
The ornamental design for a crib, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION


- FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing our new design for a crib.
- FIG. 2 is a right side plan view thereof, the left side being a mirror image.
- FIG. 3 is a front plan view thereof, the back side being a mirror image.
- FIG. 4 is a cross-section plan view along lines 4—4 of FIG. 2, the opposite direction cross-section along 4—4 of FIG. 2 being a mirror image.
- FIG. 5 is a cross-section plan view along lines 5—5 of FIG. 2, the opposite direction cross-section along lines 5—5 of FIG. 2 being a mirror image.
- FIG. 6 is a side plan view of a portion of FIG. 2, the opposite side of the portion being a mirror image.
- FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
- FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof.














