DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a first embodiment of a level incorporating our new design, wherein the subject matter illustrated in phantom forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a first side elevation view thereof, wherein the opposite side elevation view is a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is first end elevation view thereof, wherein the opposite end elevation view is identical;

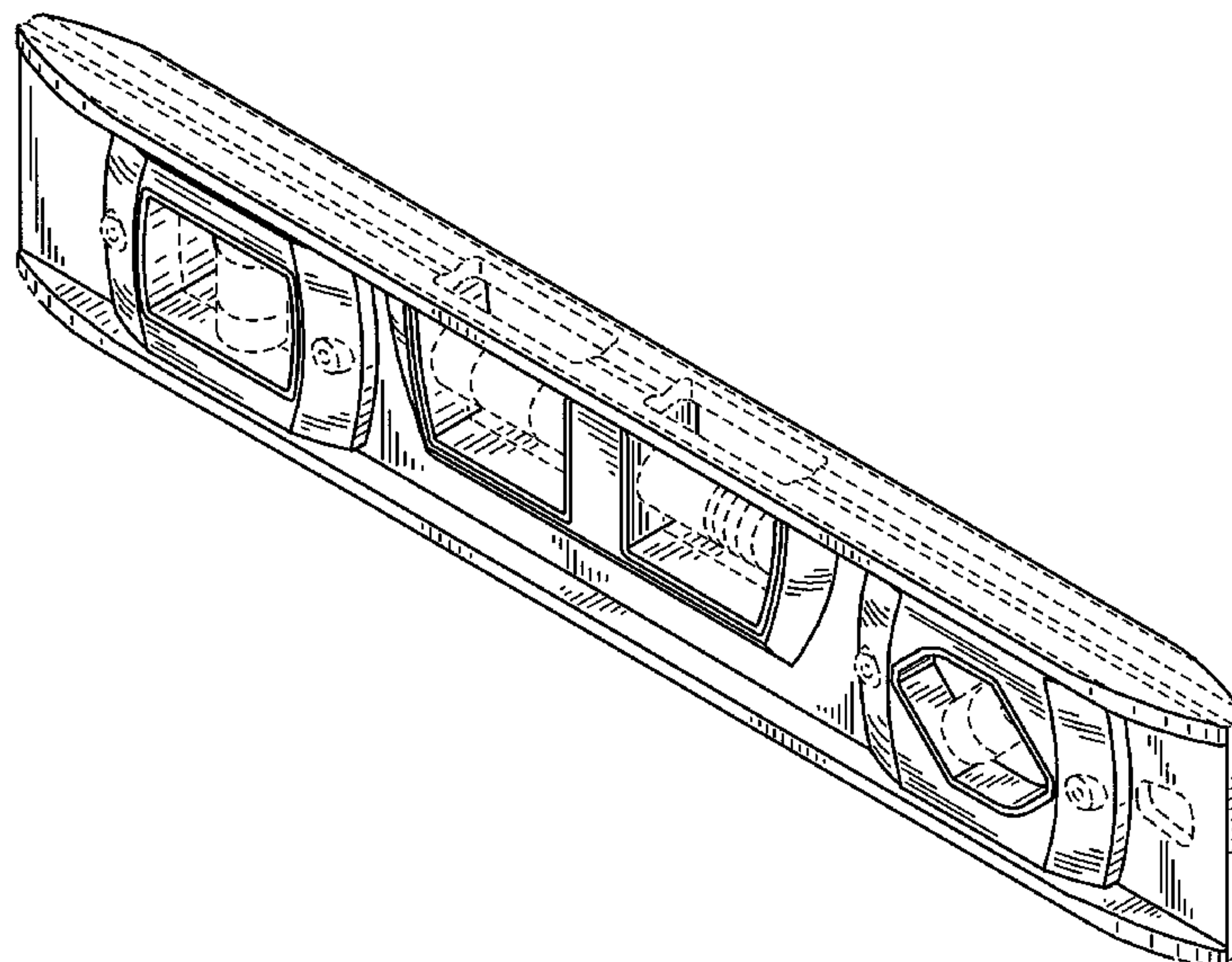
FIG. 6 is an isometric view of a second embodiment of a level incorporating our new design, wherein the subject matter illustrated in phantom forms no part of the claimed design, and wherein the end elevation is the same as shown in FIG. 5;

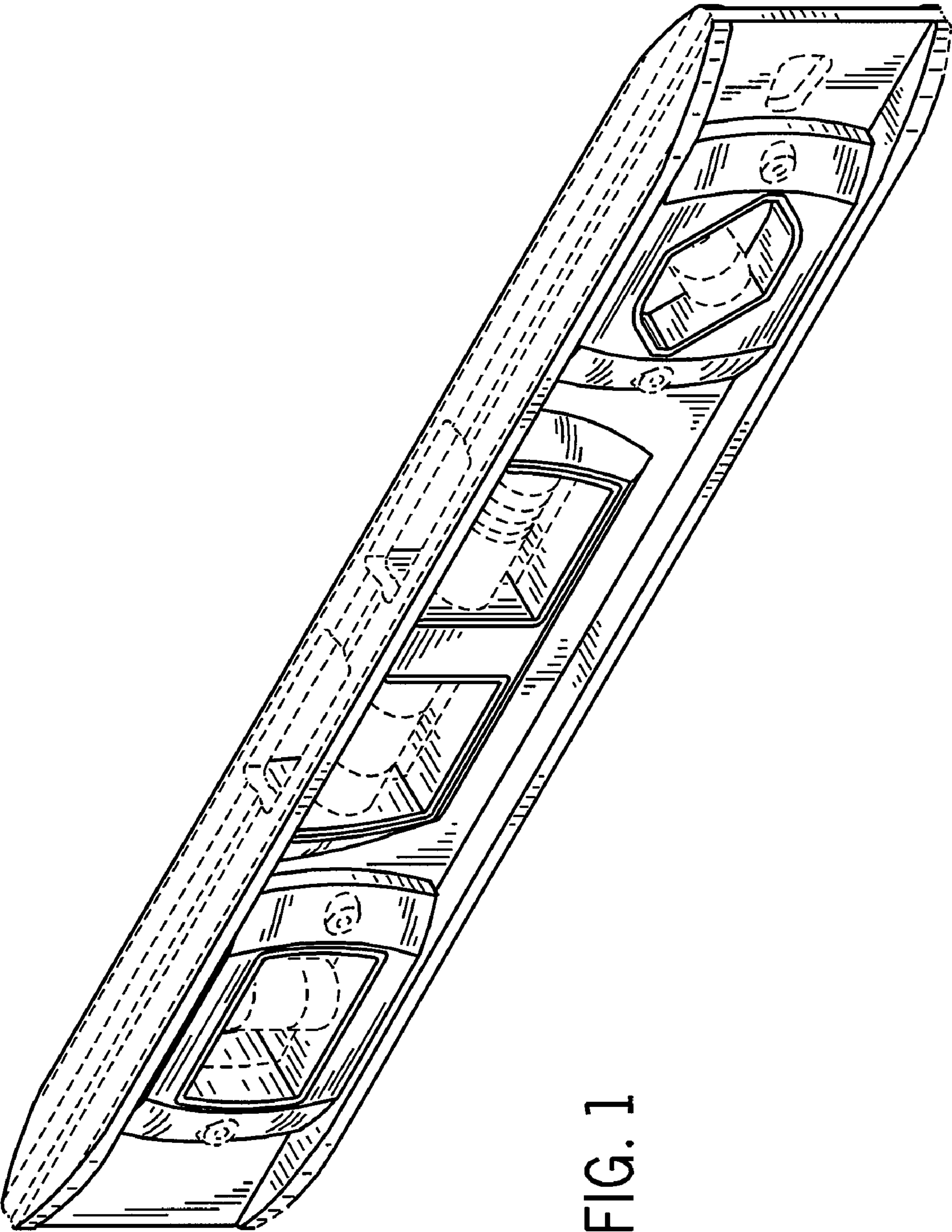

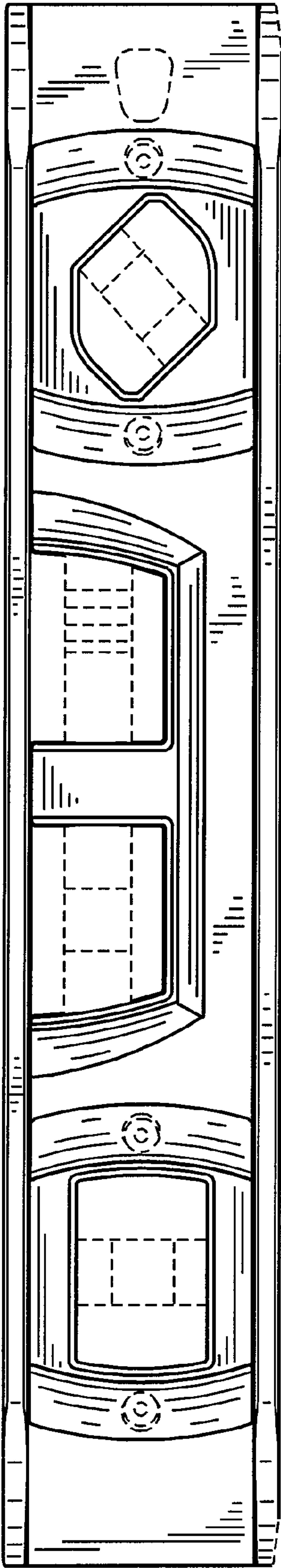

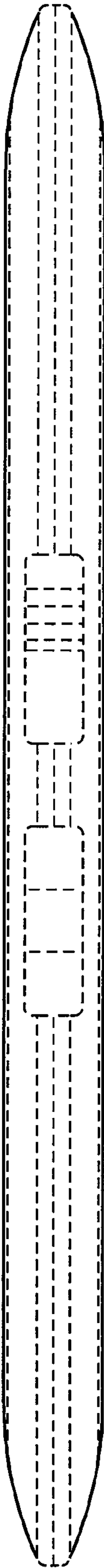

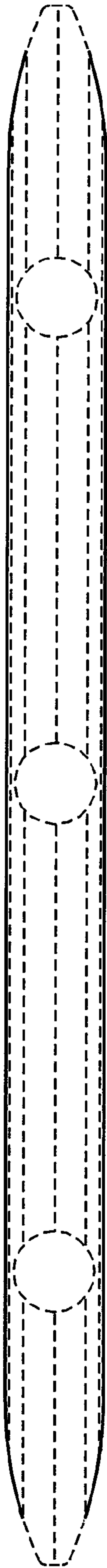

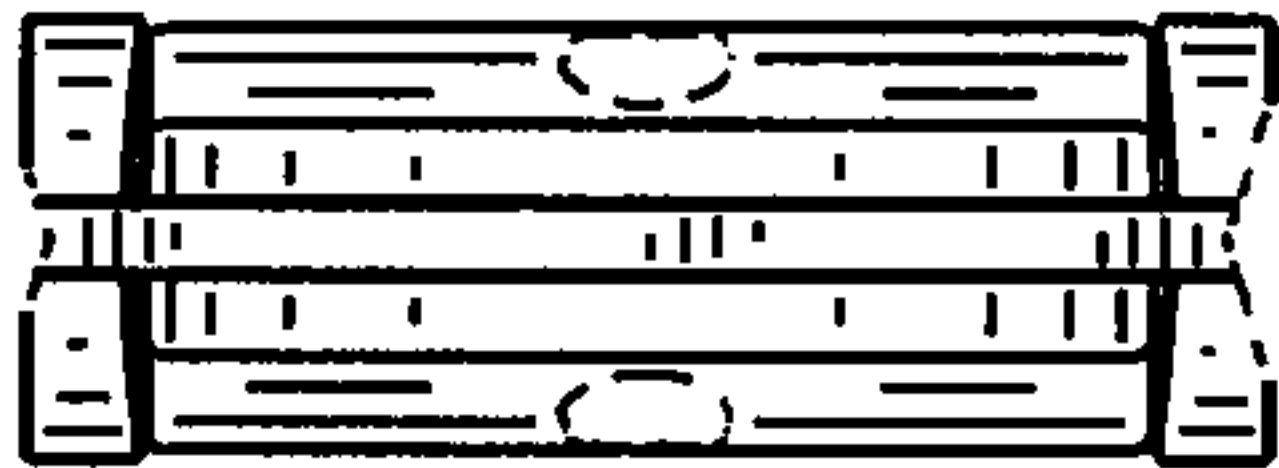

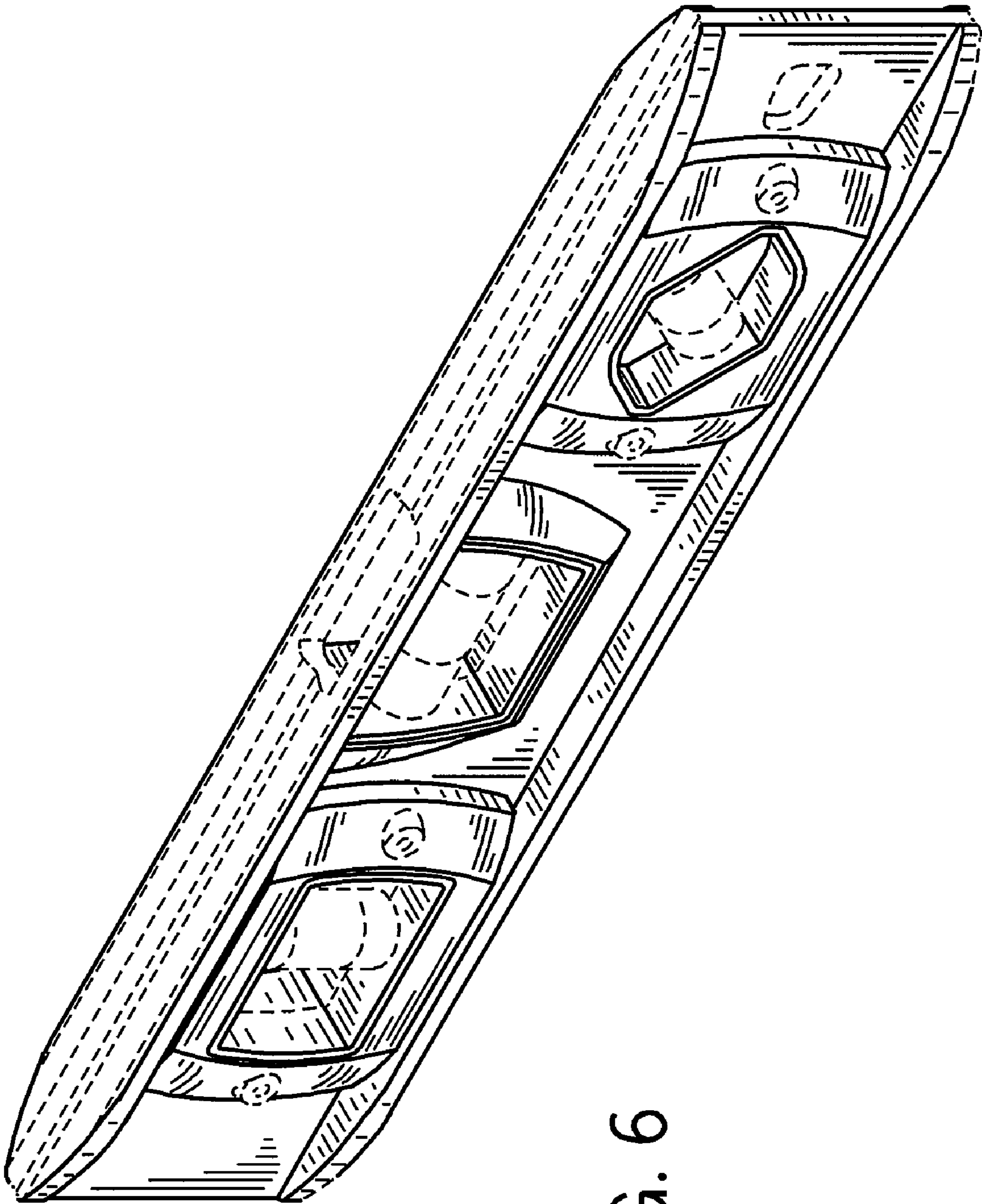

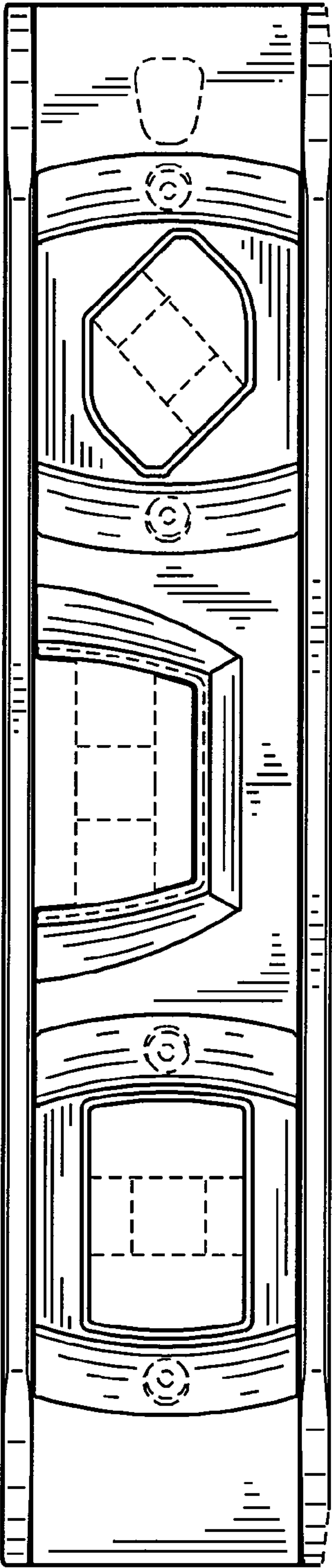

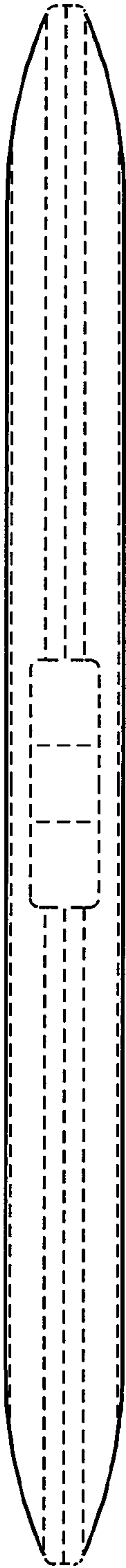

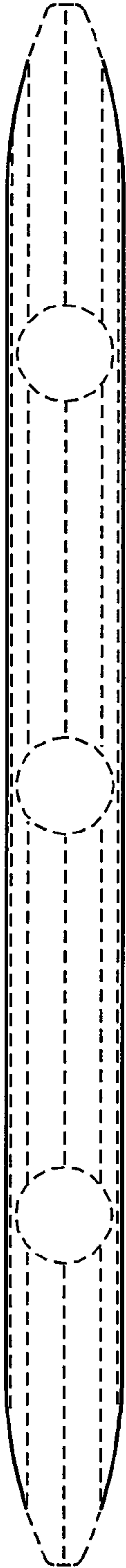
