FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of a paint brush.

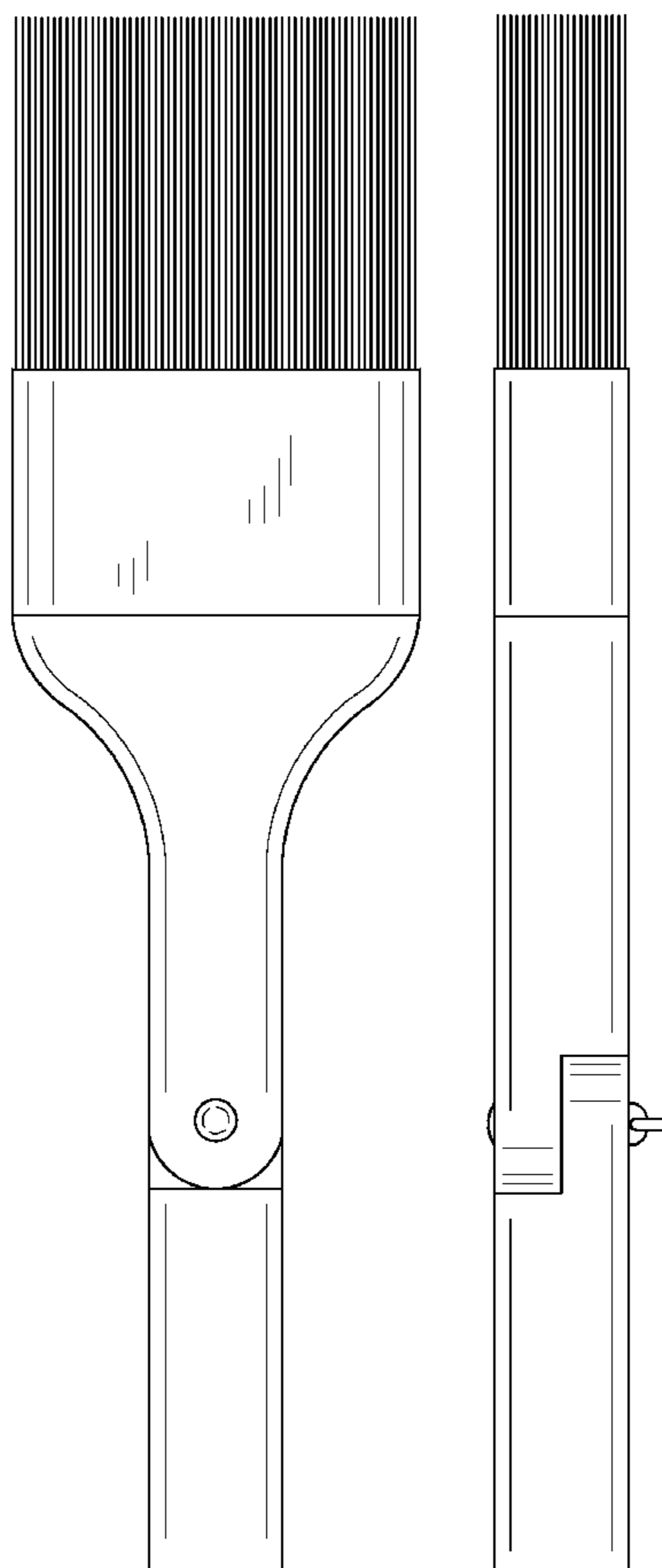

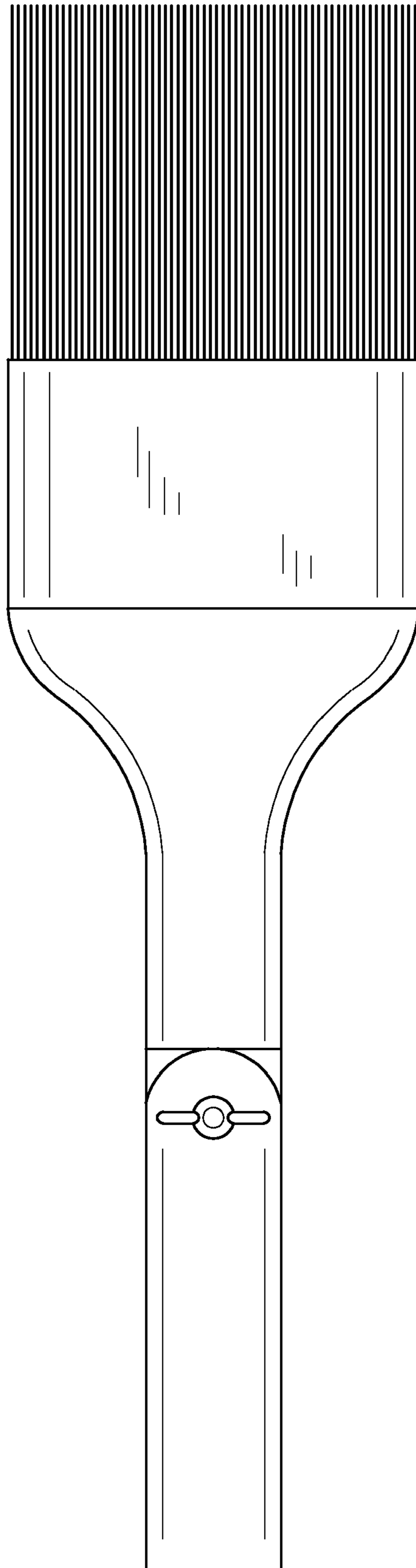

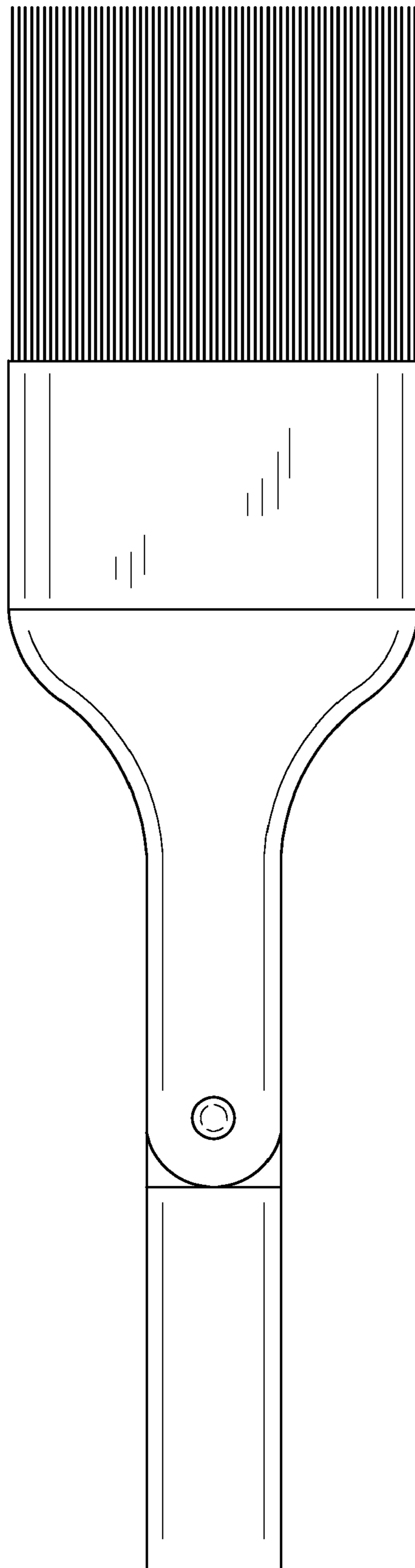

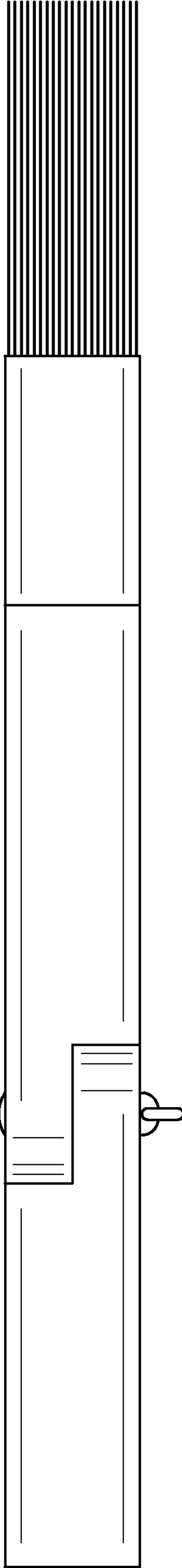

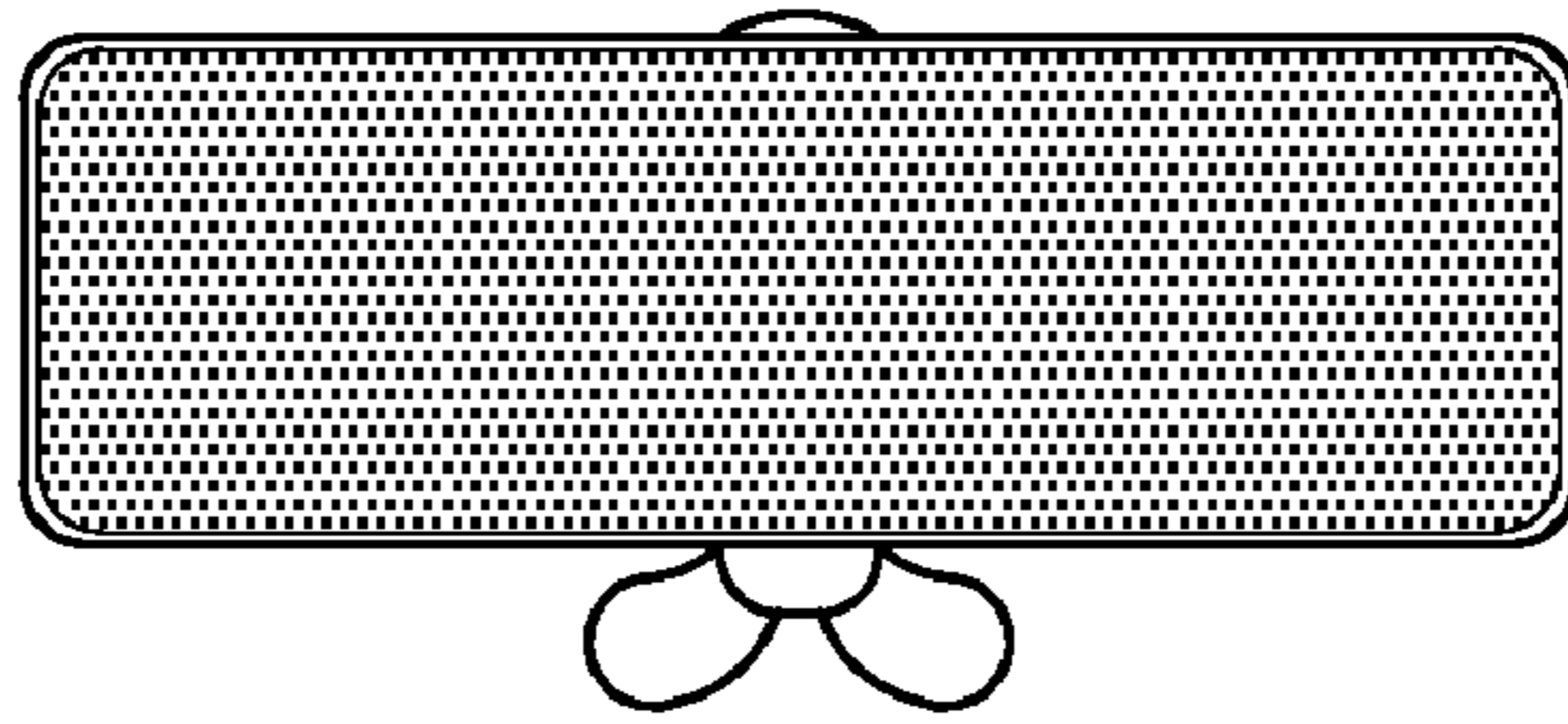

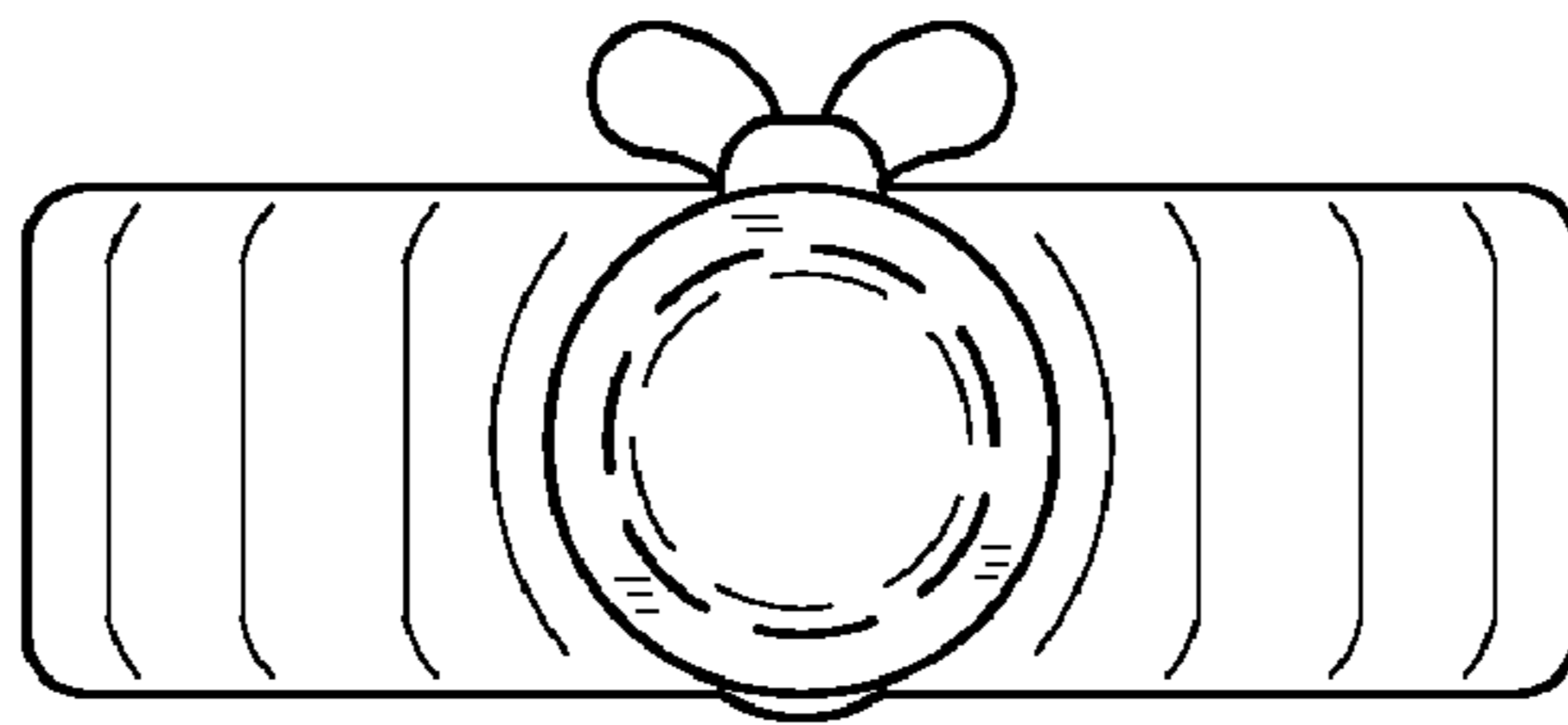
