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DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a palm plan view of a fish filleting glove showing our
new design that includes a serrated section that protrudes
through a slit located on the outer side of the glove's index
finger and a single spike that protrudes through a slit centered
on the inner side of the glove's thumb;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged front elevational view of the serrated
section that extends upward from the upper surface of a ring
that is inserted into the glove's index finger;

FIG. 8 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;

FIG. 9 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 10 is an enlarged right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 11 is an enlarged left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 12 is an enlarged front elevational view of the single
spike that extends upward from the upper surface of a ring that
is inserted into the glove's thumb;

FIG. 13 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;

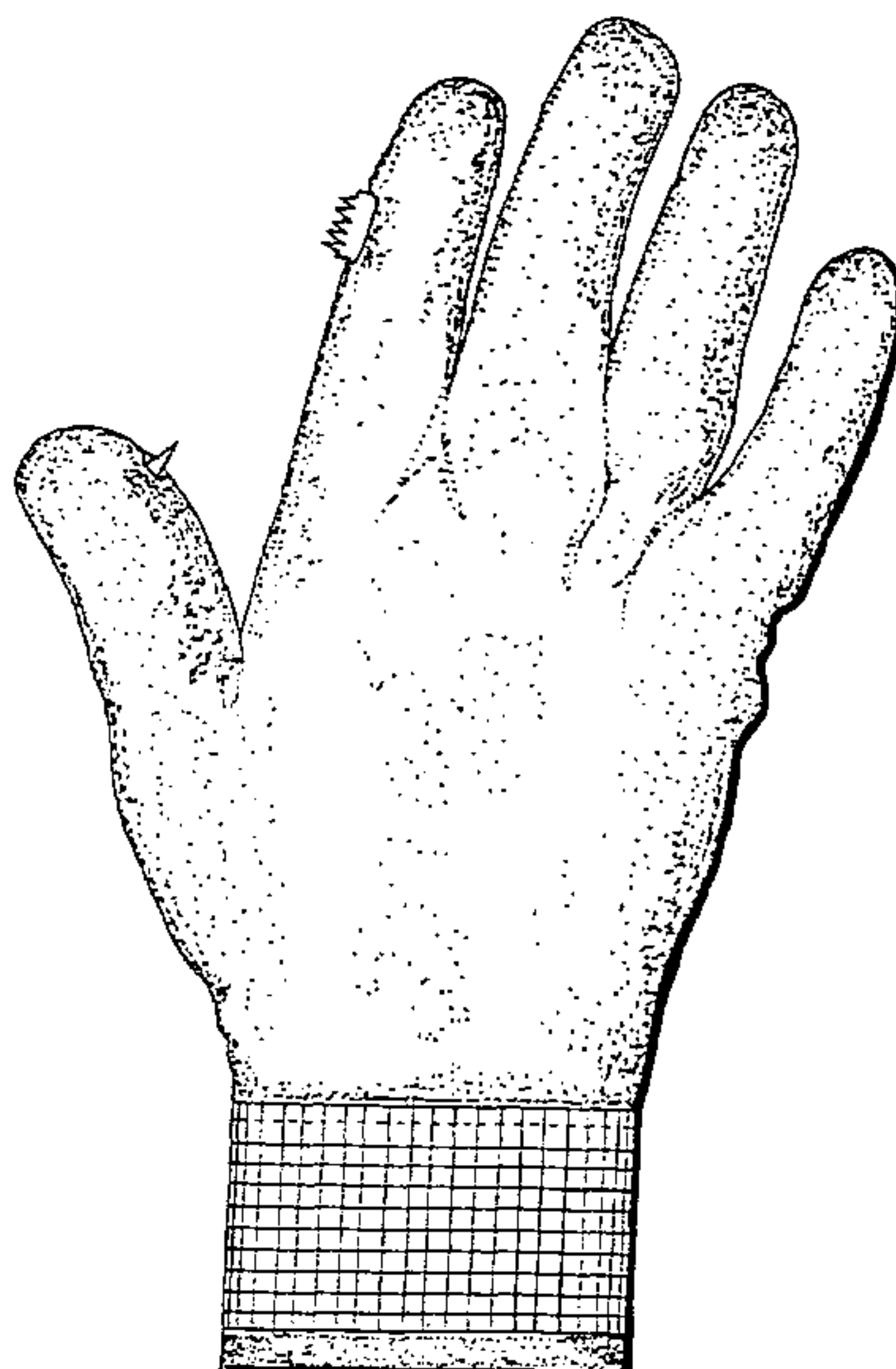
FIG. 14 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 15 is an enlarged right side elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 16 is an enlarged left side elevational view.

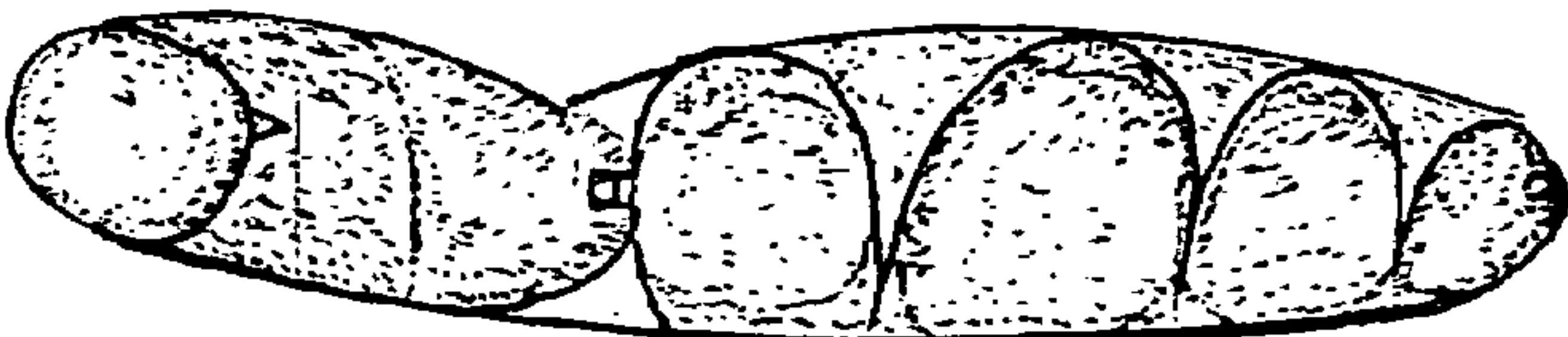

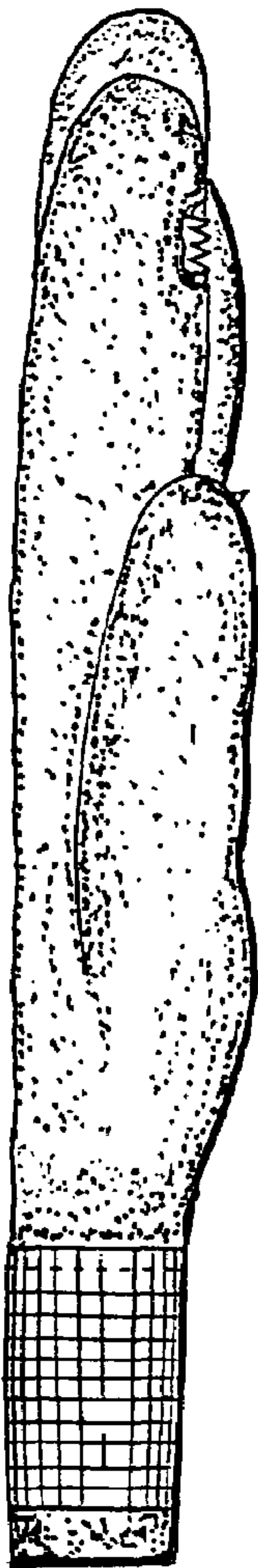

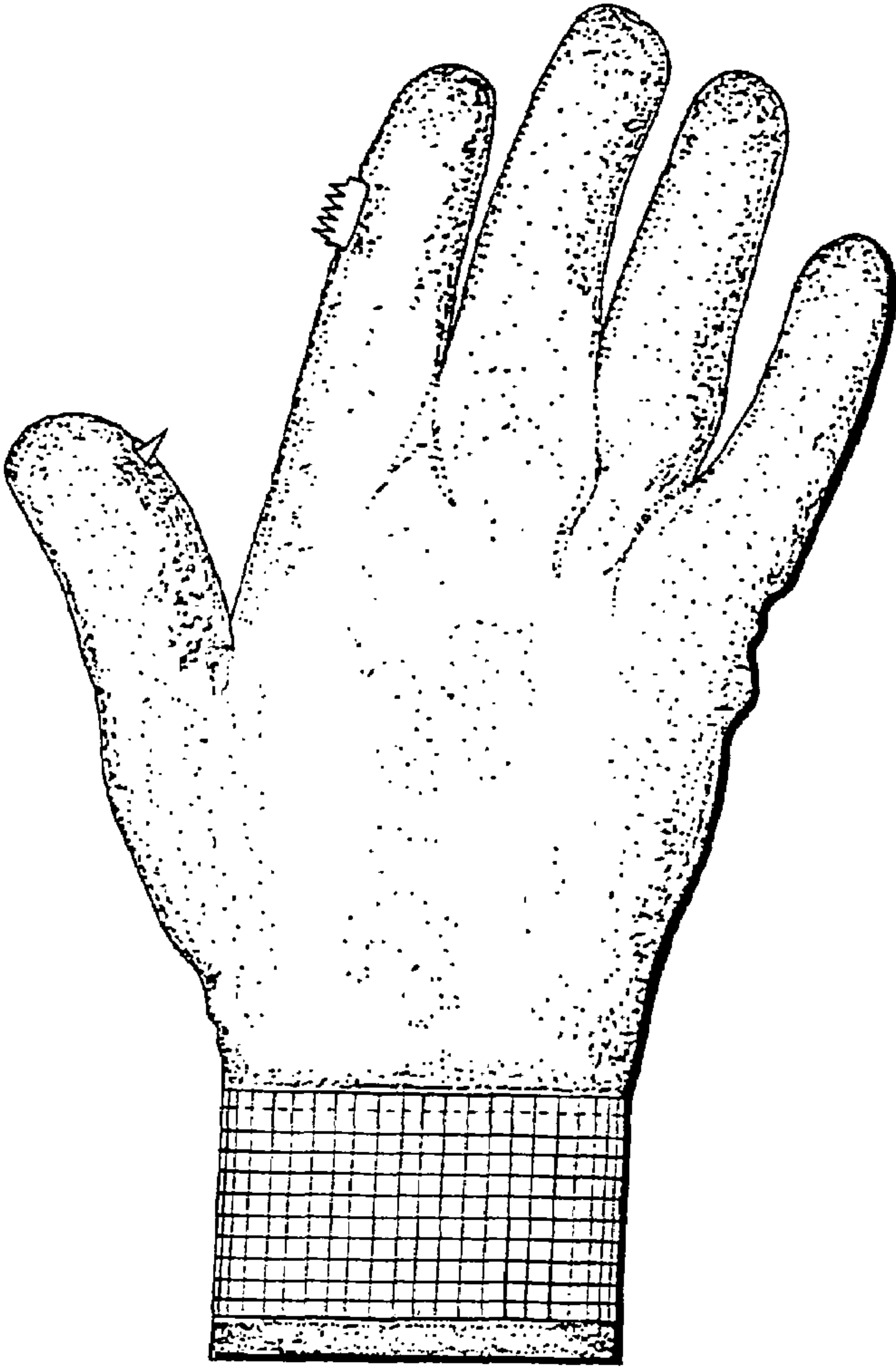

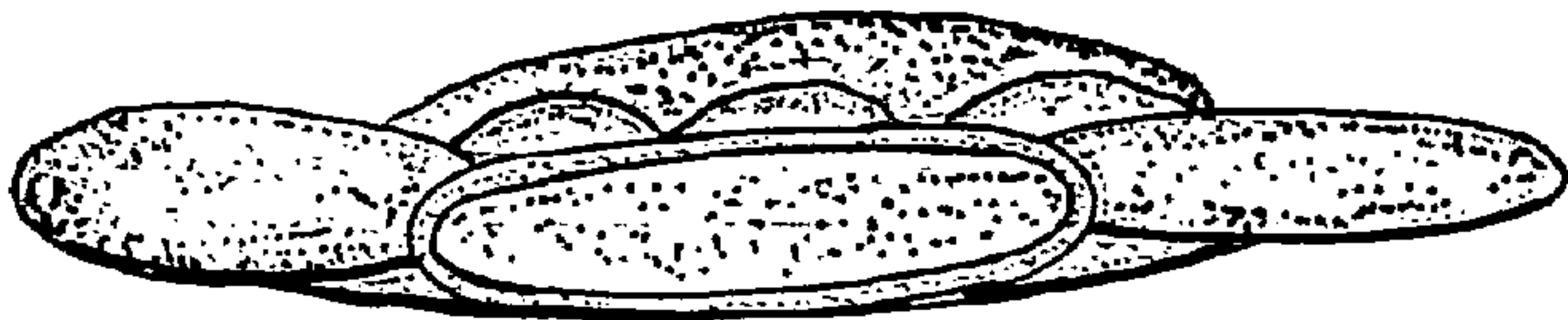

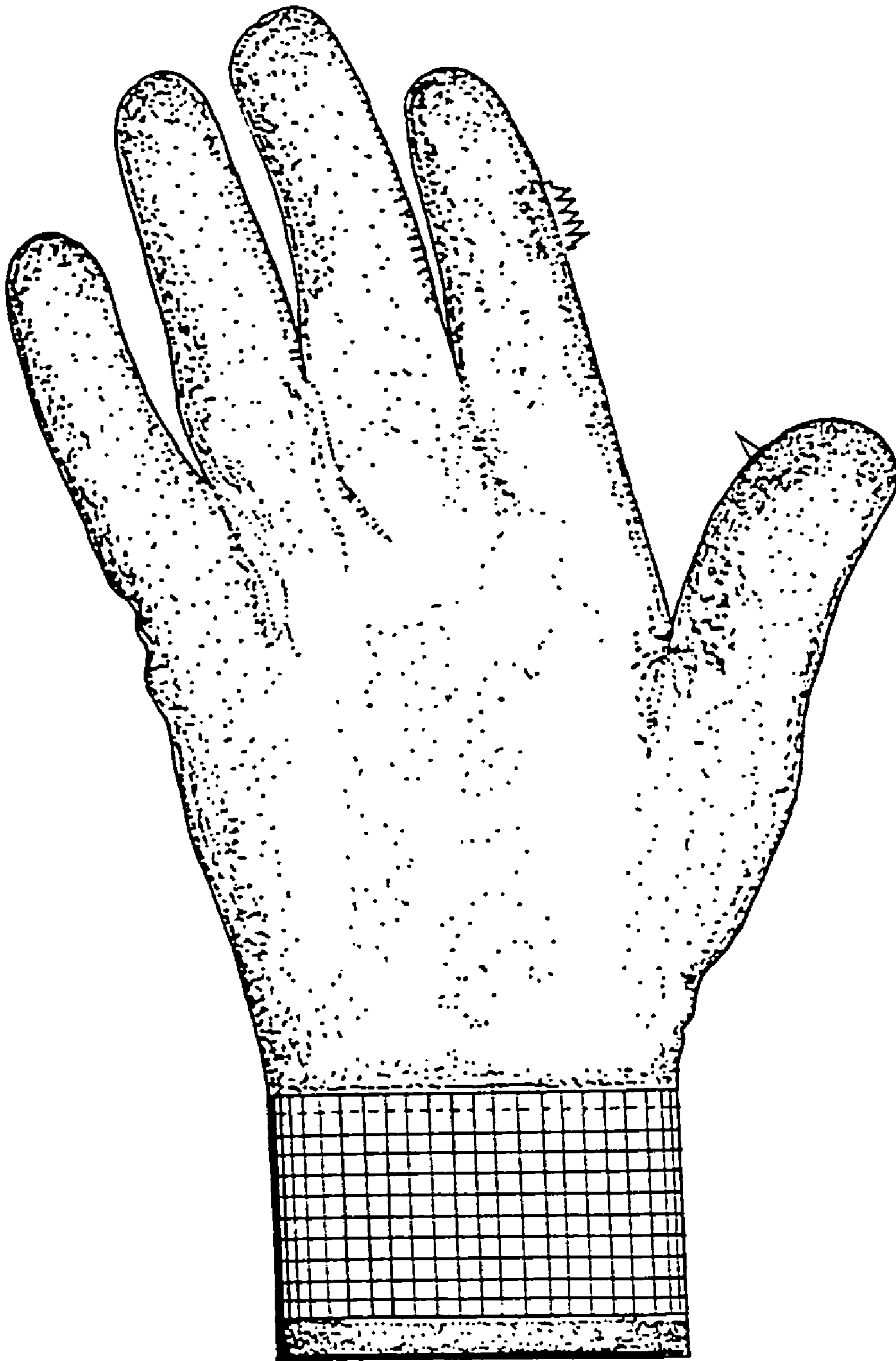

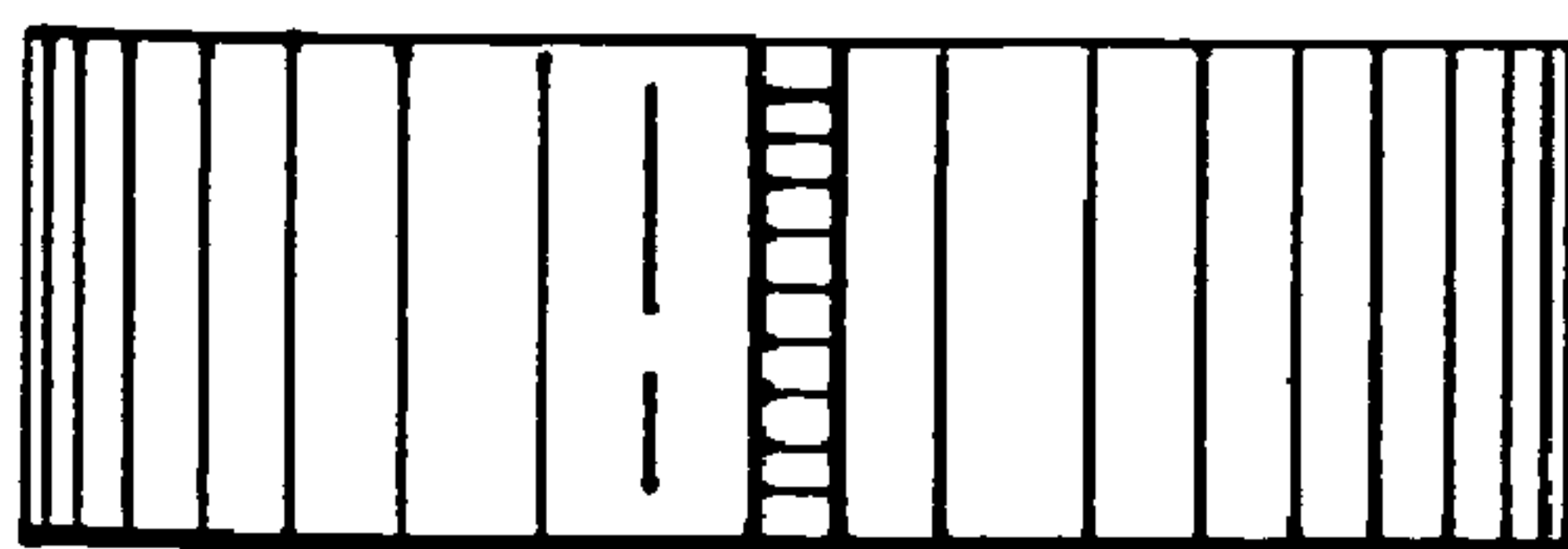

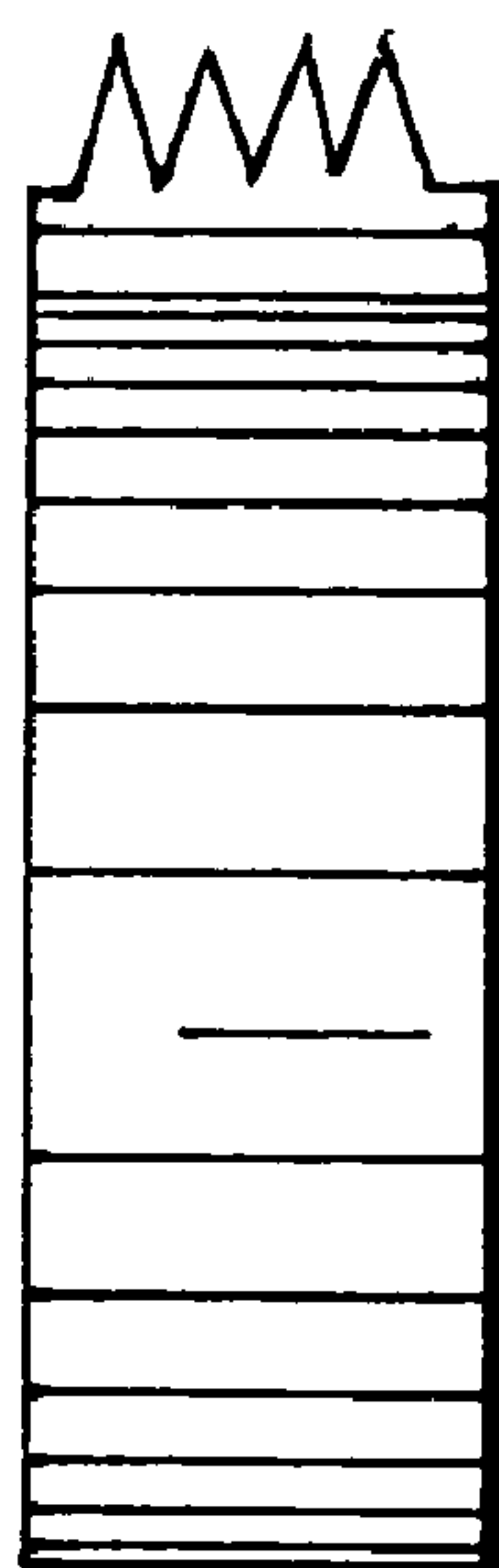

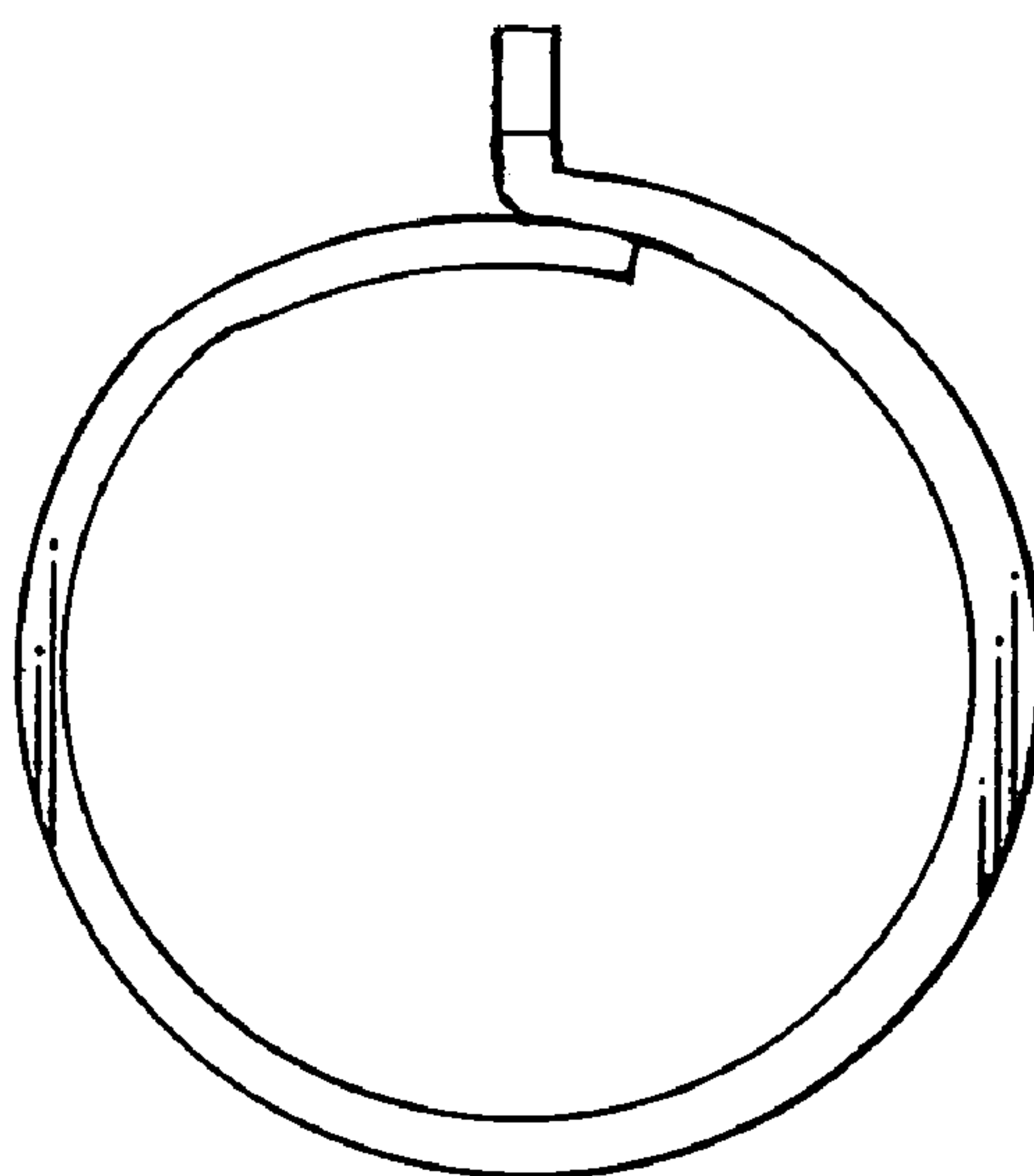

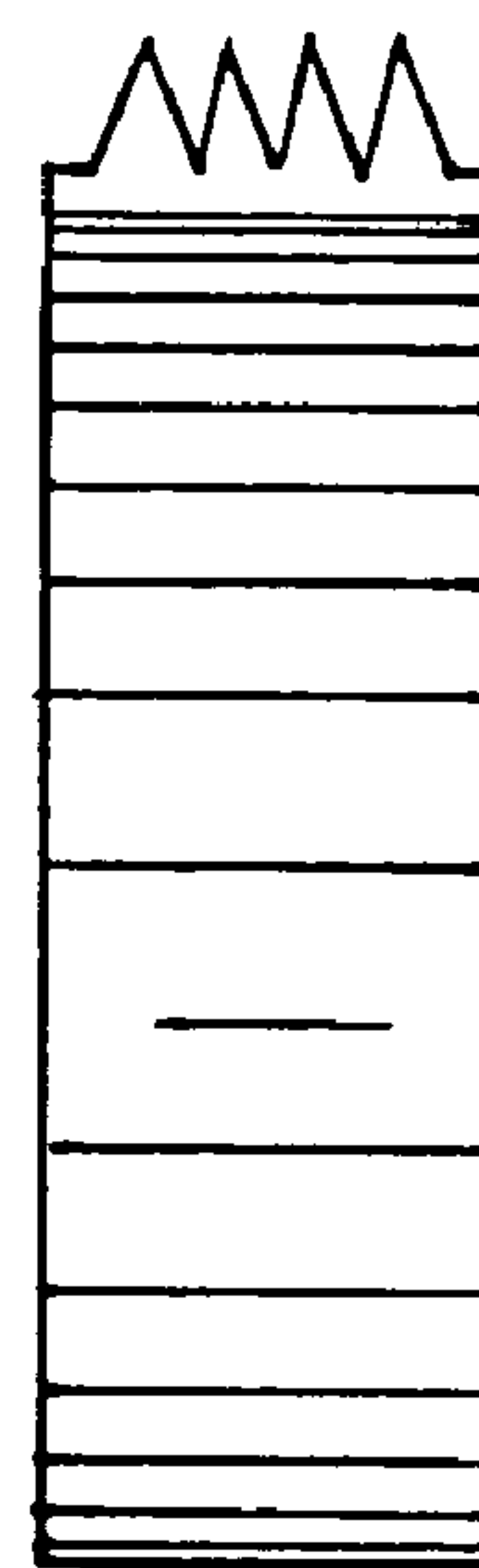

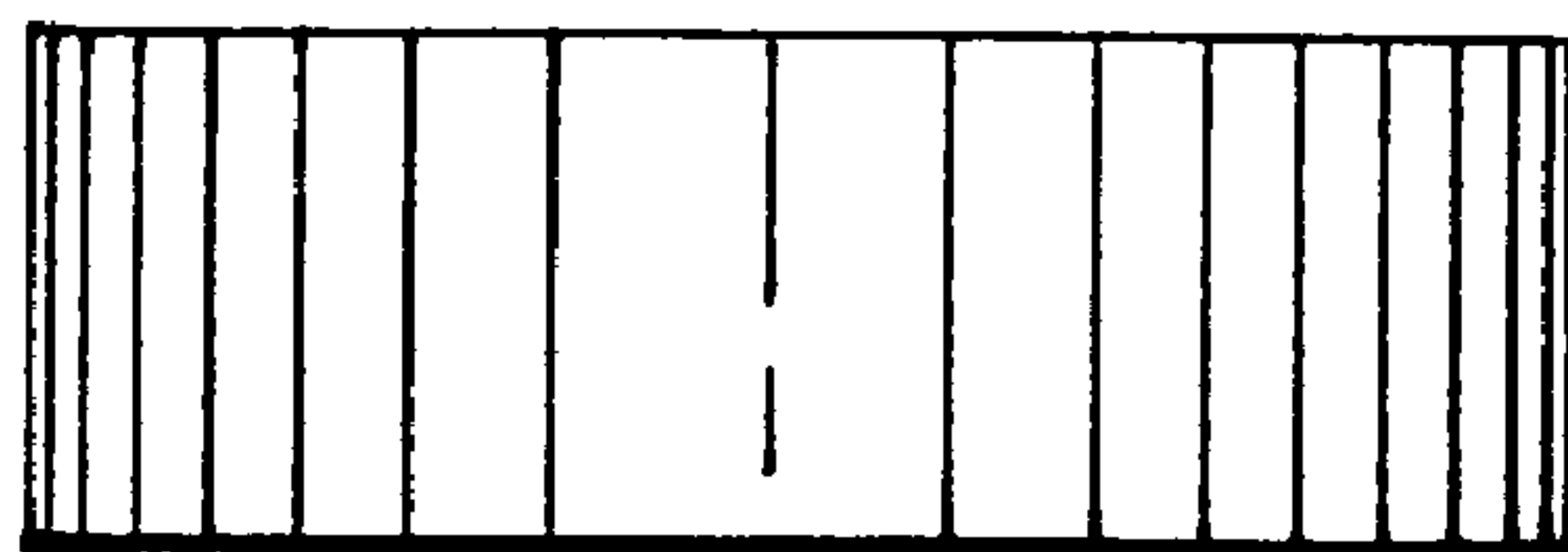

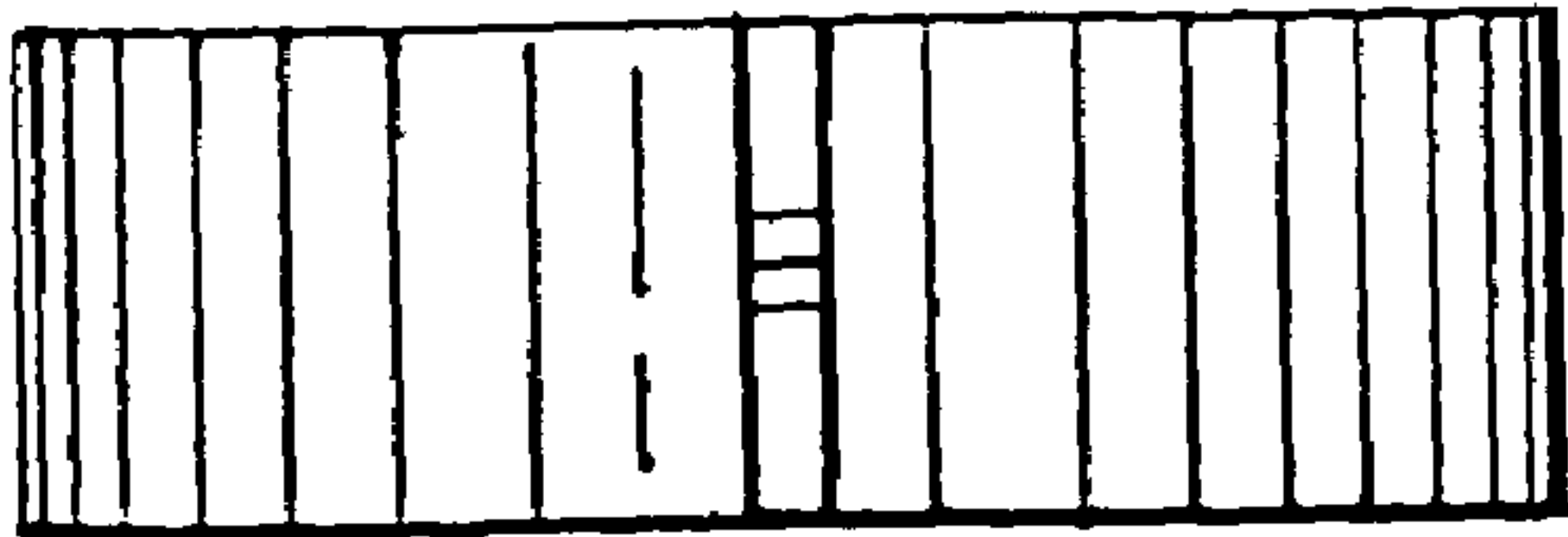

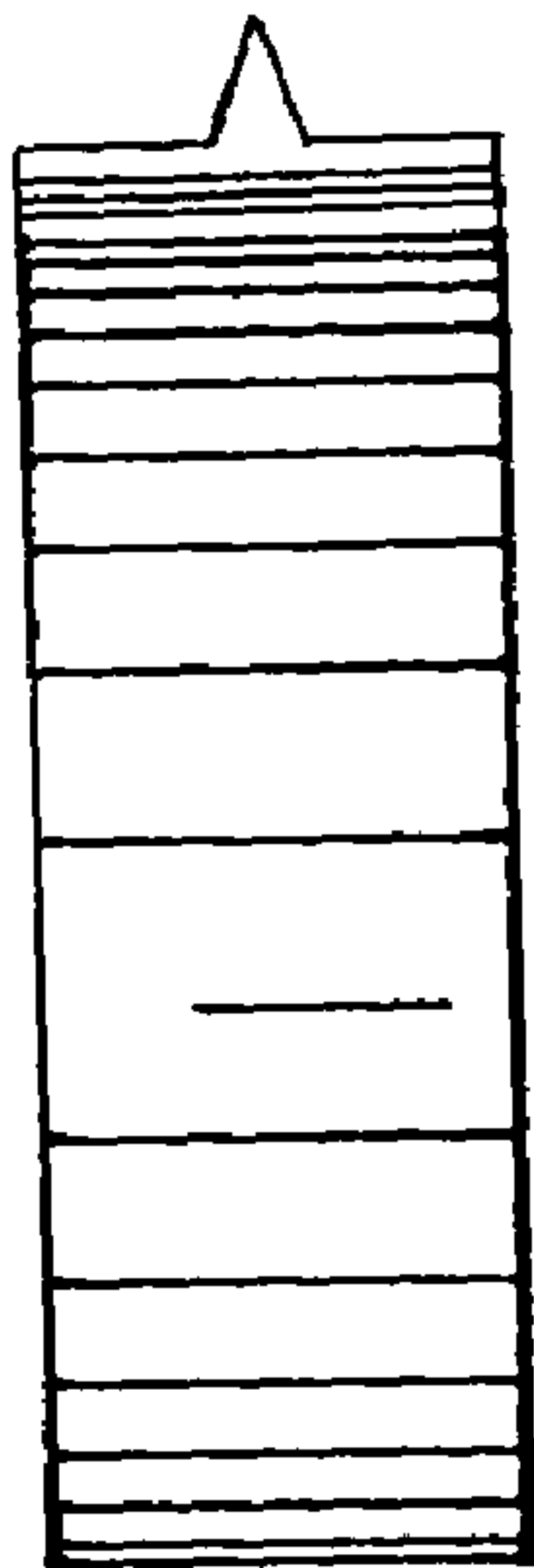

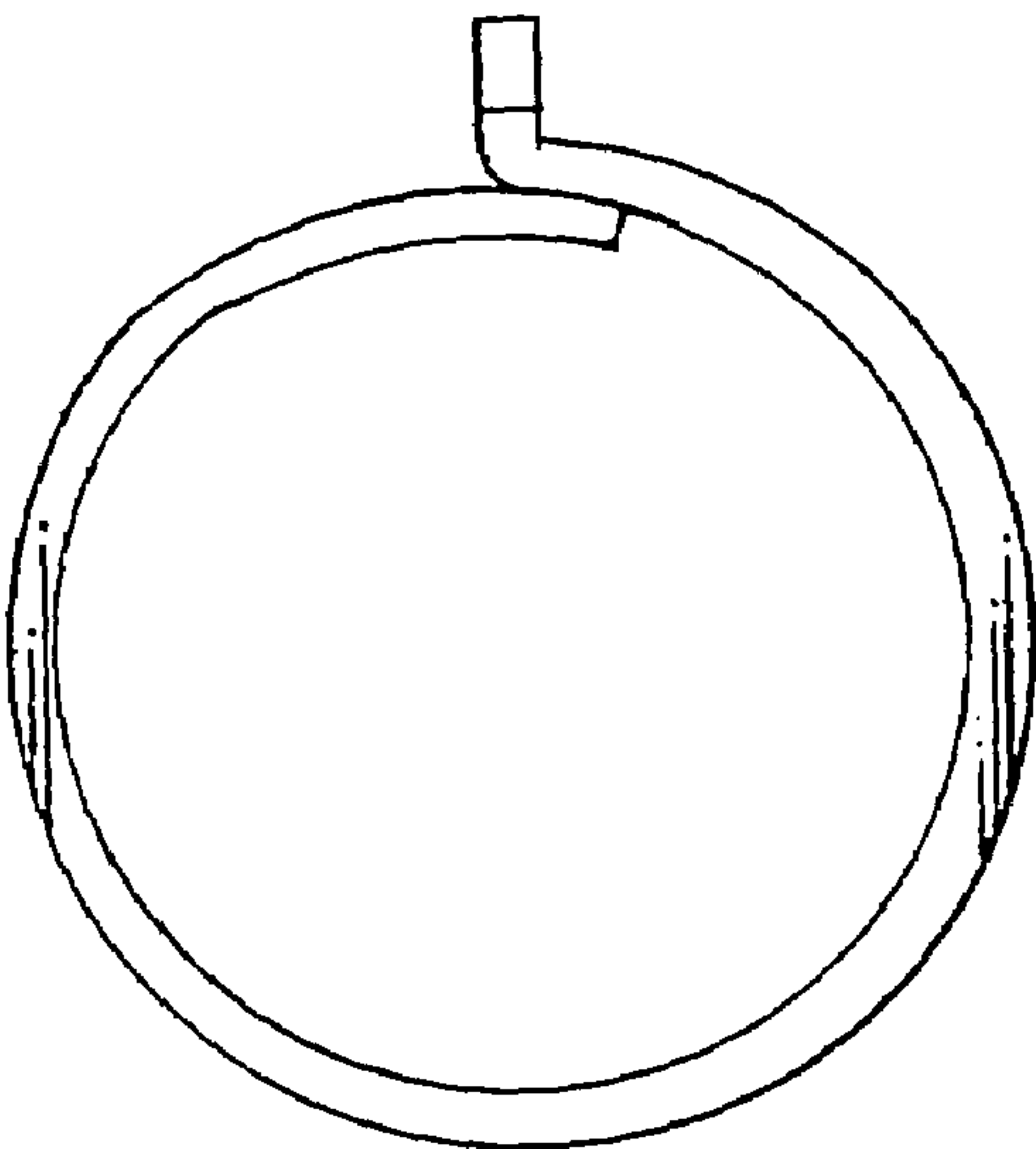

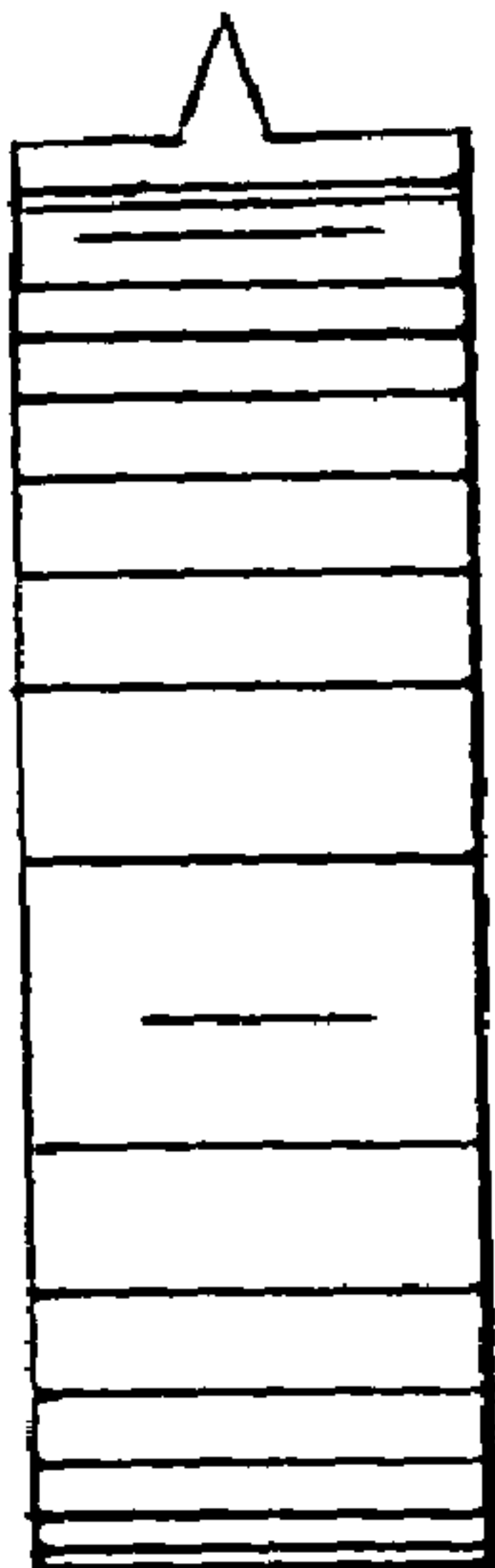

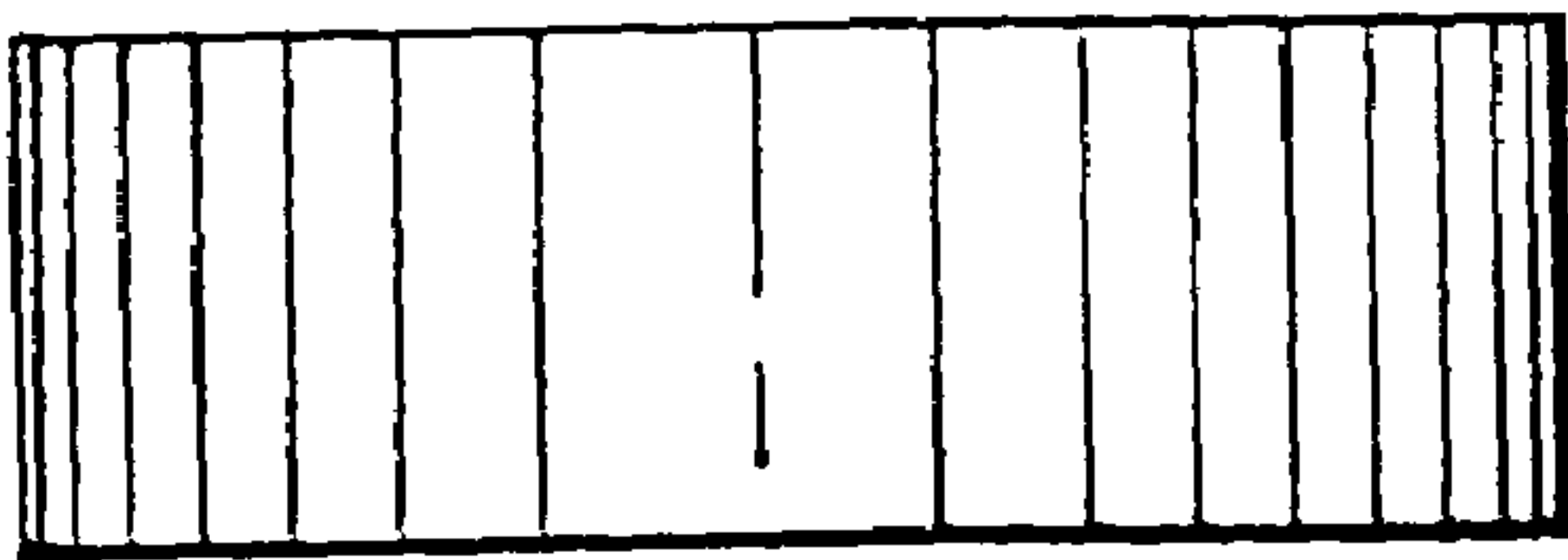
