**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 13 is a rear view of FIG. 9.

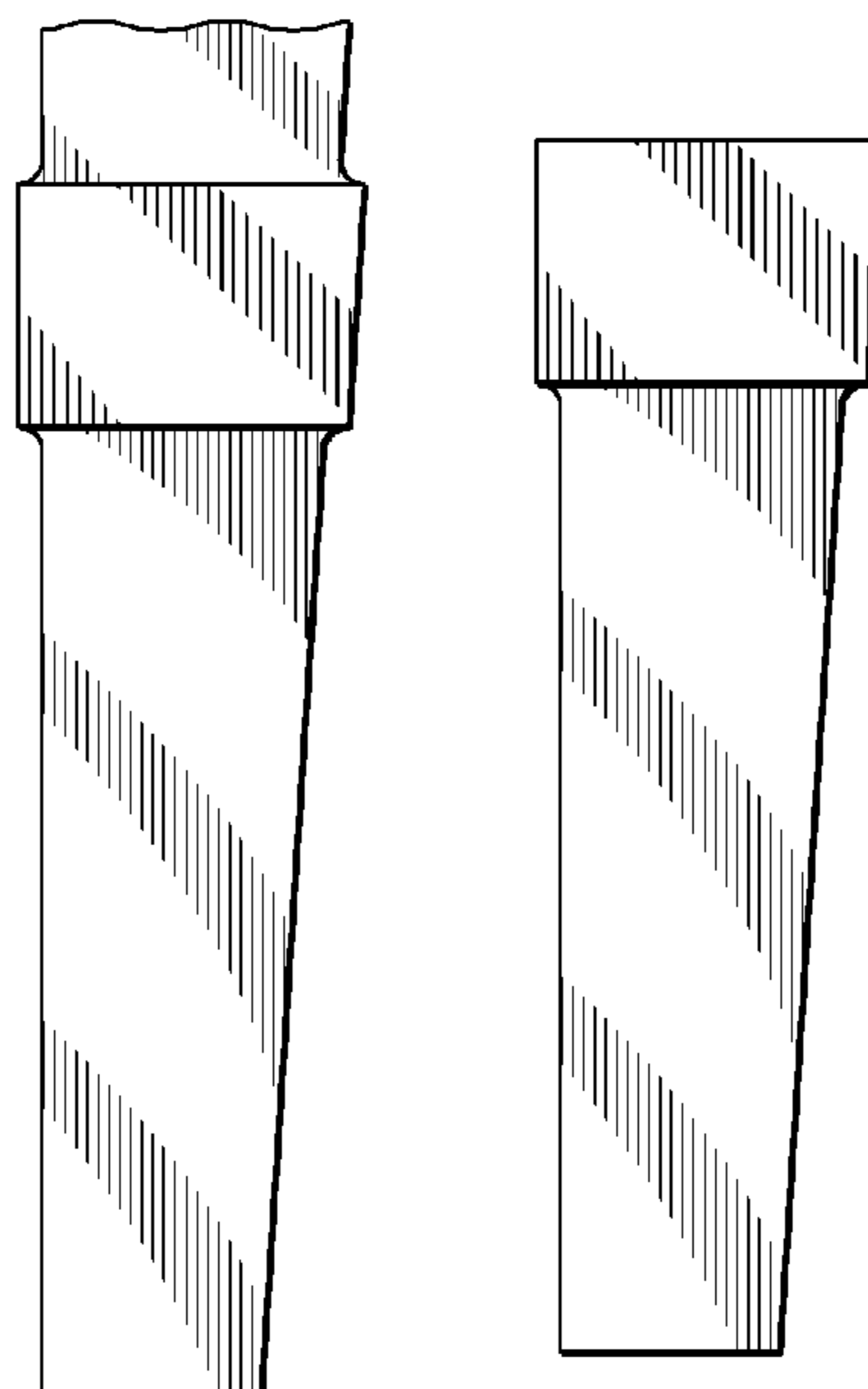
FIG. 14 is a left elevational view of FIG. 9.

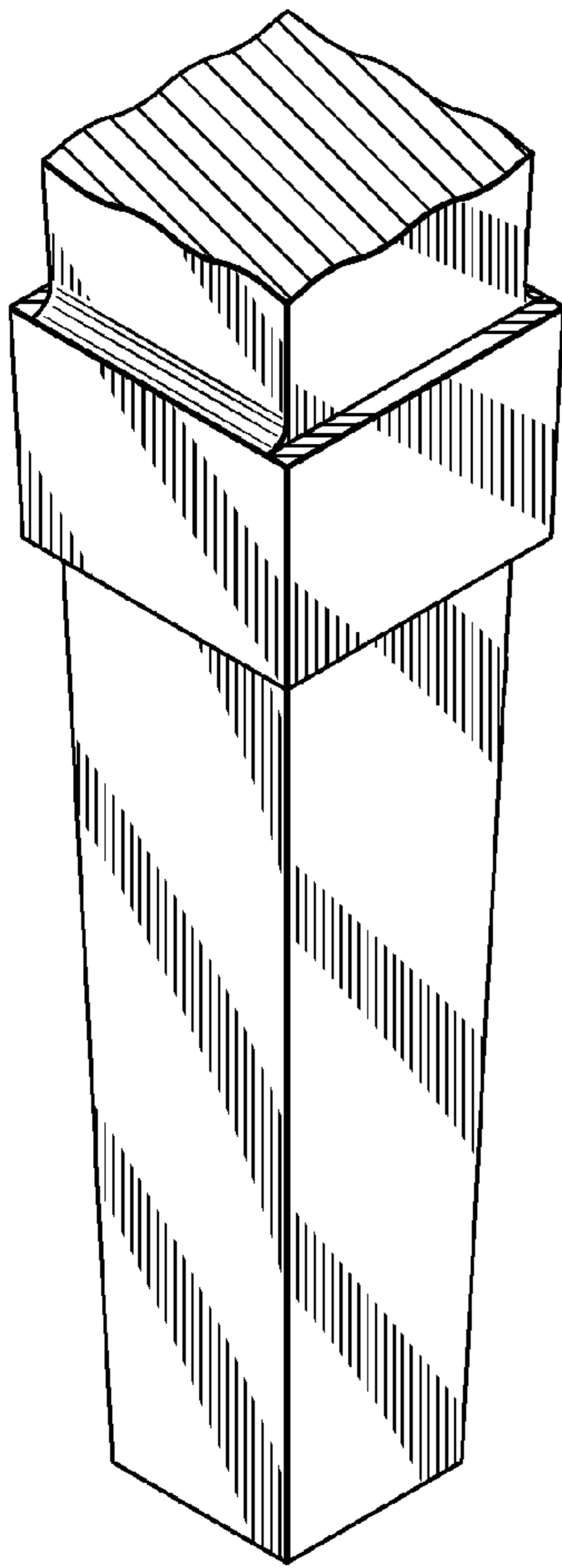

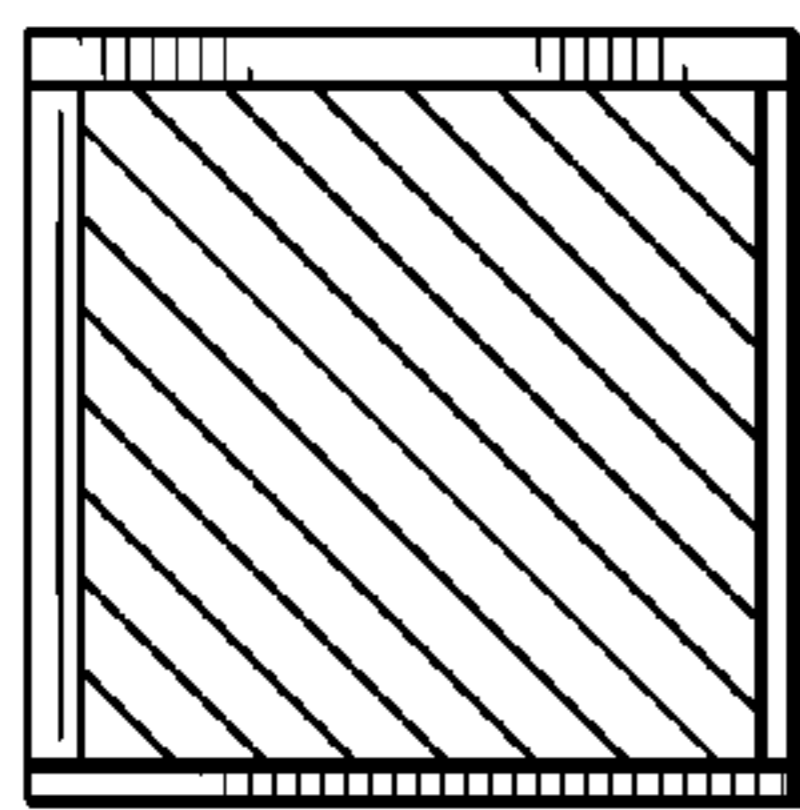

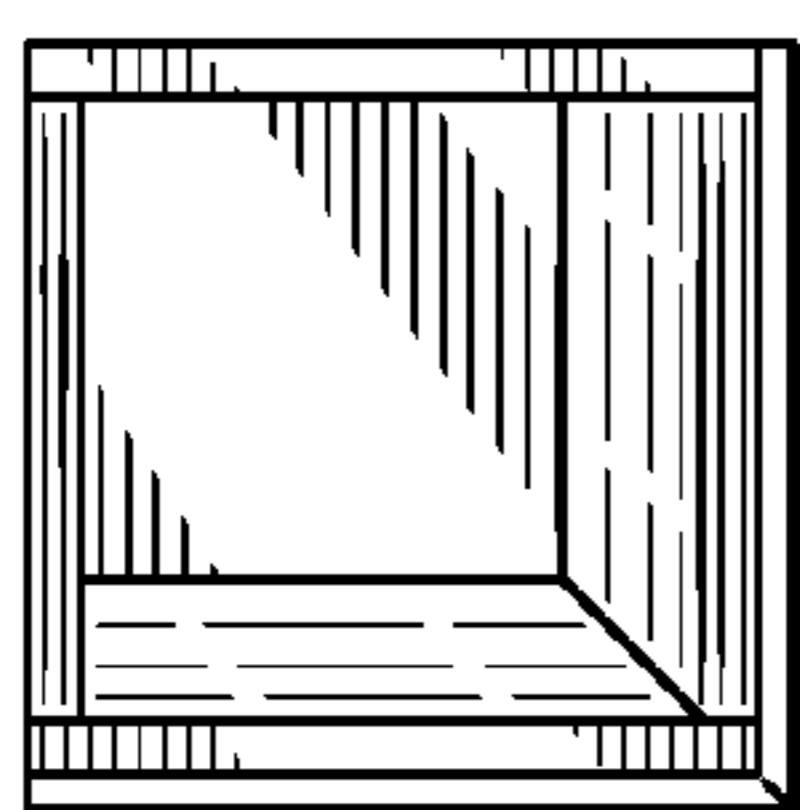

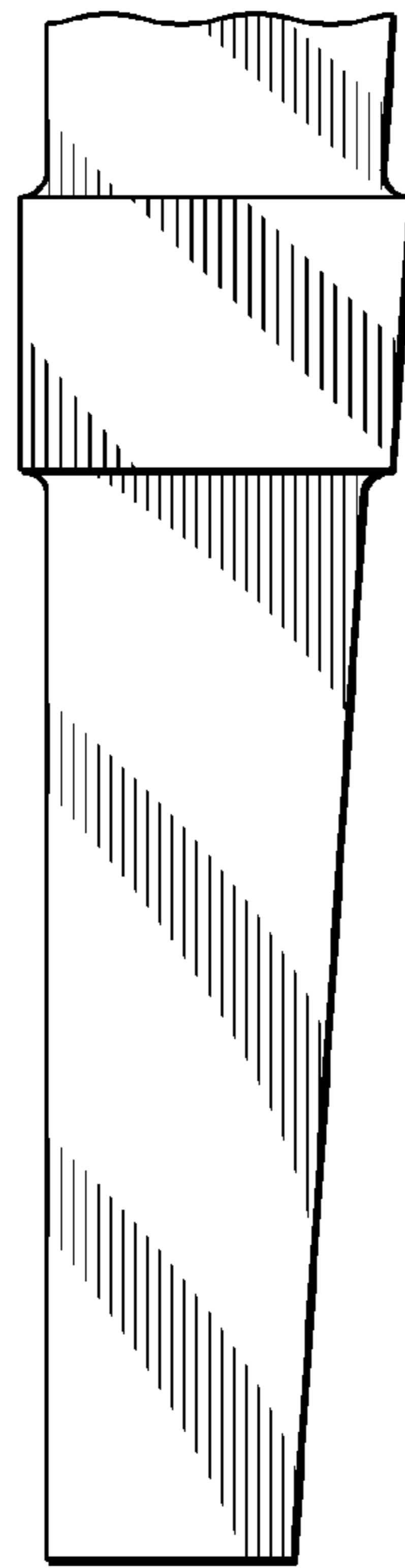

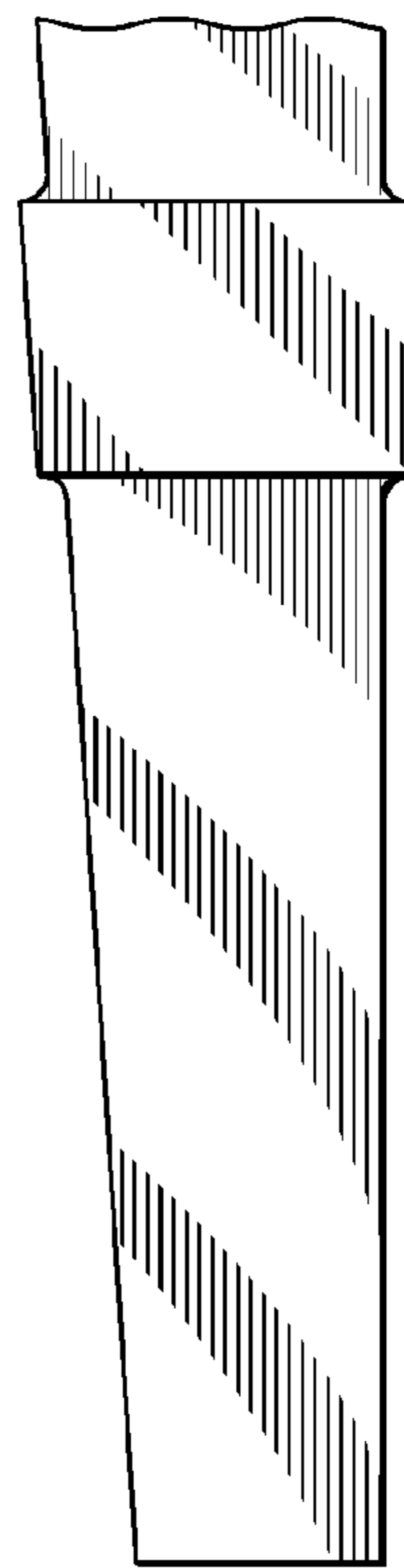

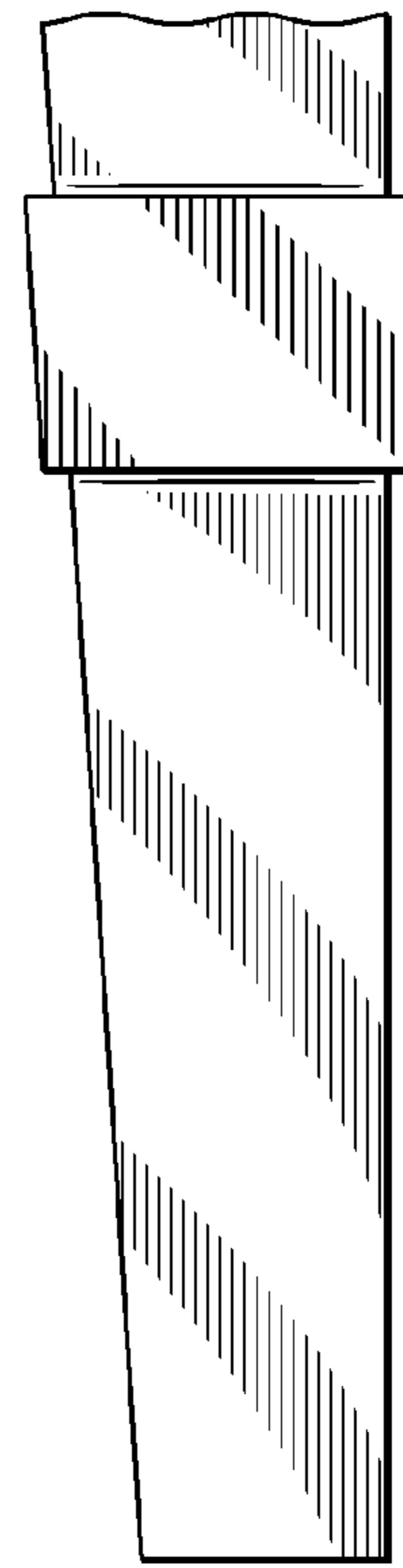

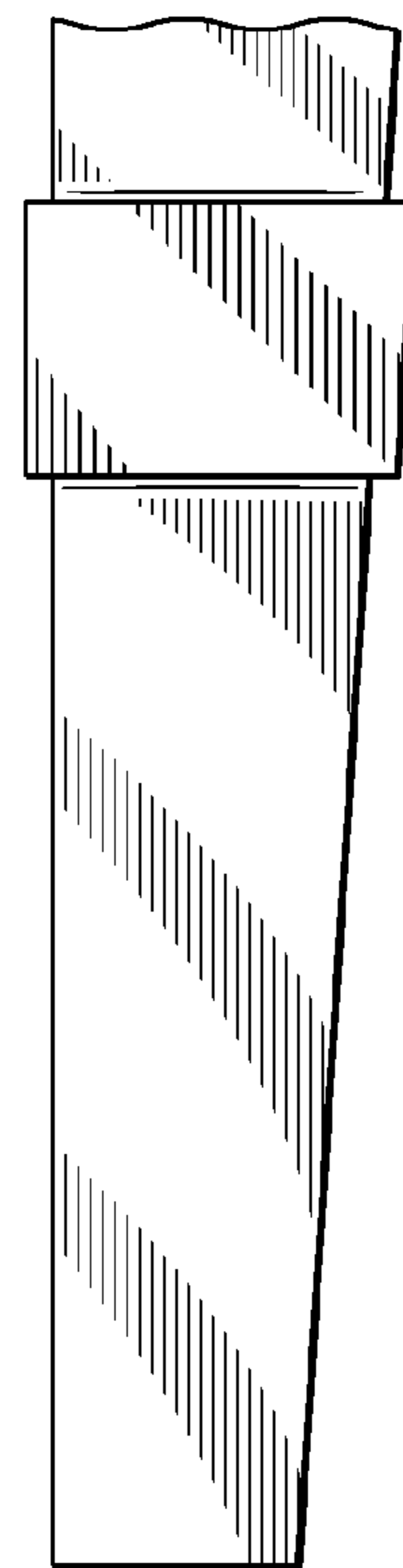

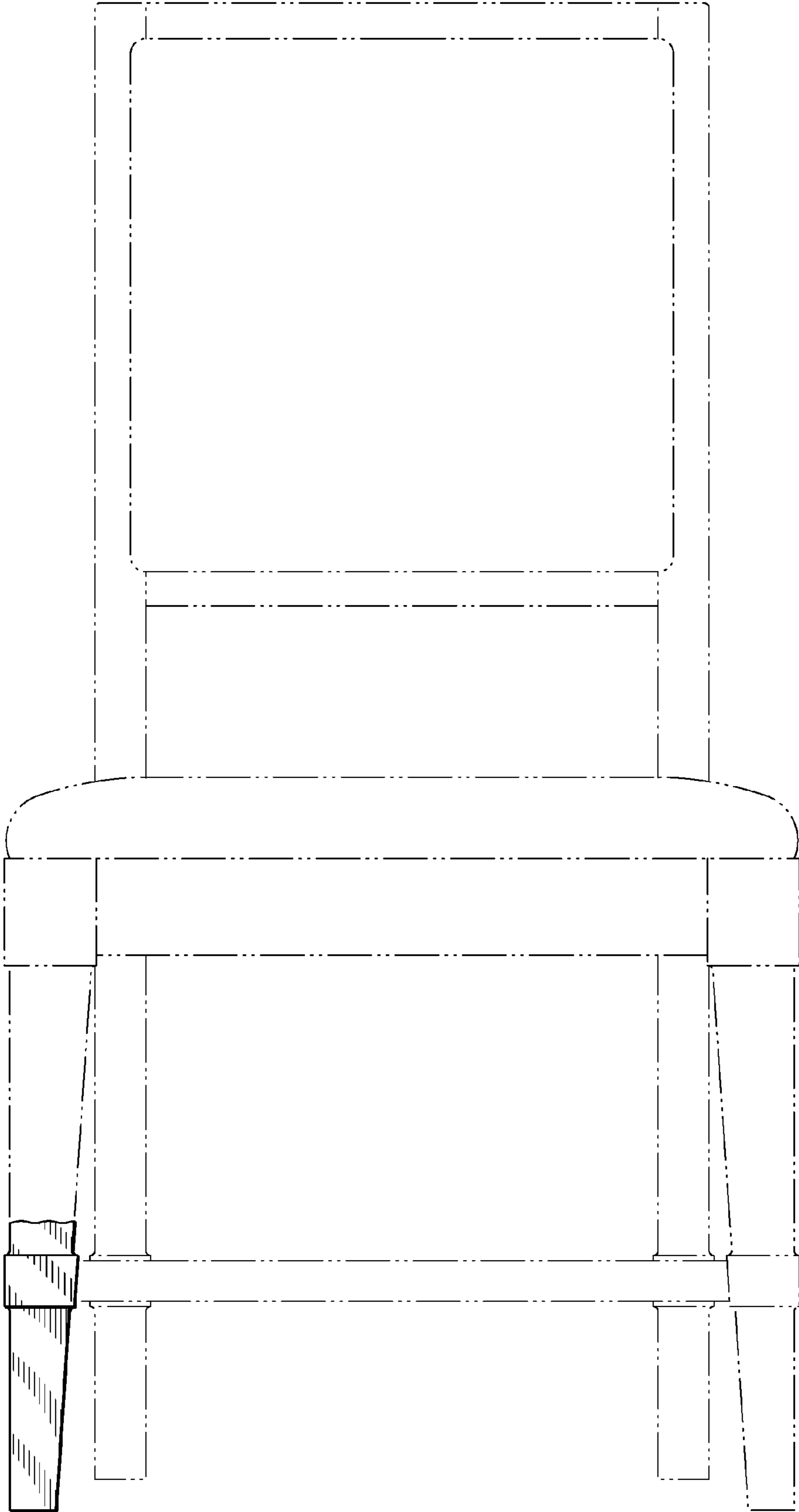

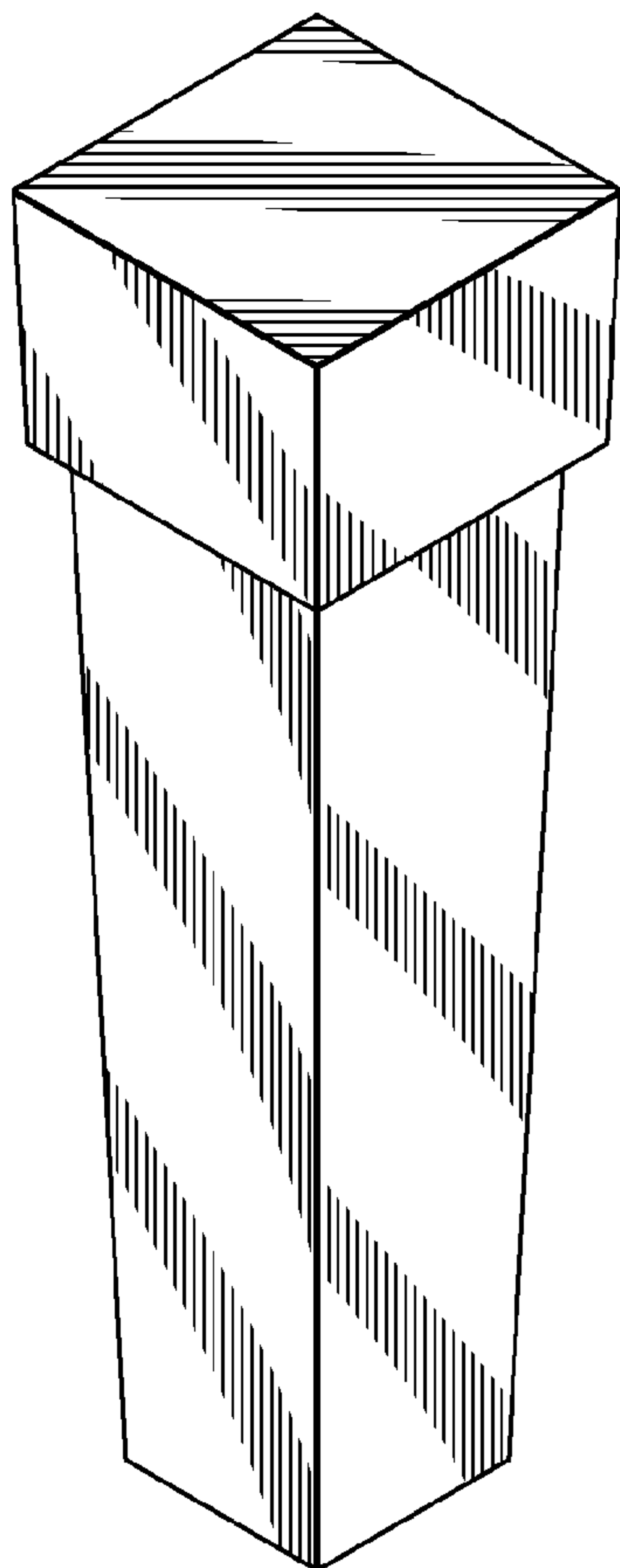

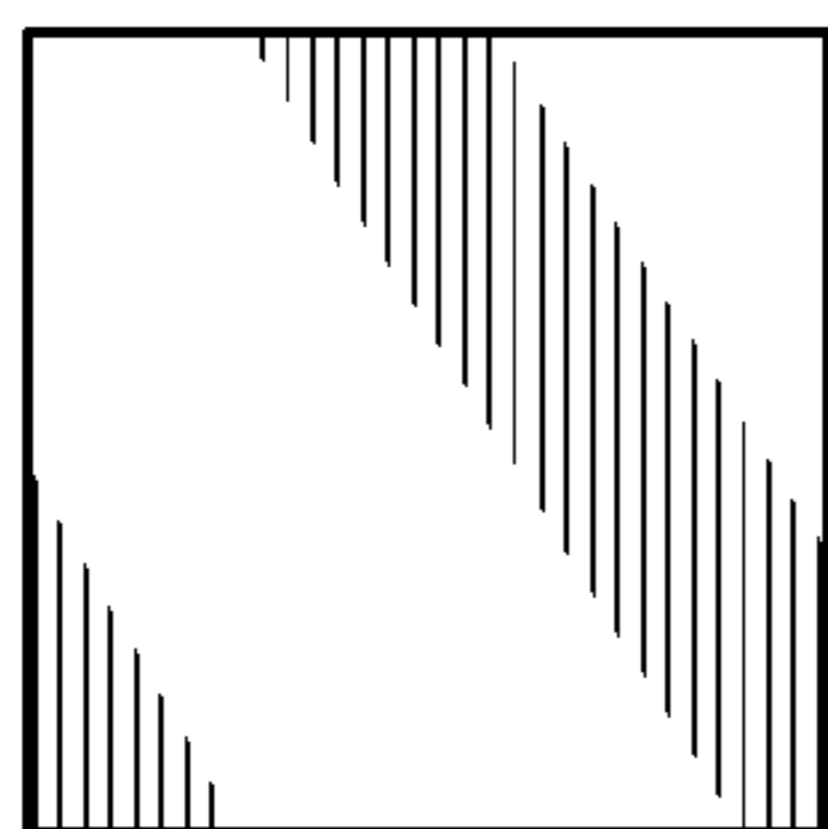

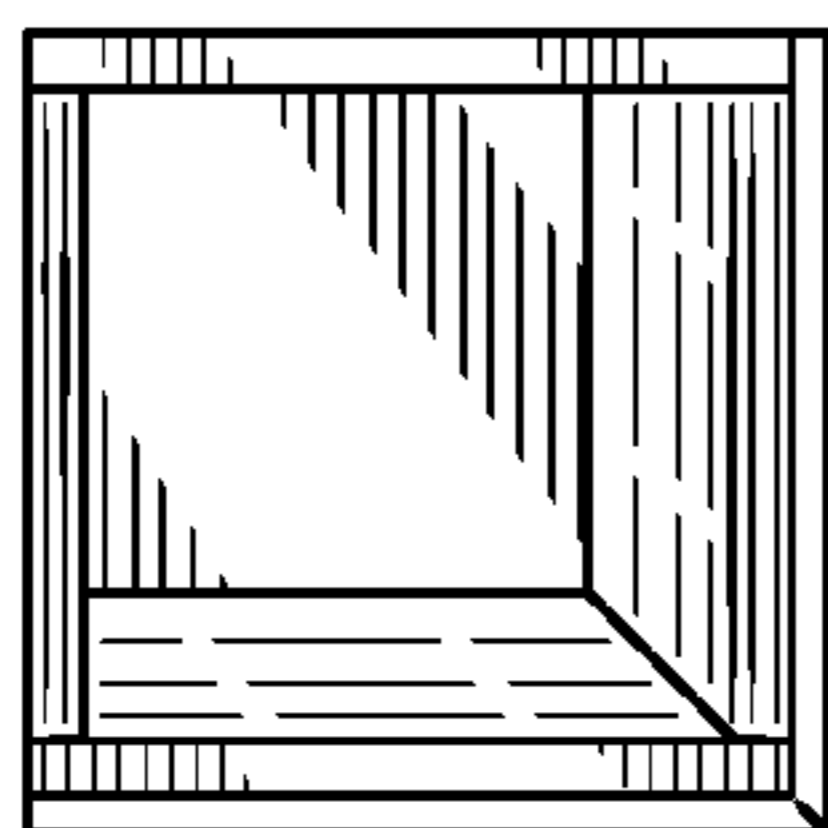

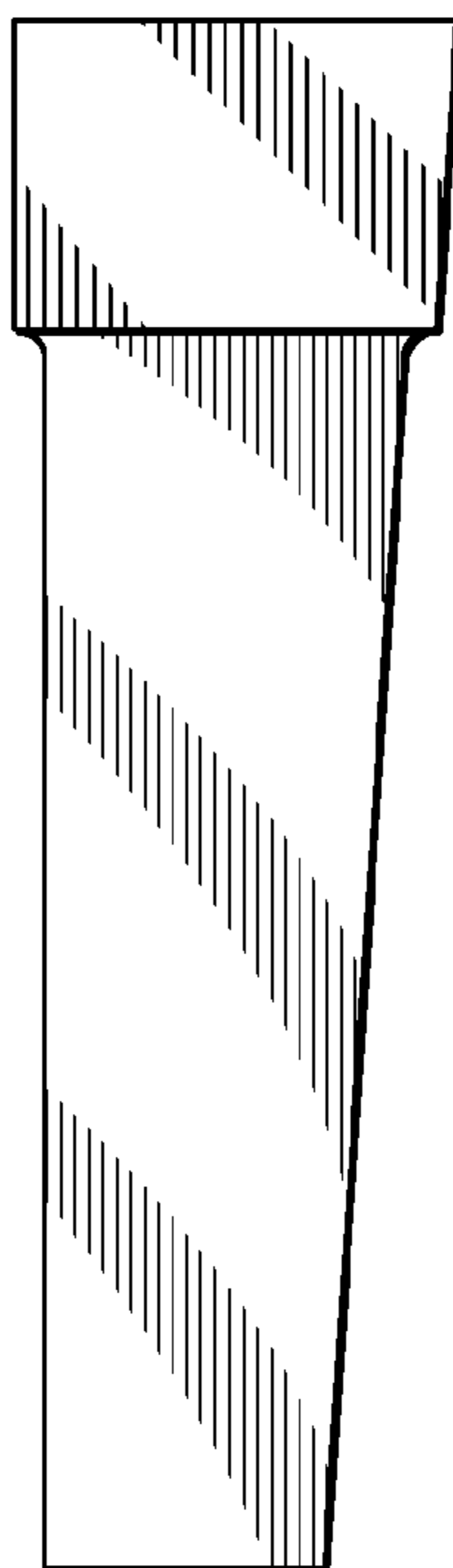

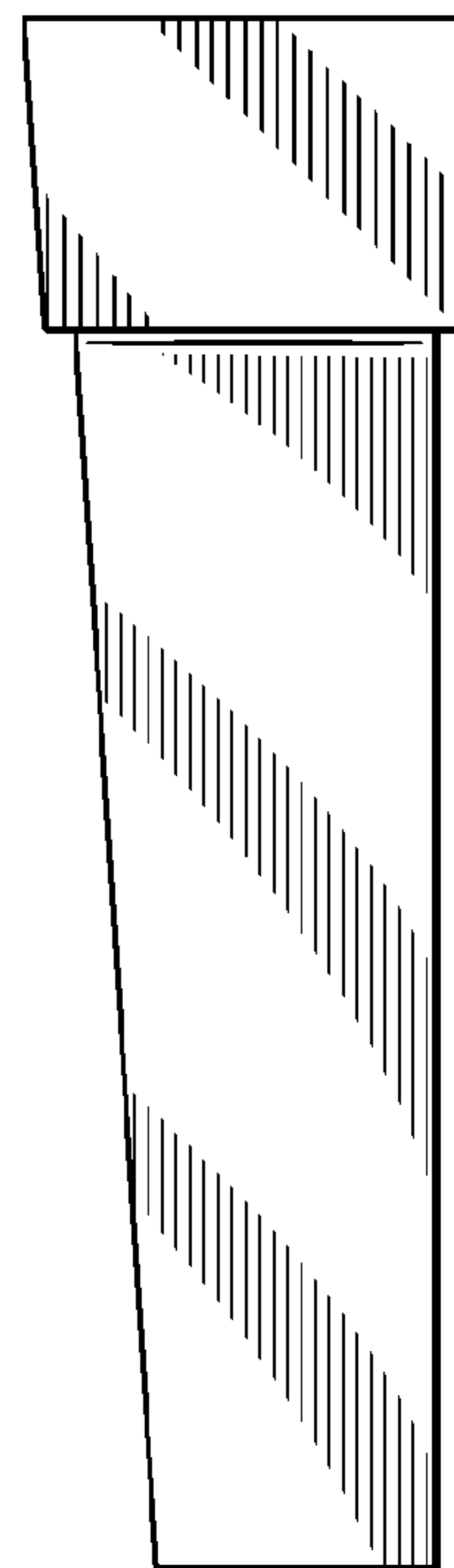

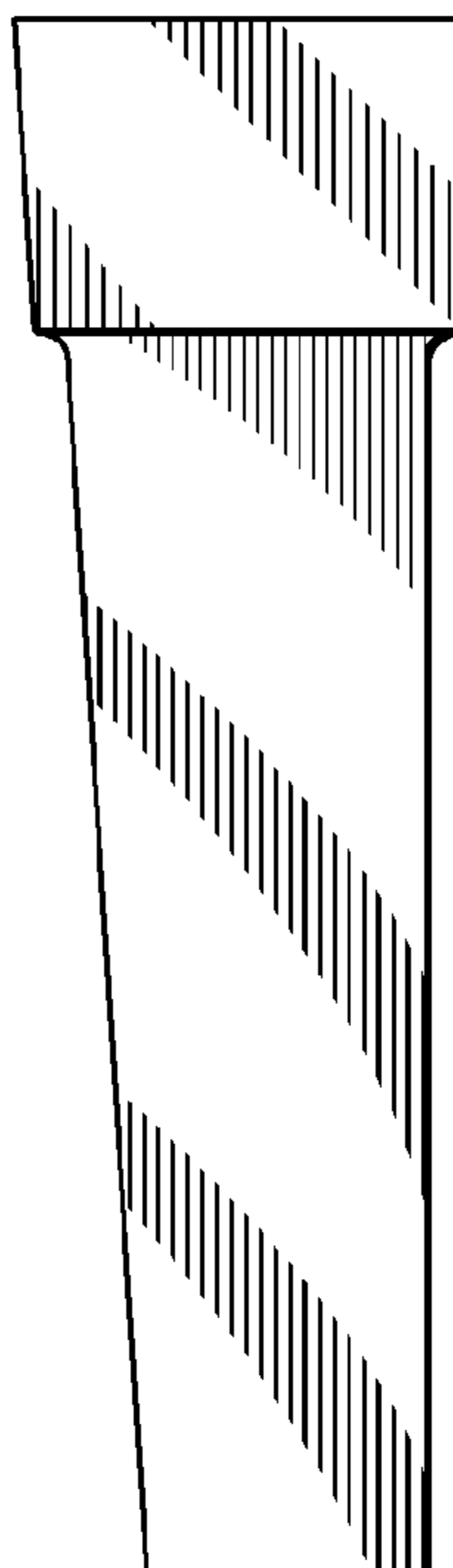

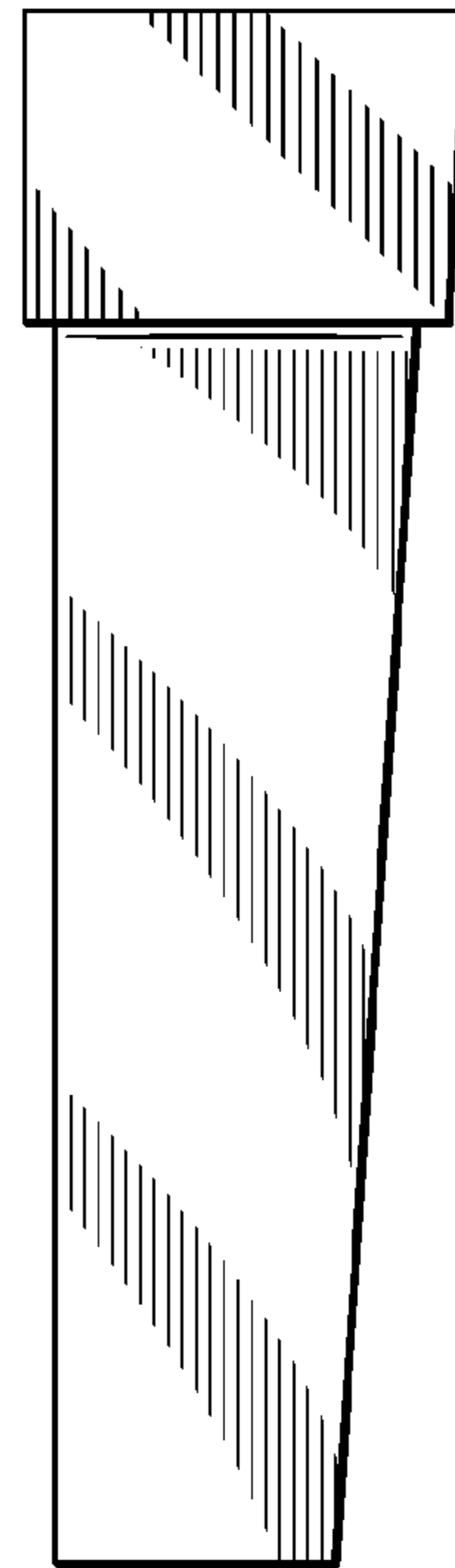

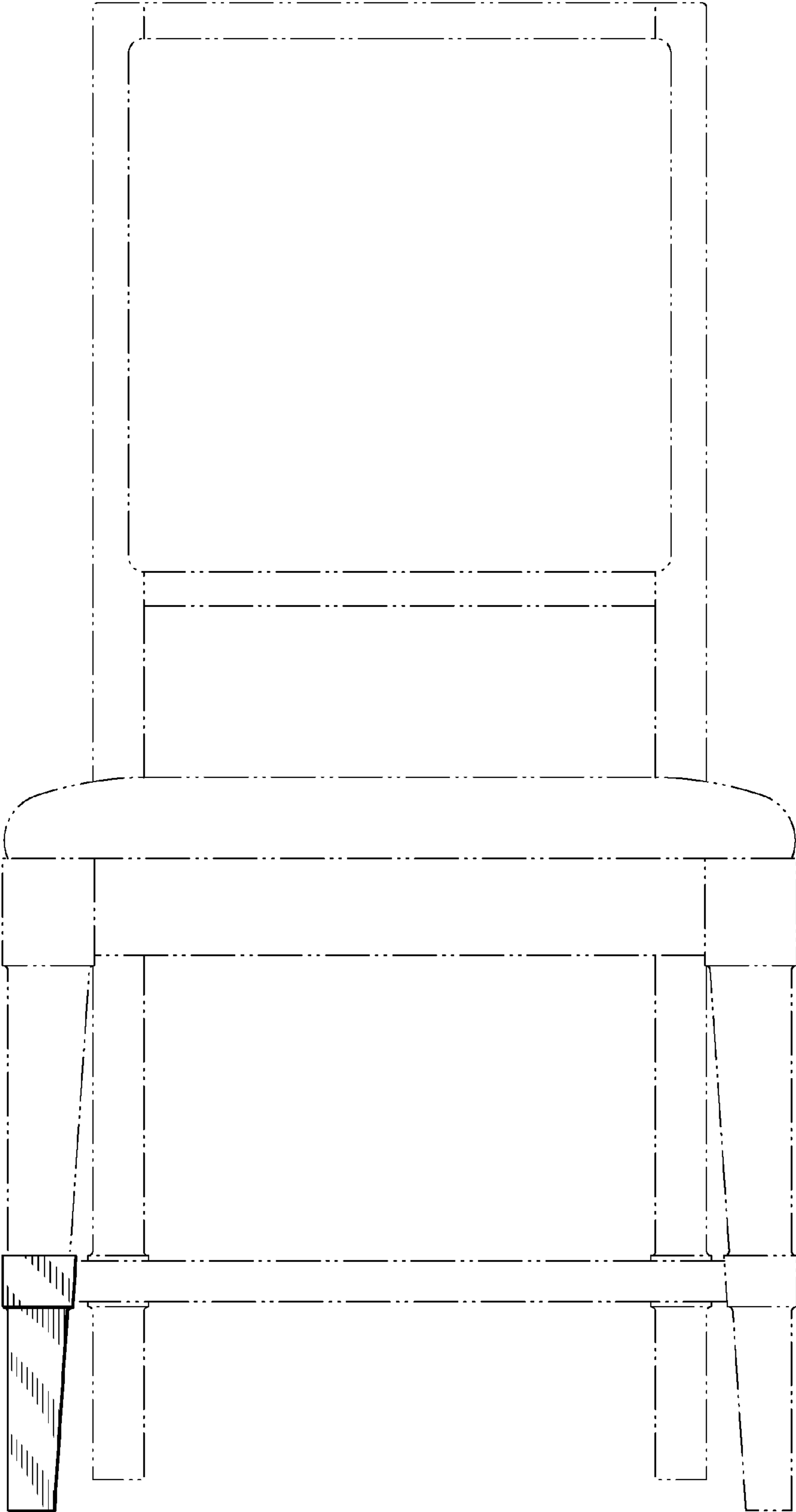
