FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof.

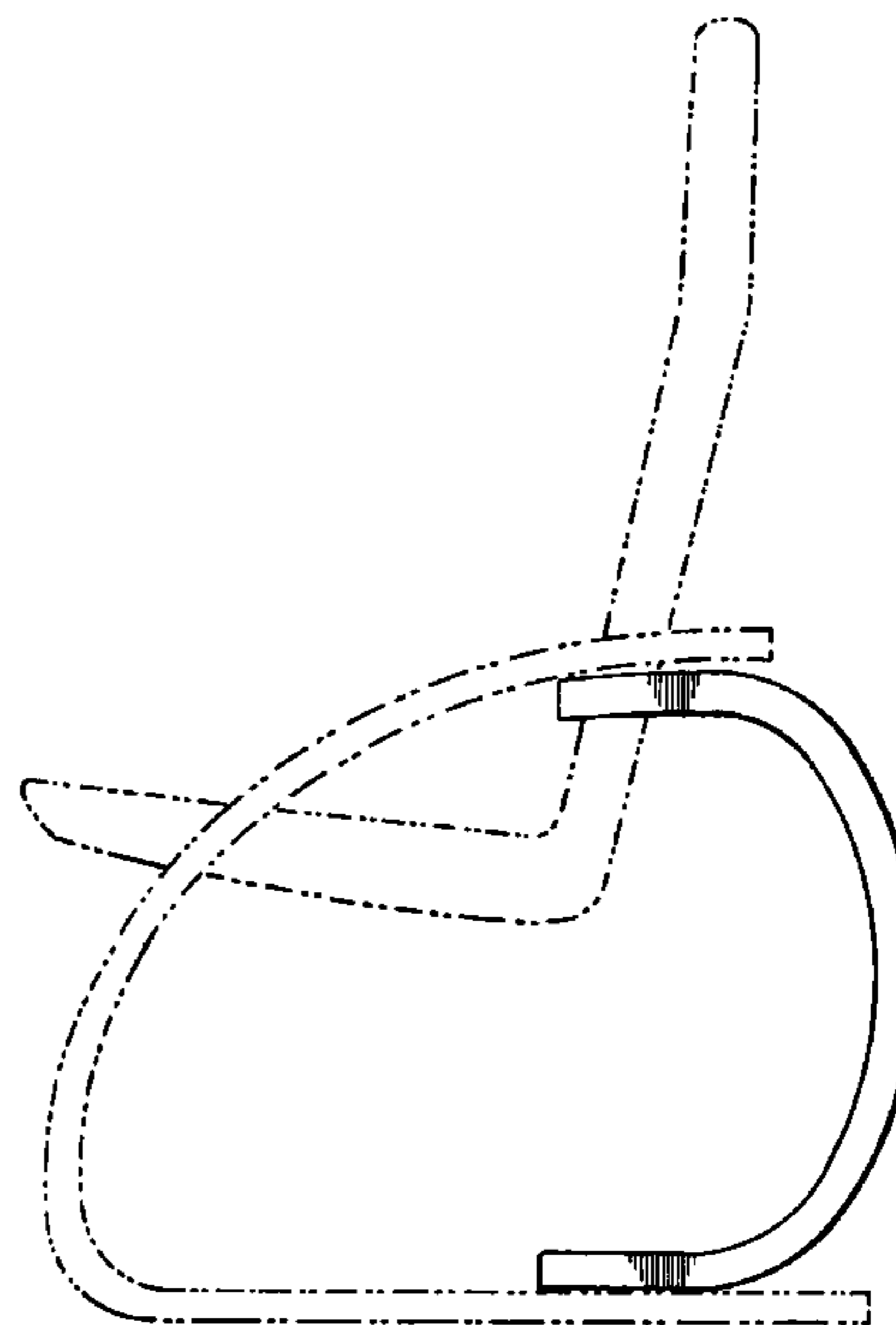
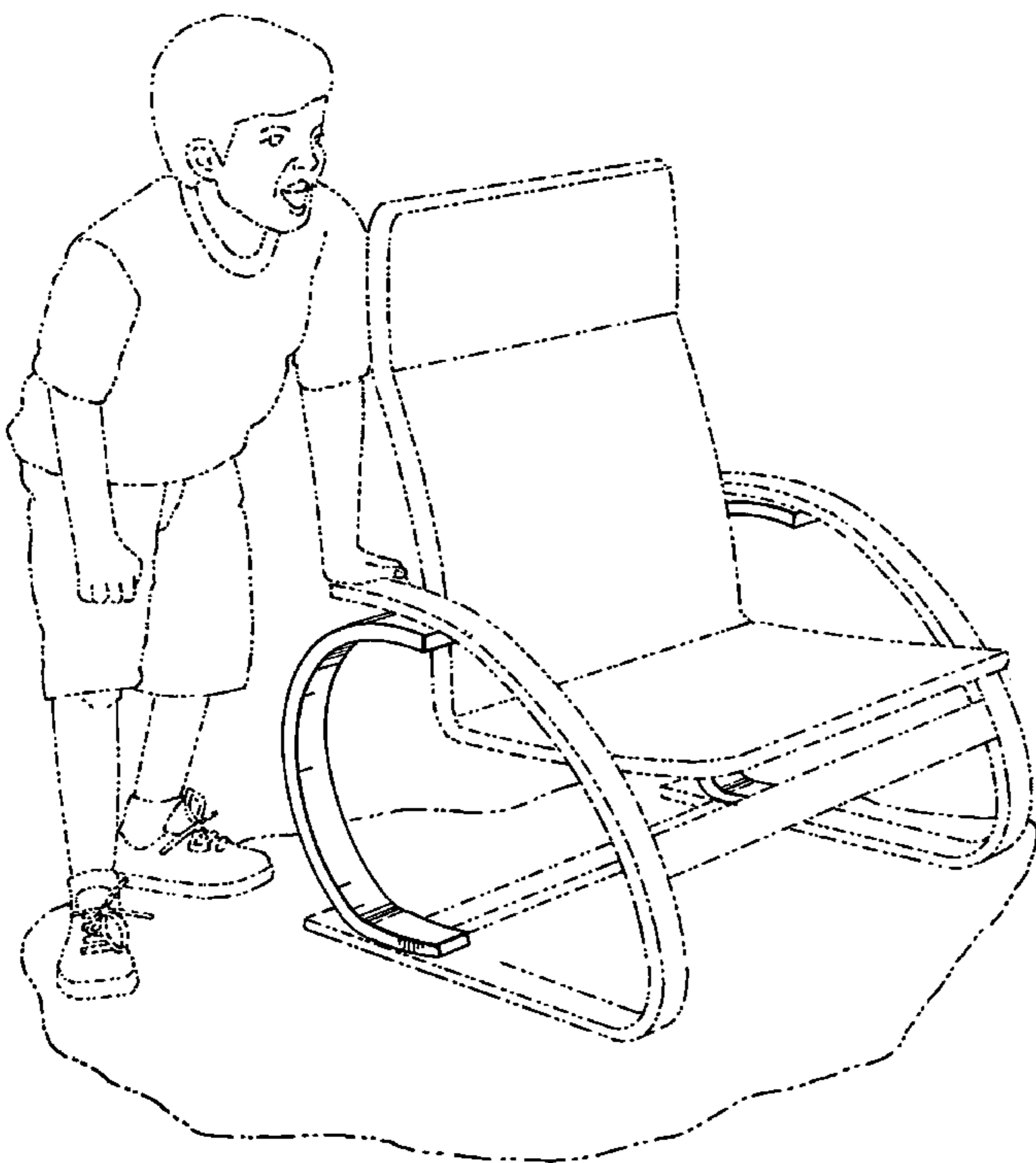

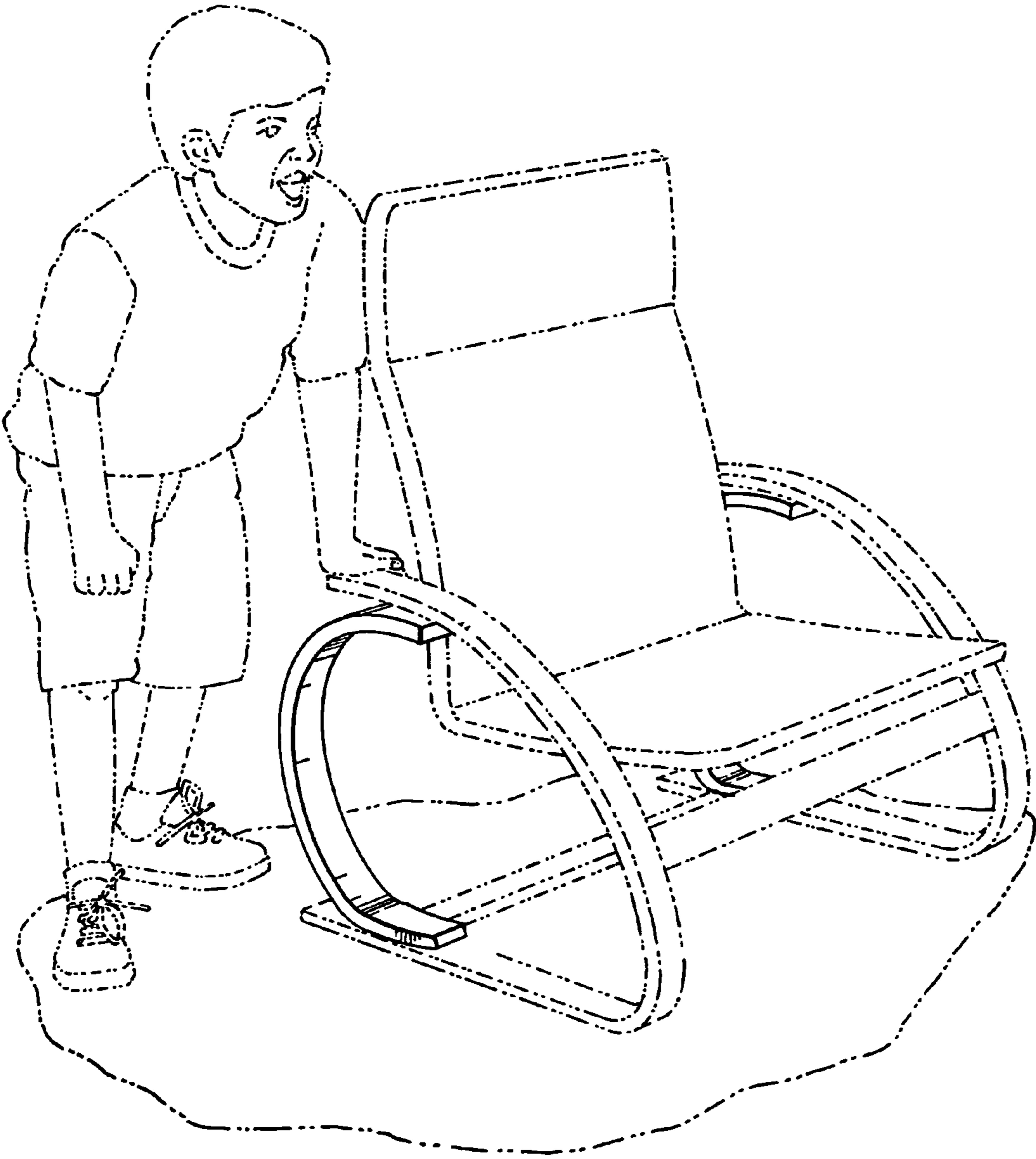

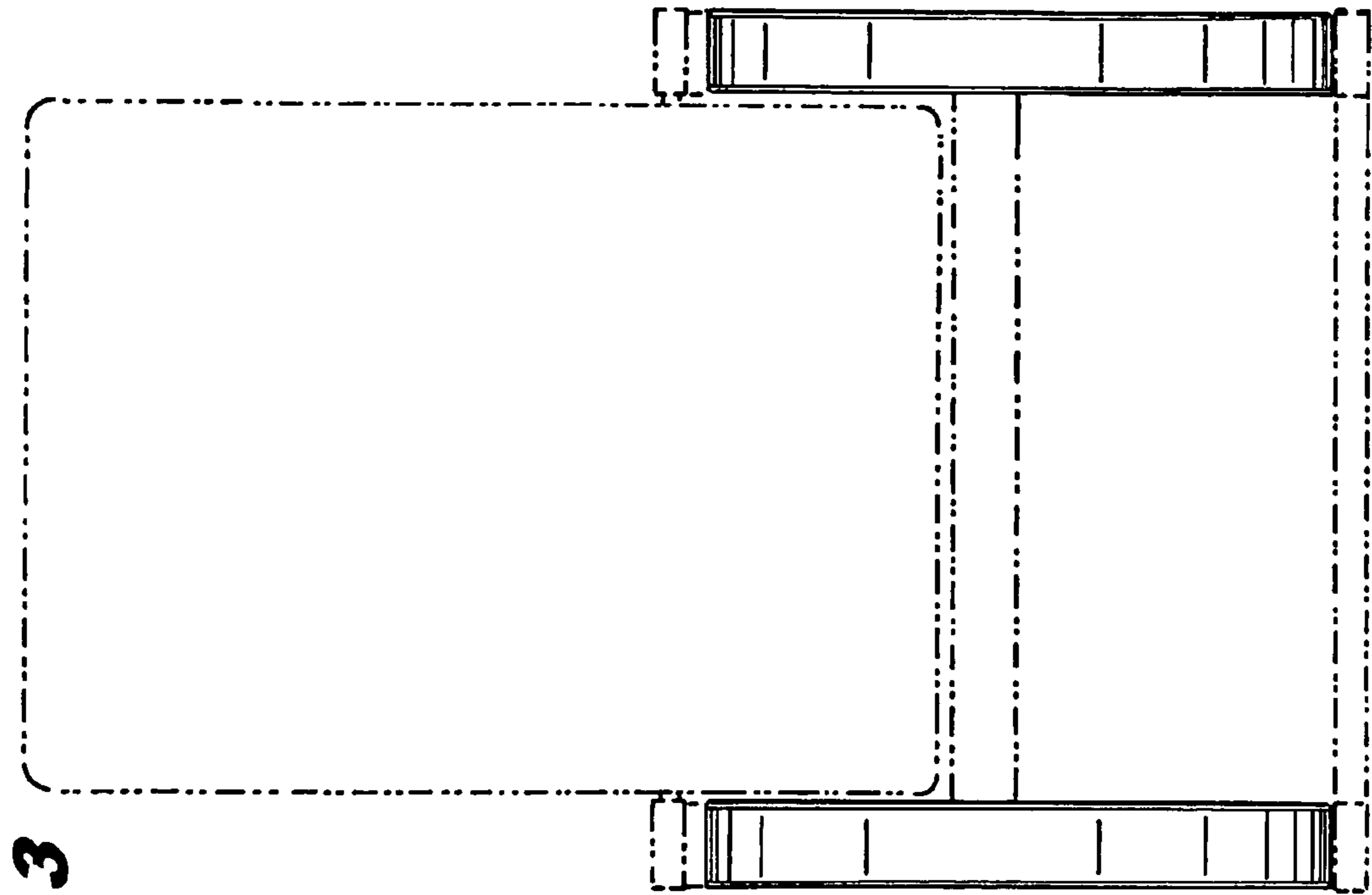

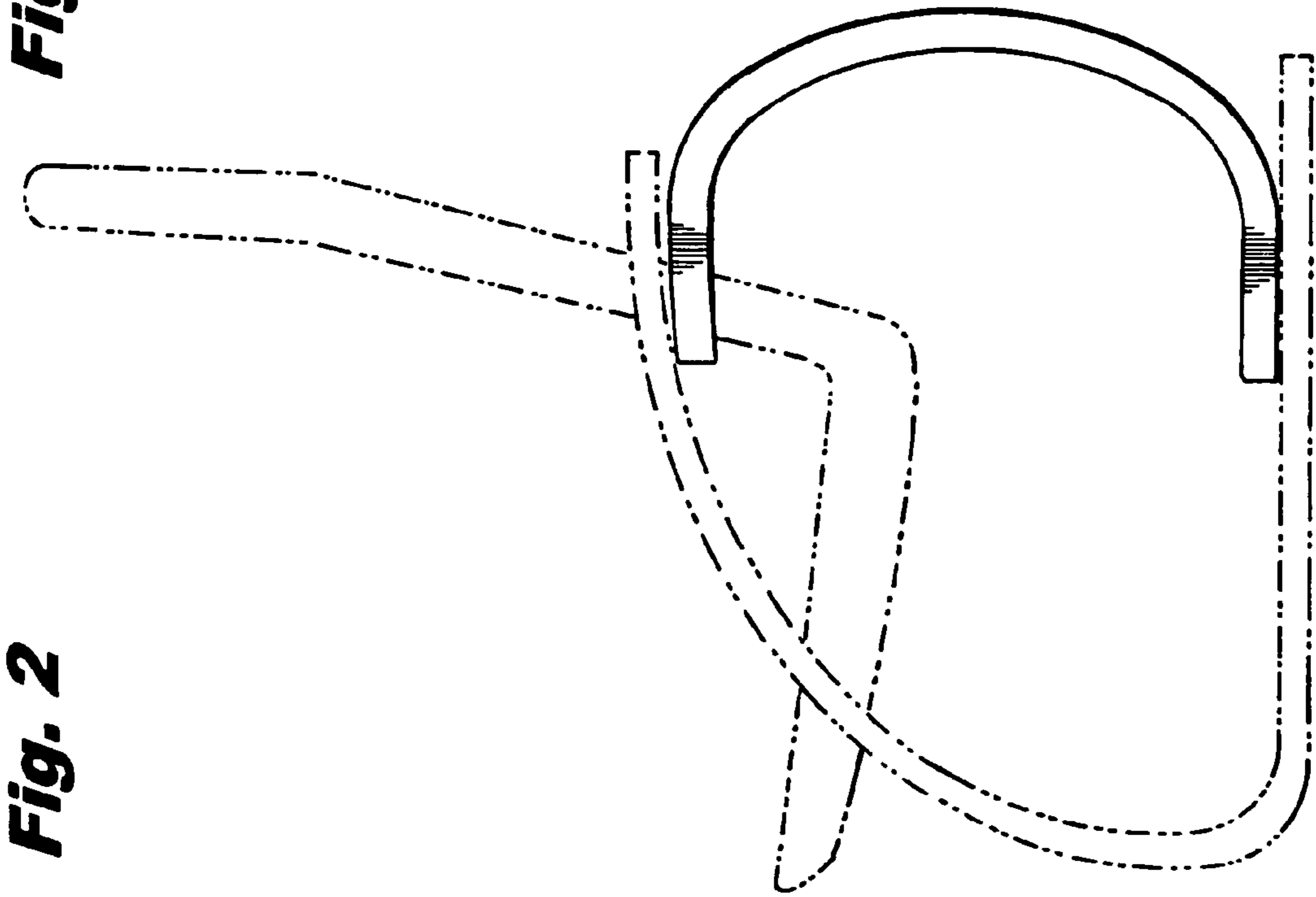
