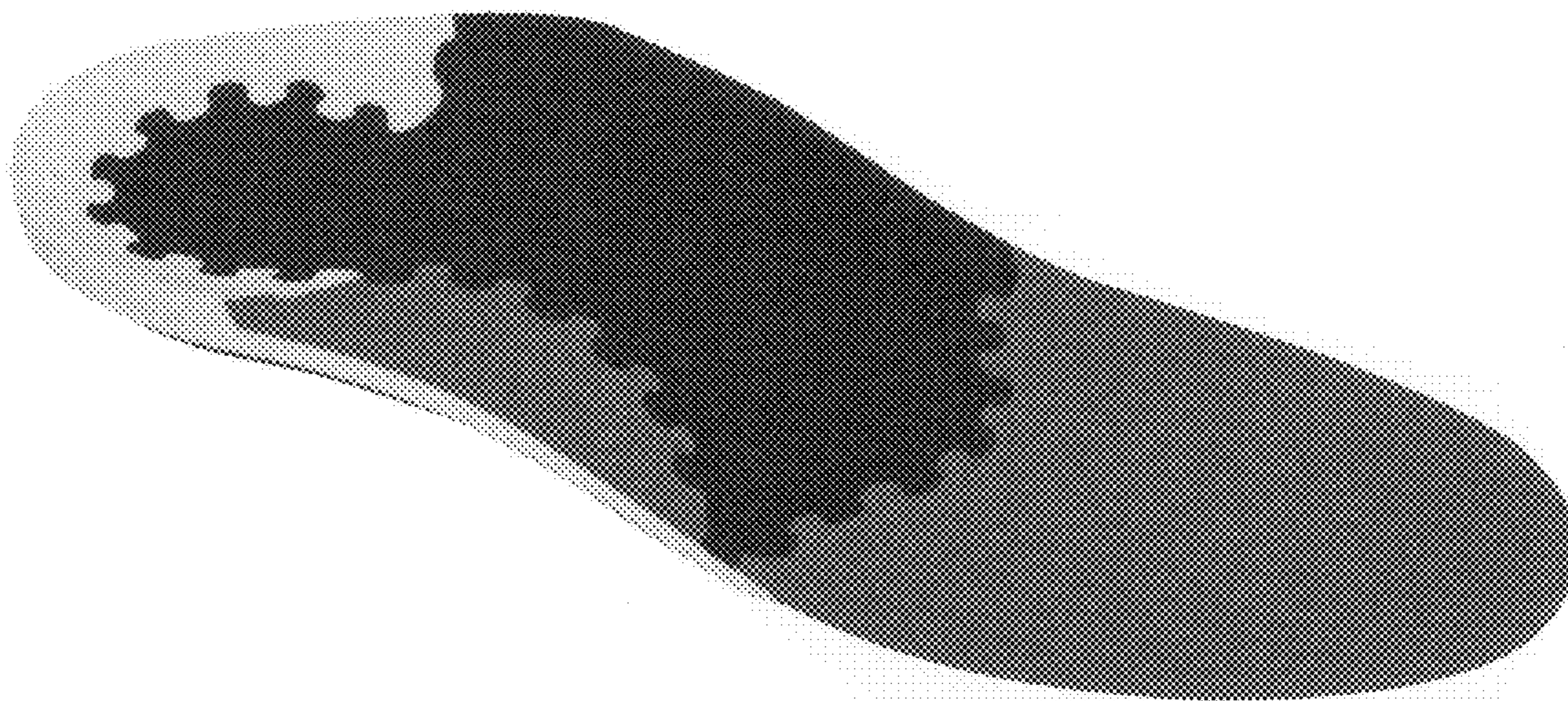
The sole FIGURE is a perspective view of an orthopedic

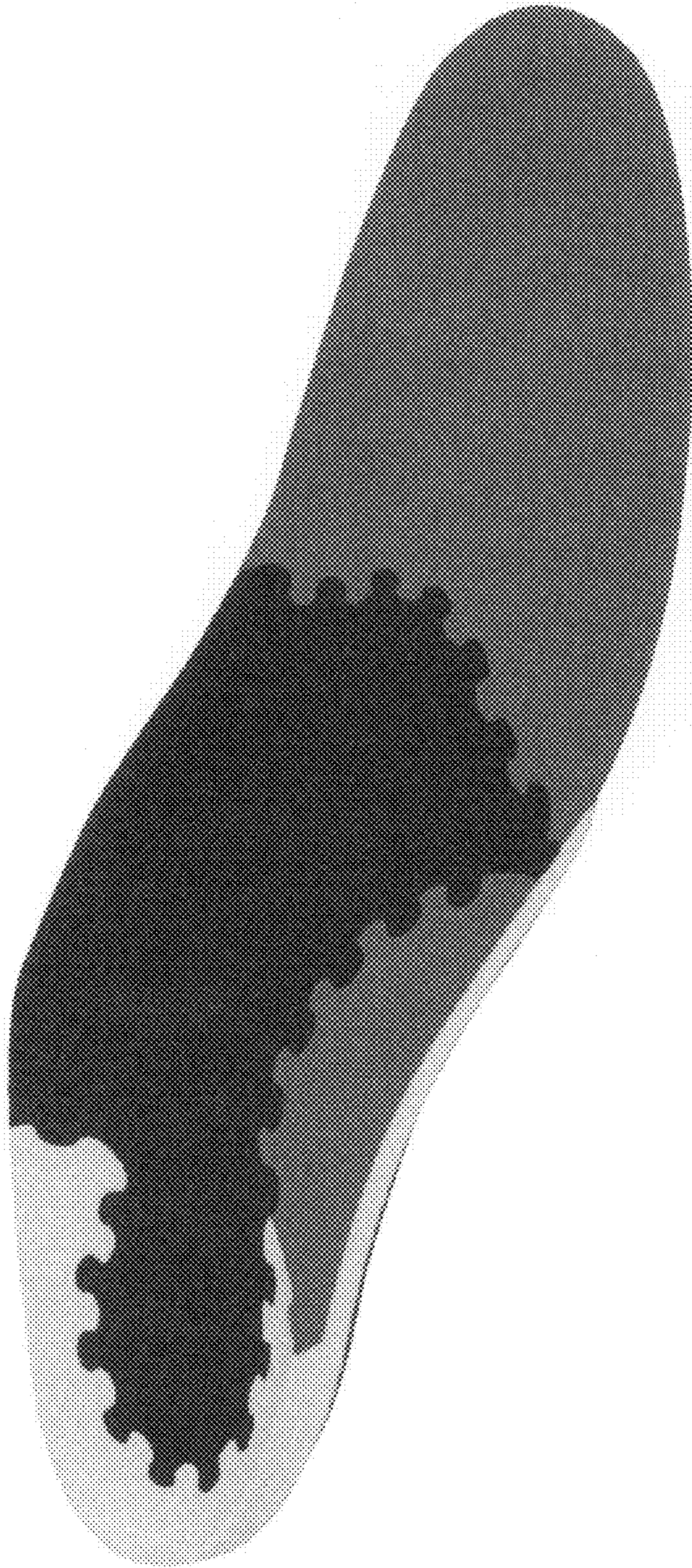
