according to my new design; and,

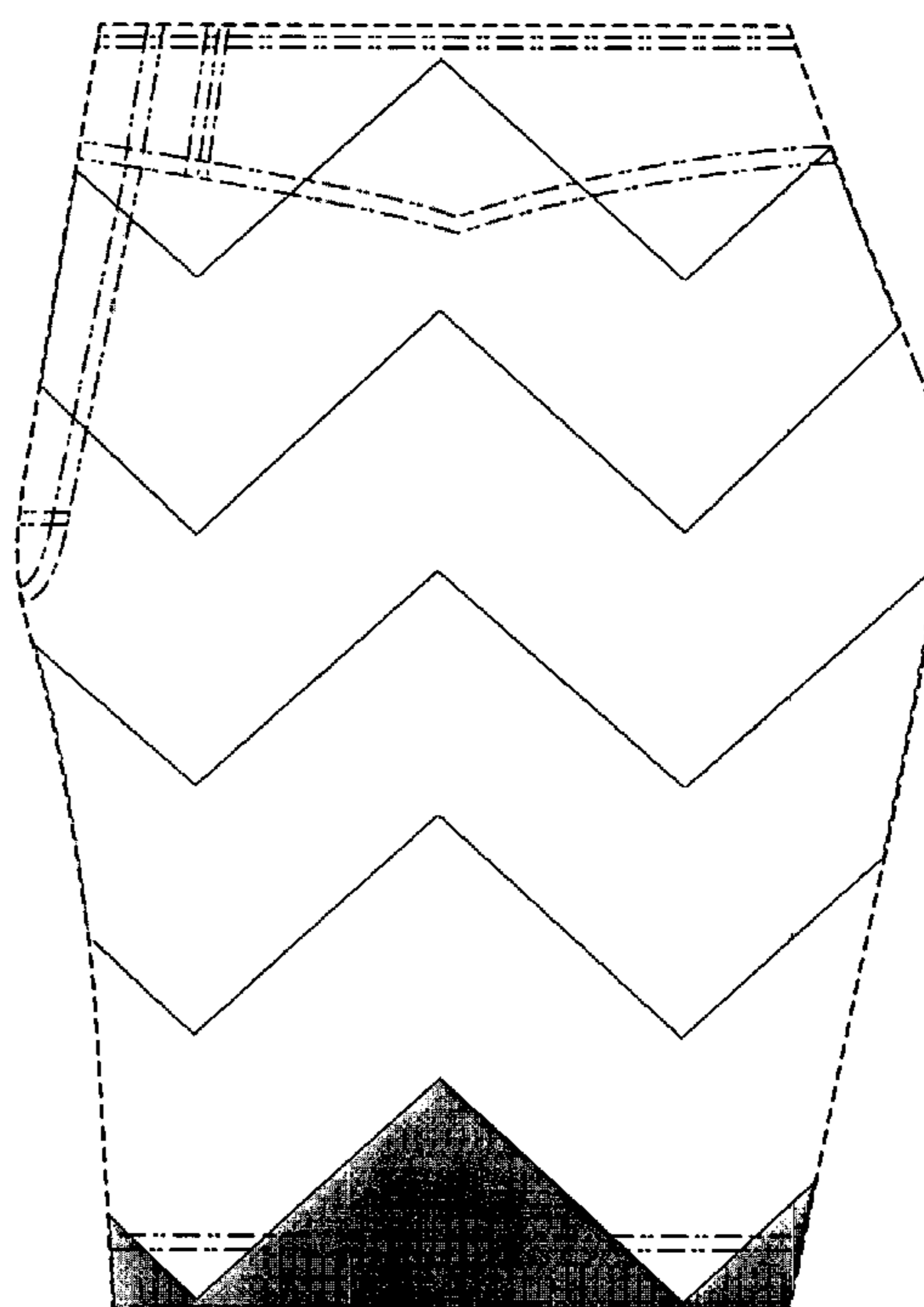
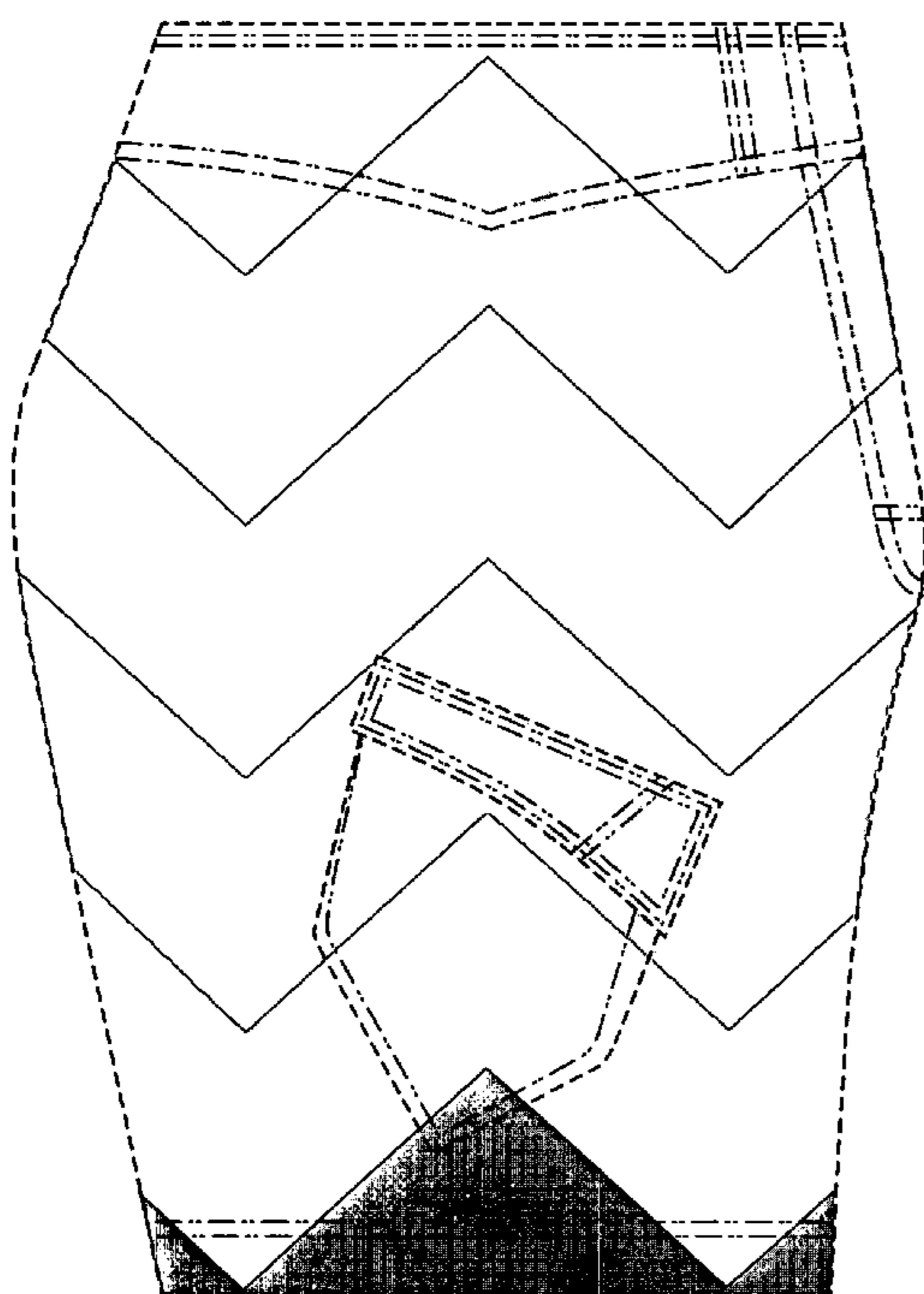
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof.

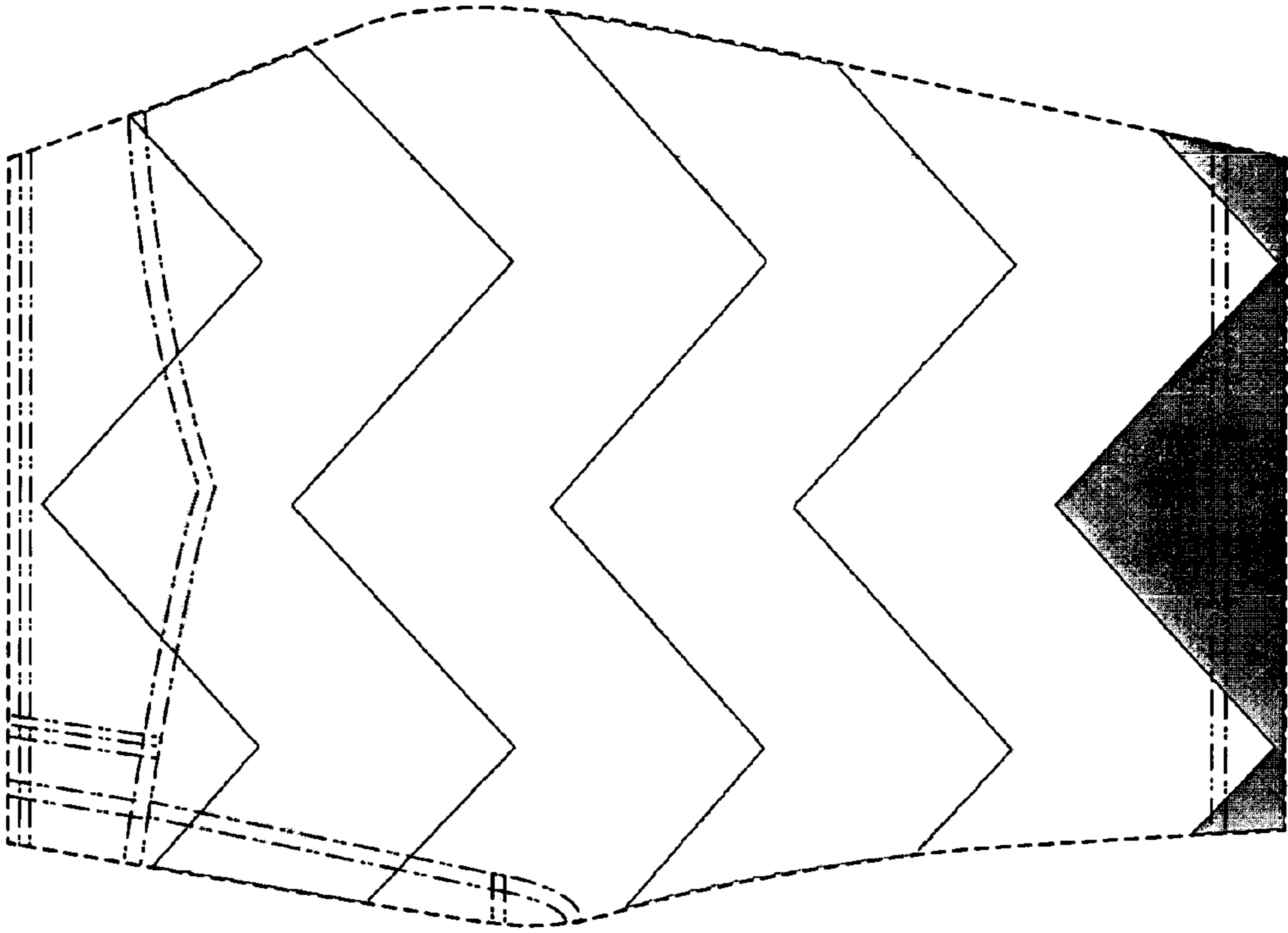

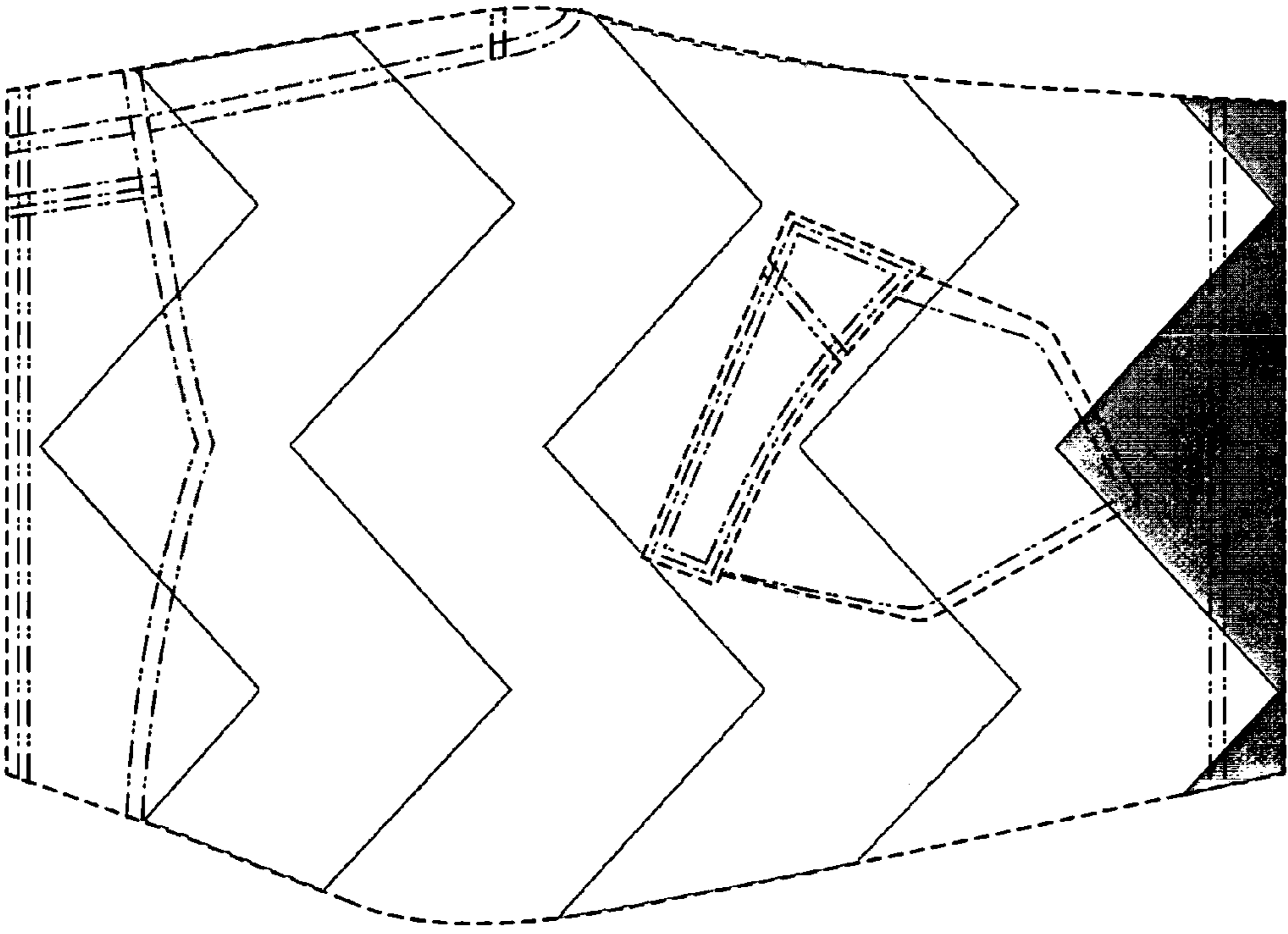
