FIG. 5 is a side elevation view of the side opposite of that shown in FIG. 4;

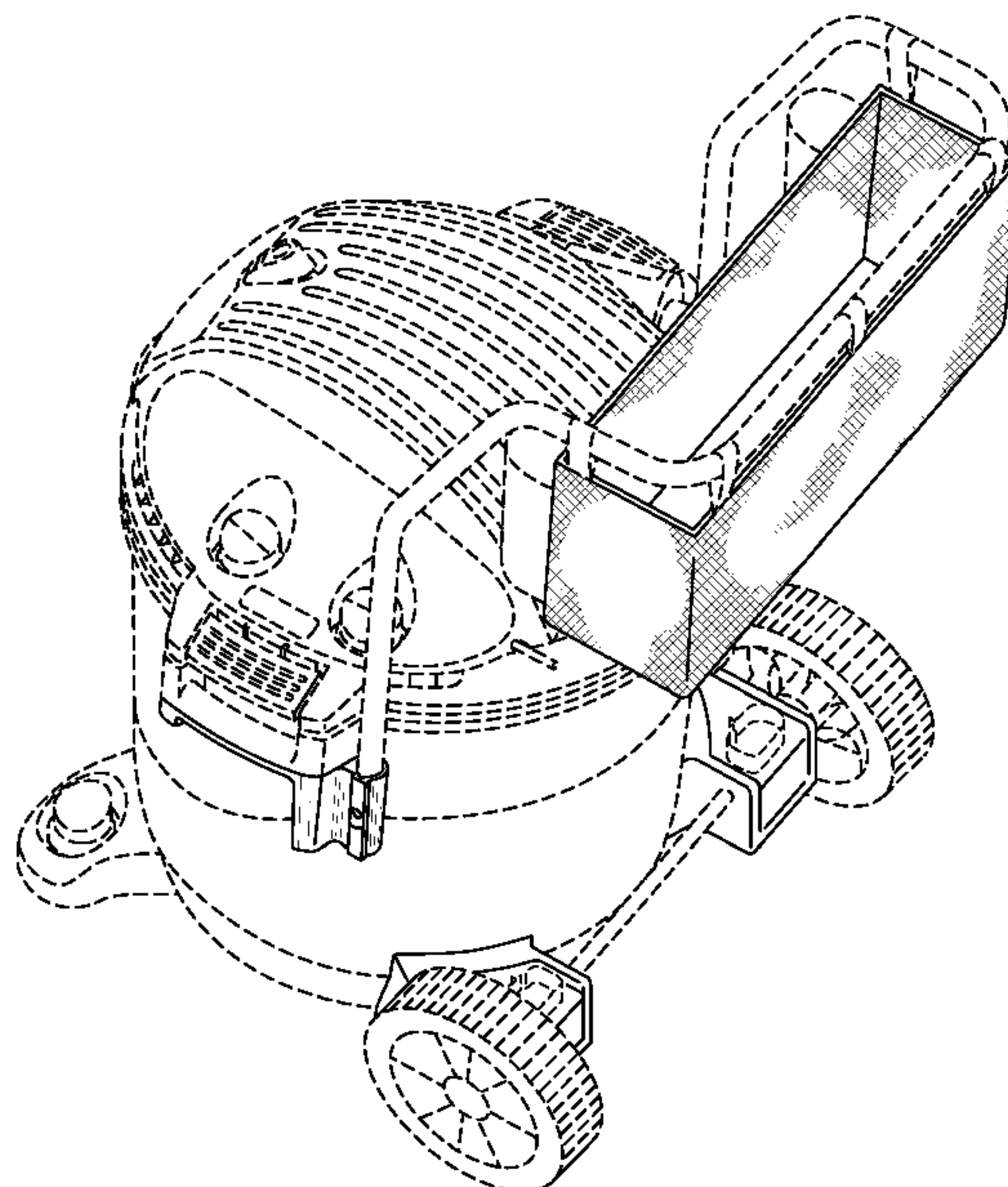
FIG. 6 is a top view;

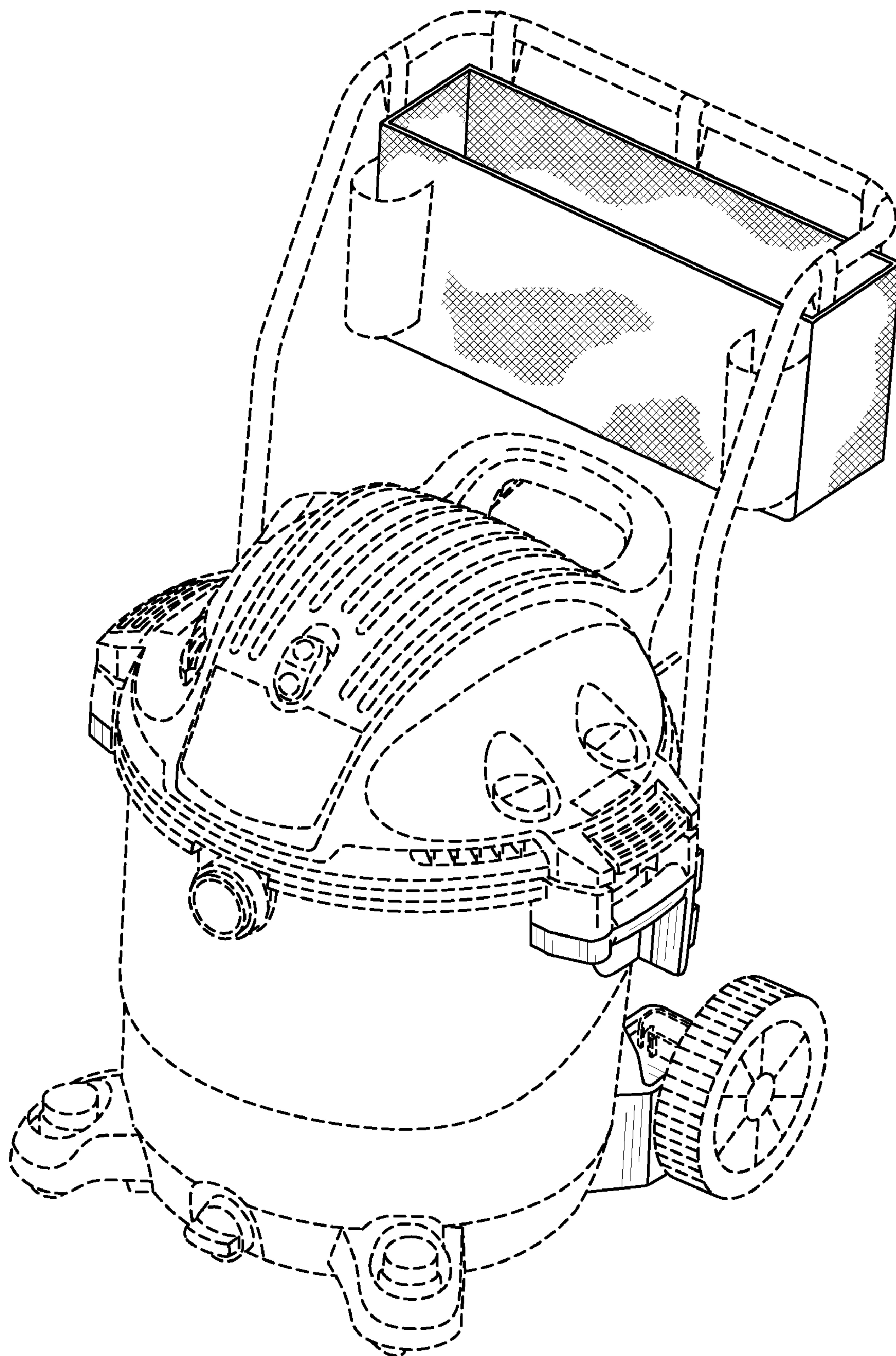

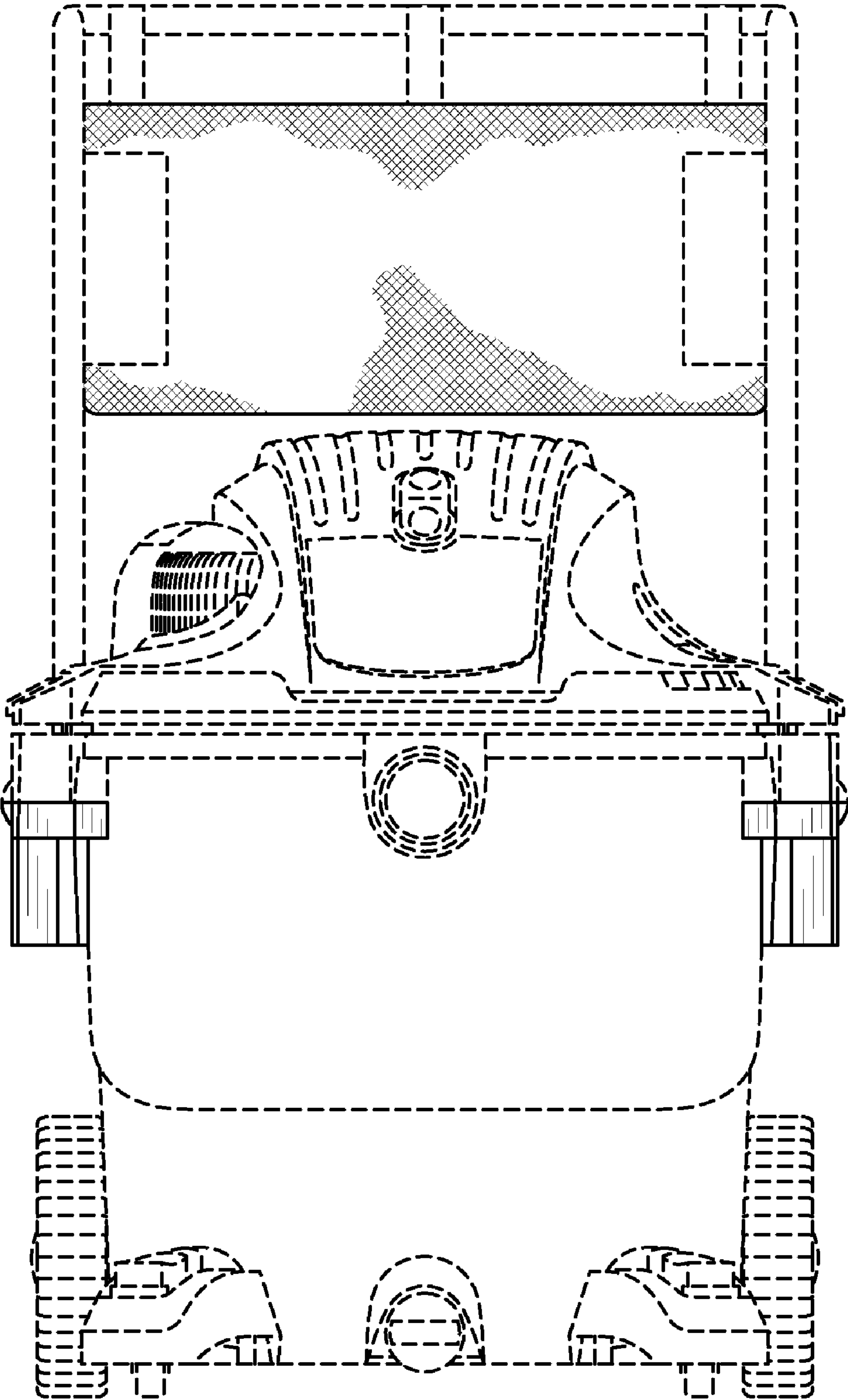

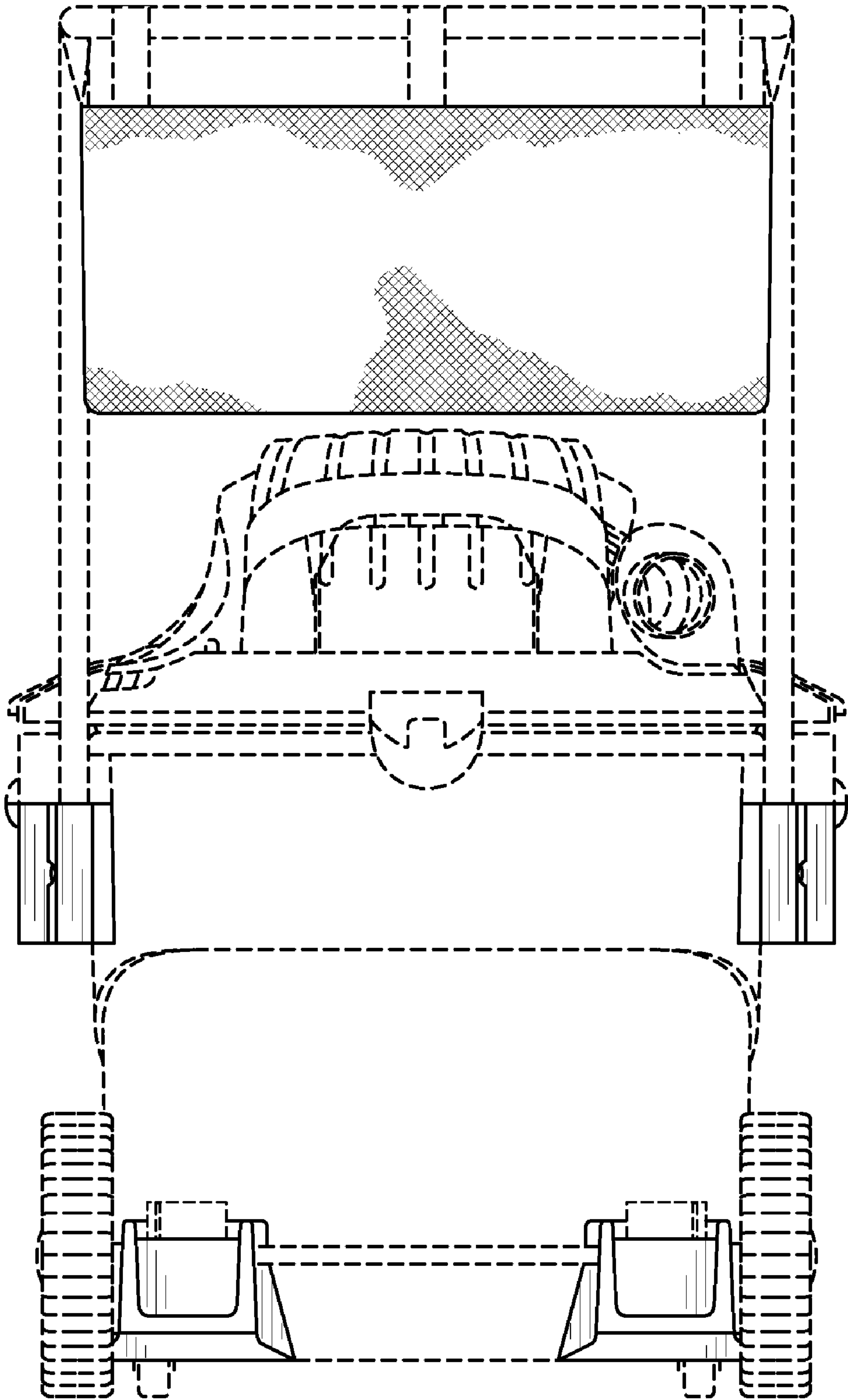

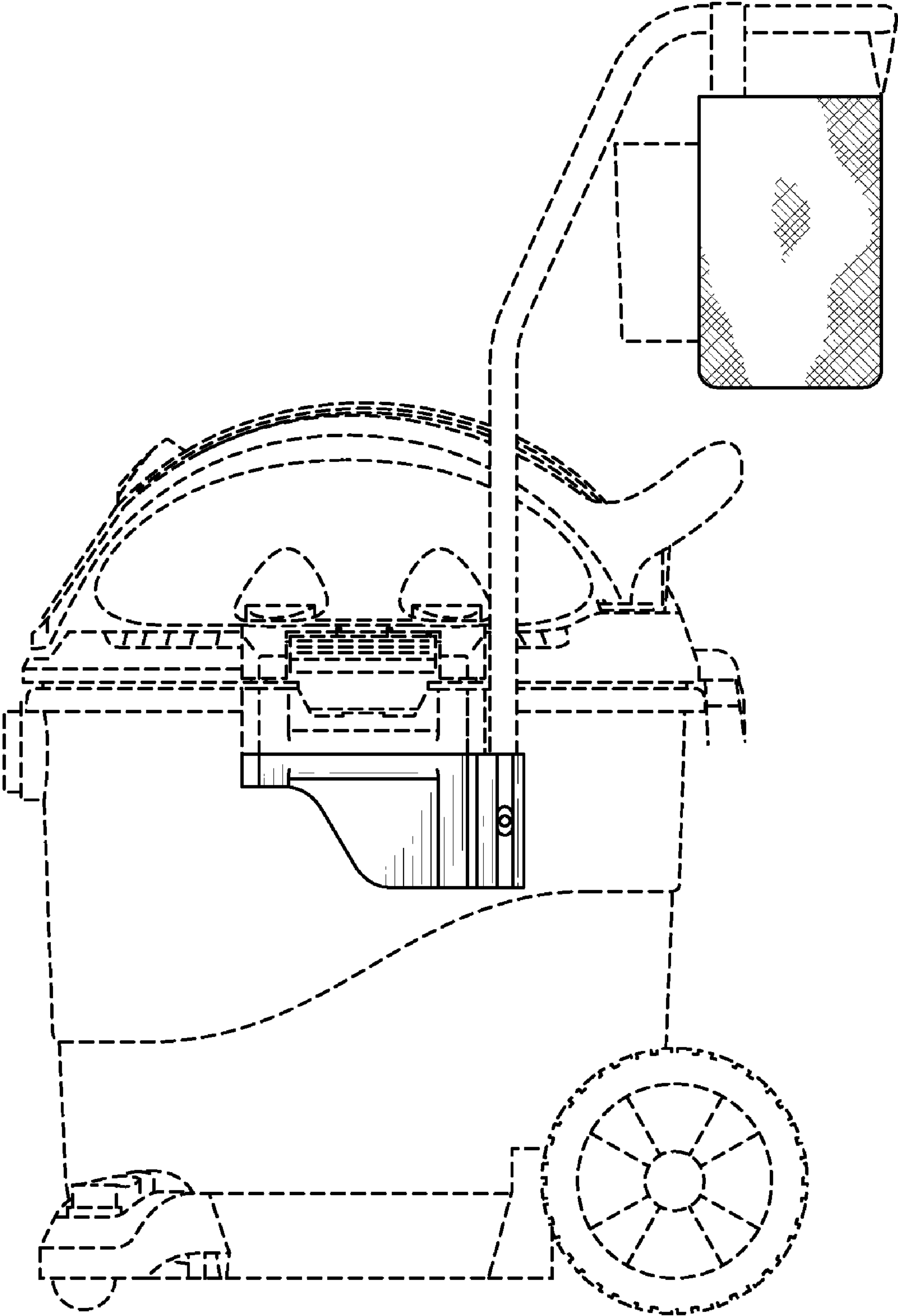

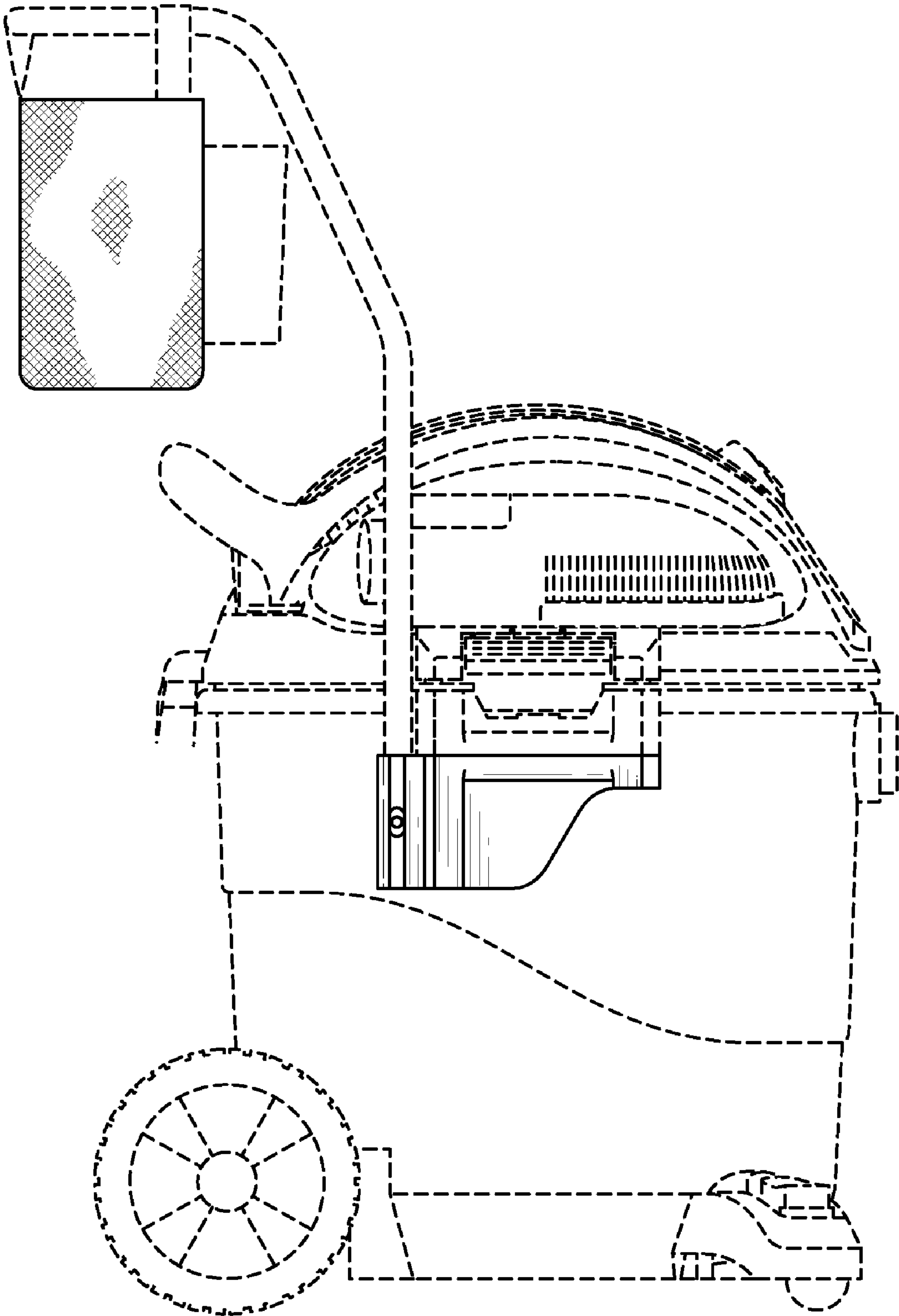

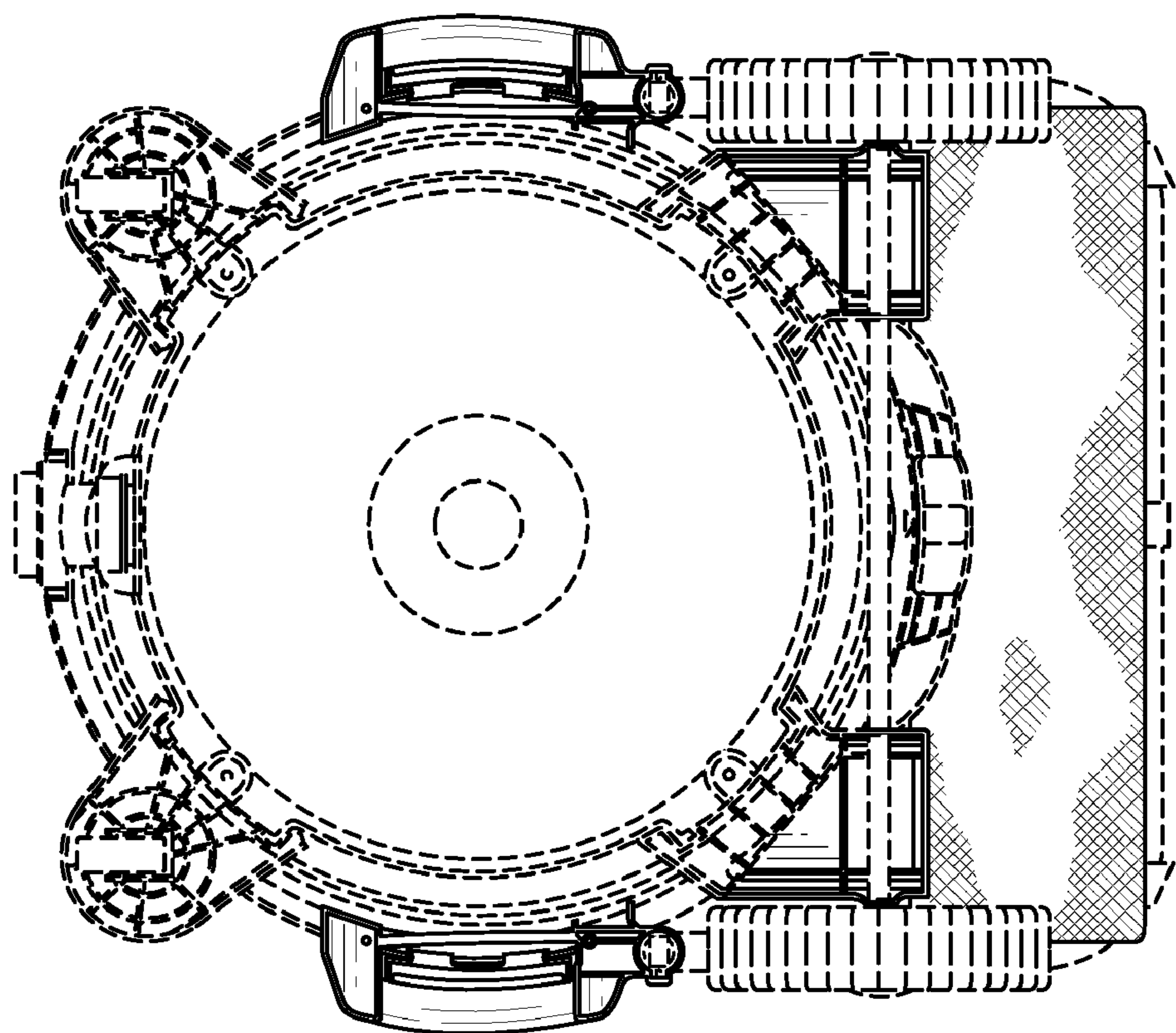

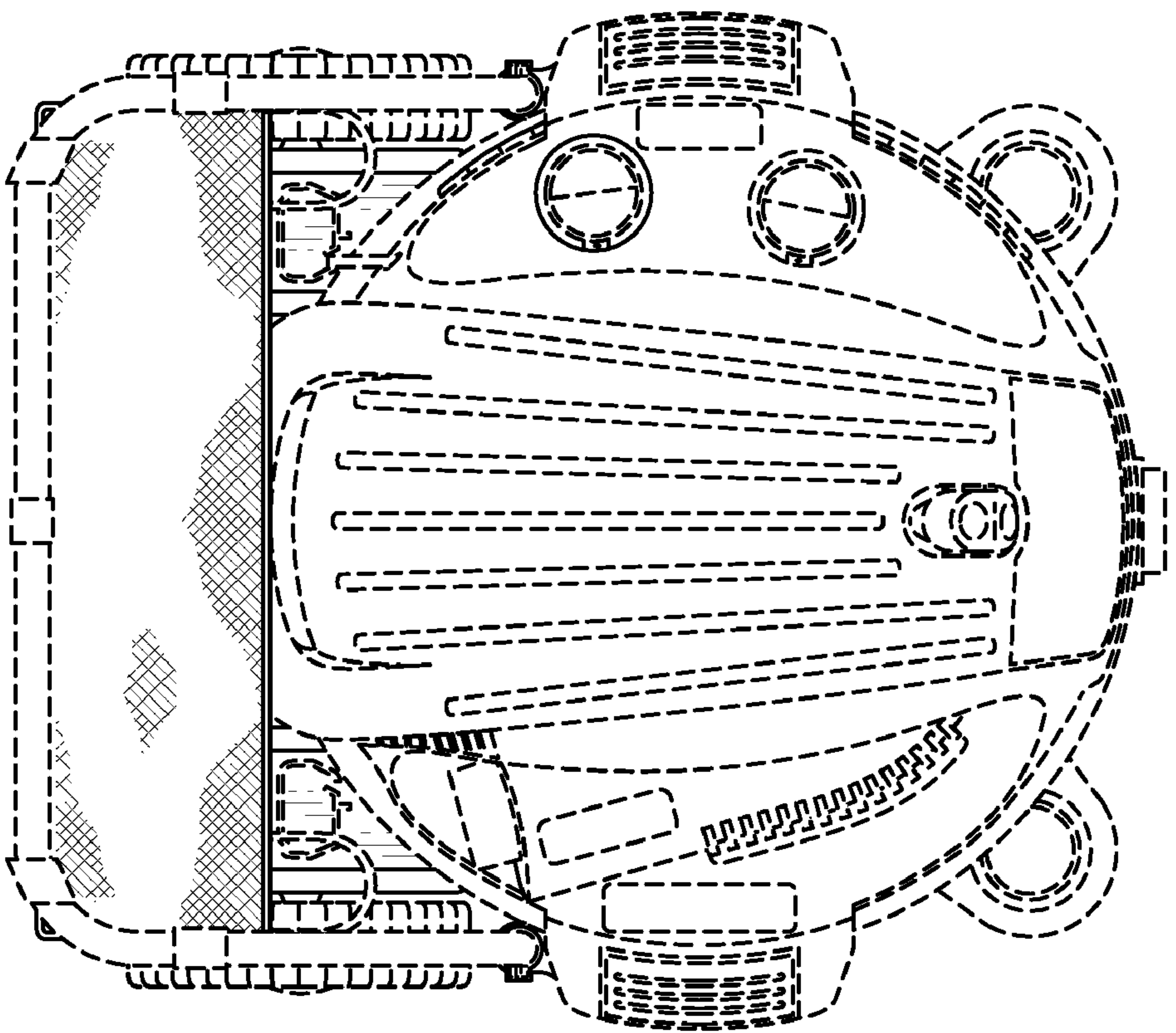

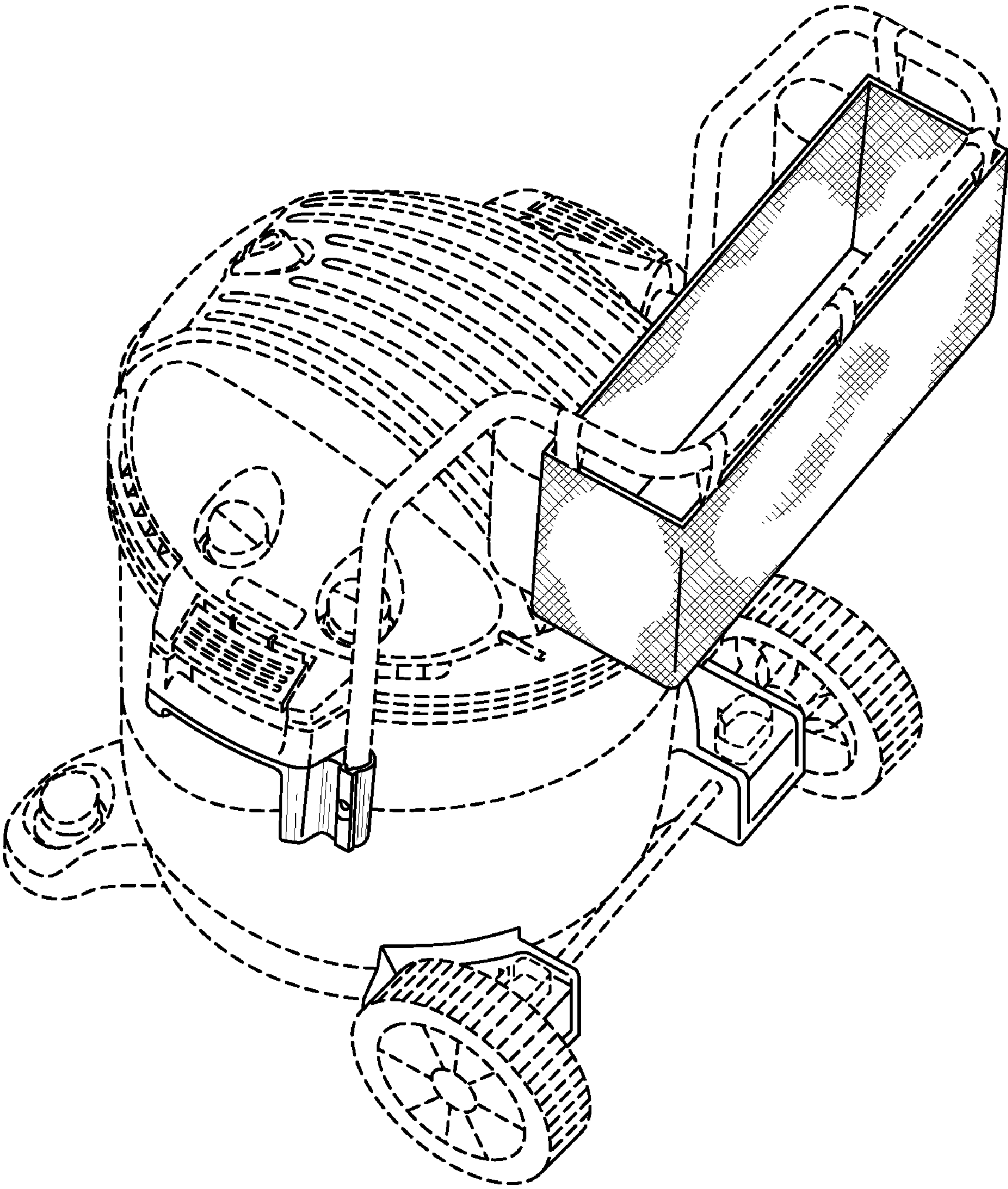
