FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view of the camera of the present invention, the portions shown in broken lines forming no part of the design sought to be patented;

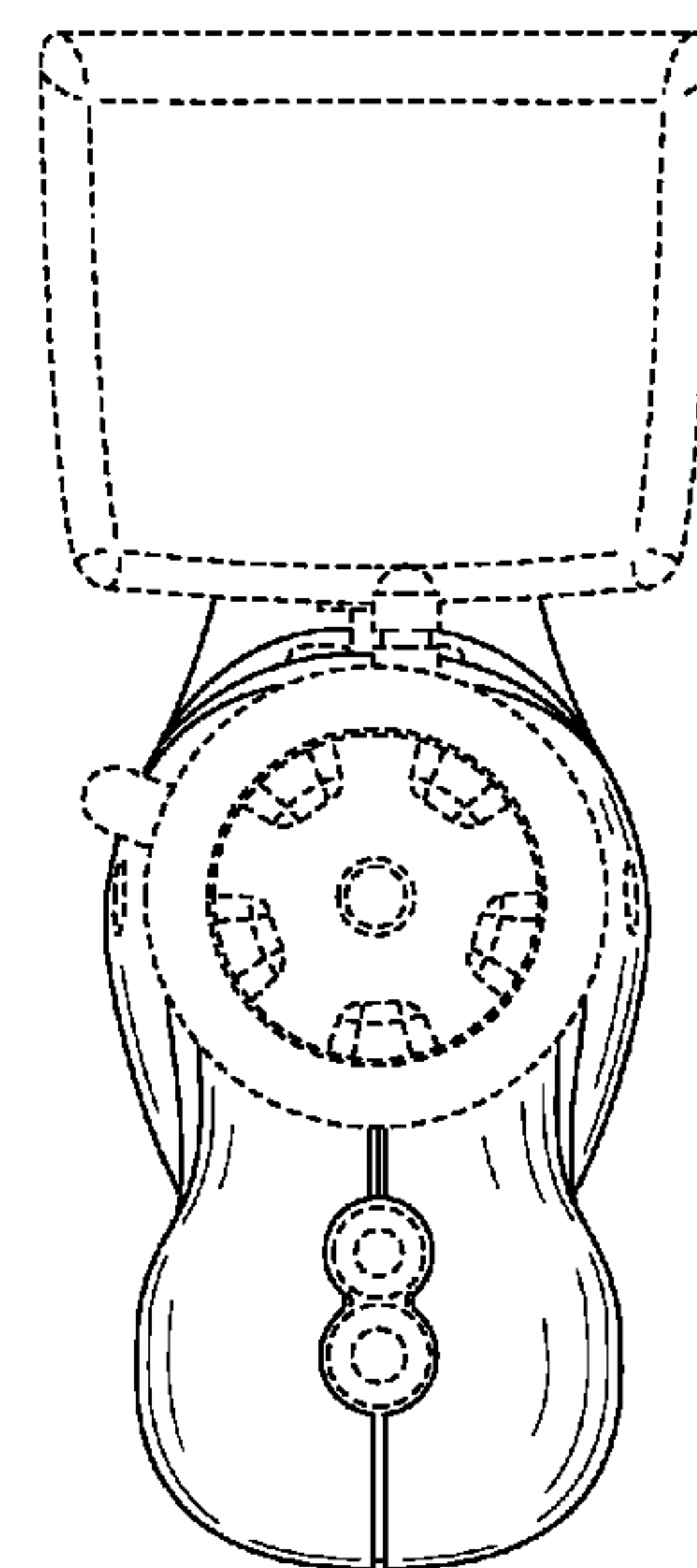
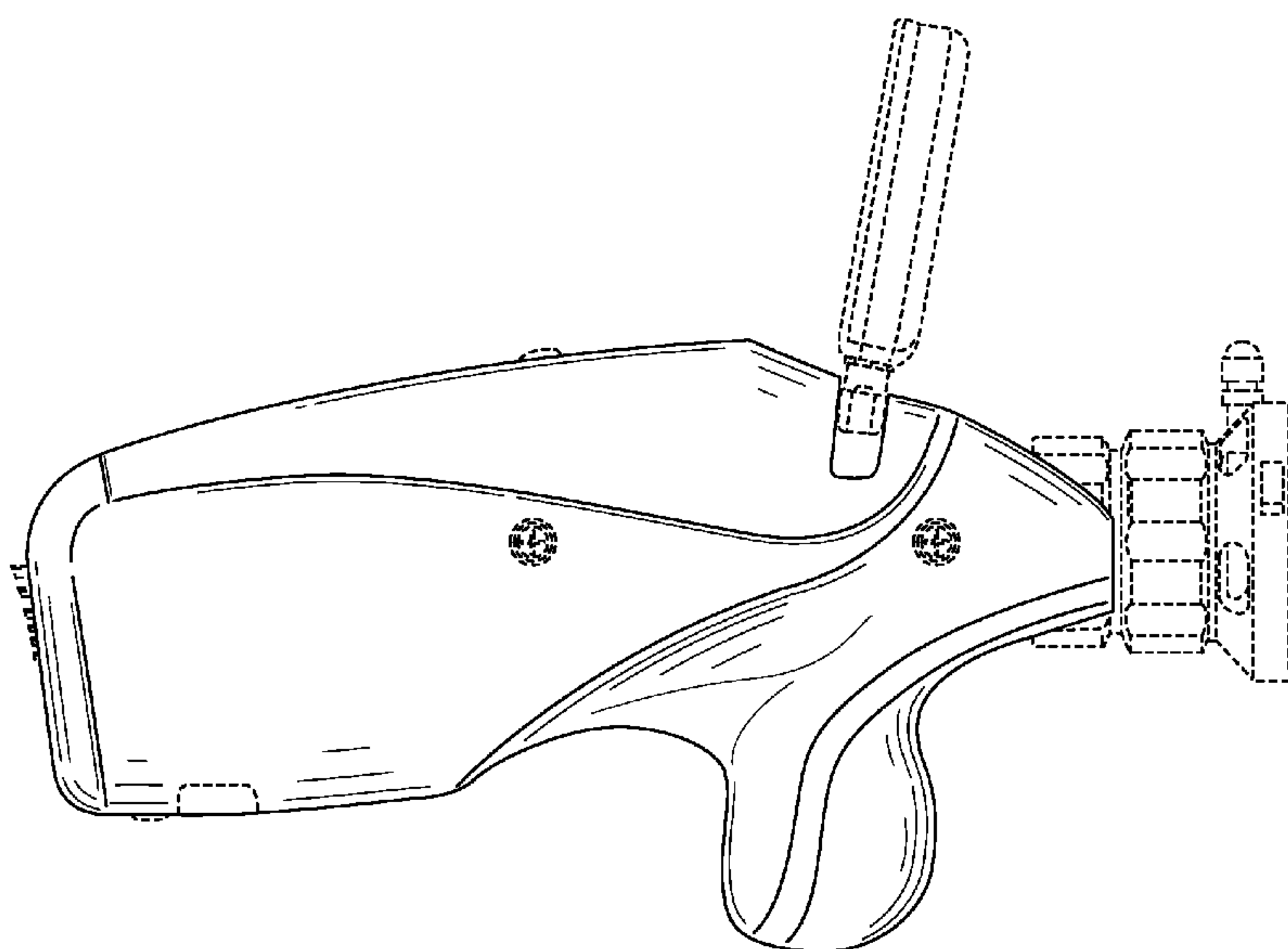
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the camera of the present invention, the portions shown in broken lines forming no part of the design sought to be patented;

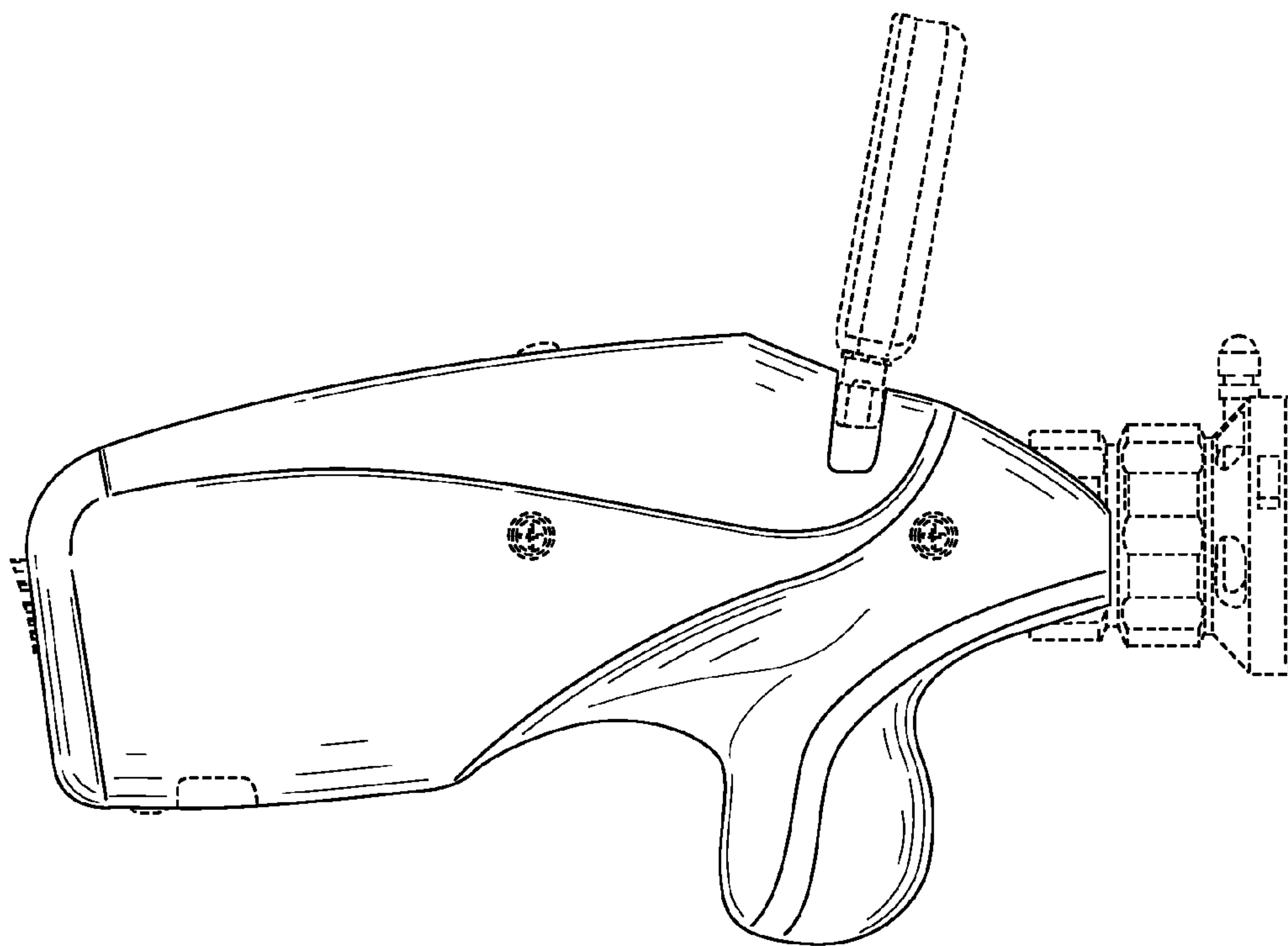

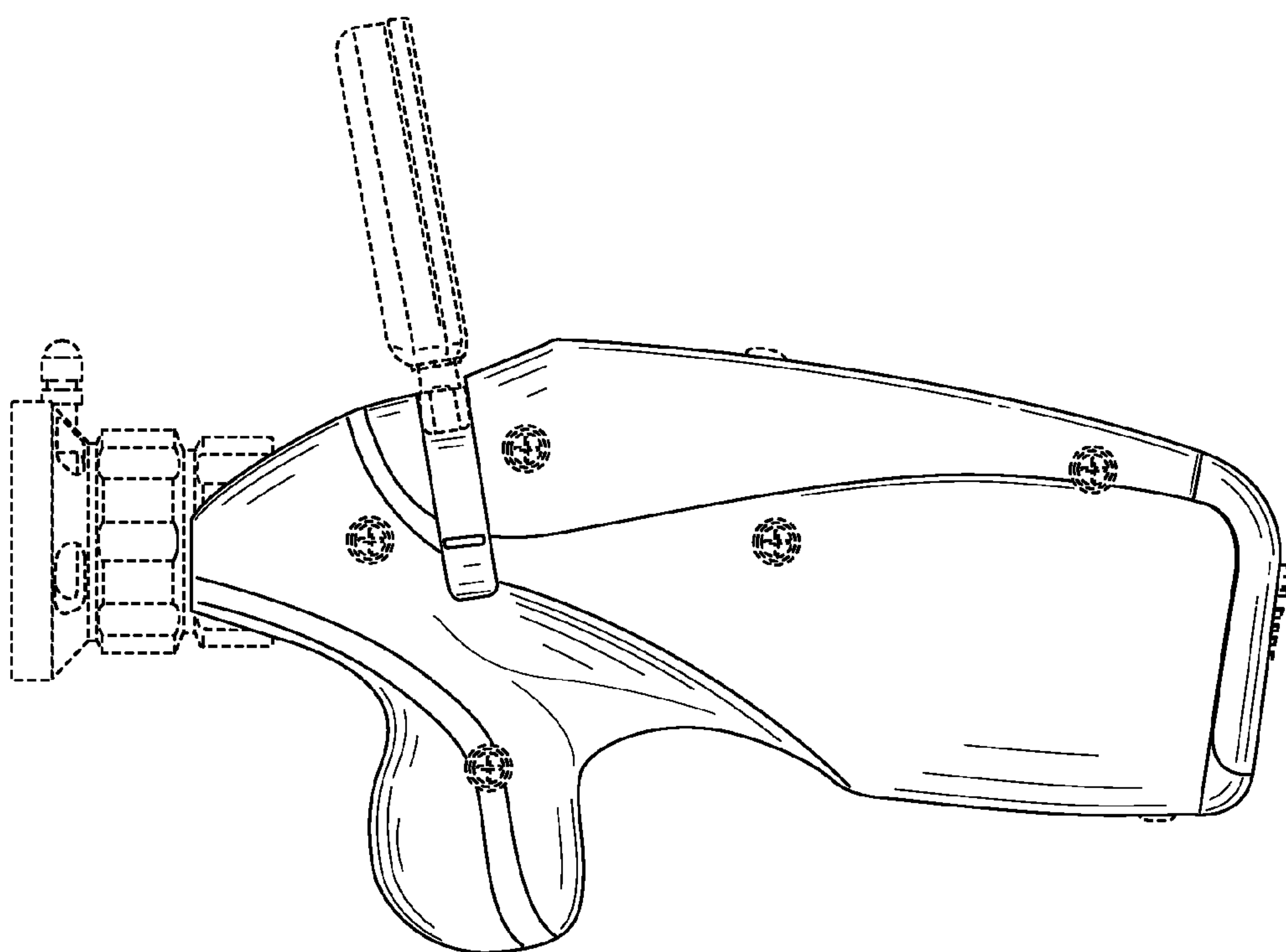

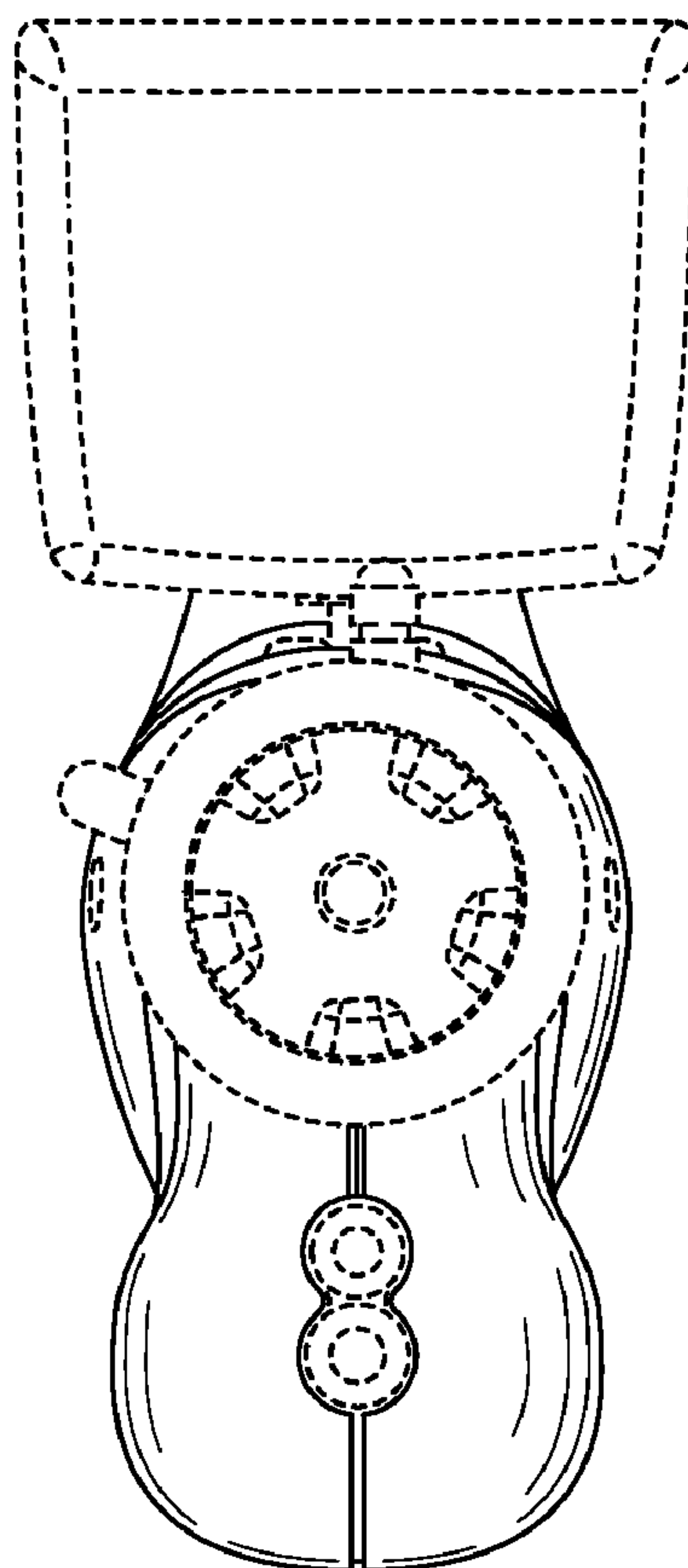

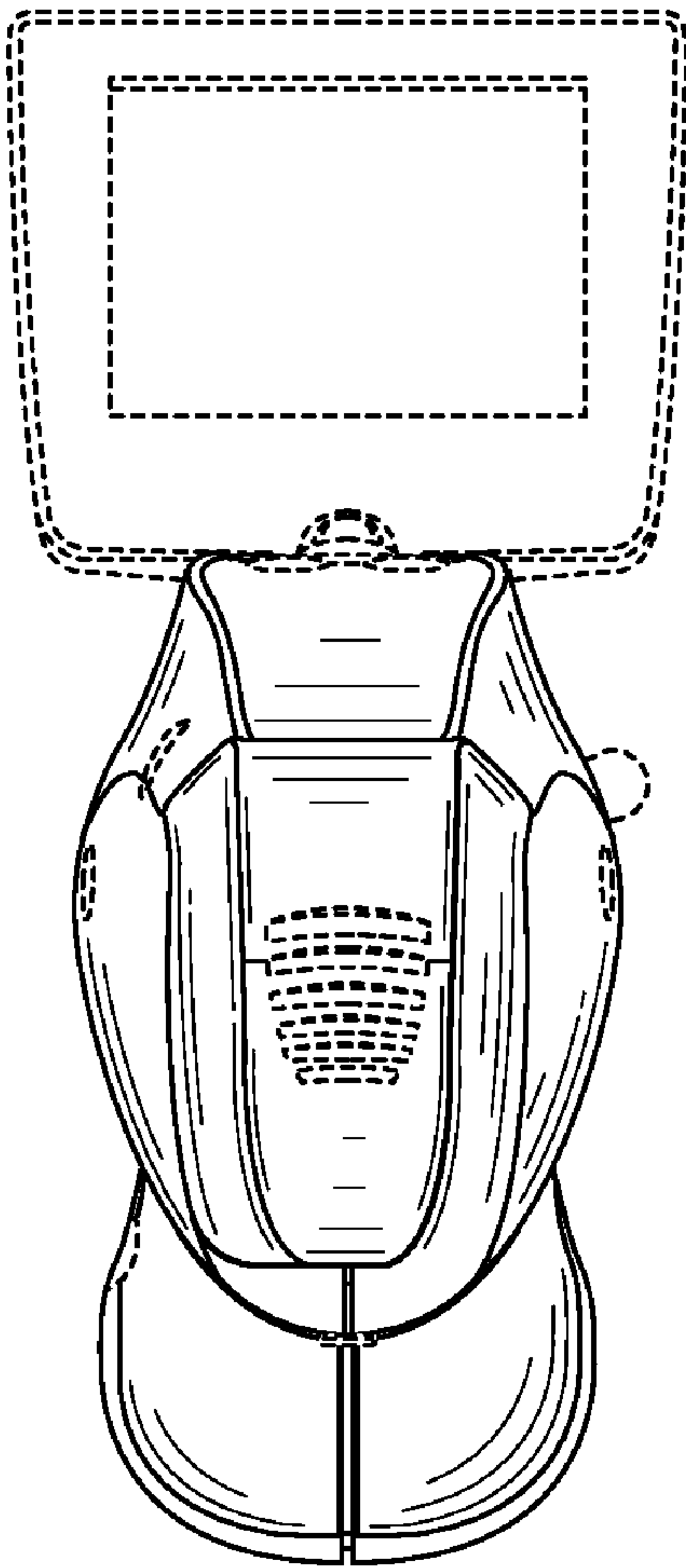

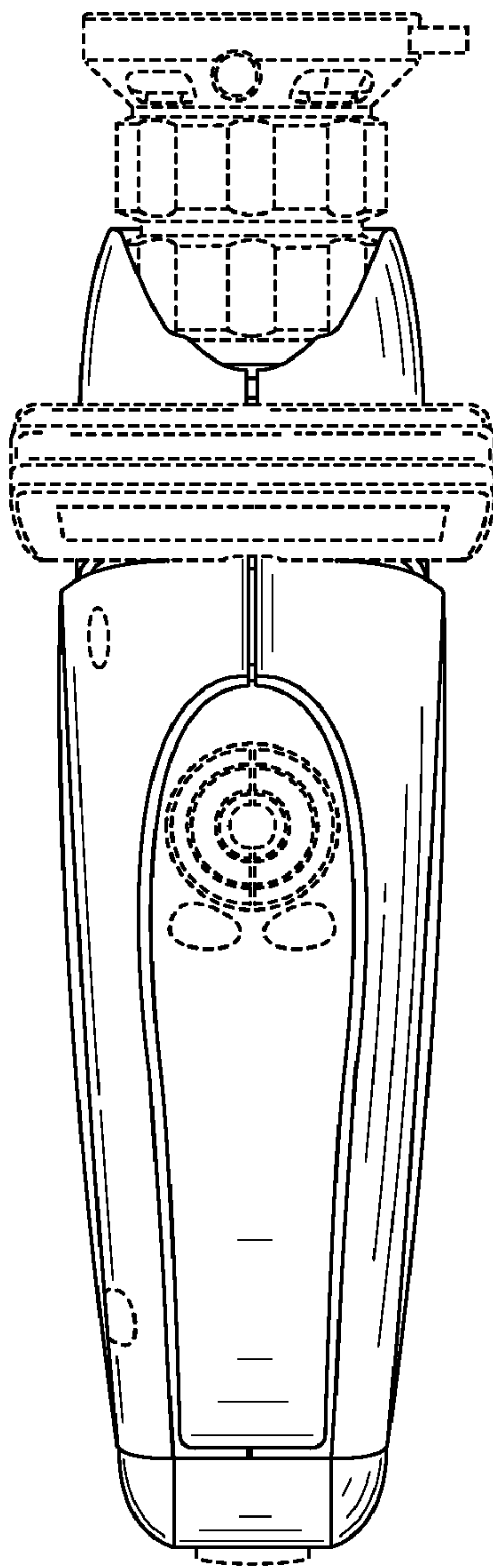

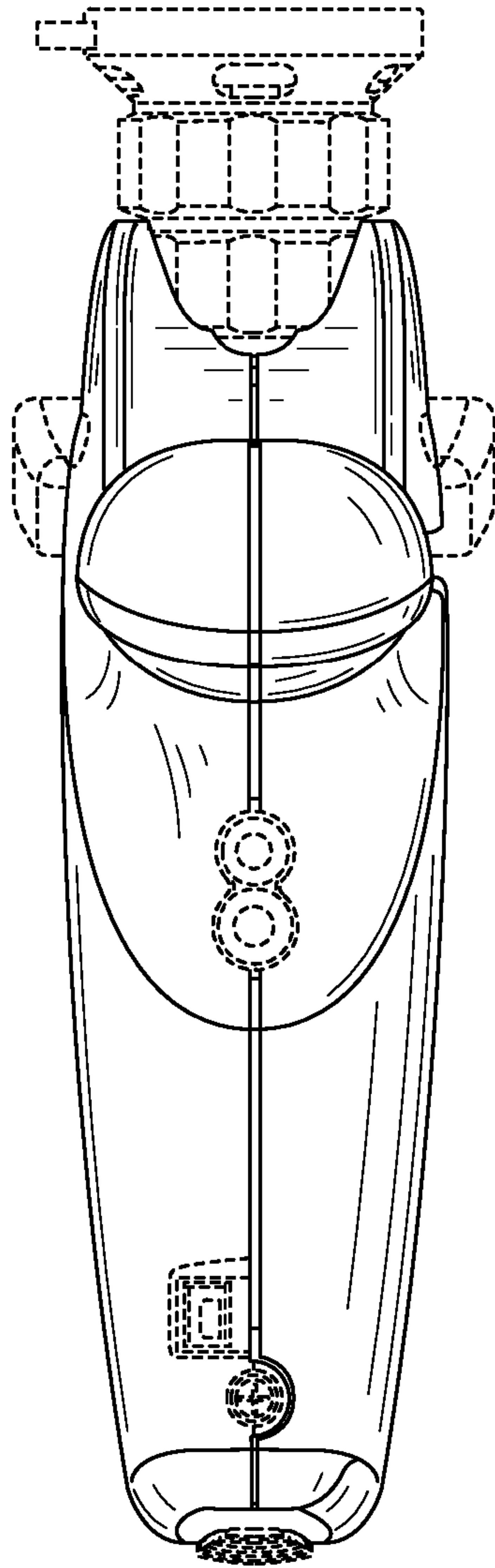
