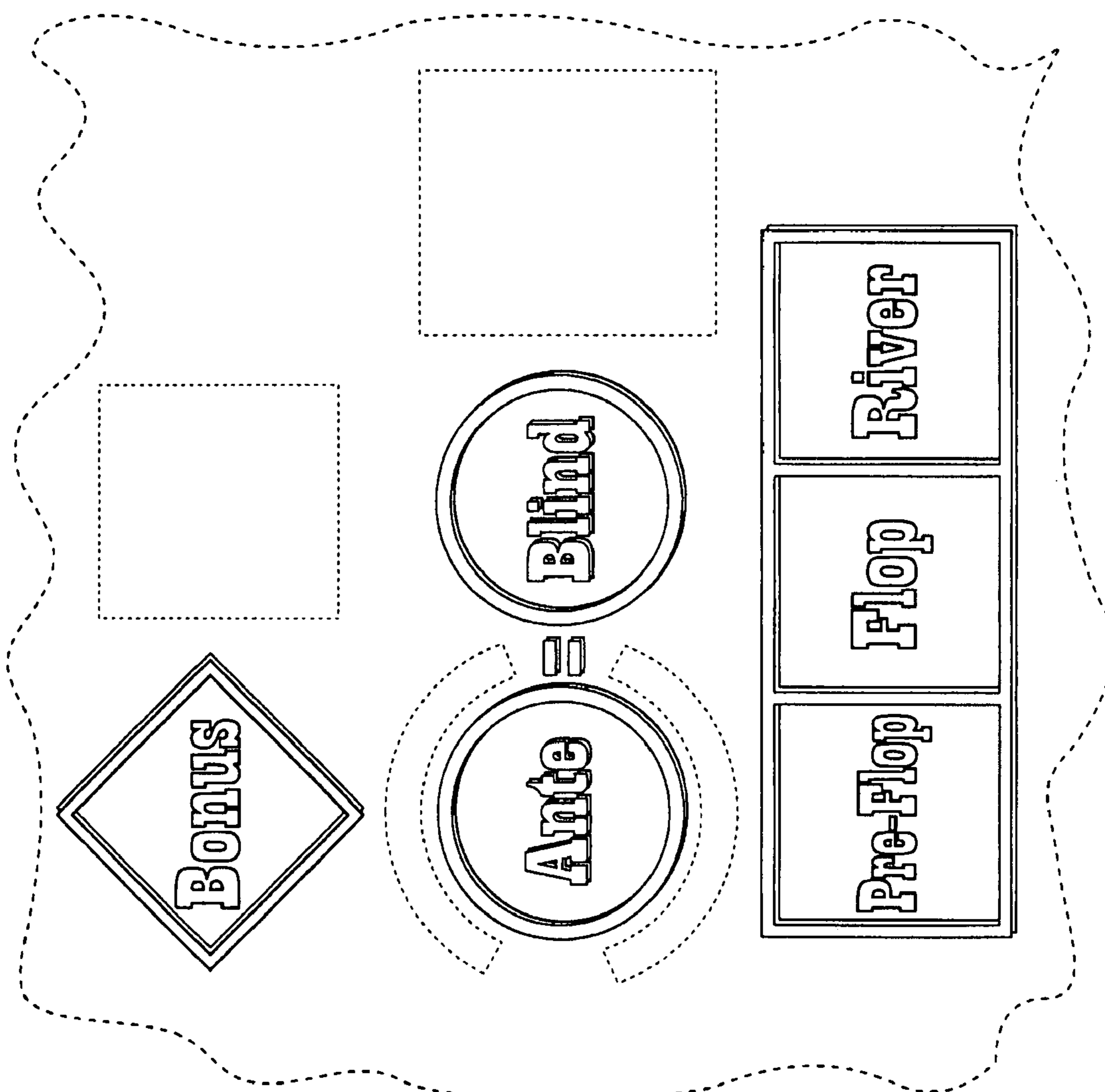

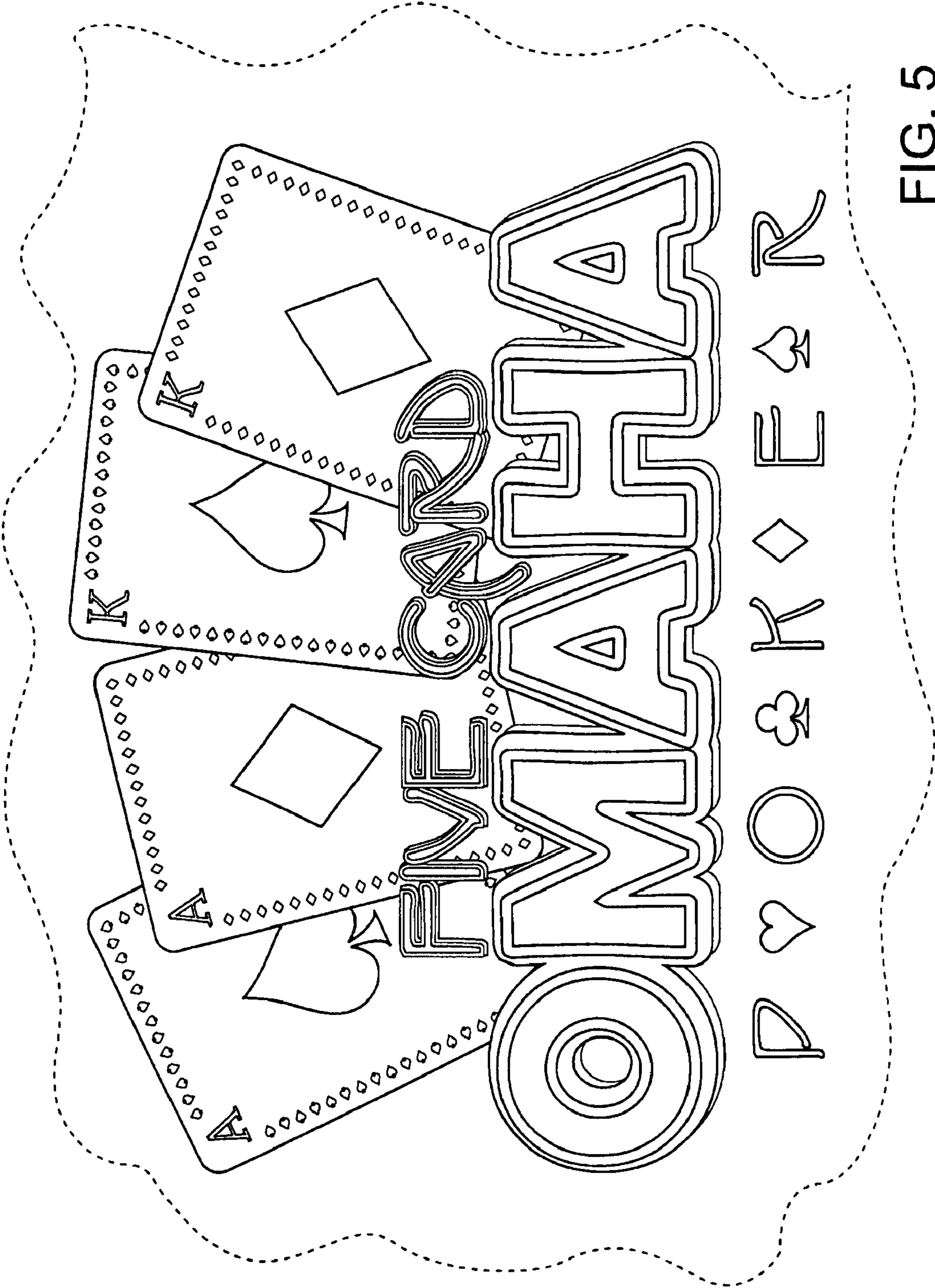

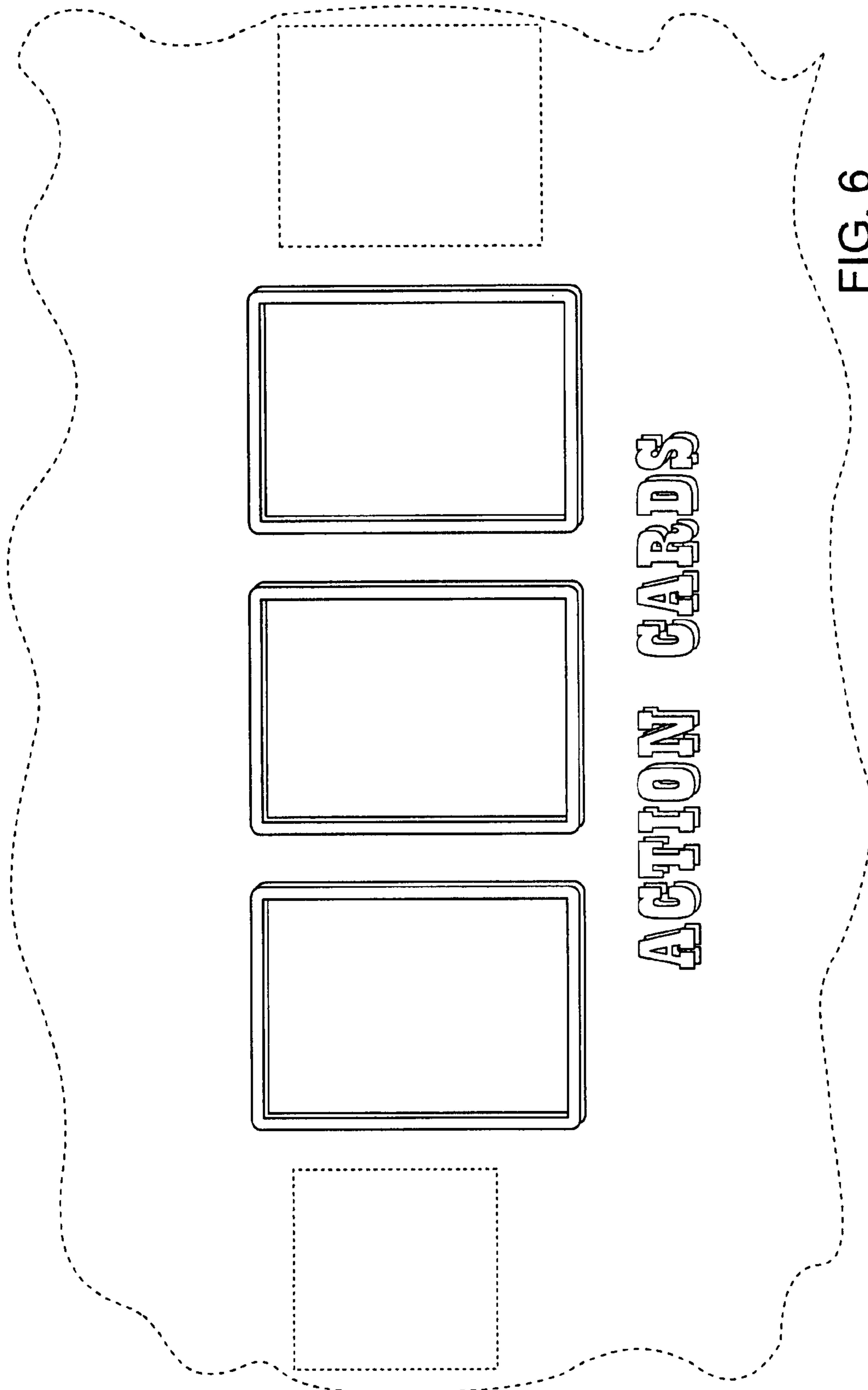
