FIG. 2 is a top view of the design shown in FIG. 1;

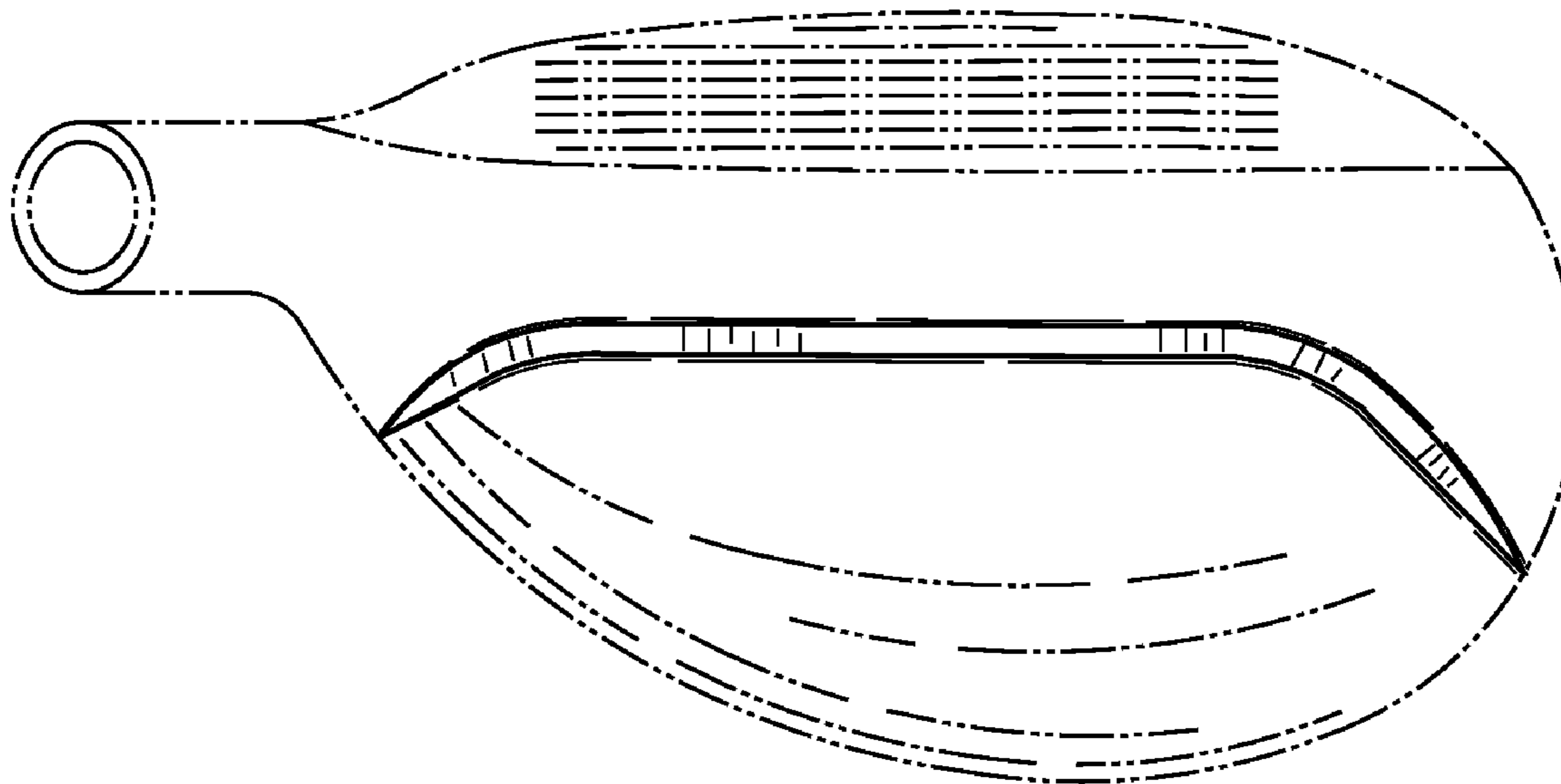
FIG. 3 is a rear view of the design shown in FIG. 1;

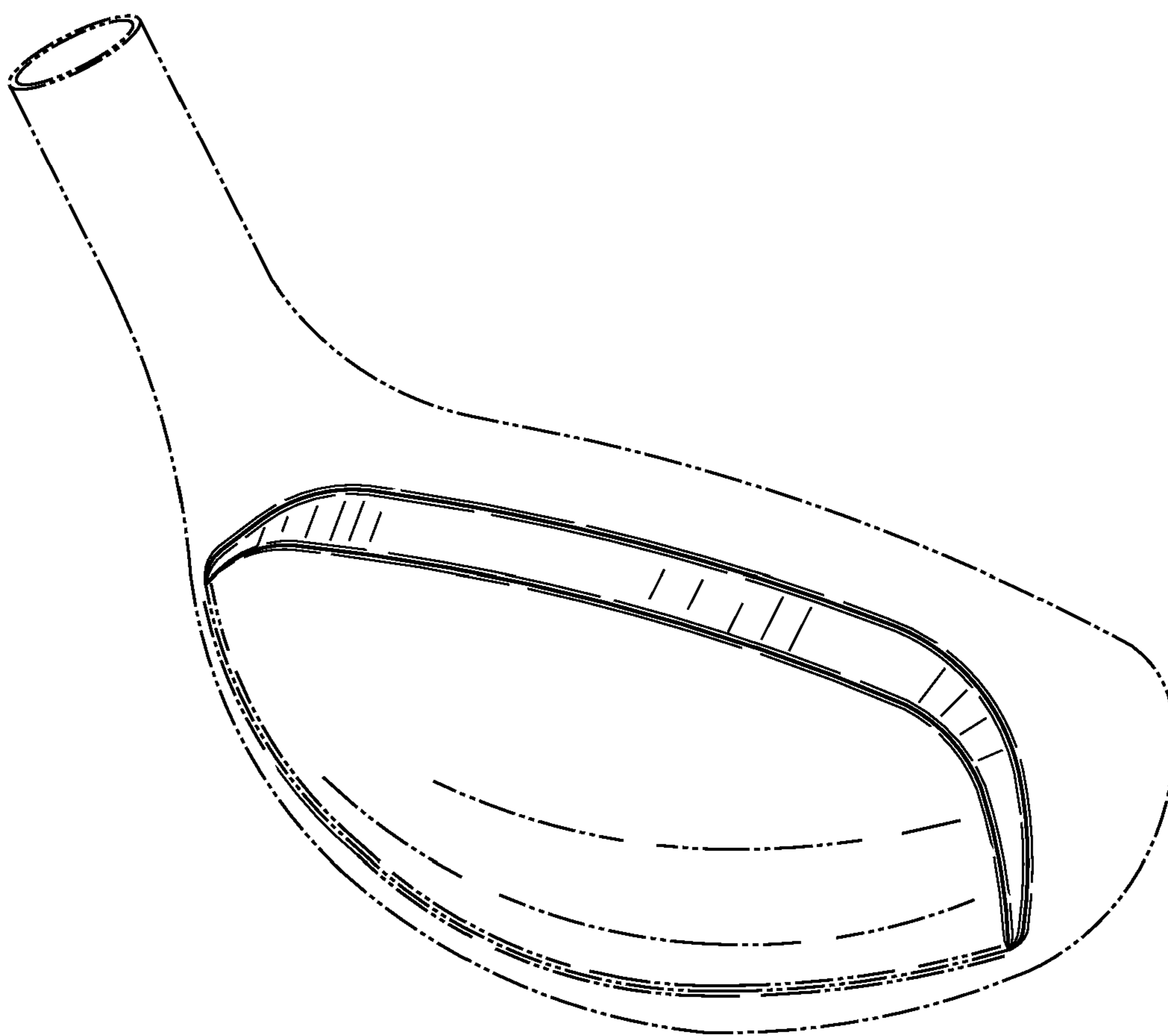

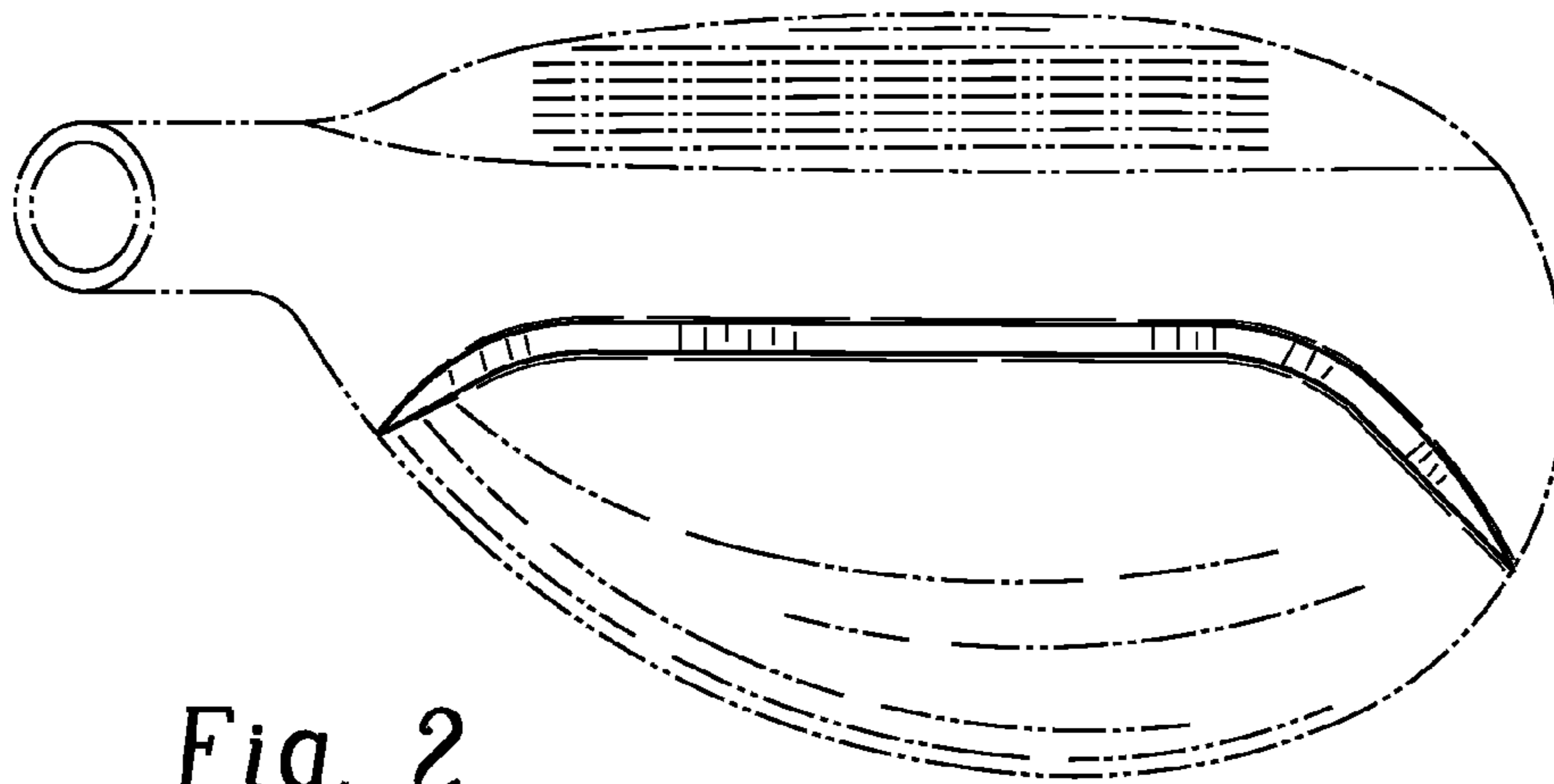

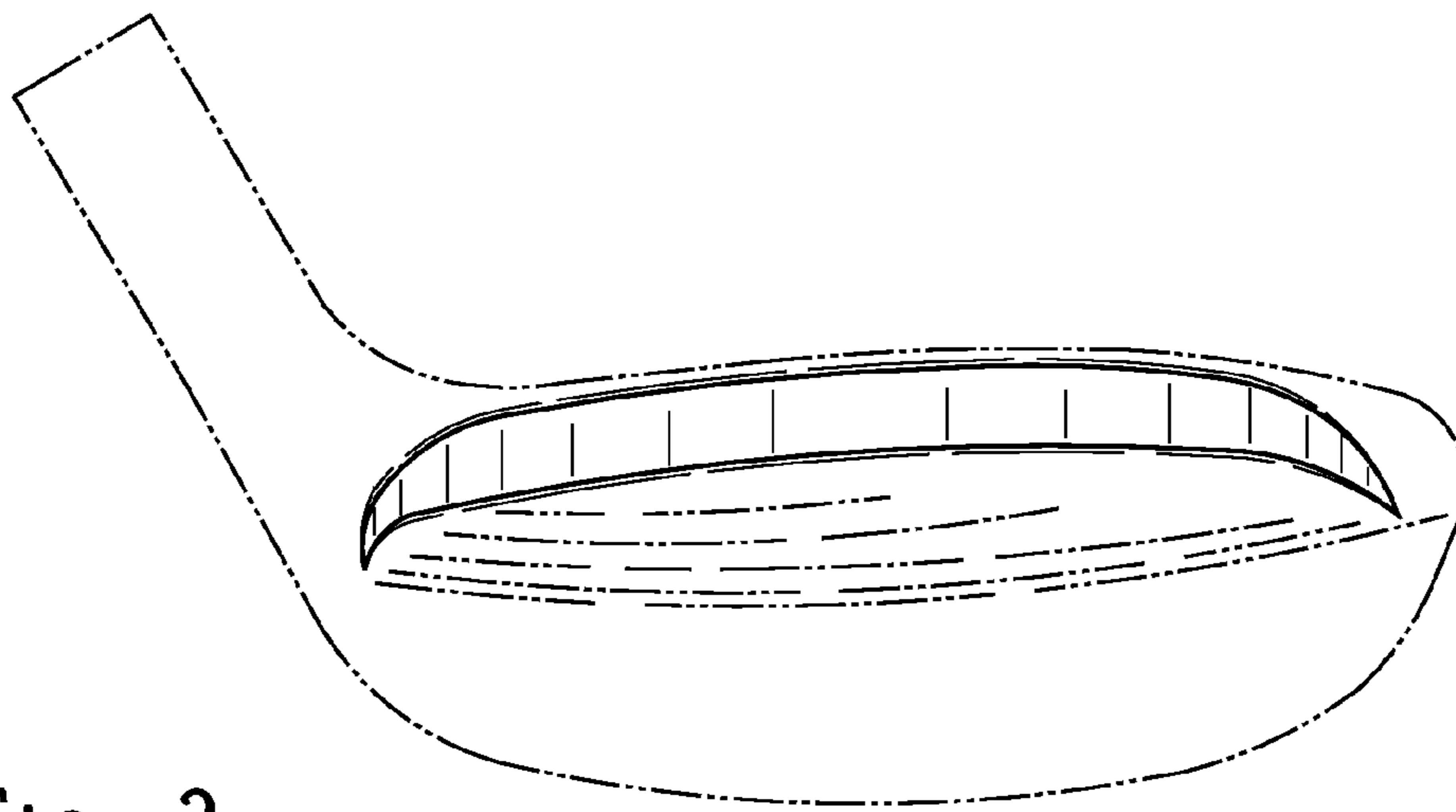

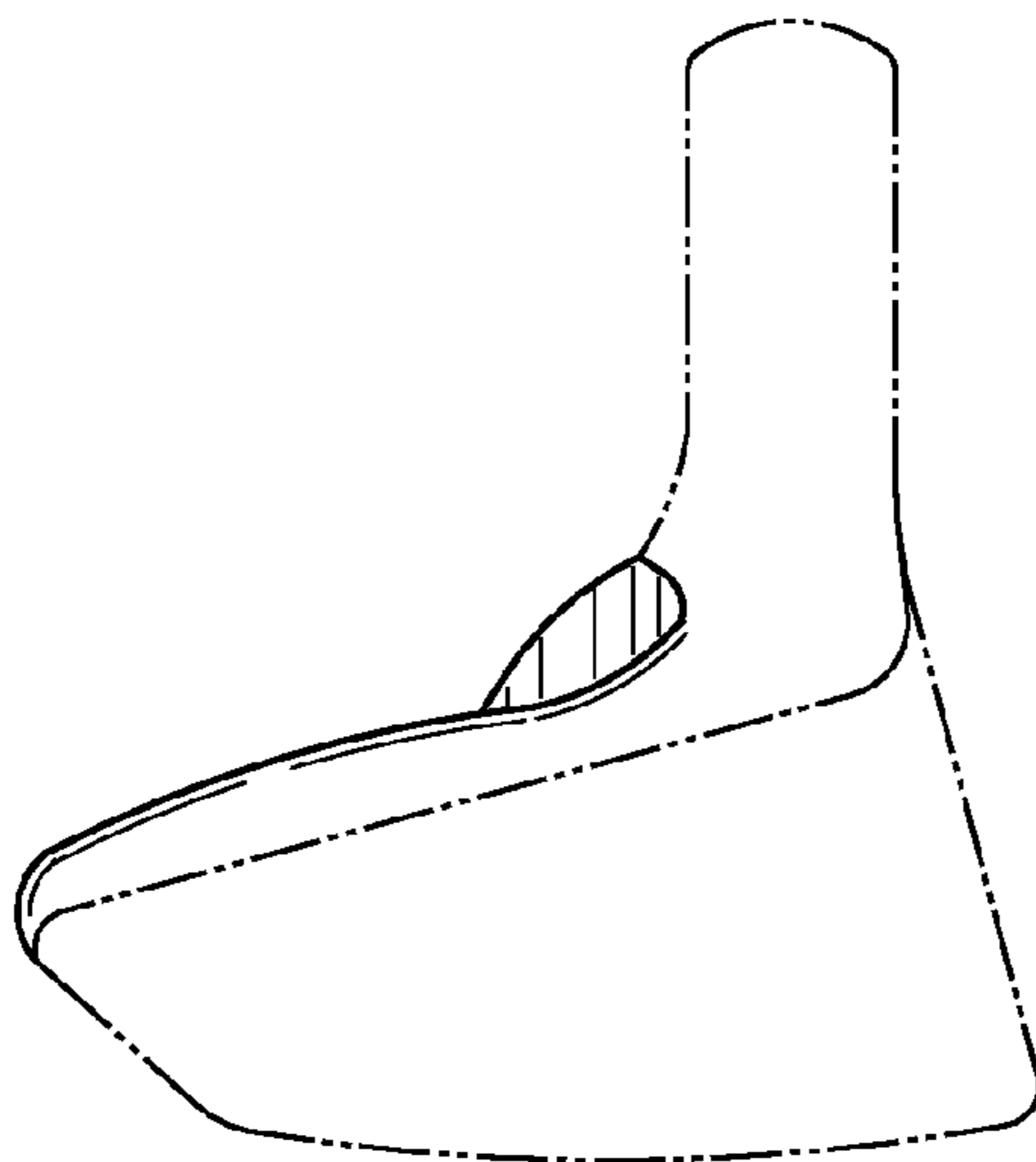

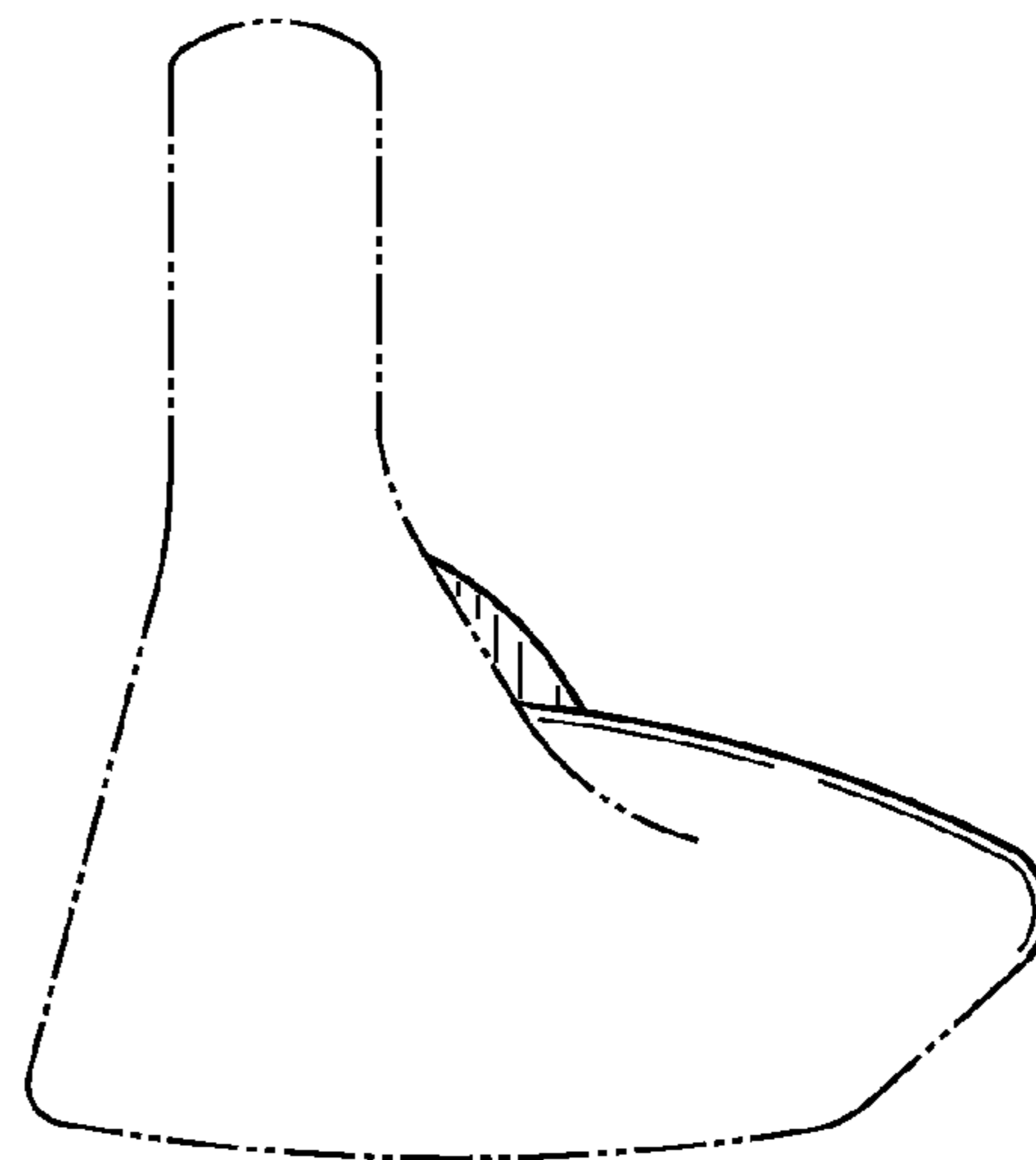
