FIG. 4 is a right side elevation thereof;

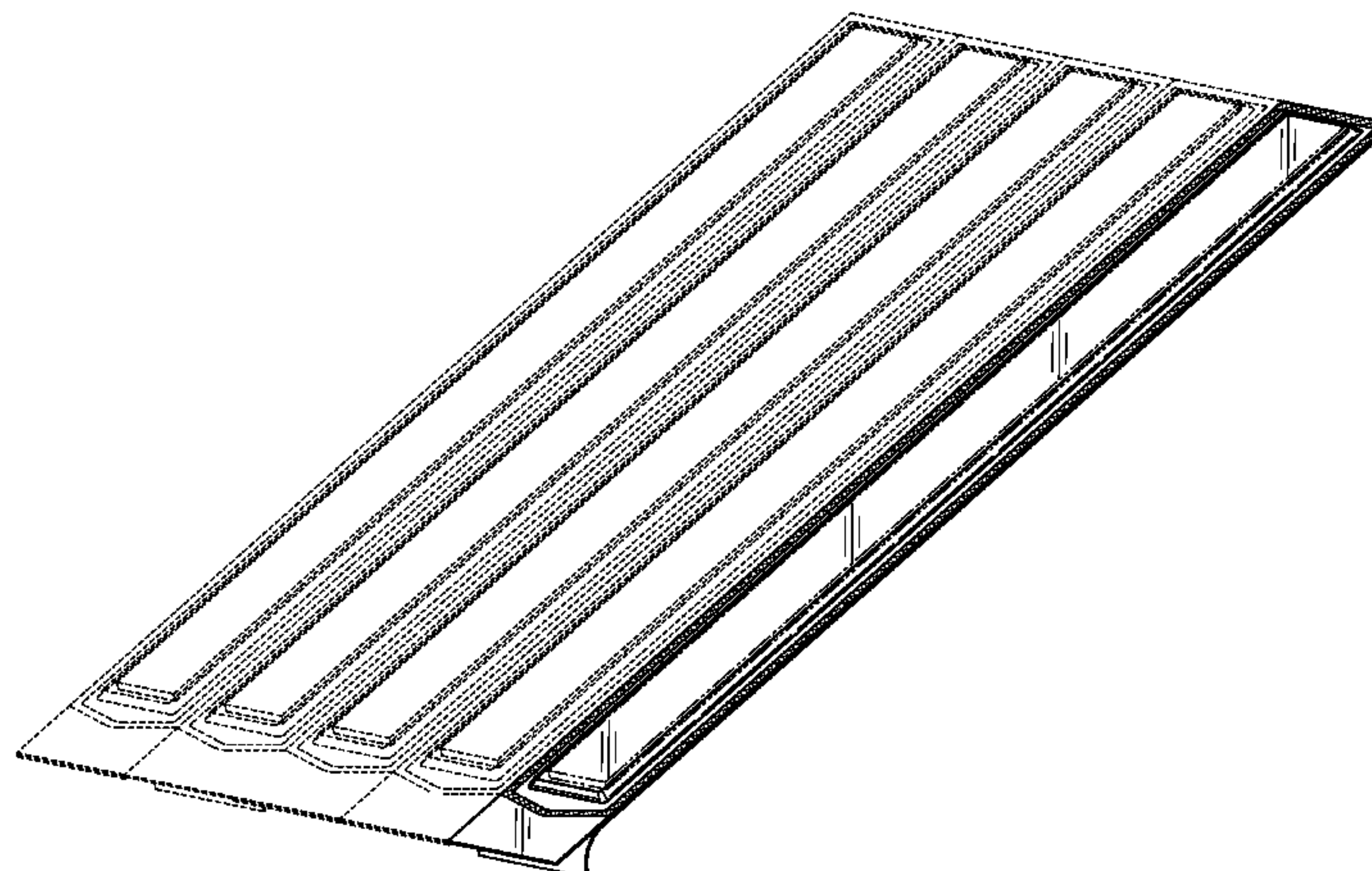
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation thereof;

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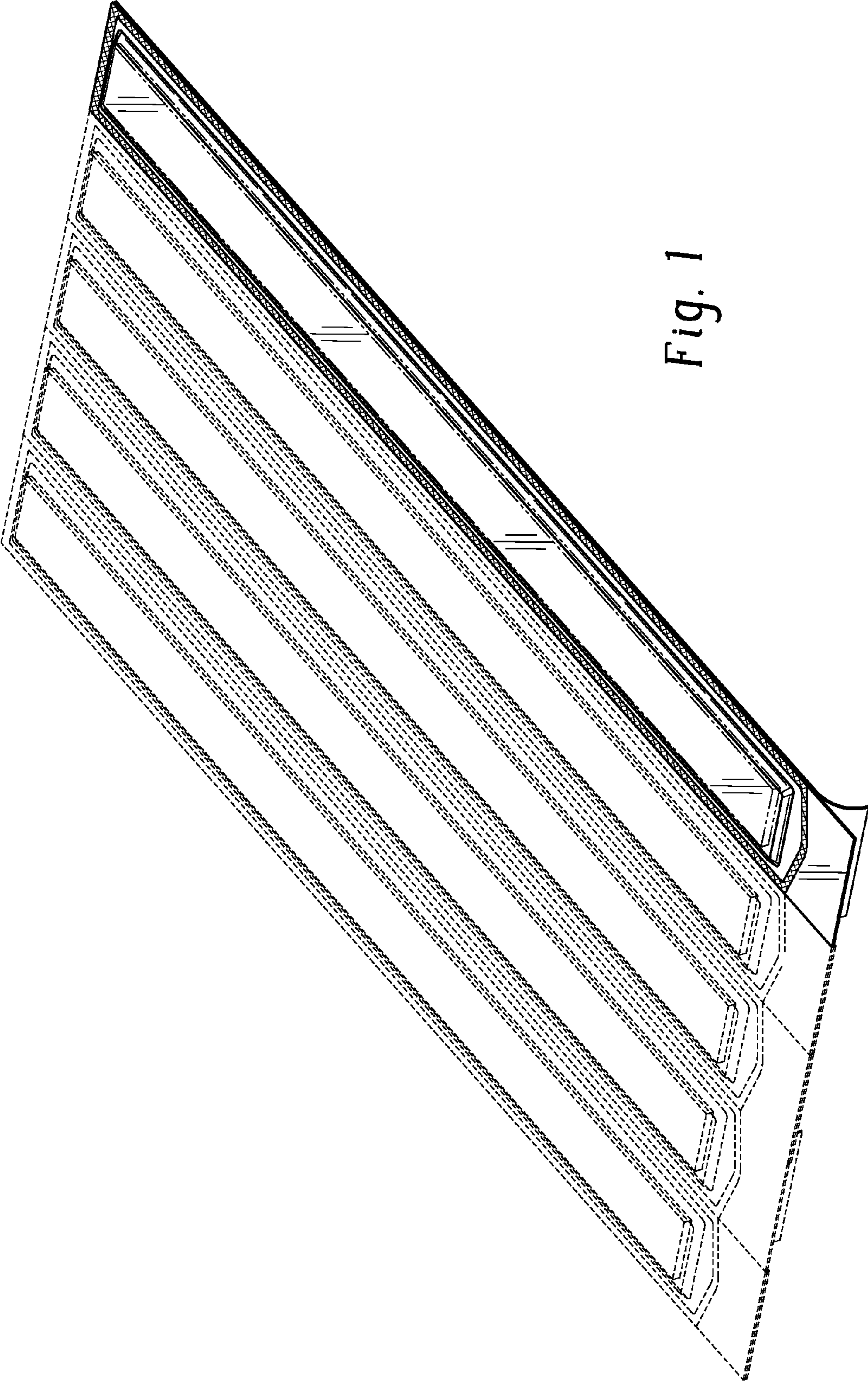

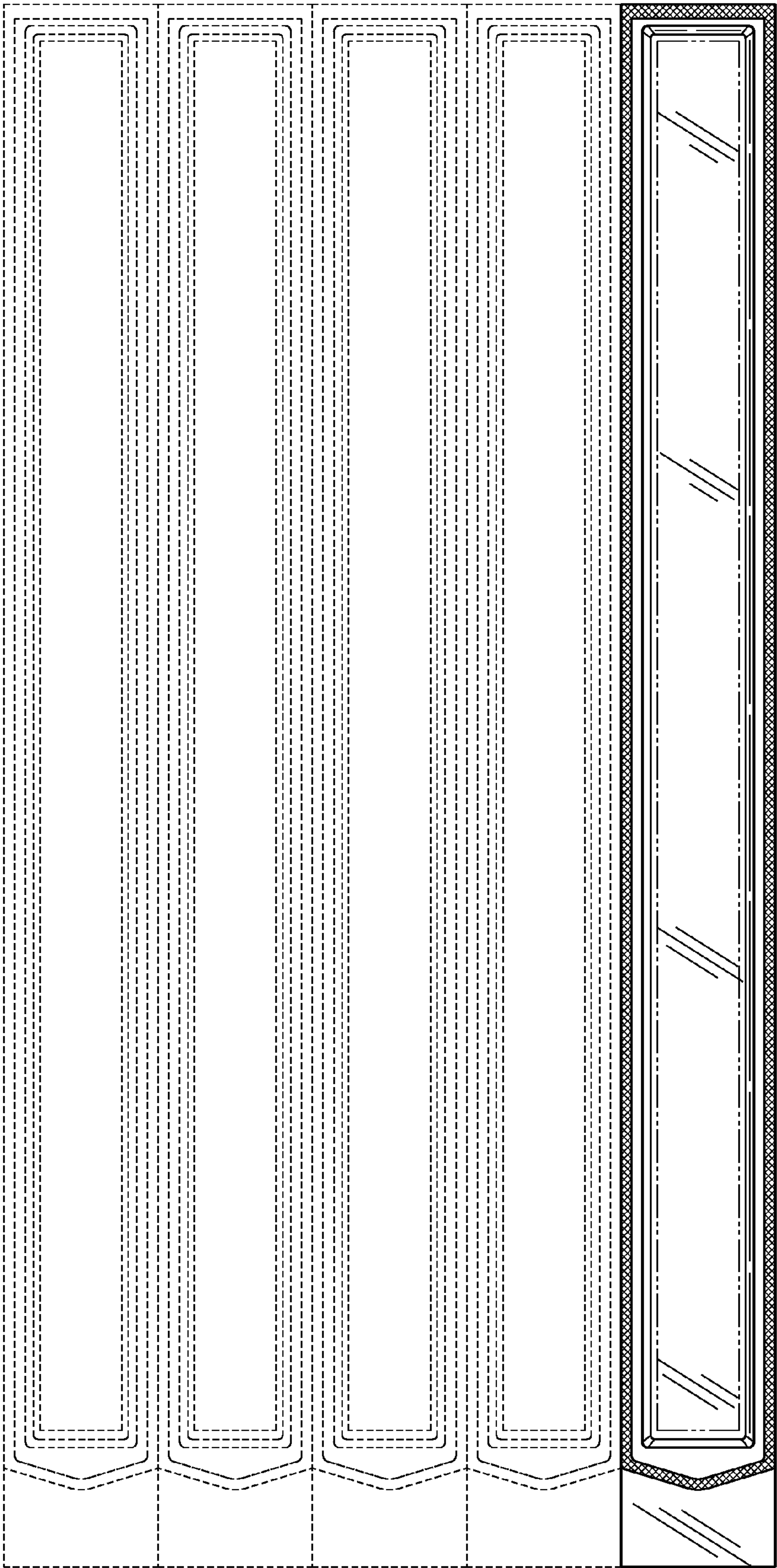

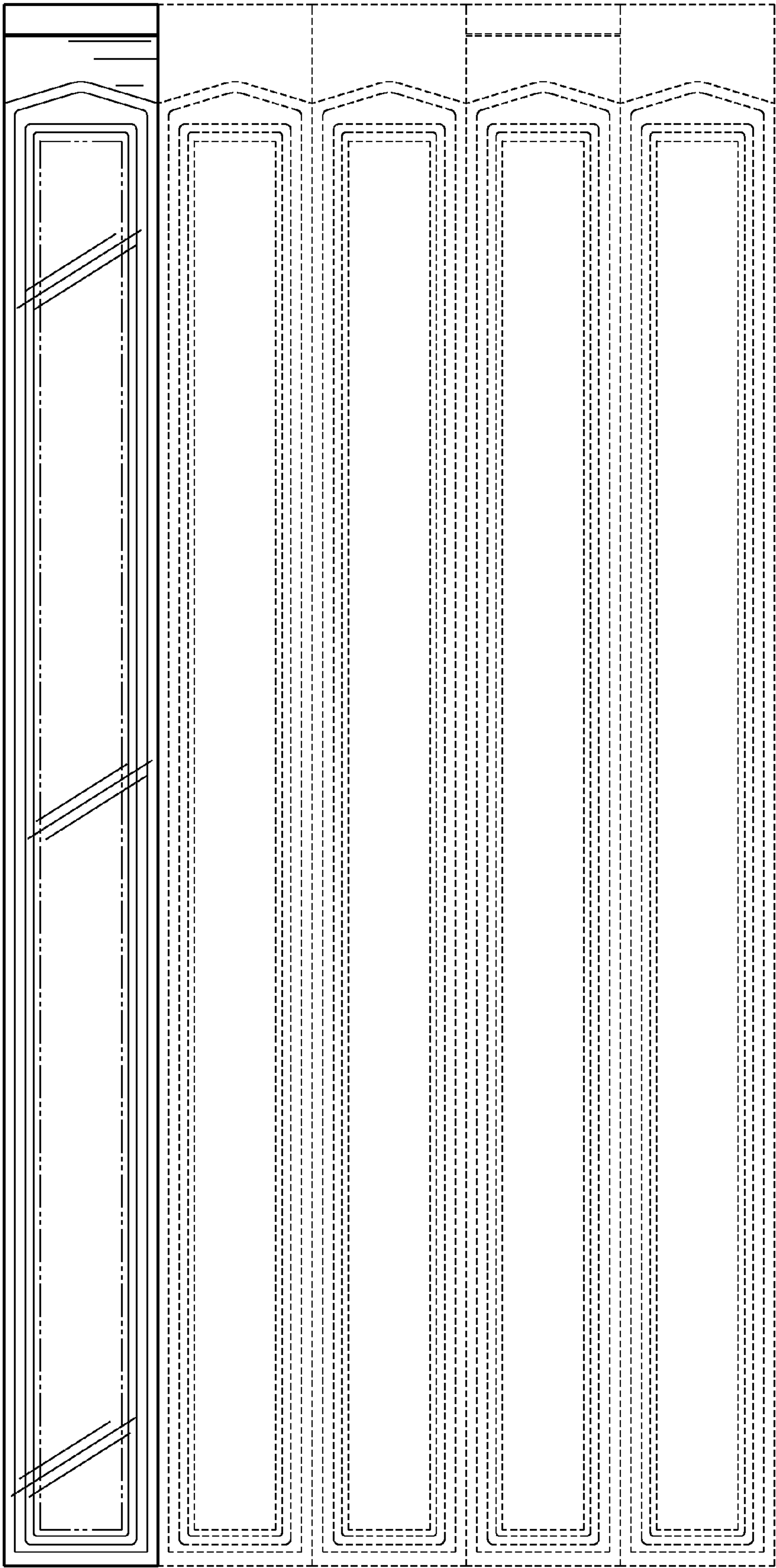

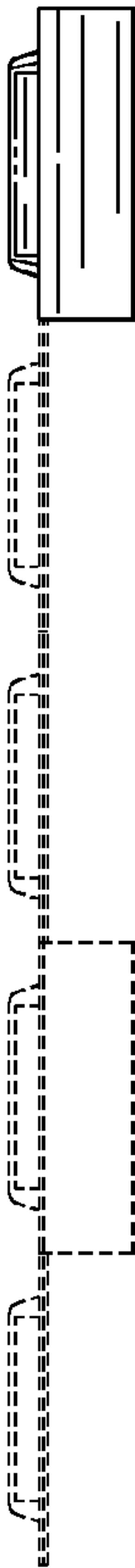

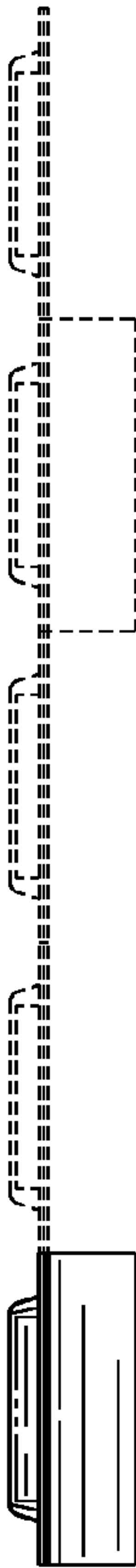
