invention;

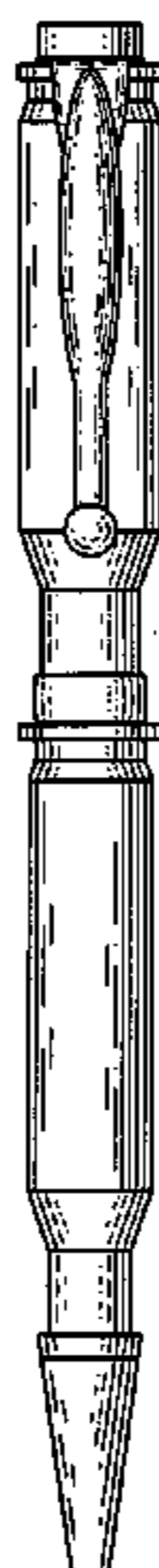
FIG. 5 is a top view of the writing instrument of the present

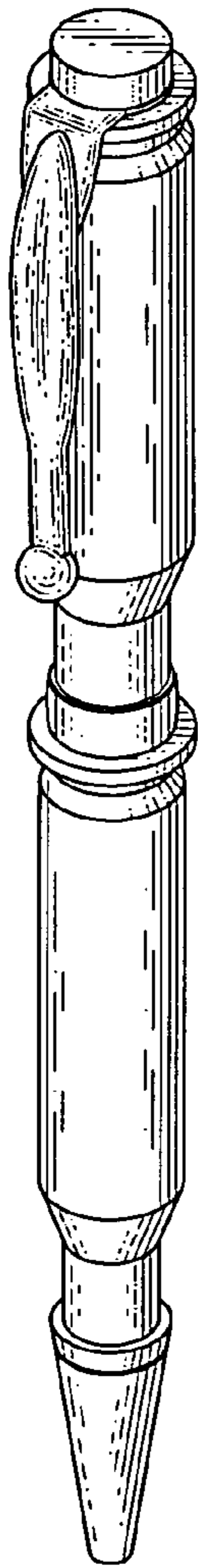

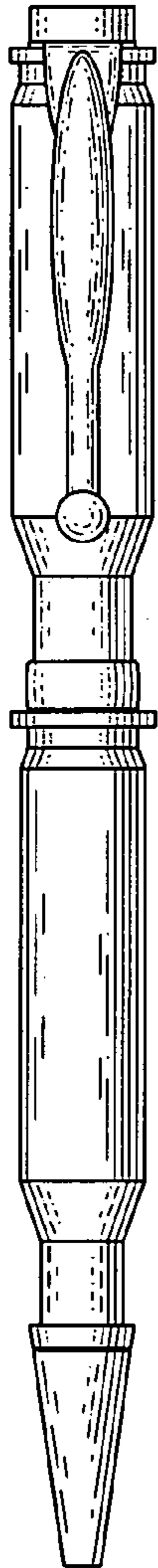

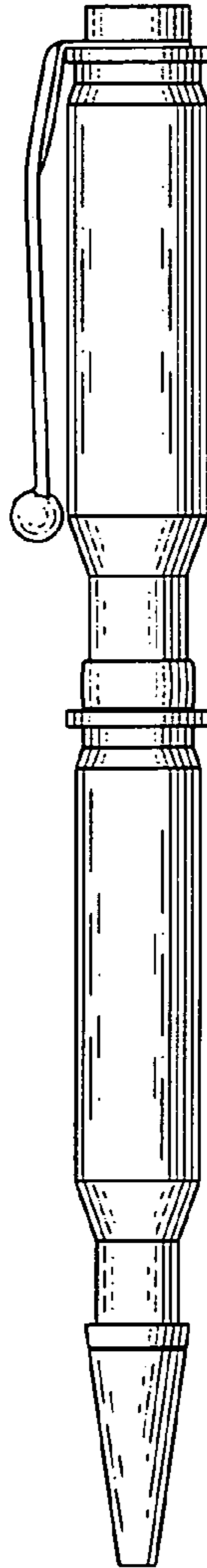

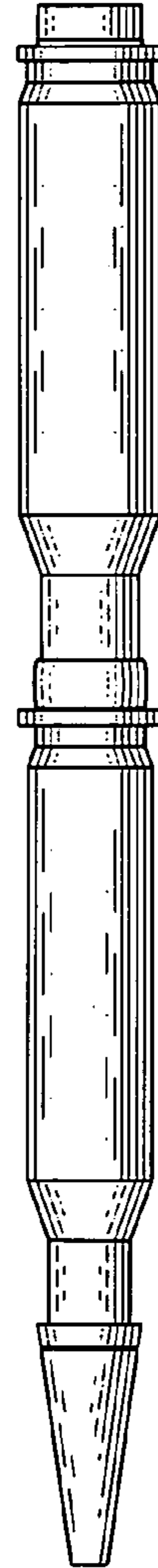

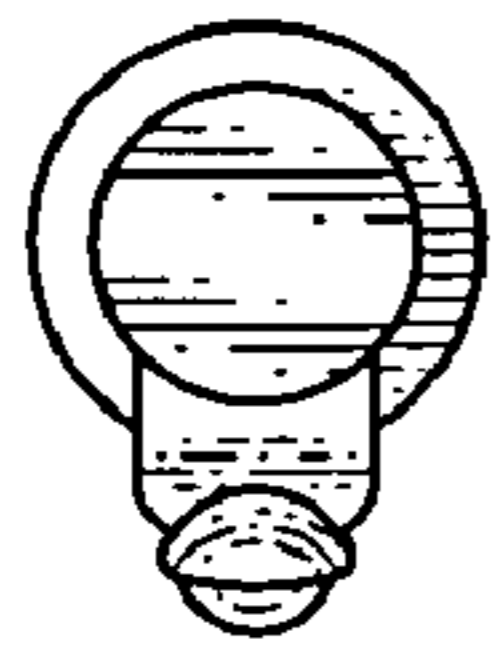

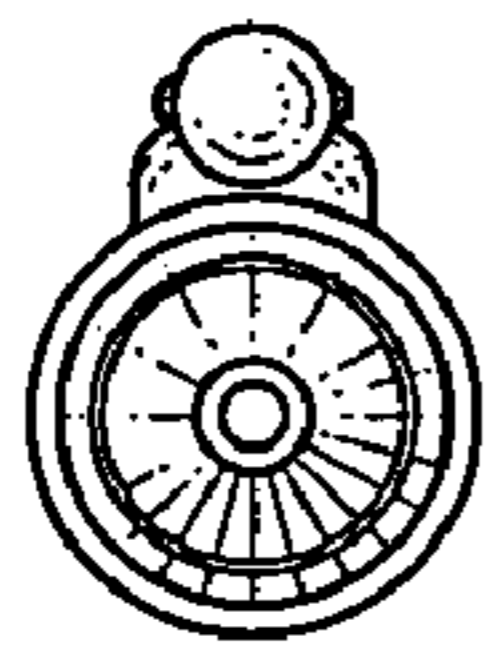

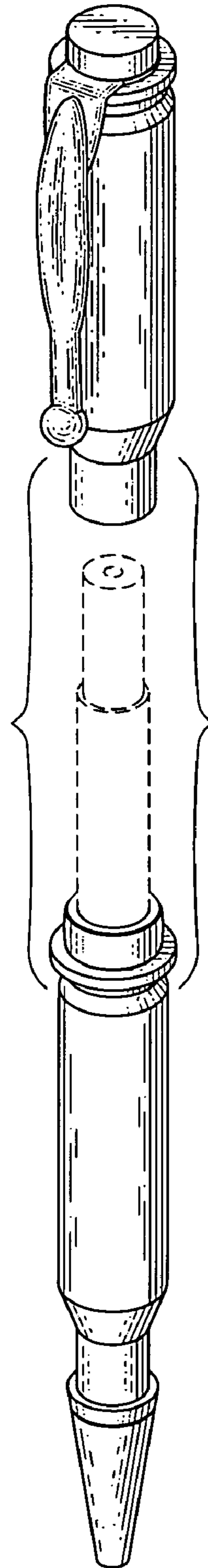
