DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a con-
tainer body portion showing our new design;

container body portion showing our new design;

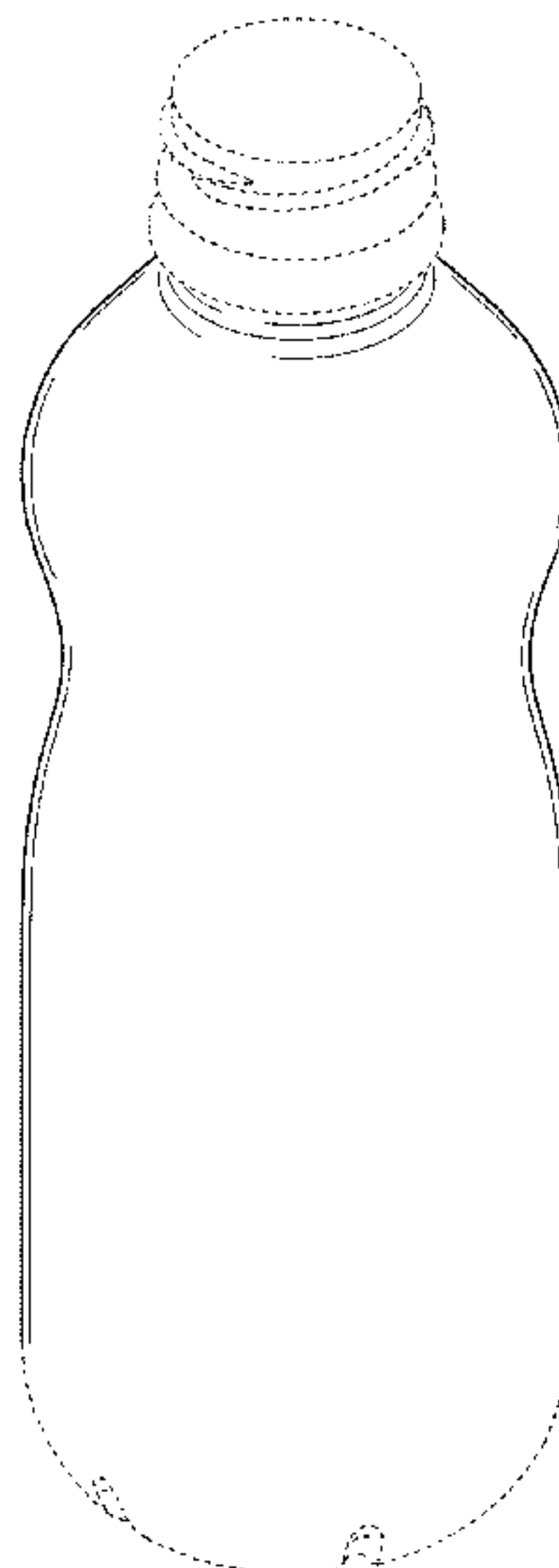
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational

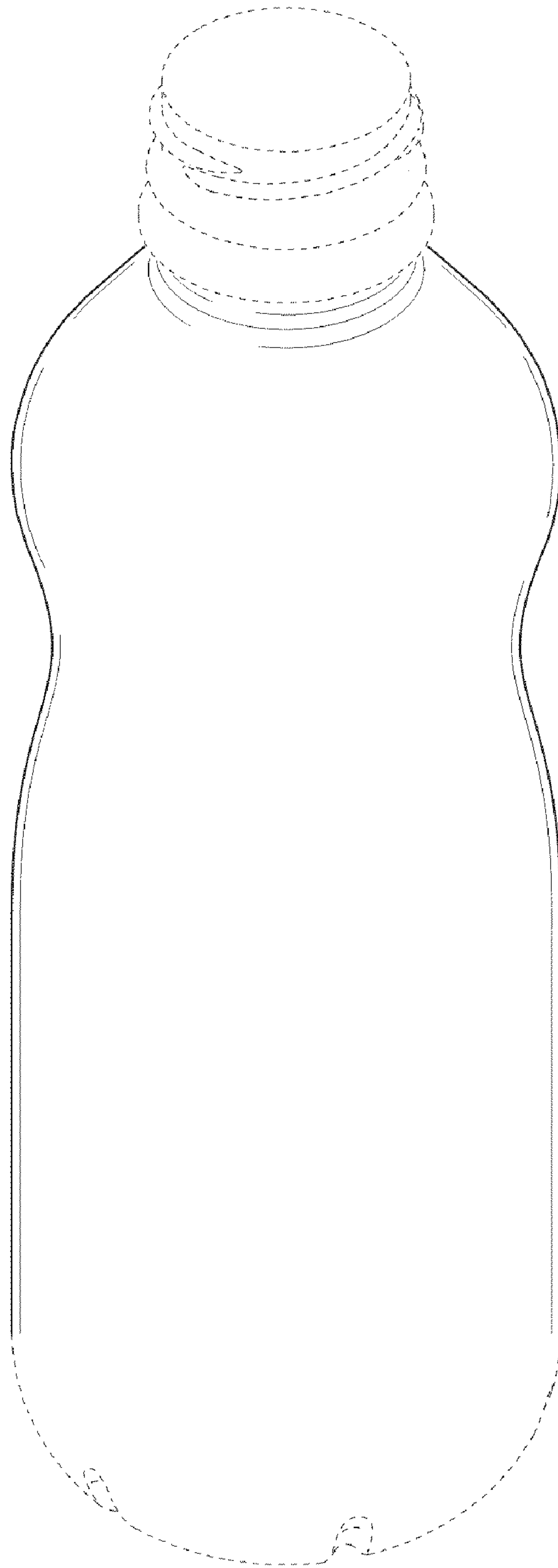

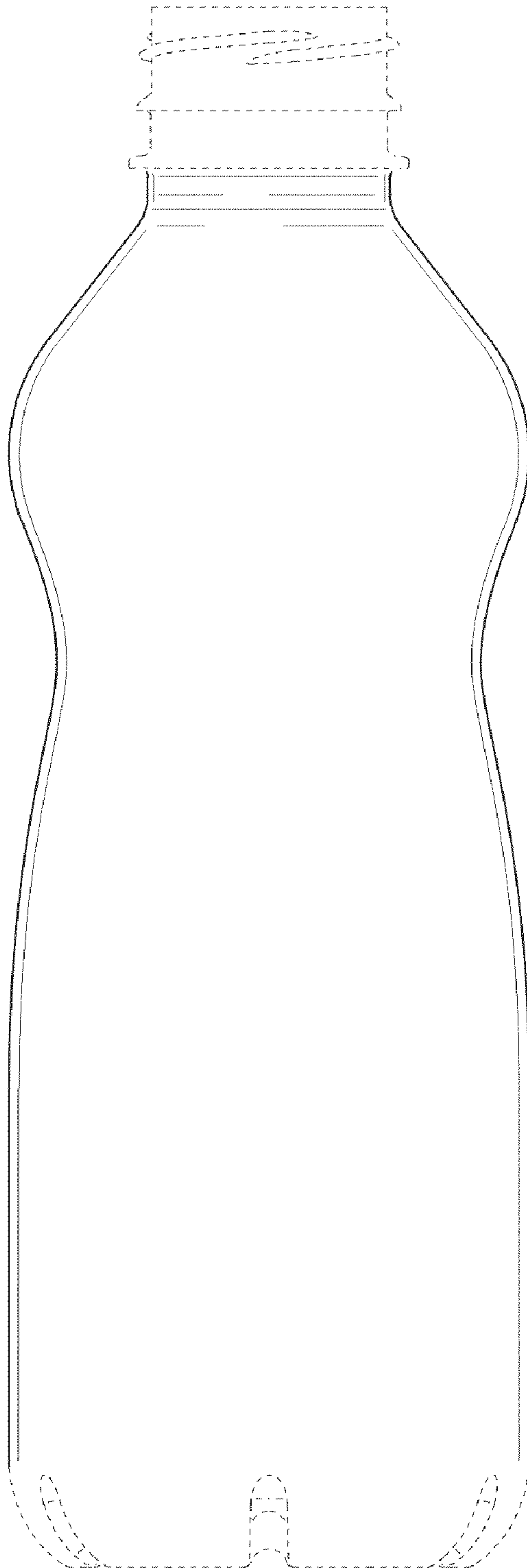

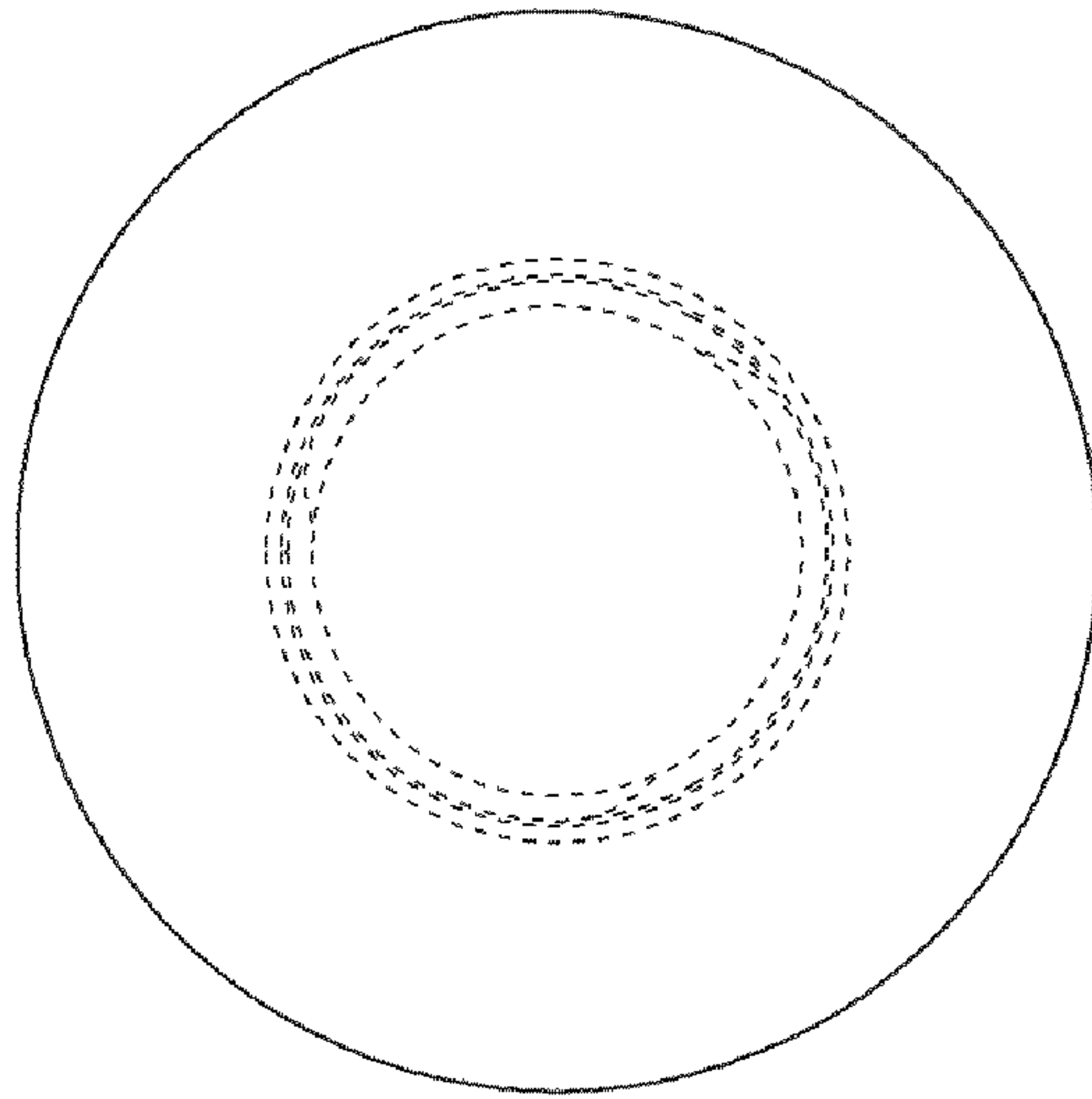

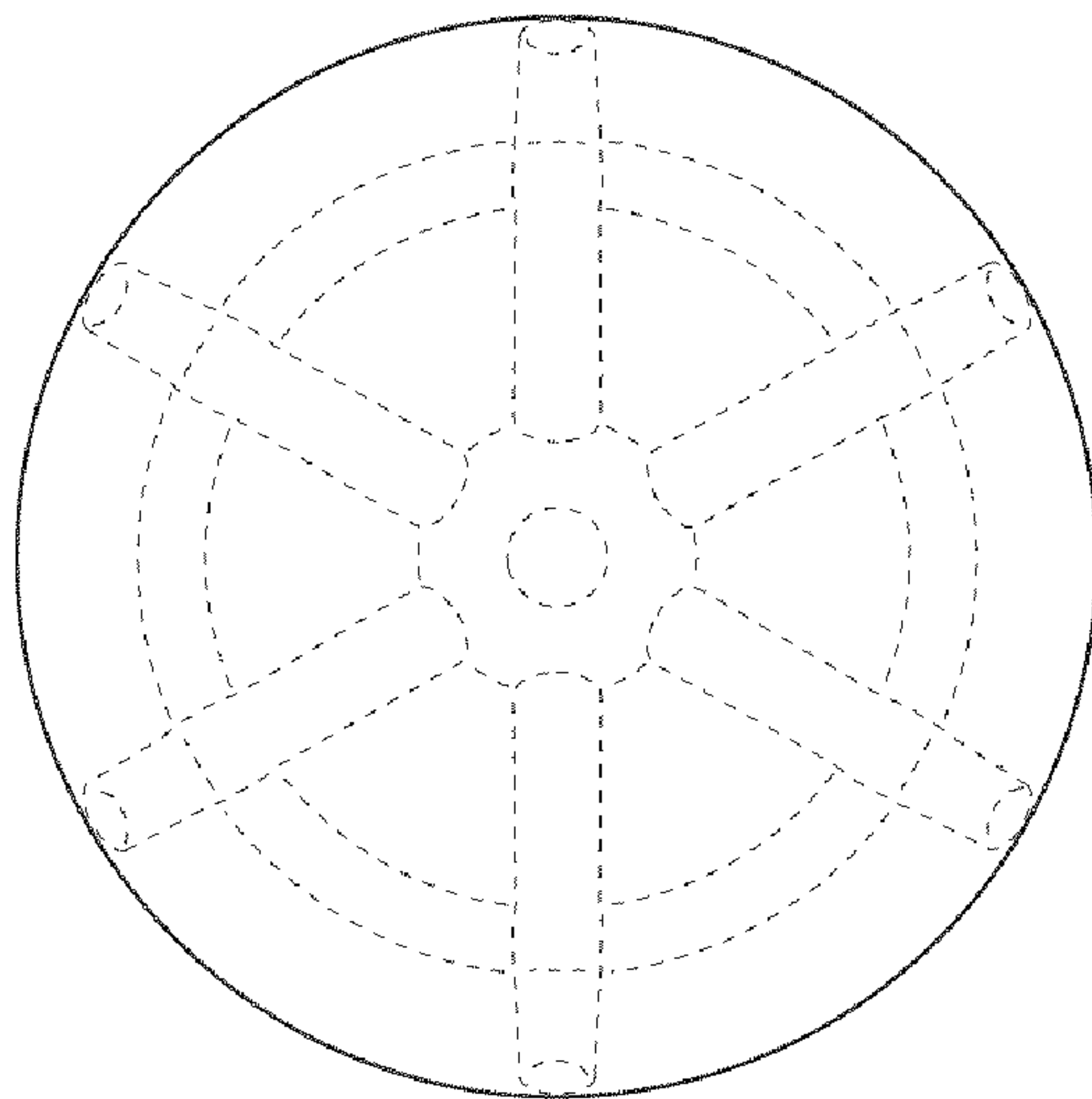

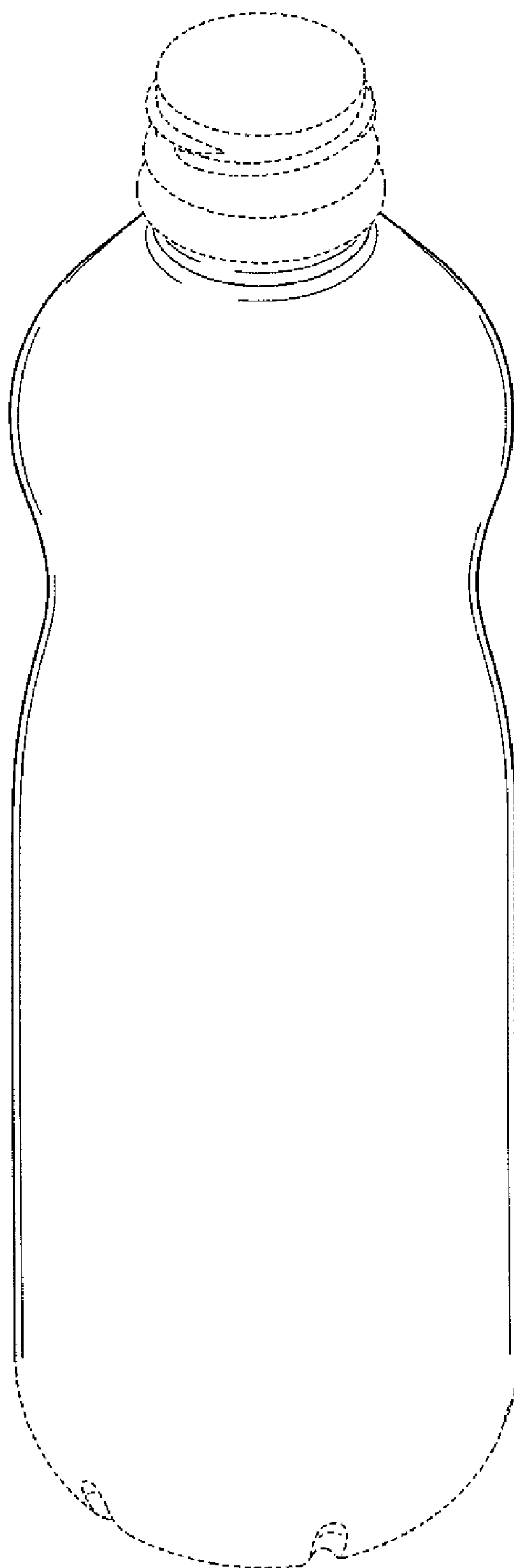

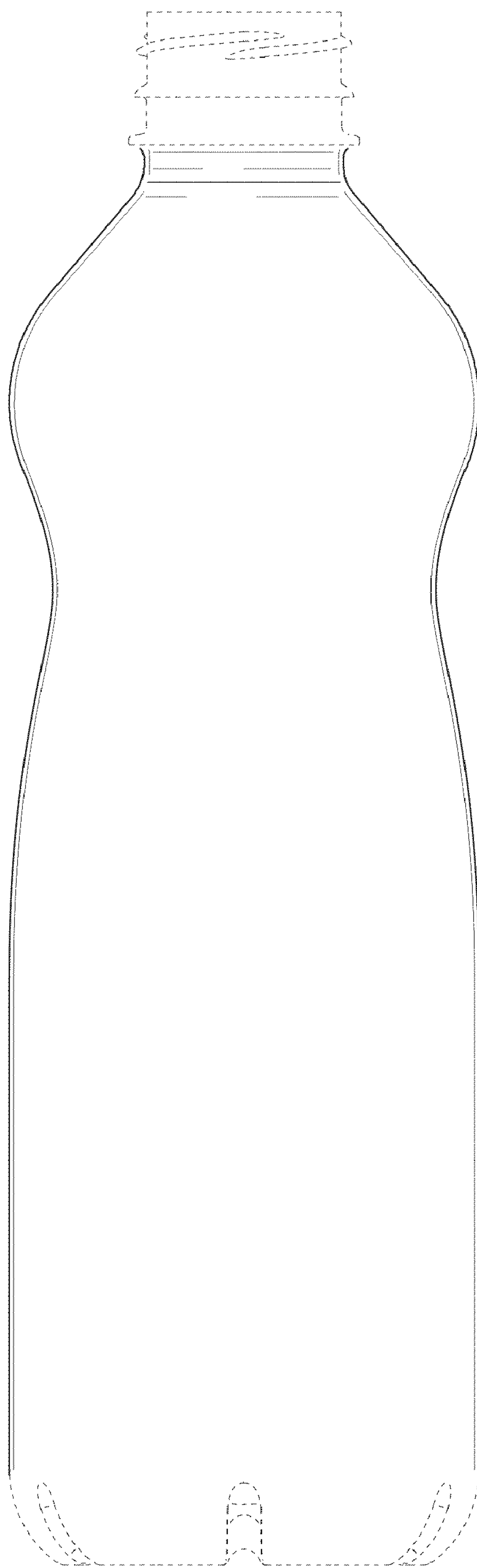

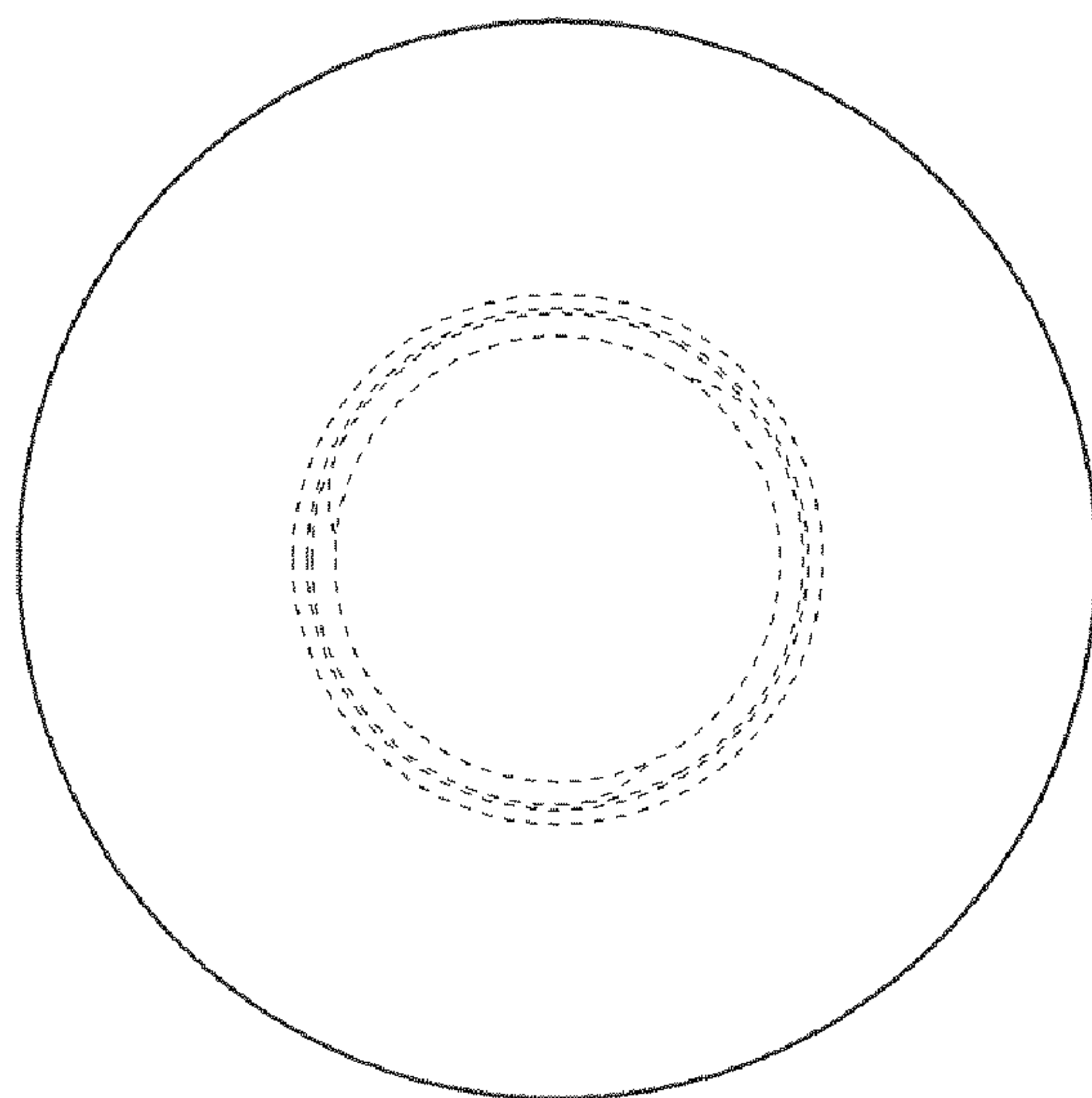

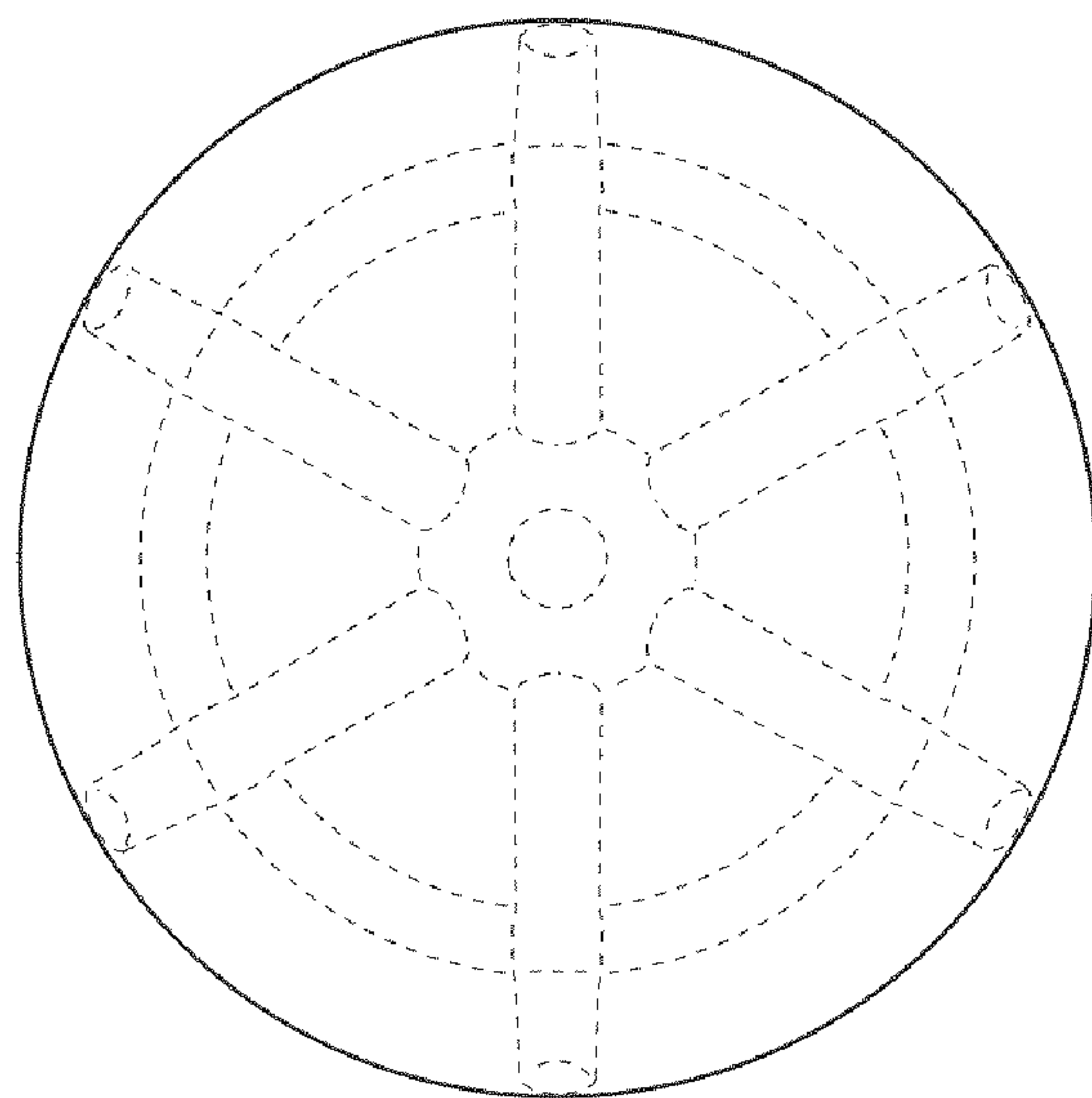
