(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for mini snack tongs, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a preferred embodiment of the mini snack tongs of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a top view of a preferred embodiment of the mini snack tongs of the present invention.

FIG. 3 is a front view of a preferred embodiment of the mini snack tongs of the present invention.

FIG. 4 is a right side view of a preferred embodiment of the mini snack tongs of the present invention.

FIG. 5 is a left side view of a preferred embodiment of the mini snack tongs of the present invention.

FIG. 6 is a rear view of a preferred embodiment of the mini snack tongs of the present invention.

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of a preferred embodiment of the mini snack tongs of the present invention; and,

FIG. 8 is a detail view of a snack contacting portion of the mini snack tongs of the present invention.
