DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a first embodiment of a bench showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view of the bench of FIG. 1, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the bench of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the bench of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a back elevational view of the bench of FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the bench of FIG. 1.

FIG. 7 is an isometric view of a second embodiment of a bench showing my new design.

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of the bench of FIG. 7, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the bench of FIG. 7.

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of the bench of FIG. 7.

FIG. 11 is a back elevational view of the bench of FIG. 7.

FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of the bench of FIG. 7.

FIG. 13 is an isometric view of a third embodiment of a bench showing my new design.

FIG. 14 is a right side elevational view of the bench of FIG. 13, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 15 is a top plan view of the bench of FIG. 13.

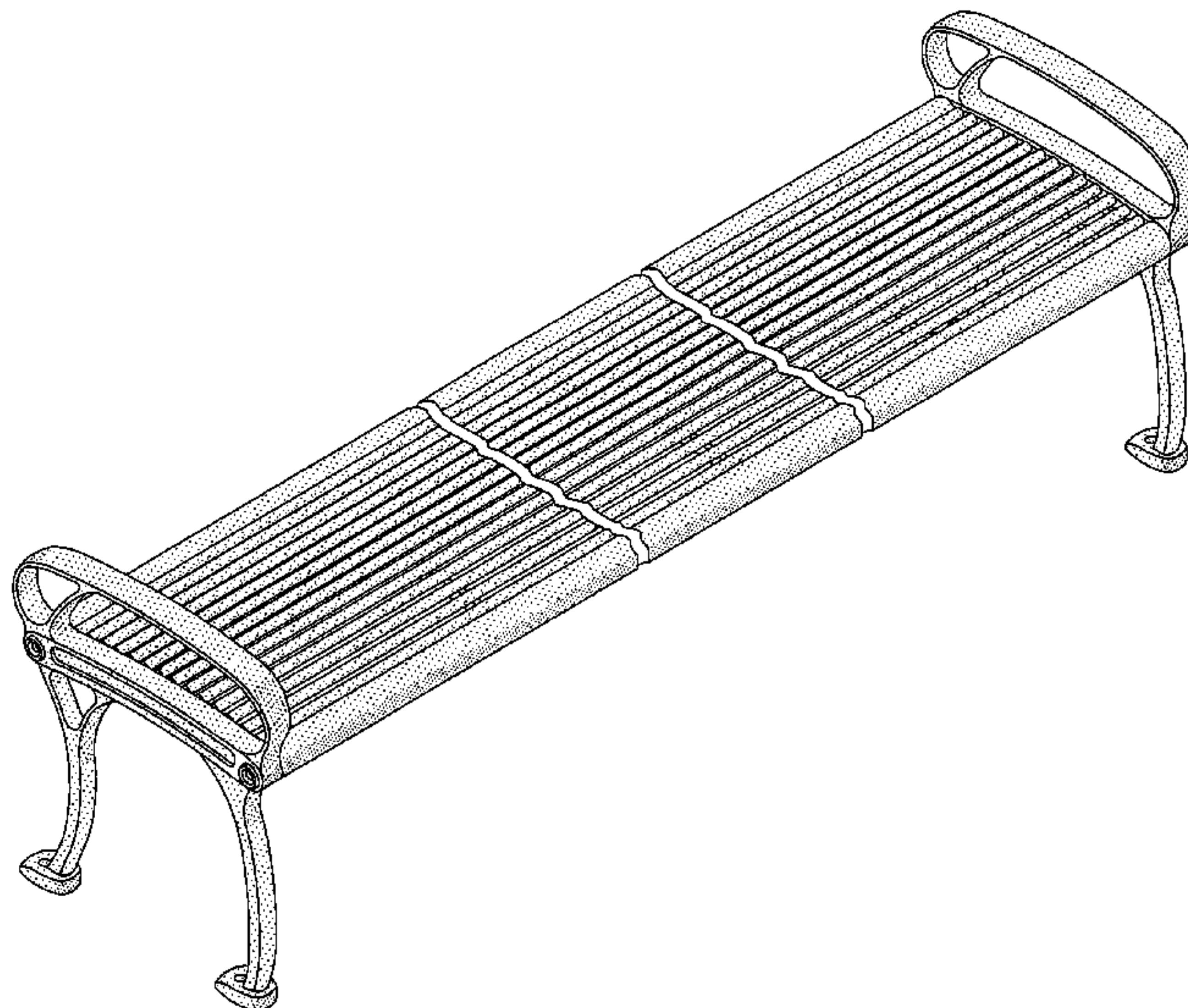
FIG. 16 is a front elevational view of the bench of FIG. 13.

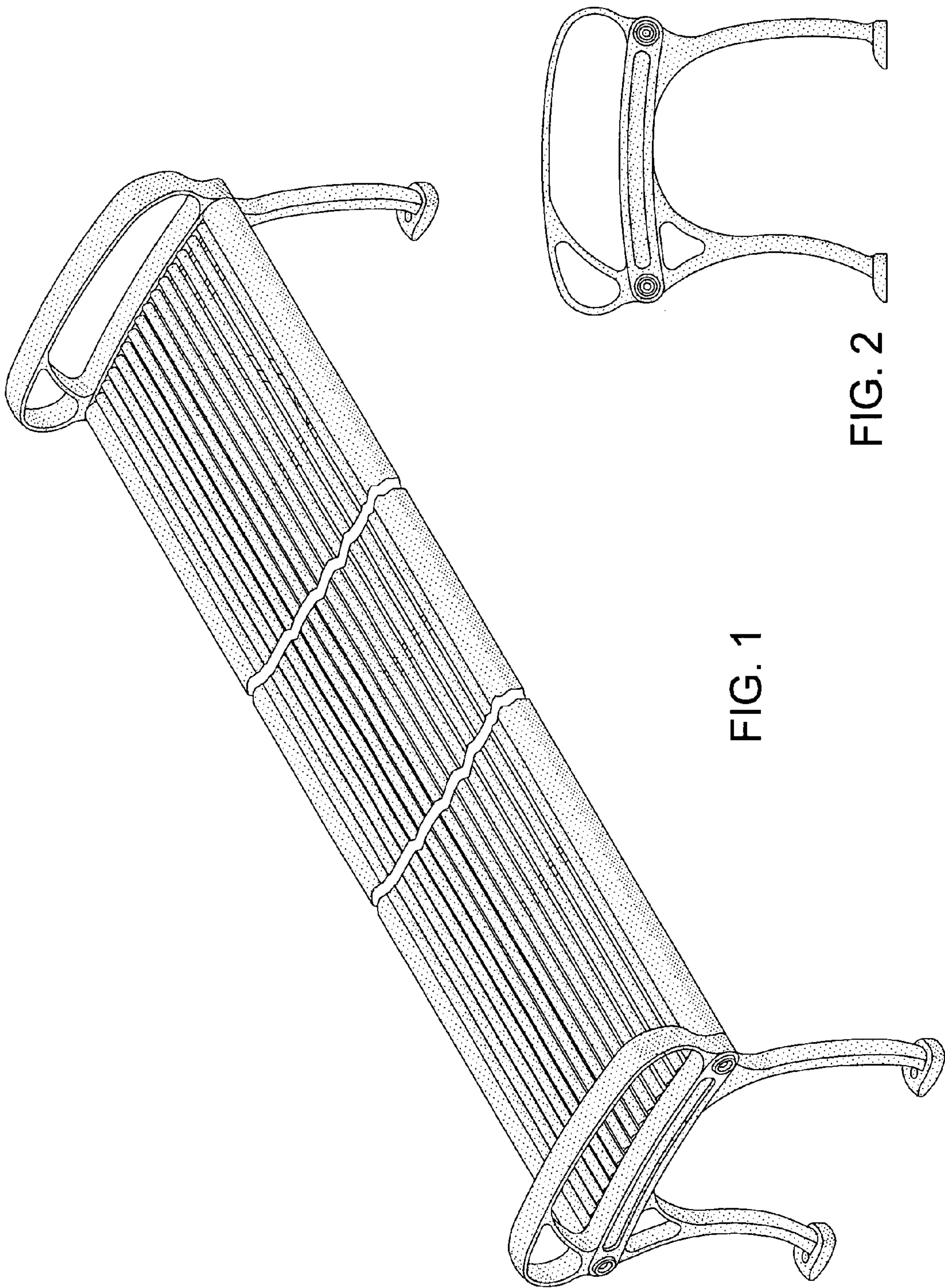

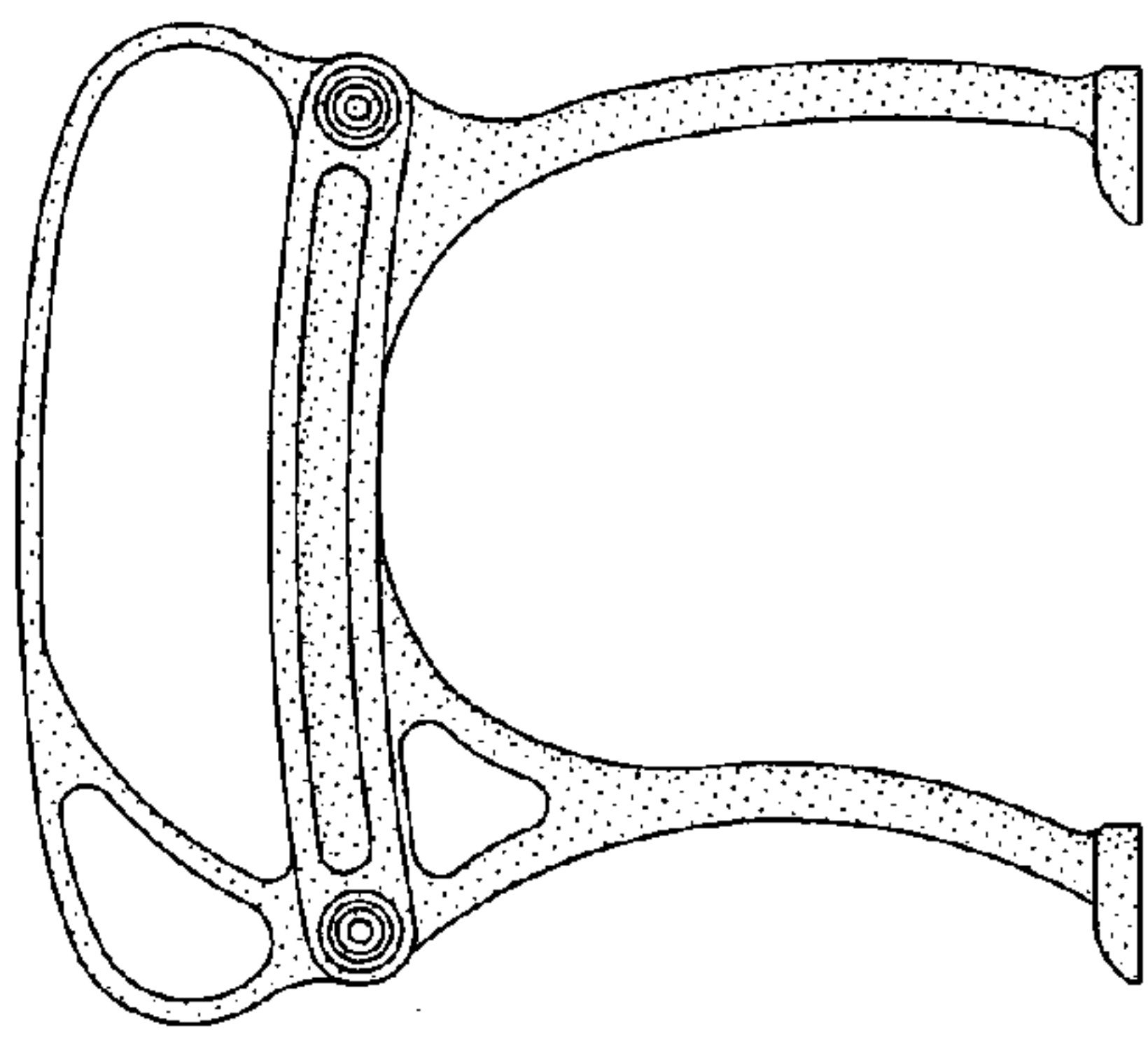

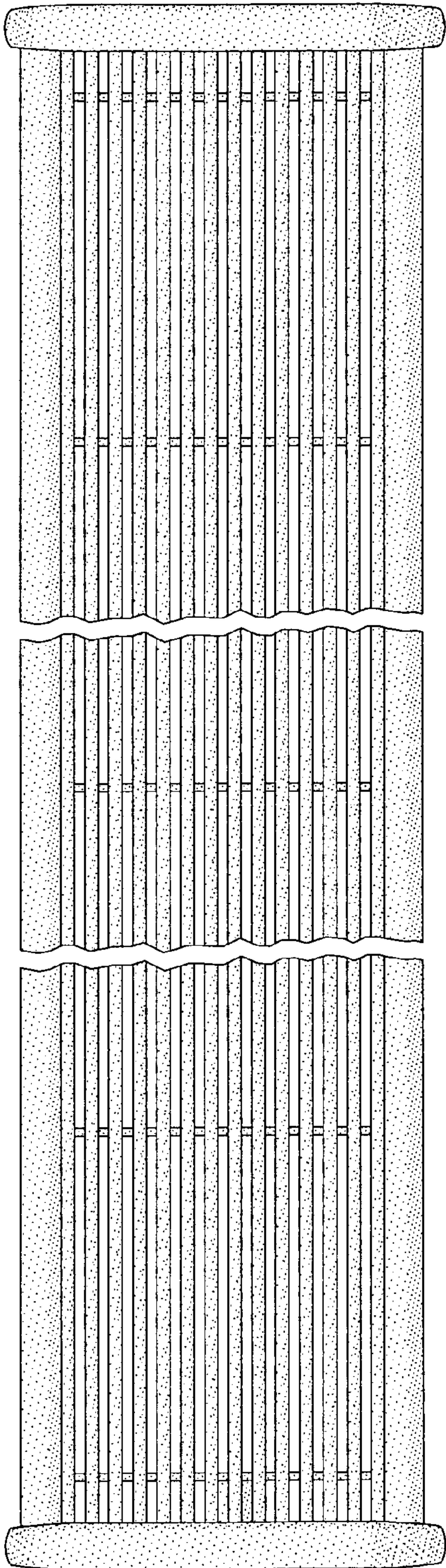

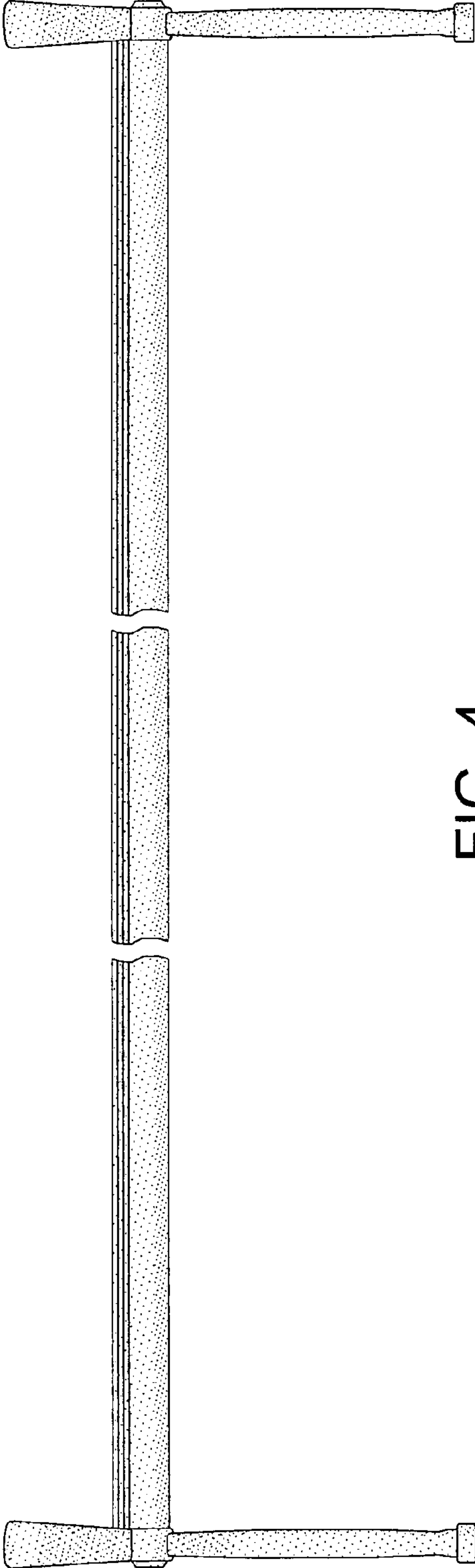

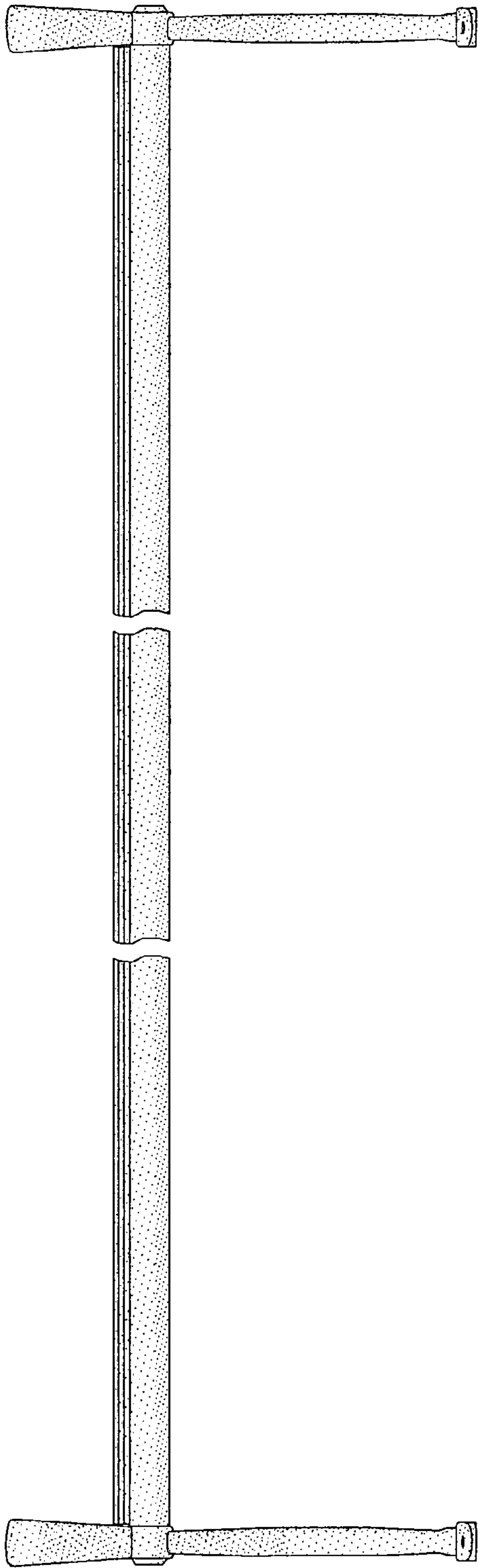

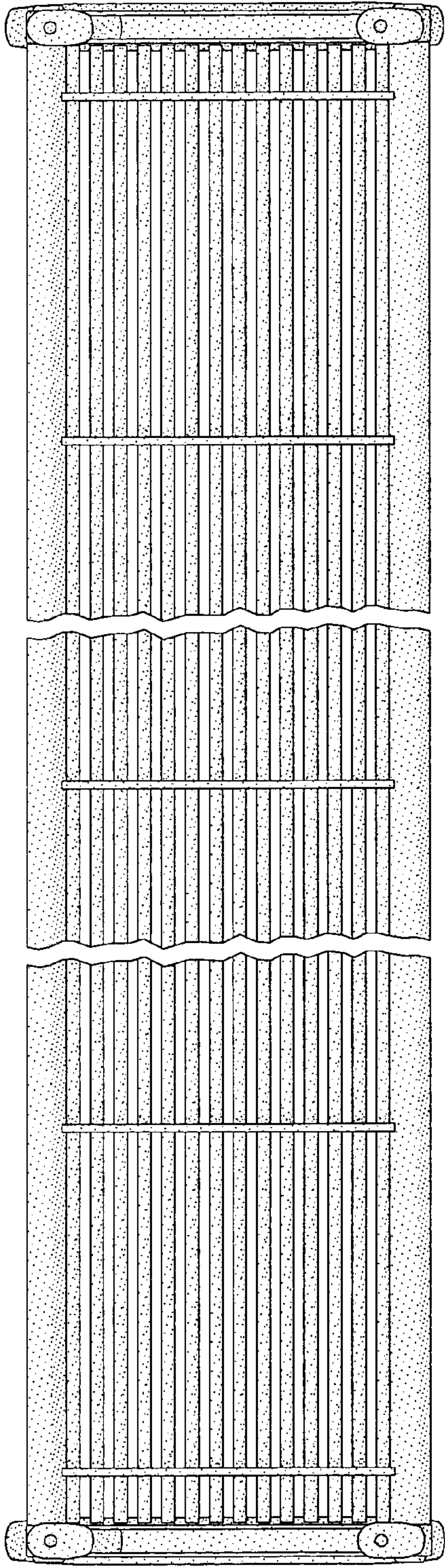

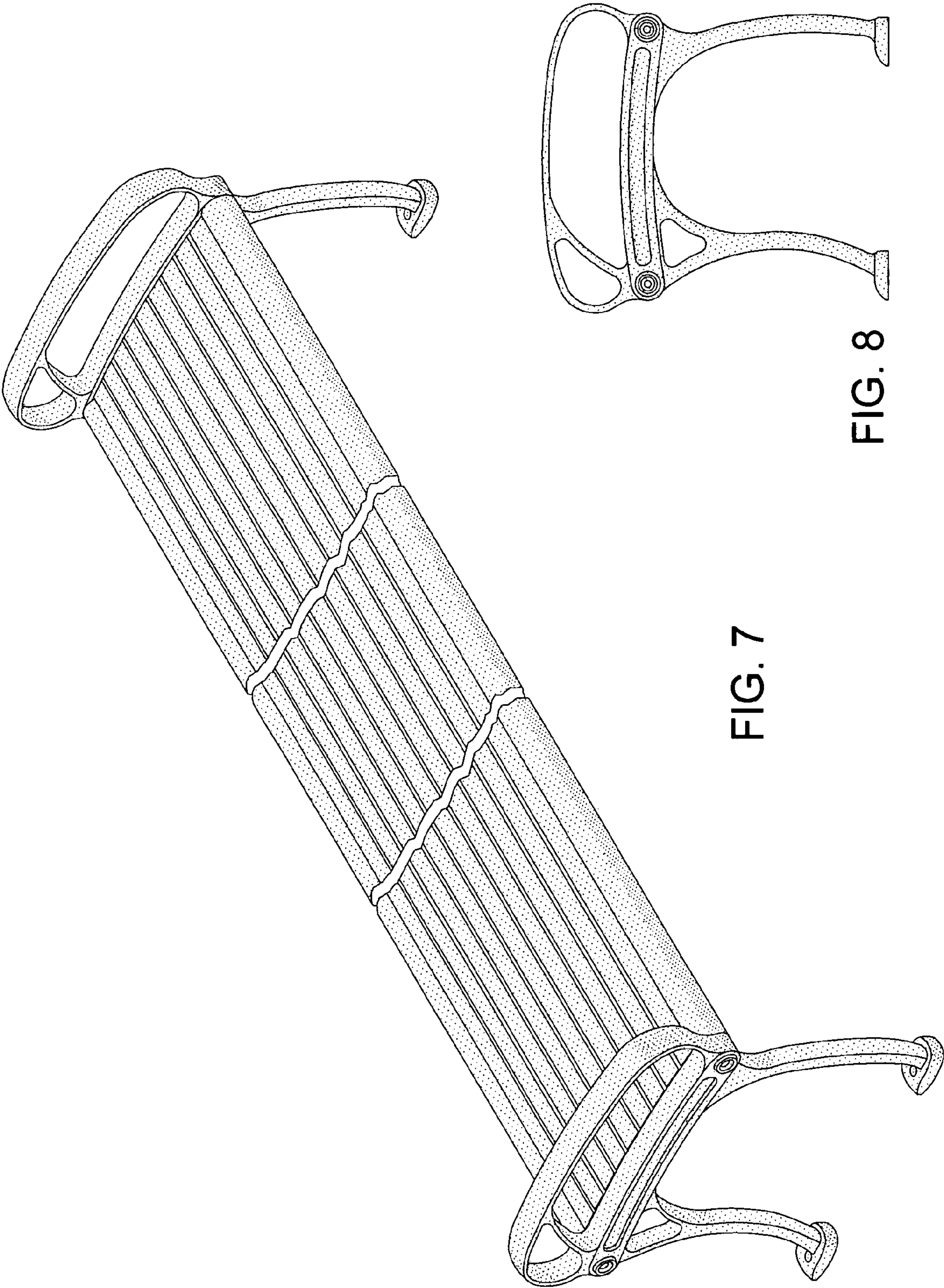

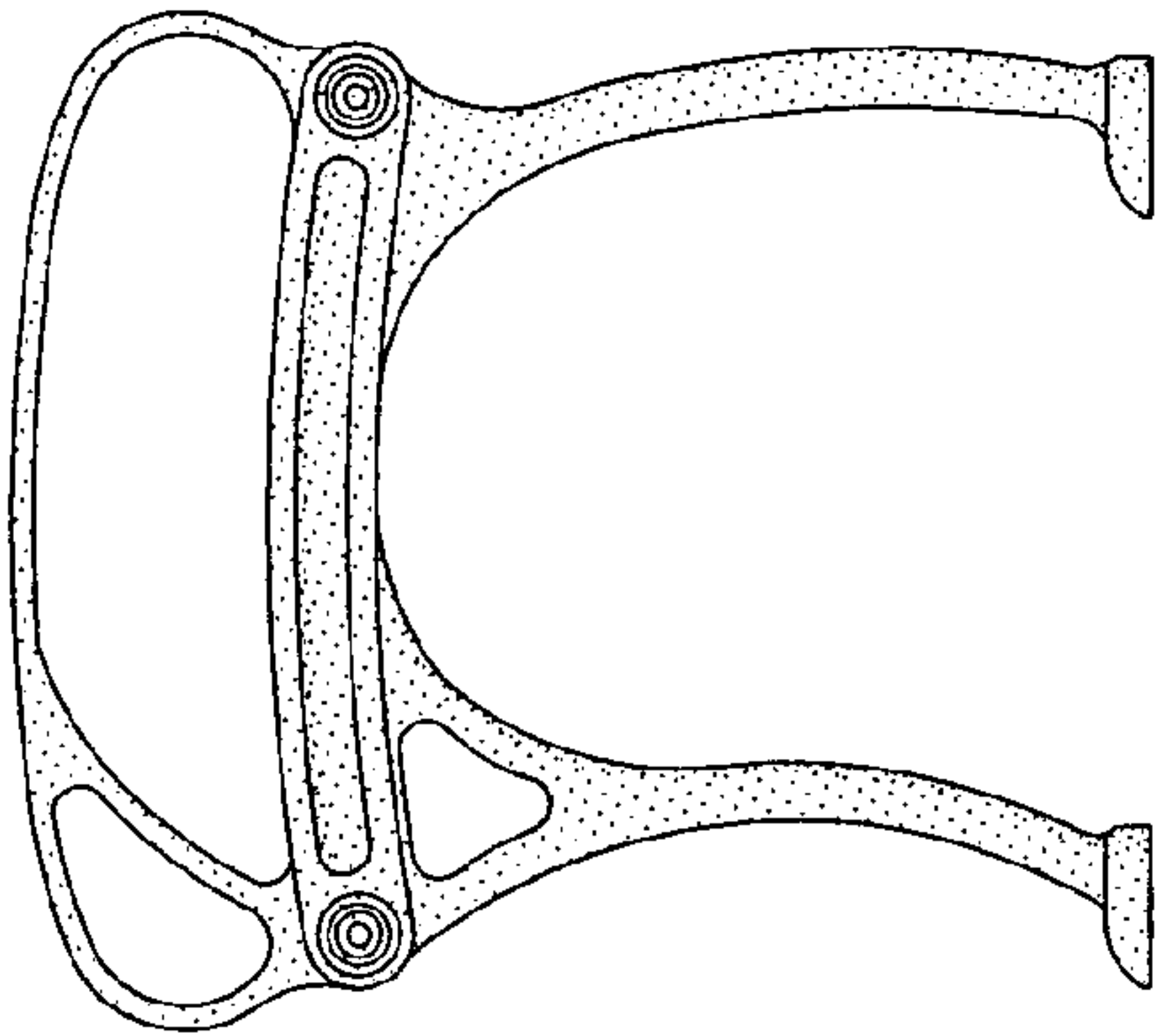

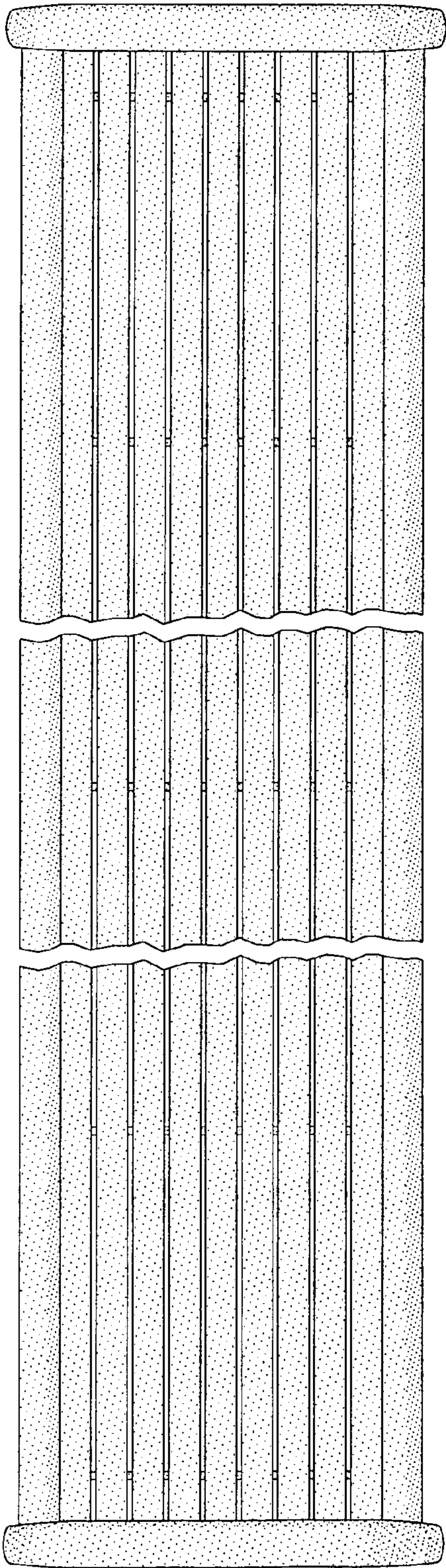

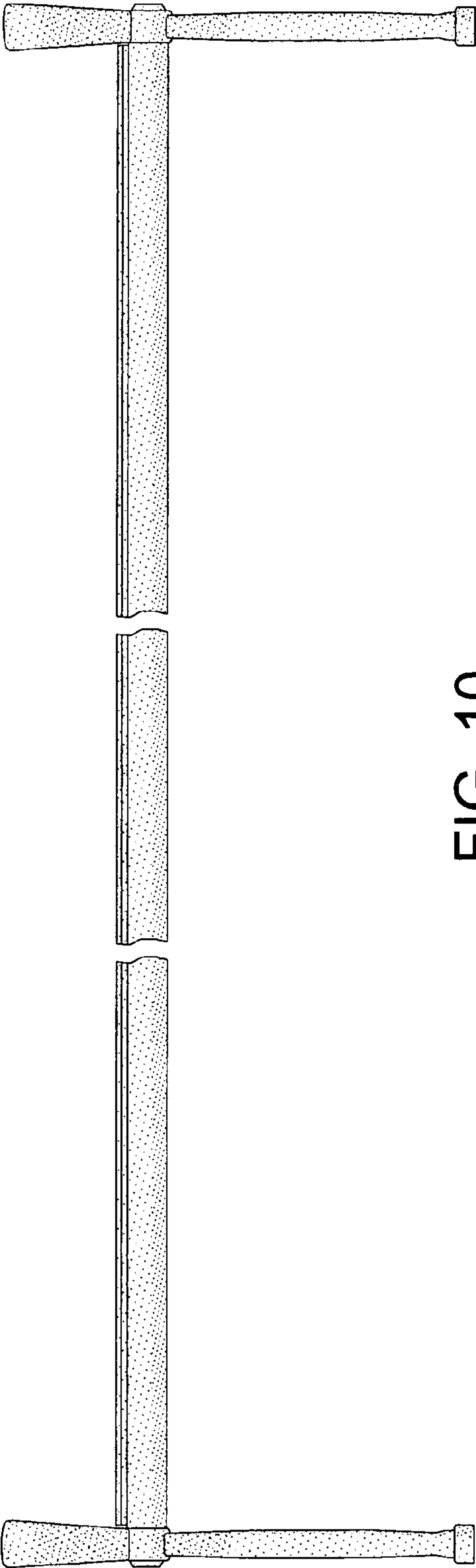

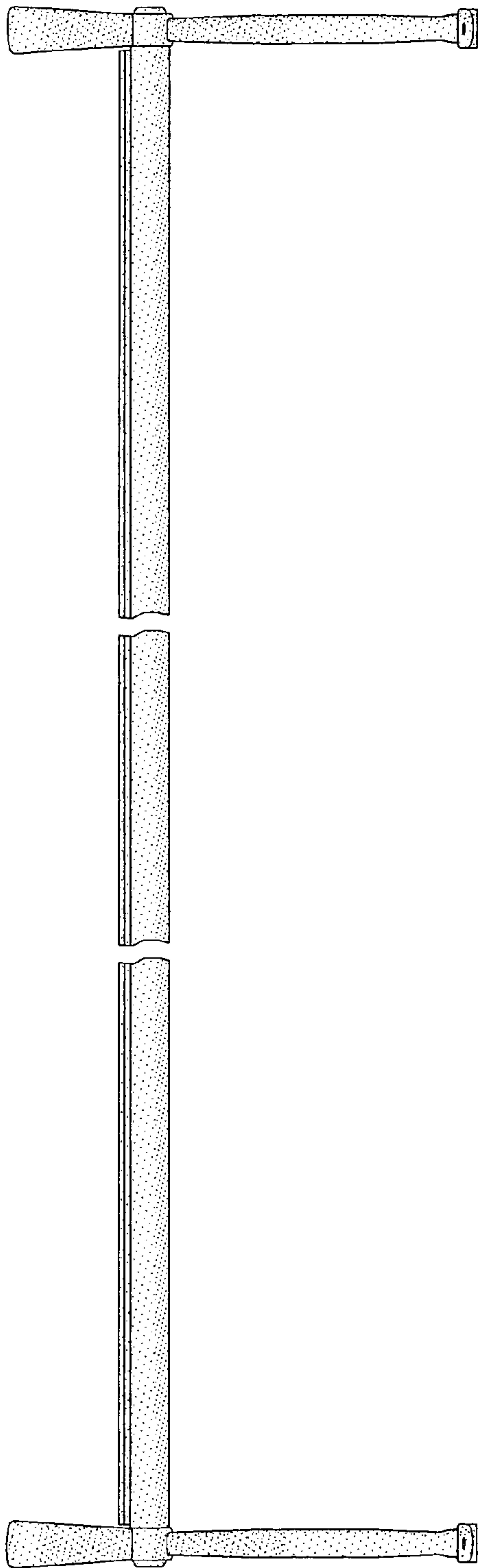

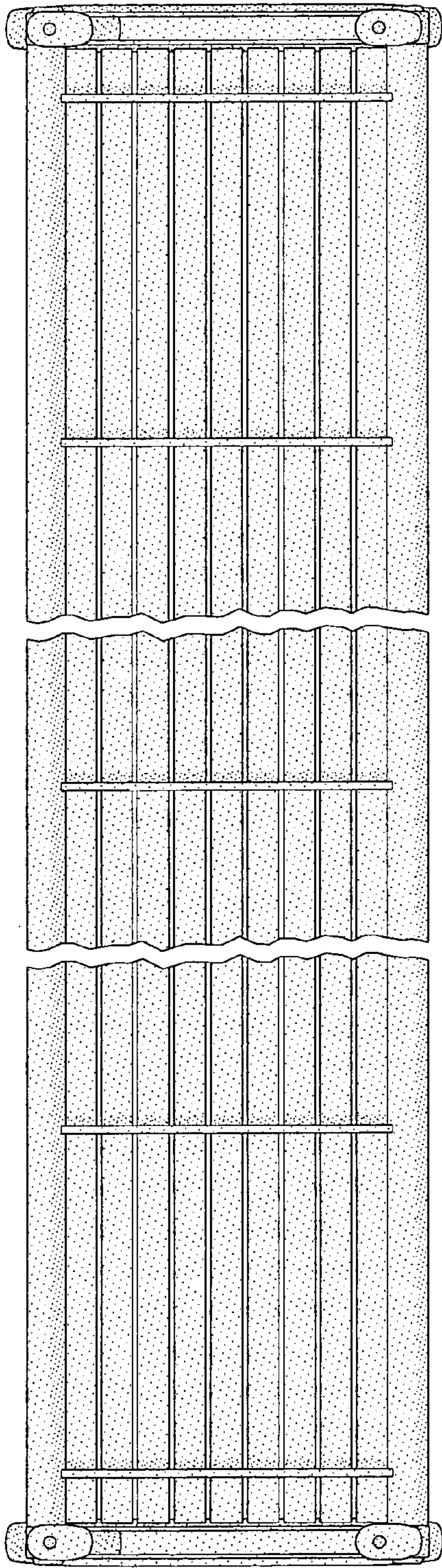
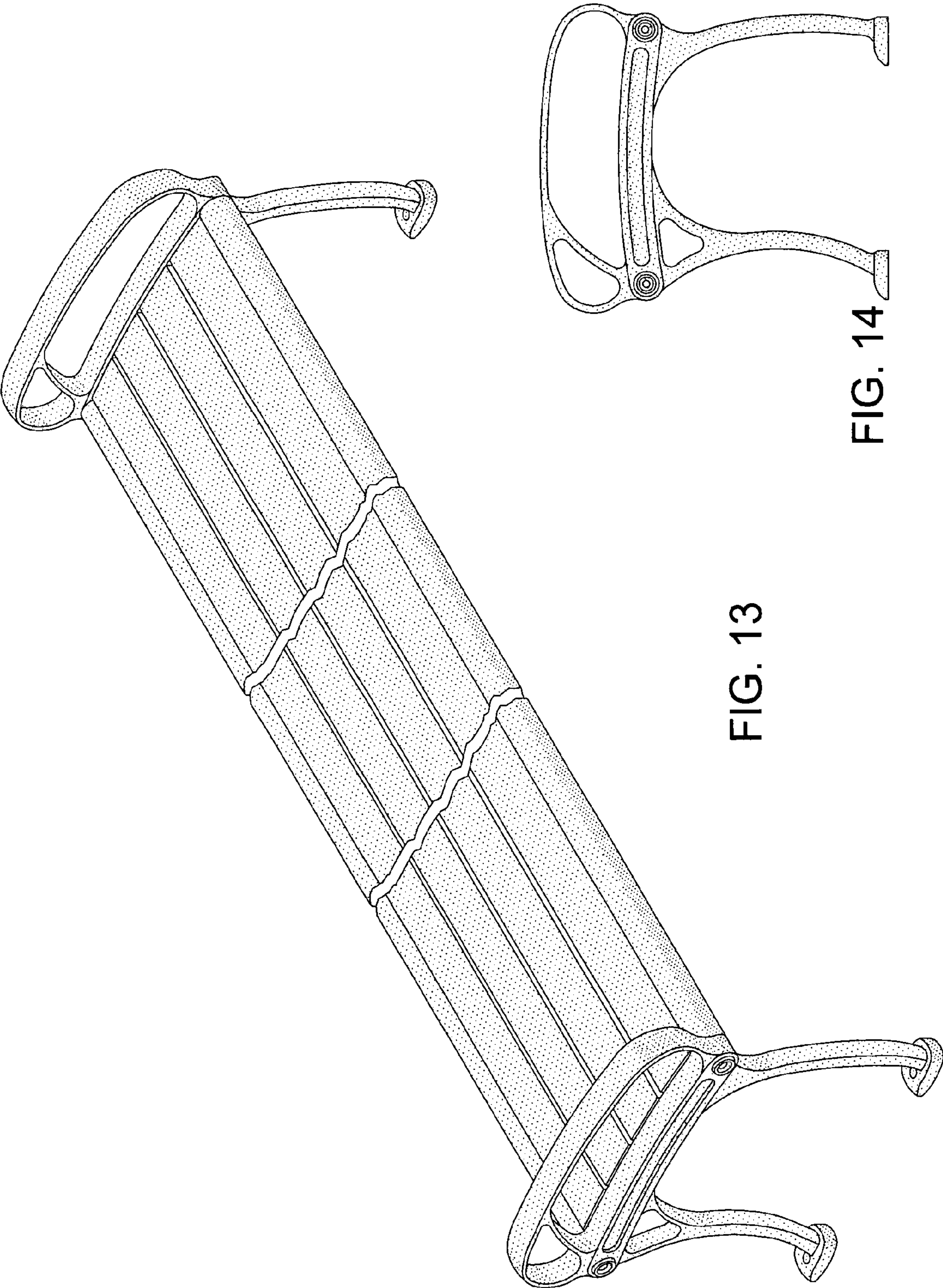

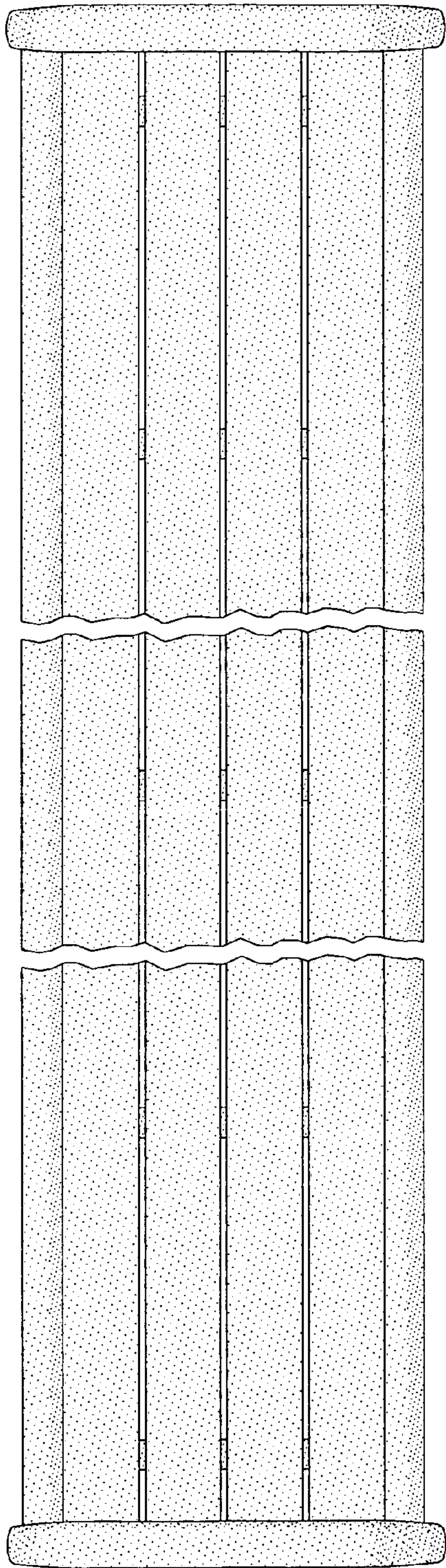

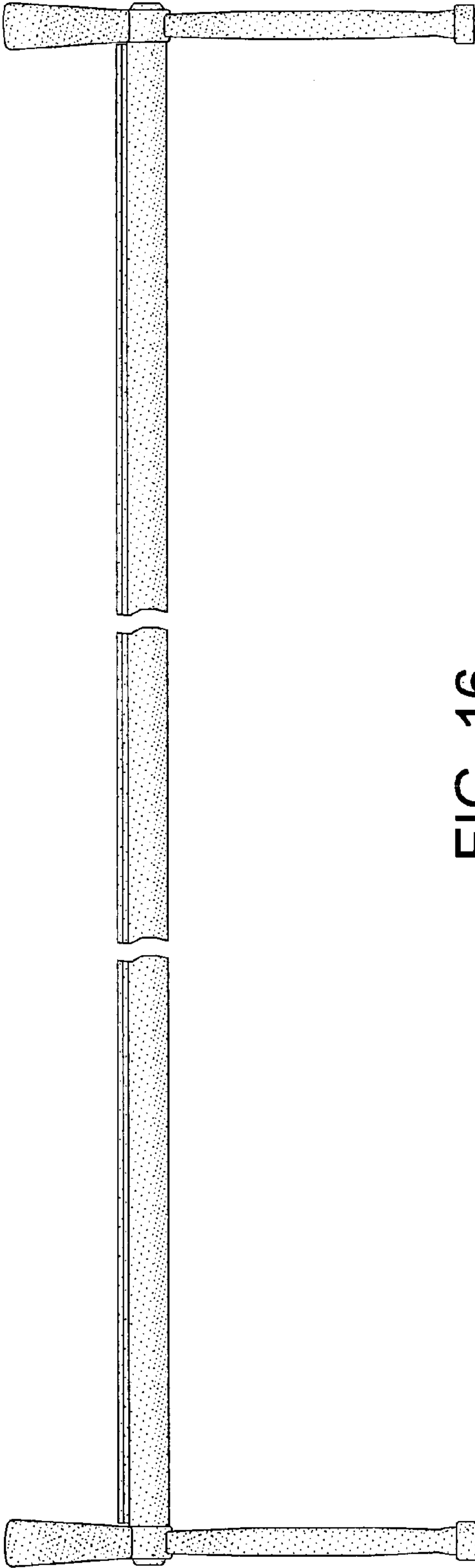

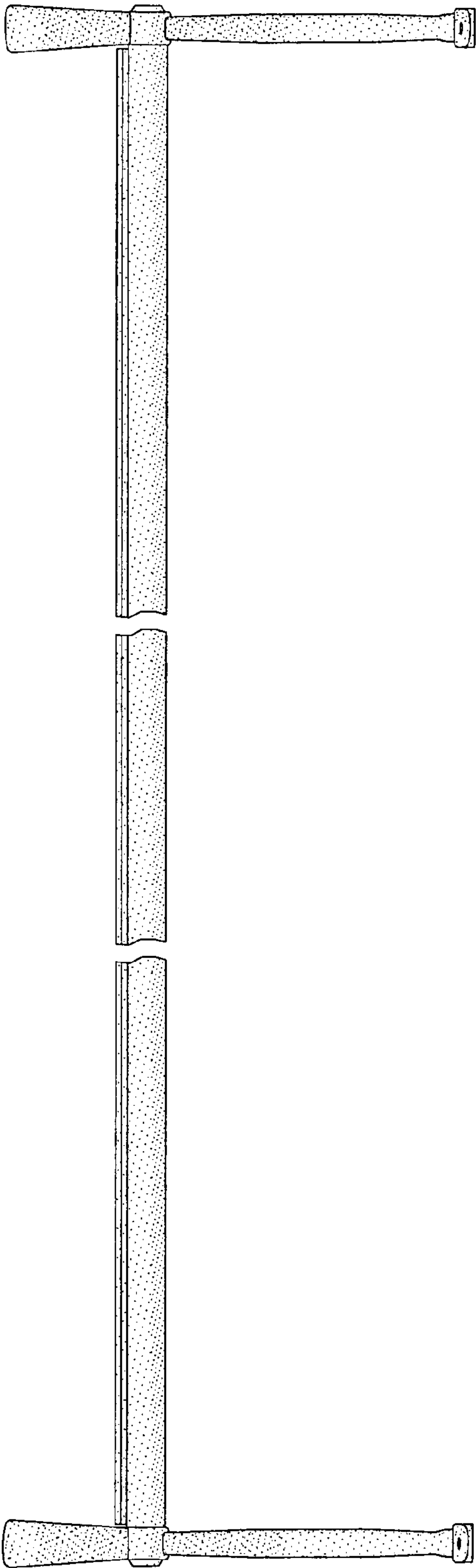

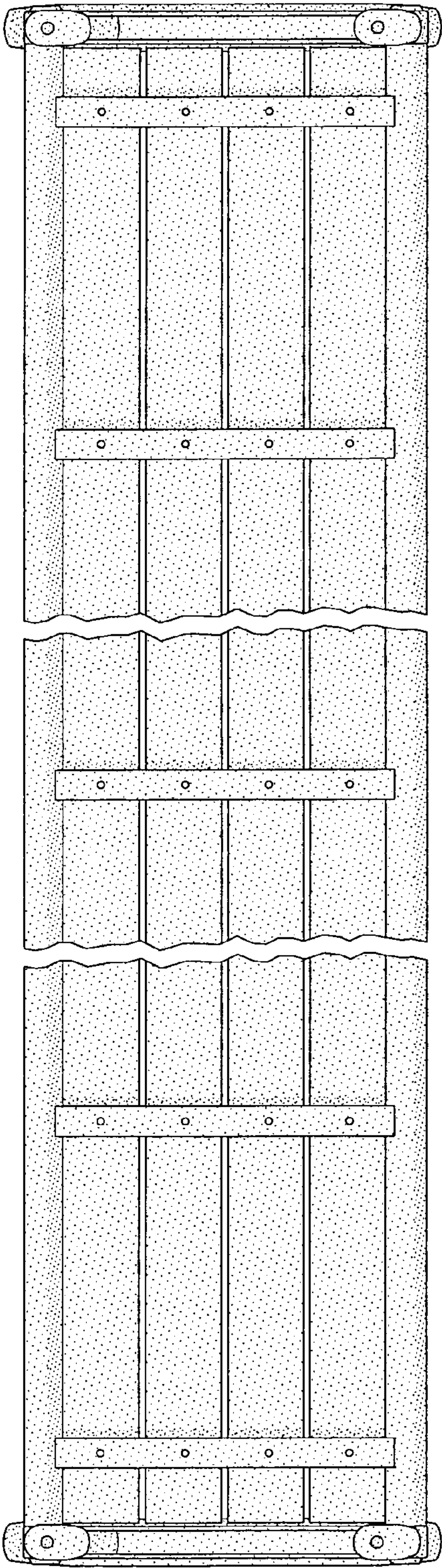
