(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a mop, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a mop showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged first top perspective view of the mop head portion, shown separately for clarity of disclosure;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged second top perspective view of the mop head portion thereof, shown separately for clarity of disclosure;

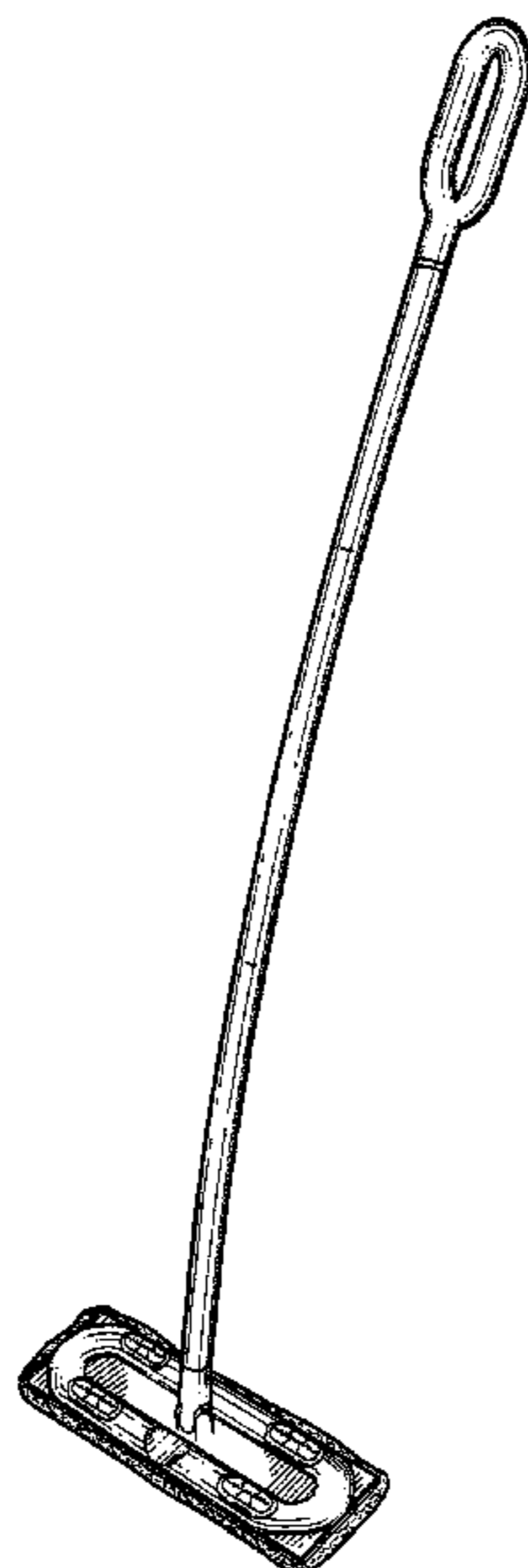
FIG. 5 is a bottom perspective view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the mop handle shown separately for clarity of disclosure; and,

FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of a mop showing our new design.

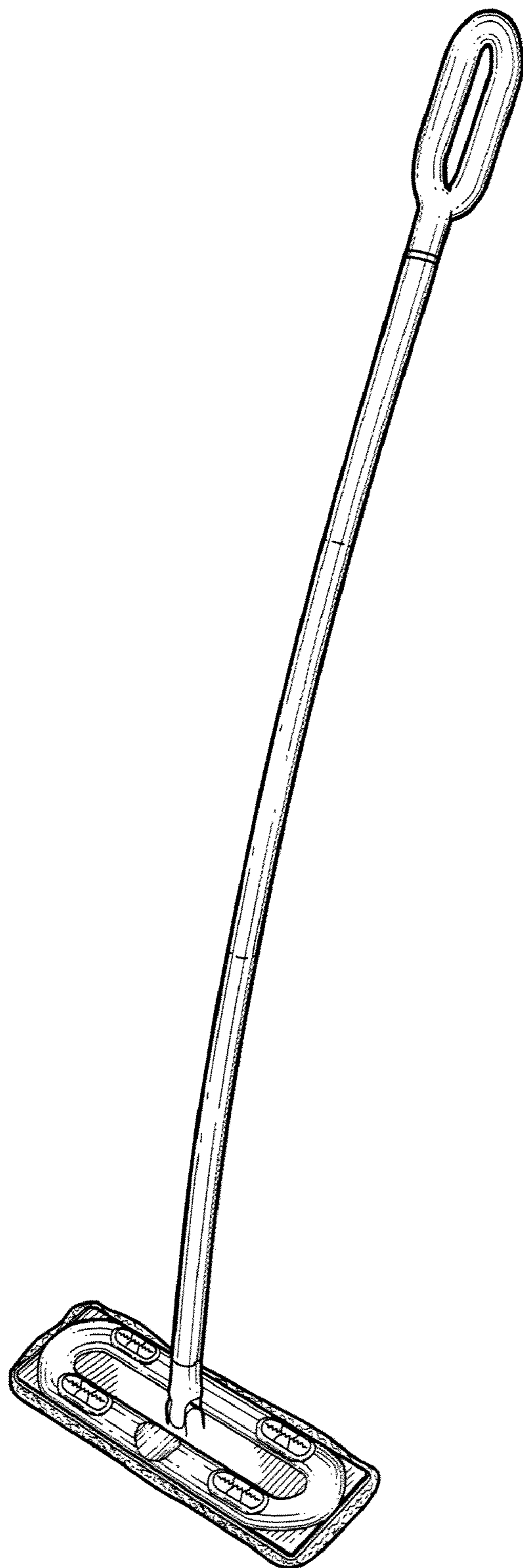

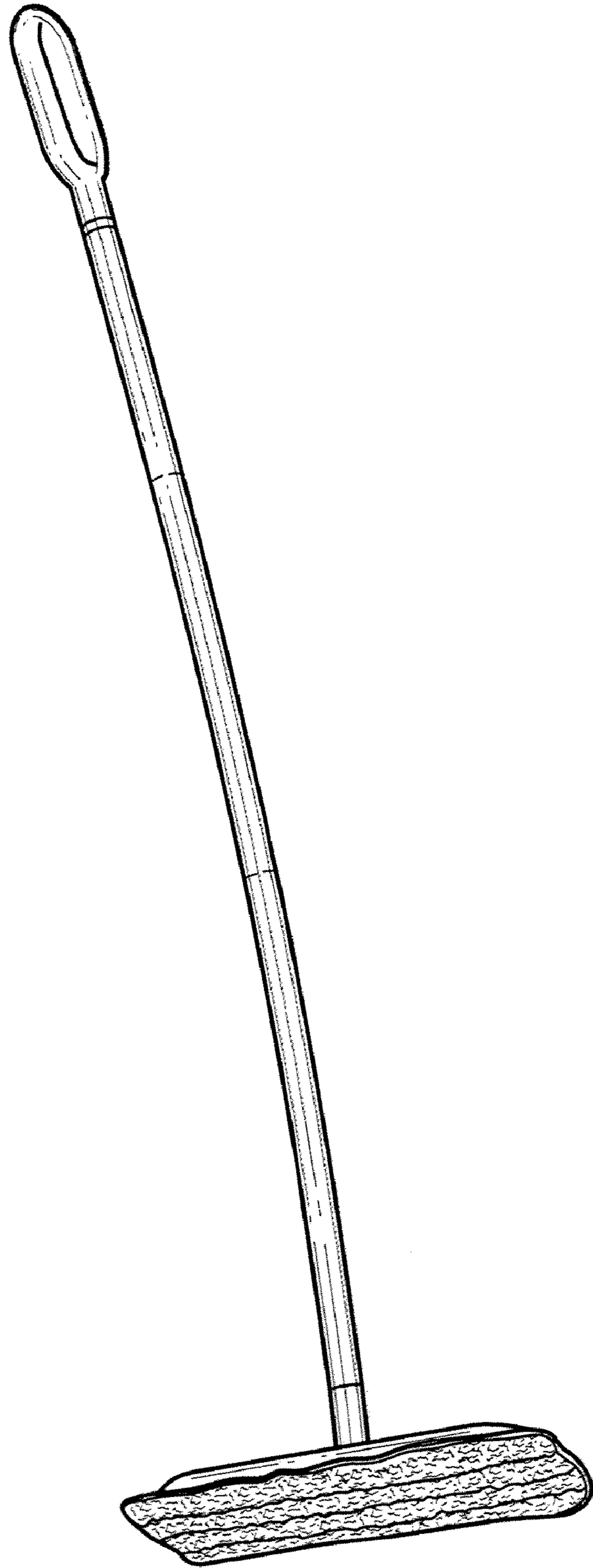

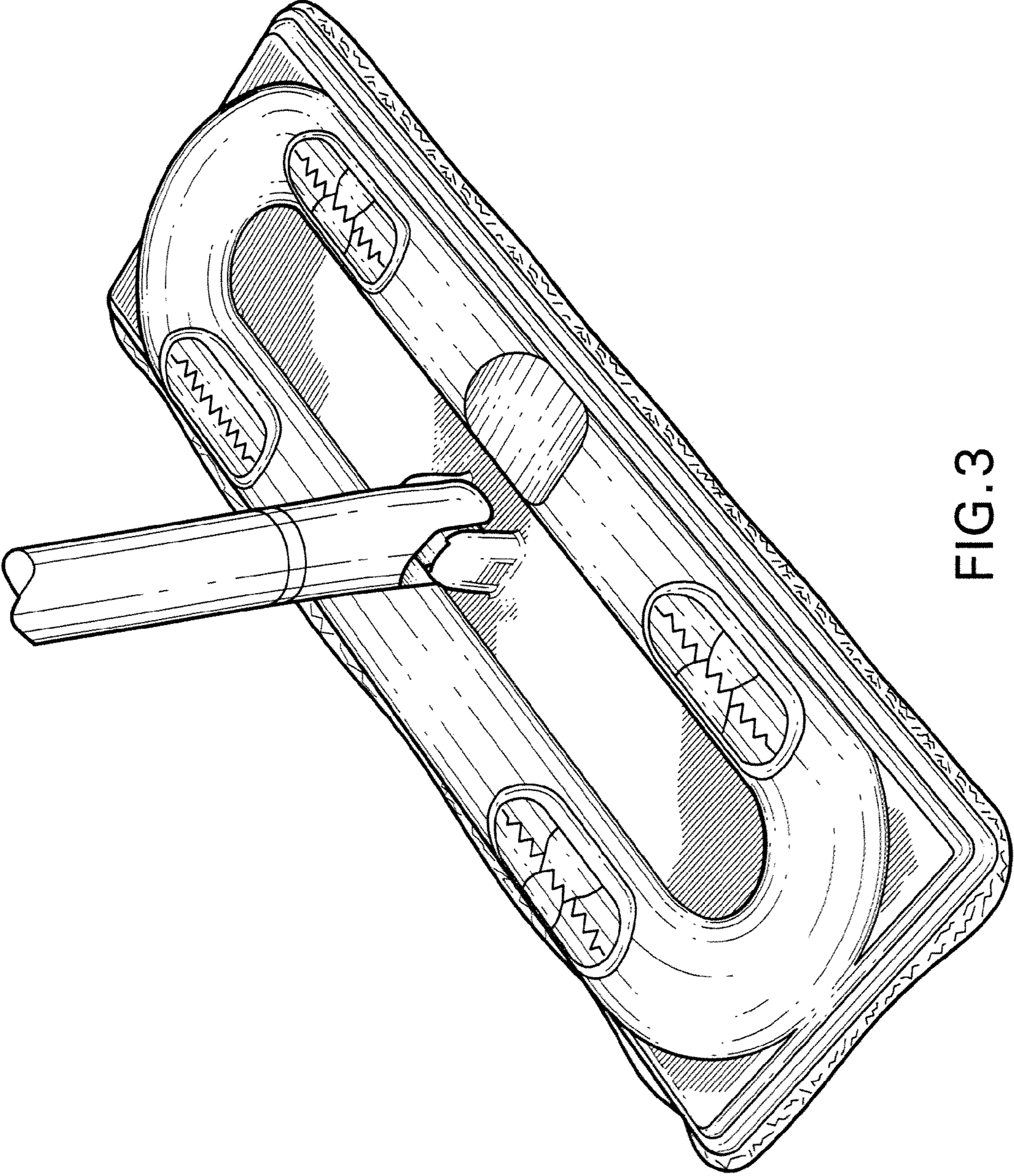

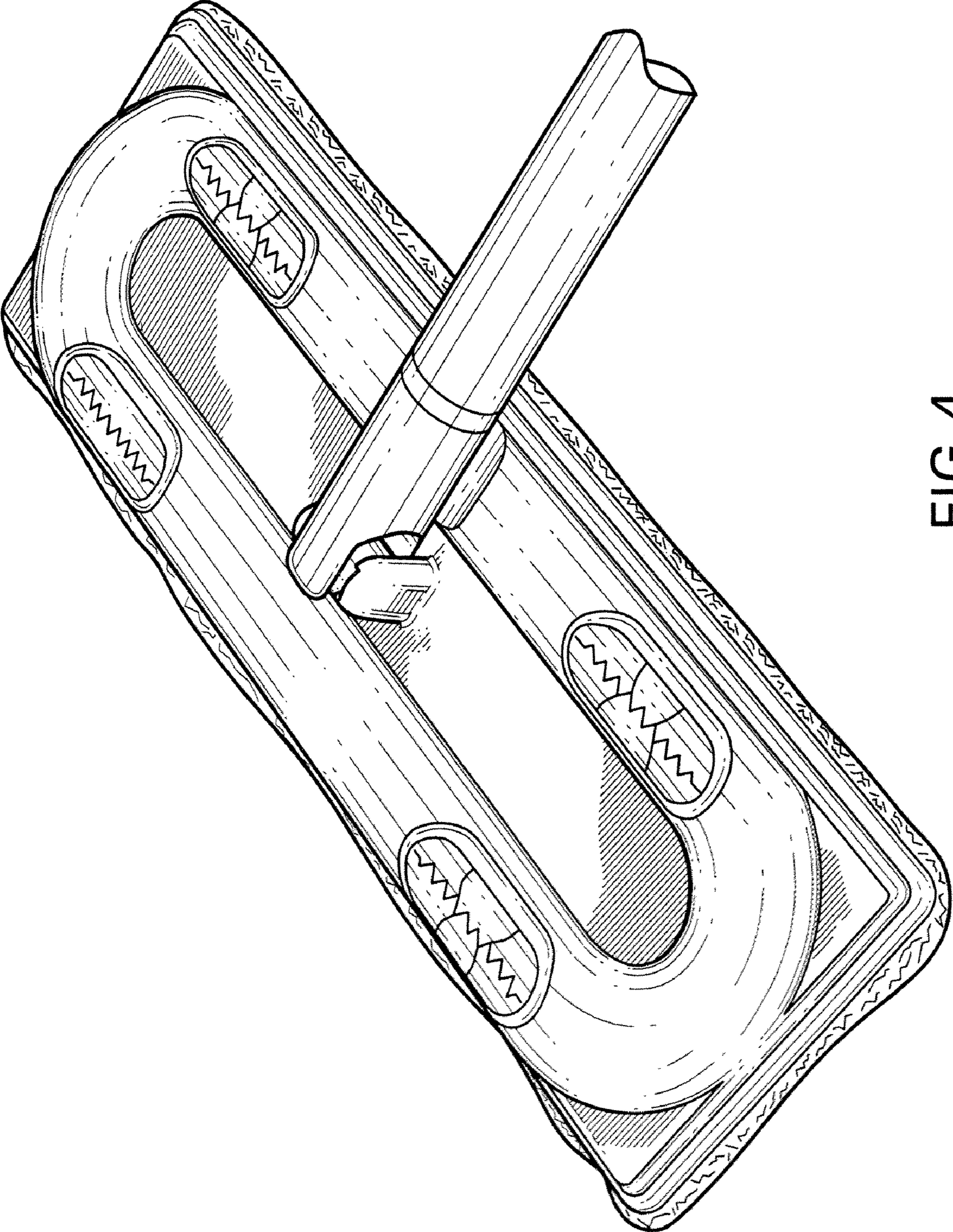

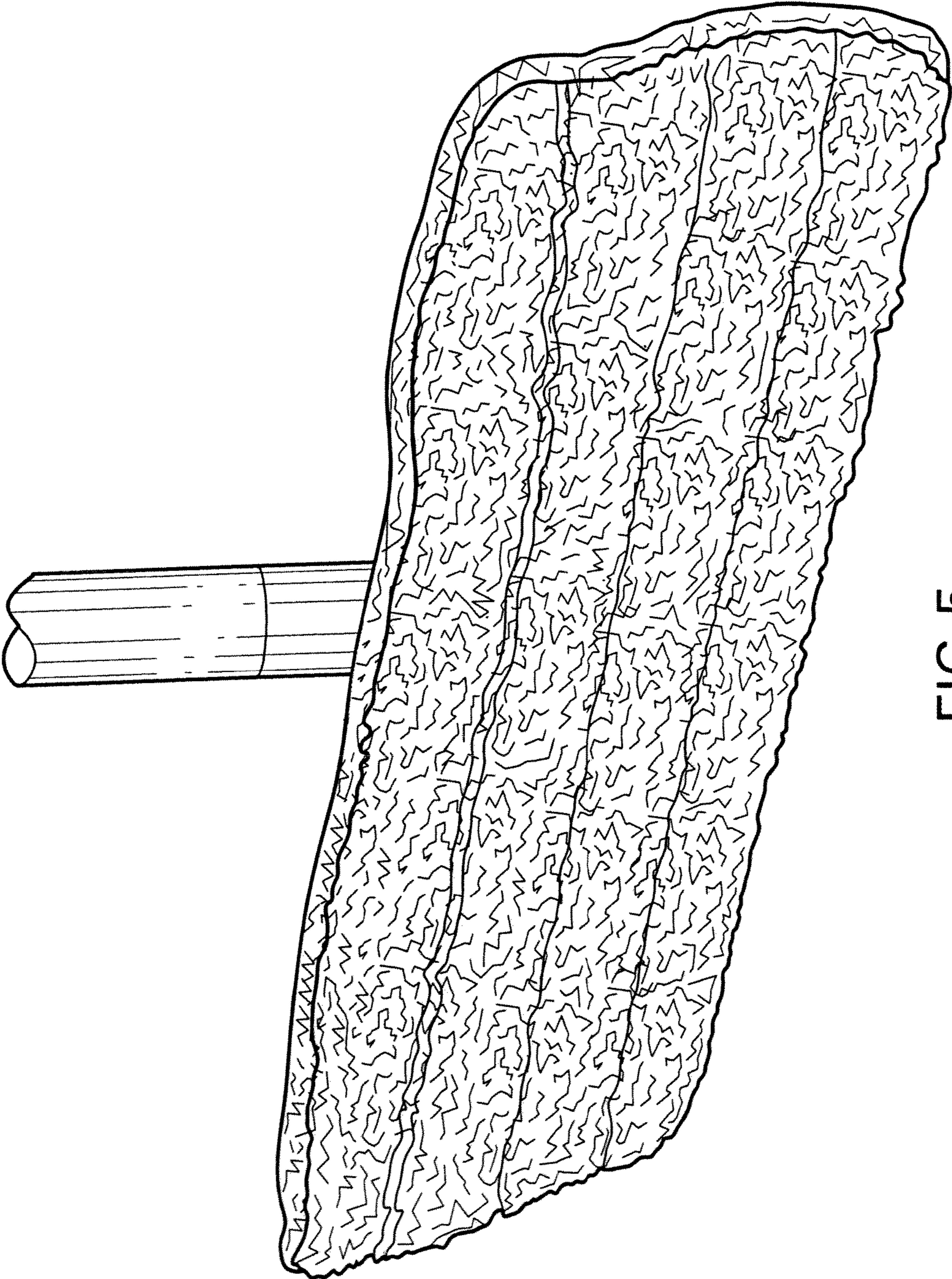

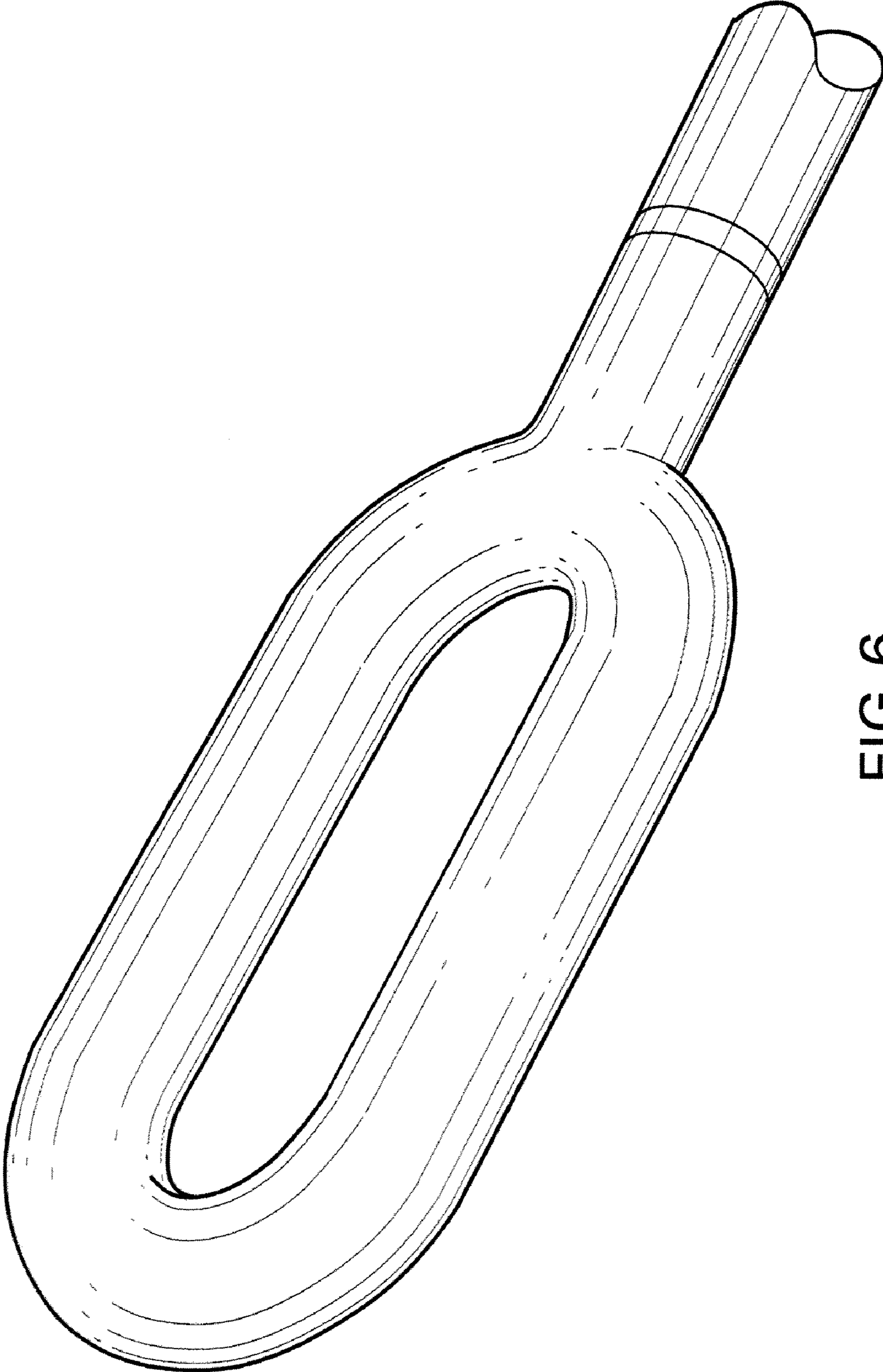

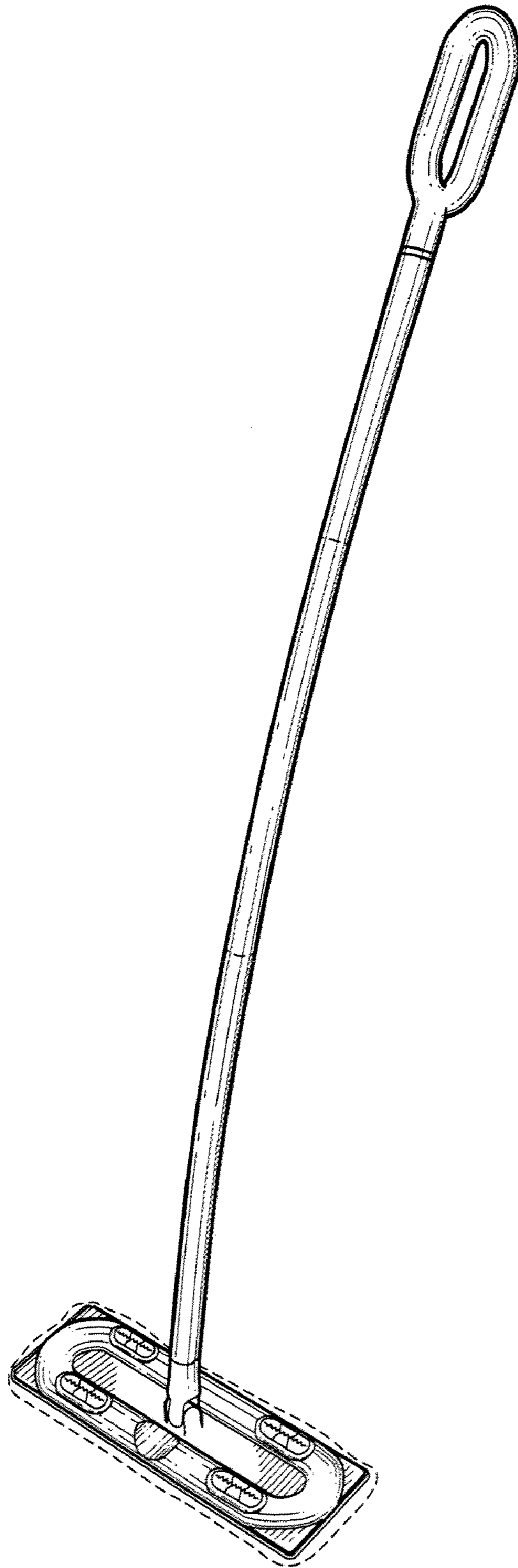
