The ornamental design for a furniture panel, as shown and  
described.

**DESCRIPTION**

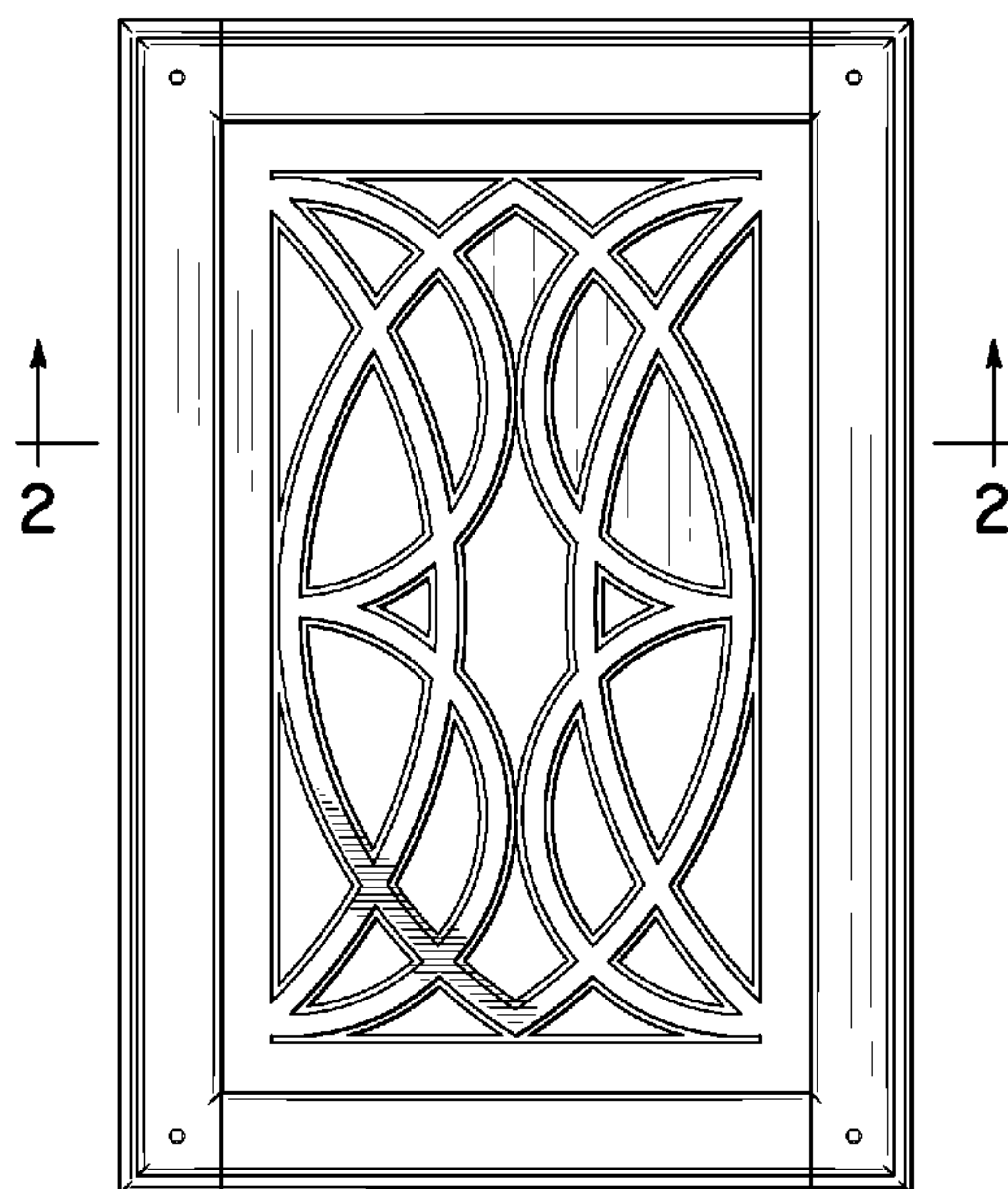
FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 2—2 of FIG.

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a furniture panel, identi-  
fying the location of the cross-sectional view of FIG. 2, show-  
ing my new design.

1 to show surface ornamentation.

FIG. 3 is a right-side elevational view thereof, with the left-  
side elevational view thereof being a mirror image.

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, with the bottom plan view  
being a mirror image thereof.

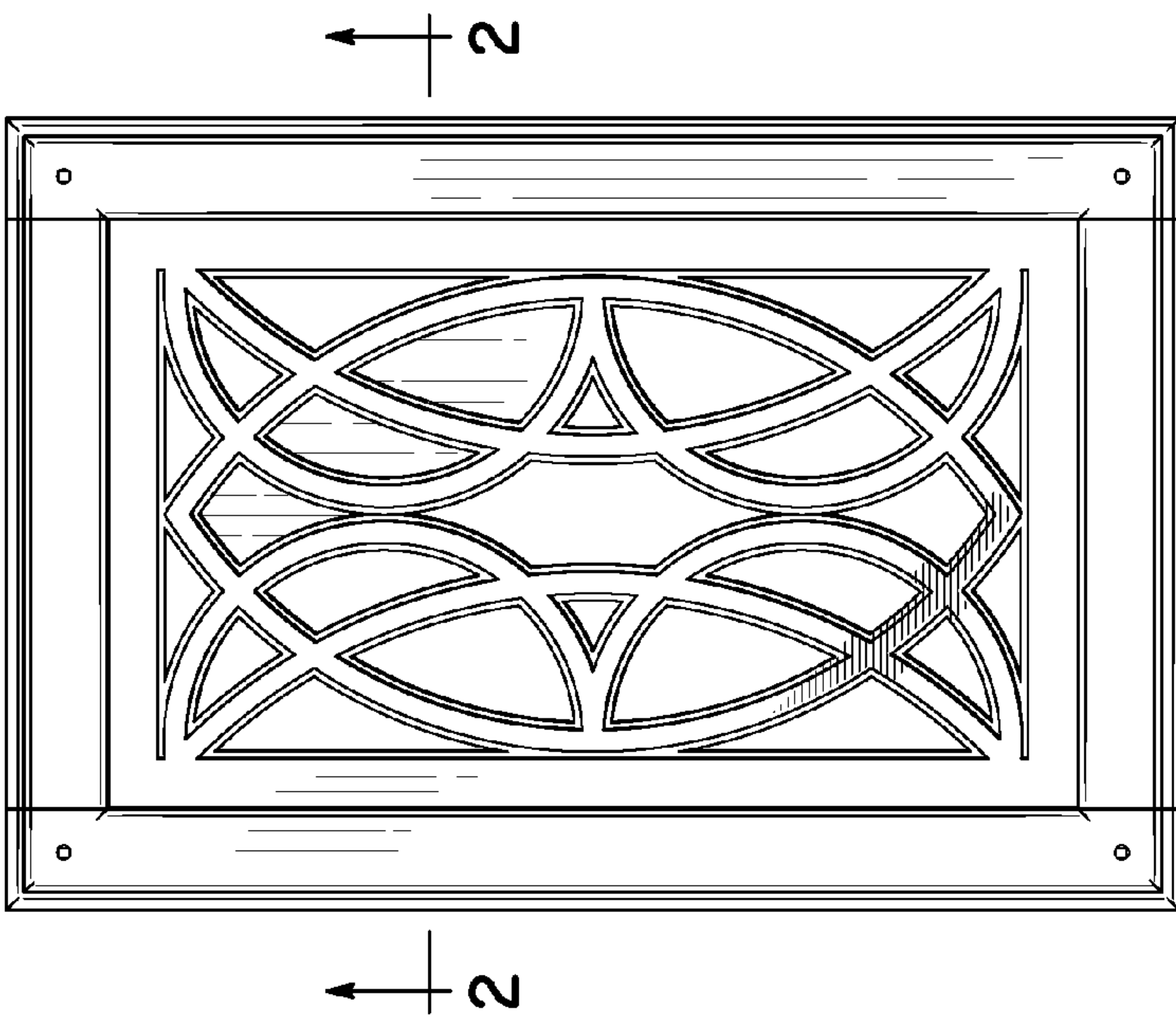

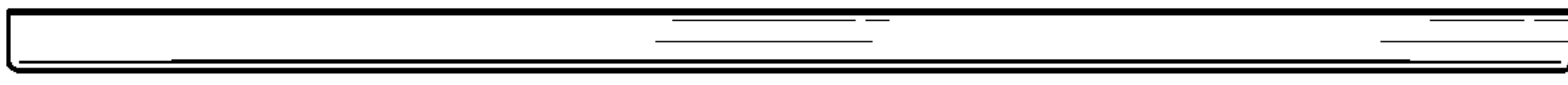

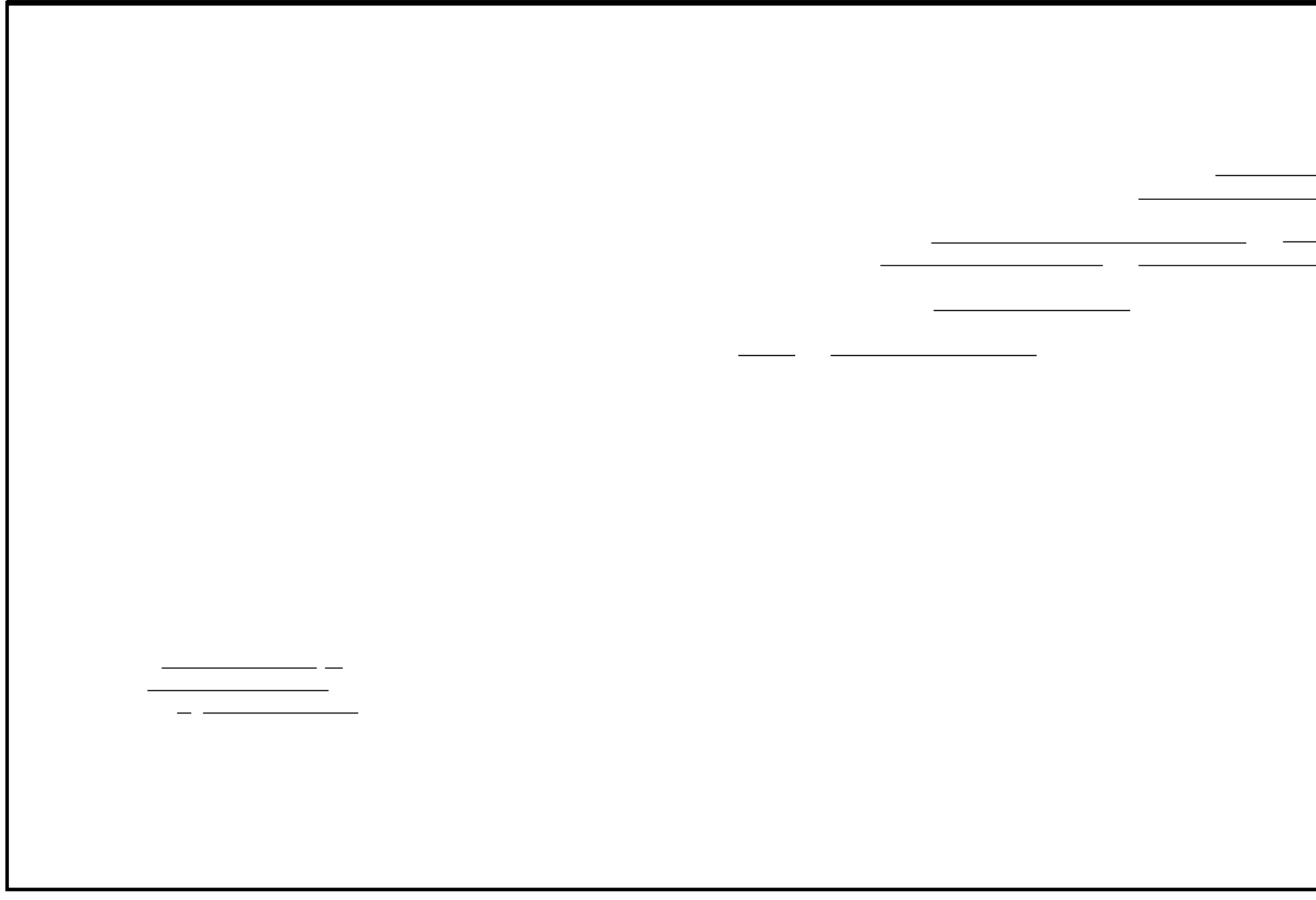

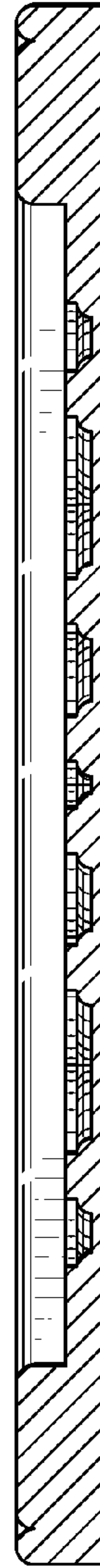

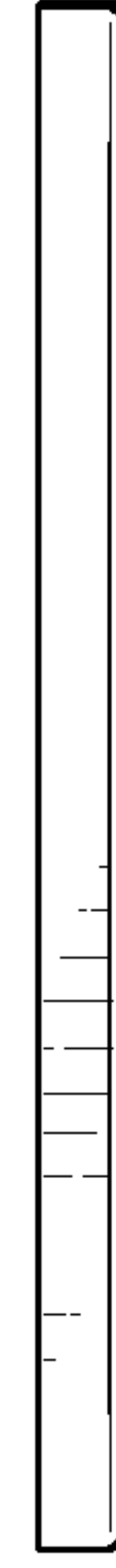
