(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for the chrome insert for a saddlebag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The claimed chrome insert for a saddlebag may used to replace an insert marked “POLICE” when removed from the saddle bags of retired police motorcycles.

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the chrome insert for a saddlebag, shown in position of use on a motorcycle saddlebag;

FIG. 2 is a perspective front view of the chrome insert for a saddlebag;

FIG. 3 is a back elevational view of the chrome insert for a saddlebag;

FIG. 5 is a bottom elevational view of the chrome insert for a saddlebag;

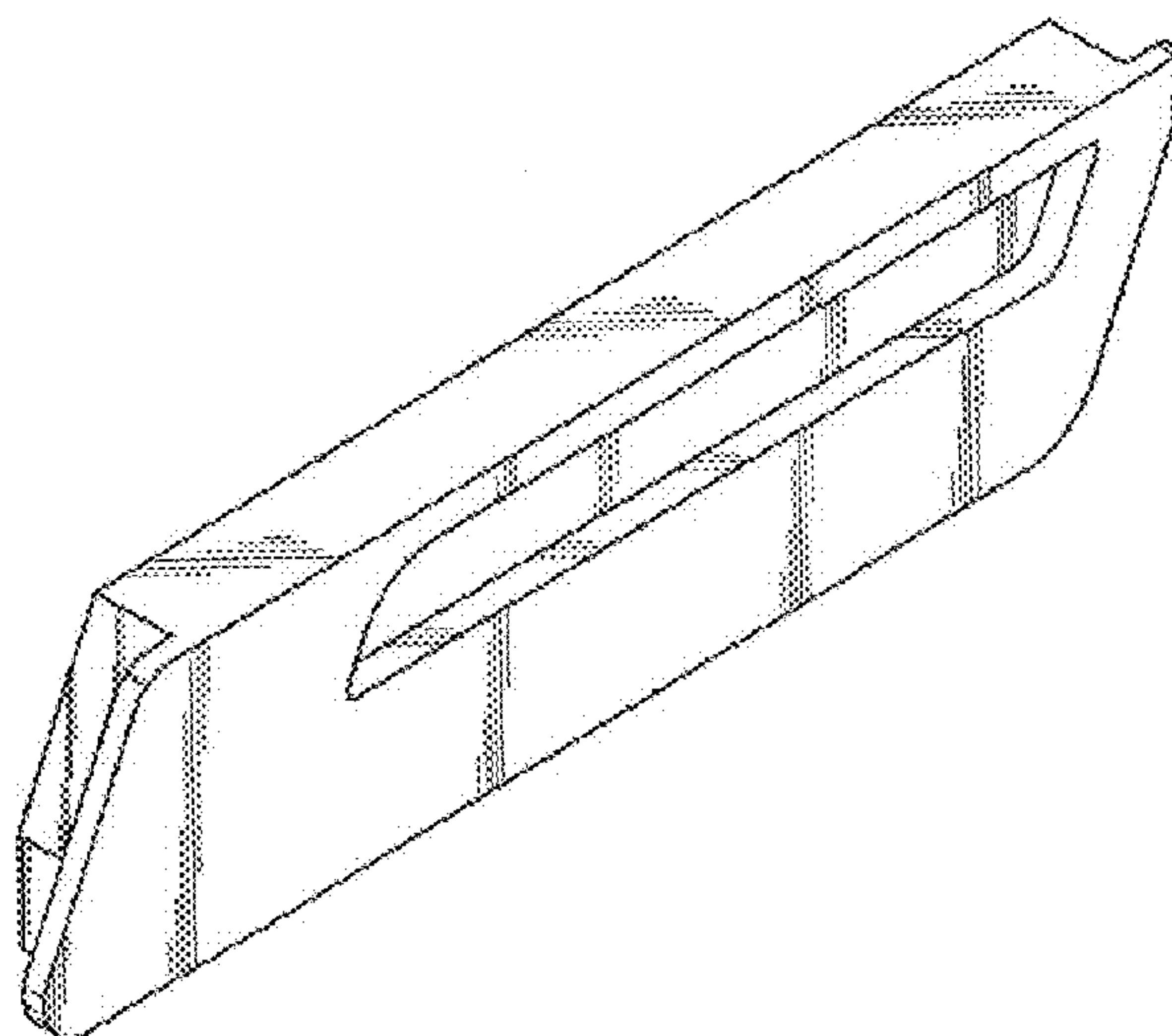
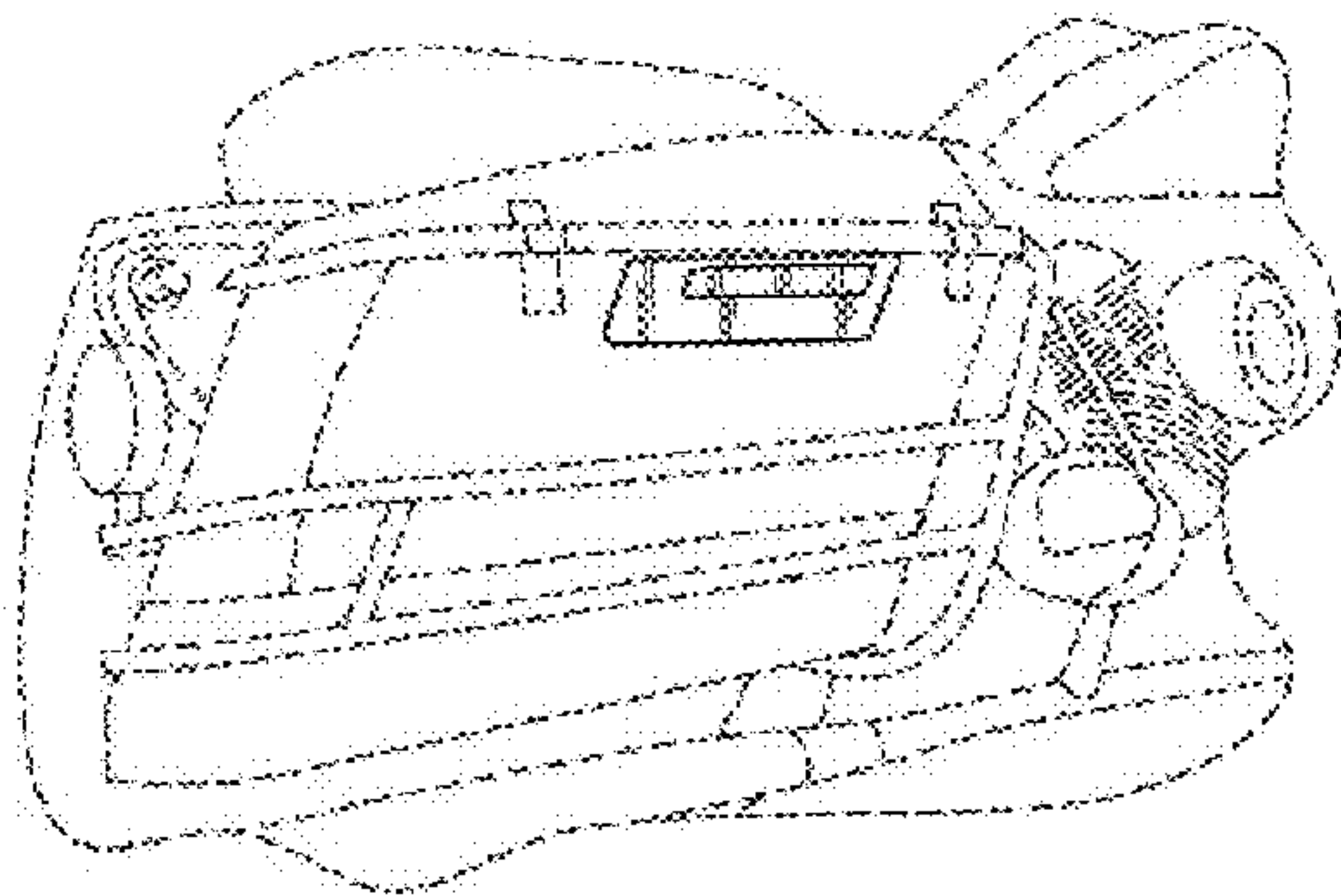
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of the chrome insert for a saddlebag;

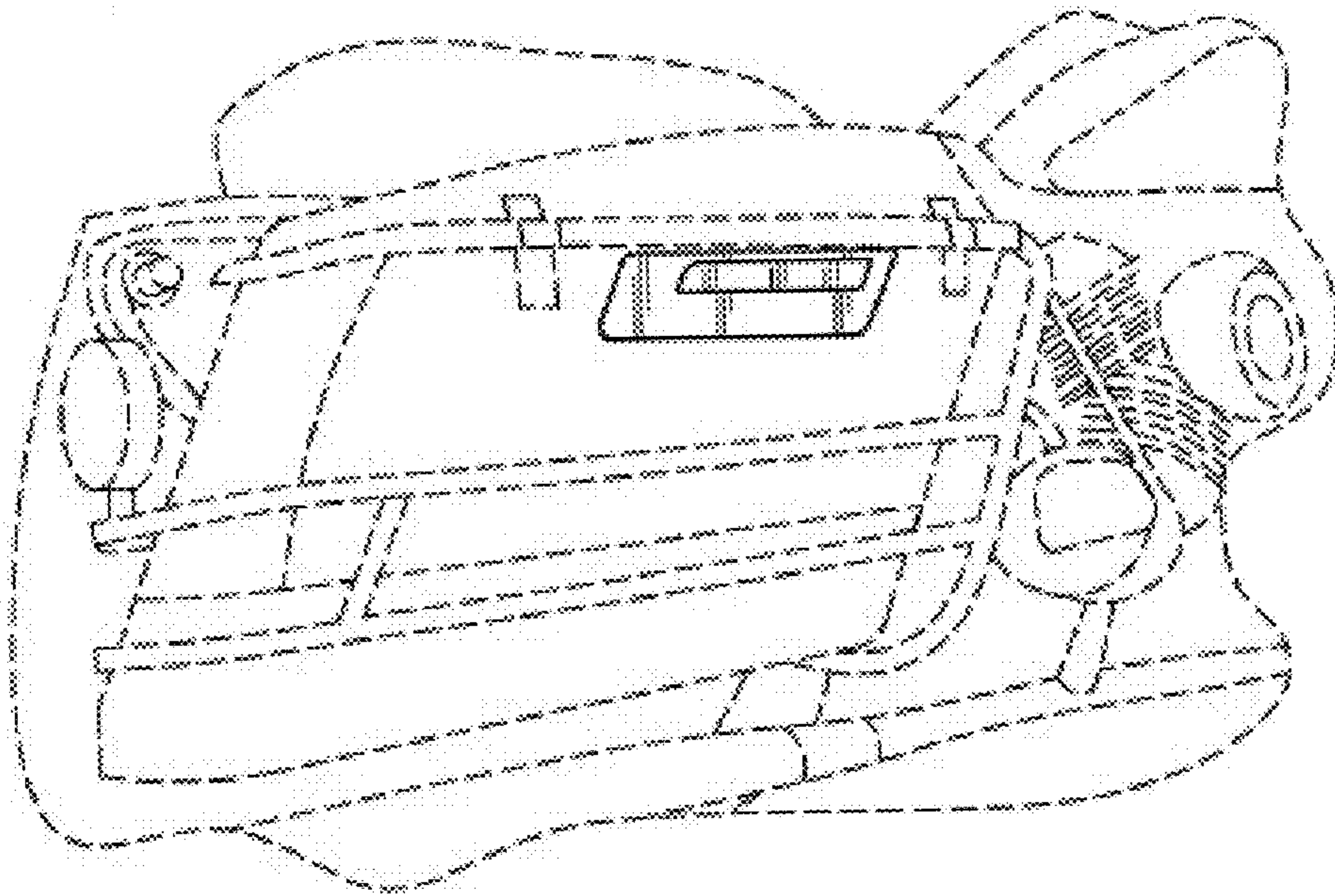

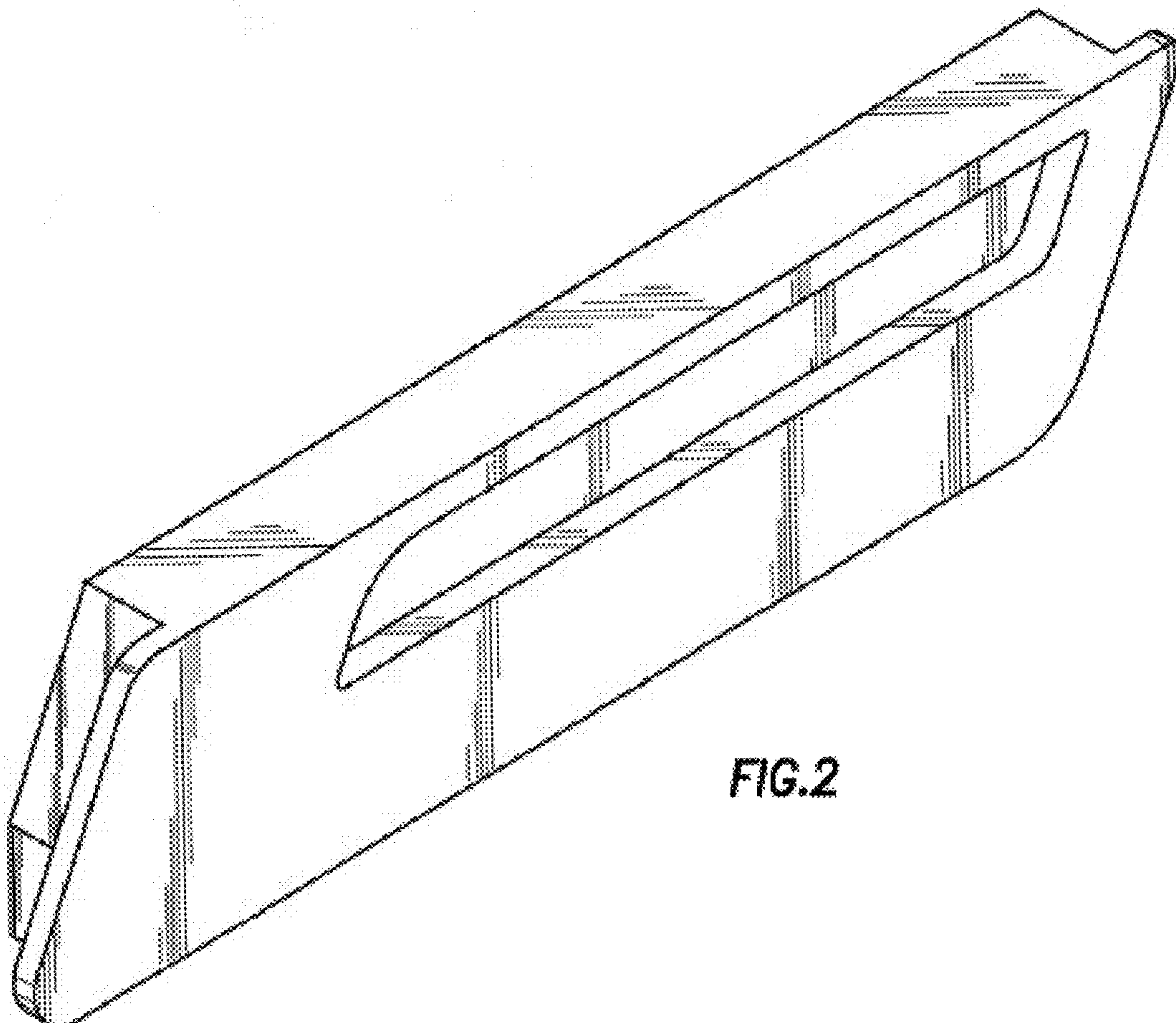

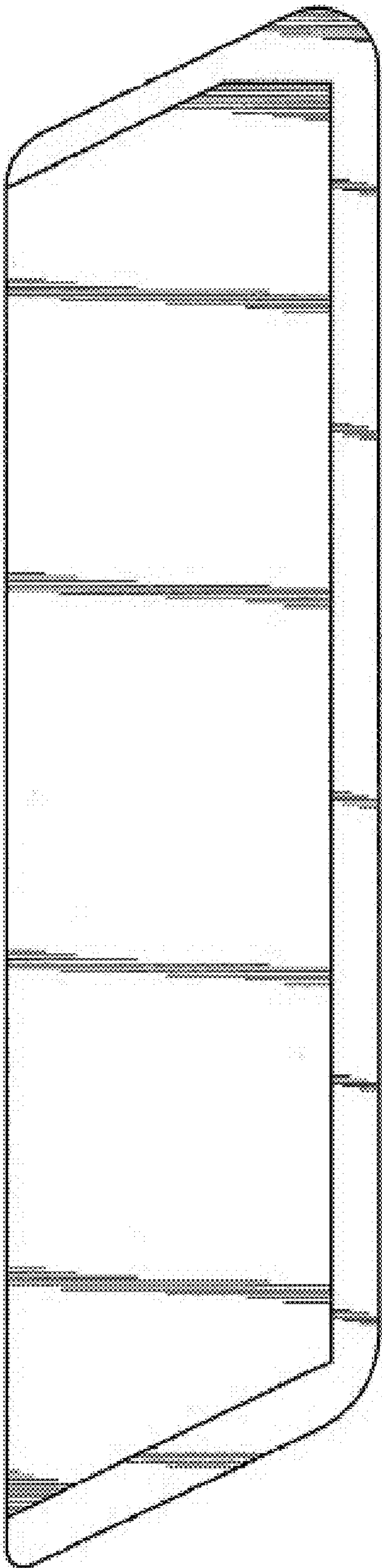

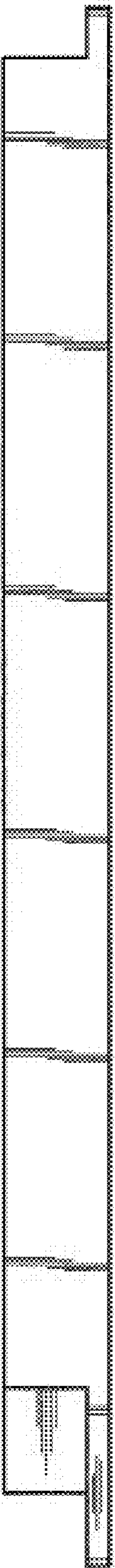

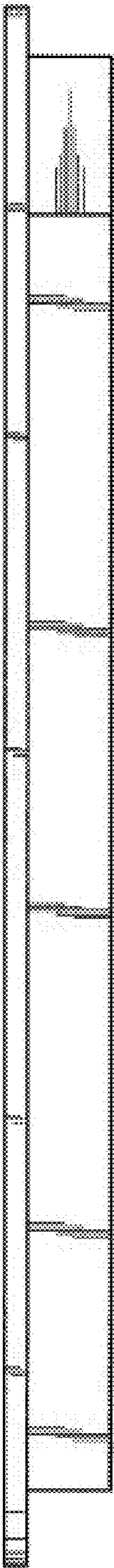

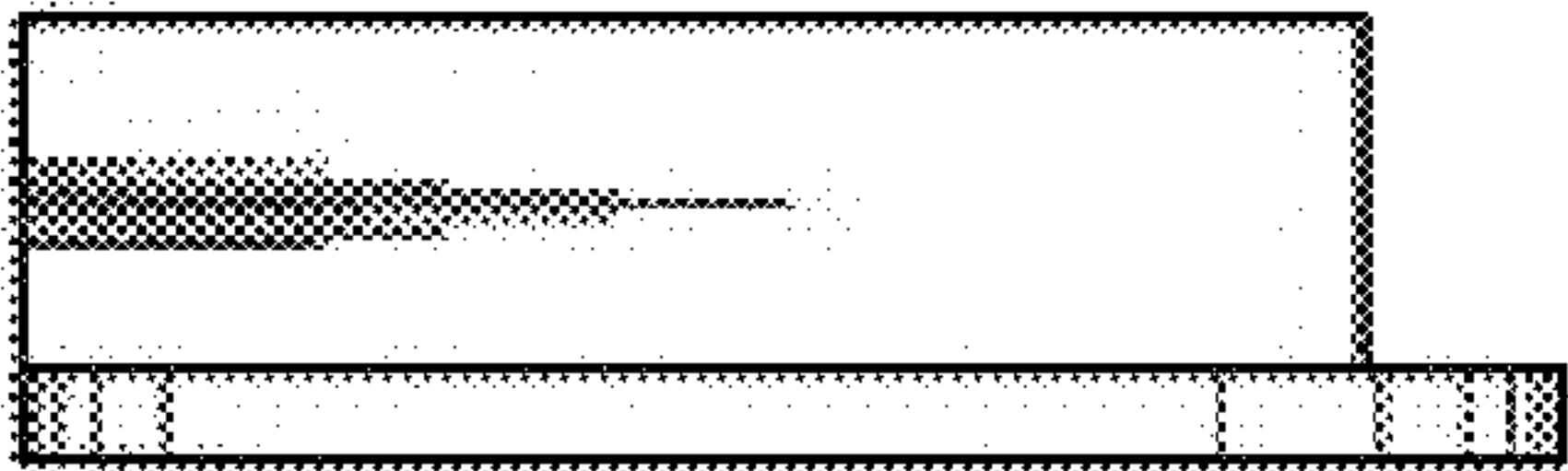

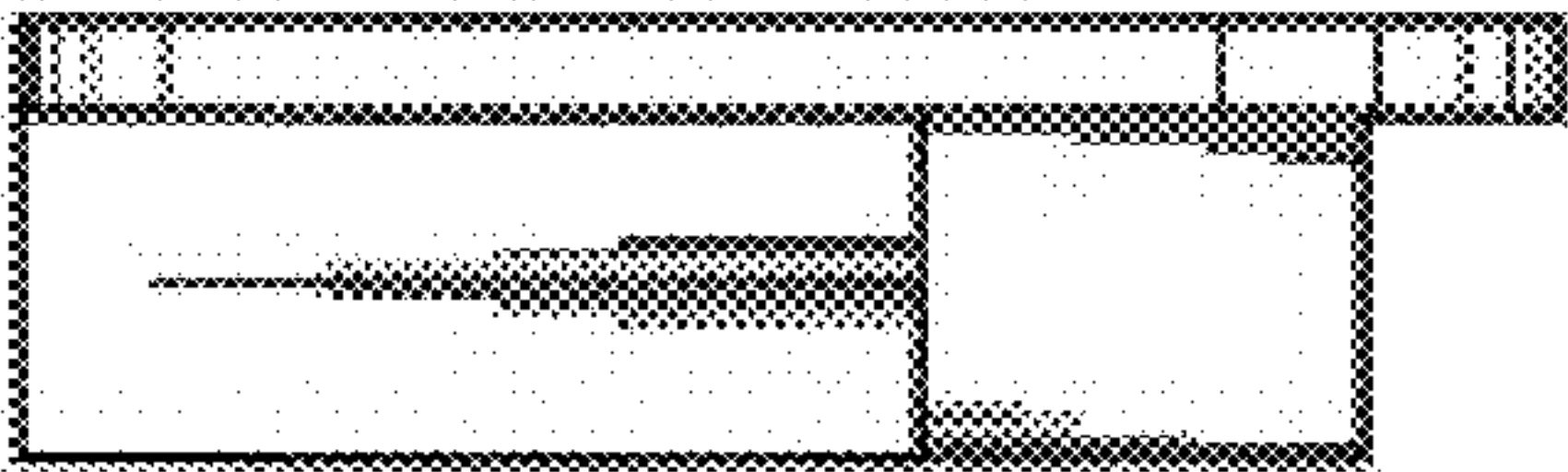

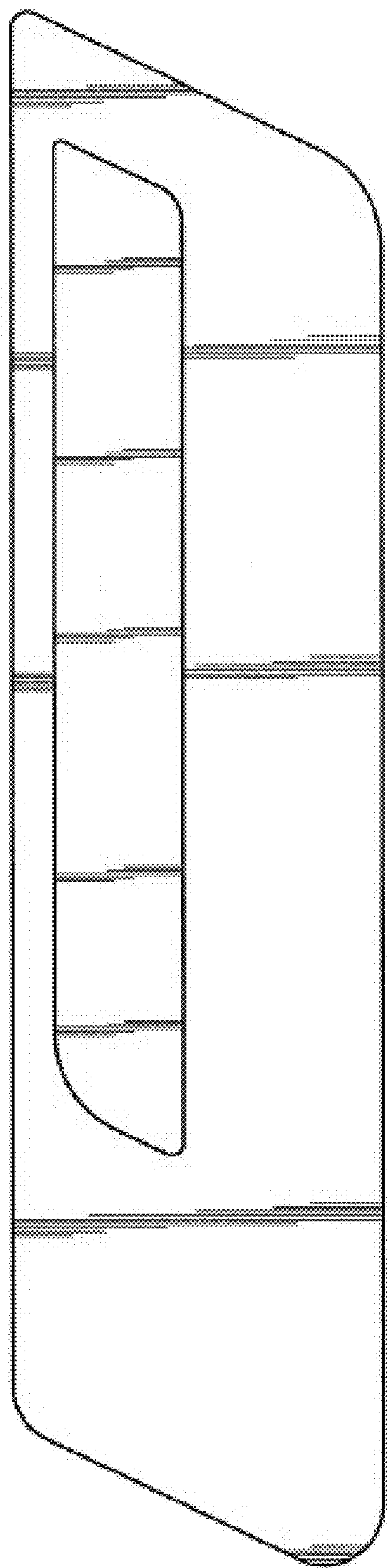
