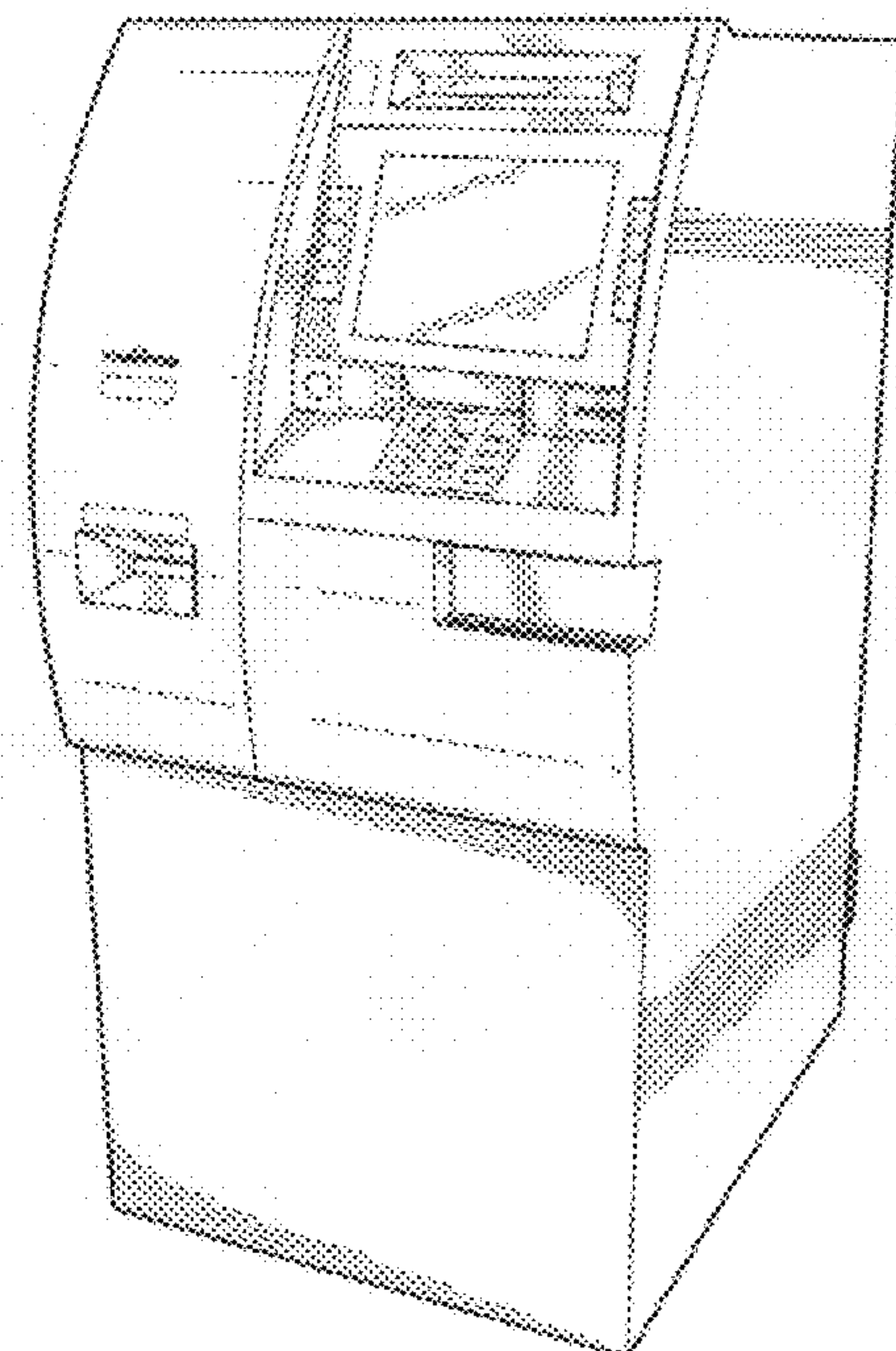
The ornamental design of an automatic teller machine, as shown and described.

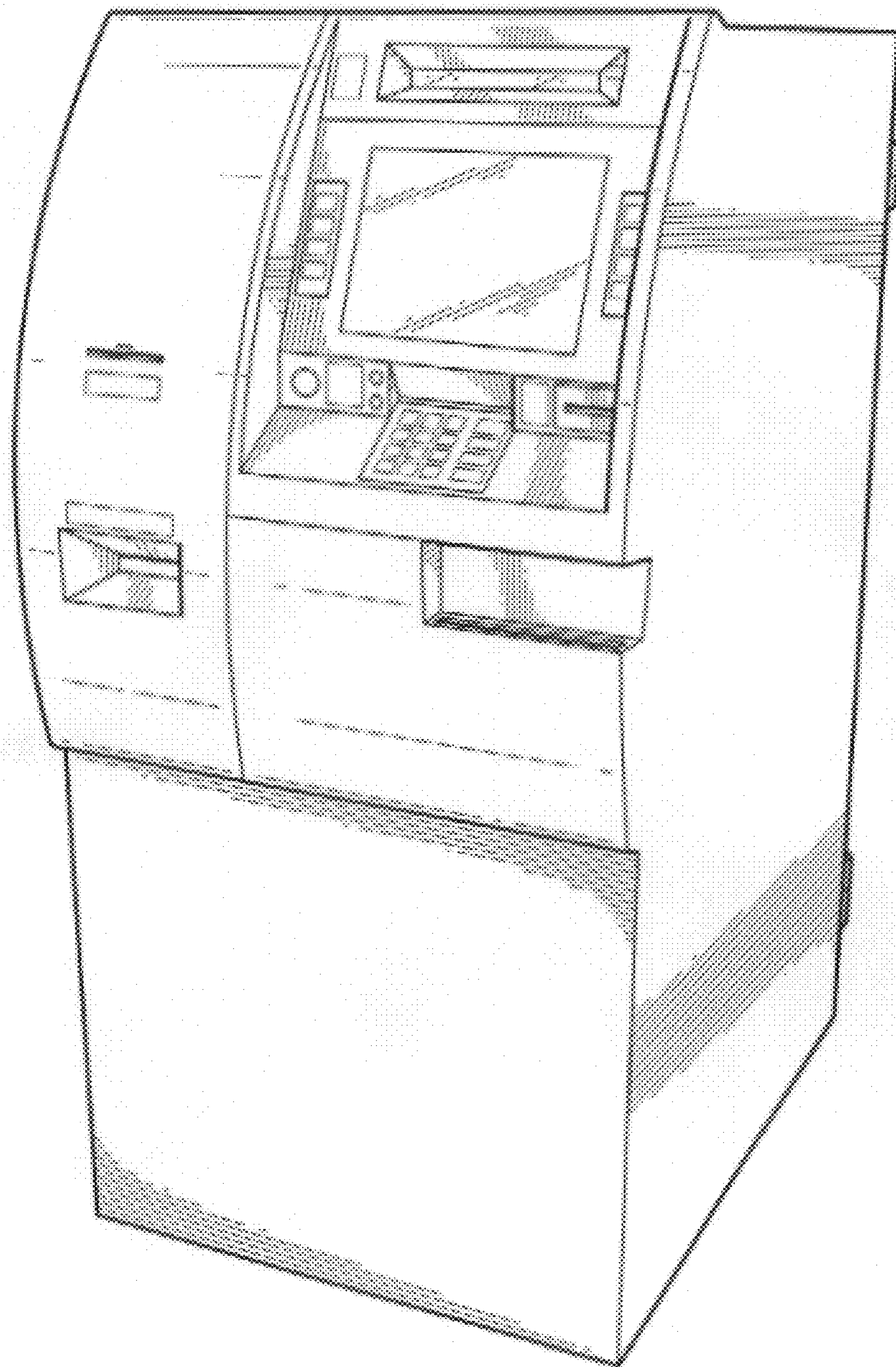

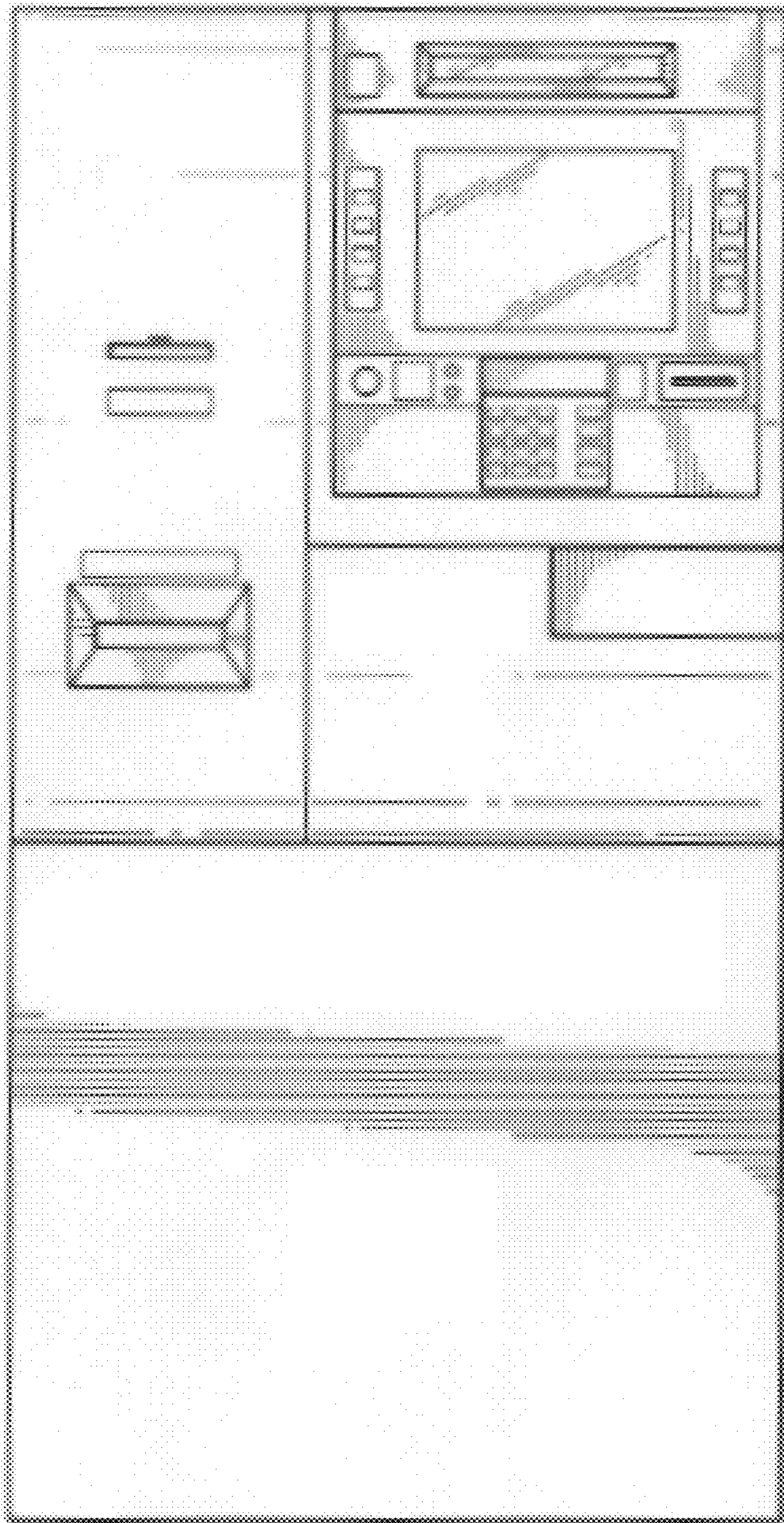

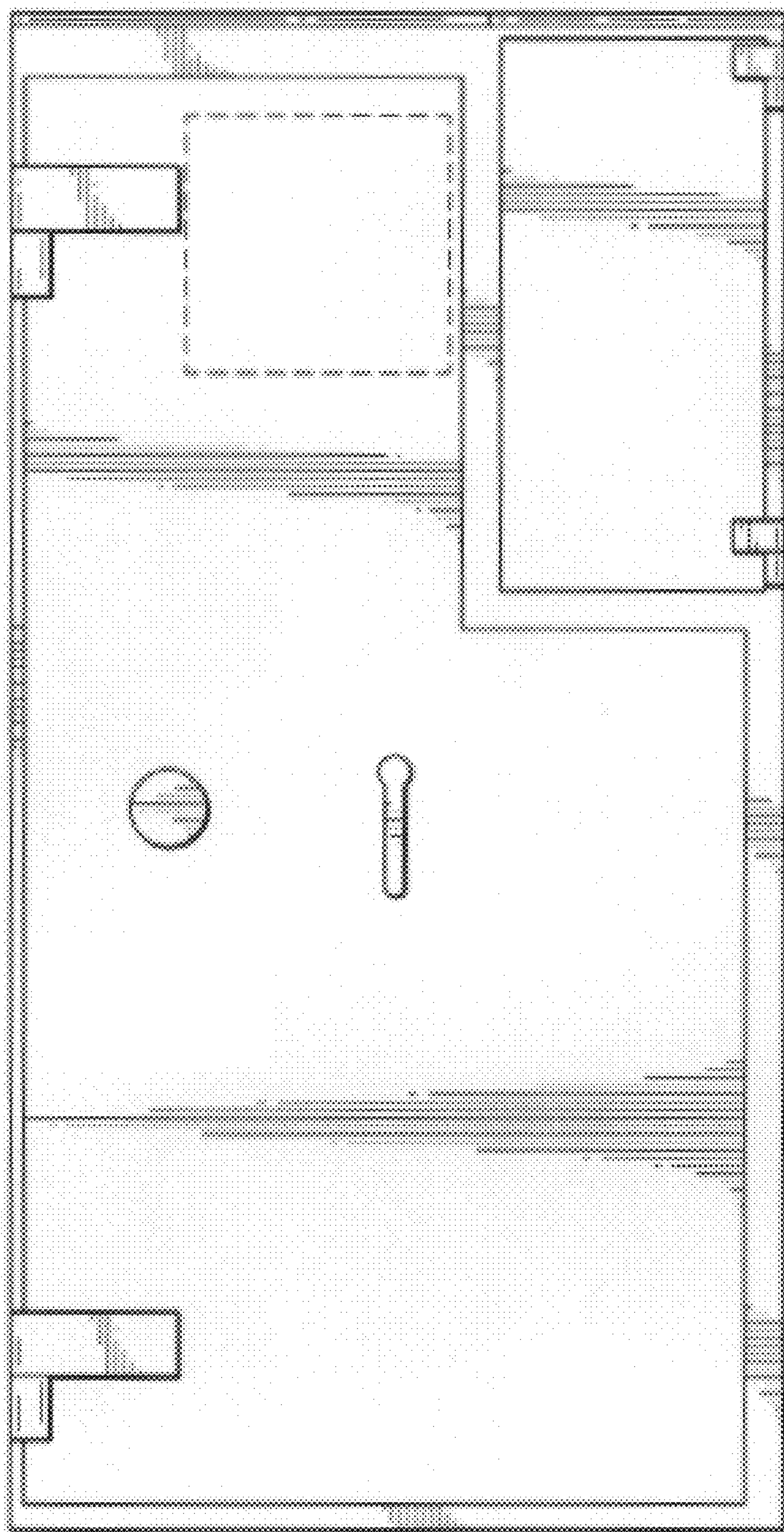

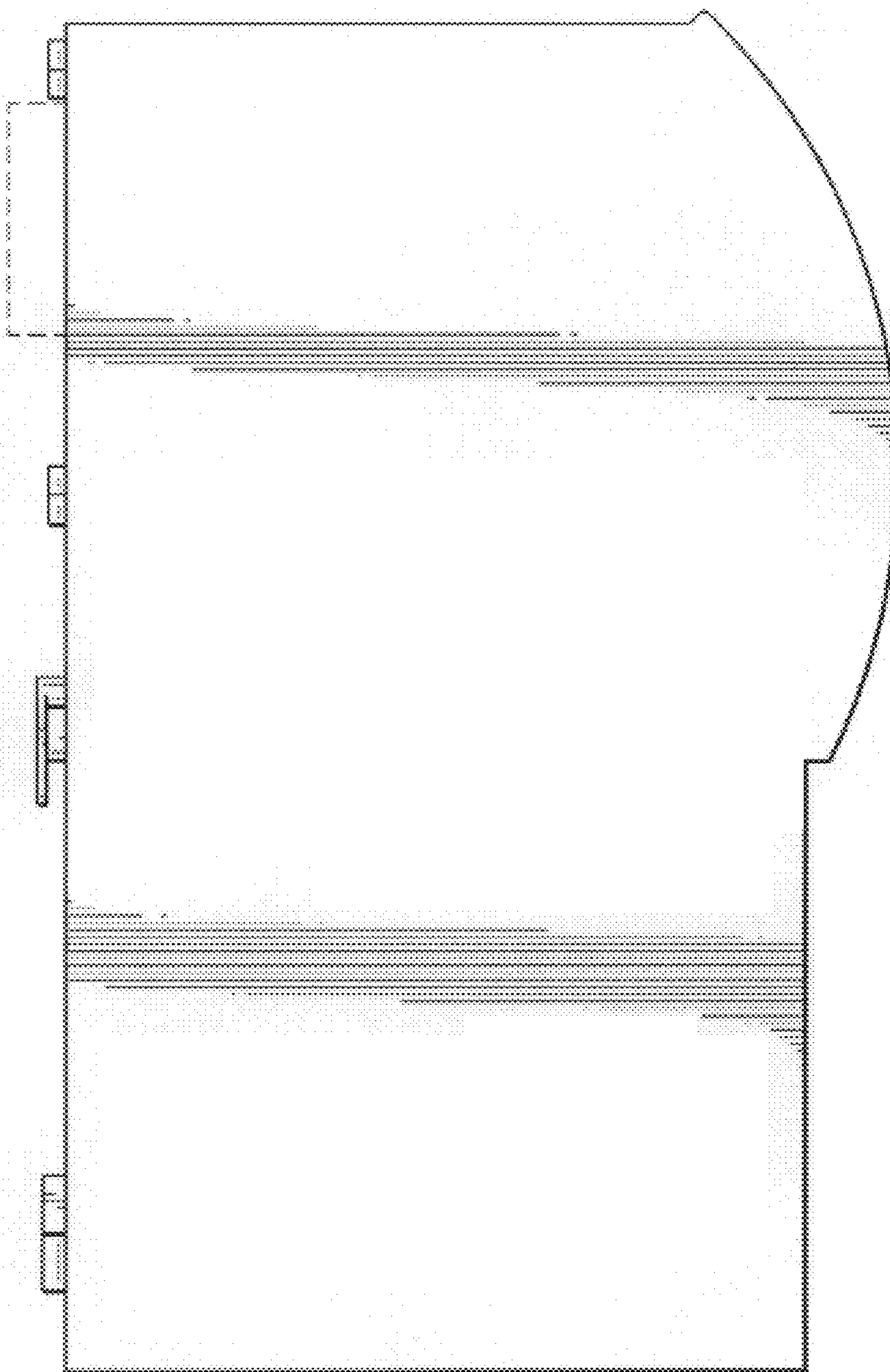

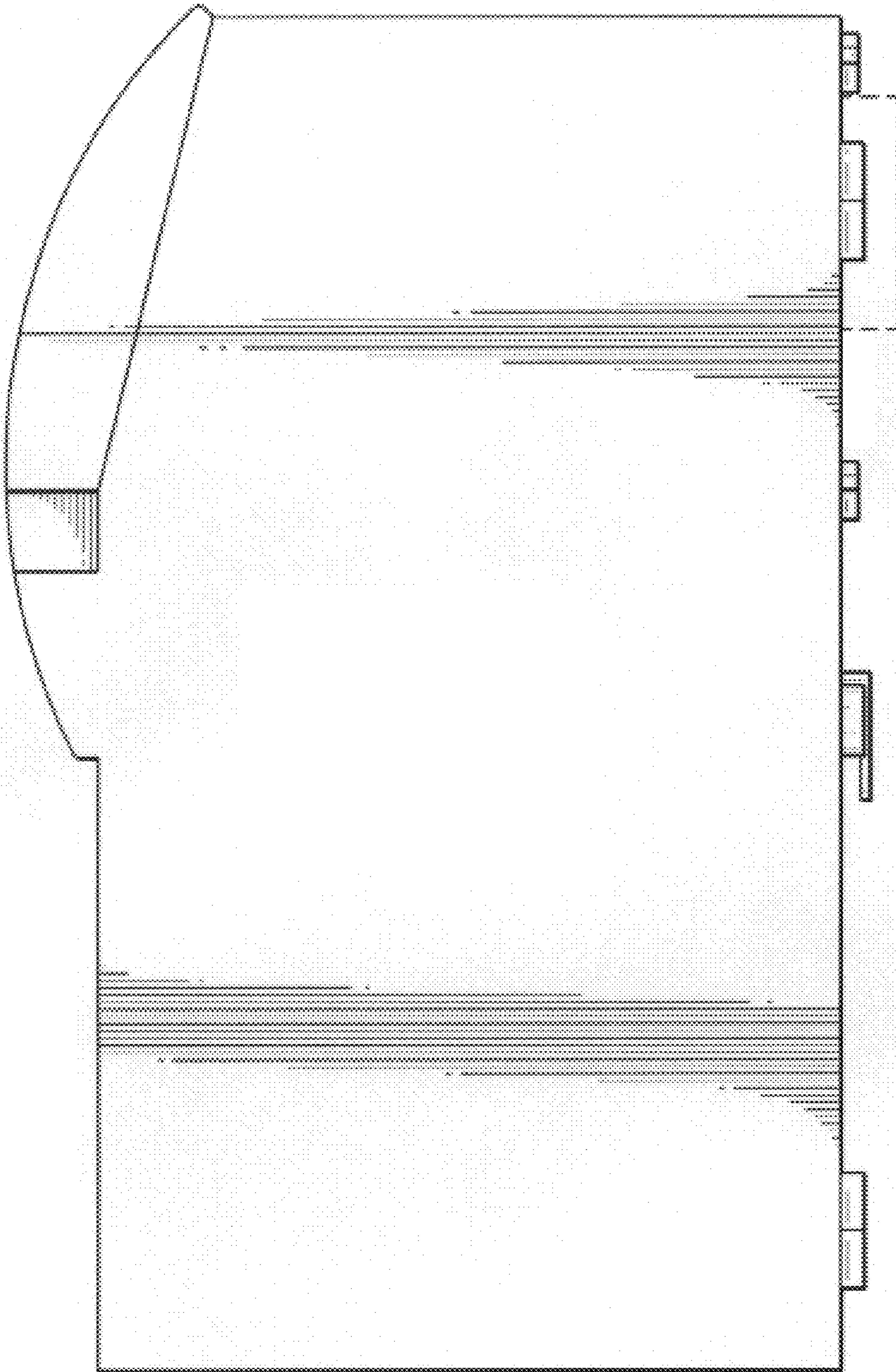

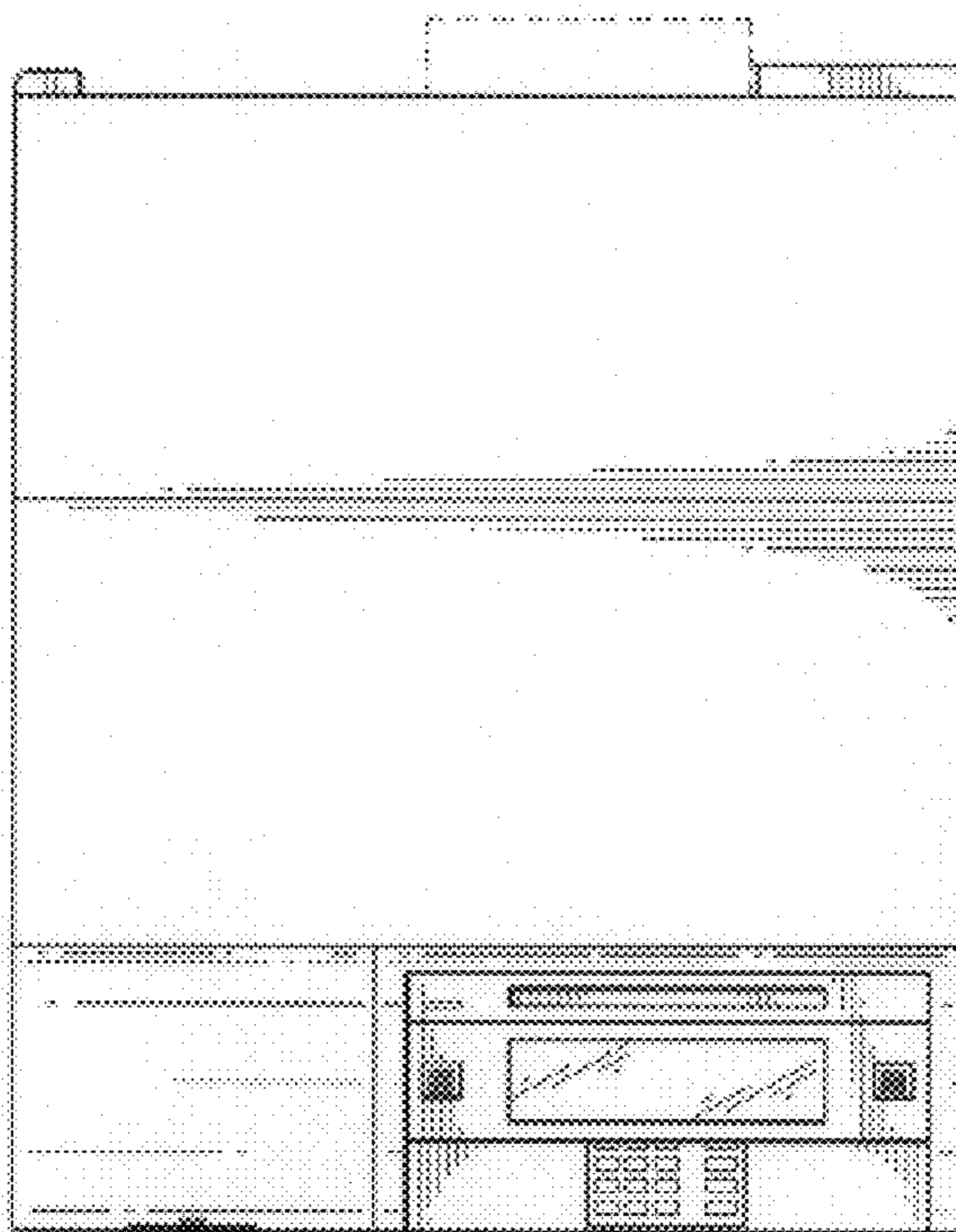

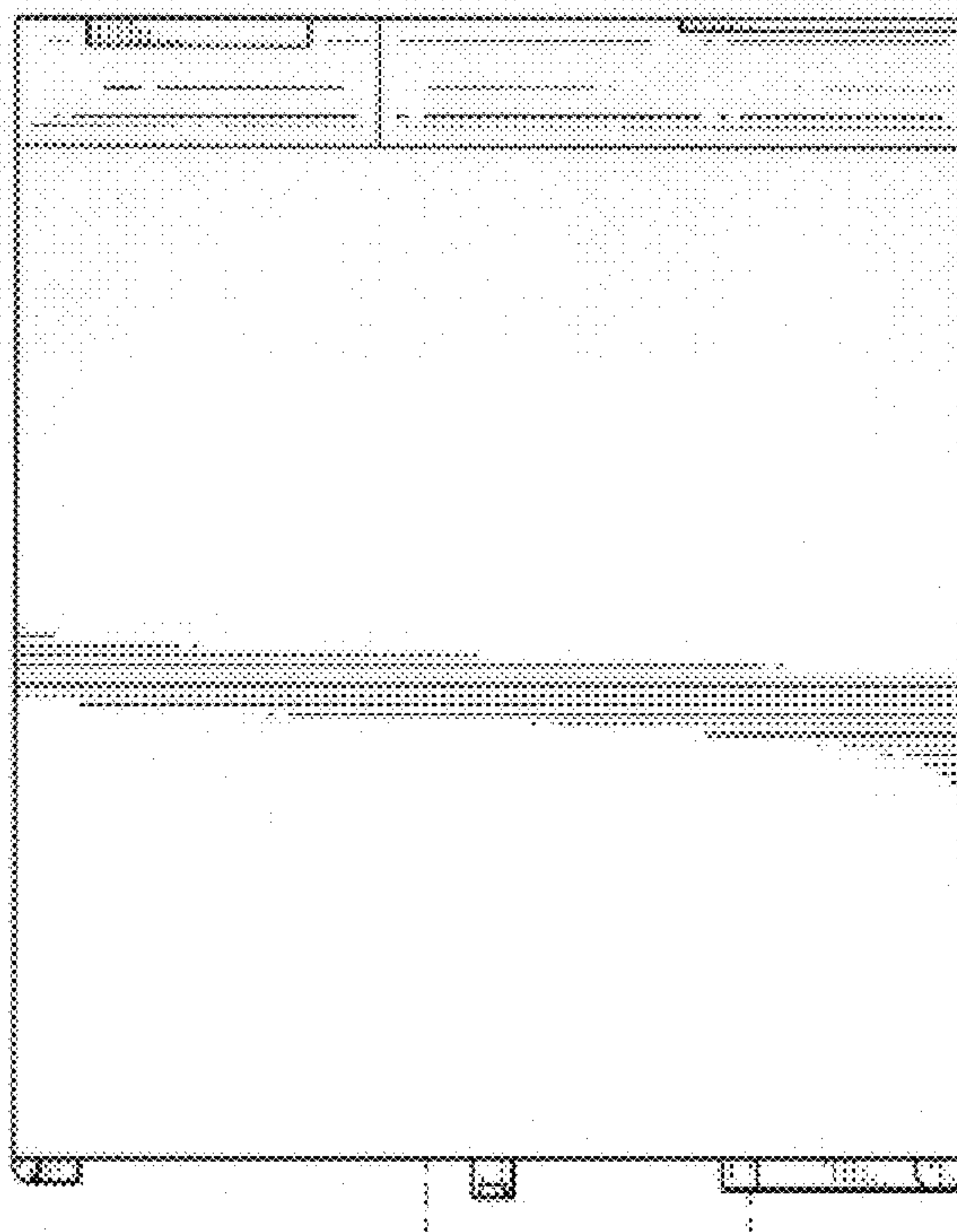
