## (57) CLAIM


The ornamental design for a mirror, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

- FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a mirror according to an embodiment of the invention.
- FIG. 2 is a front view of a mirror according to an embodiment of the invention.
- FIG. 3 is a side view of a mirror according to an embodiment of the invention, the view from the opposite side being a mirror-image thereof; and,
- FIG. 4 is an top view of a mirror according to the embodiment of the invention.





